(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front side perspective view of a first embodiment of the present invention, shown in a right-foot orientation, a left-foot orientation being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a front side perspective view of a second embodiment of the present invention, shown in a right-foot orientation, a left-foot orientation being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 5.

FIG. 7 is a right side elevation view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 5; and,

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 5.

No claim is made to the upper construction in the first and second, embodiments as shown by the use of dashed lines. The upper construction is shown as an environmental illustration only to aid the public. In bottom plan views the dashed line regions indicate disclaimed portions forming no part of the claimed design.

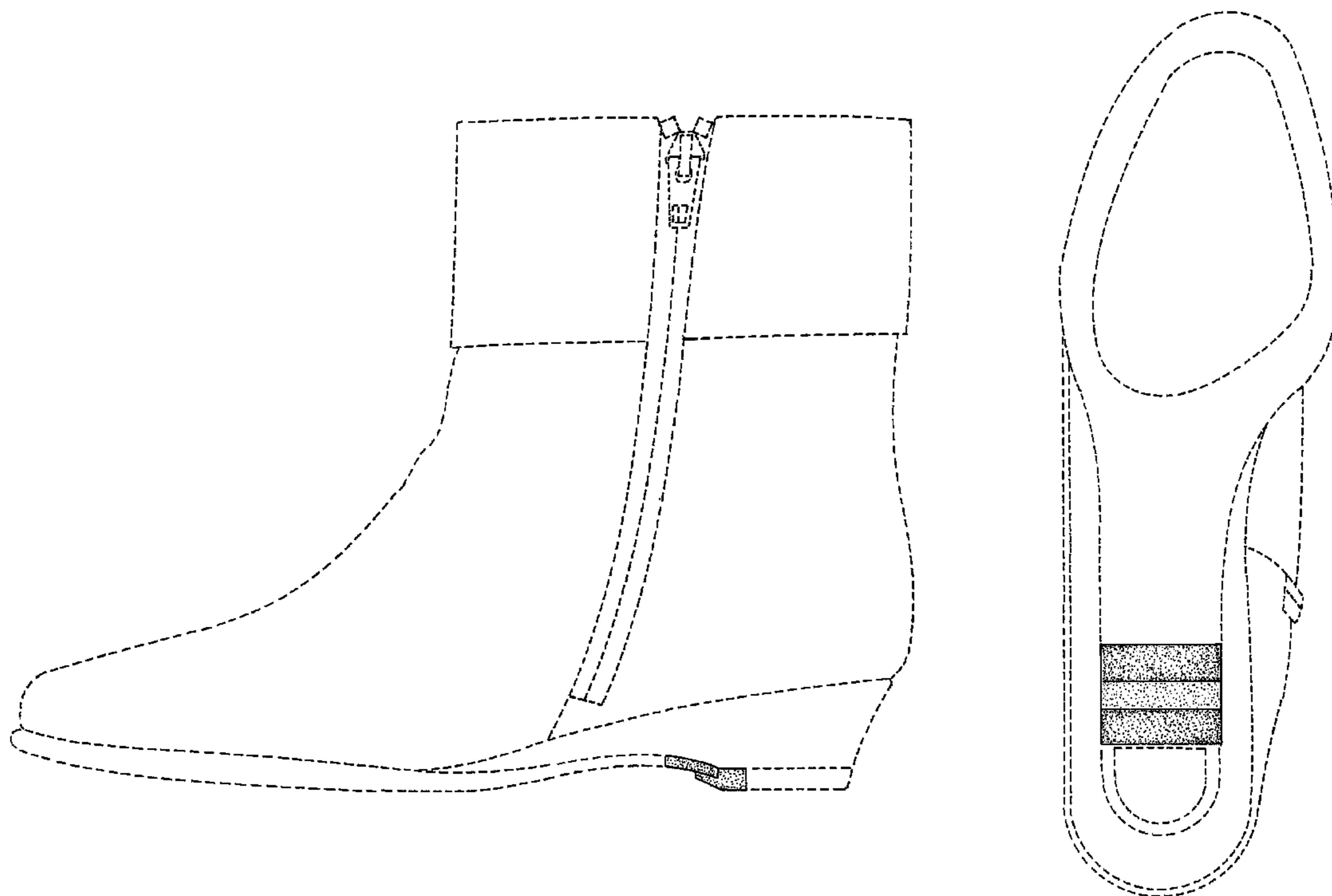

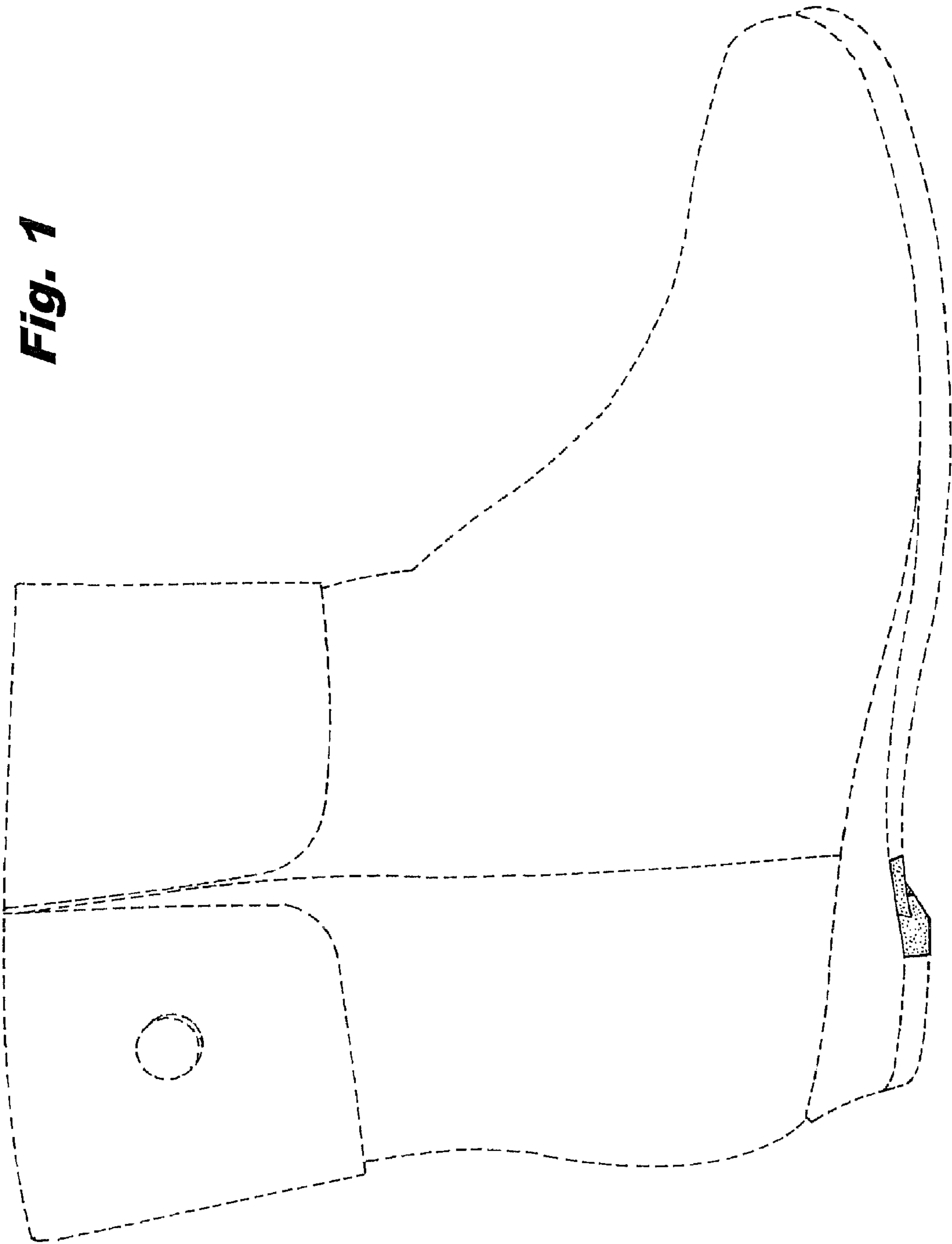
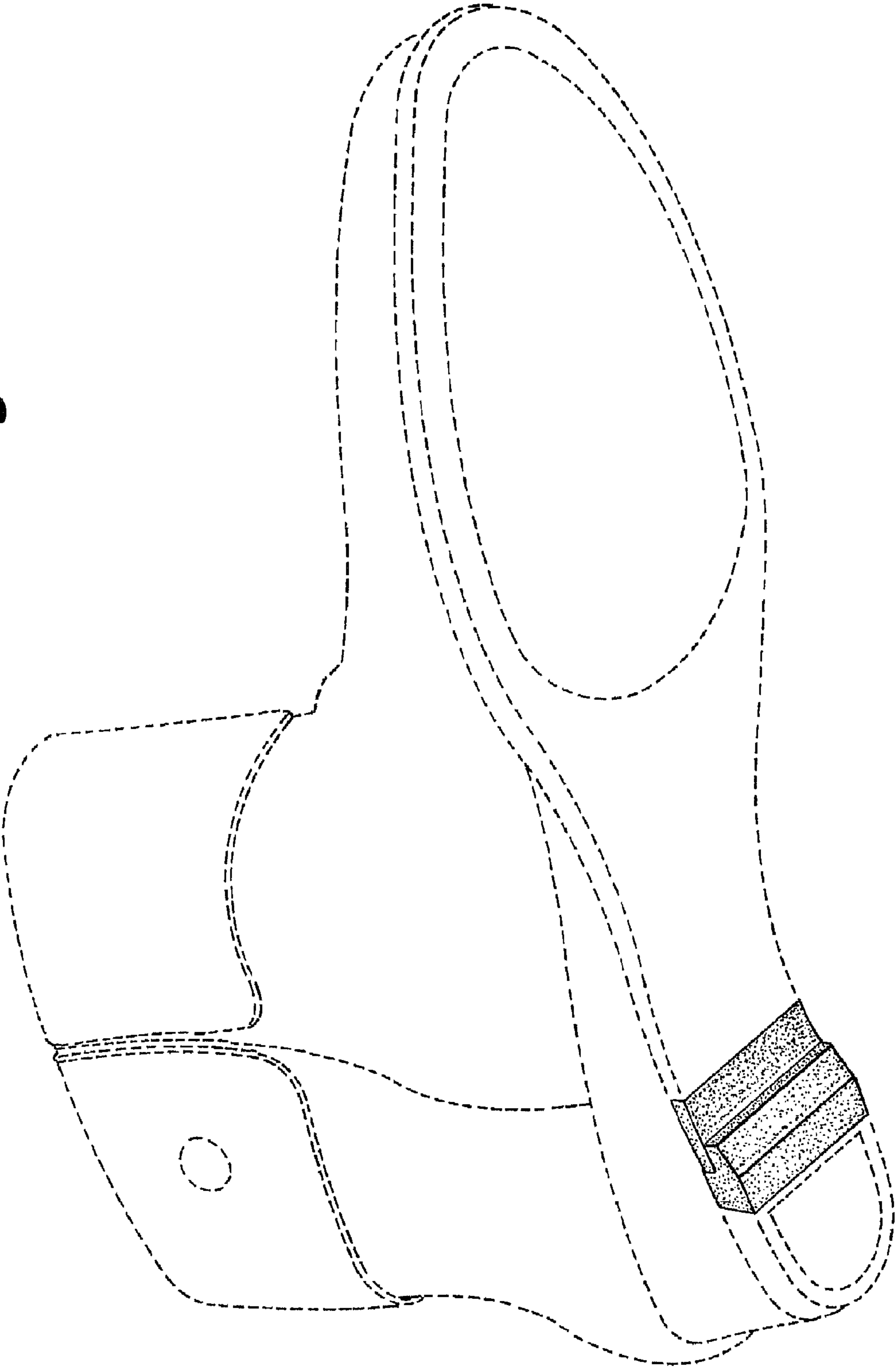

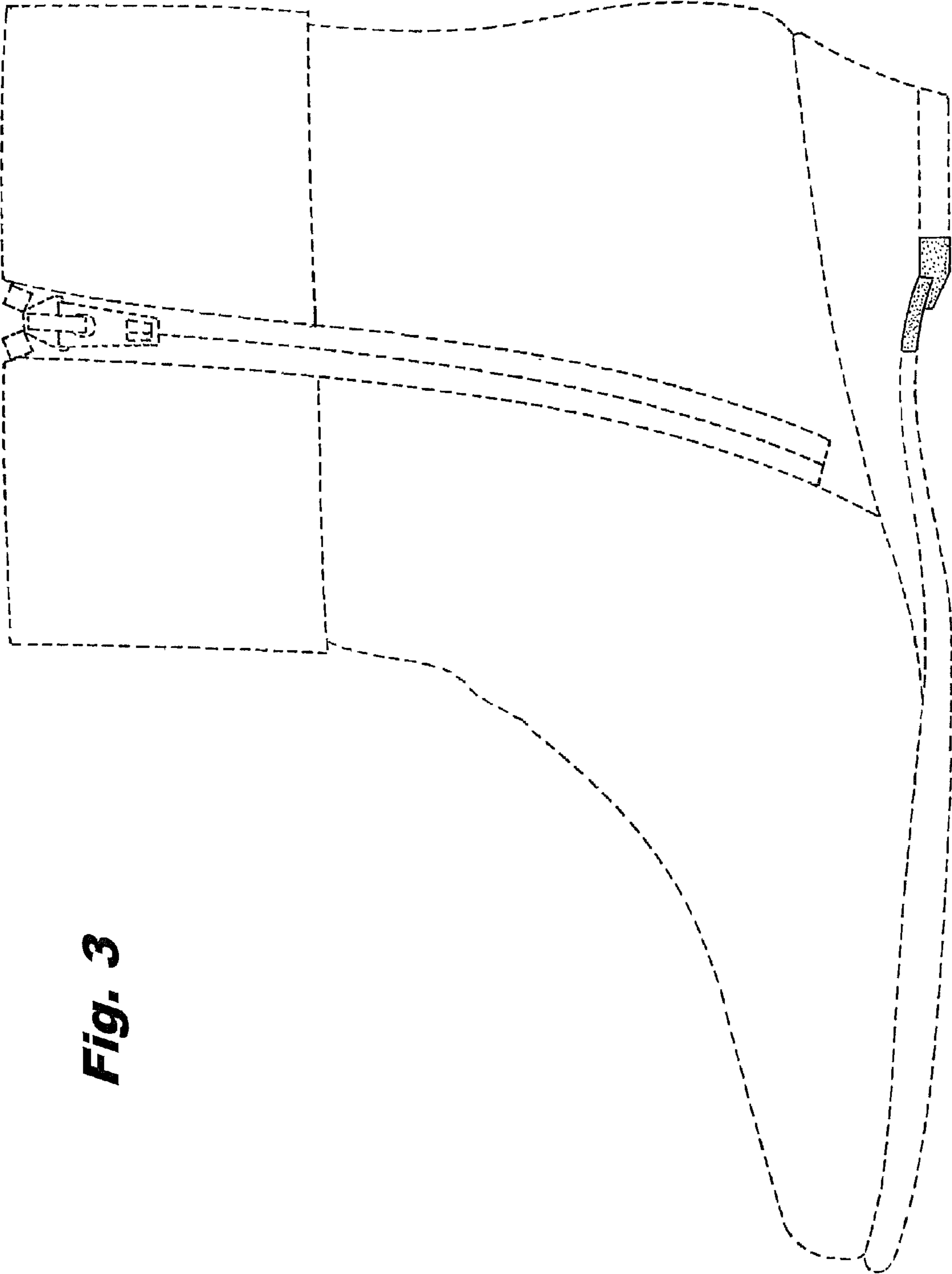

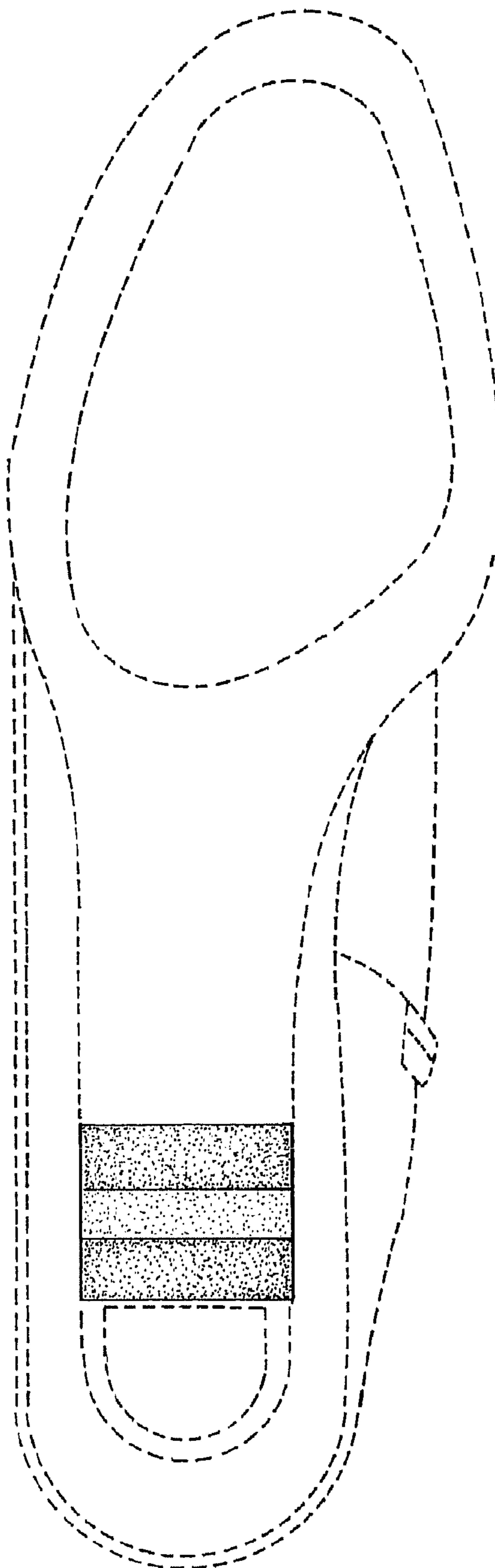

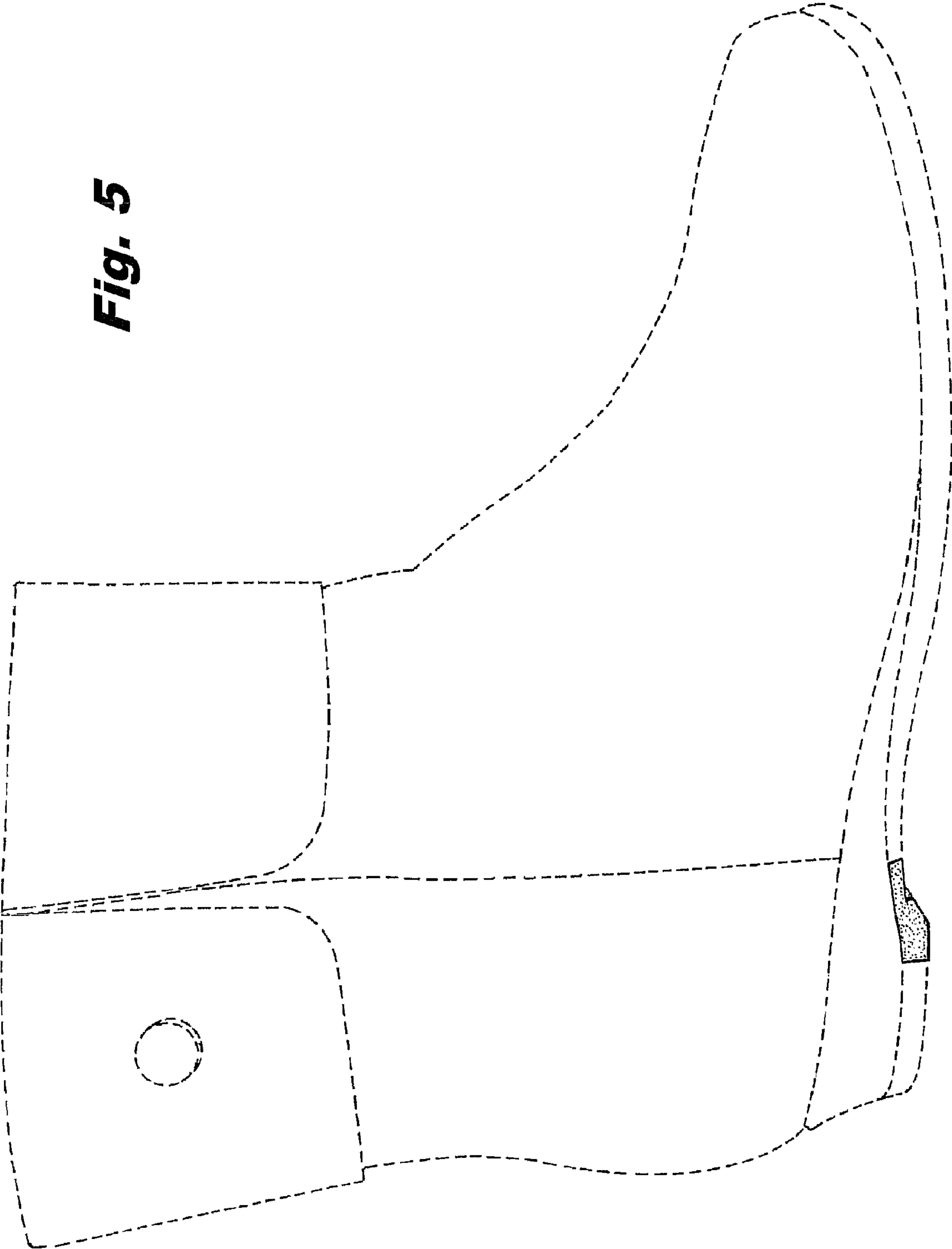
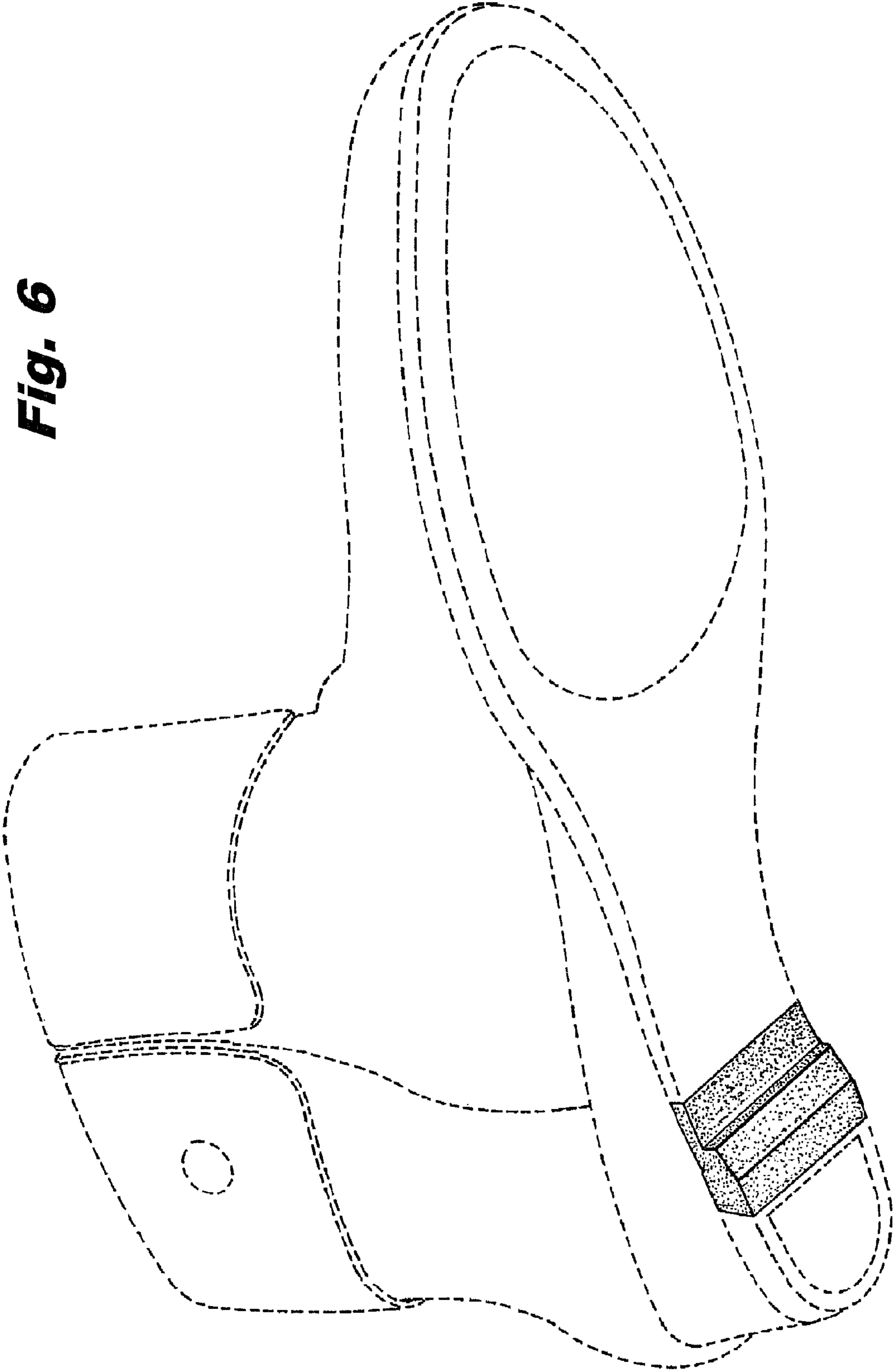

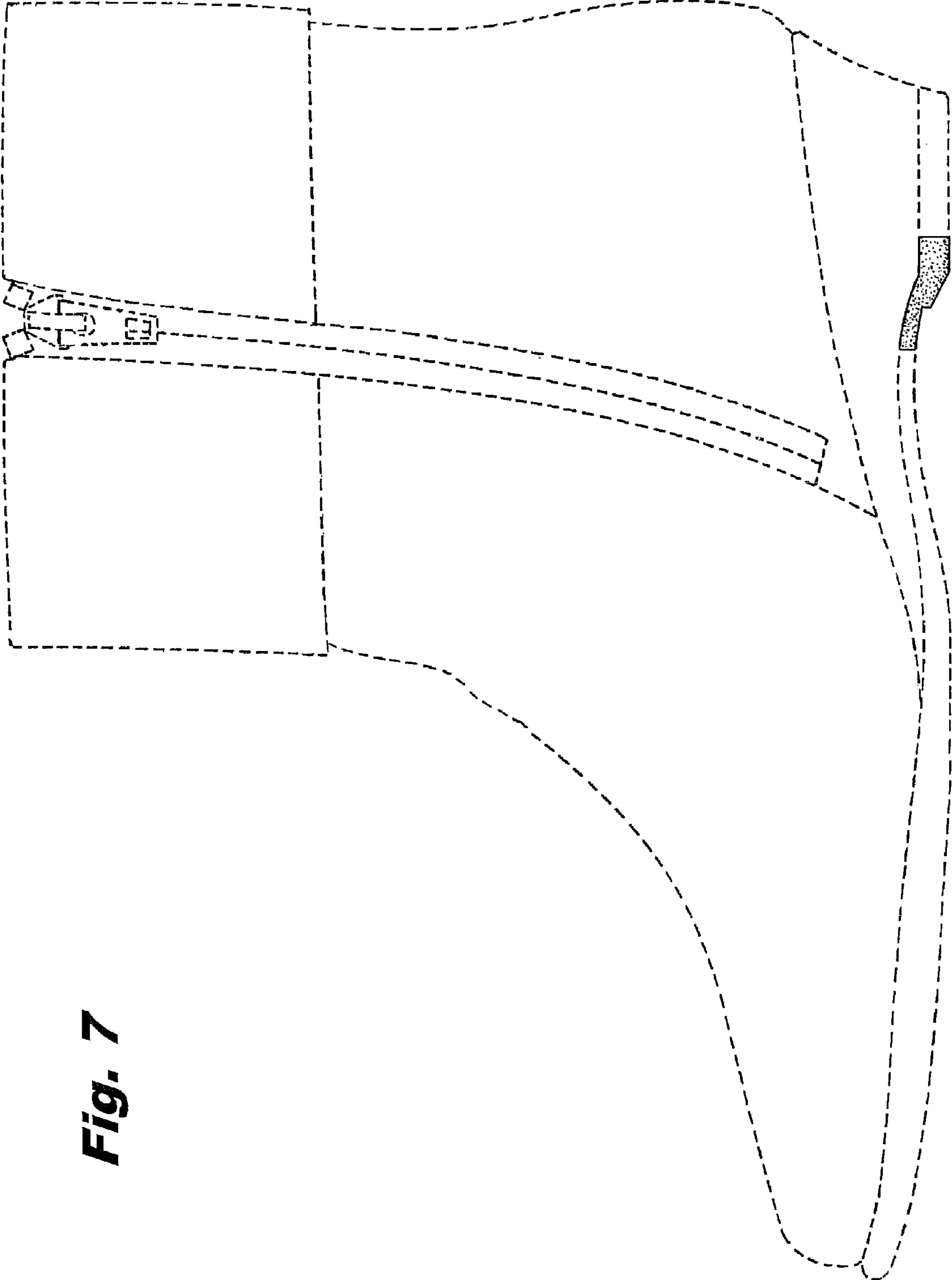
