**DESCRIPTION**

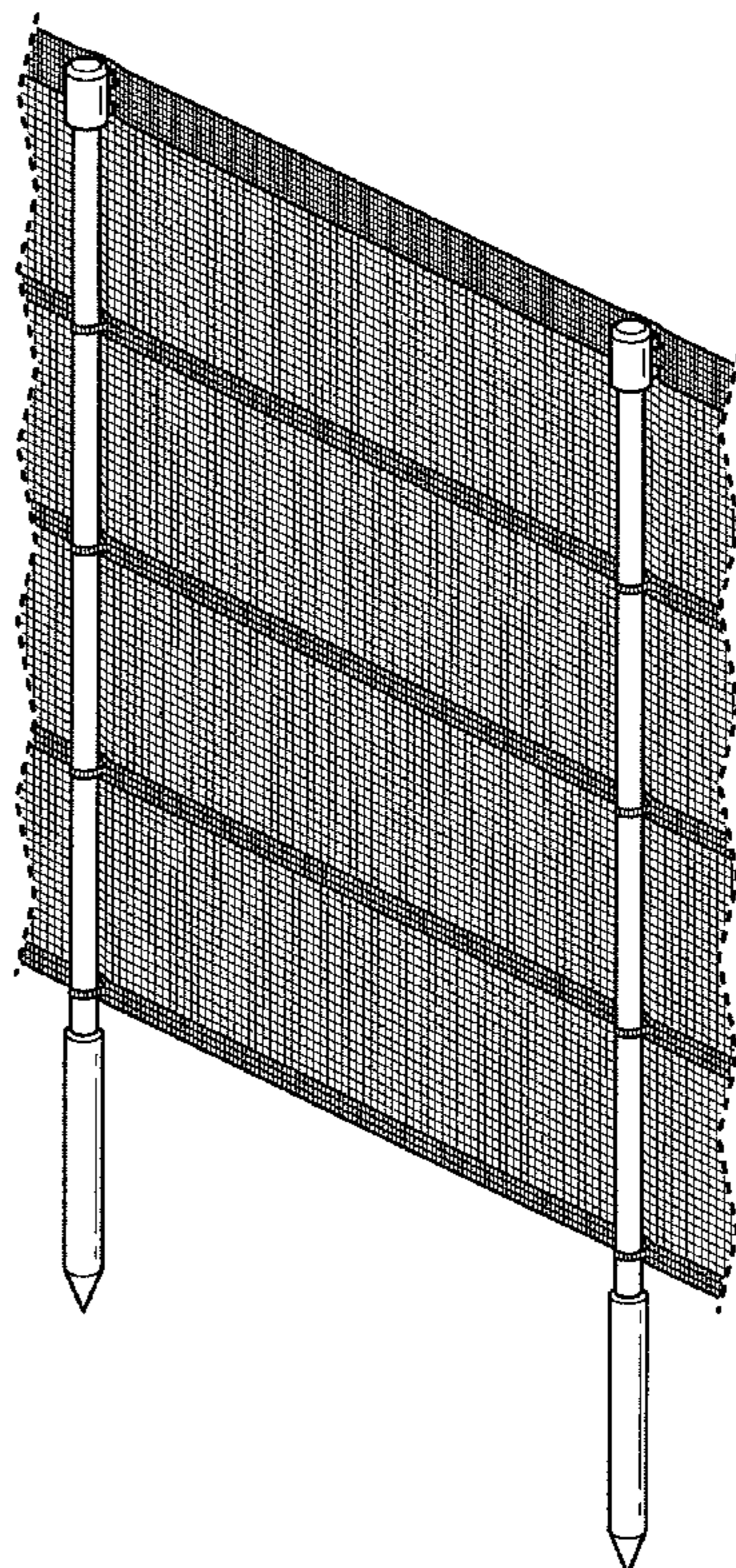
FIG. 1 is a top right perspective view of a temporary fence;

illustration.

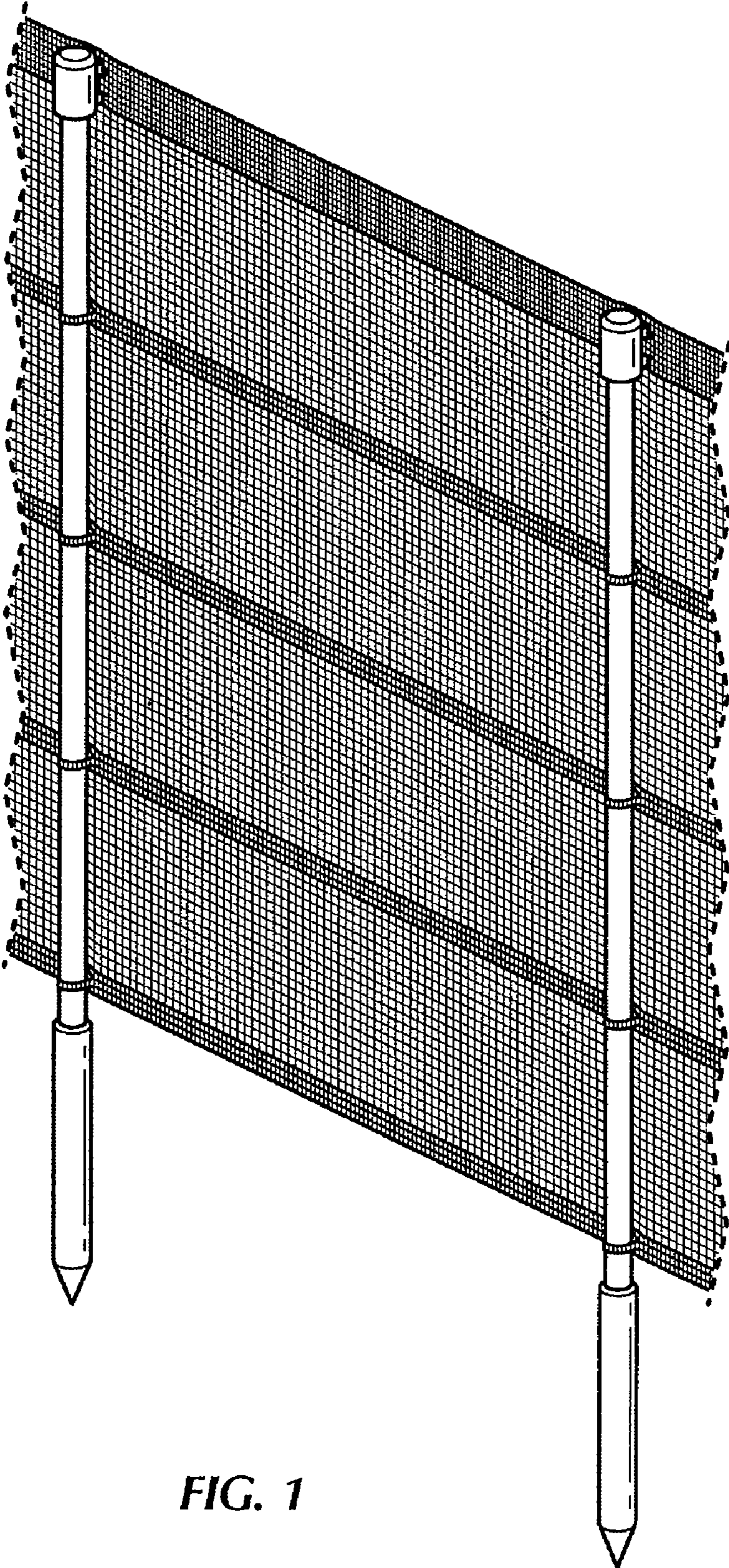

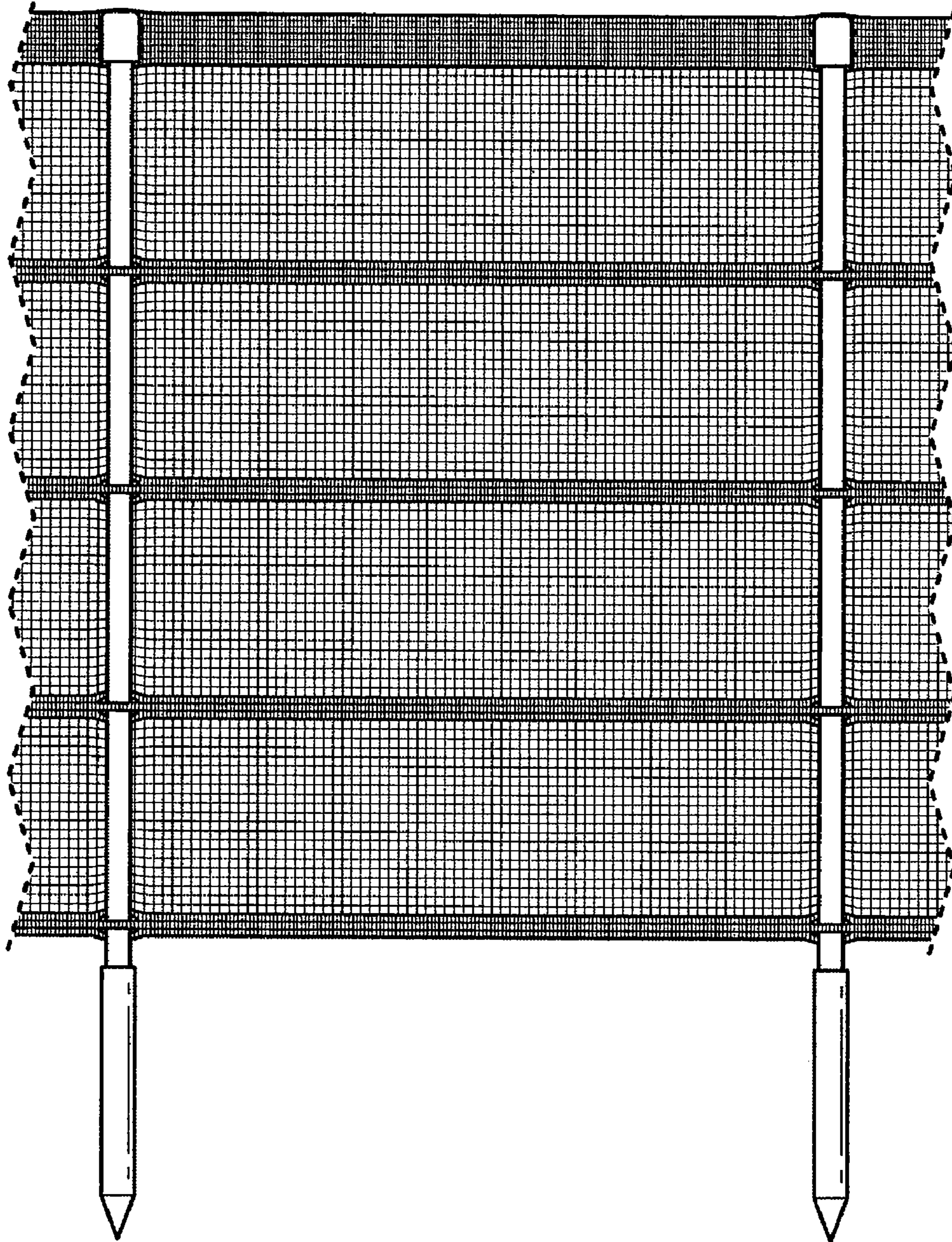

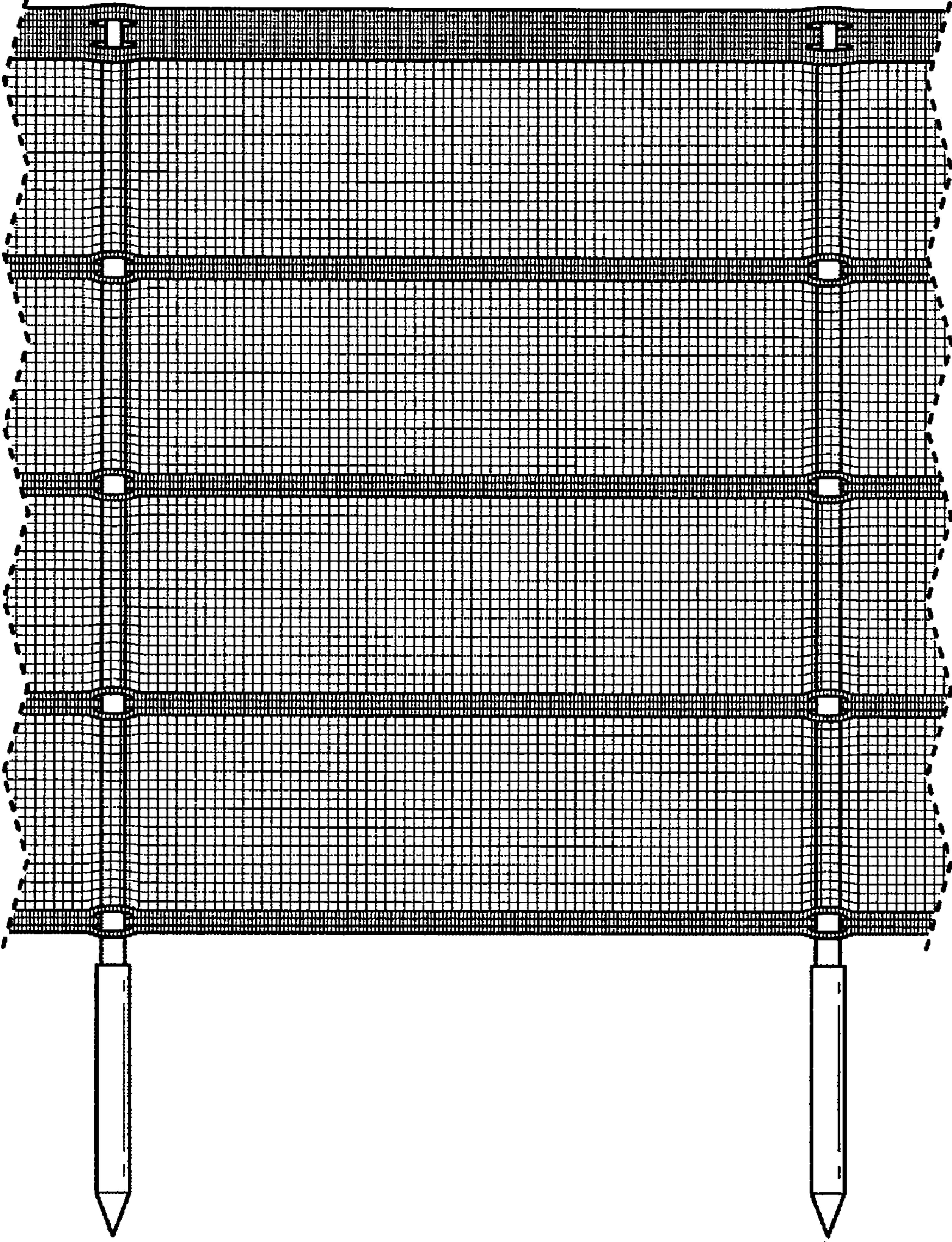

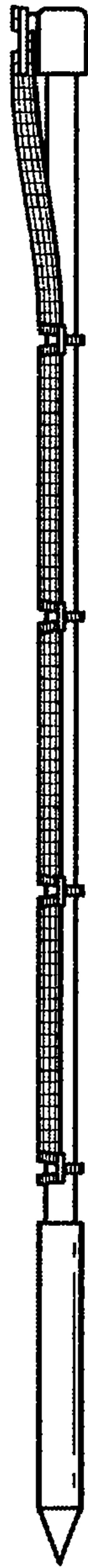

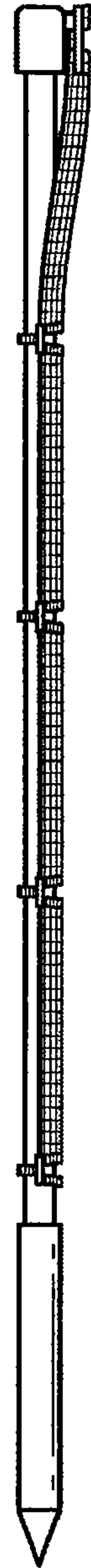
