The ornamental design for a shower rod, as shown and described.

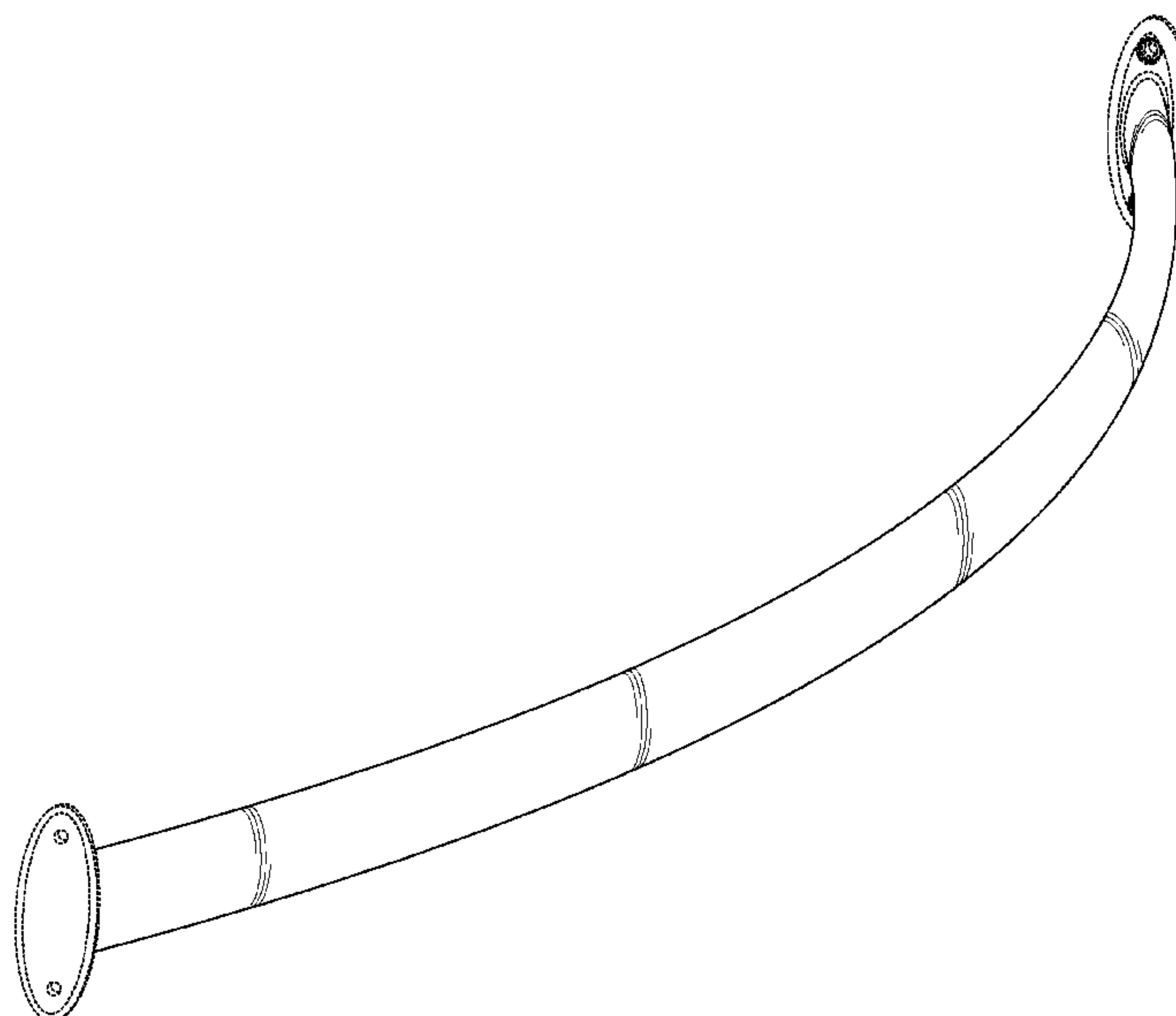
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shower rod of the new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the shower rod of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the shower rod of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the shower rod of FIG. 1, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the shower rod of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the shower rod of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 7 is an enlarged partial cross-sectional view of the shower rod of FIG. 1, taken along the line 7—7 in FIG. 6, showing the external profile of the shower rod.

The broken line showing of rod attachments is included for the purpose of illustrating environment and forms no part of the claimed design.

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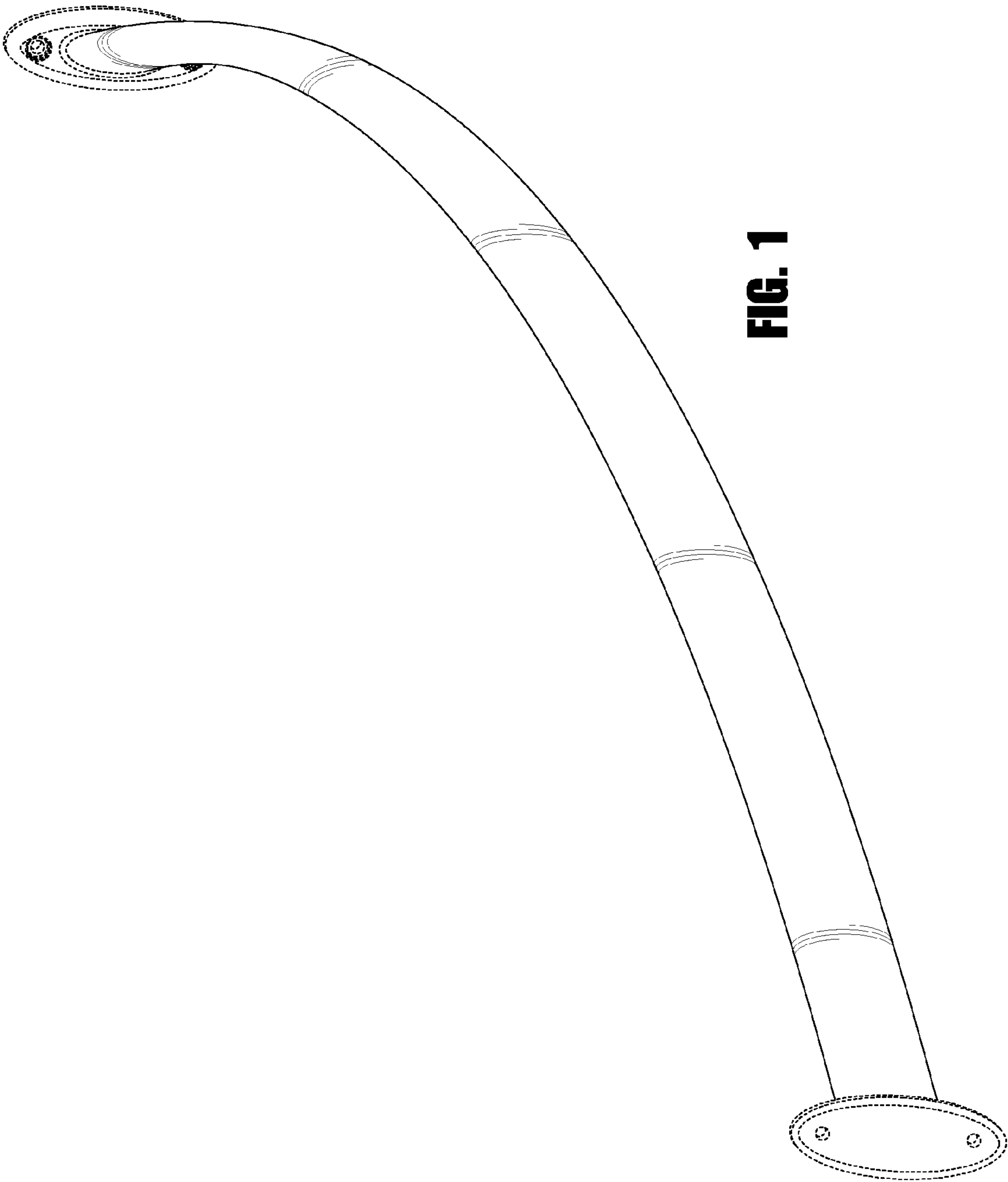

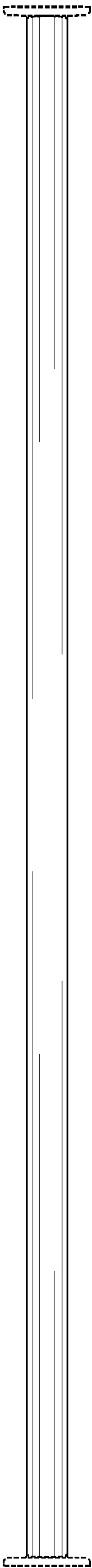

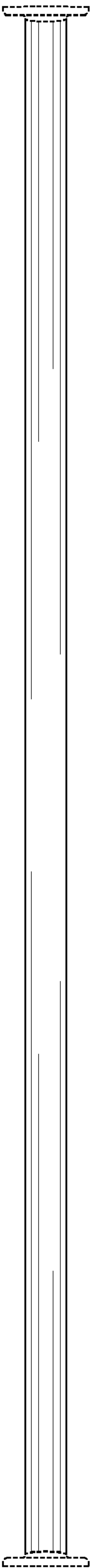

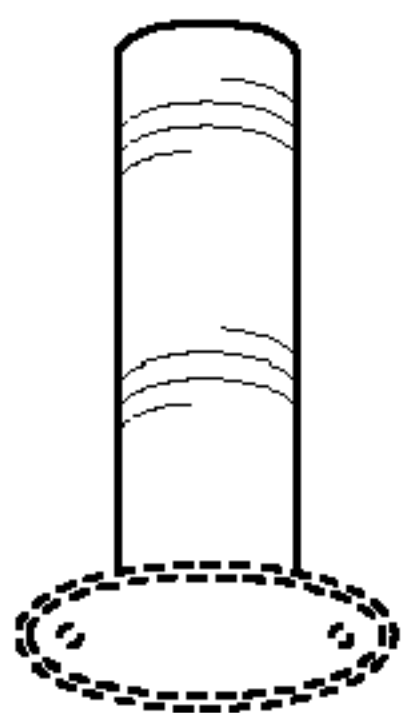

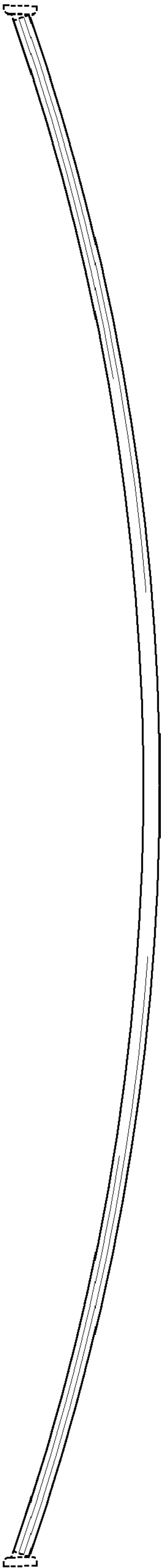

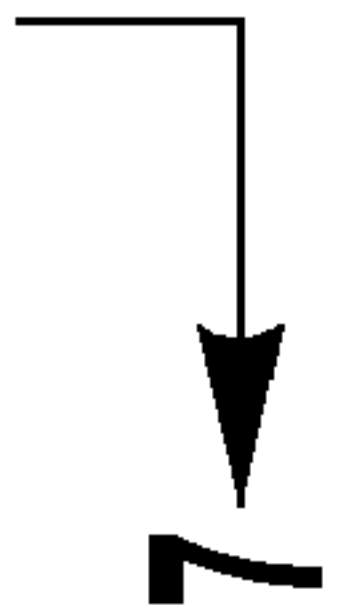
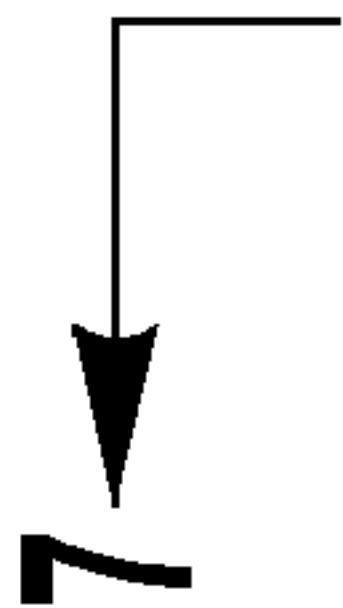

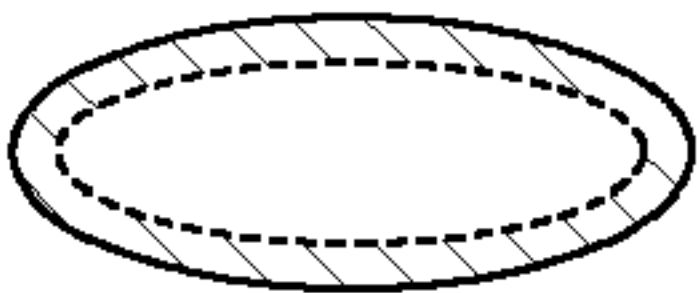
