(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a mop pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view for a mop pad showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is top view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged view taken along lines 7 in FIG. 1, showing the looped nap and mop pad;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is top view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a front view thereof;

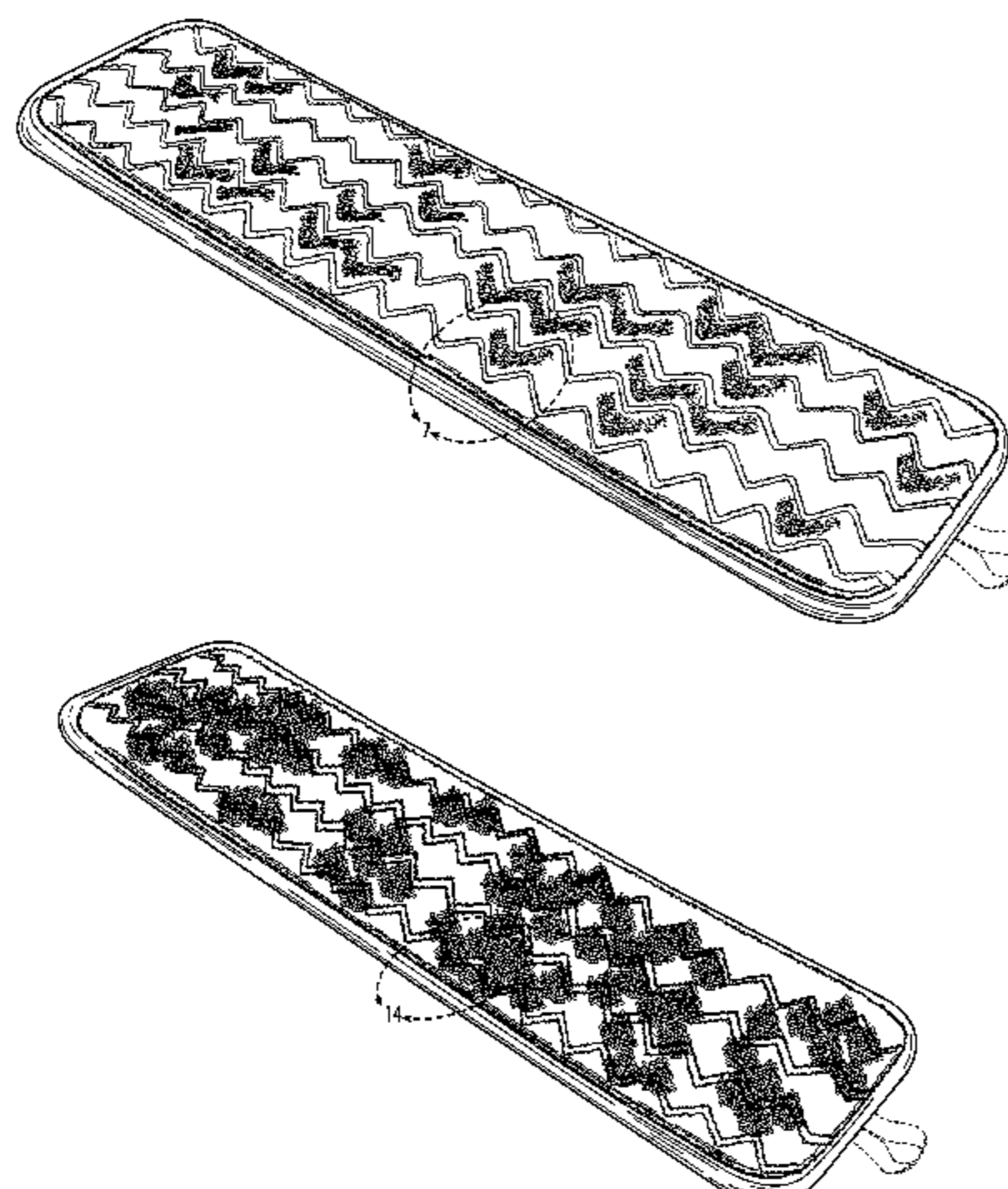
FIG. 12 is a right side elevational view thereof;

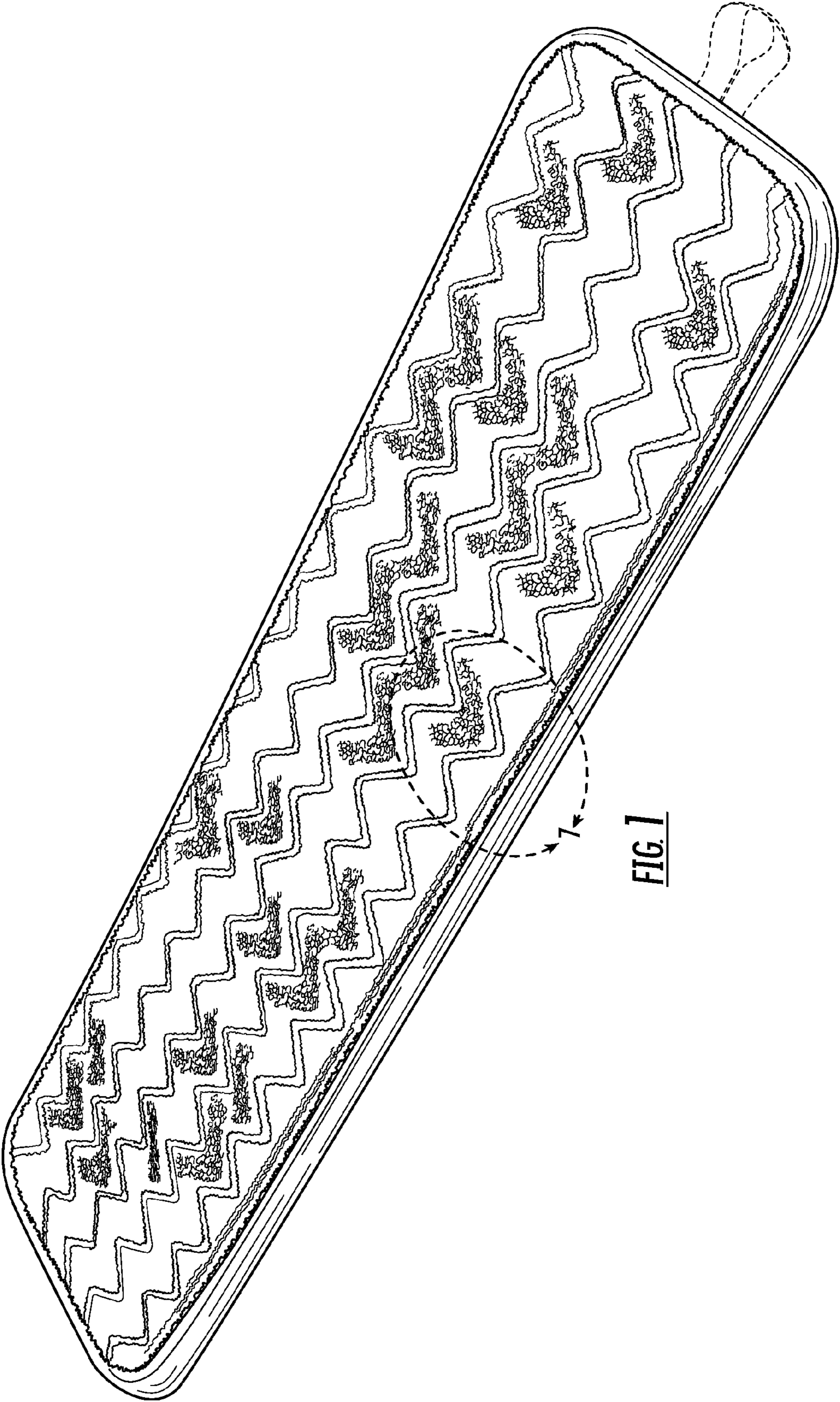

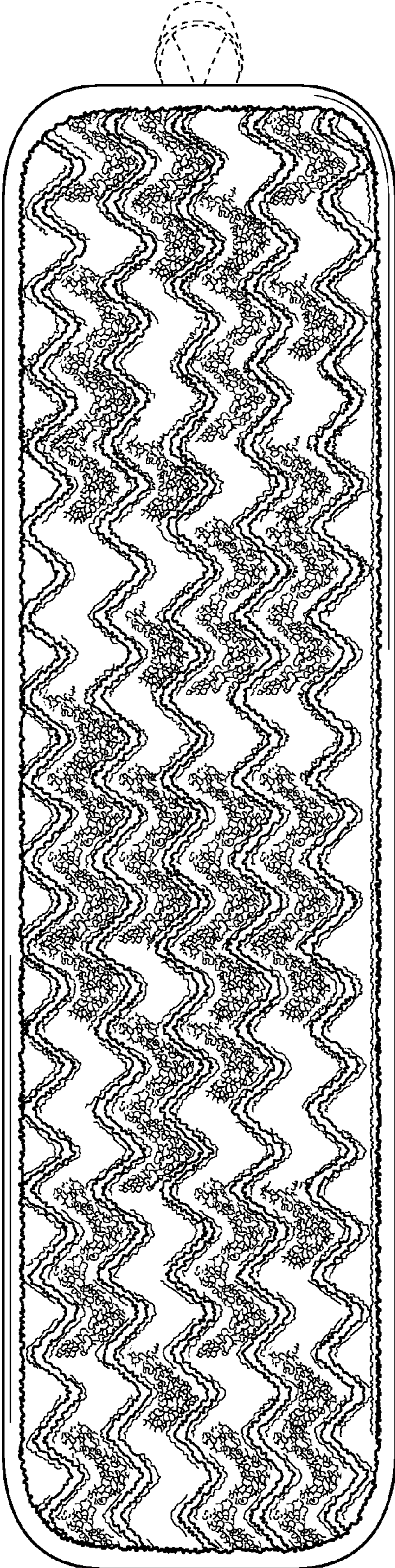

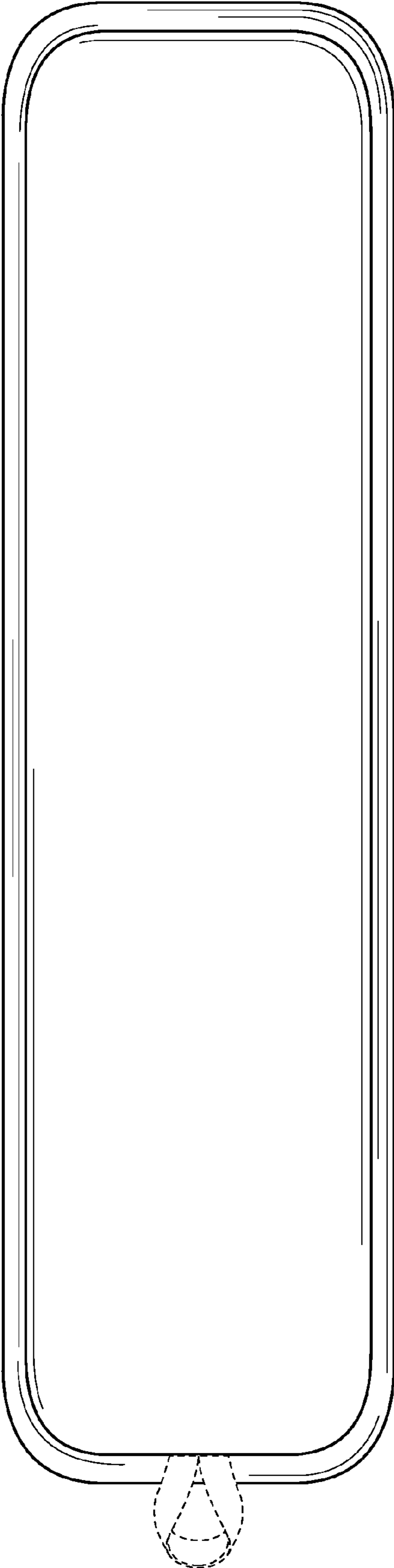

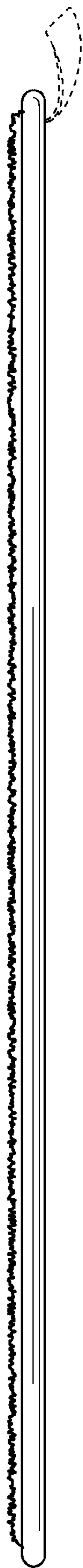

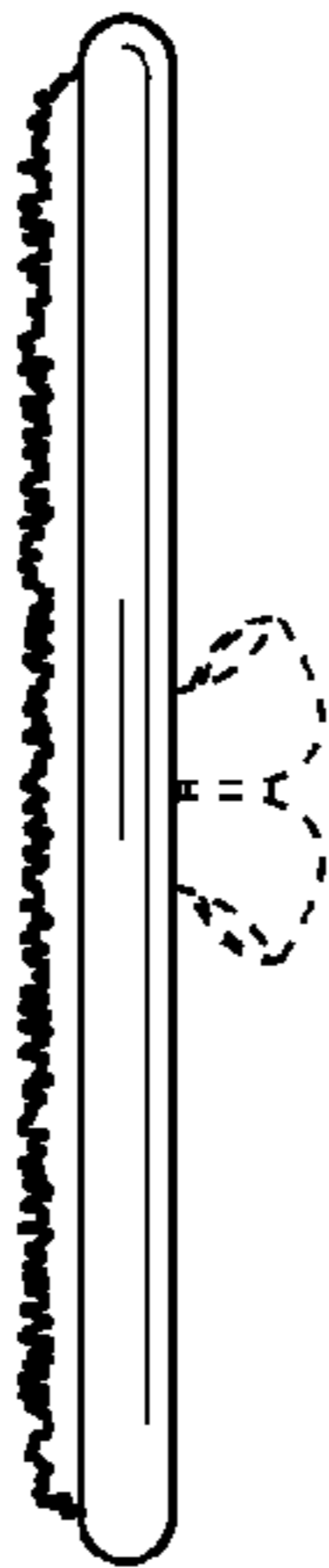

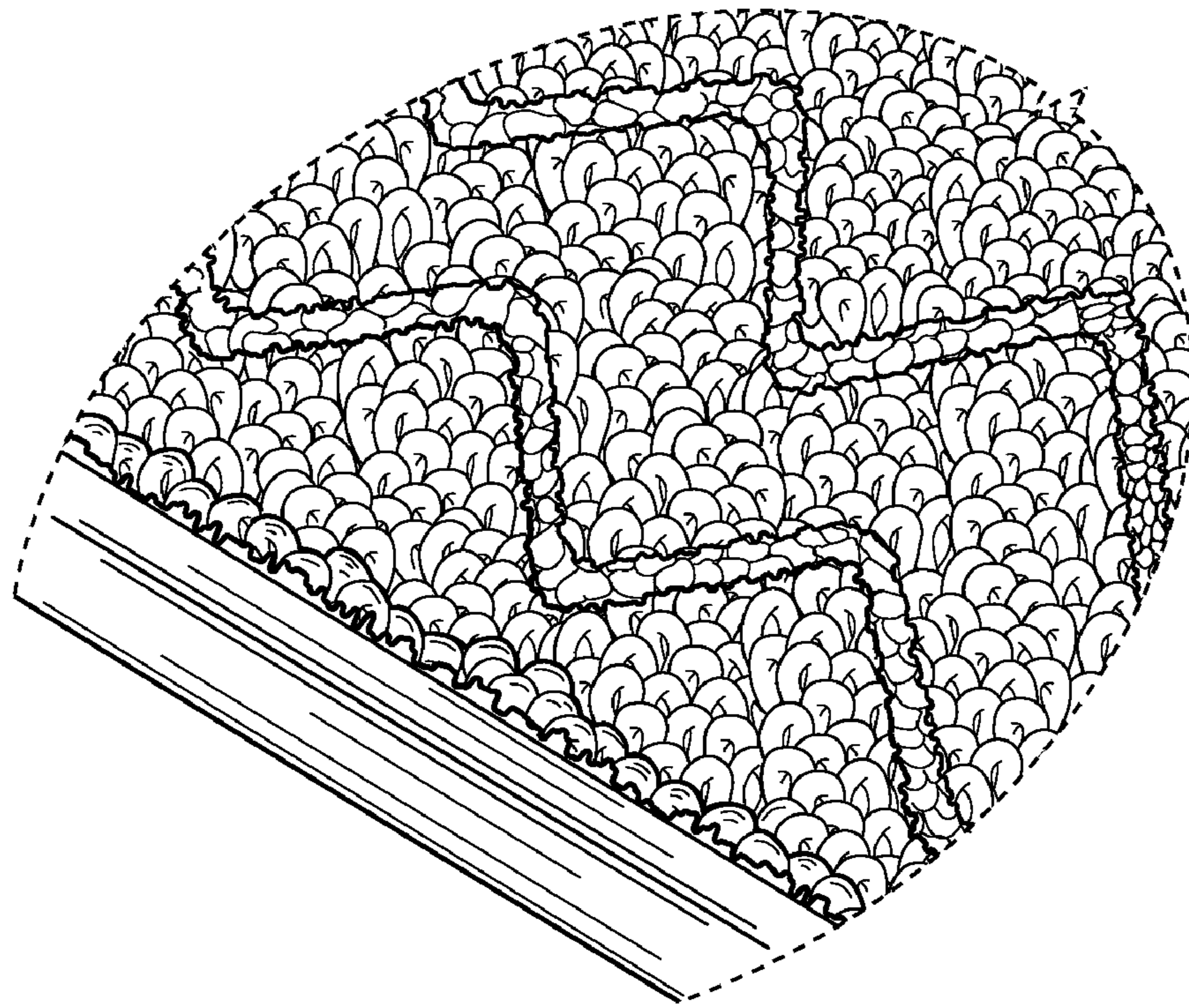

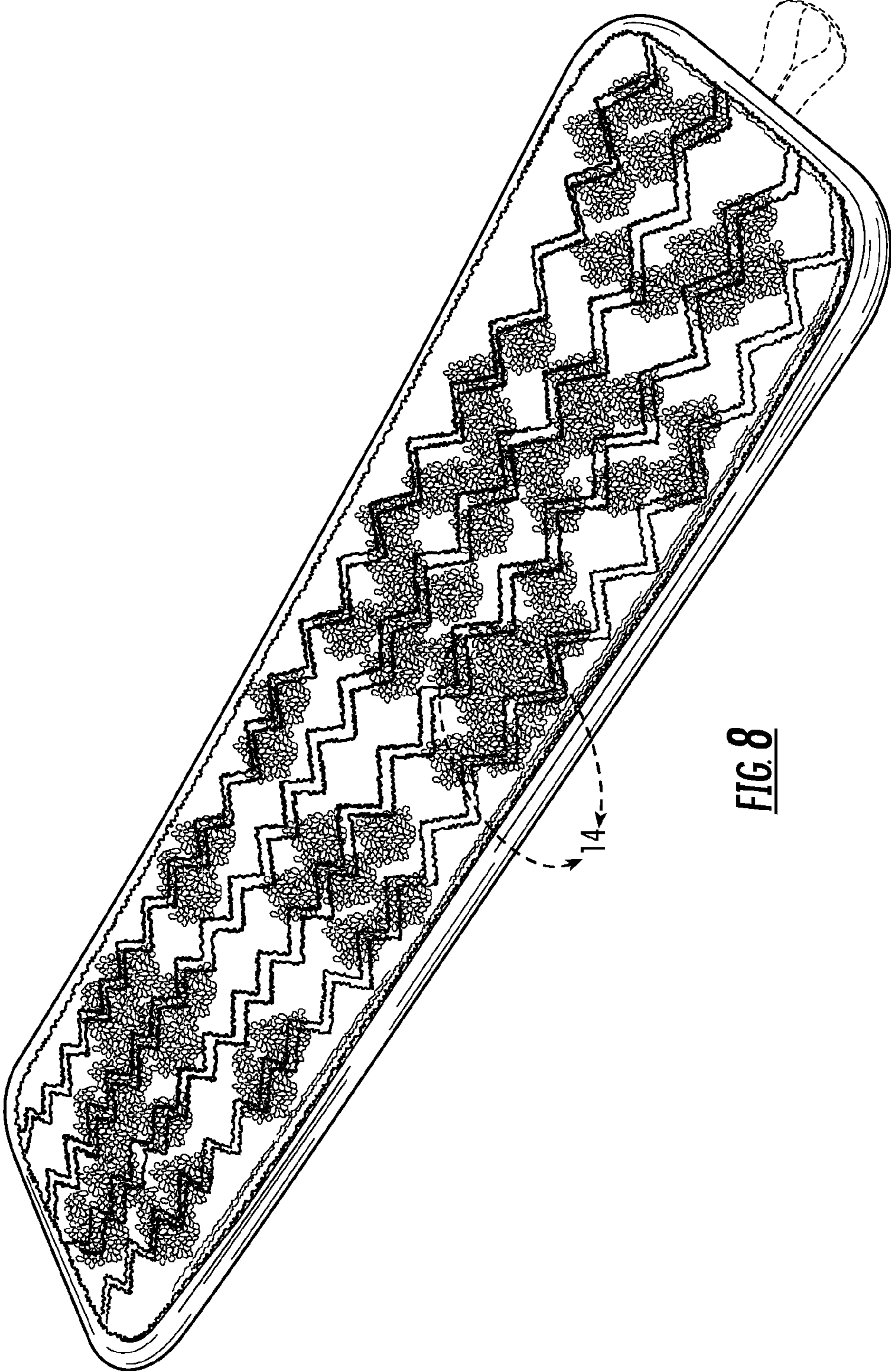

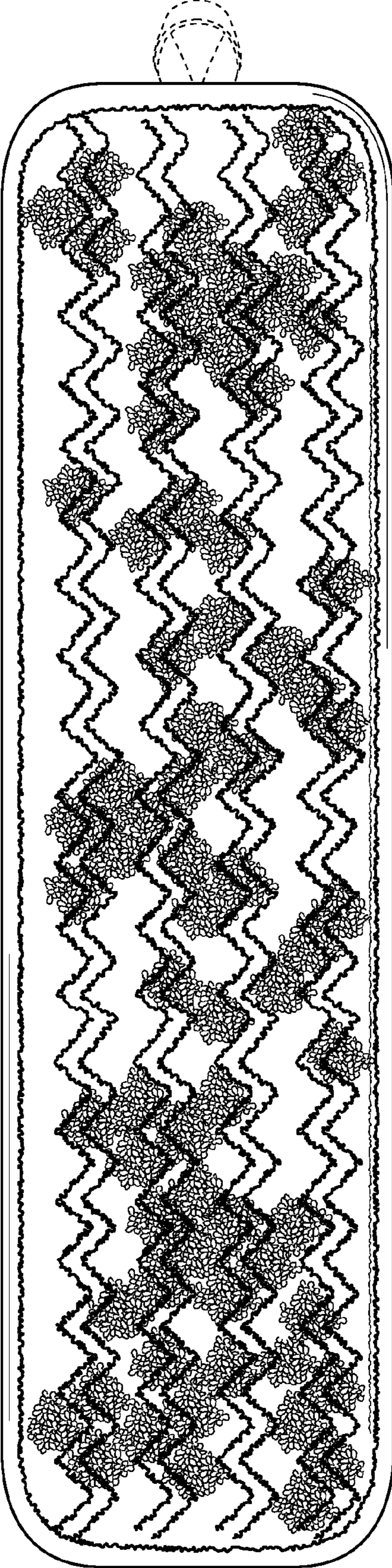

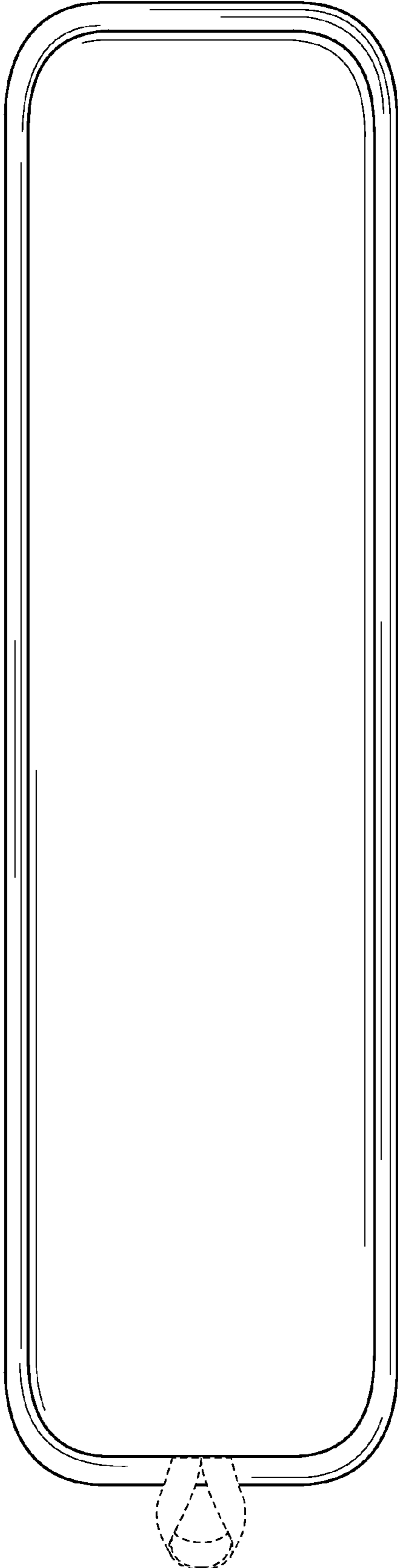

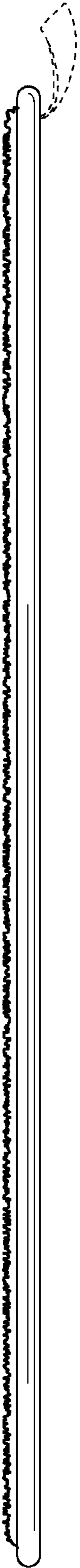

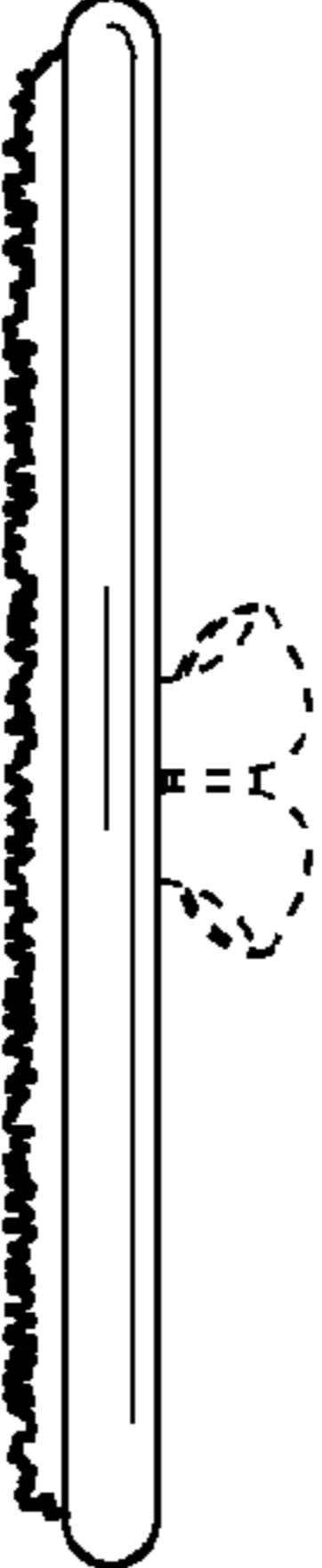

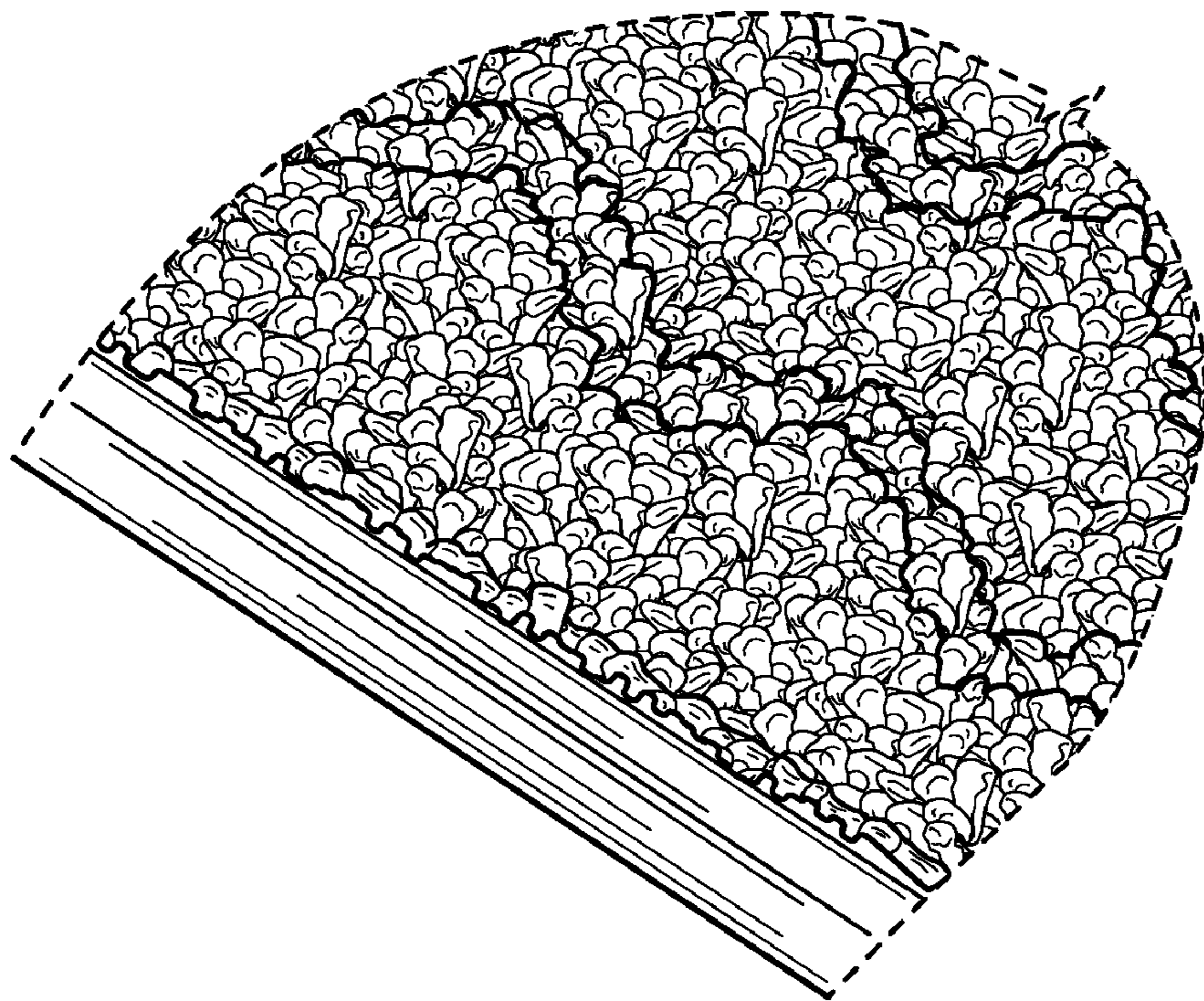
