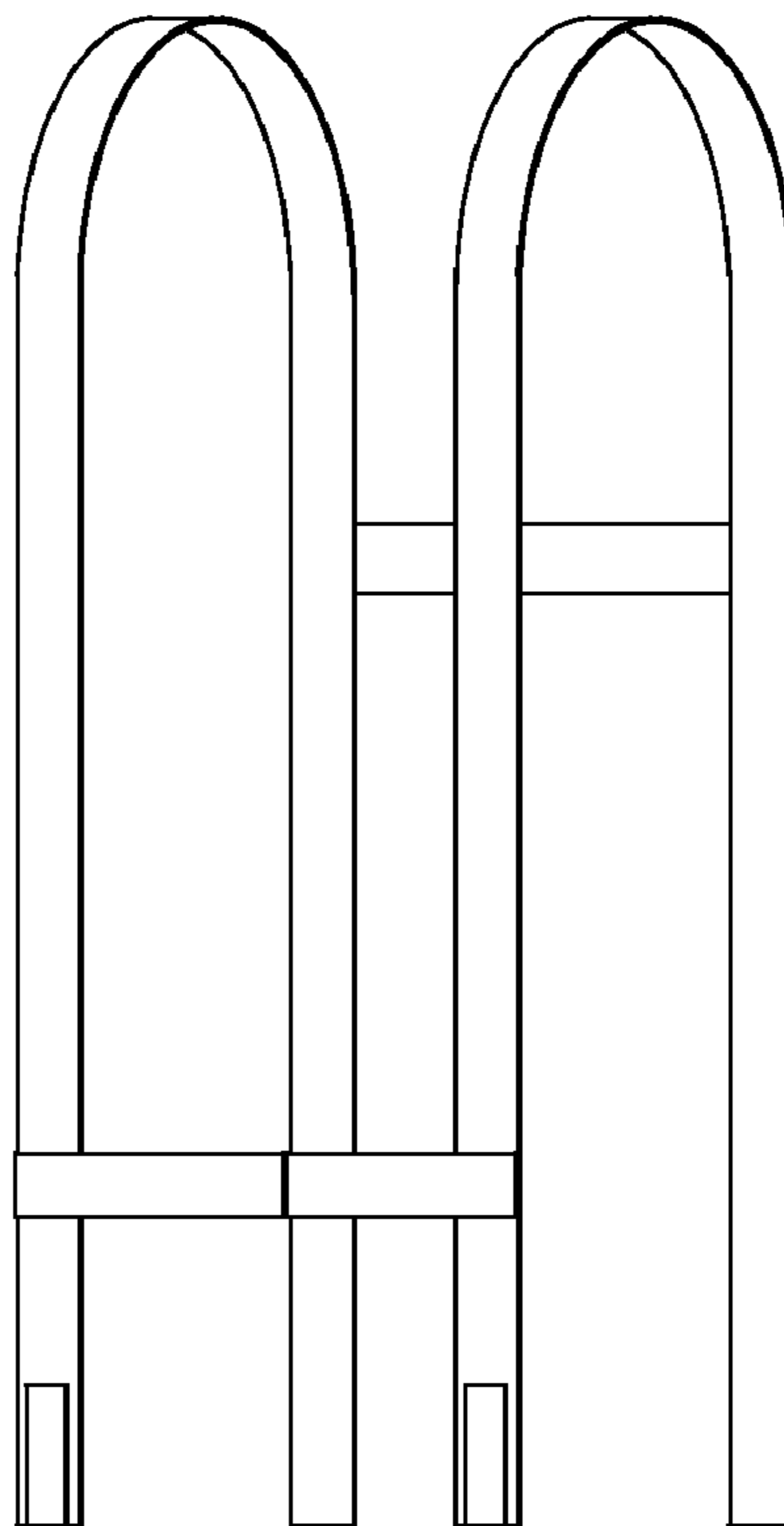
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pair of suspenders, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a pair of suspenders showing the front strap in a fastened position; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a pair of suspenders showing the front strap in a fastened position; FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of a pair of suspenders showing the front strap in a fastened position; FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view of a pair of suspenders showing the front strap in a fastened position; and, FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a pair of suspenders showing the front strap in an unfastened position.

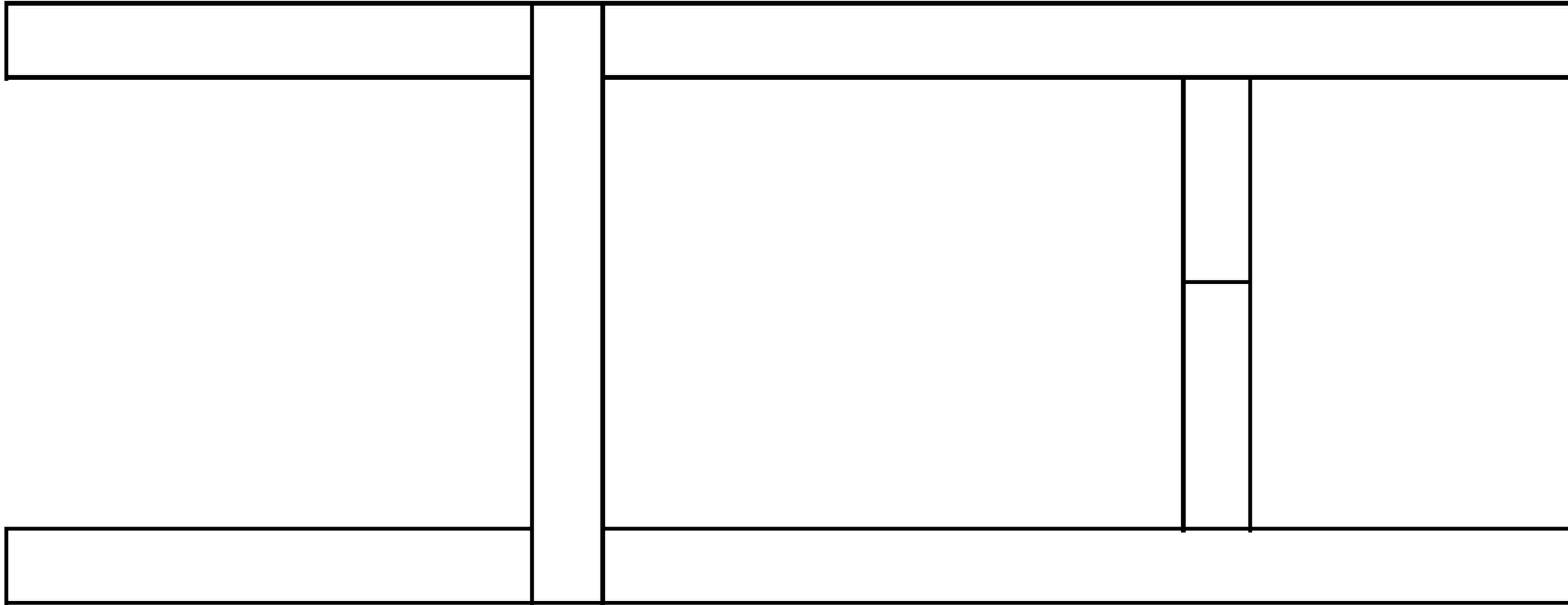

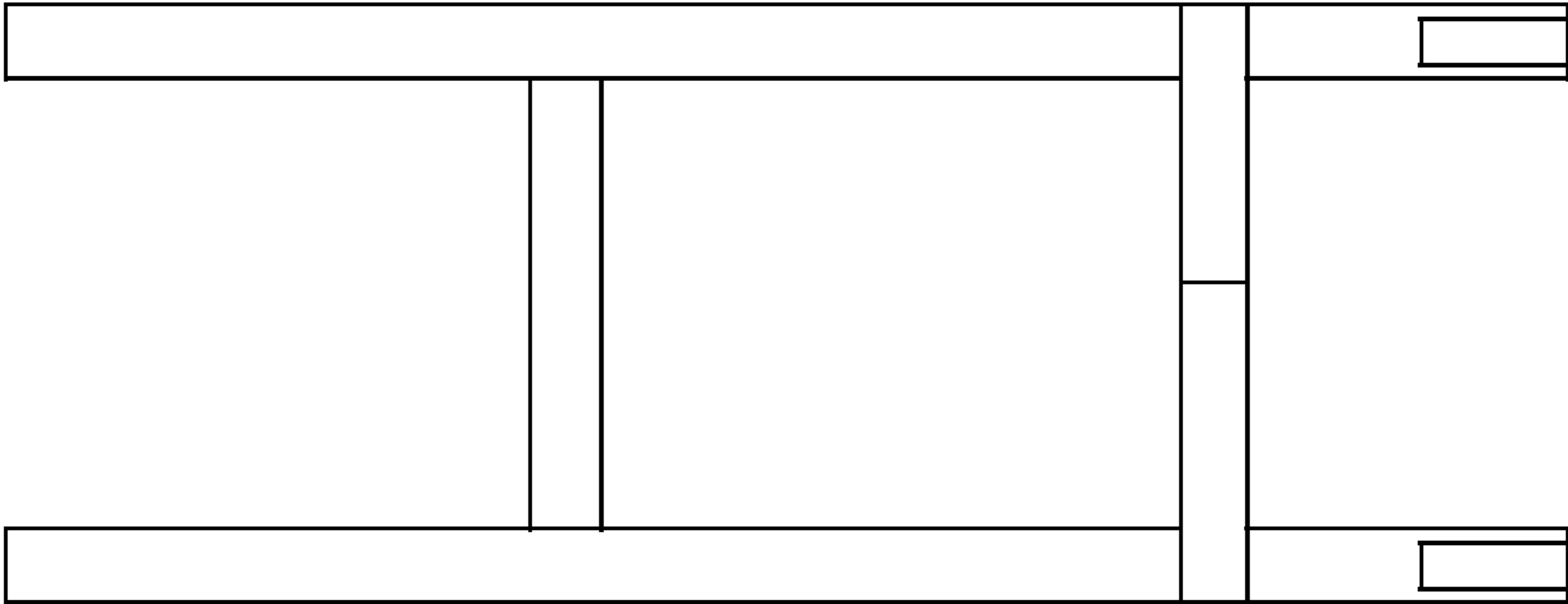

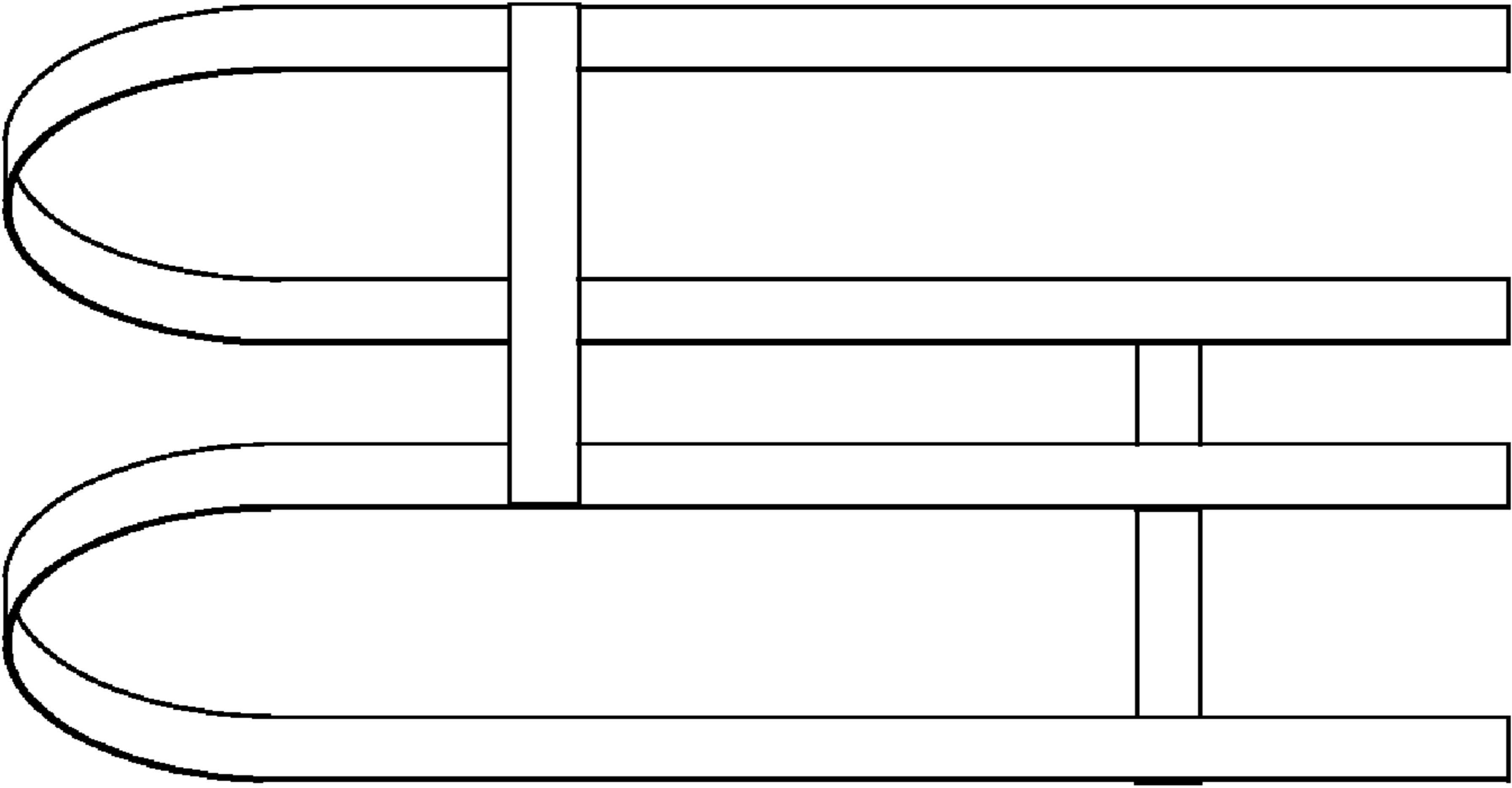

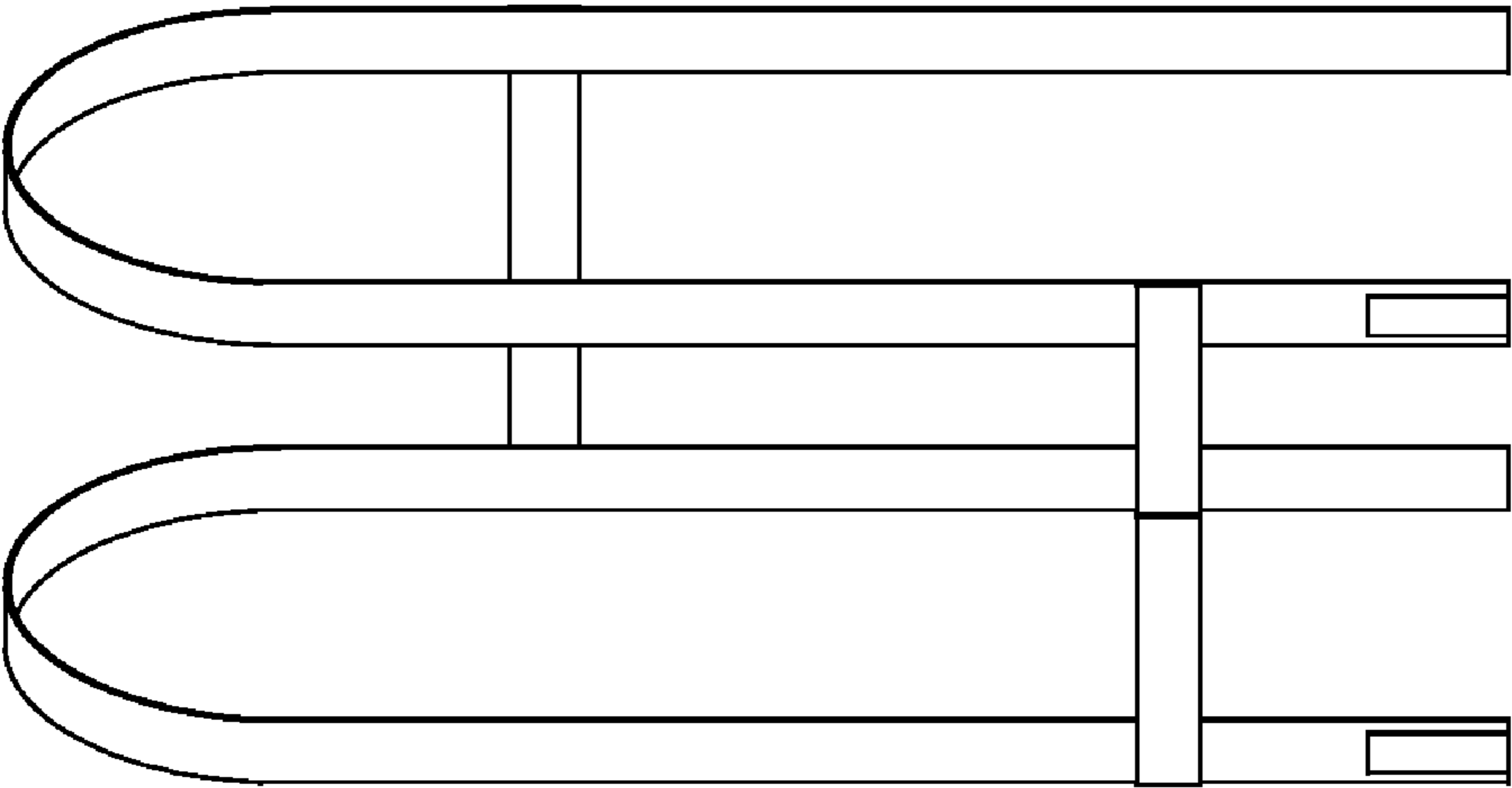

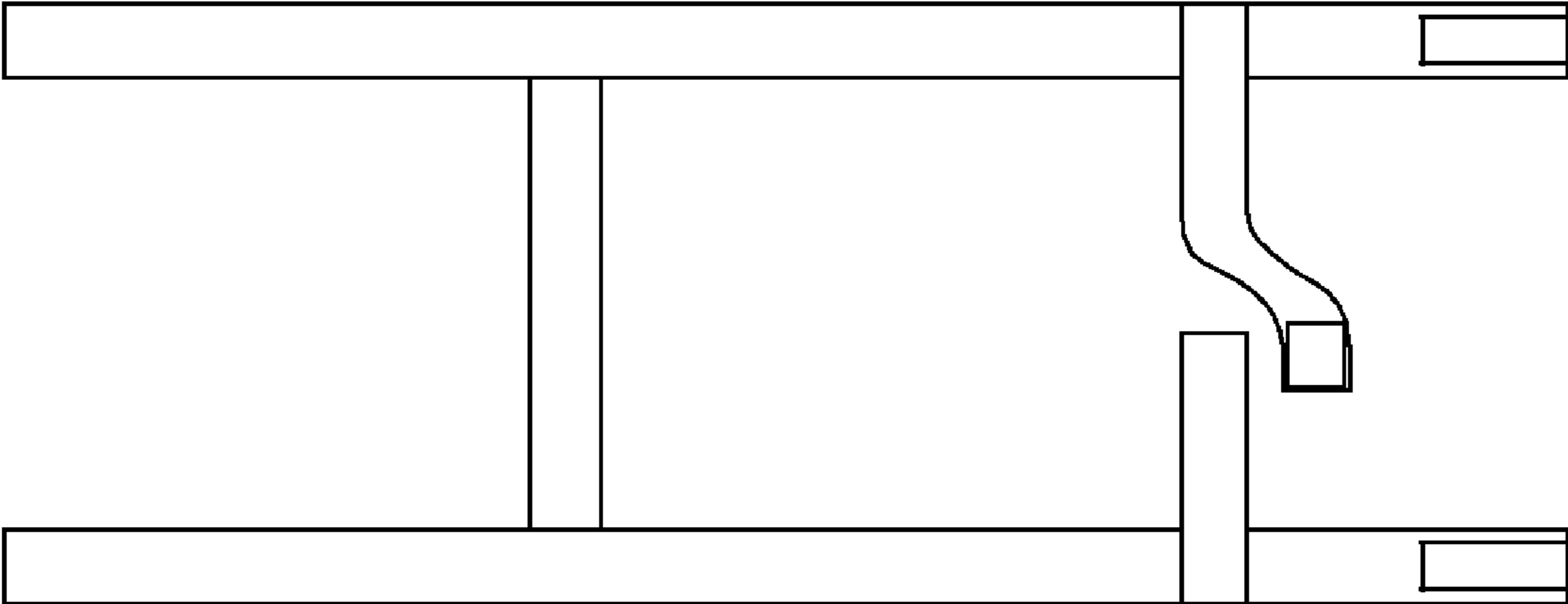
