DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a cleaning tool grip accord-
ing to an exemplary embodiment of the present disclosure;

rotated one hundred eighty degrees with respect to the view of

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the cleaning tool grip of FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is a top perspective view of the cleaning tool grip of

view of FIG. 12;

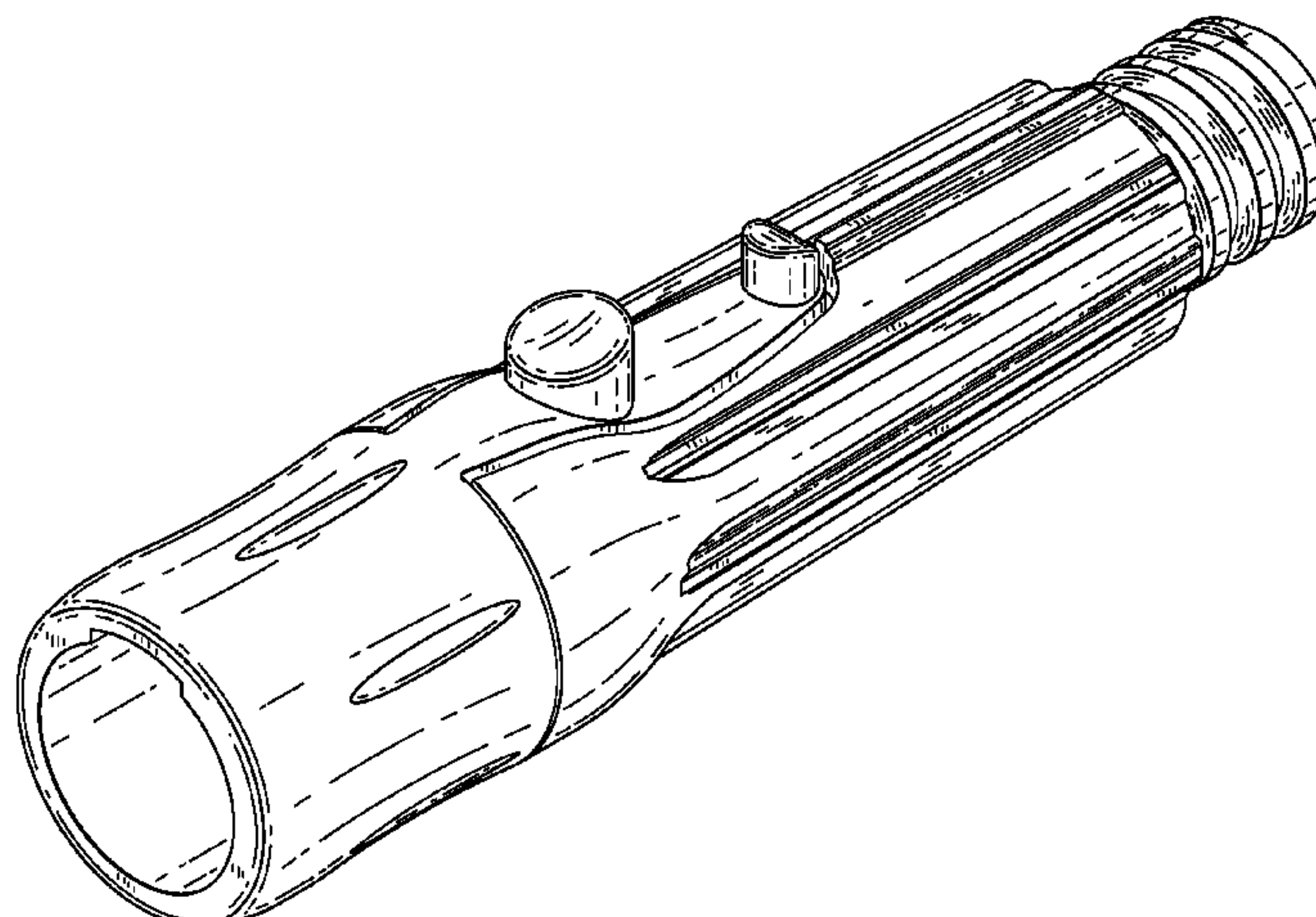
FIG. 16 is a bottom view of the cleaning tool grip of FIG. 10;

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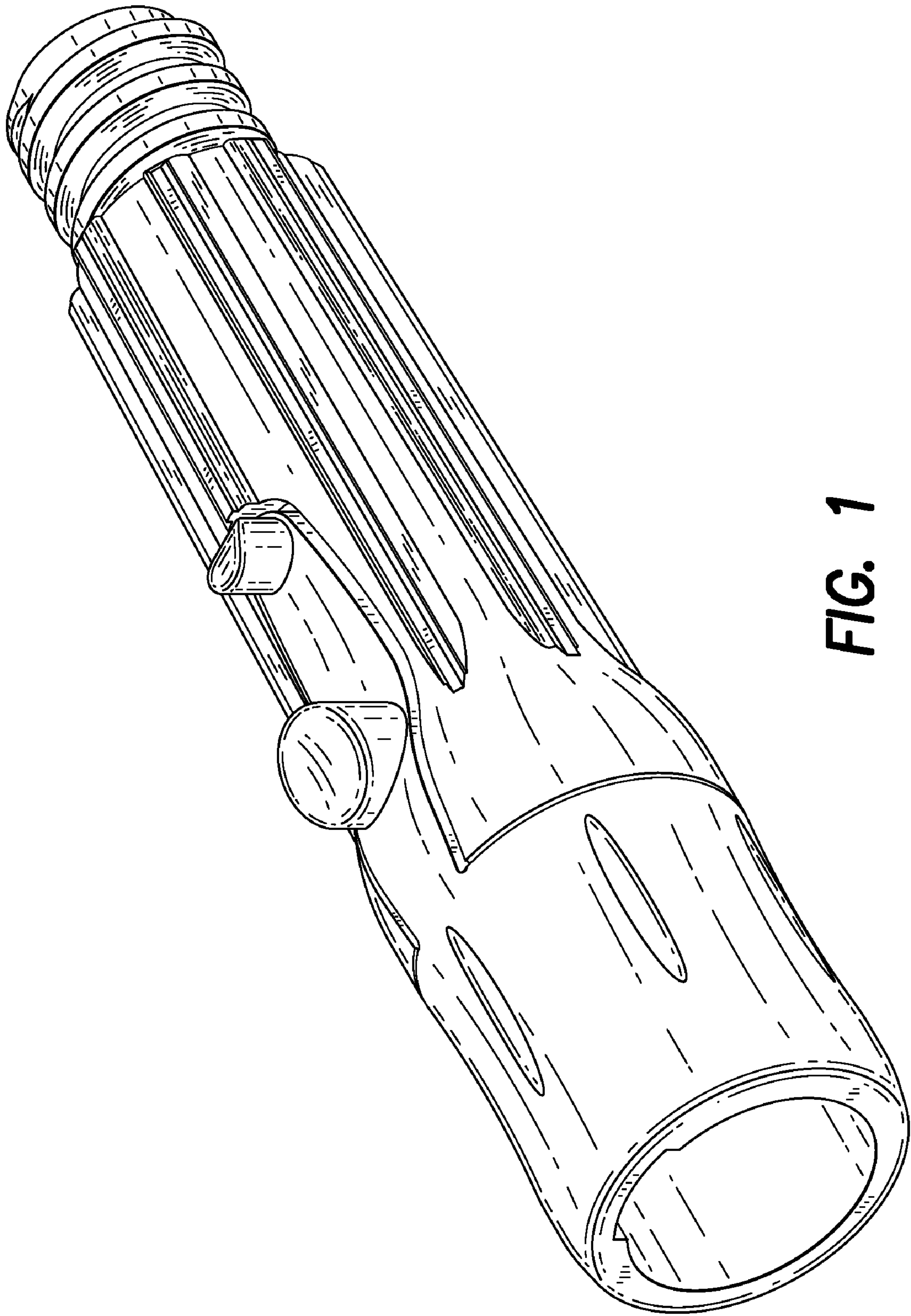

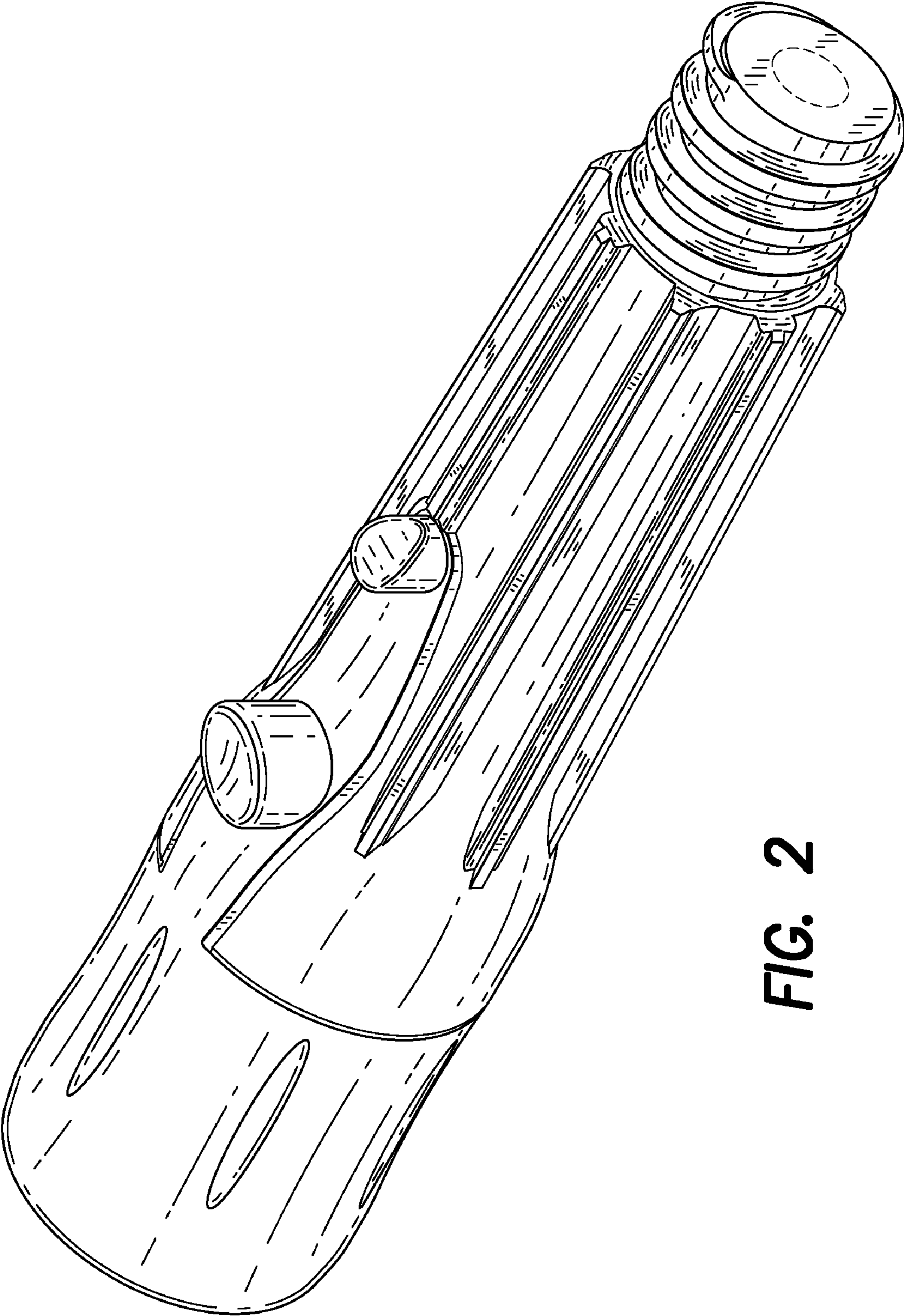

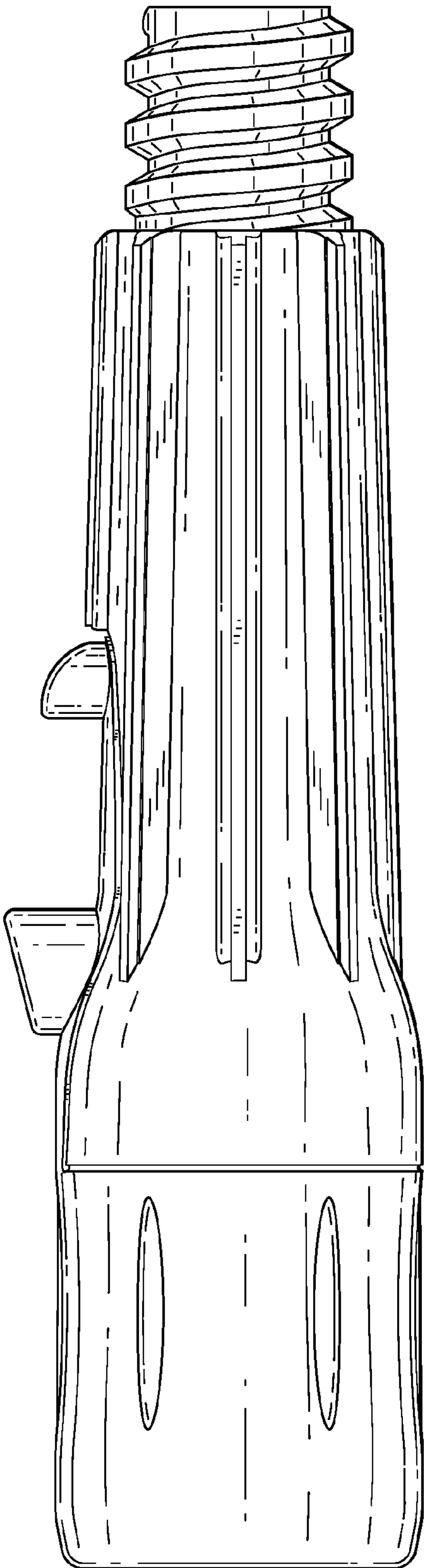

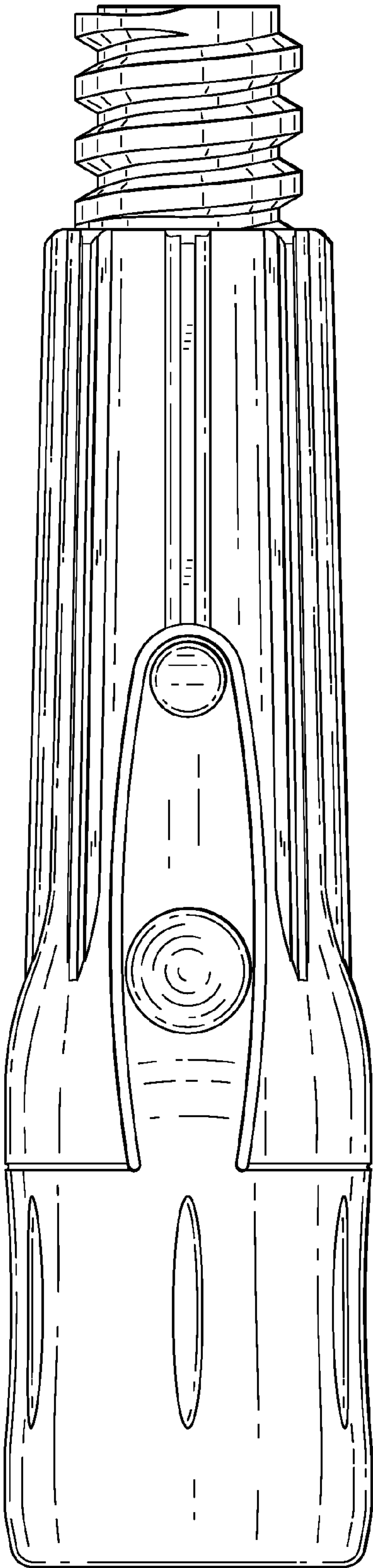

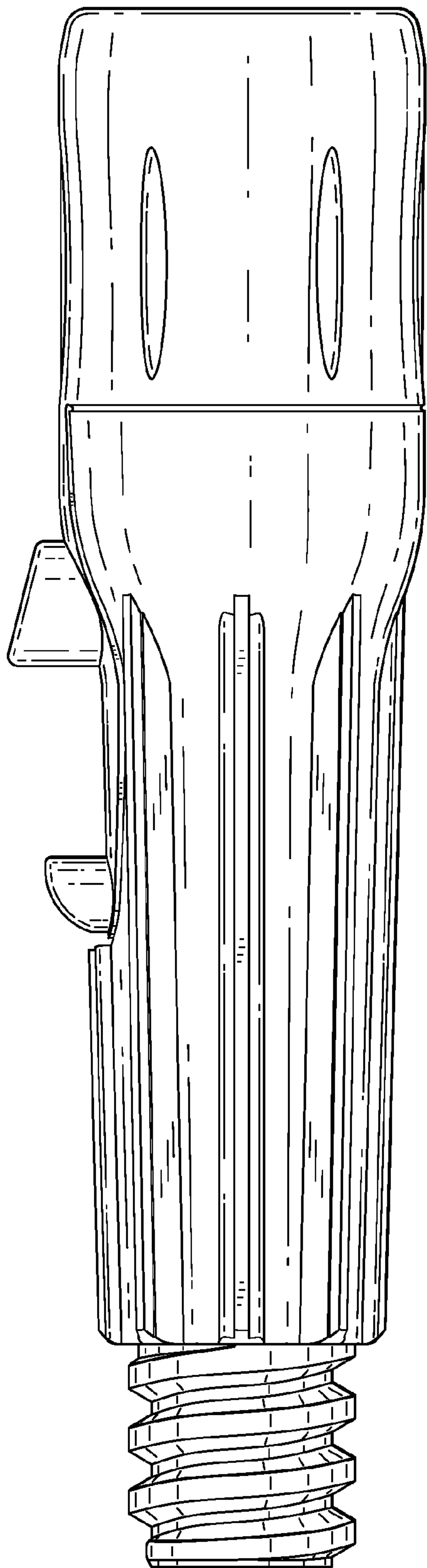

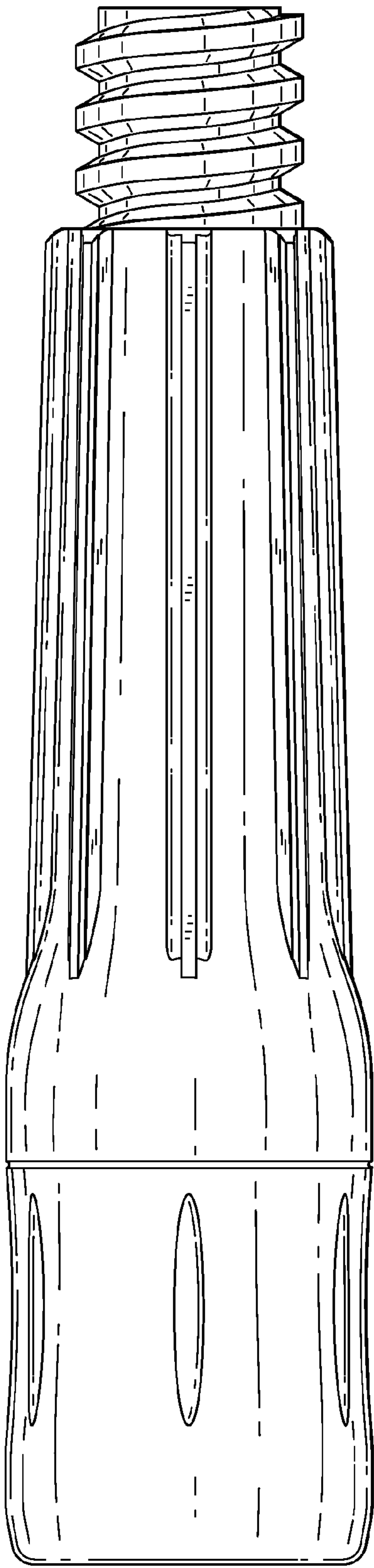

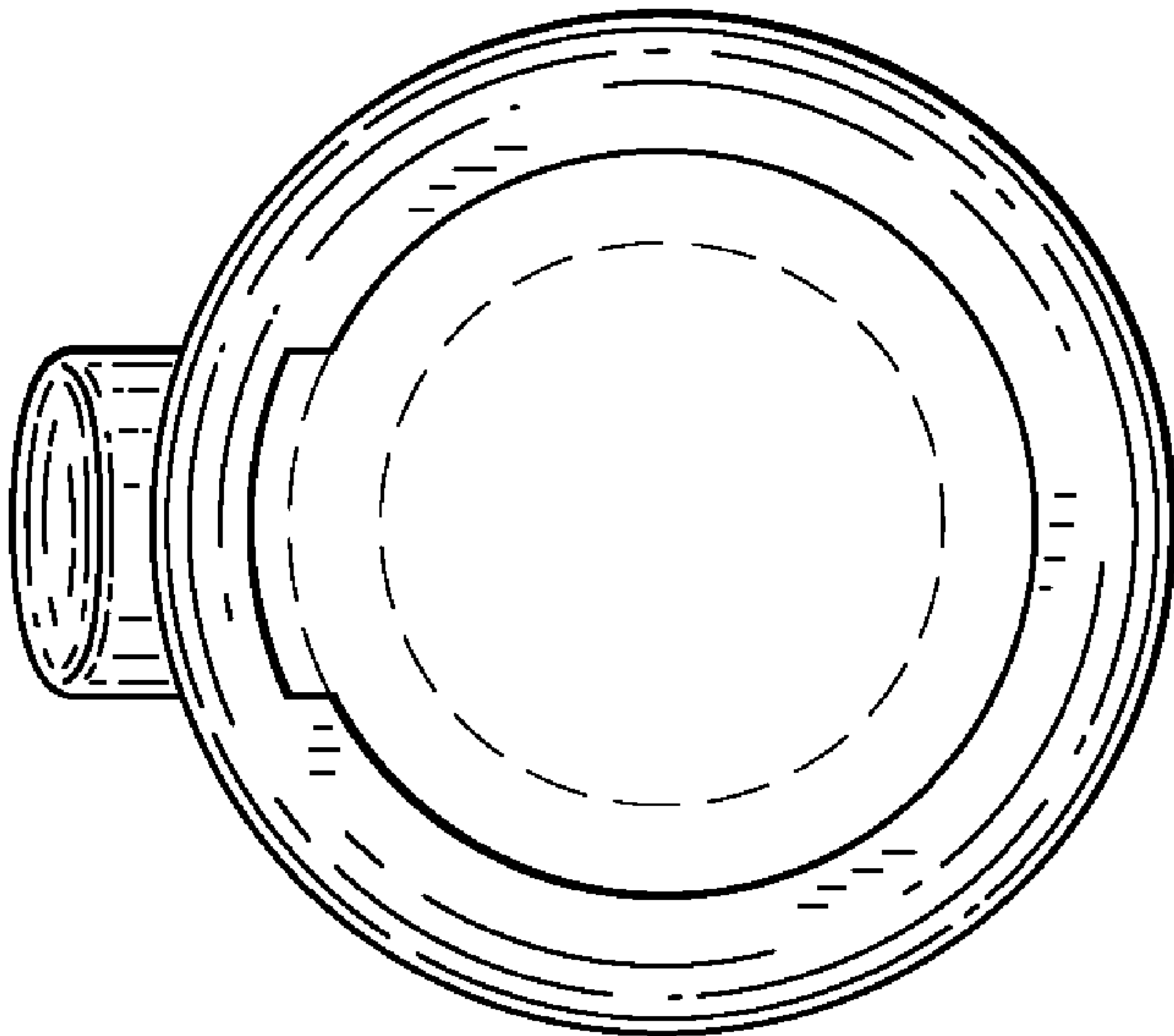

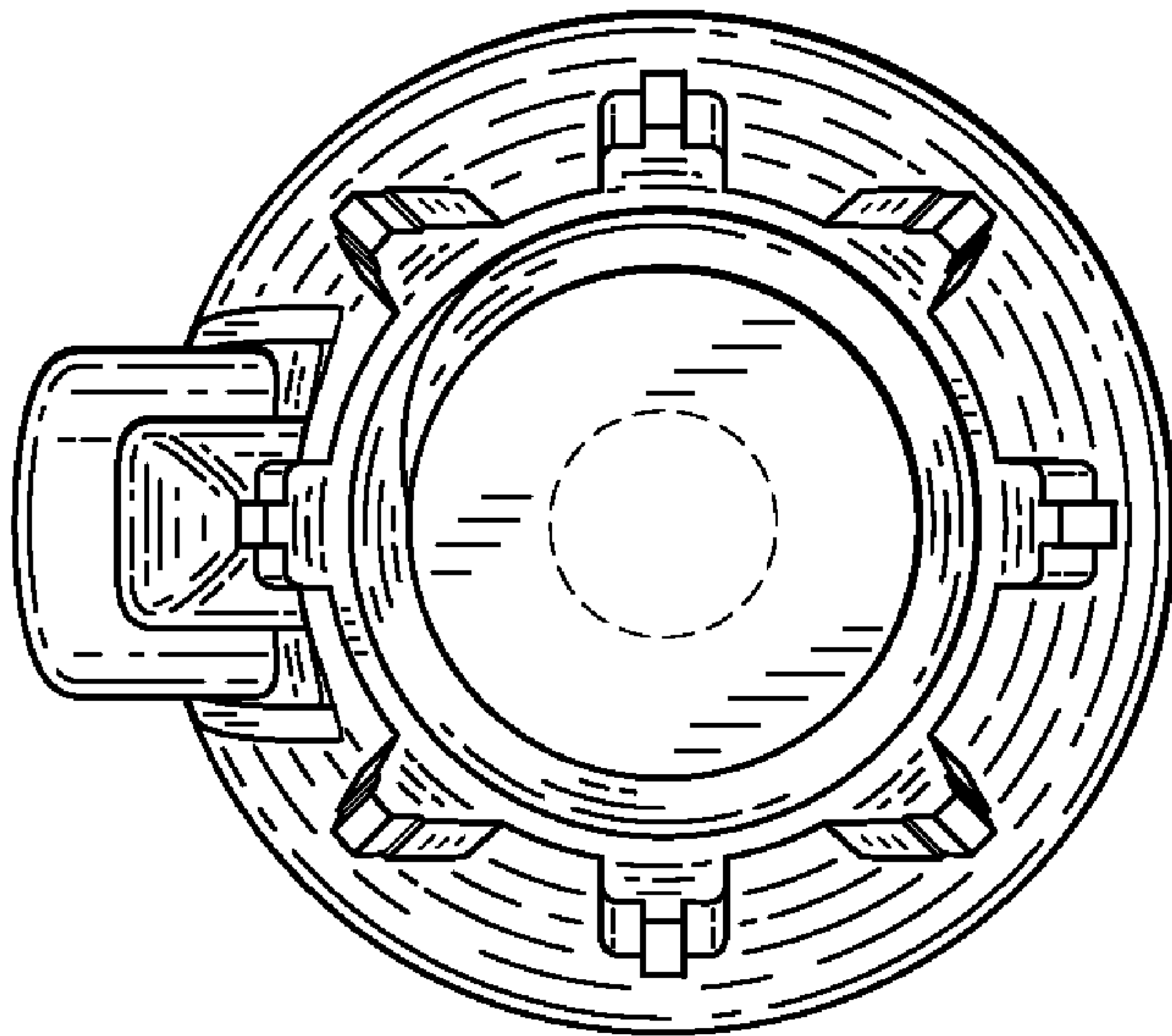

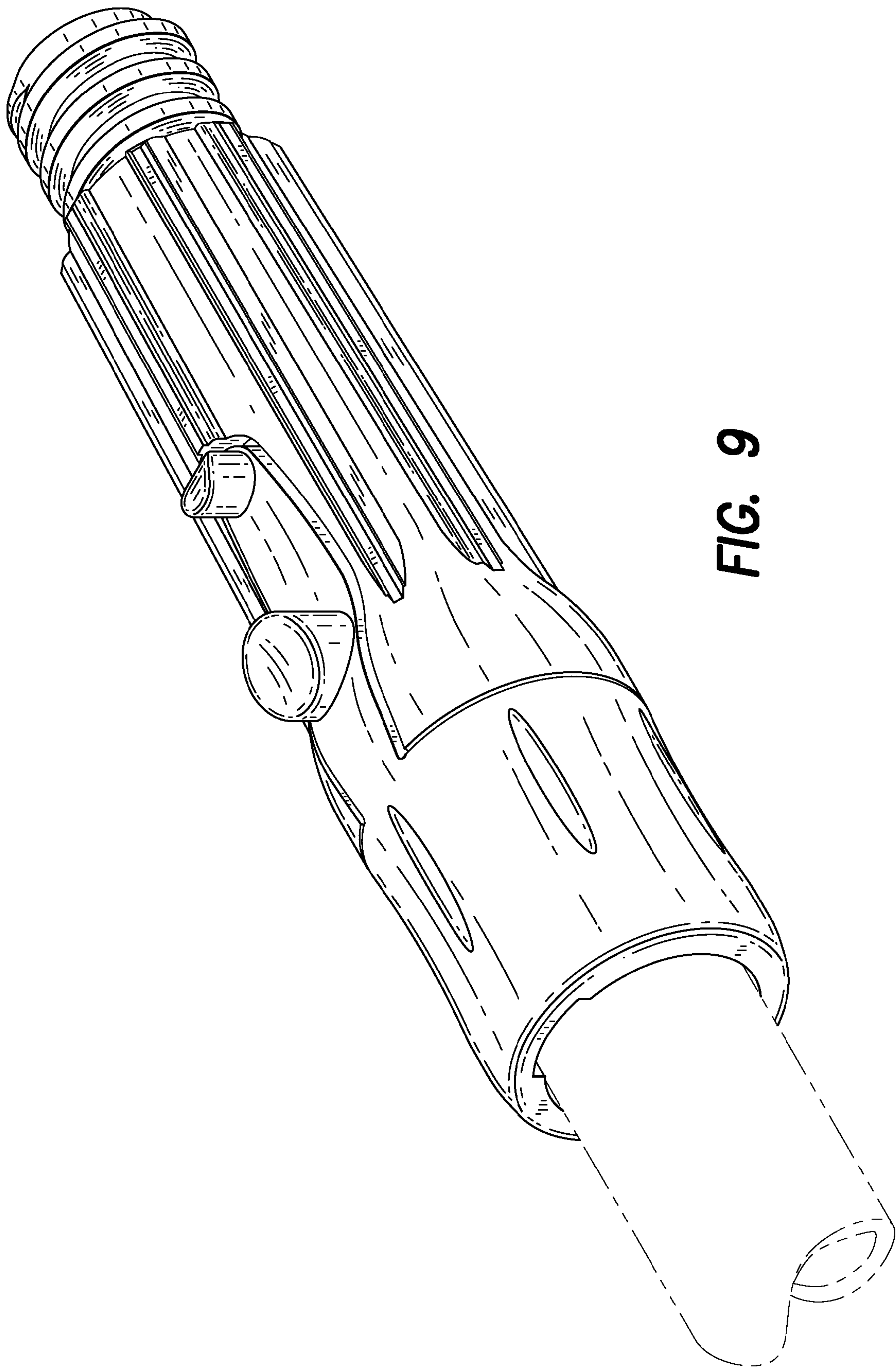

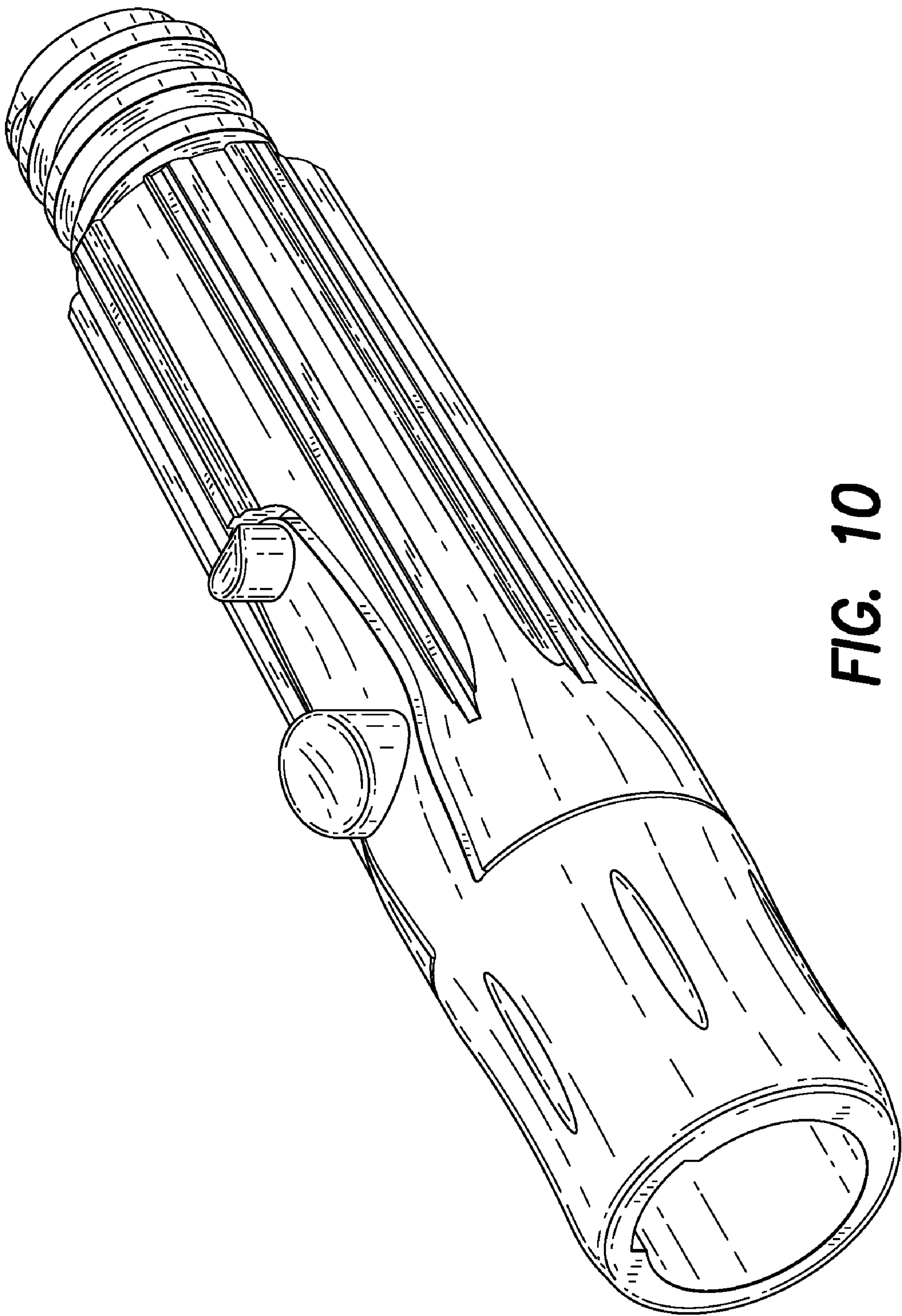

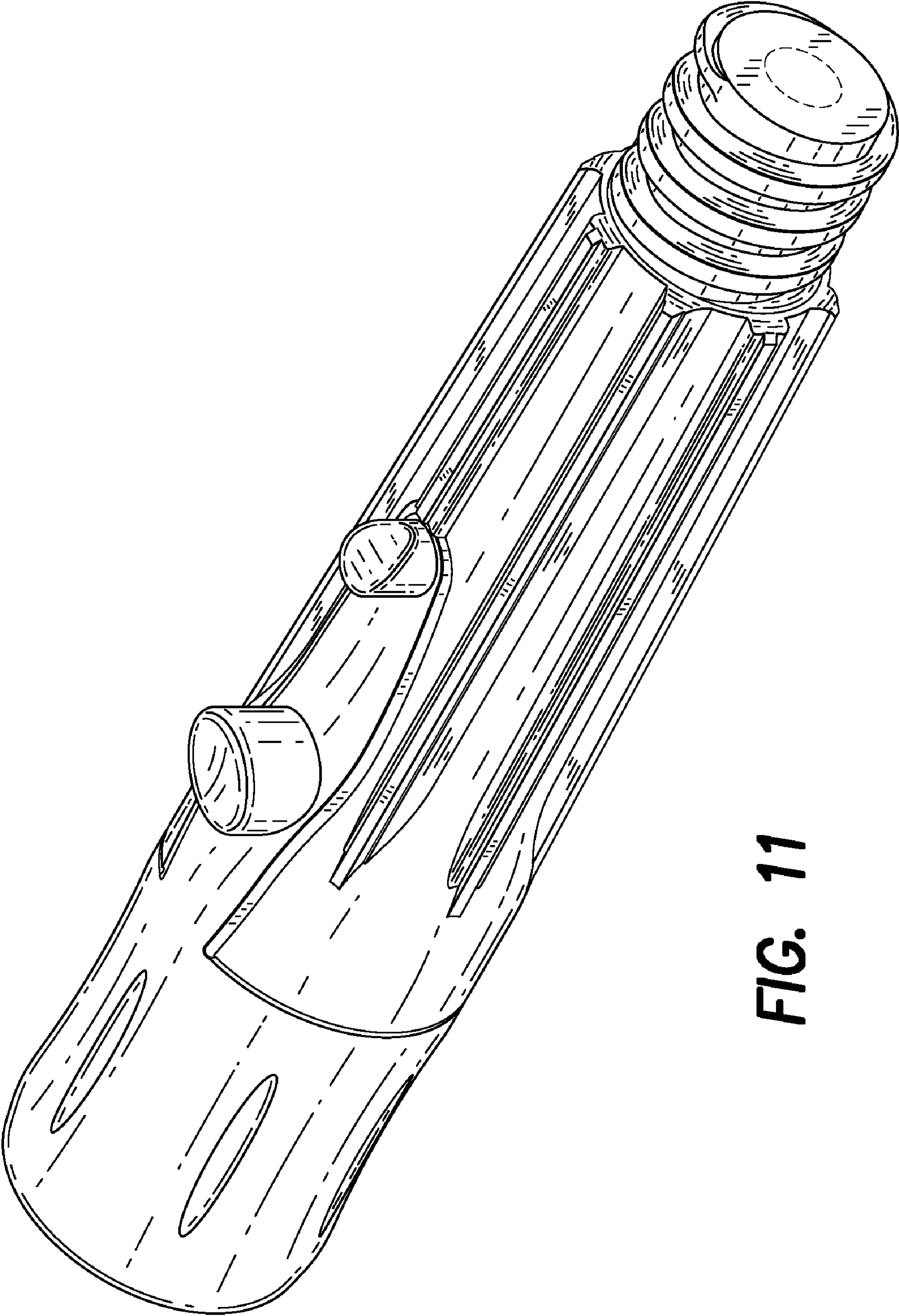

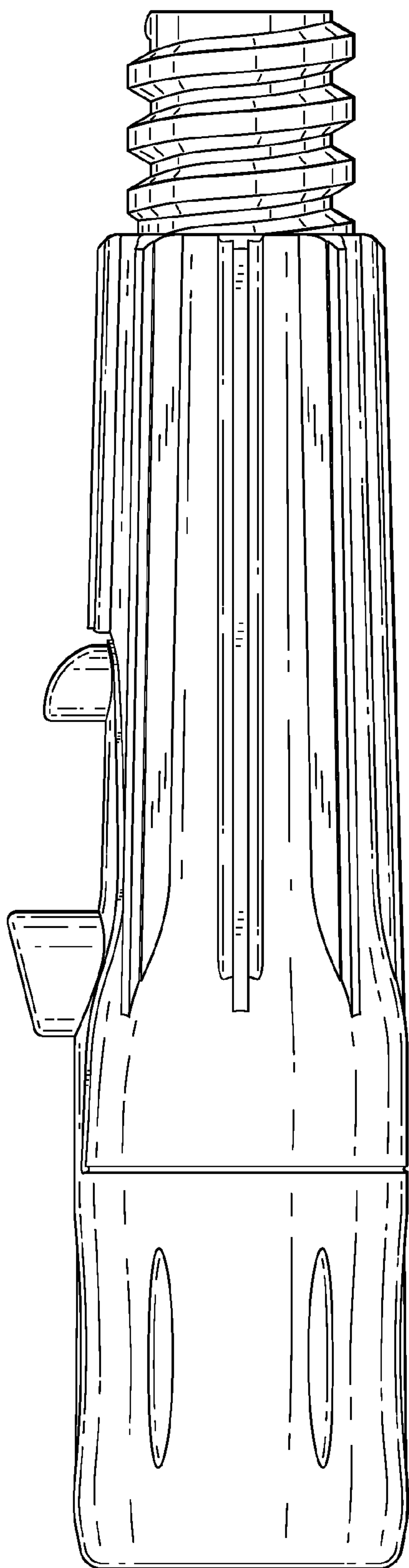

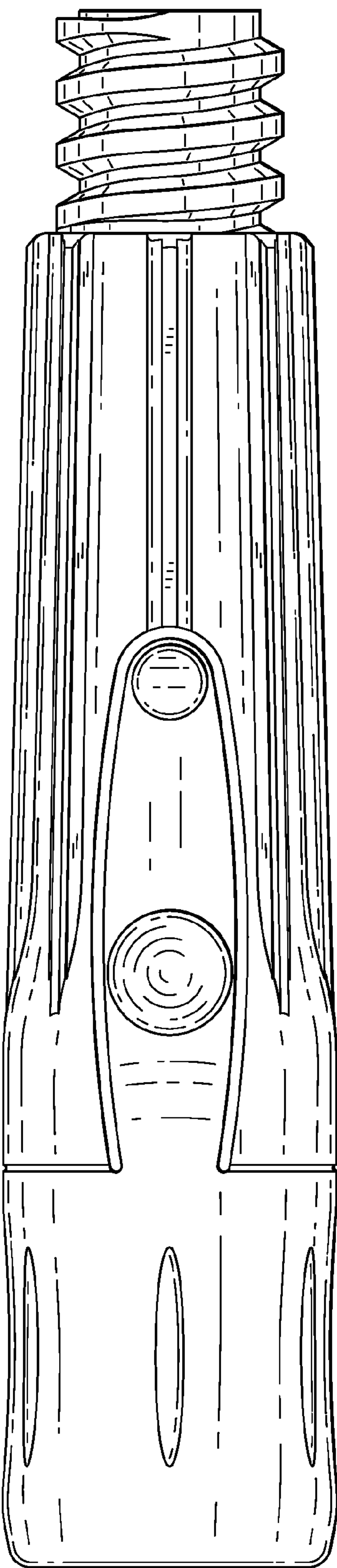

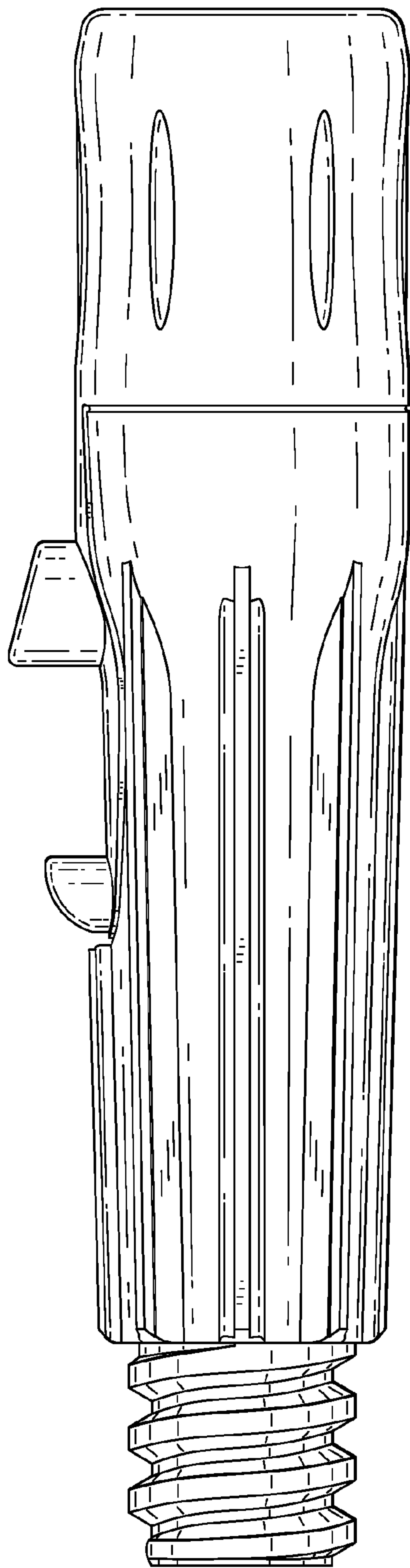

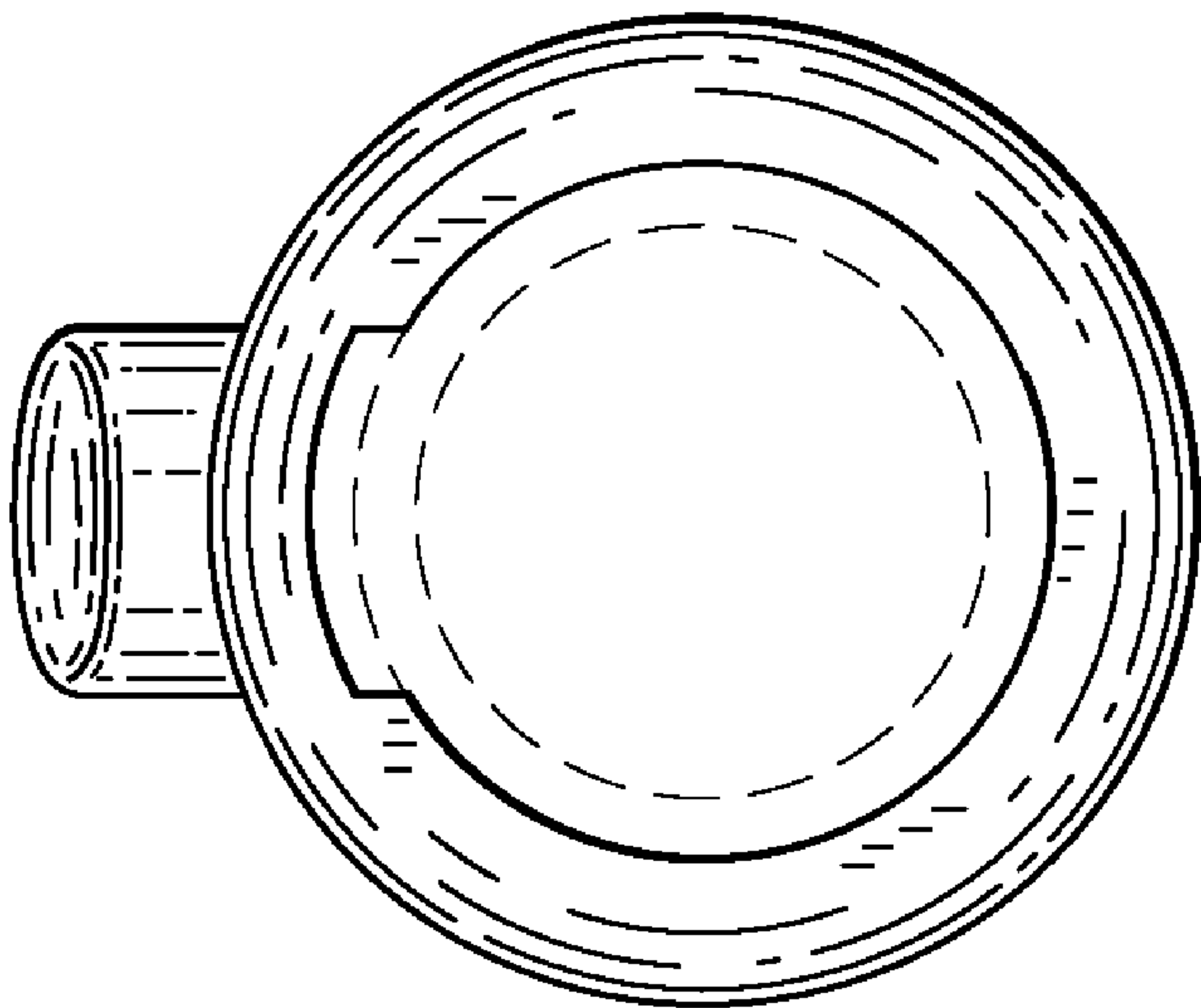

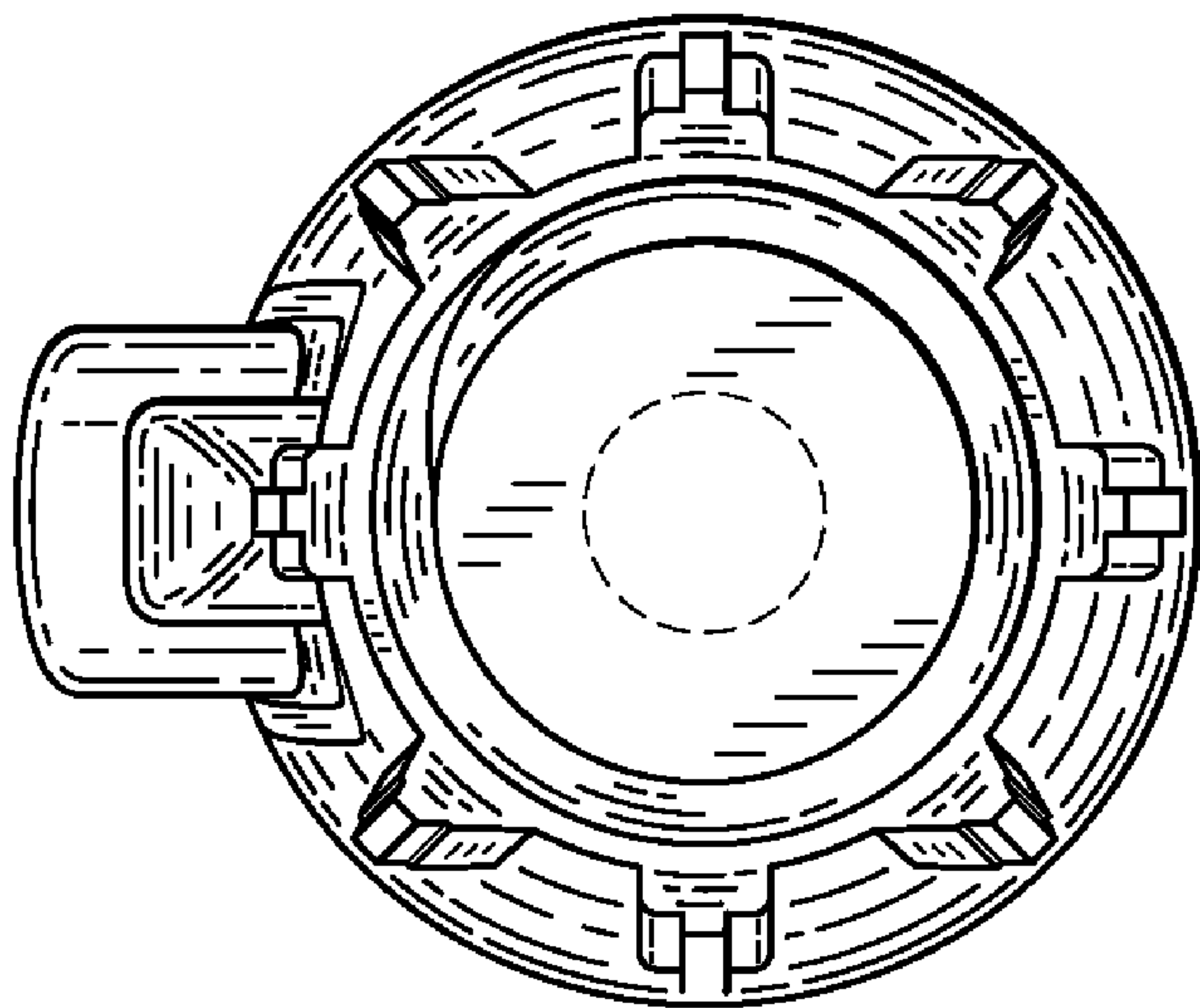

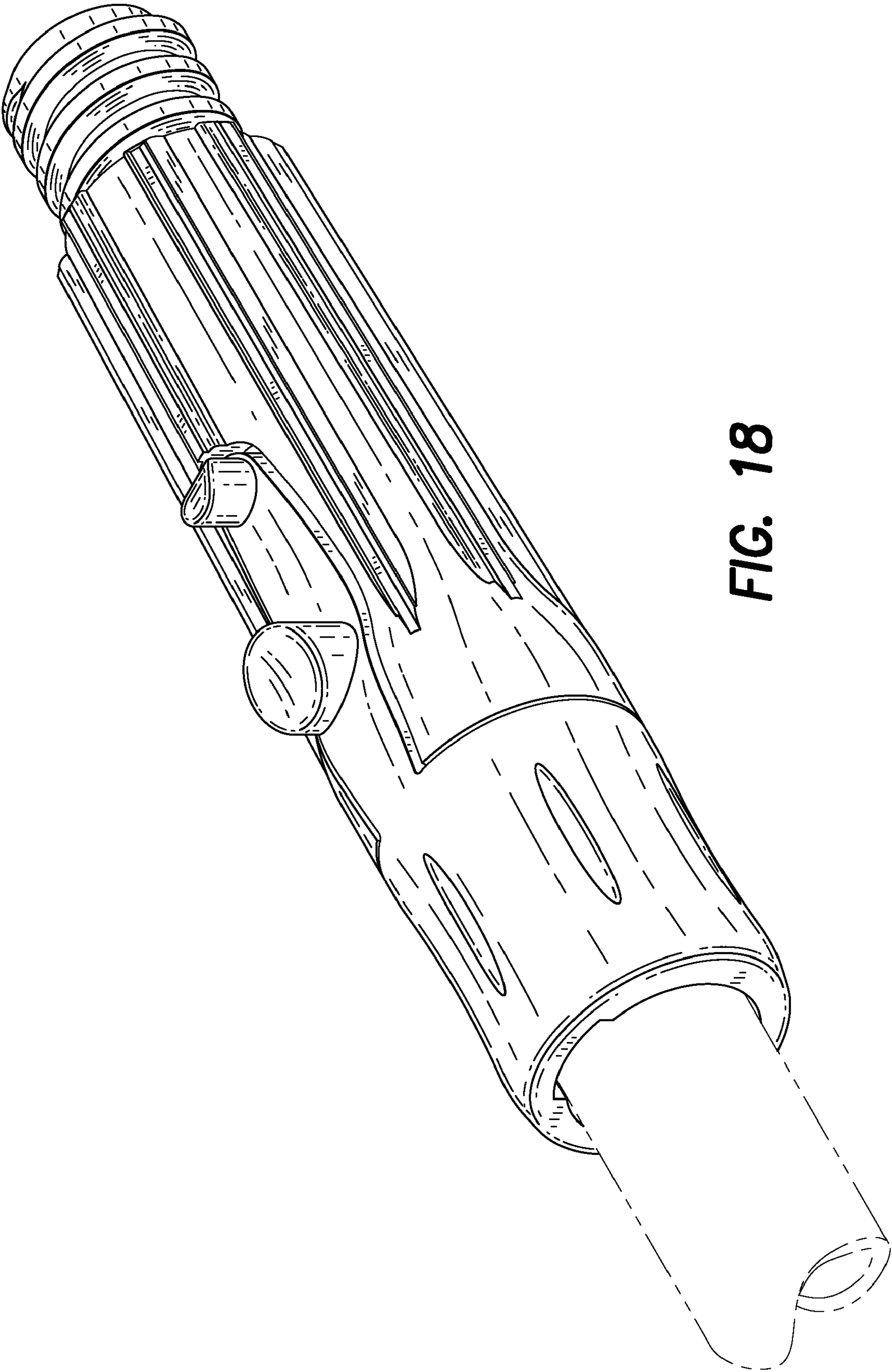
