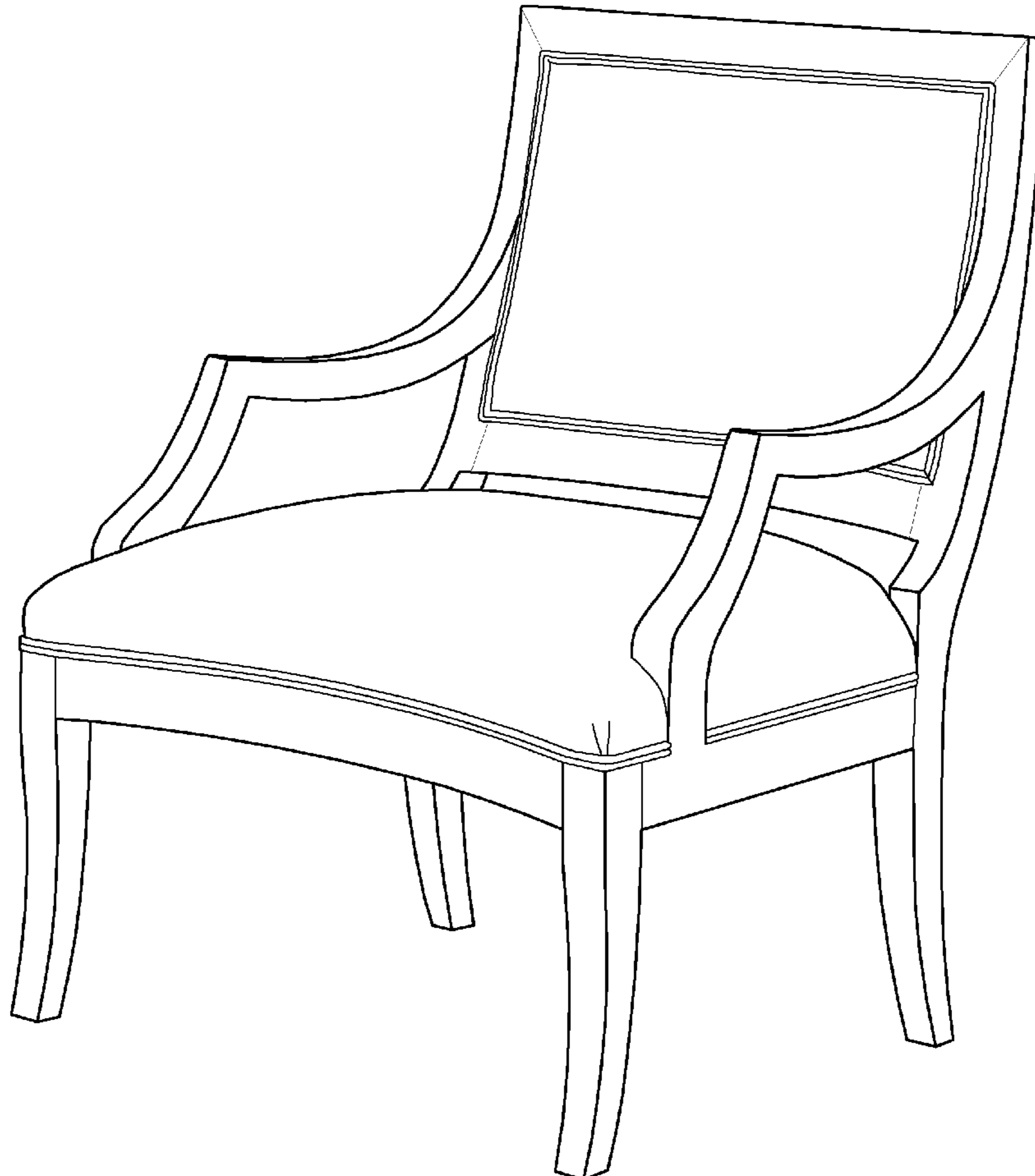
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the chair of my design;  
FIG. 2 is a top view of the chair;  
FIG. 3 is a front view of the chair;  
FIG. 4 is right side facing view of the chair (the left side facing view, being a mirror image of the right side facing view, is not shown);  
FIG. 5 is a back view of the chair; and,  
FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the chair. The broken lines shown on the bottom of the seat represent stapling.

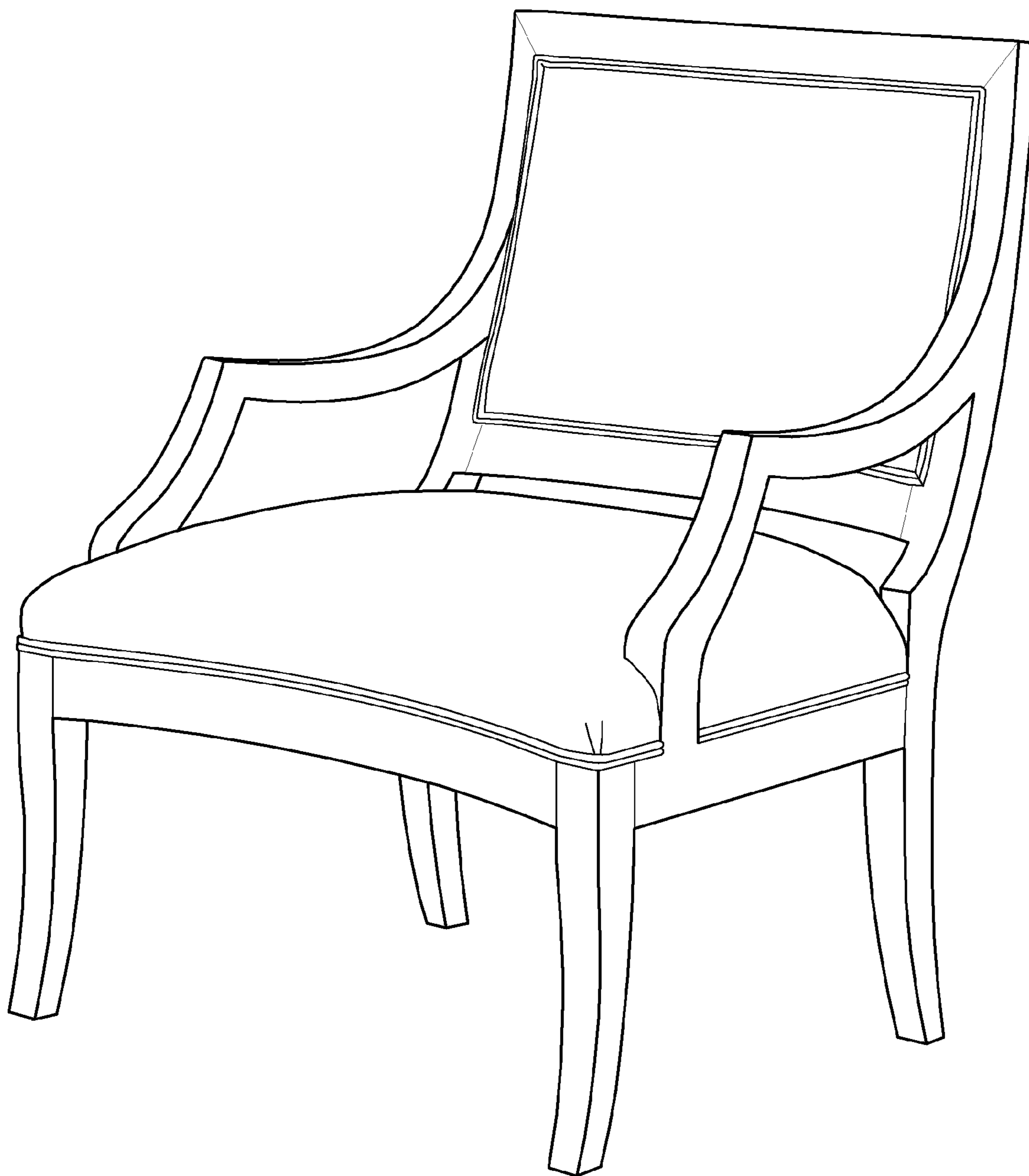

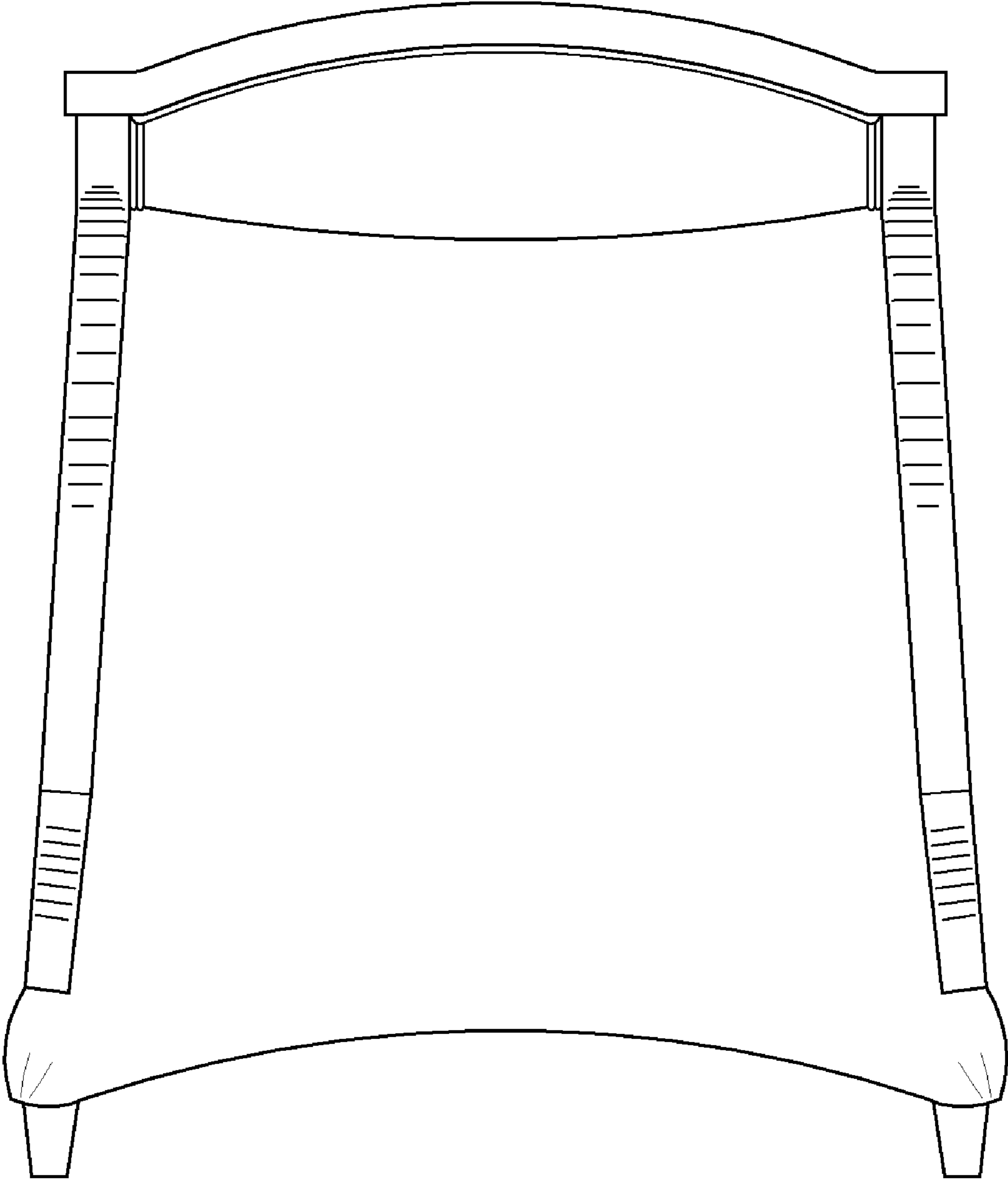

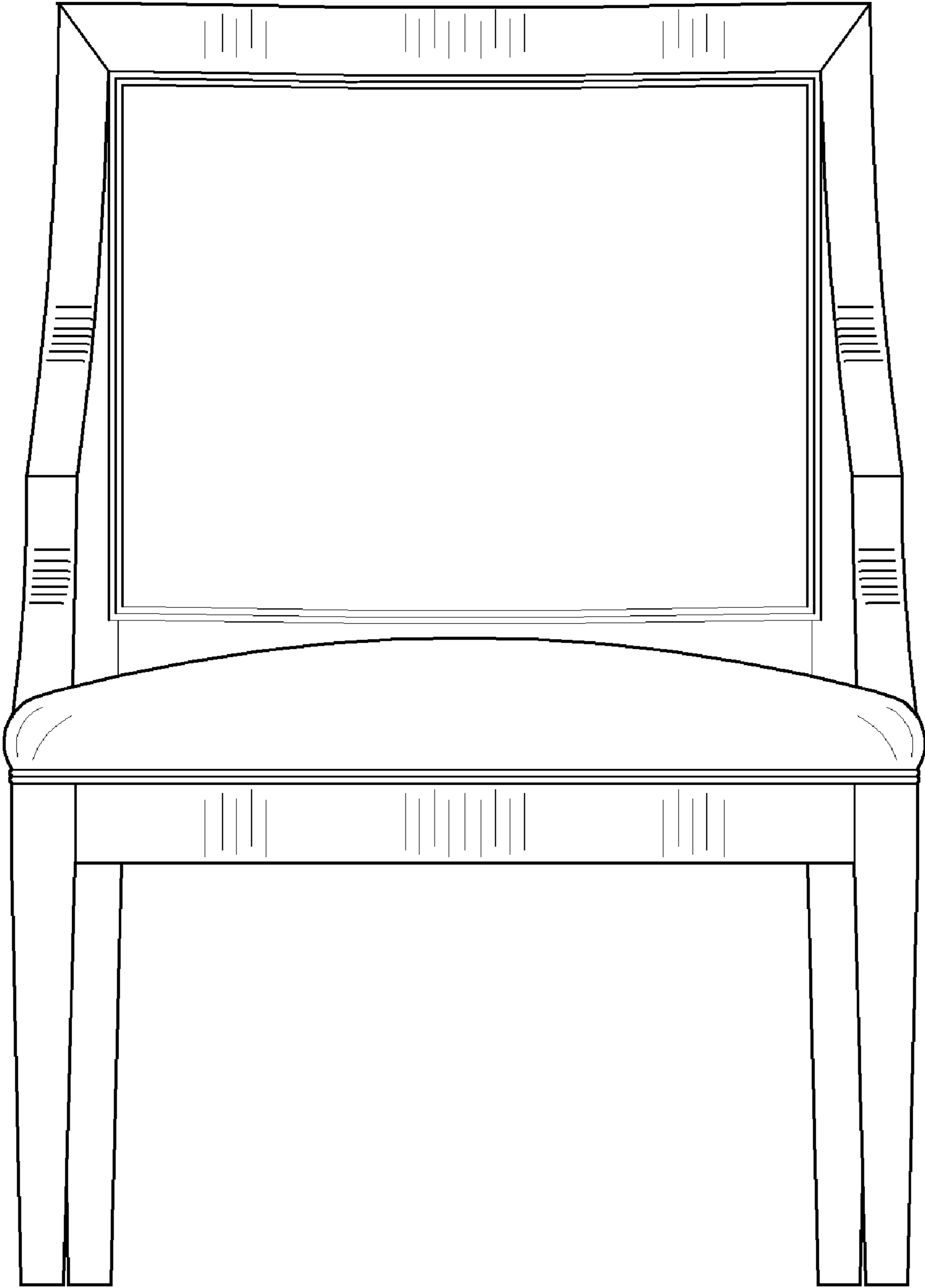

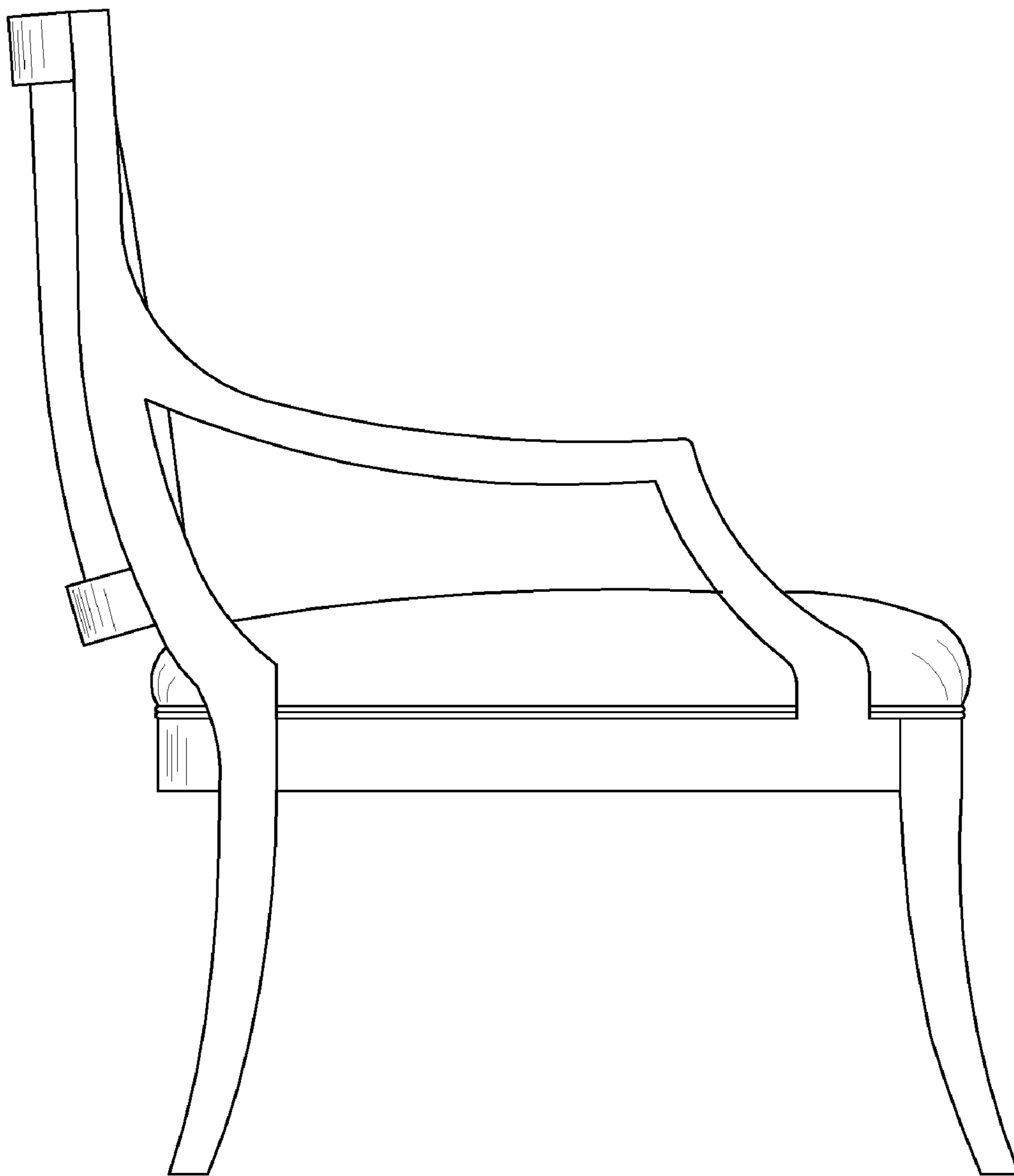

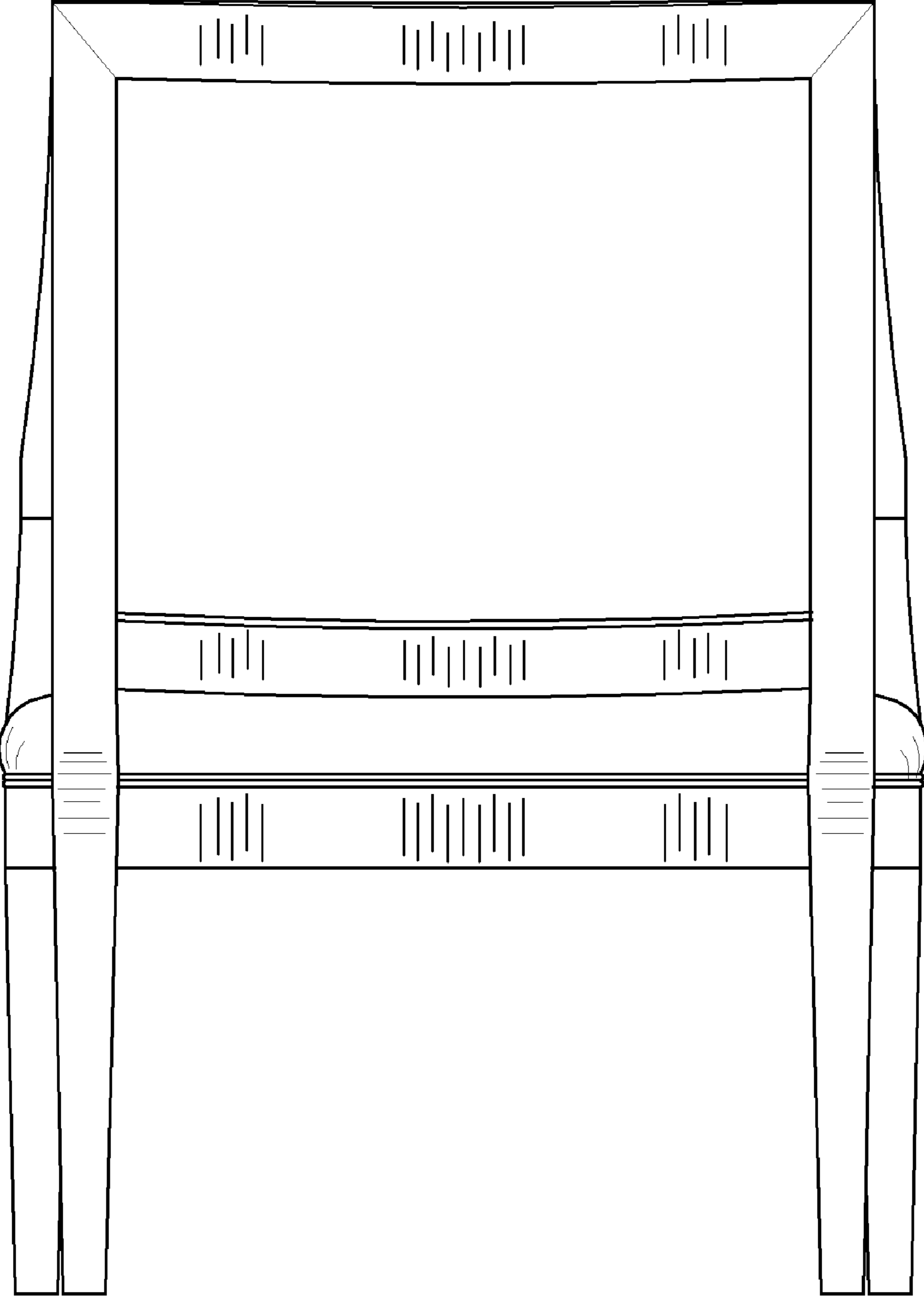

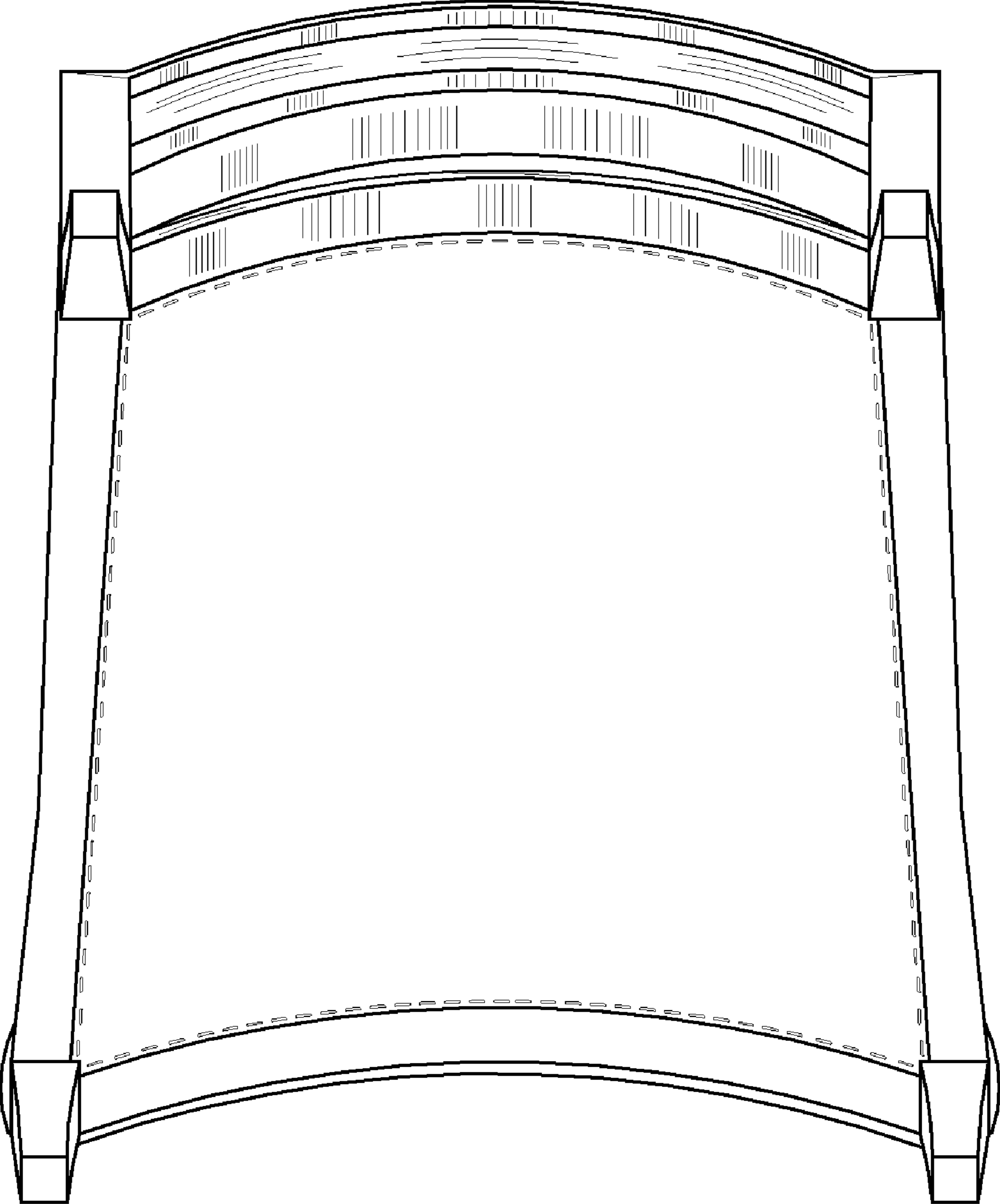
