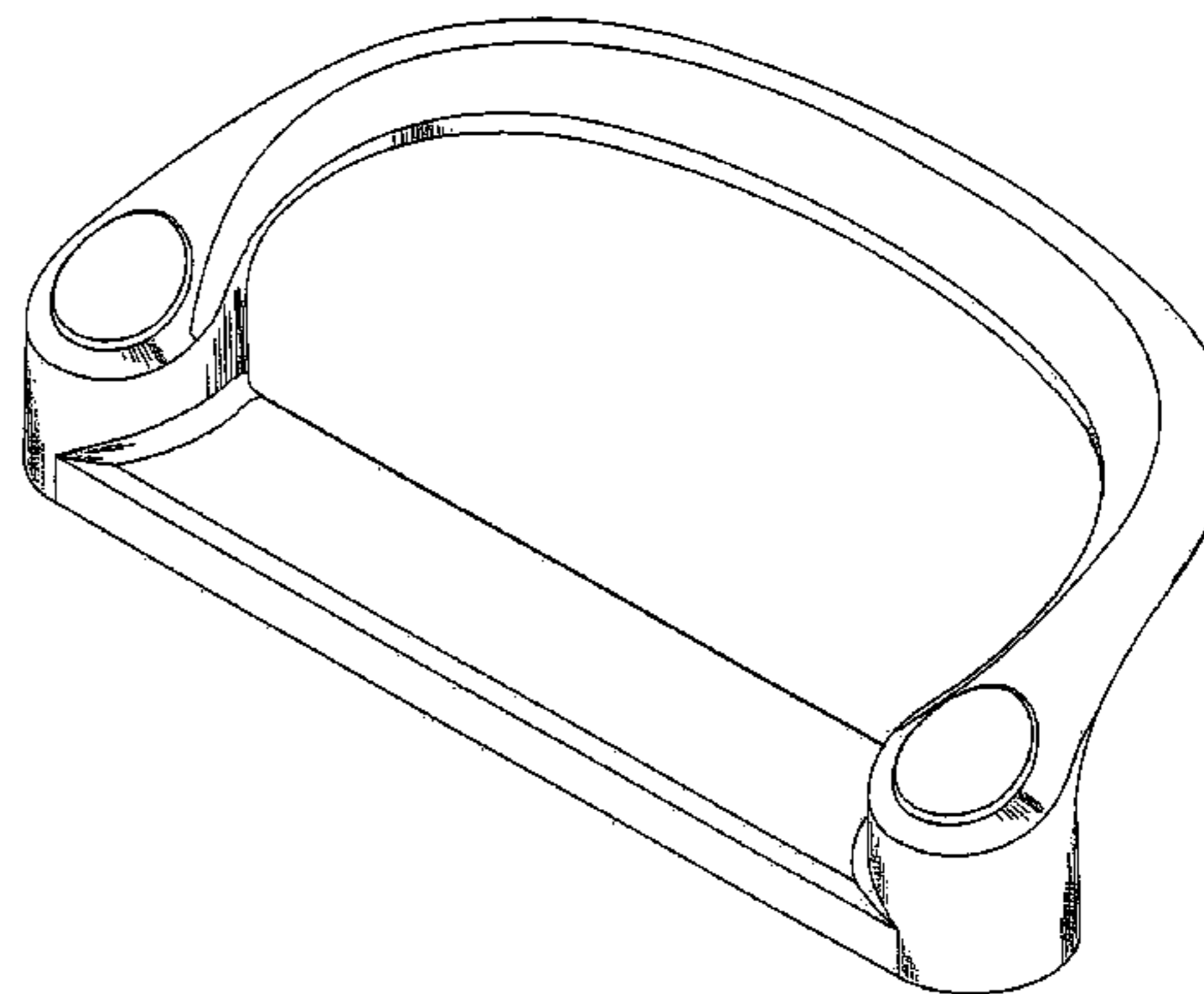
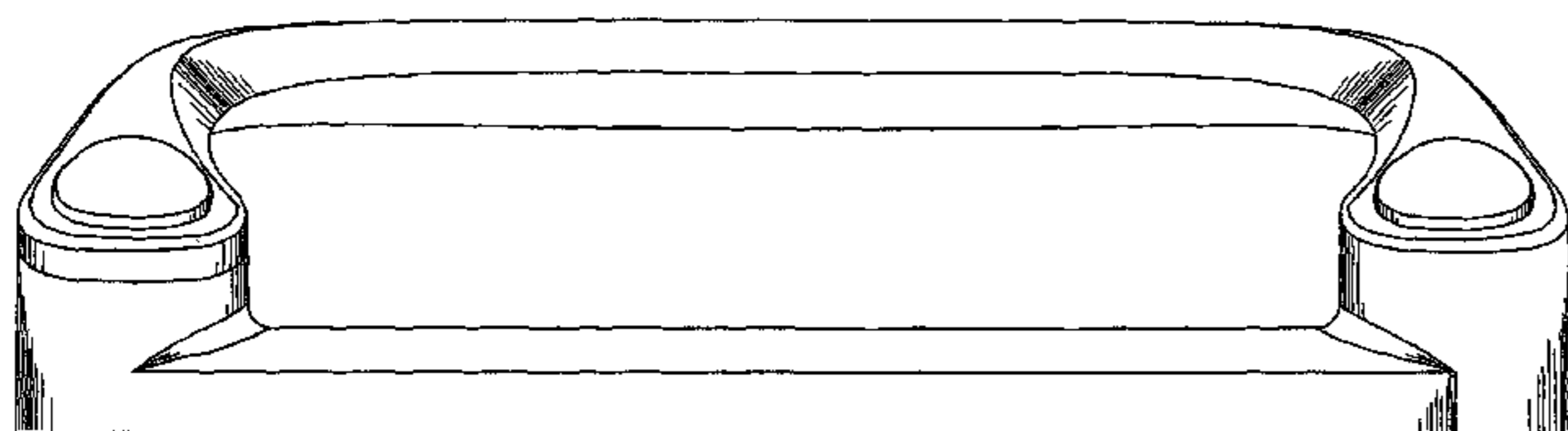
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of the handle of the present invention. FIG. 2 is a top view of the handle of FIG. 1. FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the handle of FIG. 1. FIG. 4 is a side view of the handle of FIG. 1; the opposite side view is a mirror image of this side view. FIG. 5 is a rear view of the handle of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the handle of FIG. 1. The broken lines in FIG. 5 form no part of the claimed design.

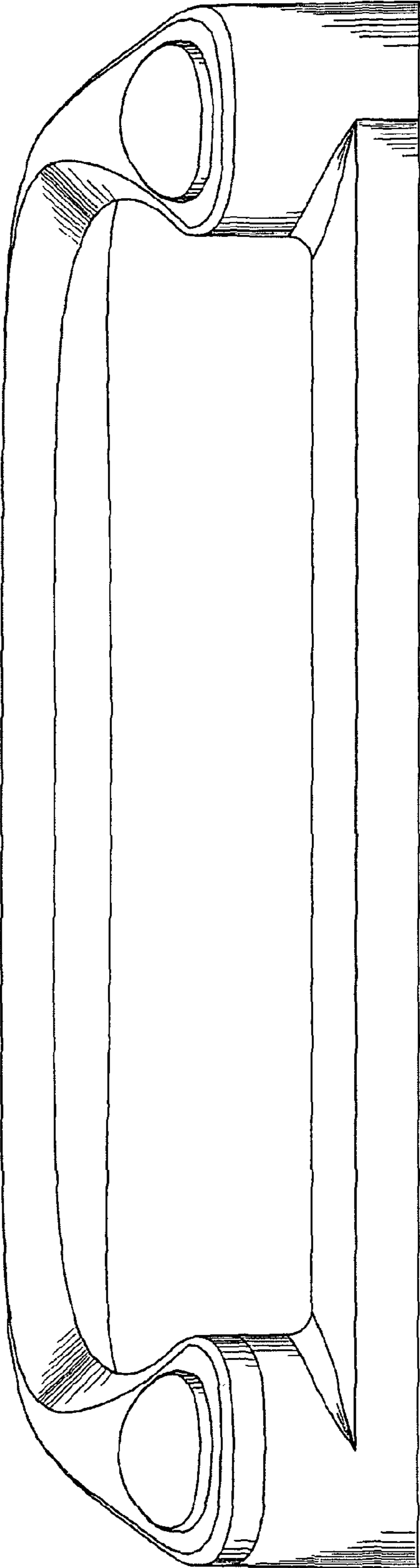

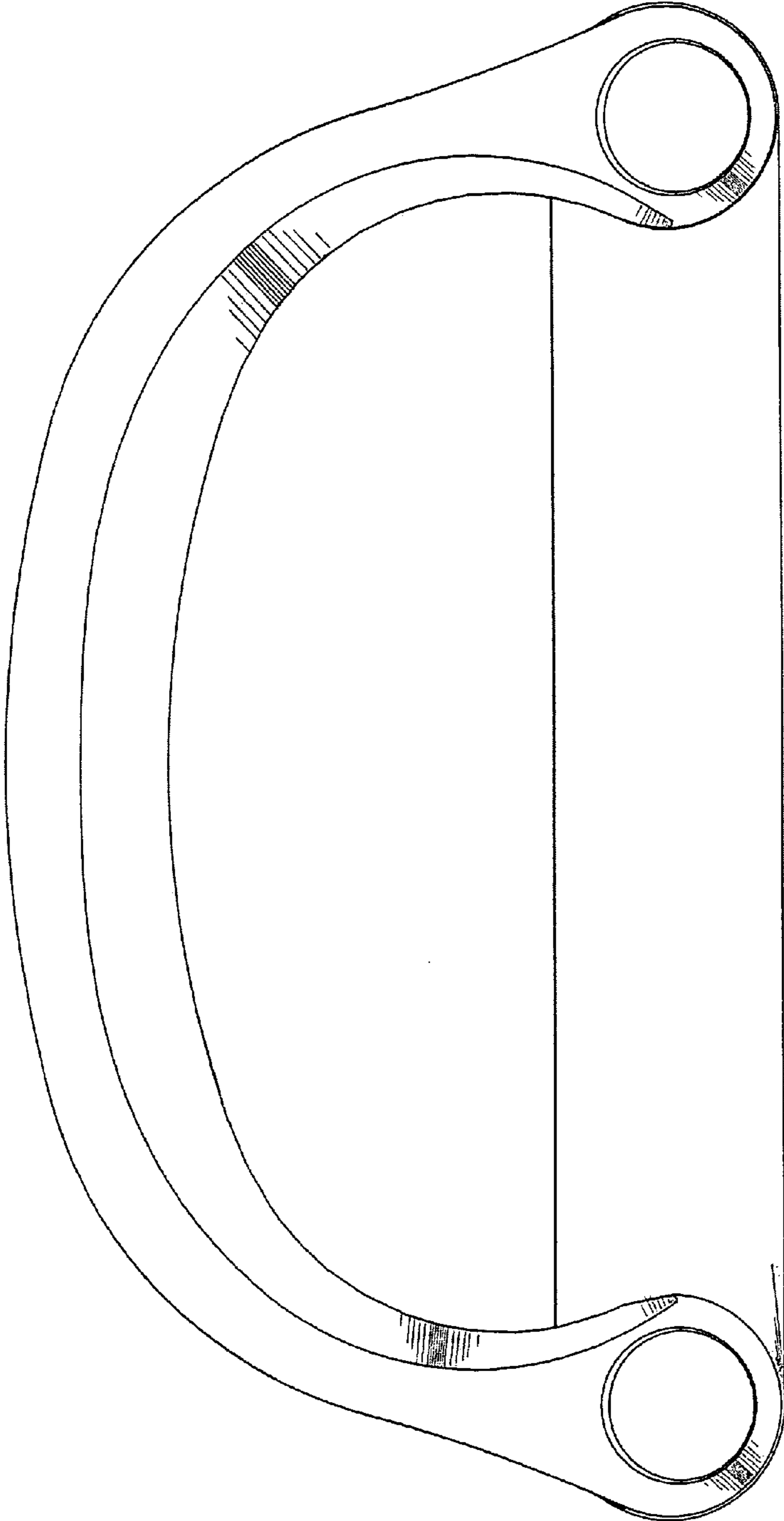

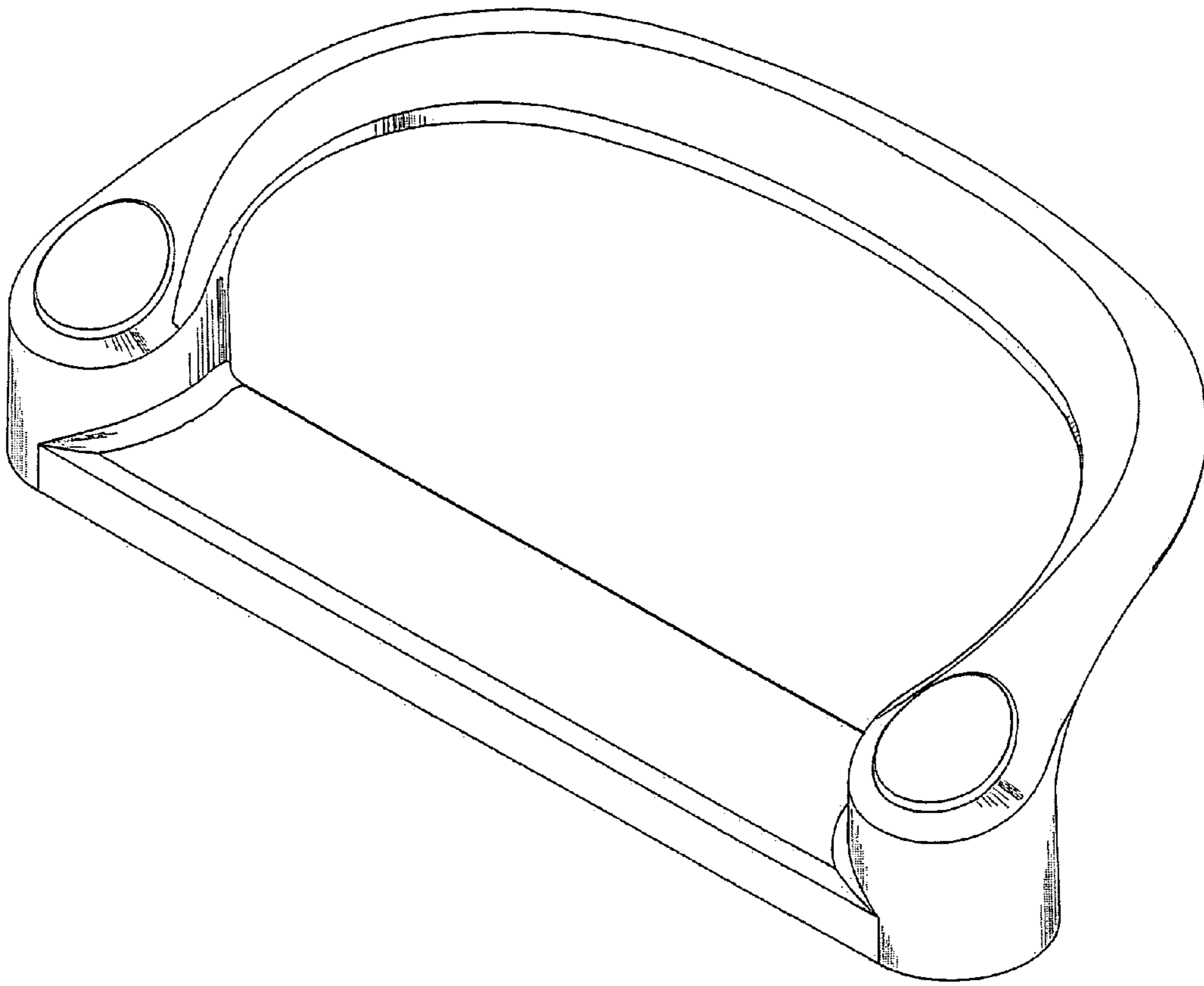

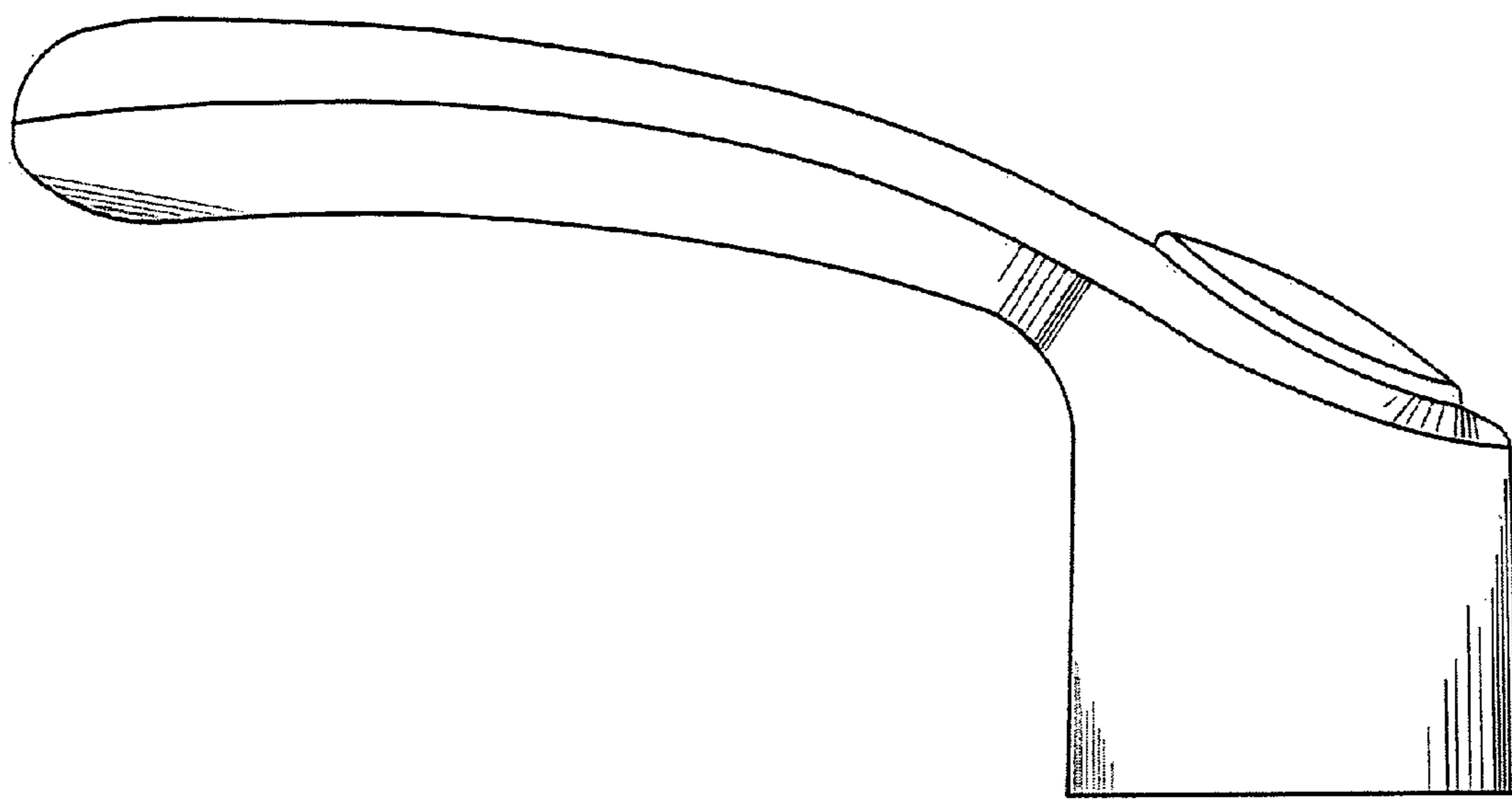

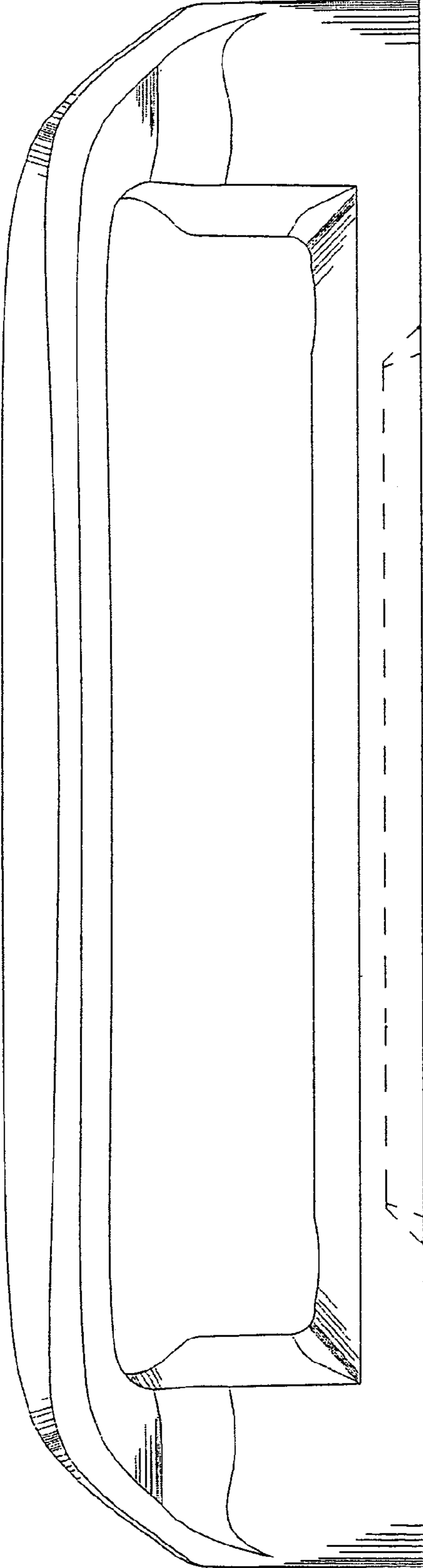

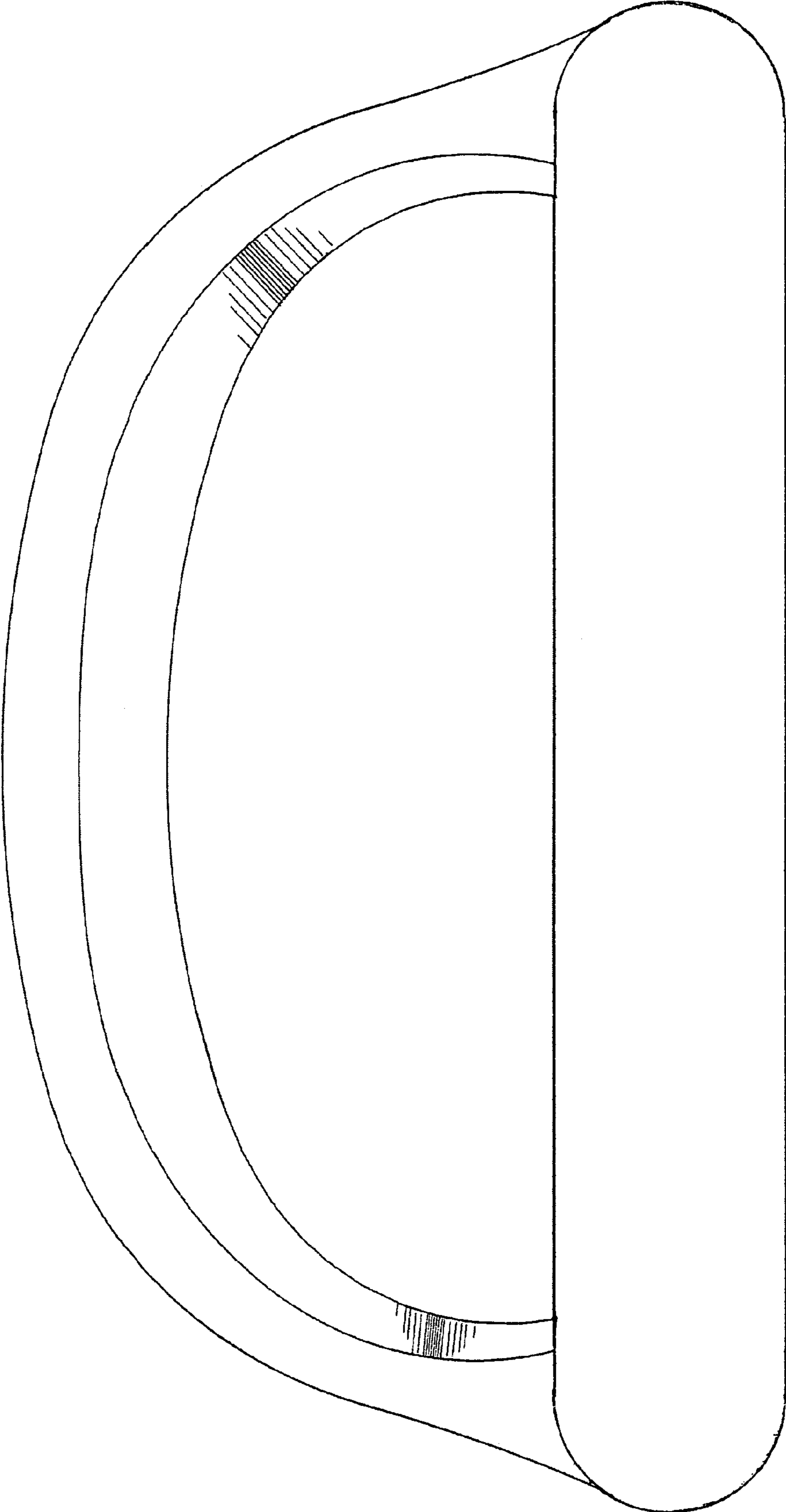
