What is claimed is the ornamental design for a cap with visor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cap with visor, showing the new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

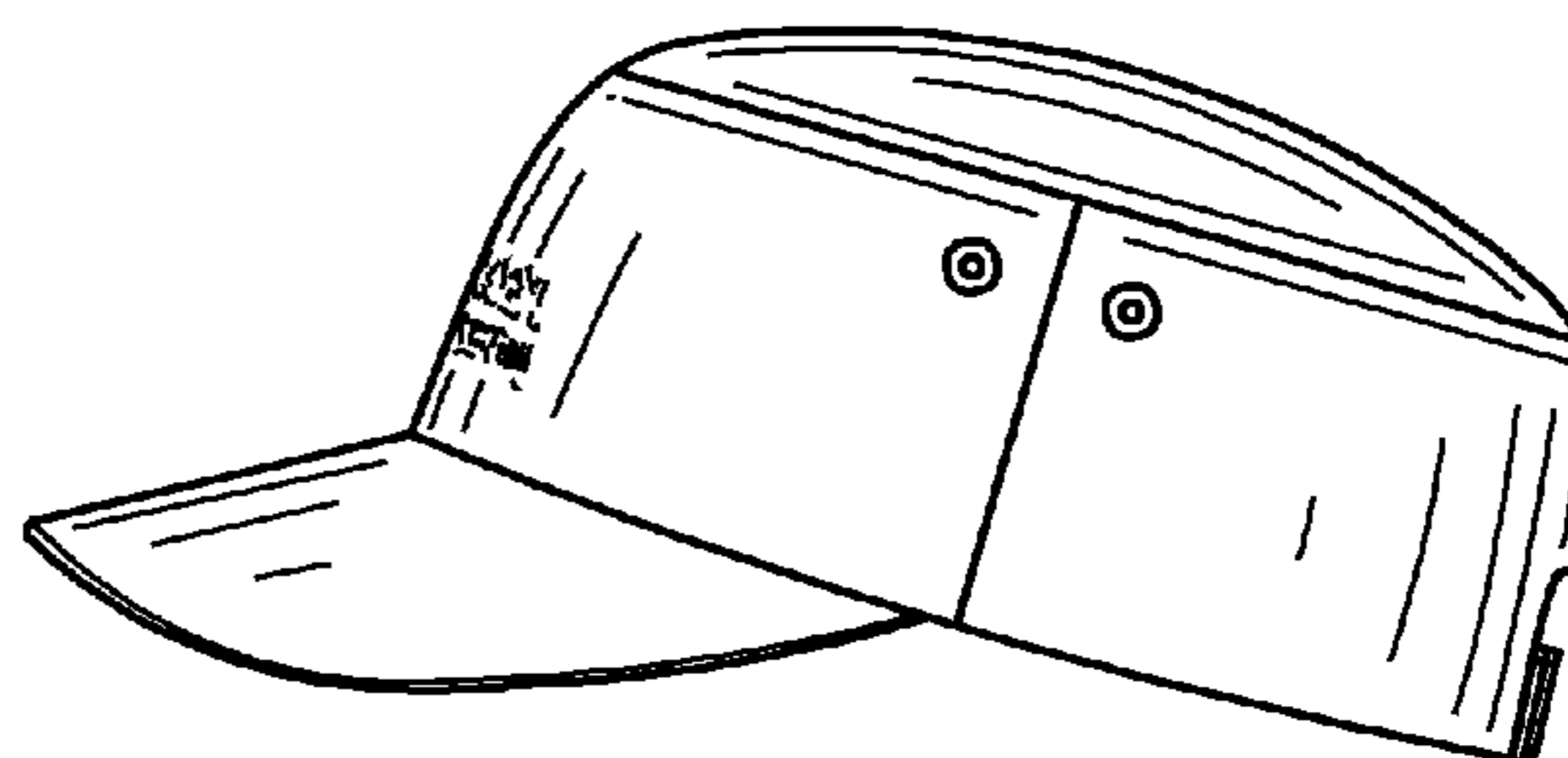
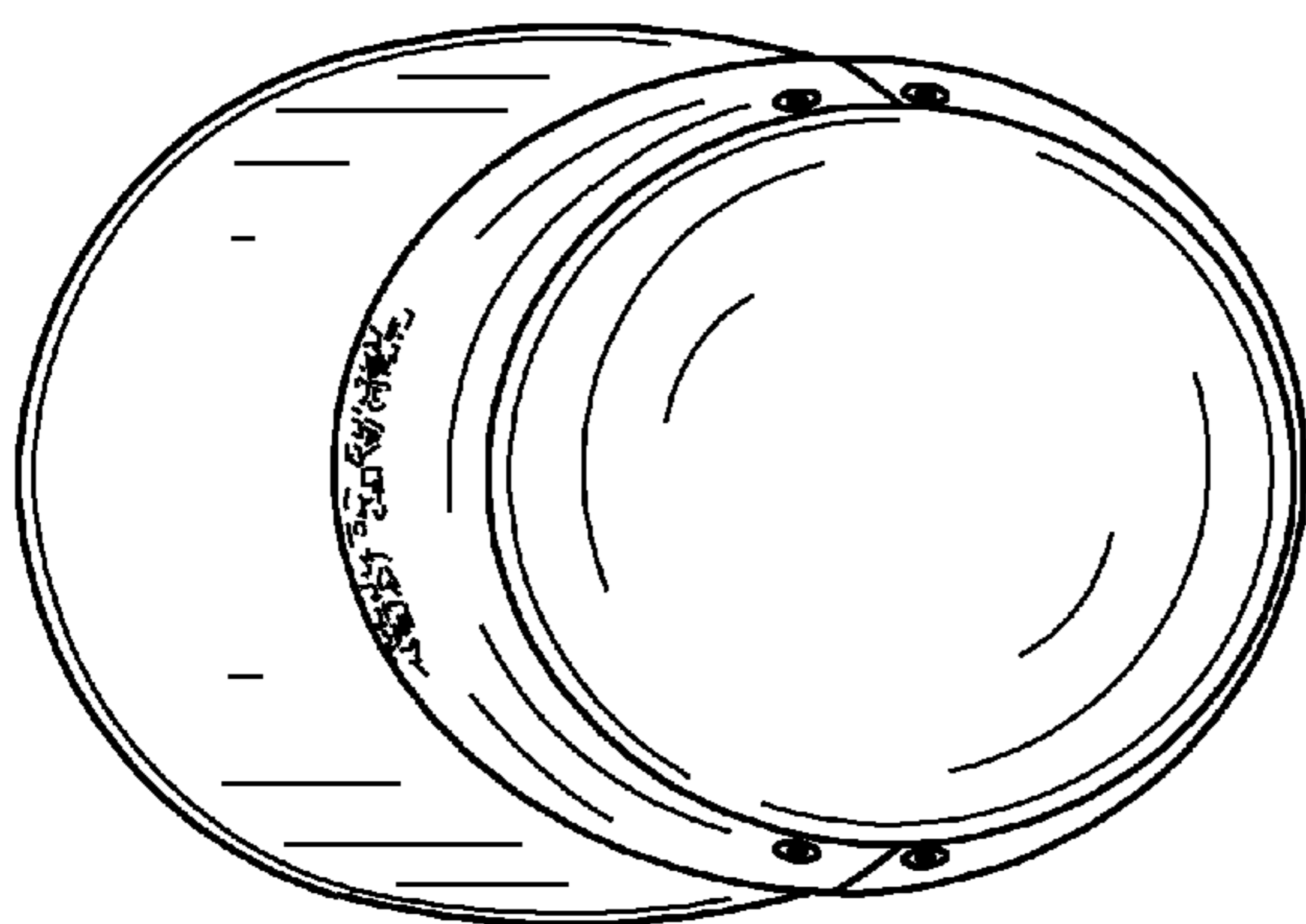
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

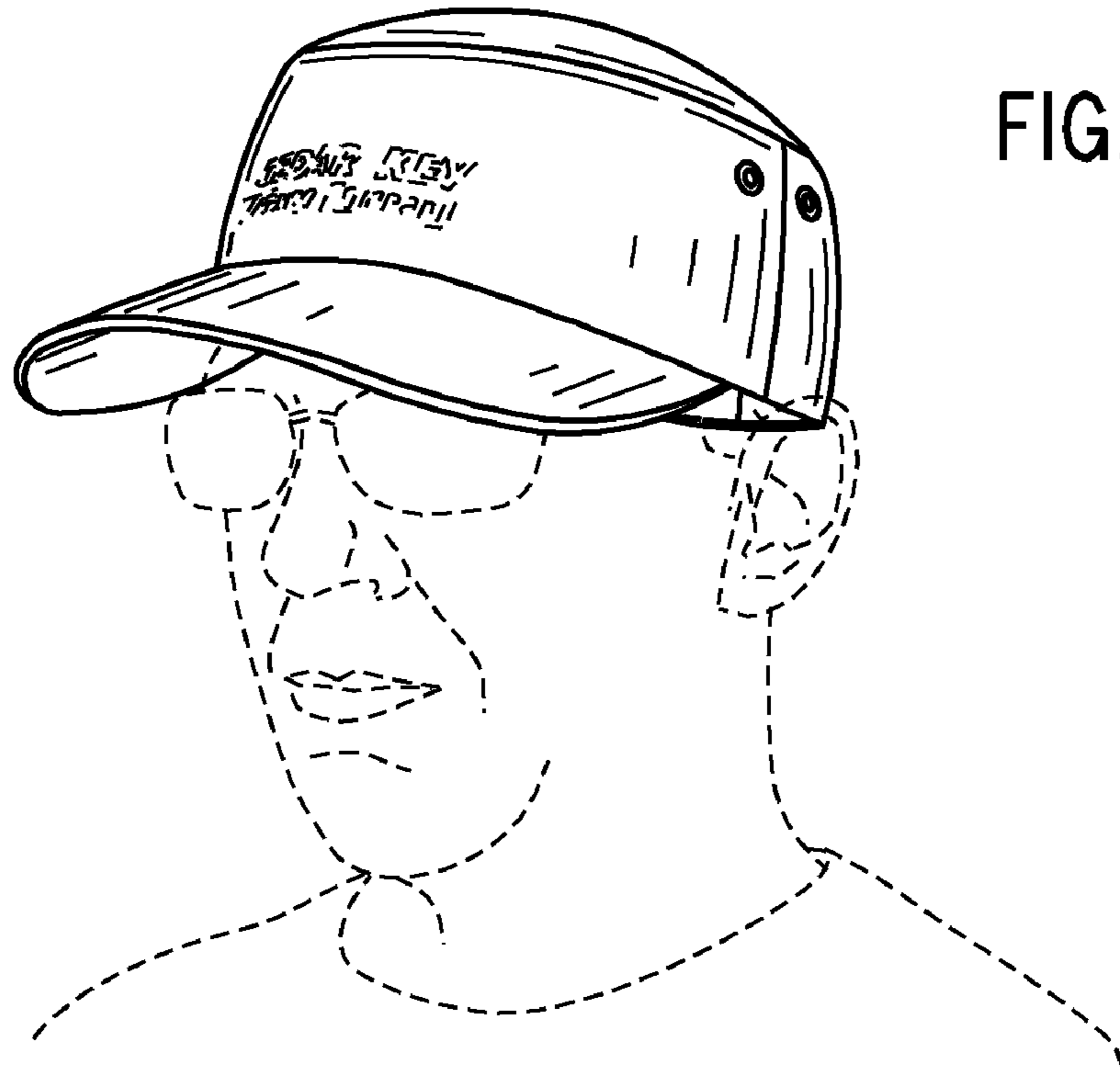

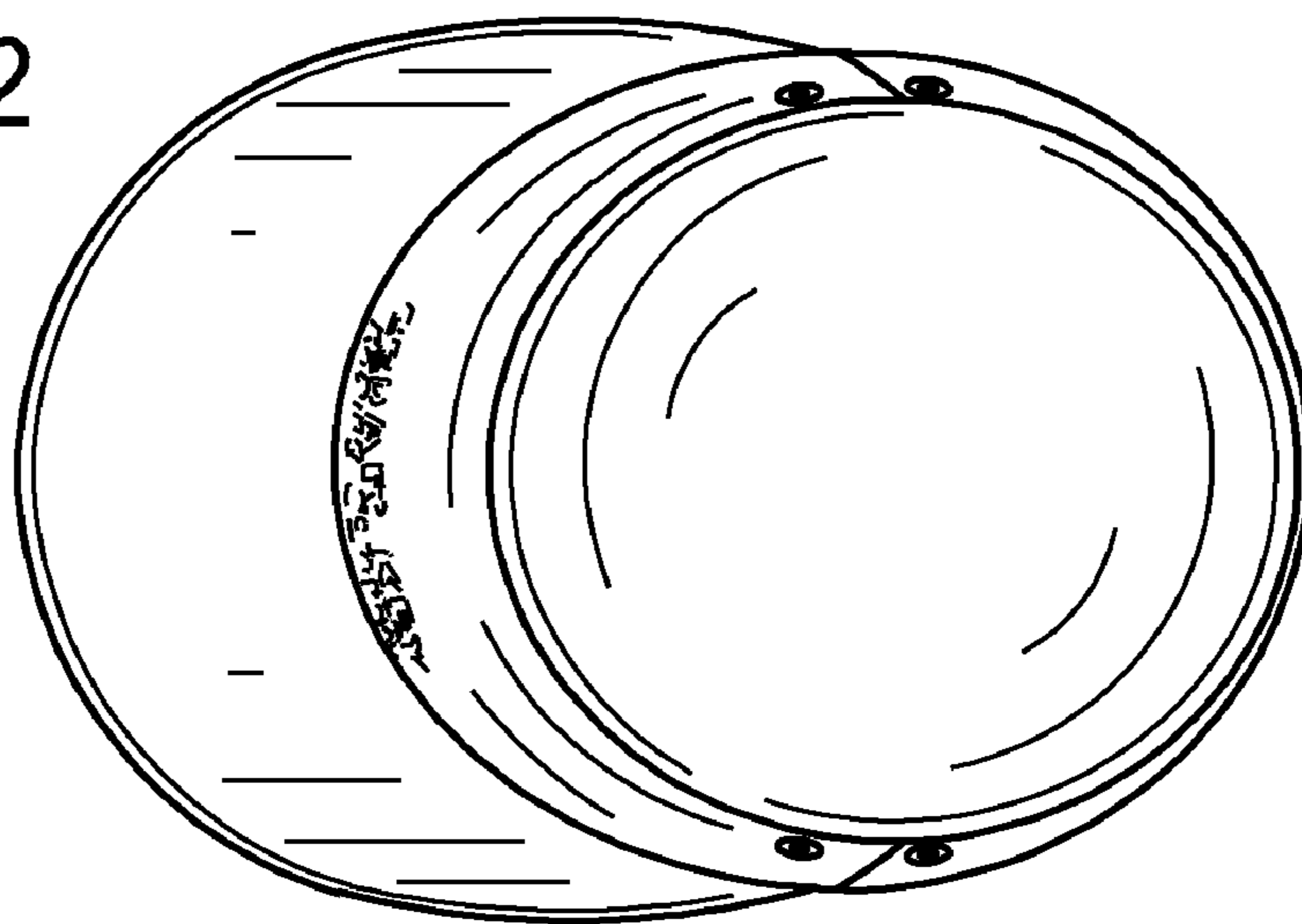

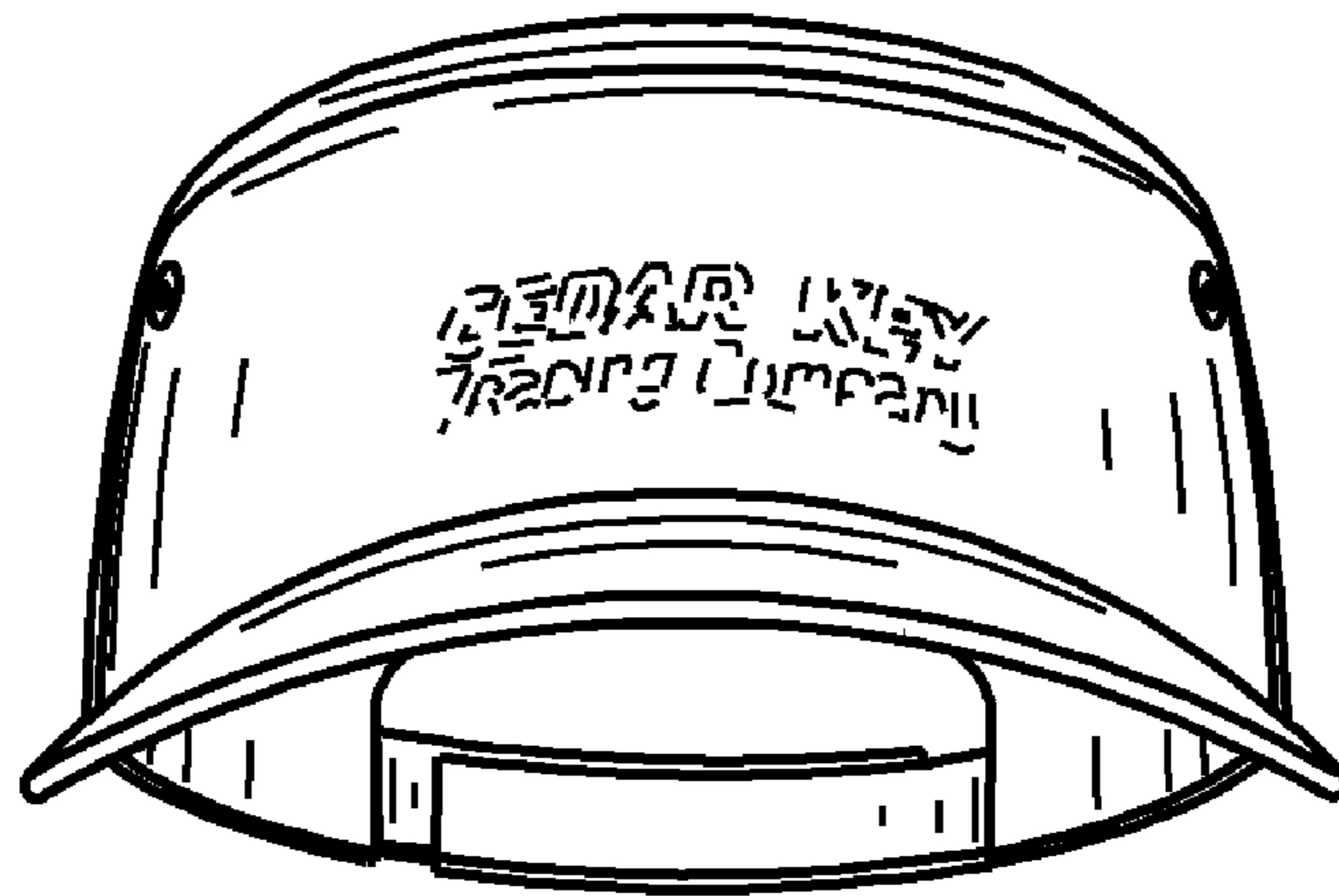

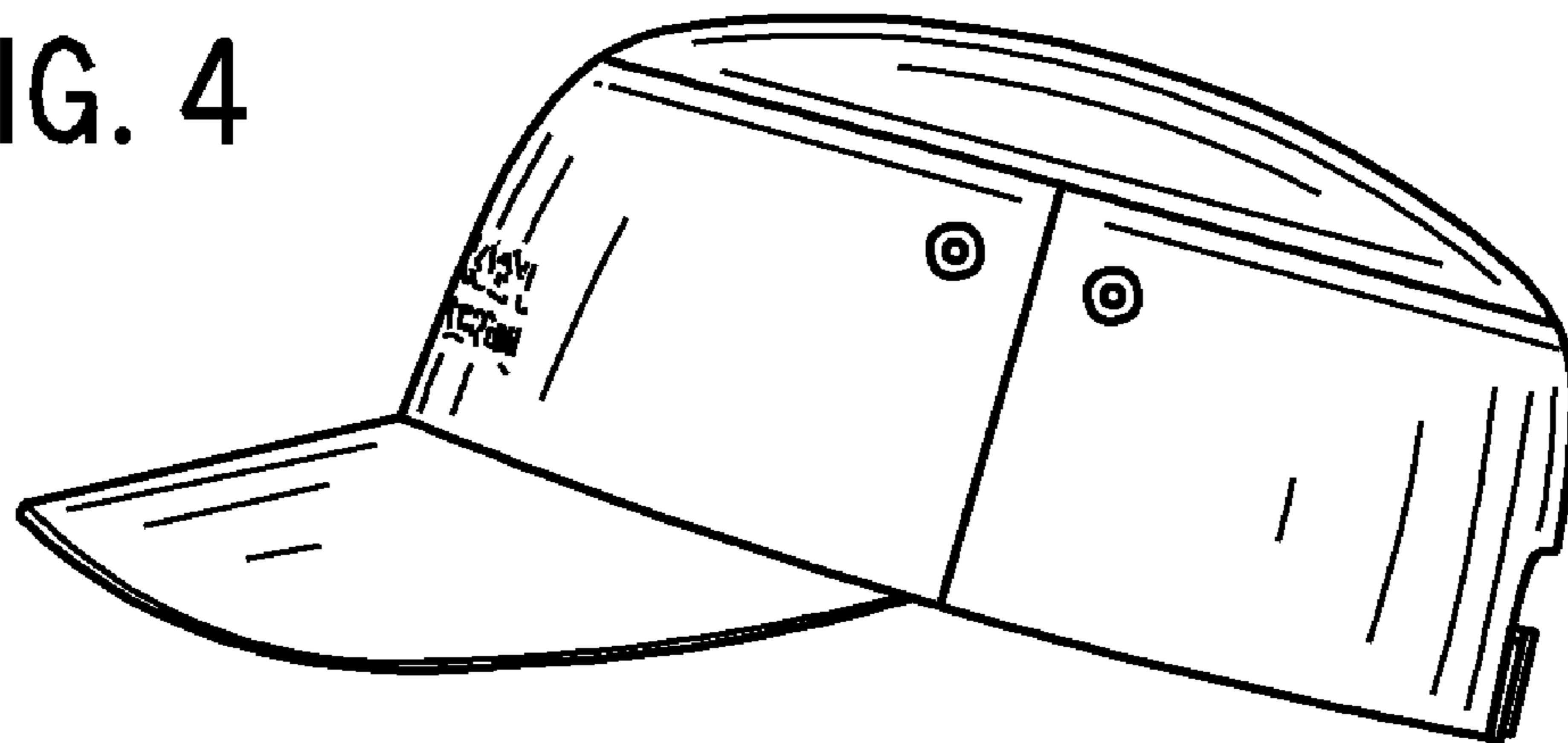

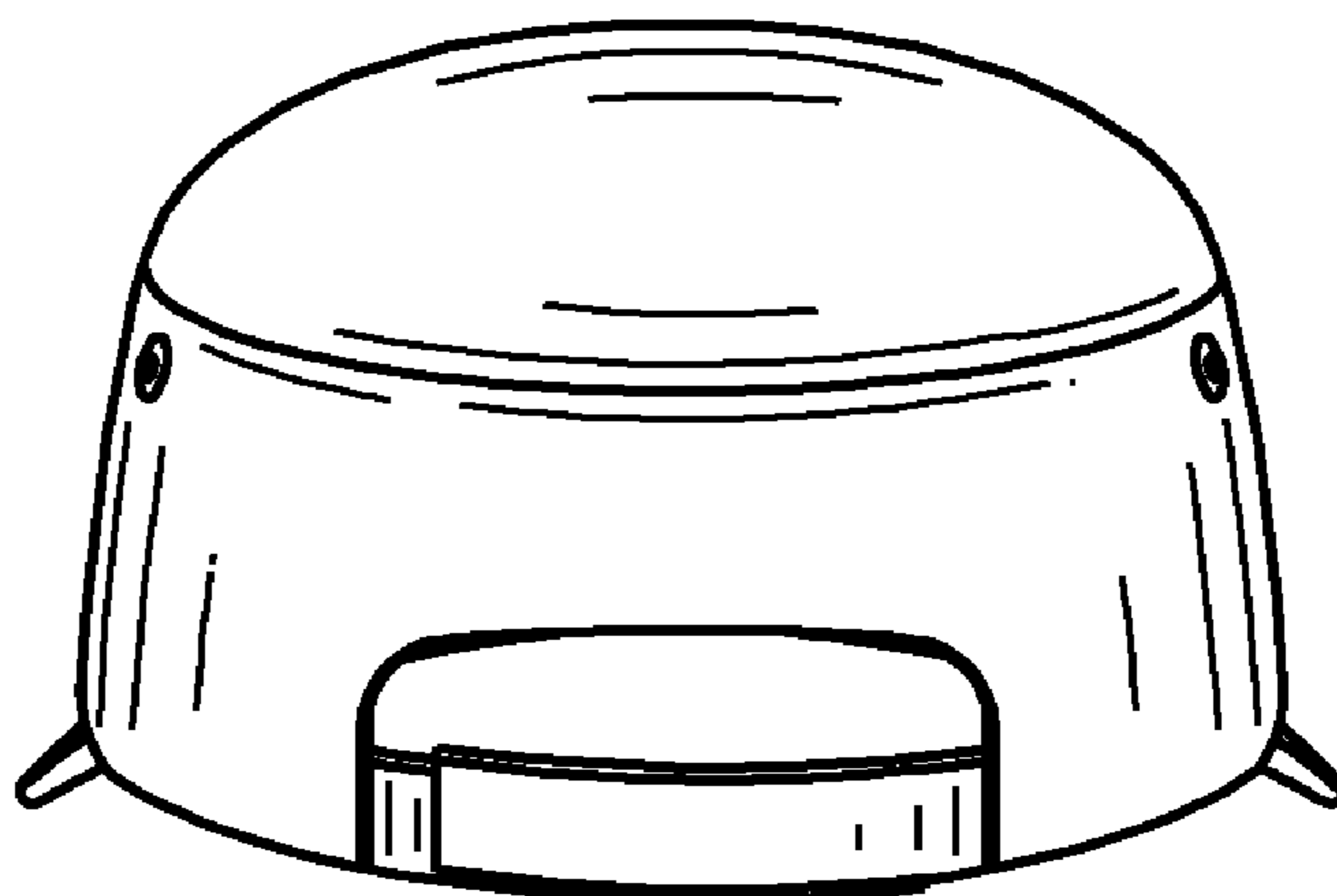

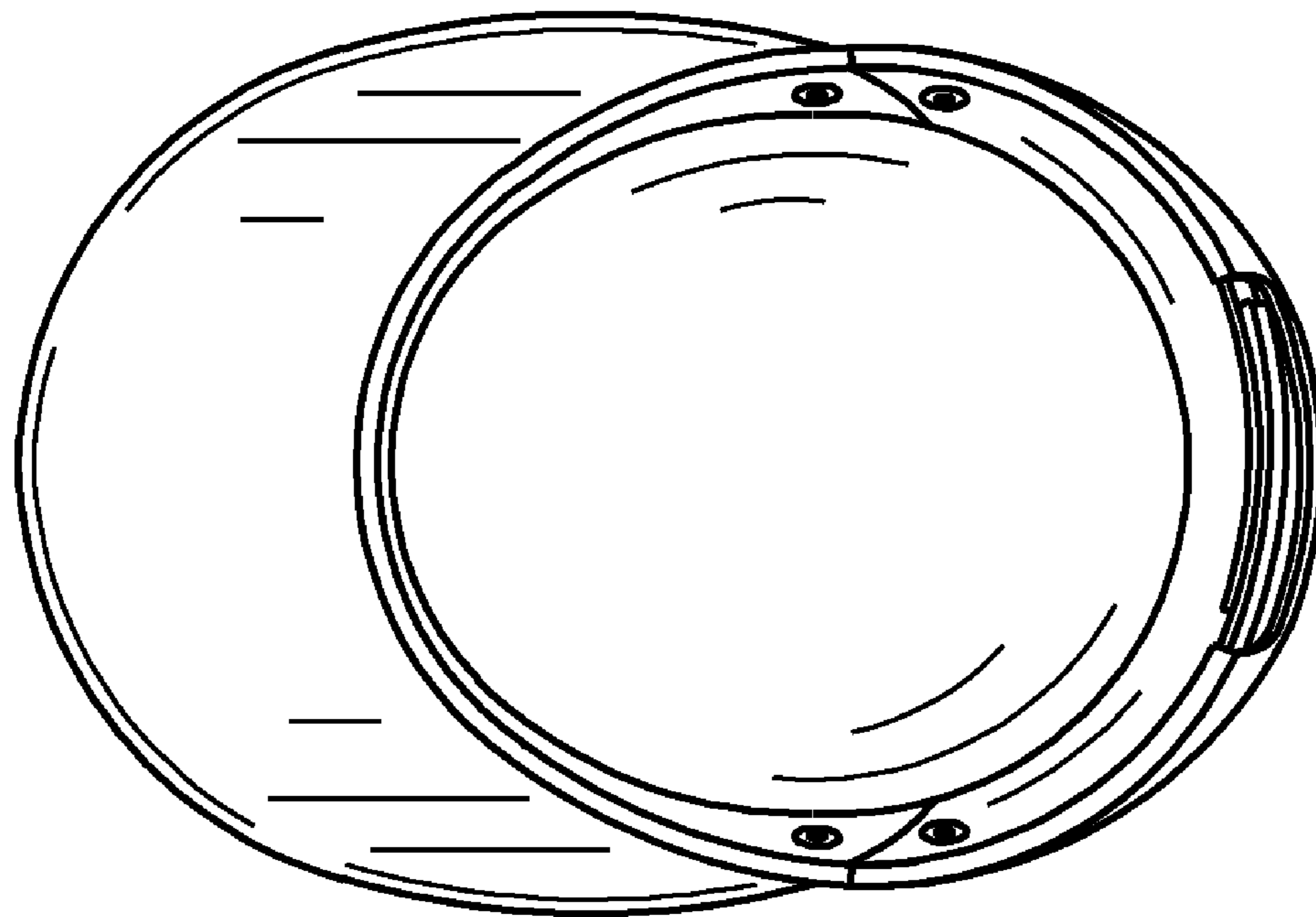
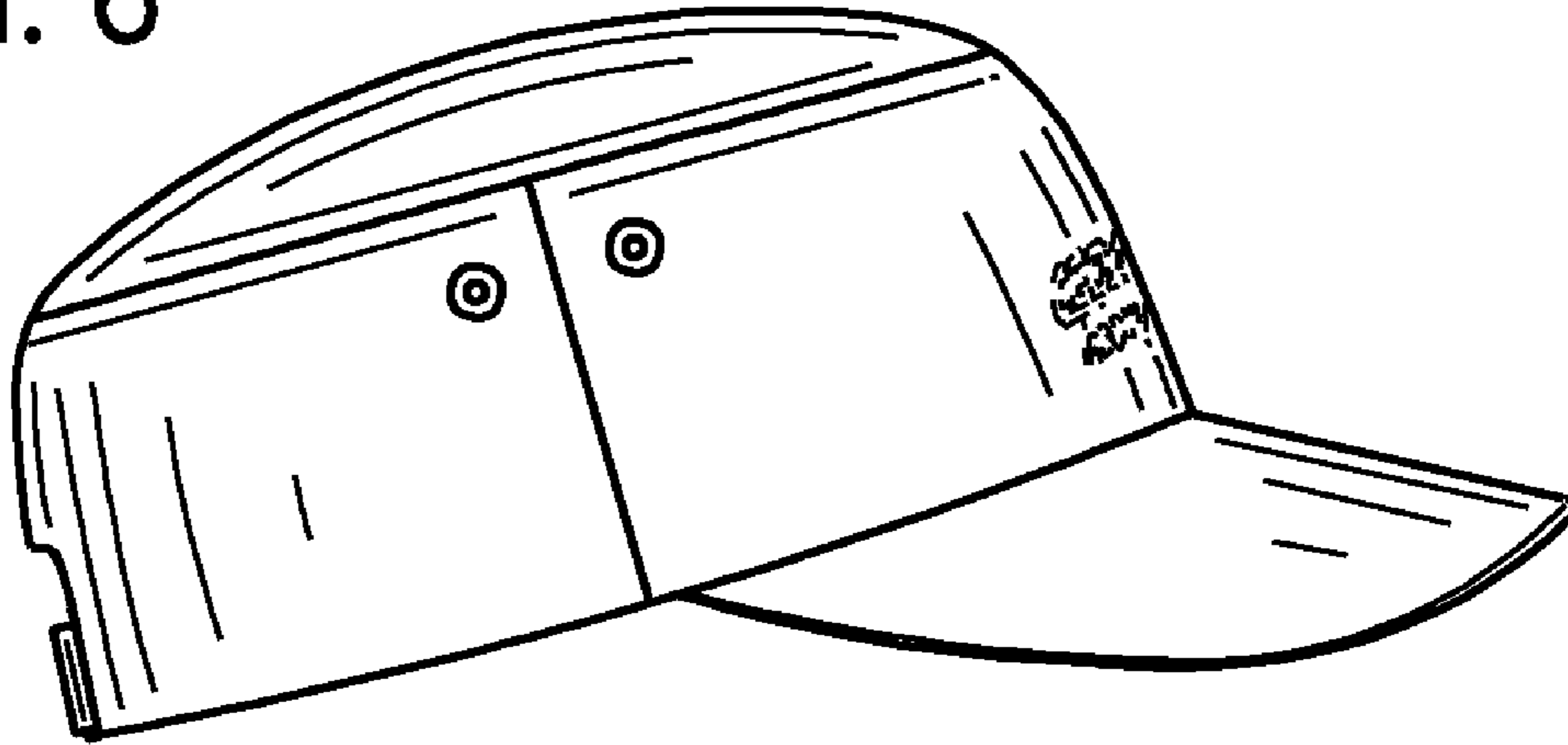
