FIG. 4 is a first end view thereof

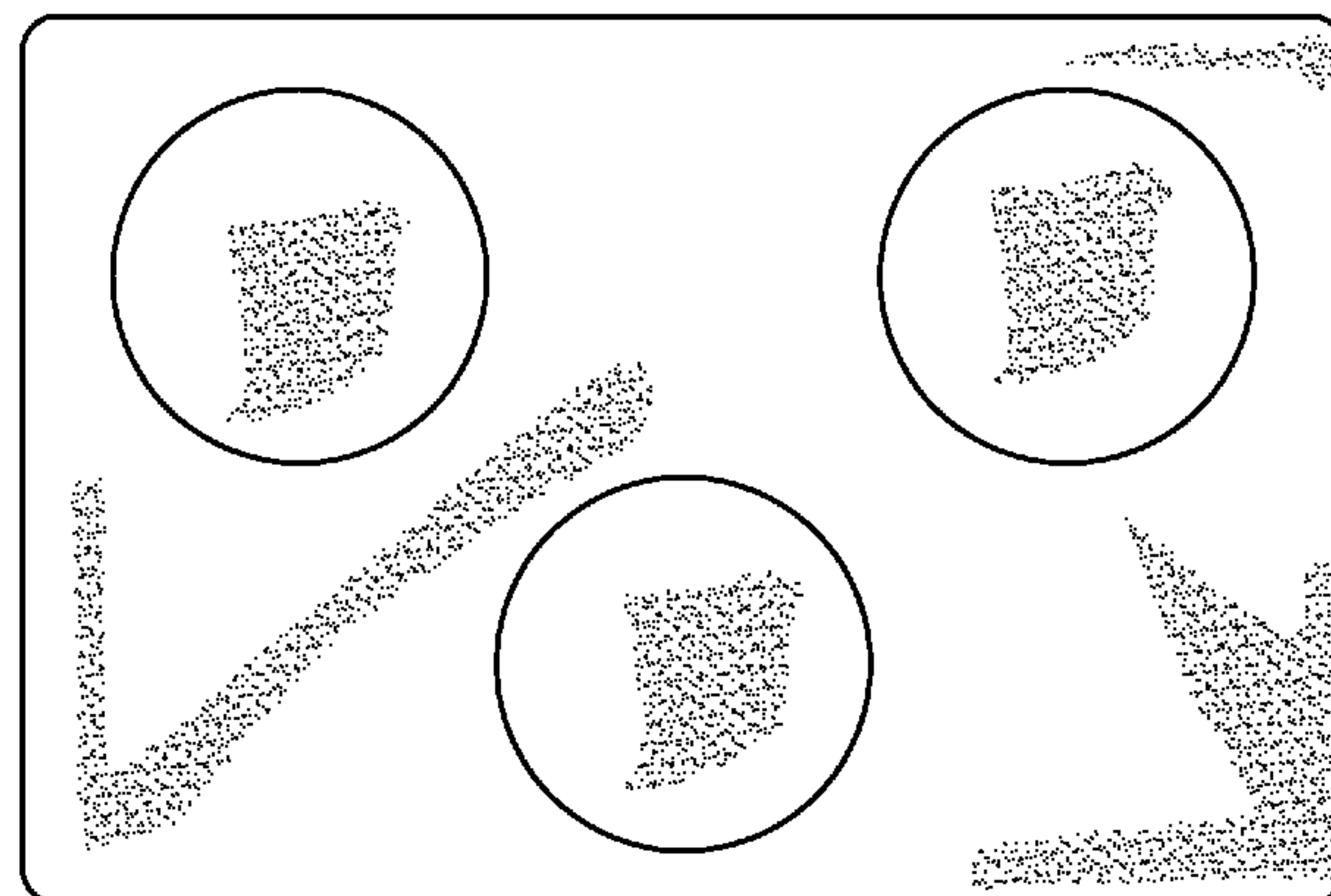
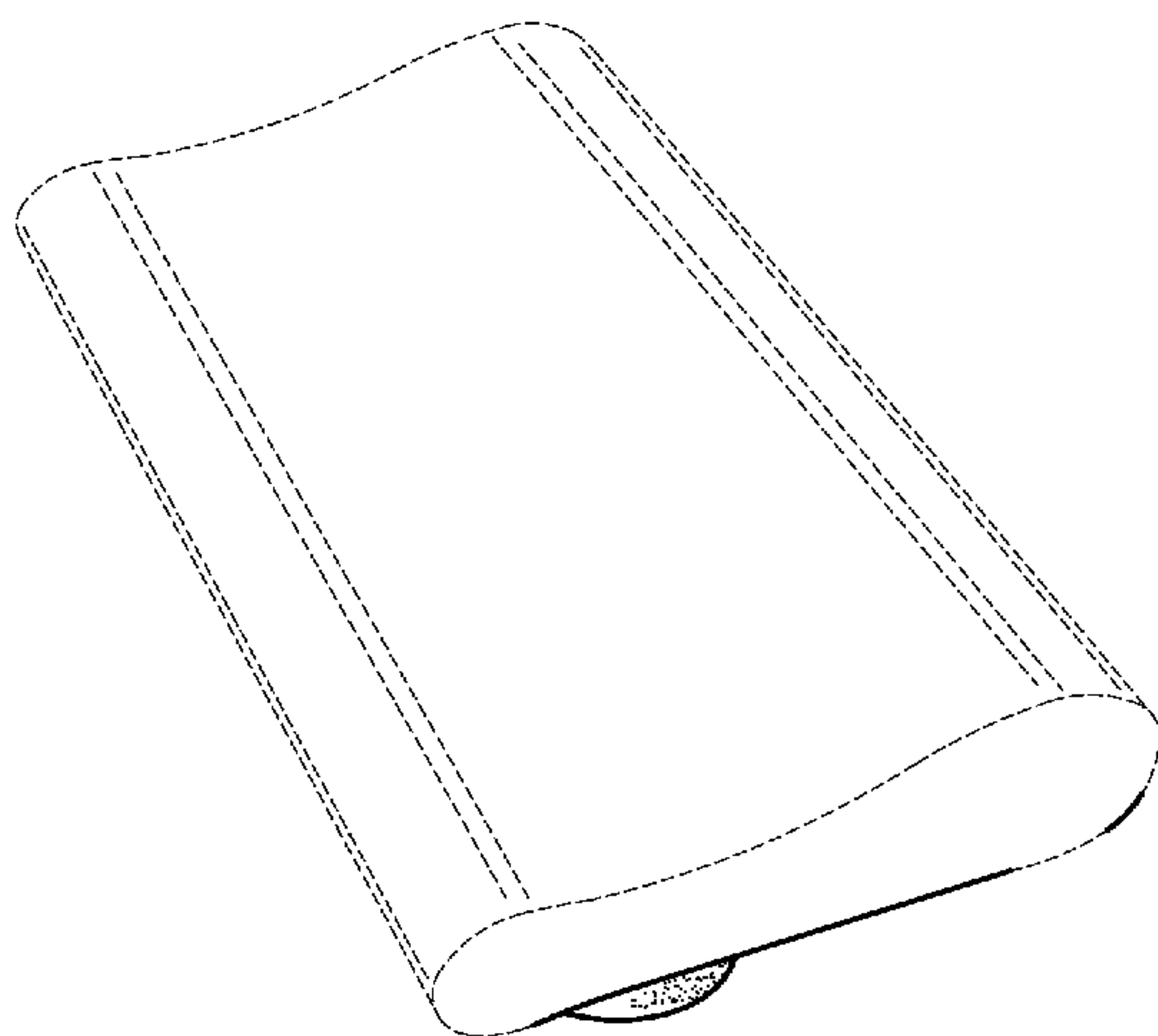
FIG. 5 is a second side view thereof;

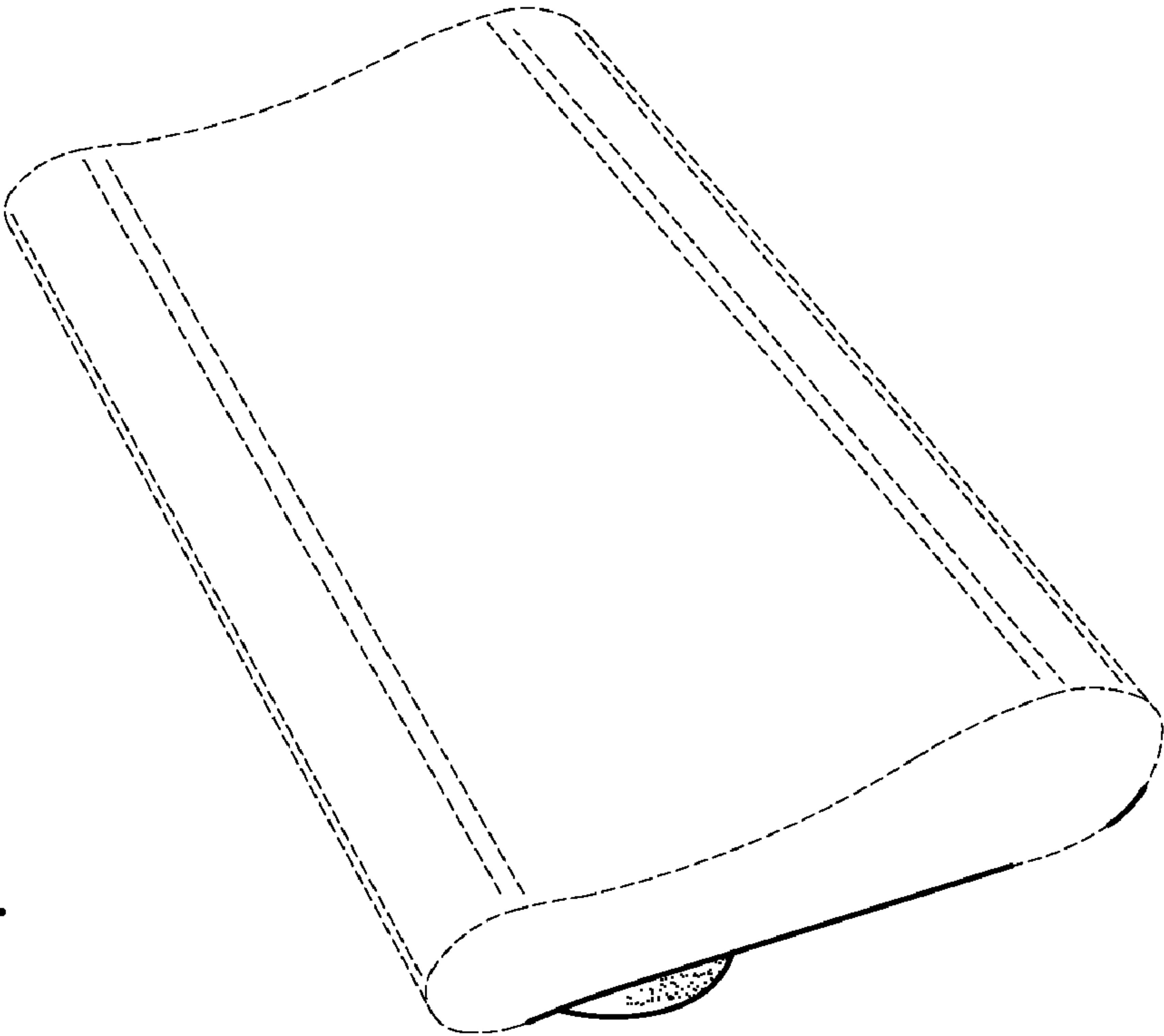

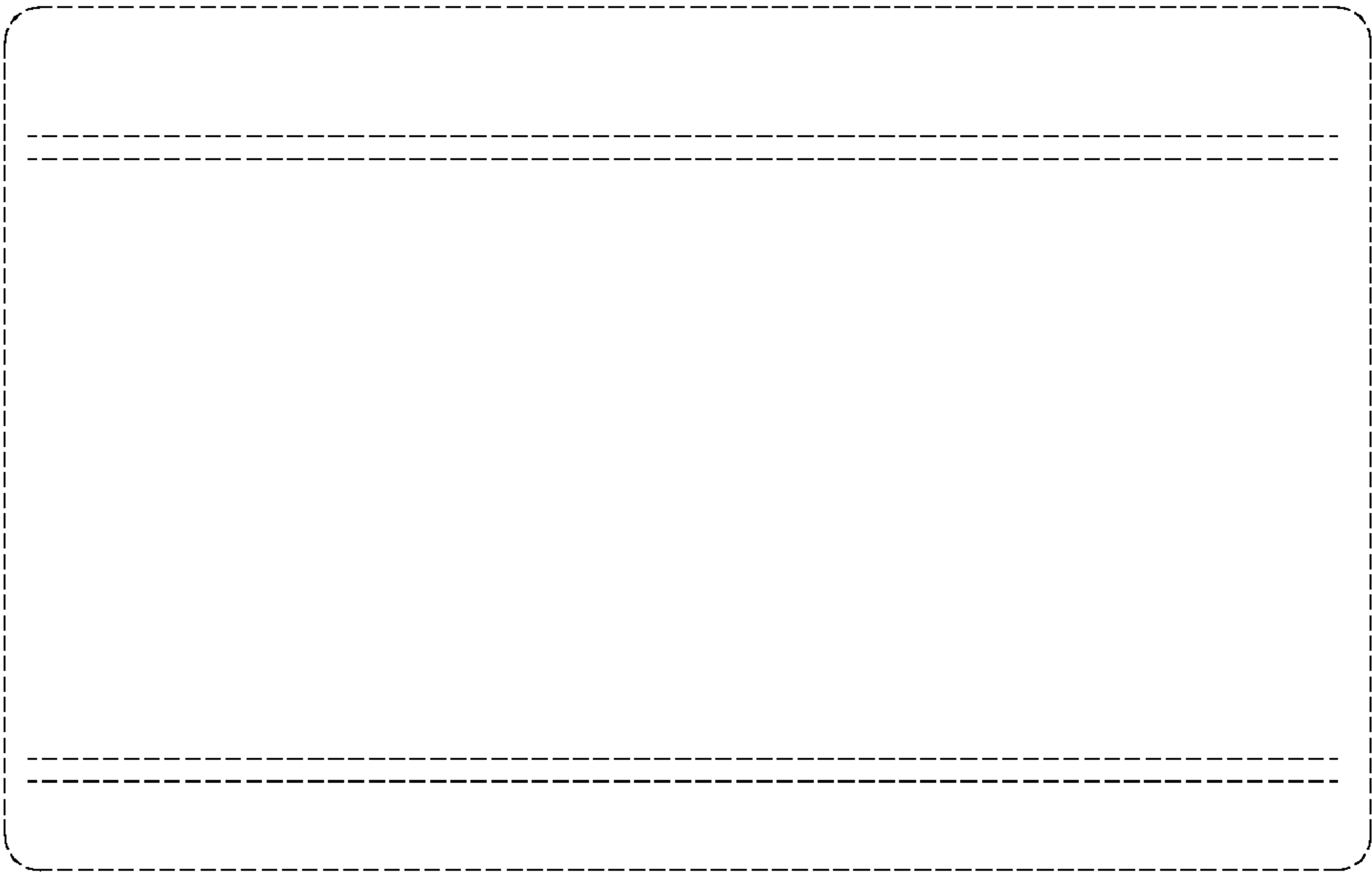

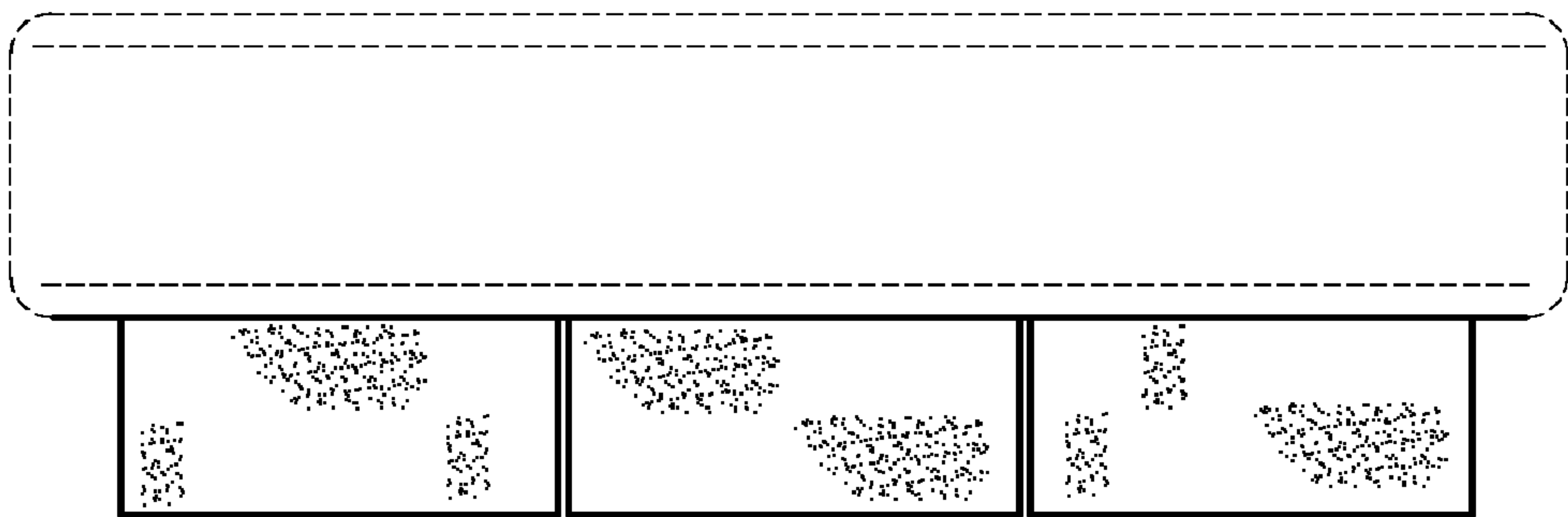

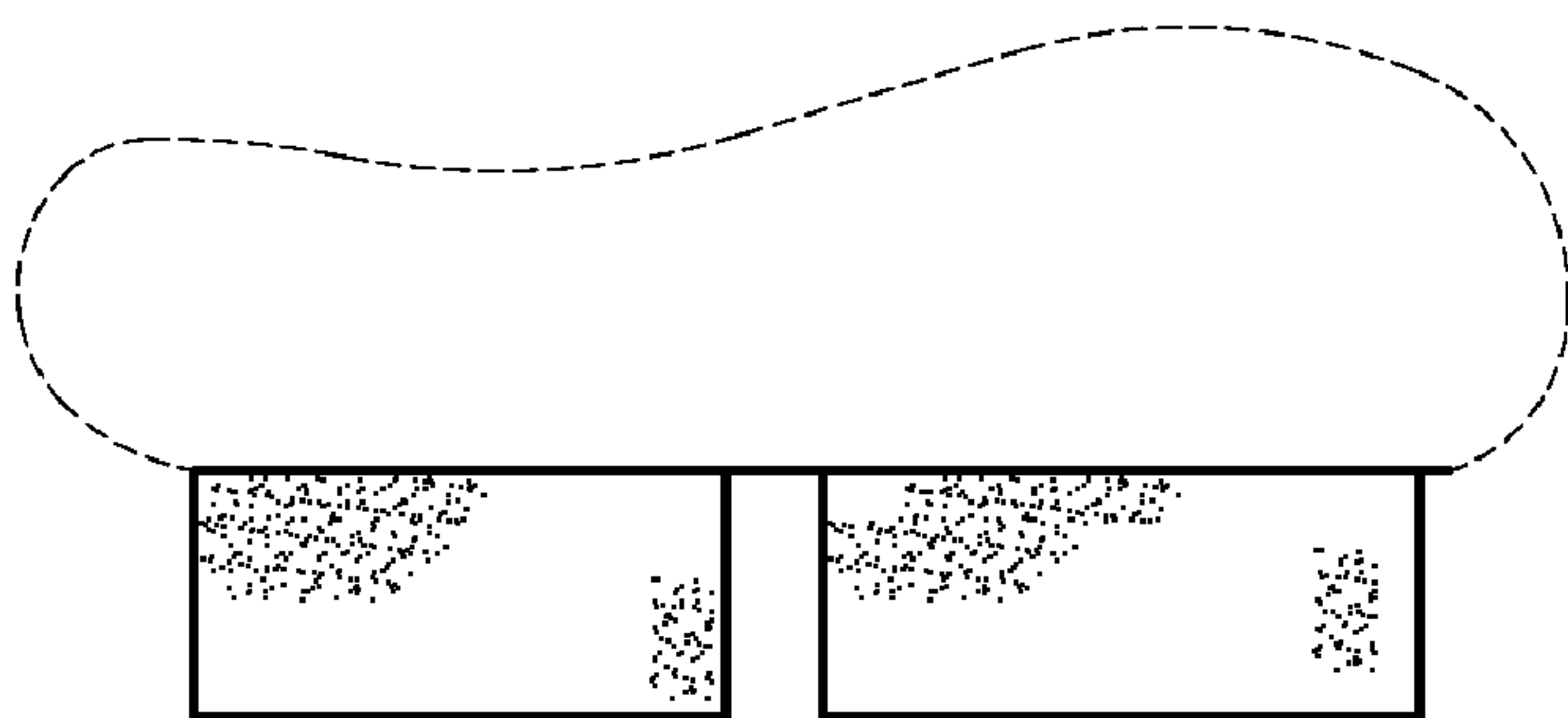

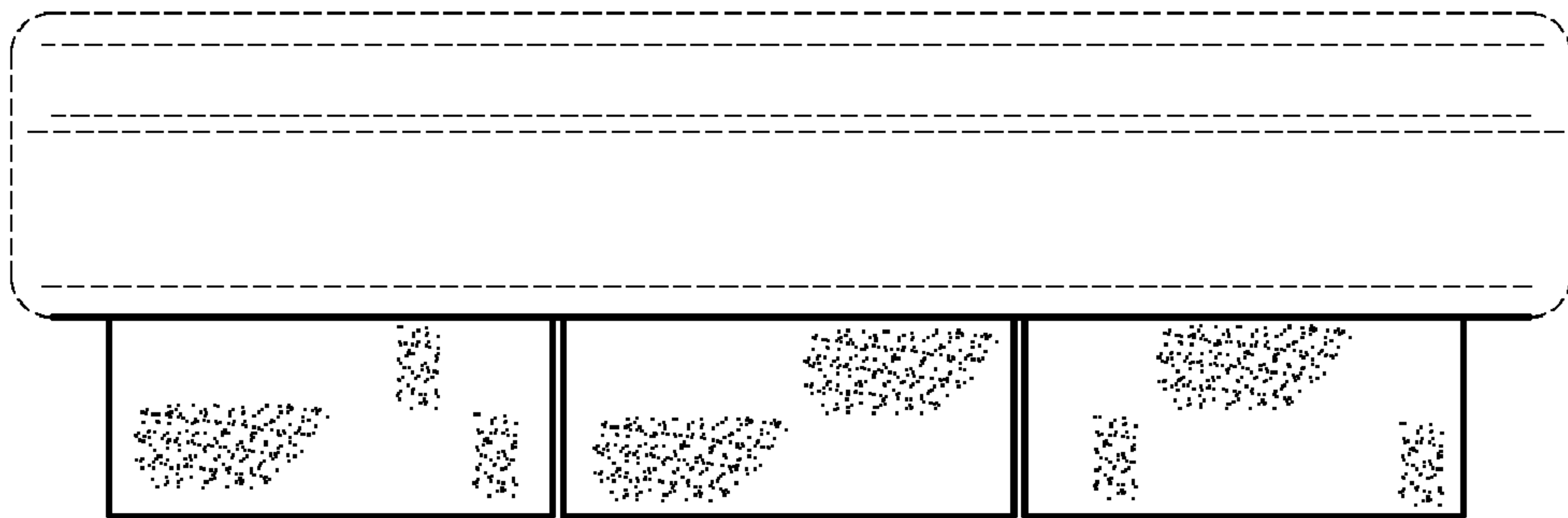

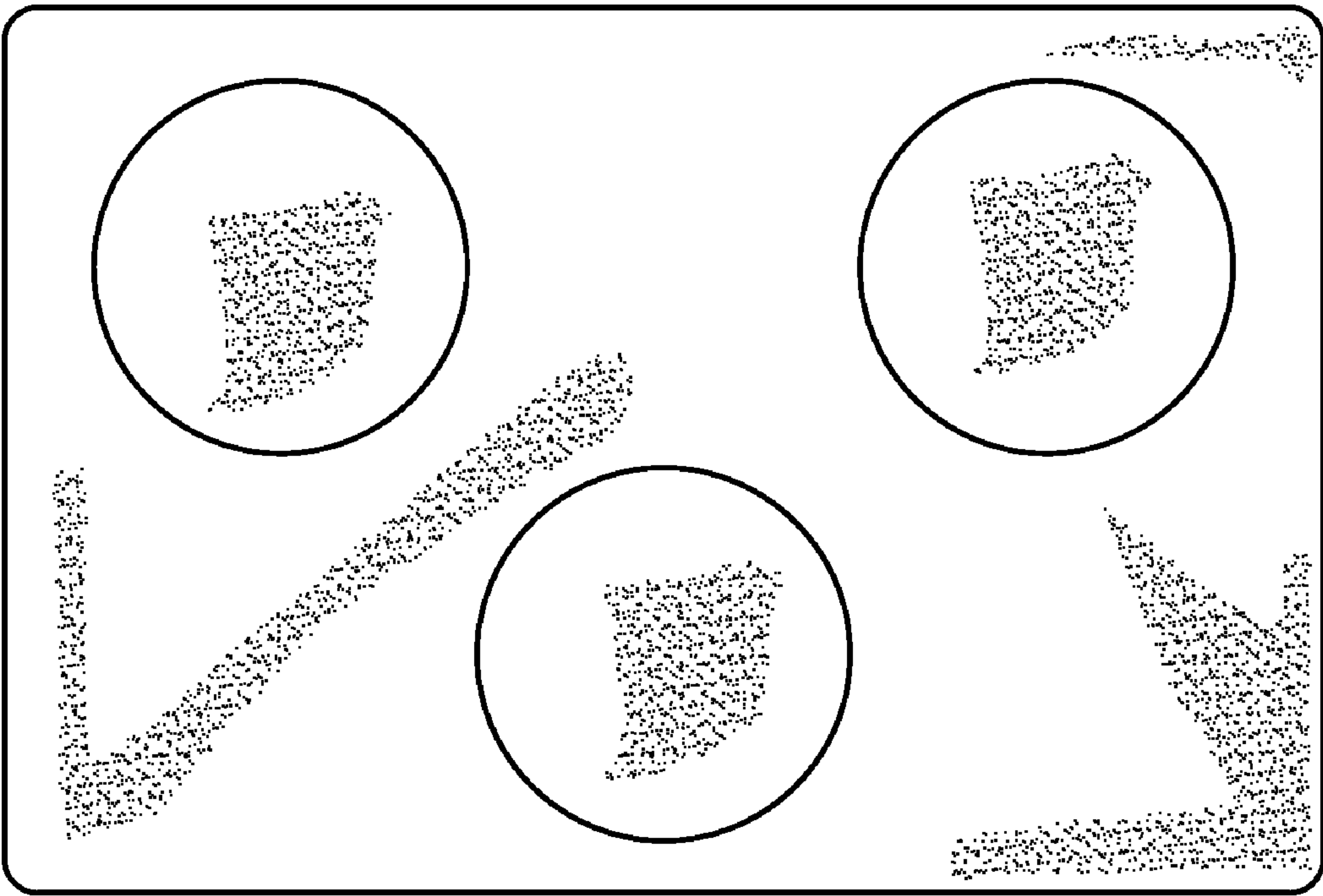
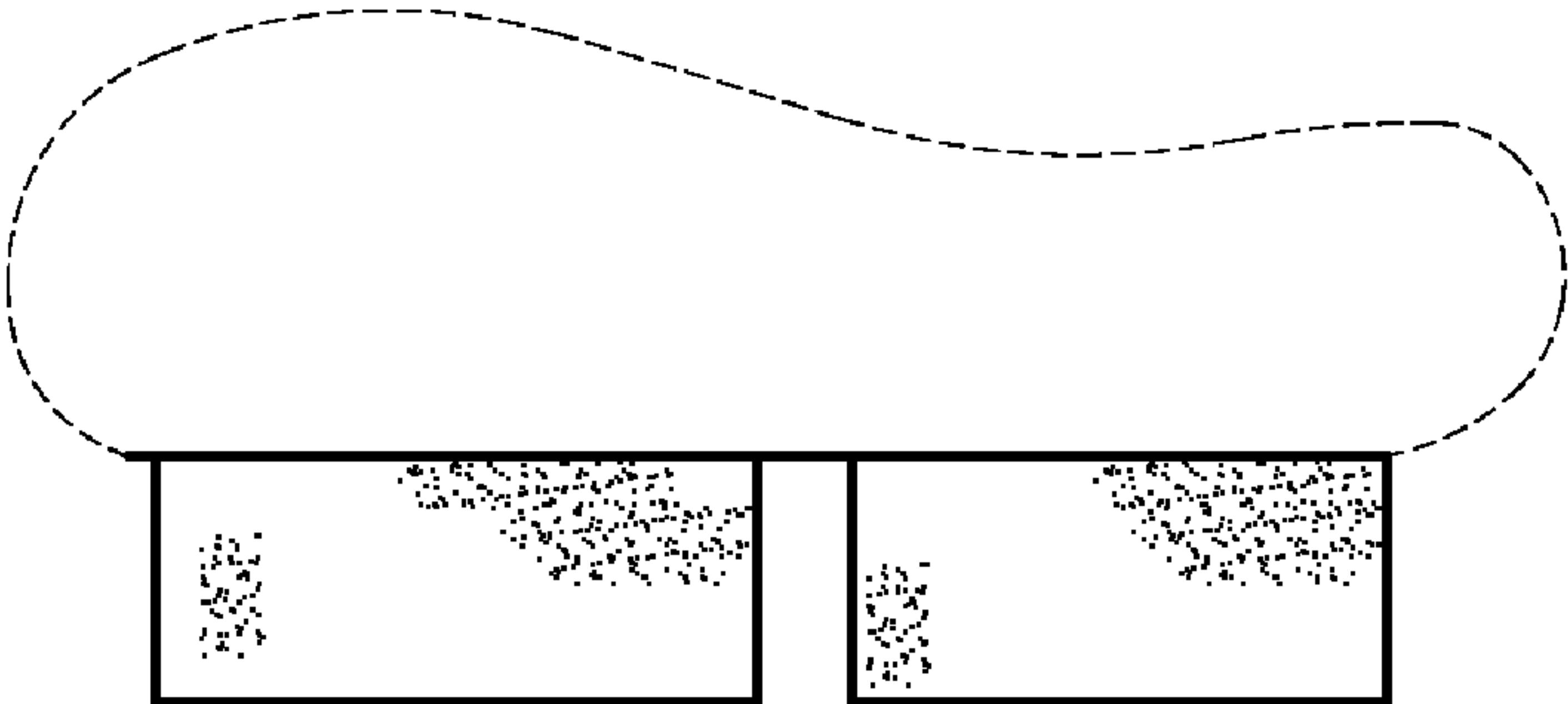
