I claim the ornamental design for sheet of glass, as shown and described.

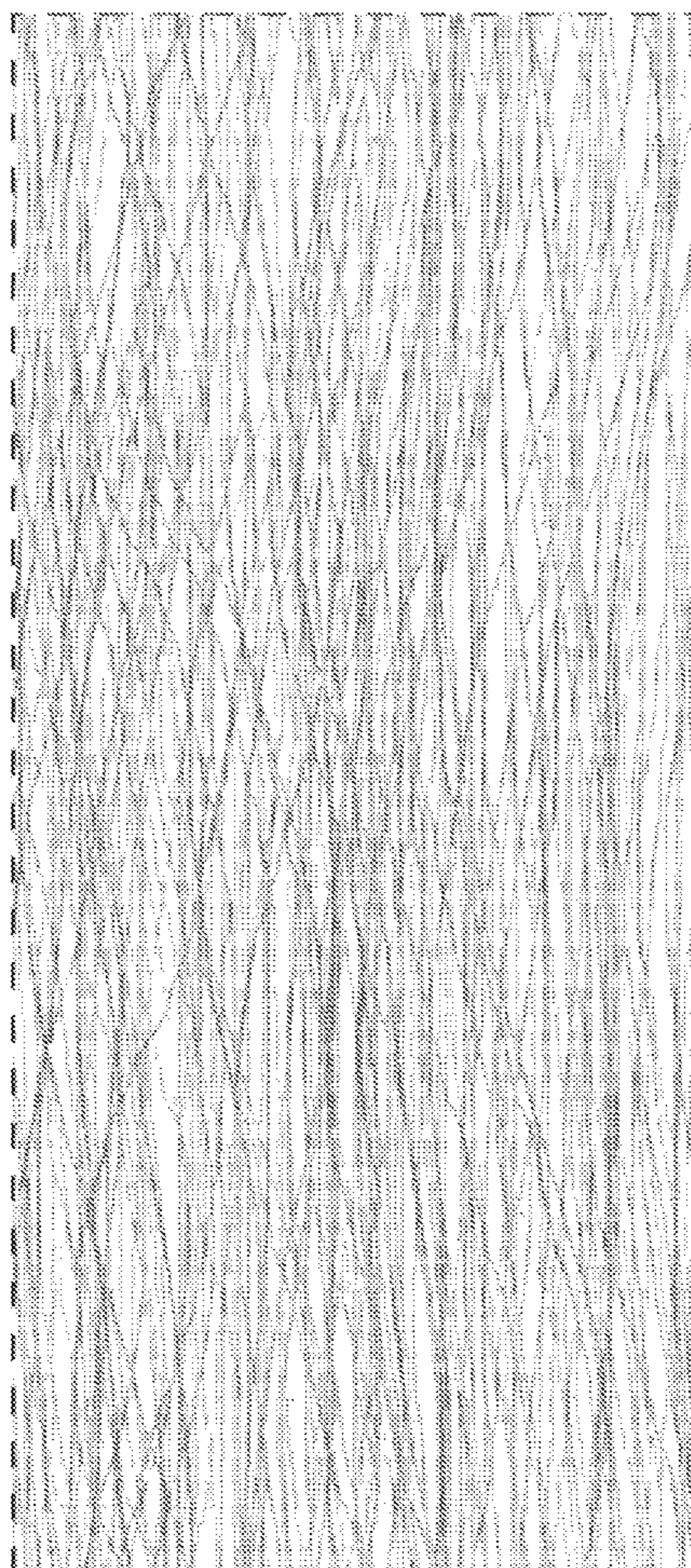
DESCRIPTION

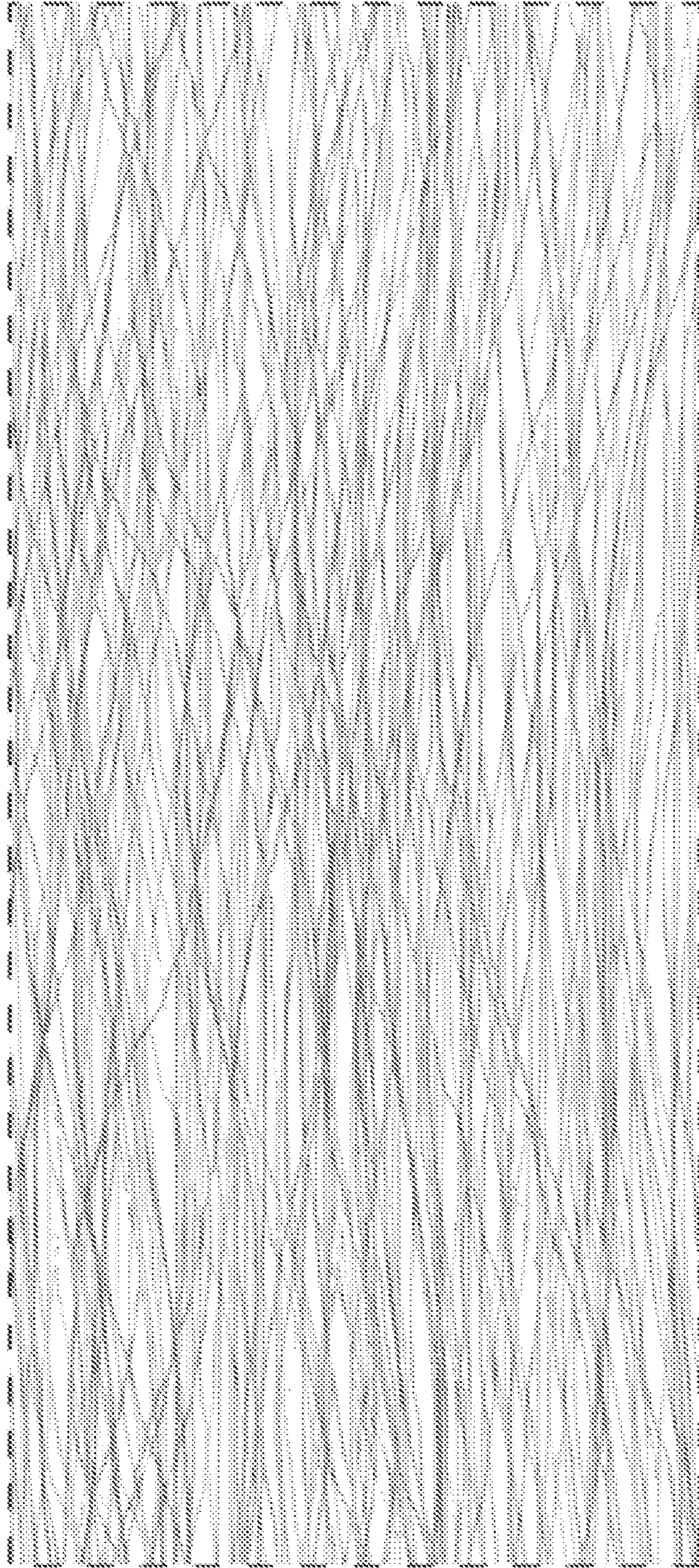

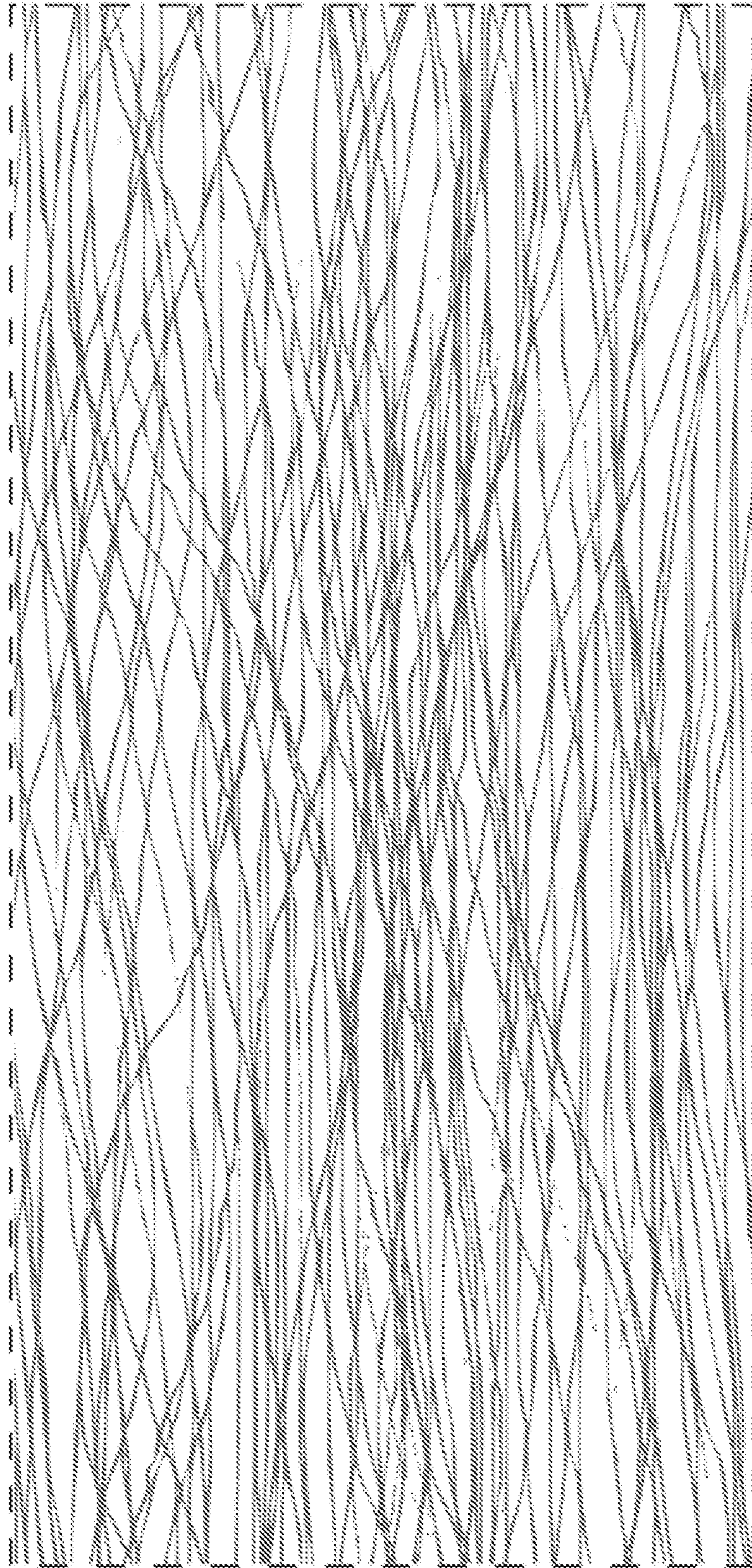
