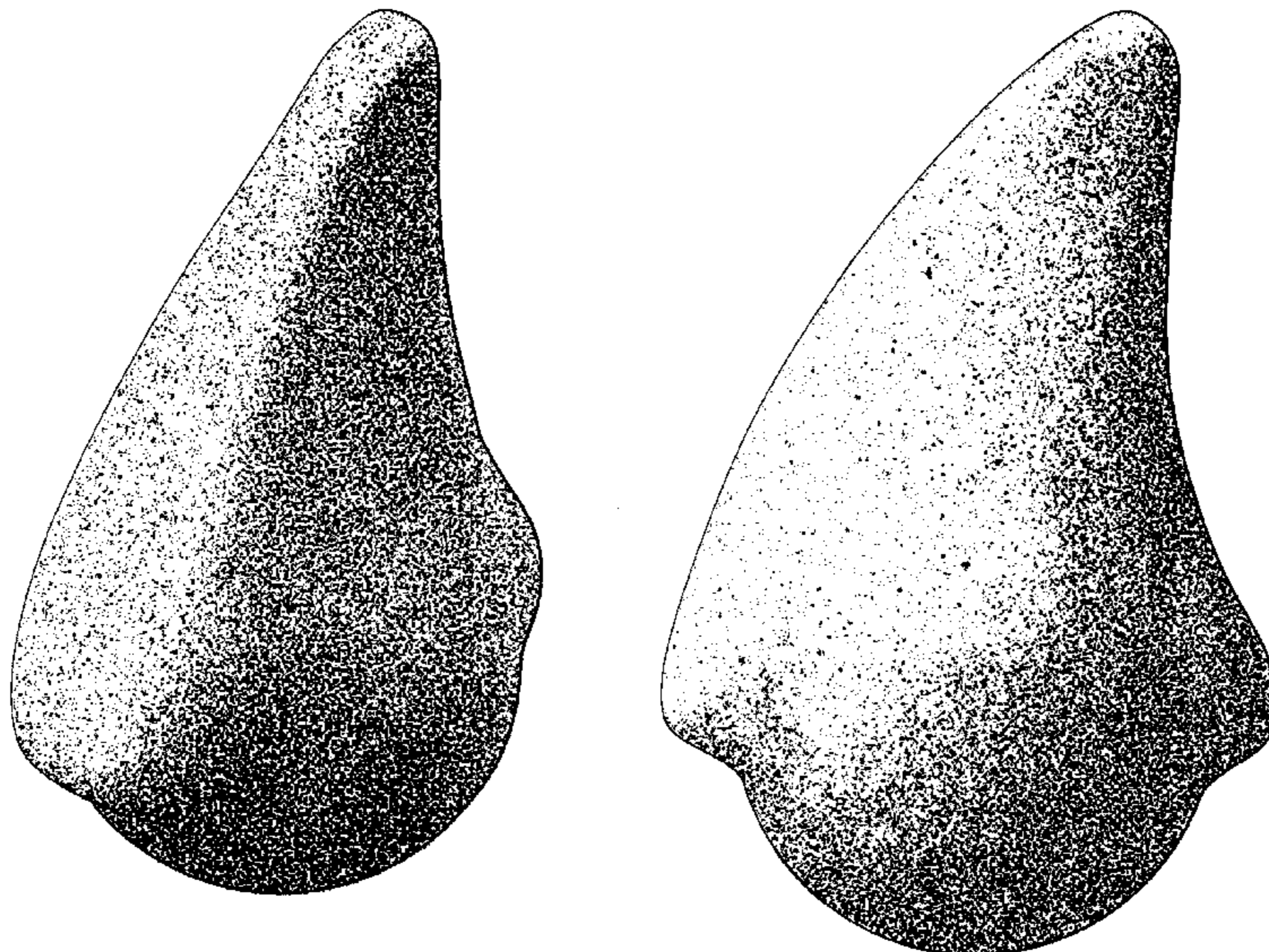
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shark fin pet toy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of the shark fin pet toy of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a left rear perspective view of the shark fin pet toy of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the shark fin pet toy of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view of the shark fin pet toy of FIG. 1, the right side elevation view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the shark fin pet toy of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the shark fin pet toy of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the shark fin pet toy of FIG. 1.

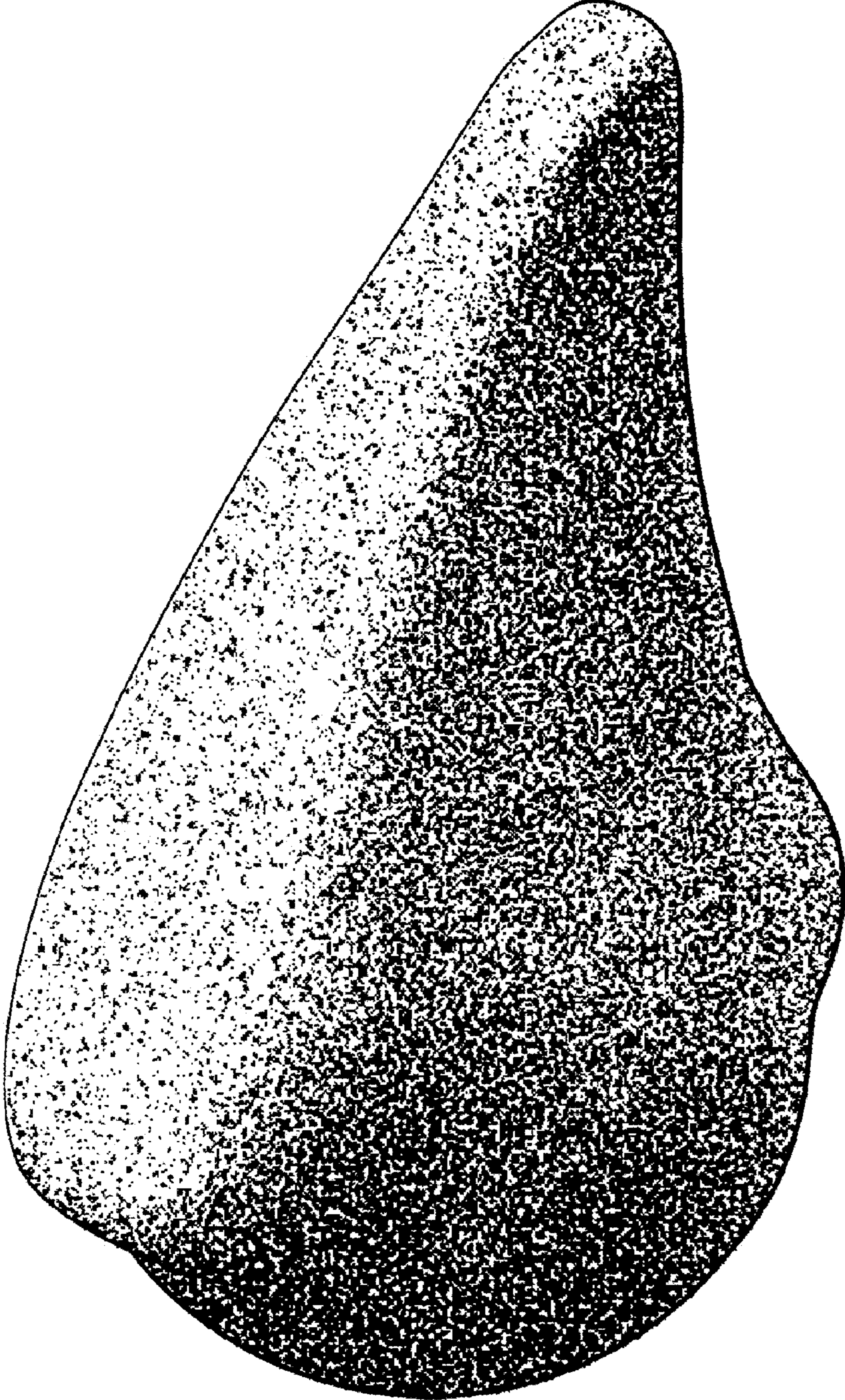

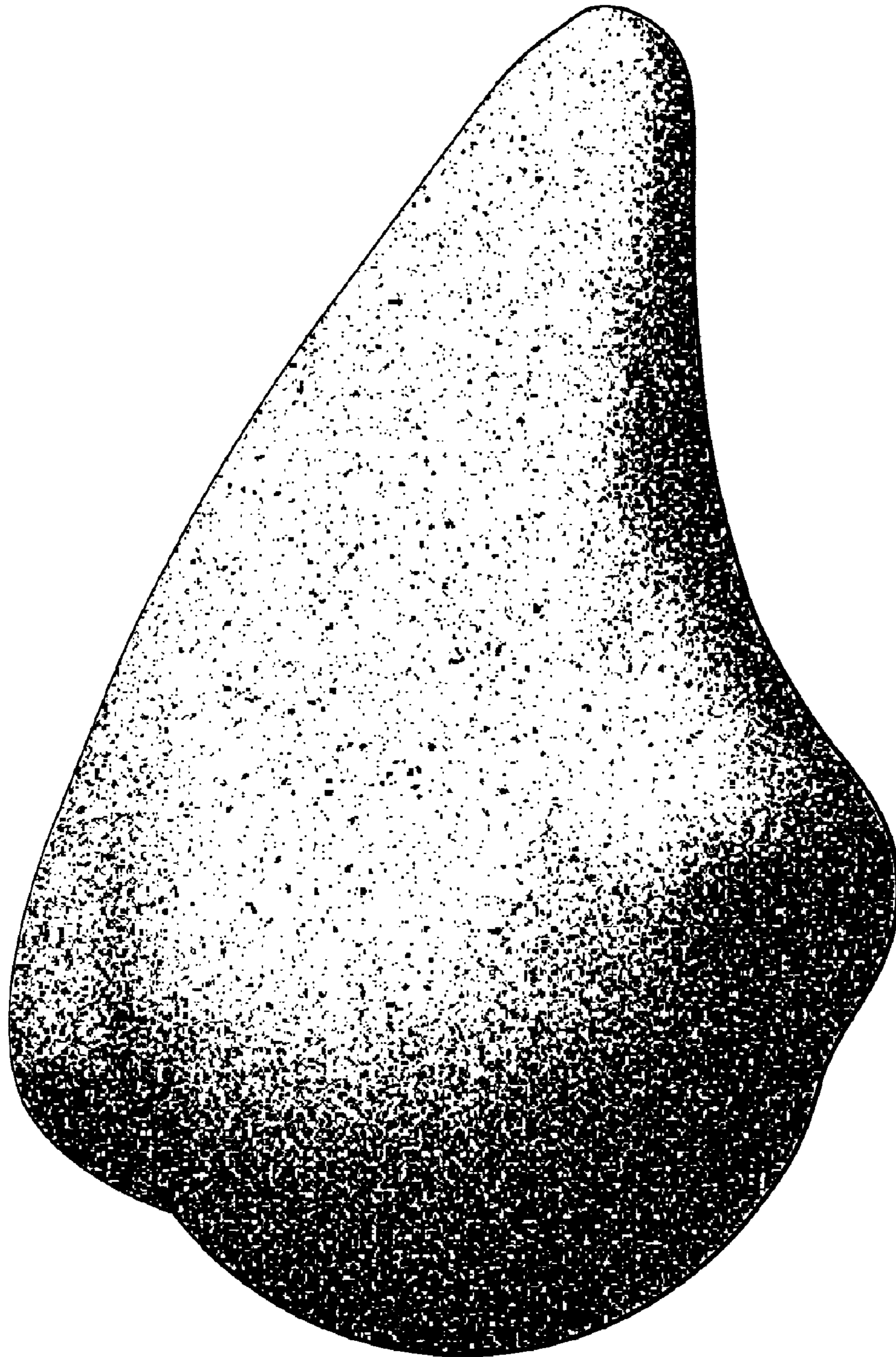

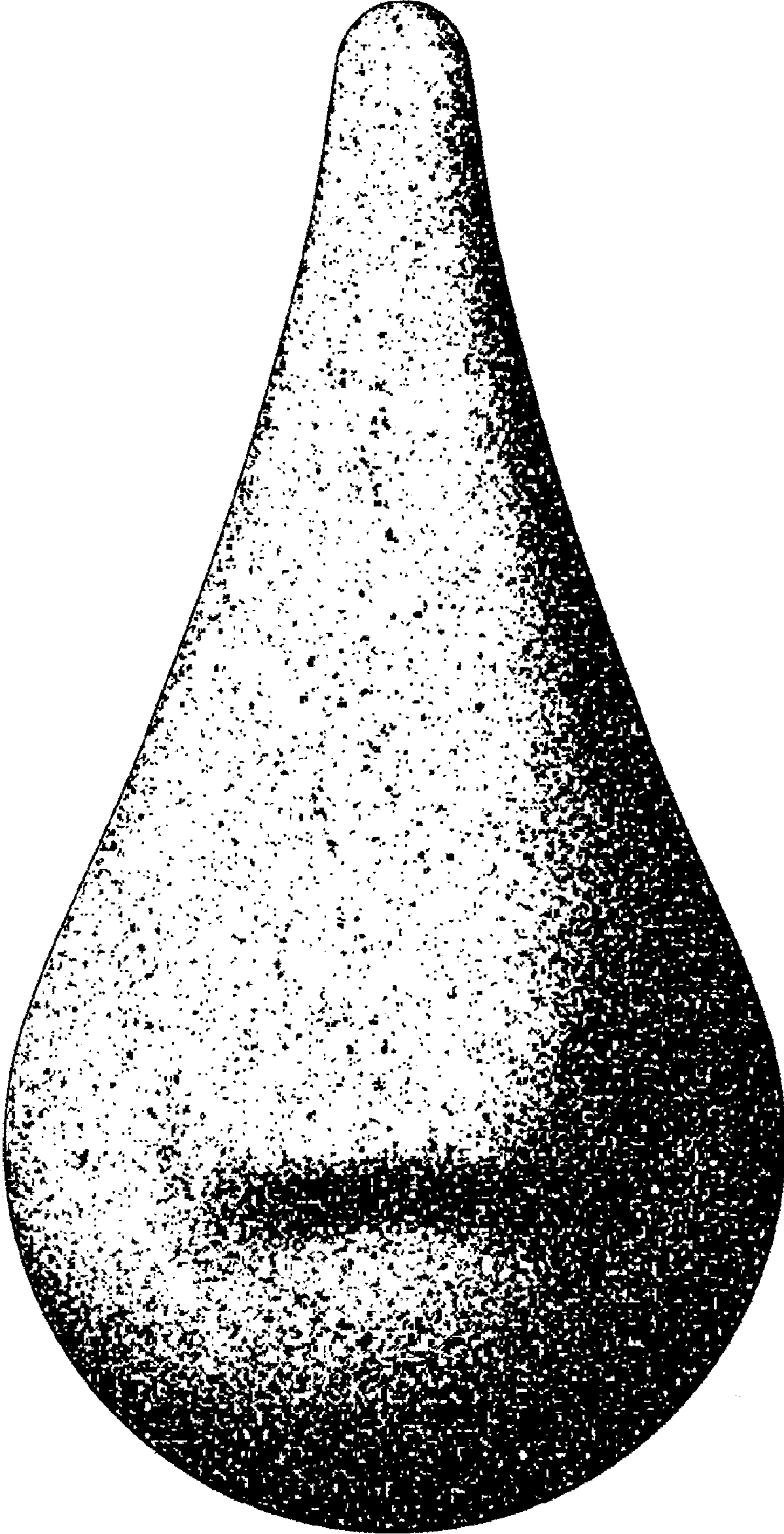

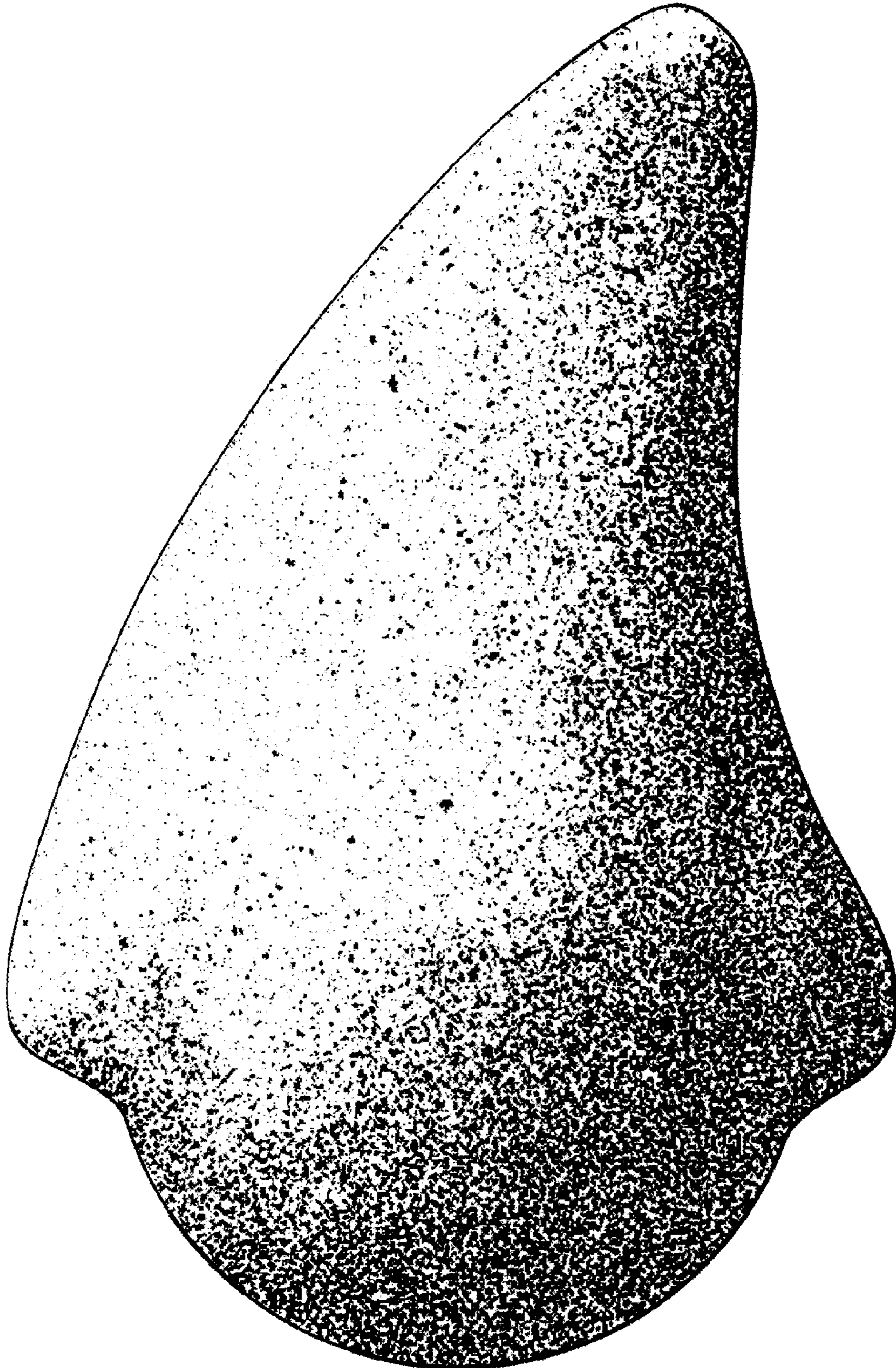

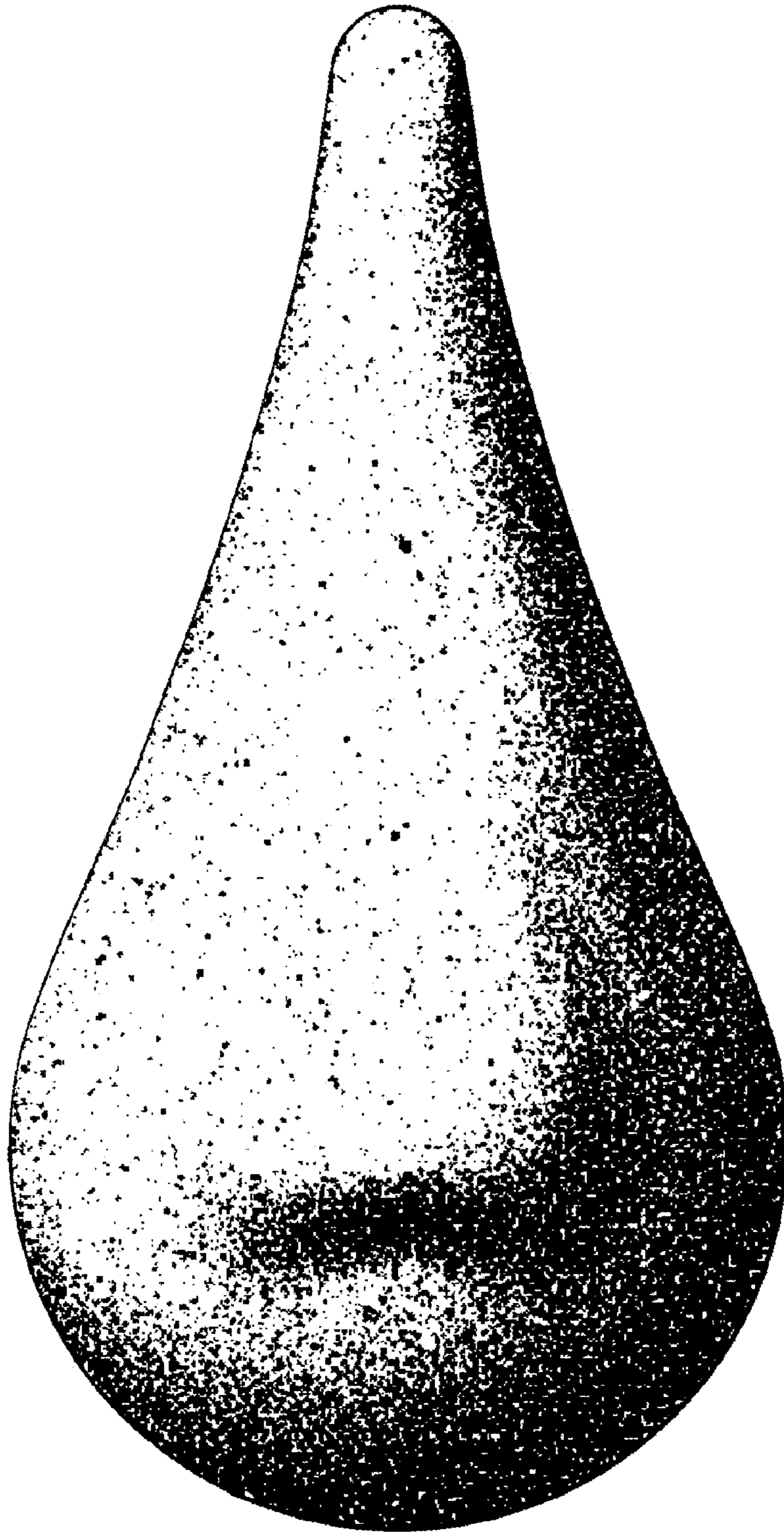

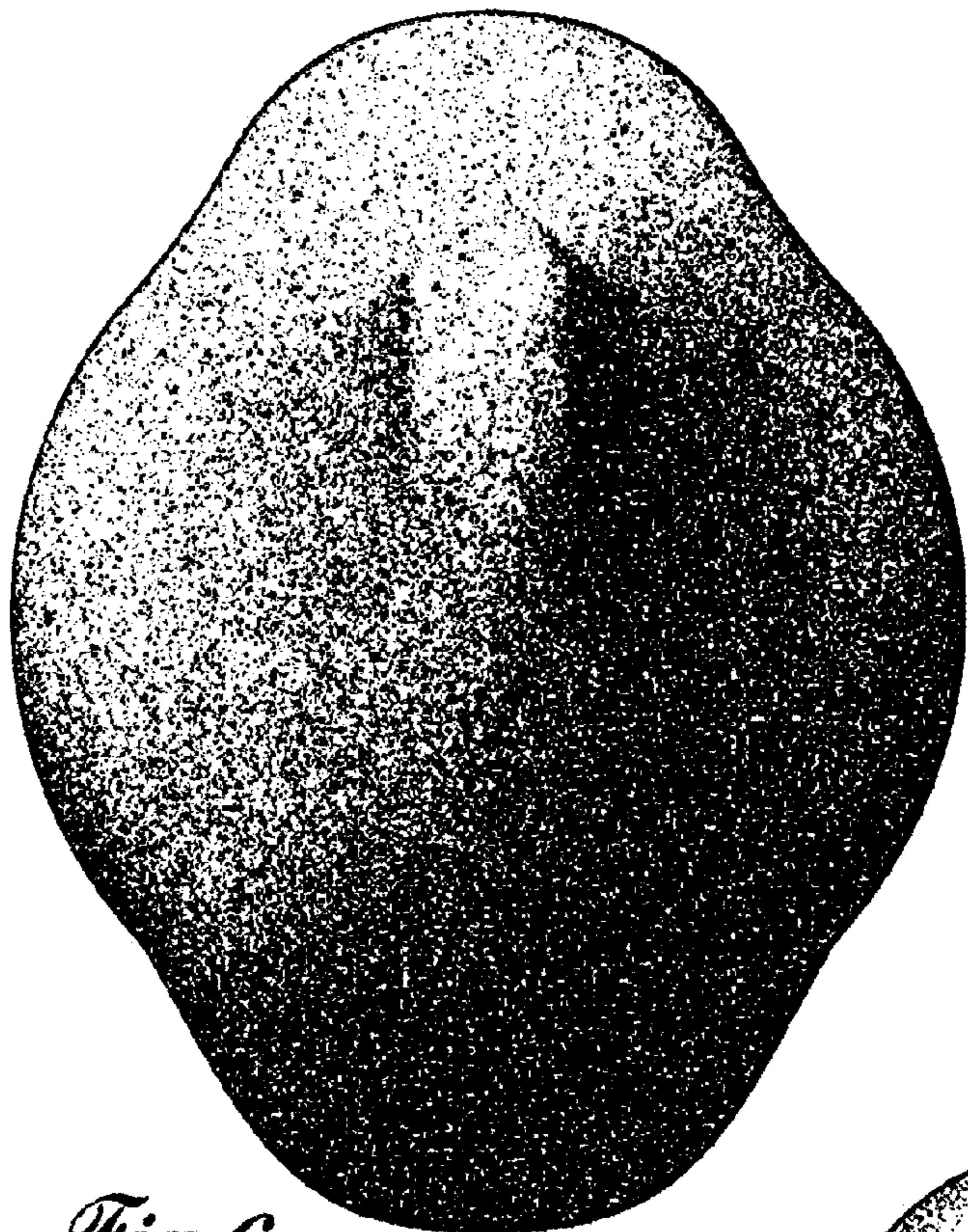

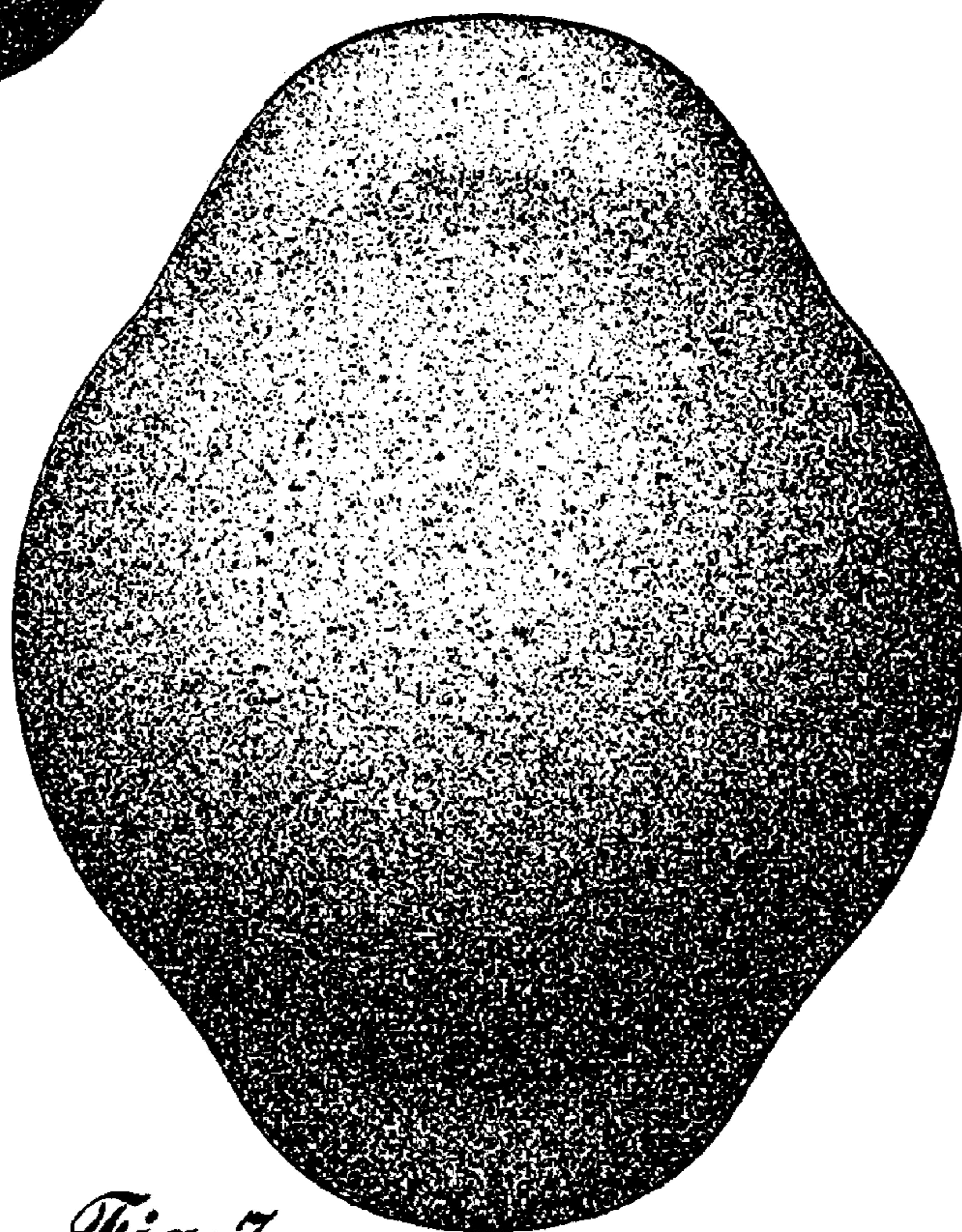
