(57) **CLAIM**

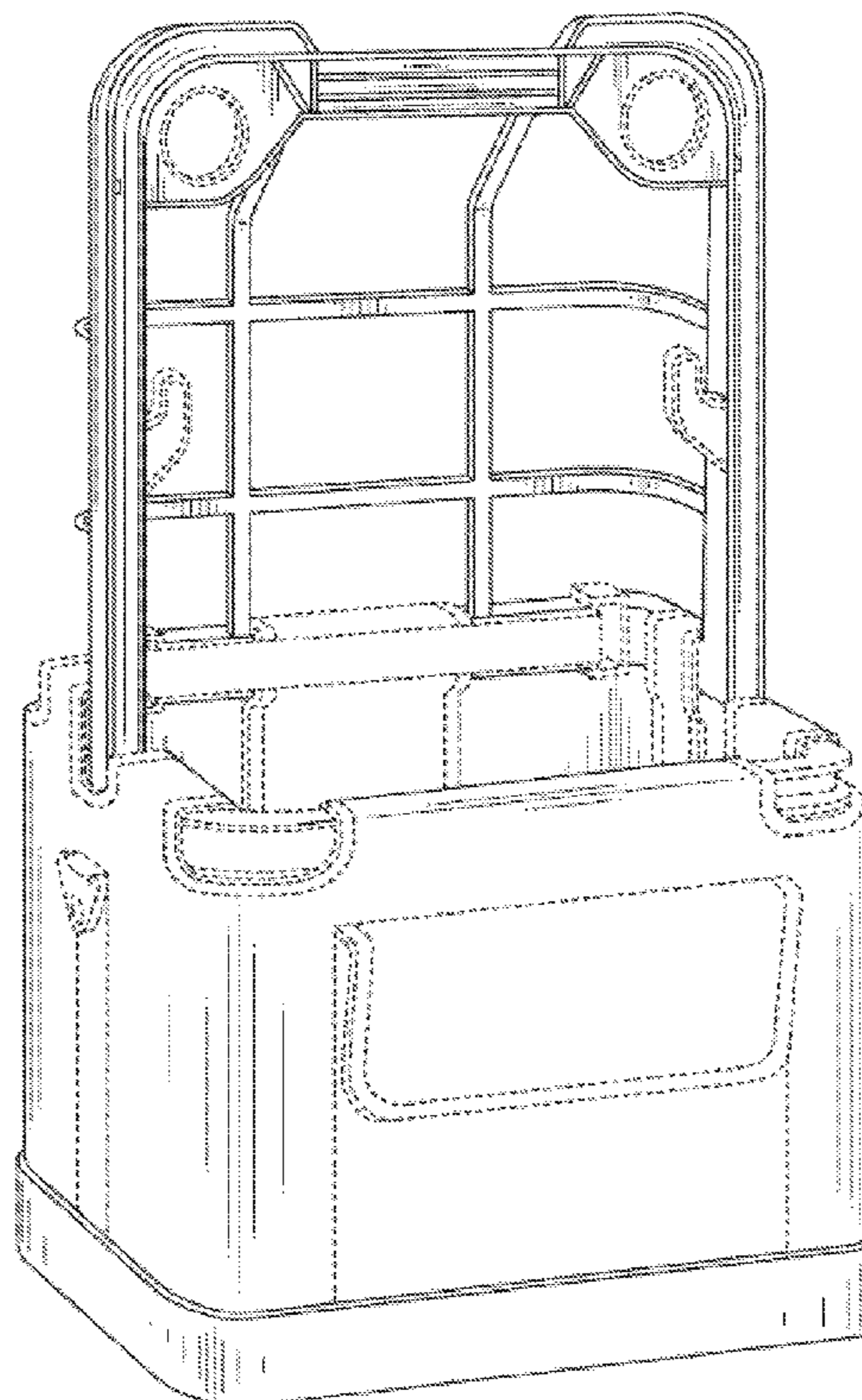
The ornamental design for a portable welding kit container, as

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portable welding kit con-
tainer showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

The bottom is unornamented and disclaimed. The broken
lines immediately adjacent to the shaded area represent the
boundaries of the claimed design. Other broken lines repre-

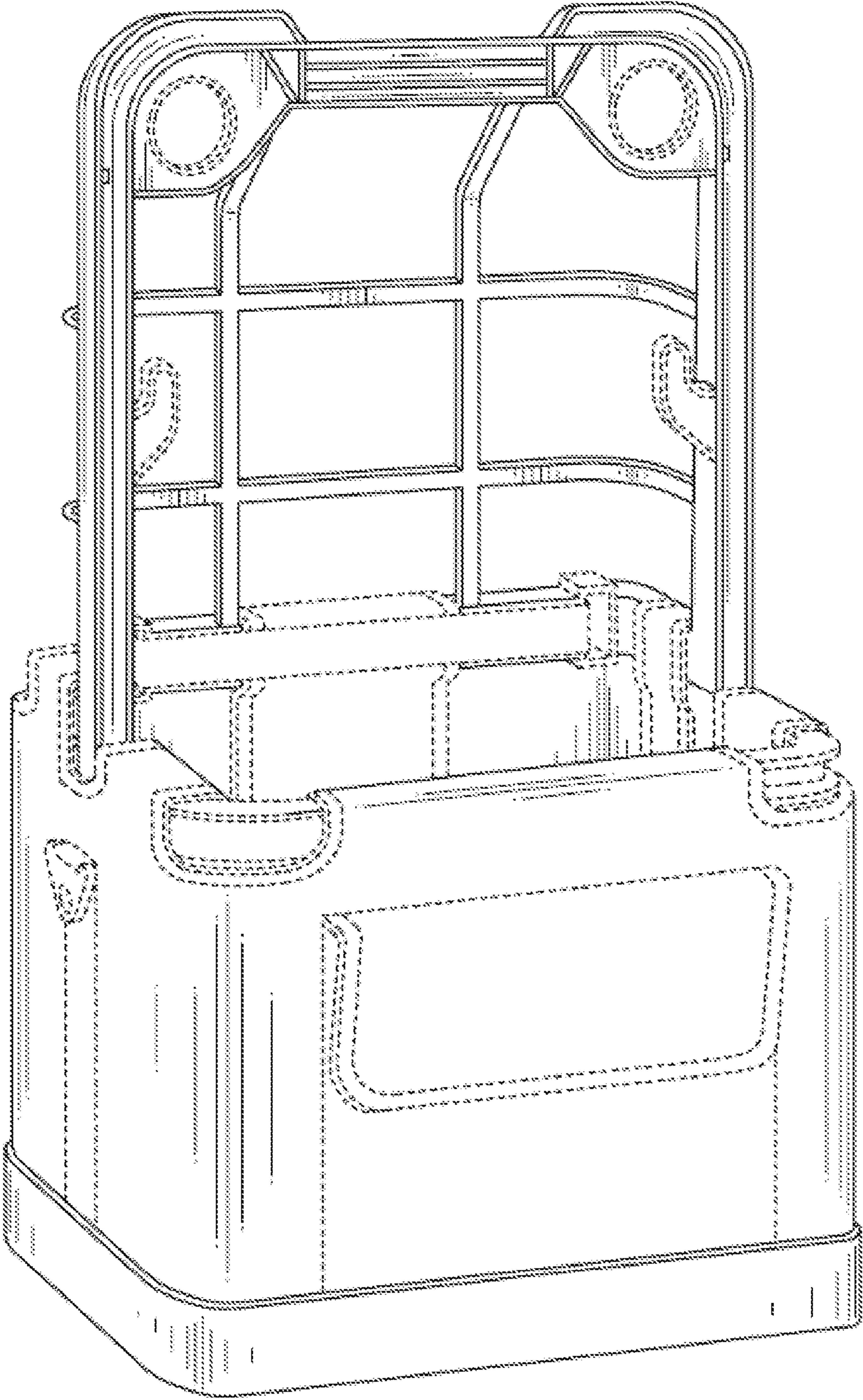

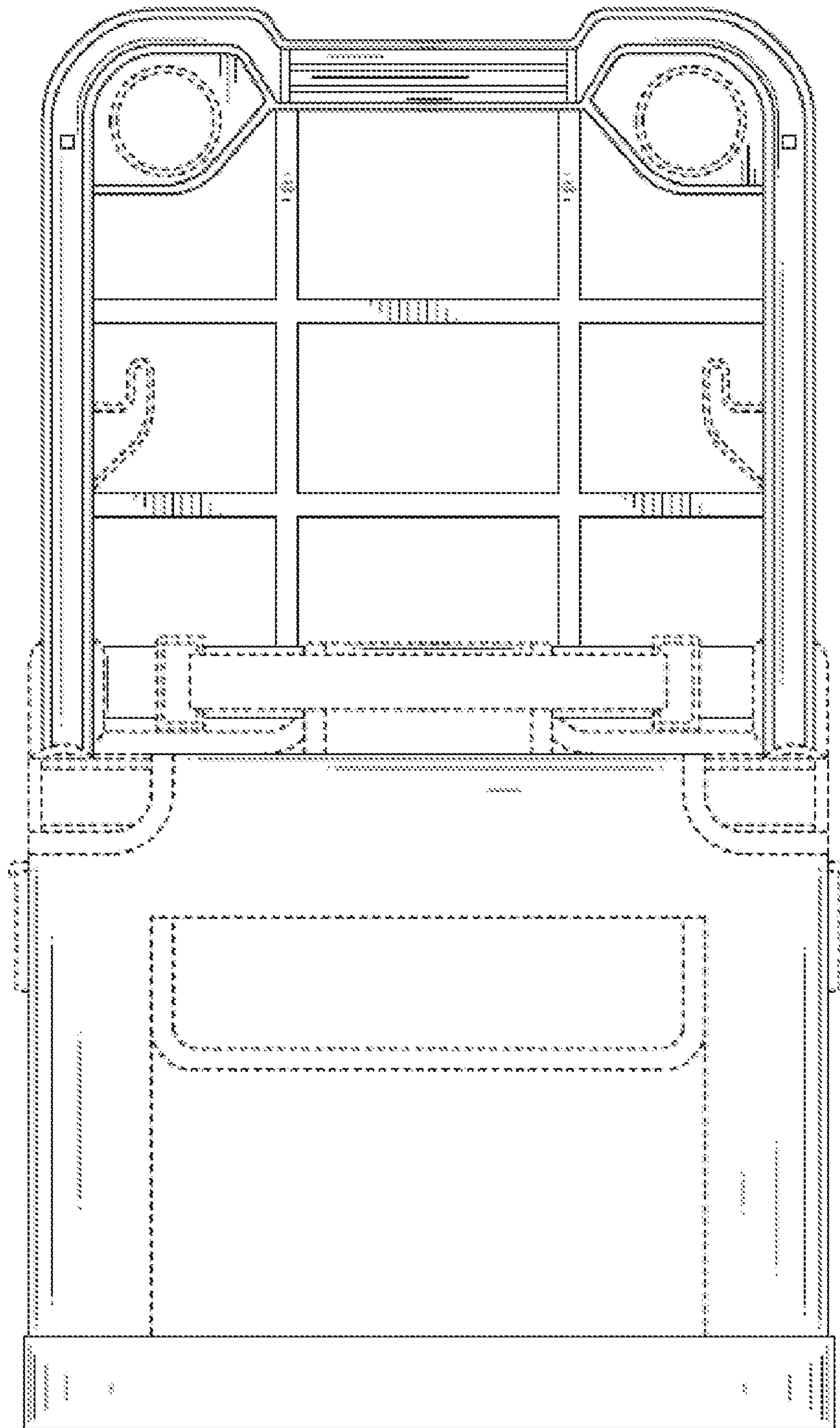

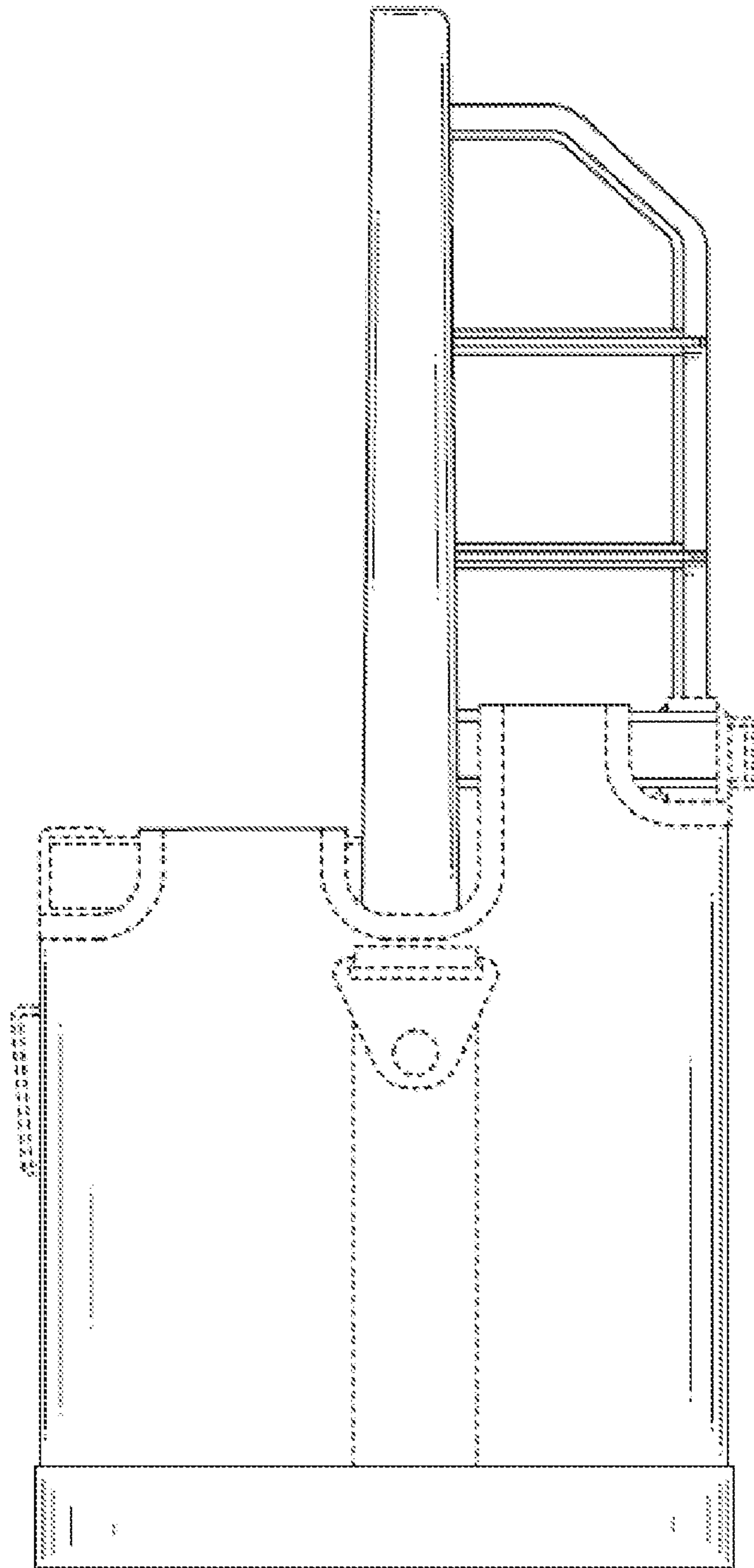

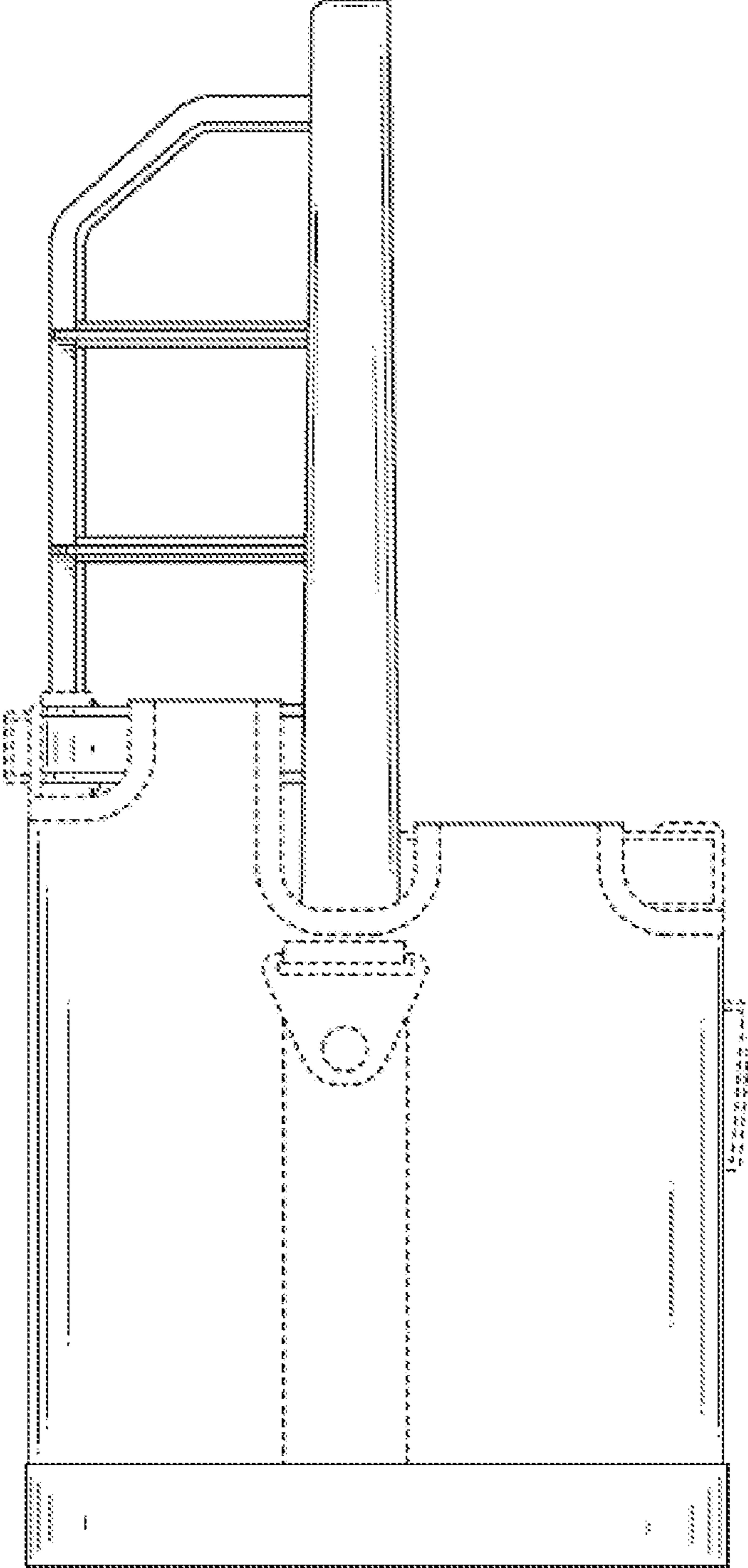

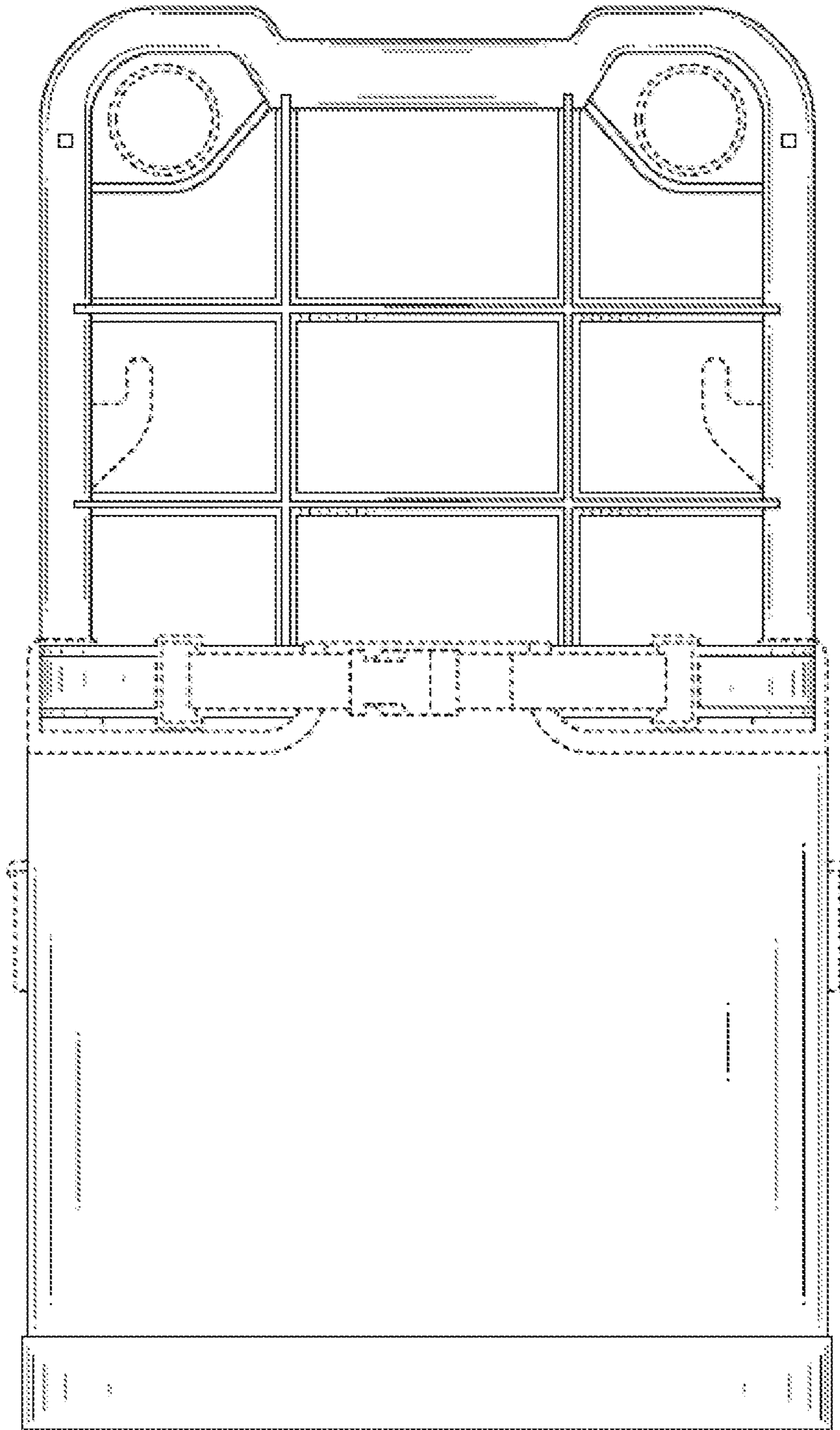

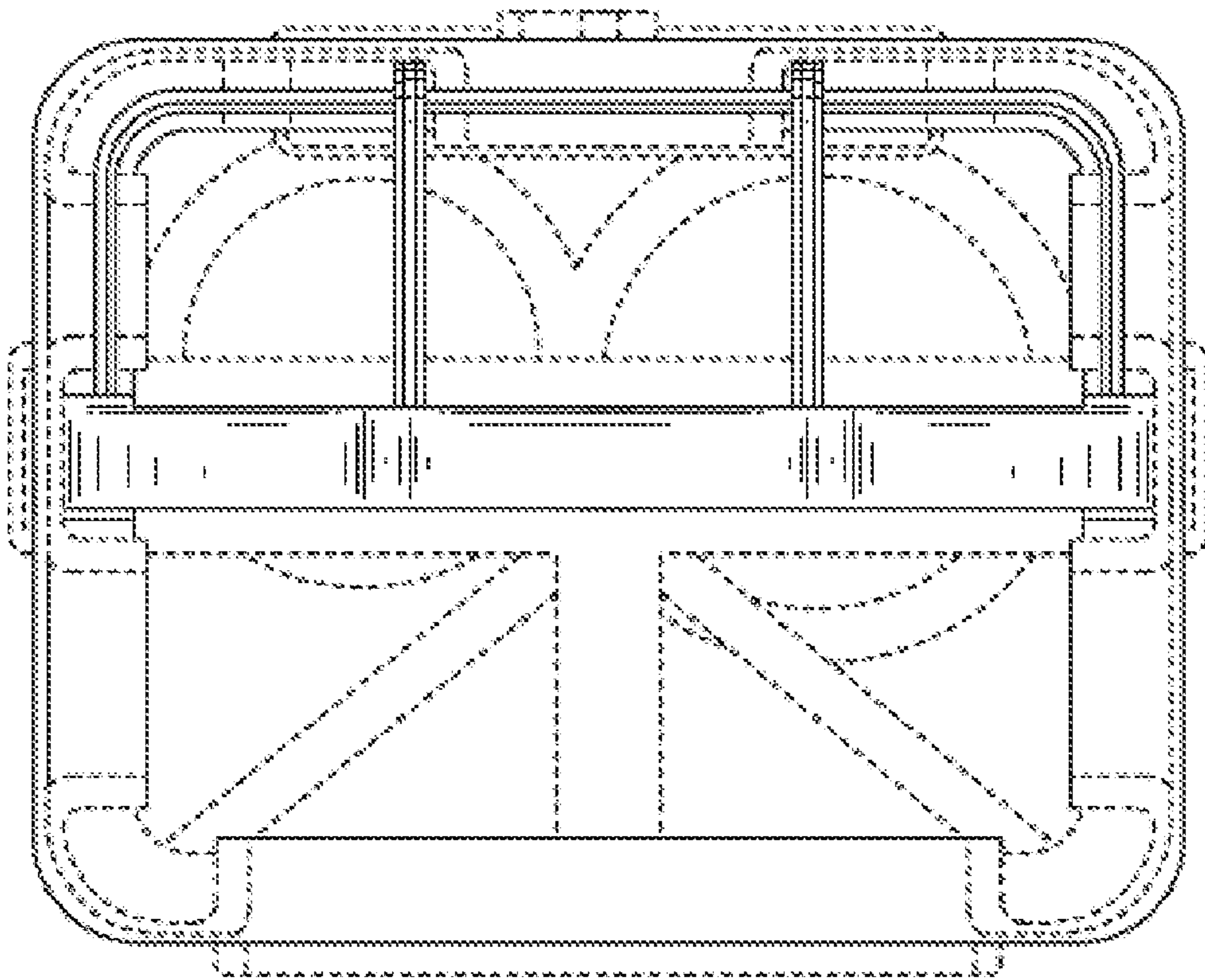
