(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a hinge, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an open front, left, top-side perspective view of the hinge showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a back view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof, the top view being a mirror image of the bottom view;

FIG. 5 is a closed, right, front, top-side perspective view of the hinge showing our new design;

FIG. 6 is a closed, right view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a closed, left view thereof; and

FIG. 8 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a back view thereof; and,

FIG. 10 is a top view thereof, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view.

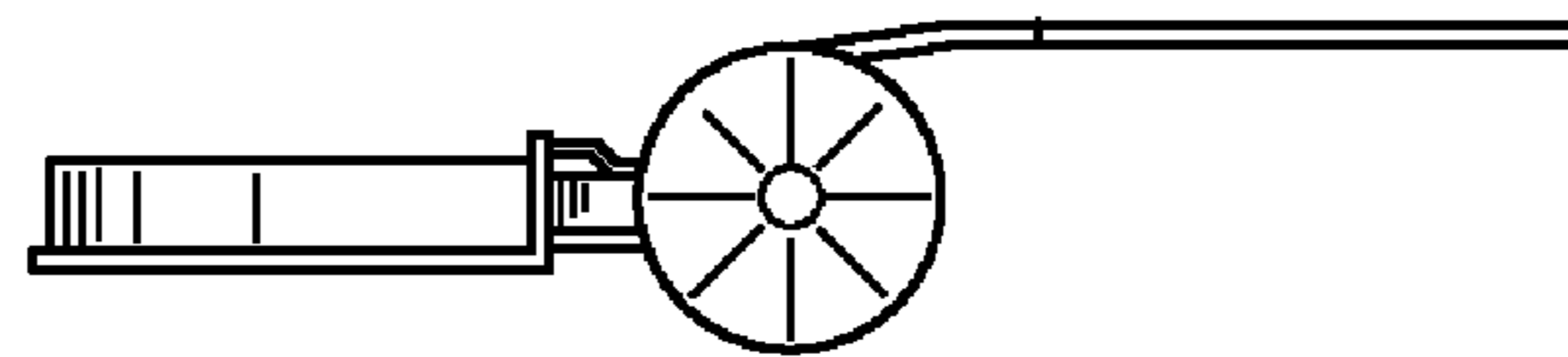
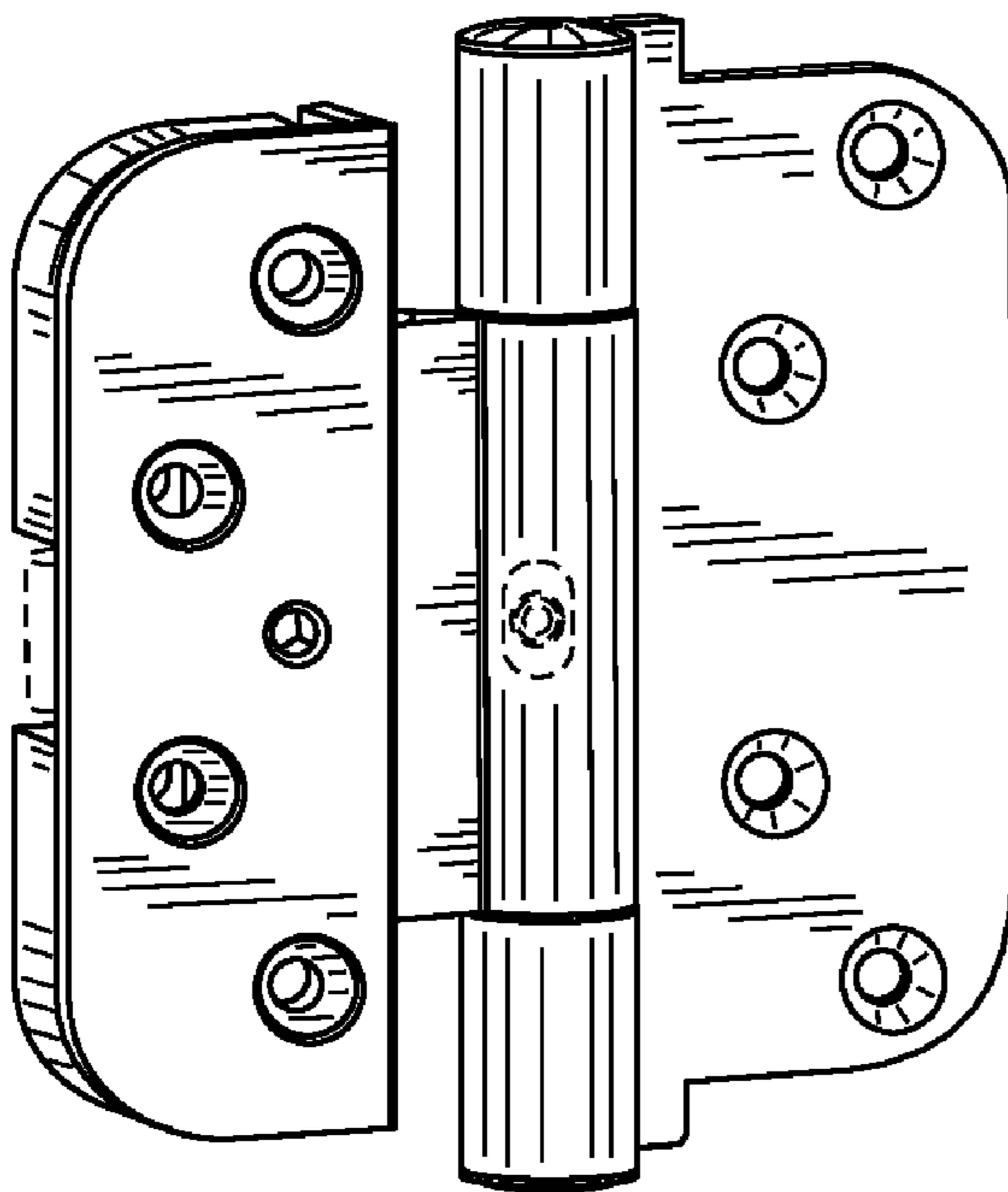

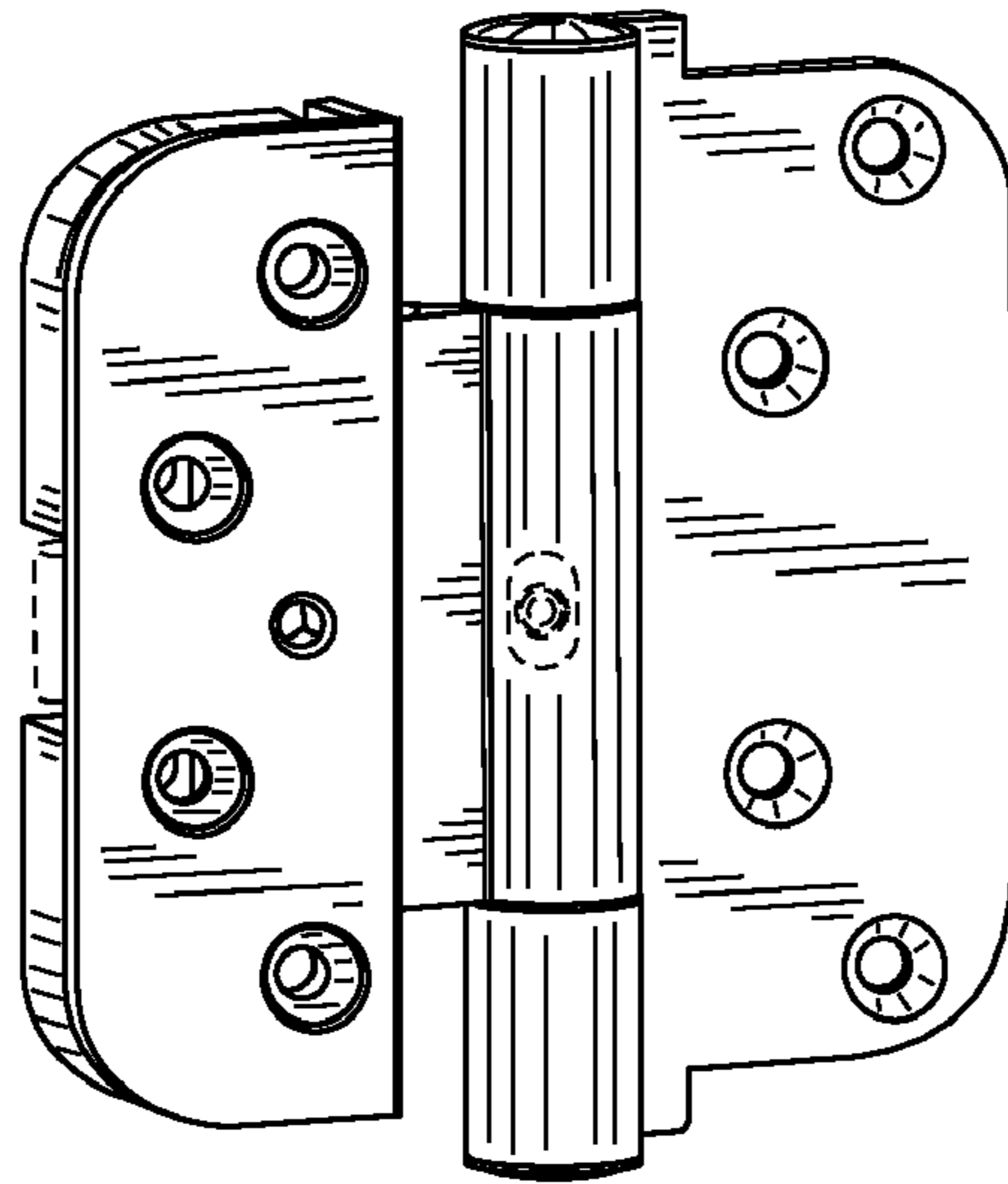

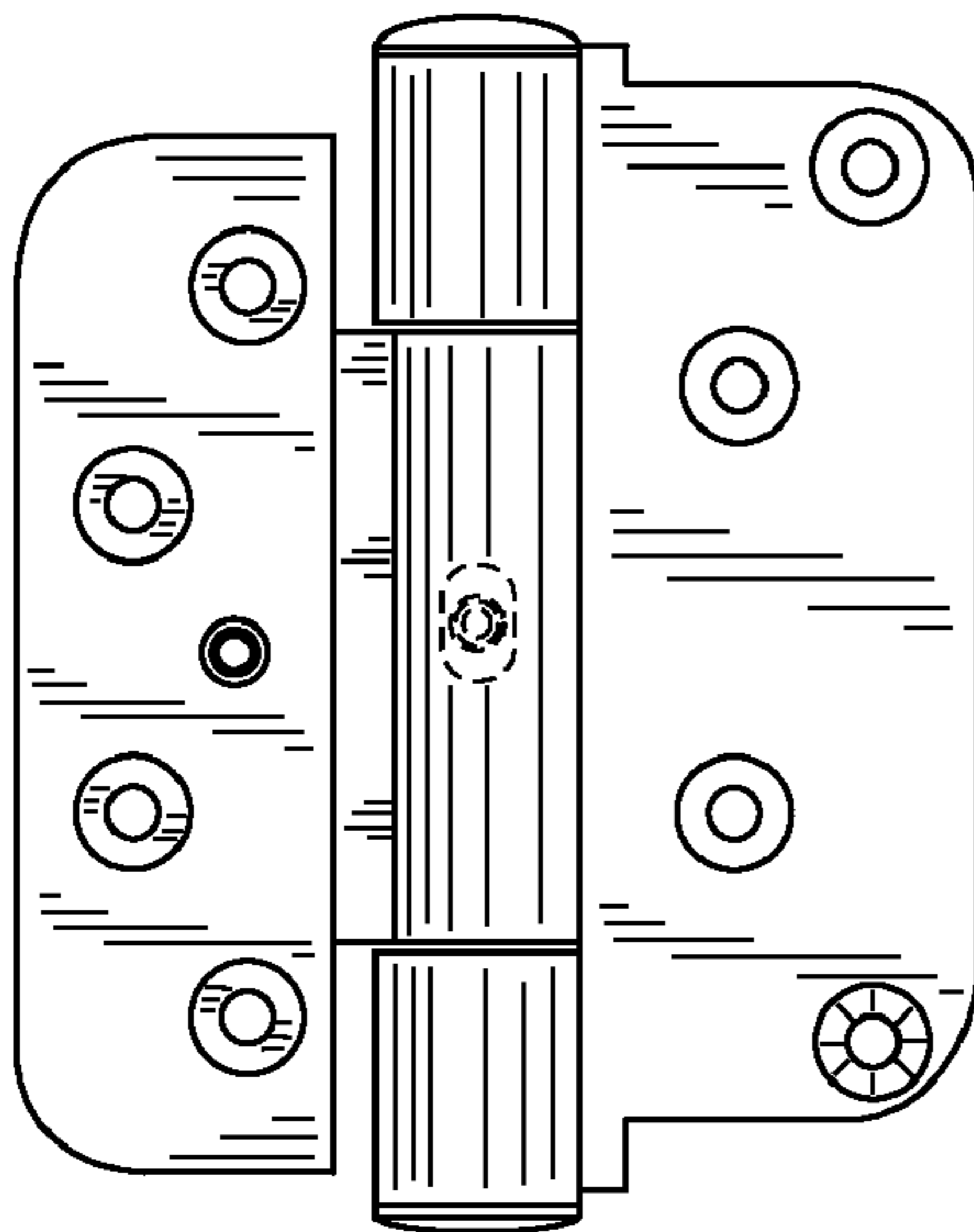

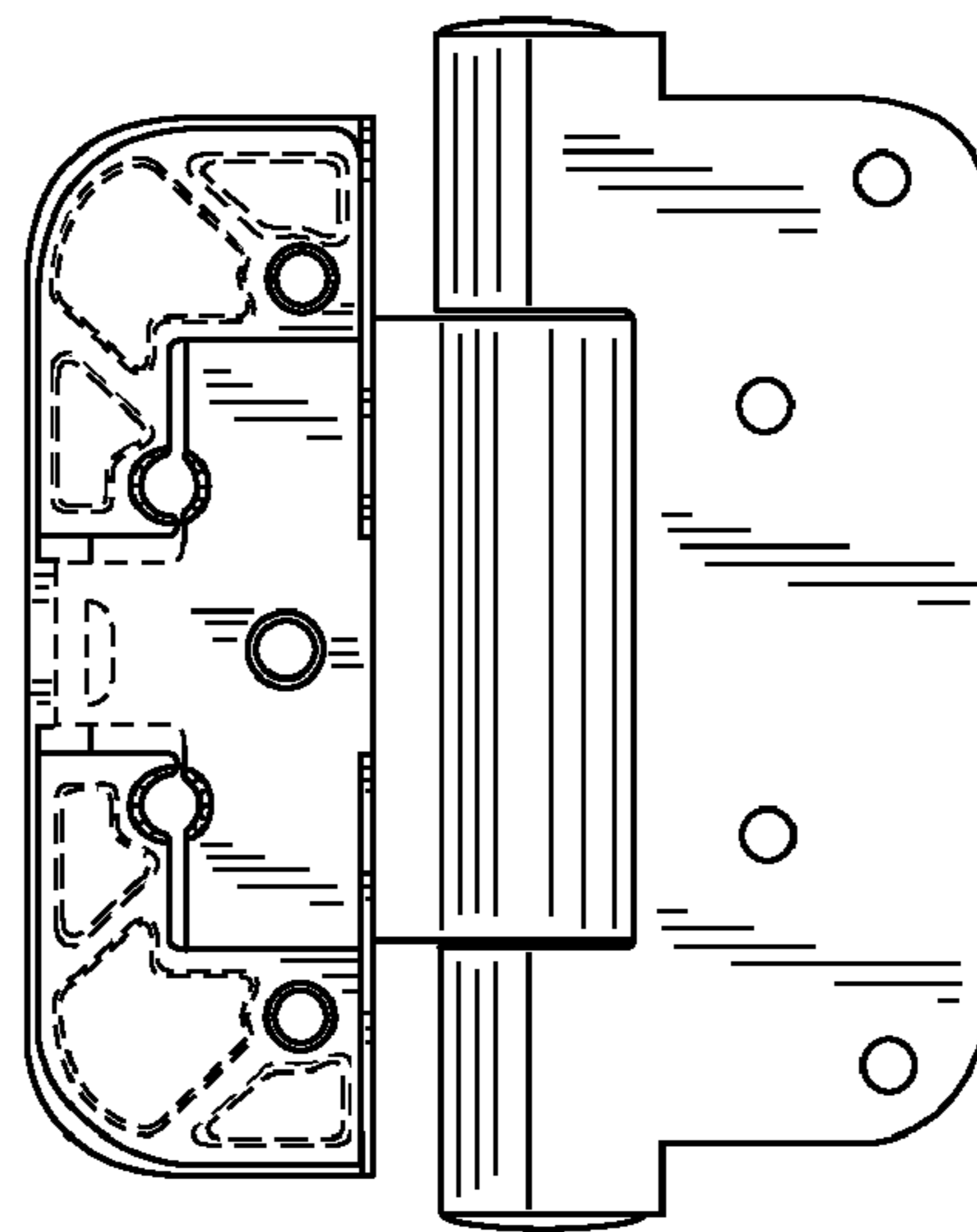

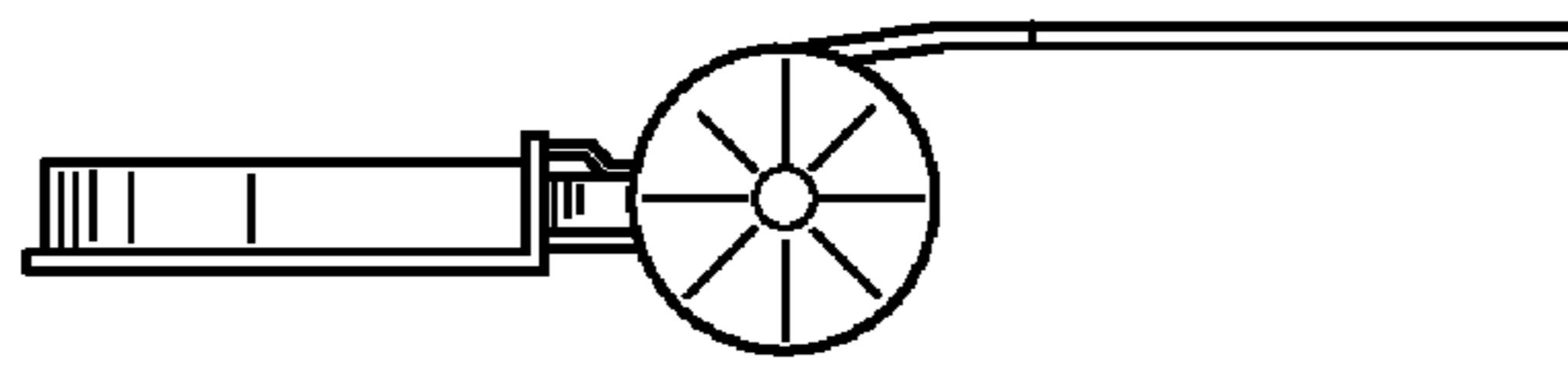

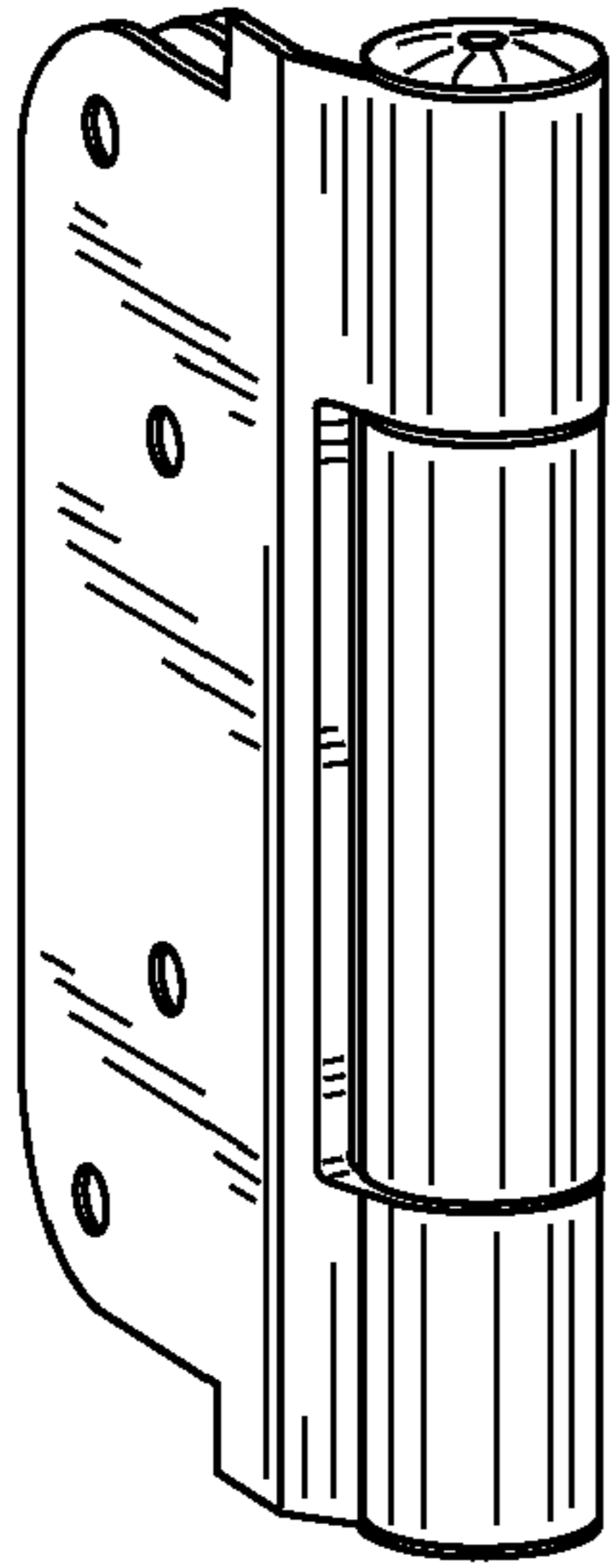

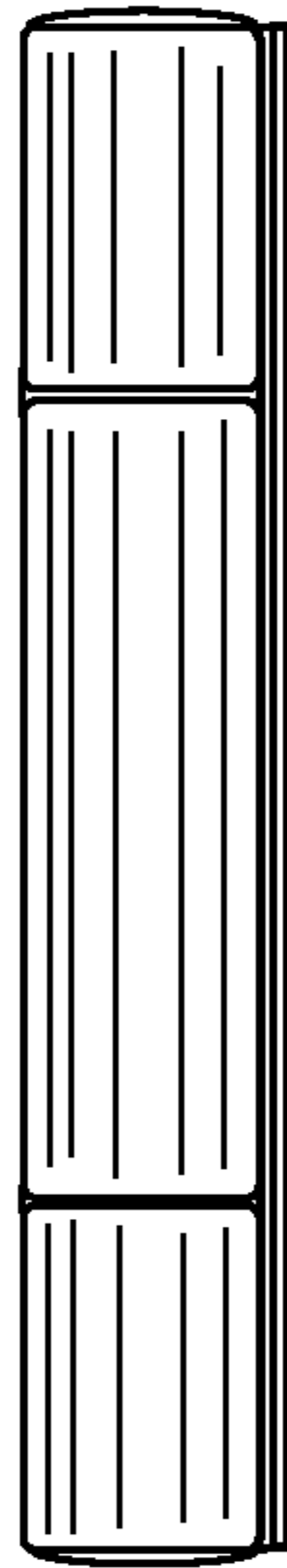

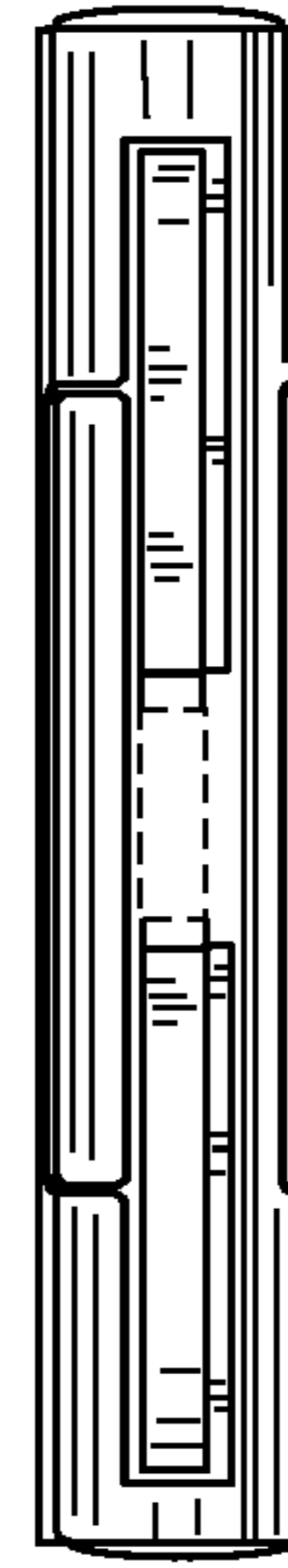

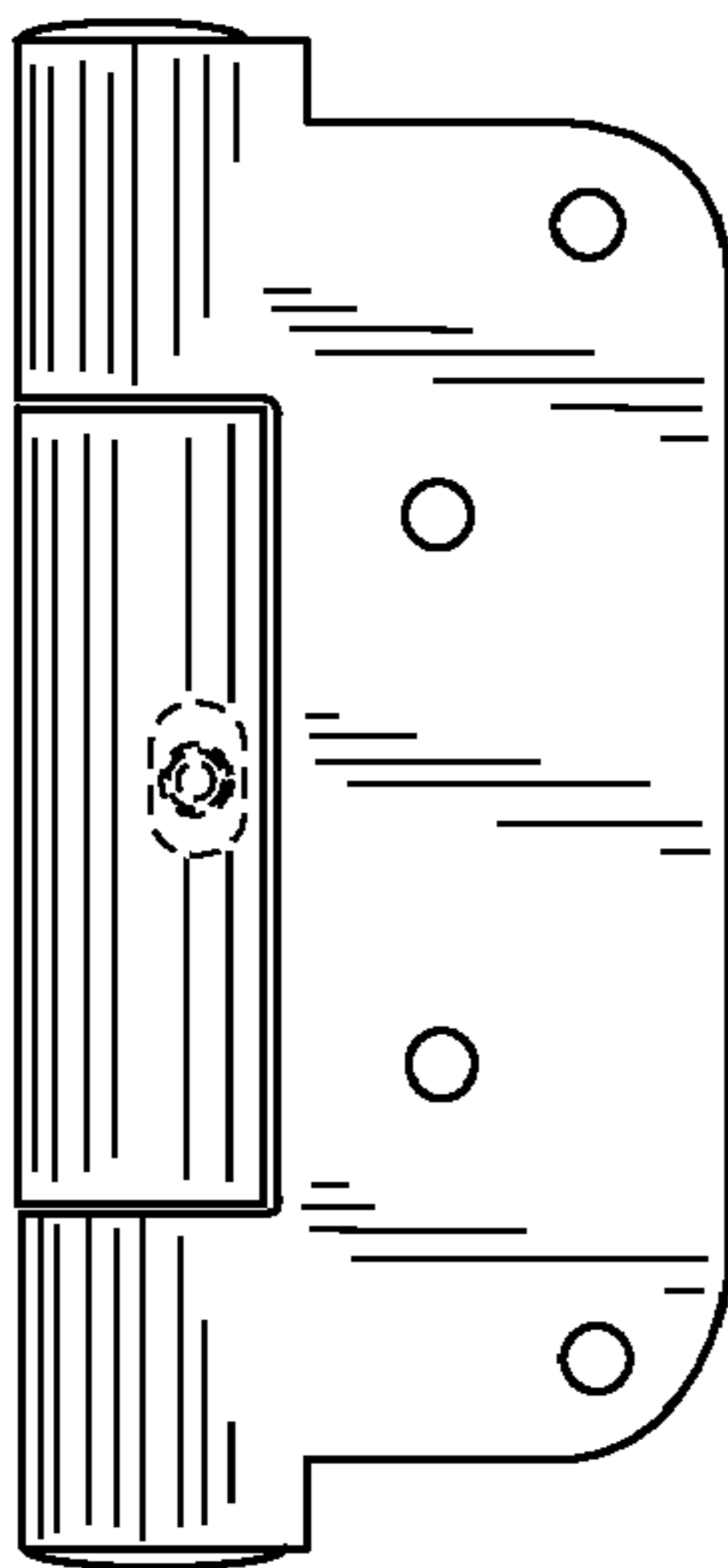

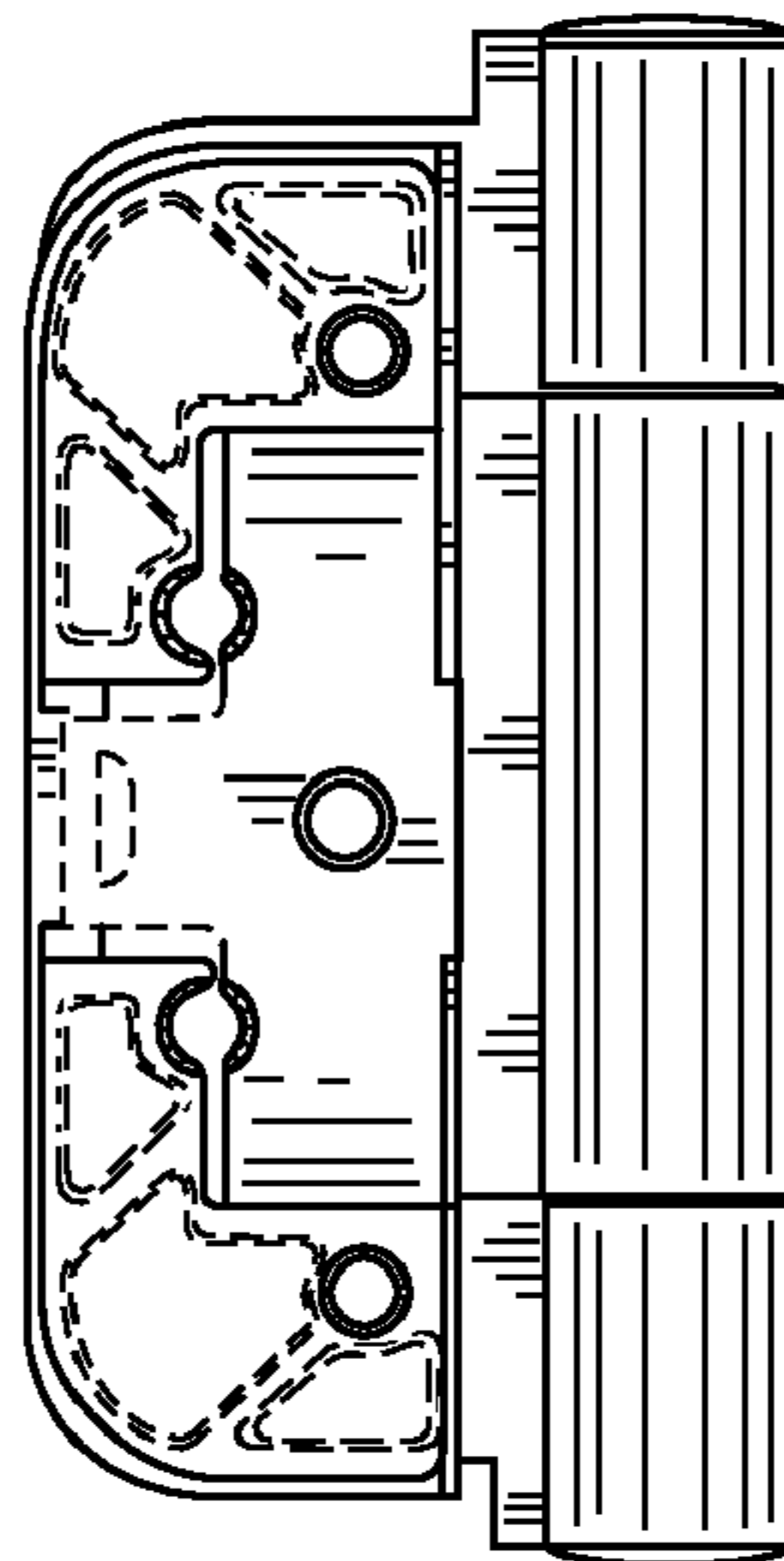
