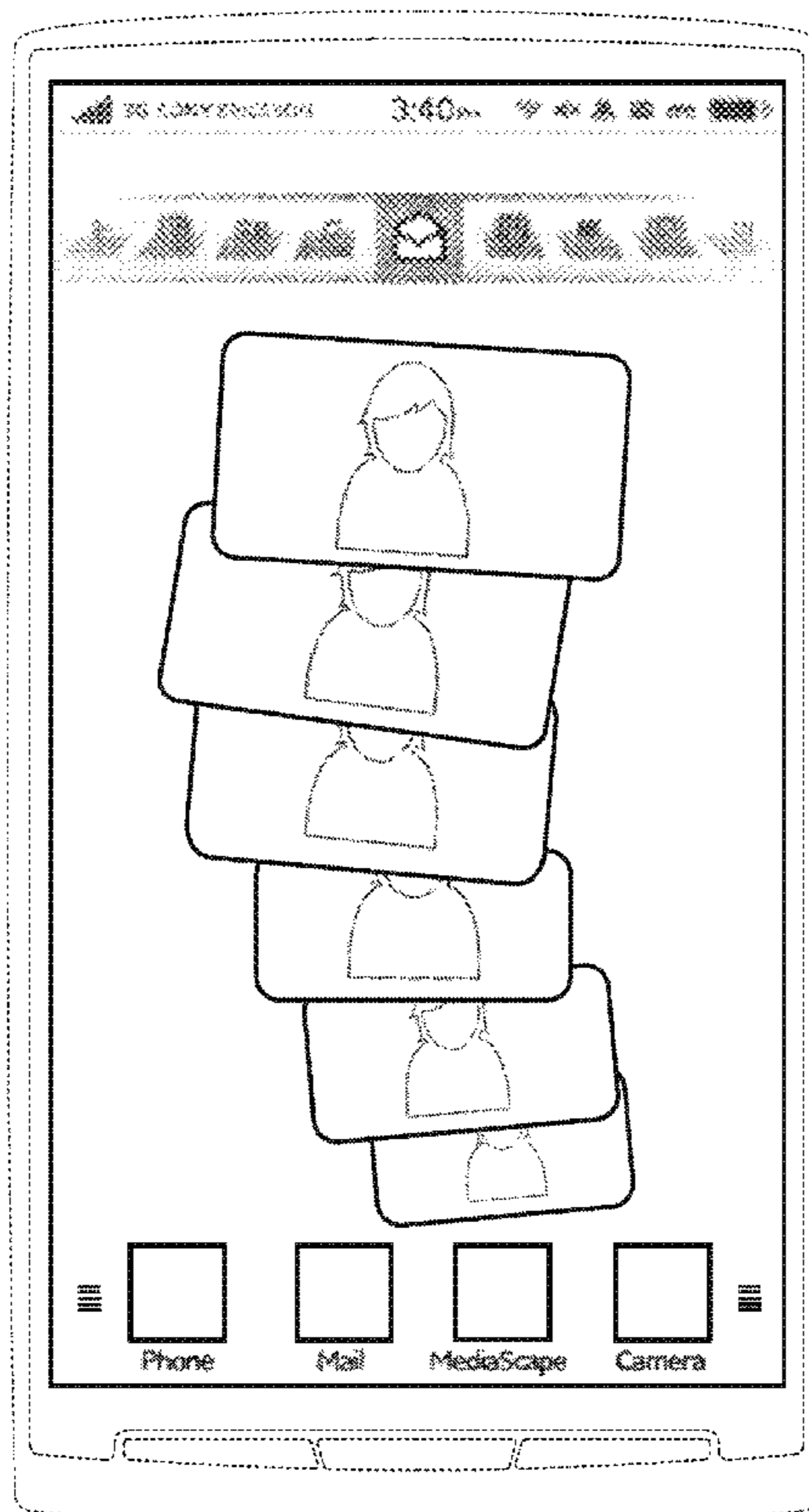

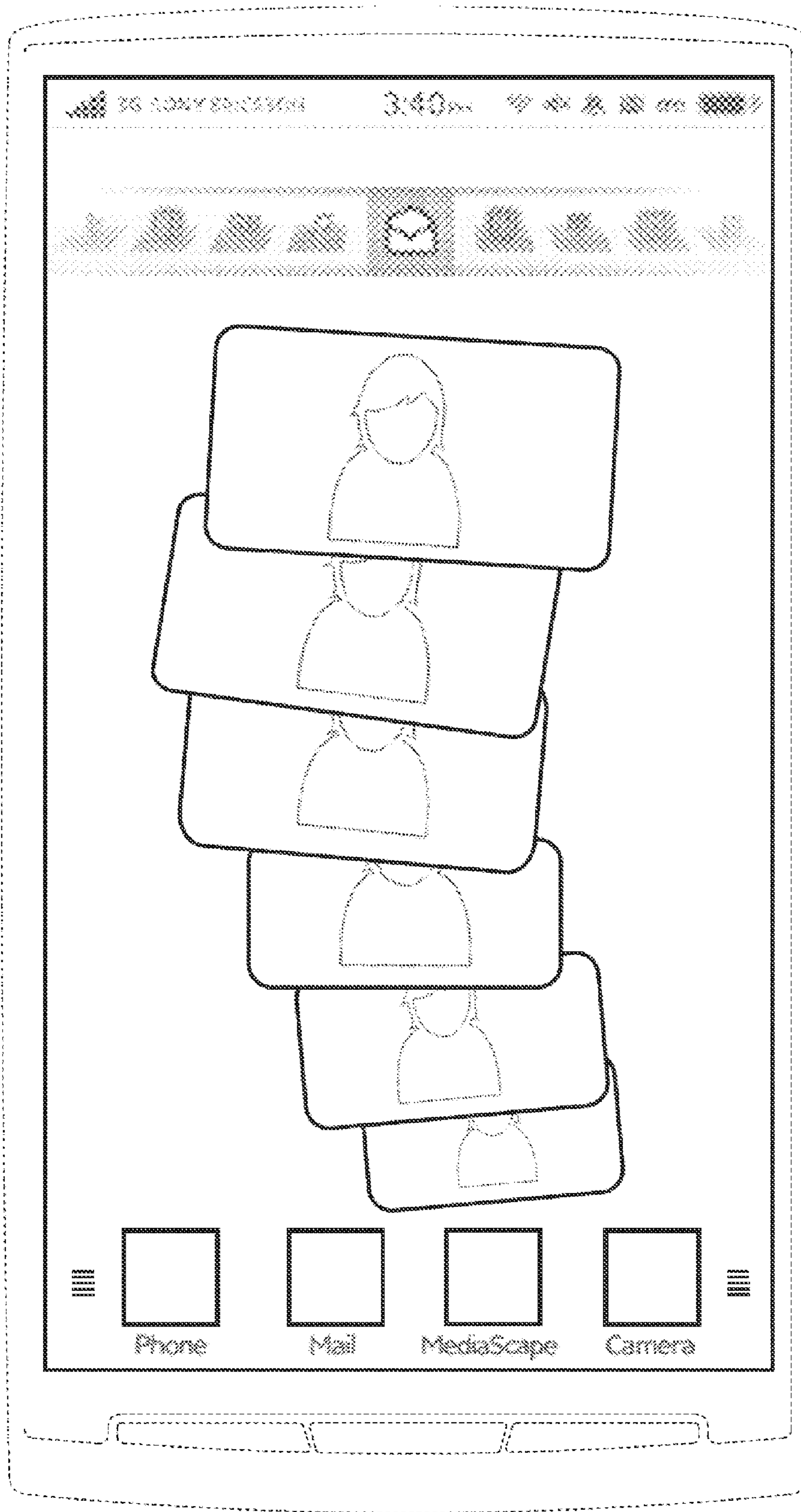
The FIGURE is a front view of a display screen with graphical user interface on a communications terminal according to our design.
