(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a magnifying device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a magnifying device showing my new design, as viewed from the top and one side.

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the magnifying device of FIG. 1.

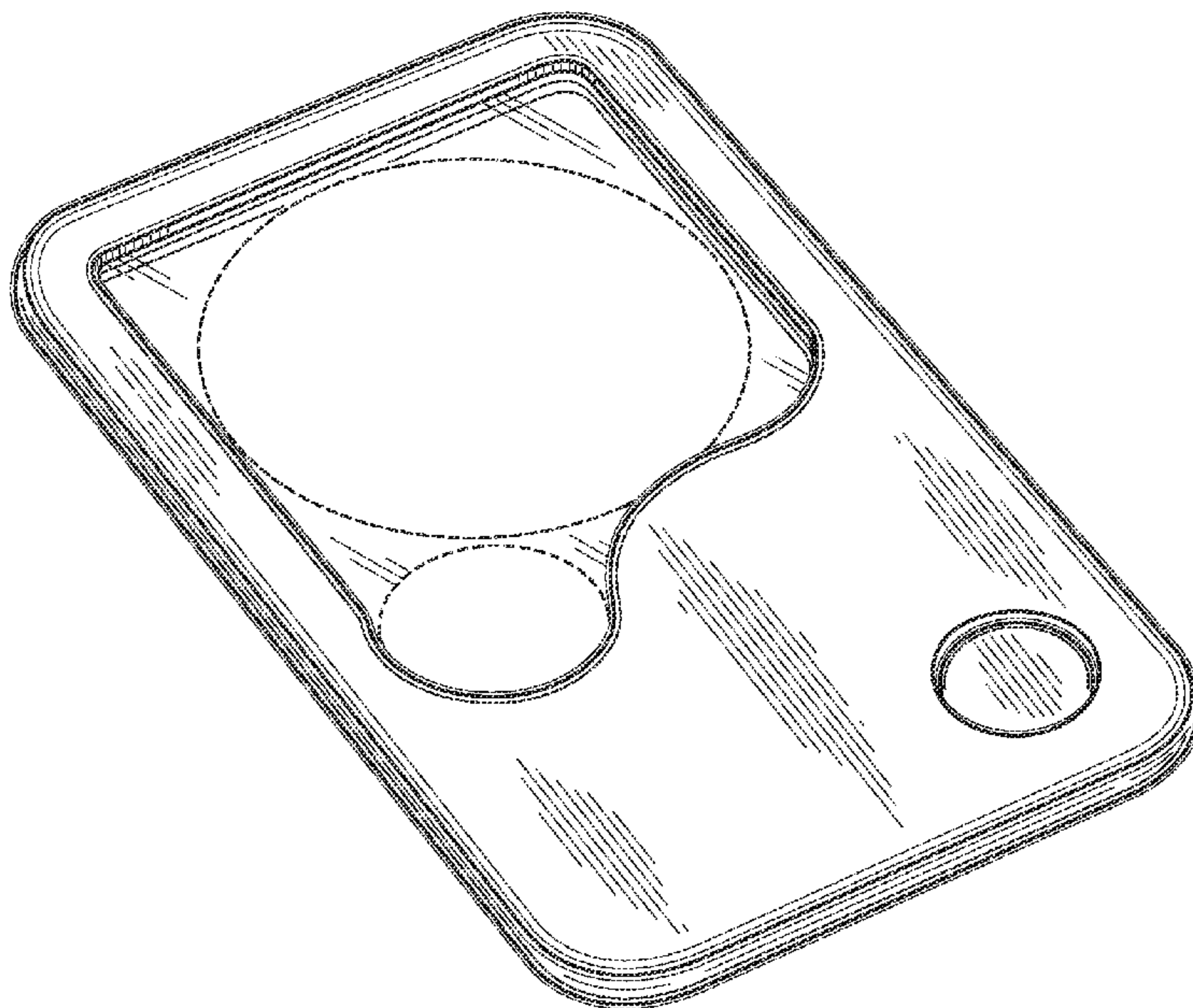
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the magnifying device of FIG. 1, the bottom plan view being identical.

FIG. 4 is a back elevation view of the magnifying device of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 5 is a side elevation view of the magnifying device of FIG. 1, the opposite side elevation view being identical.

The details shown in broken lines illustrate portions of the magnifying device that form no part of the claimed design.

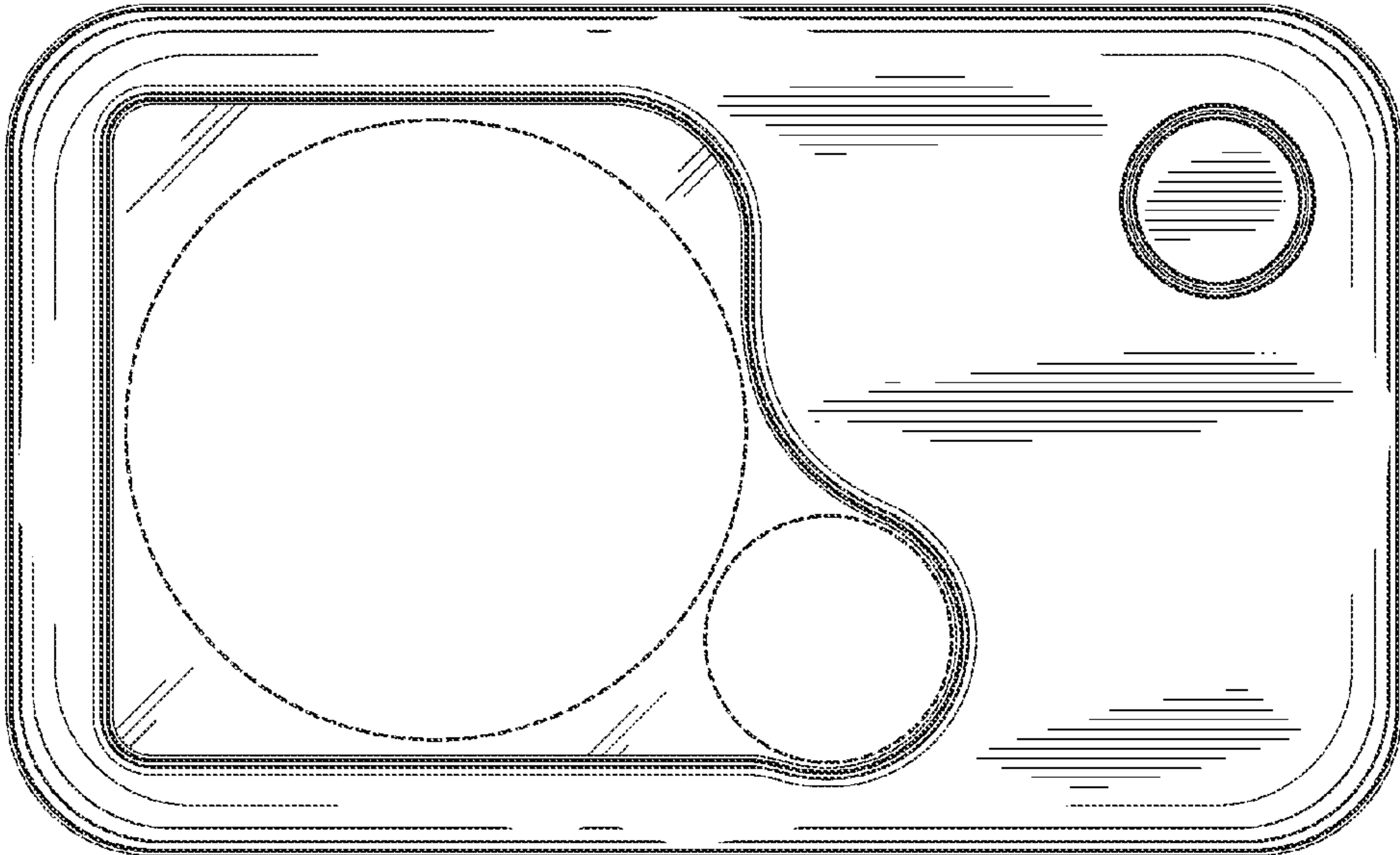

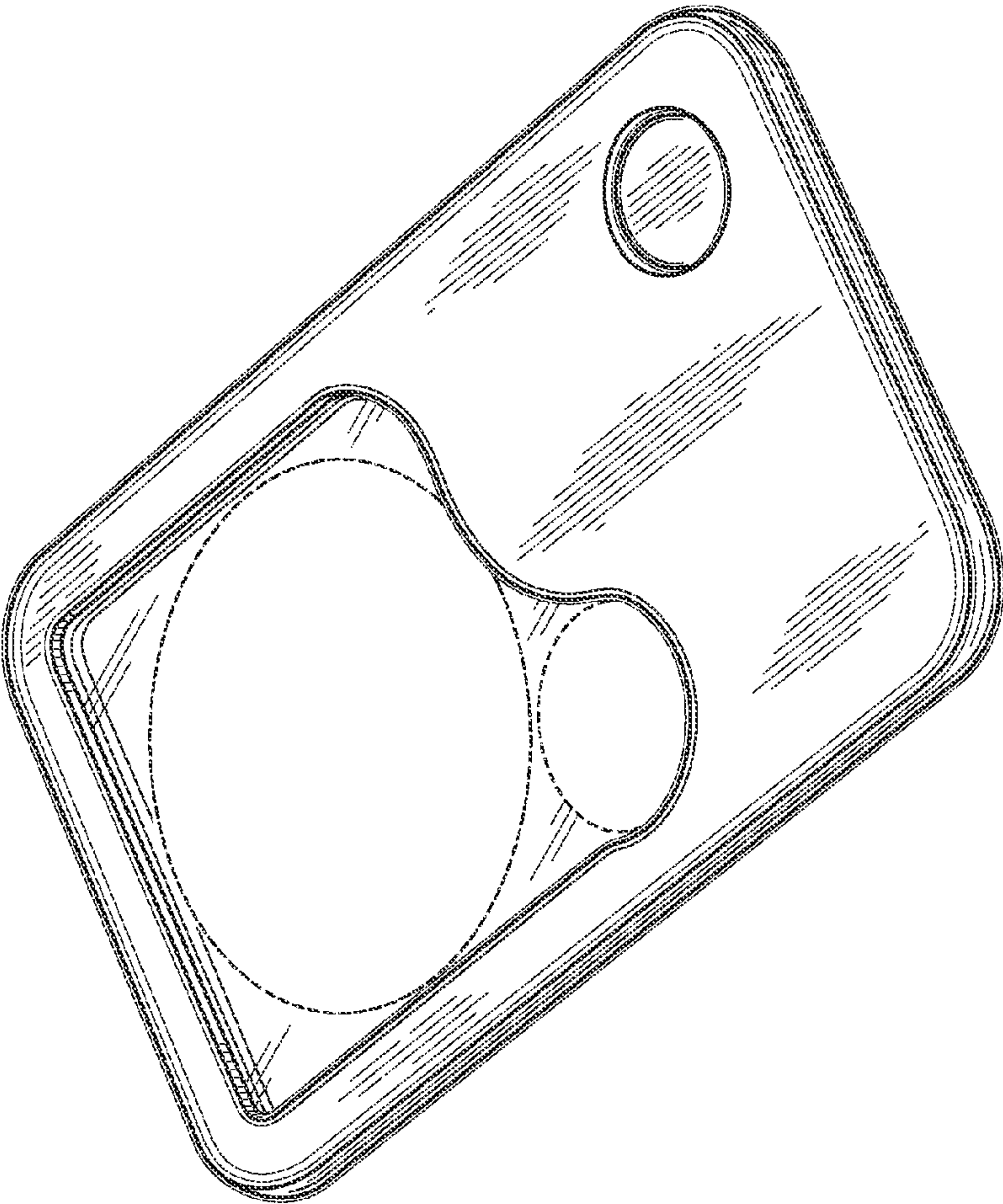

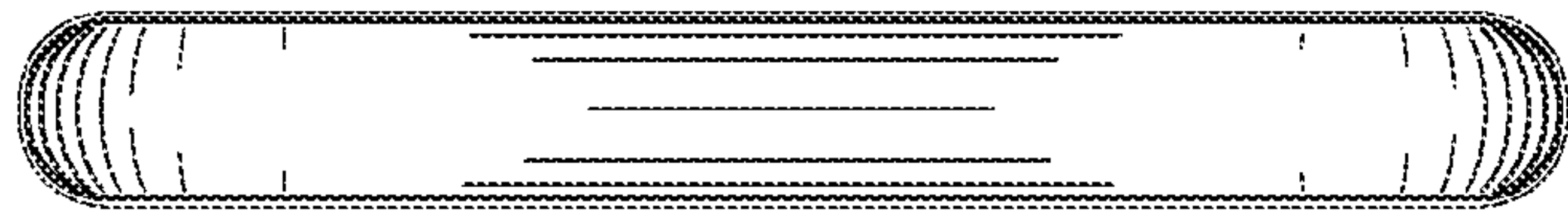

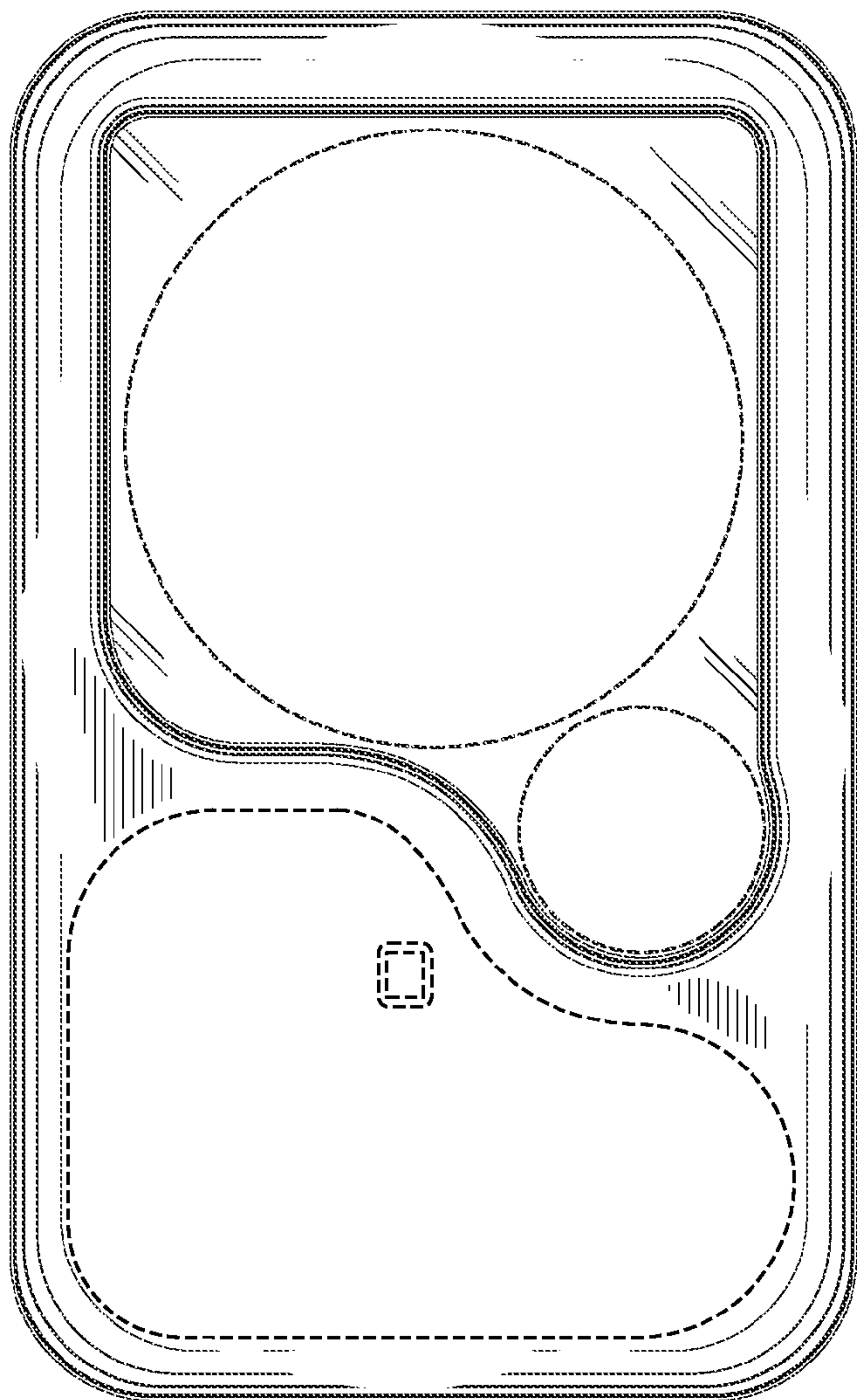

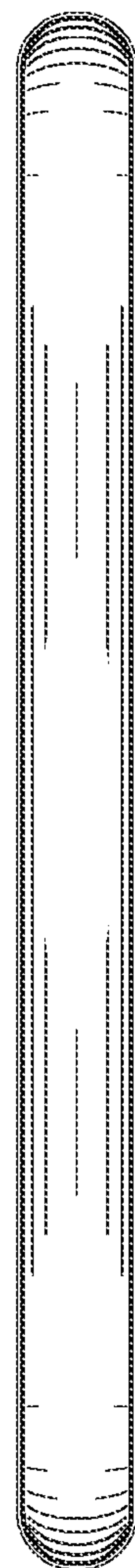
