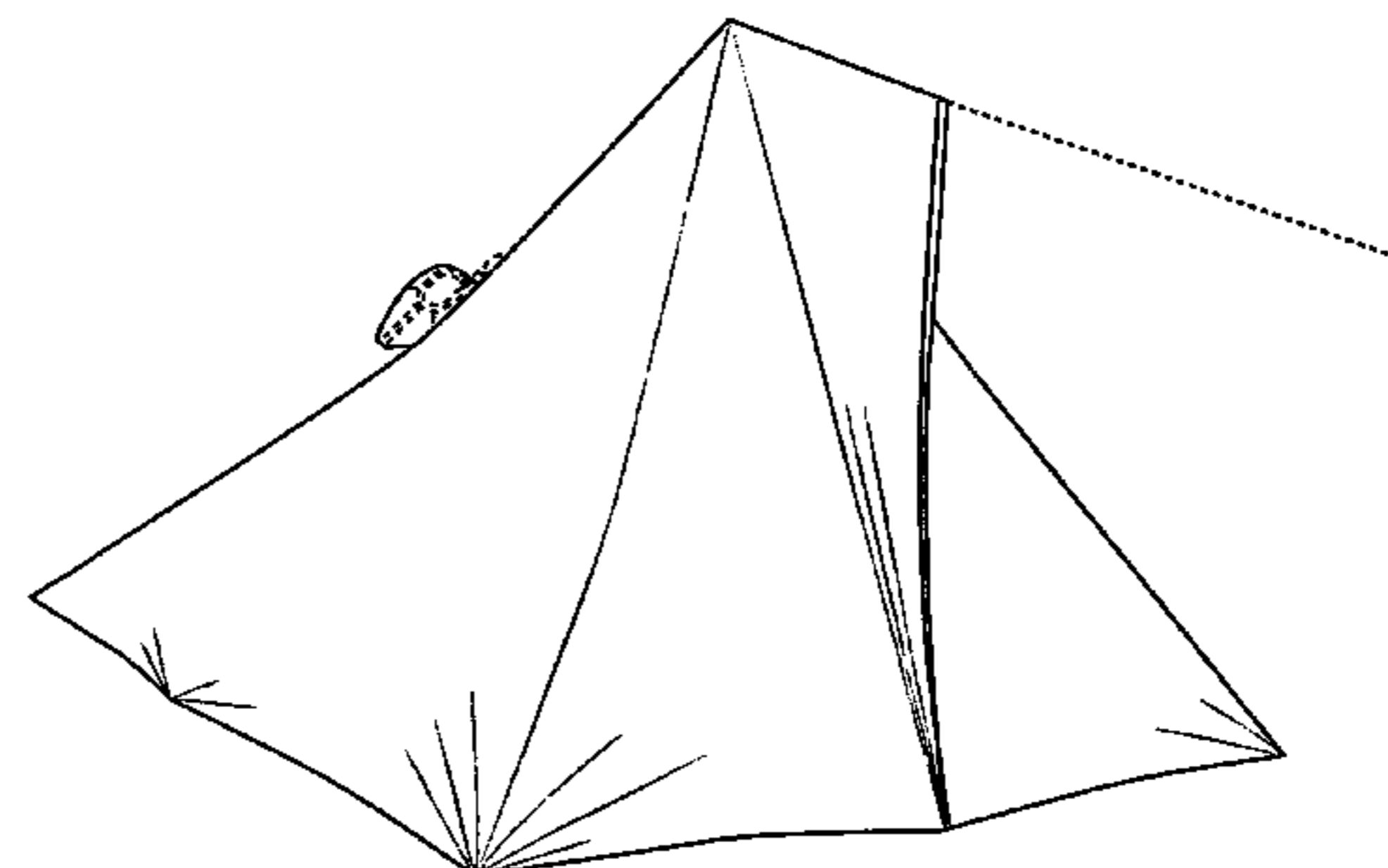
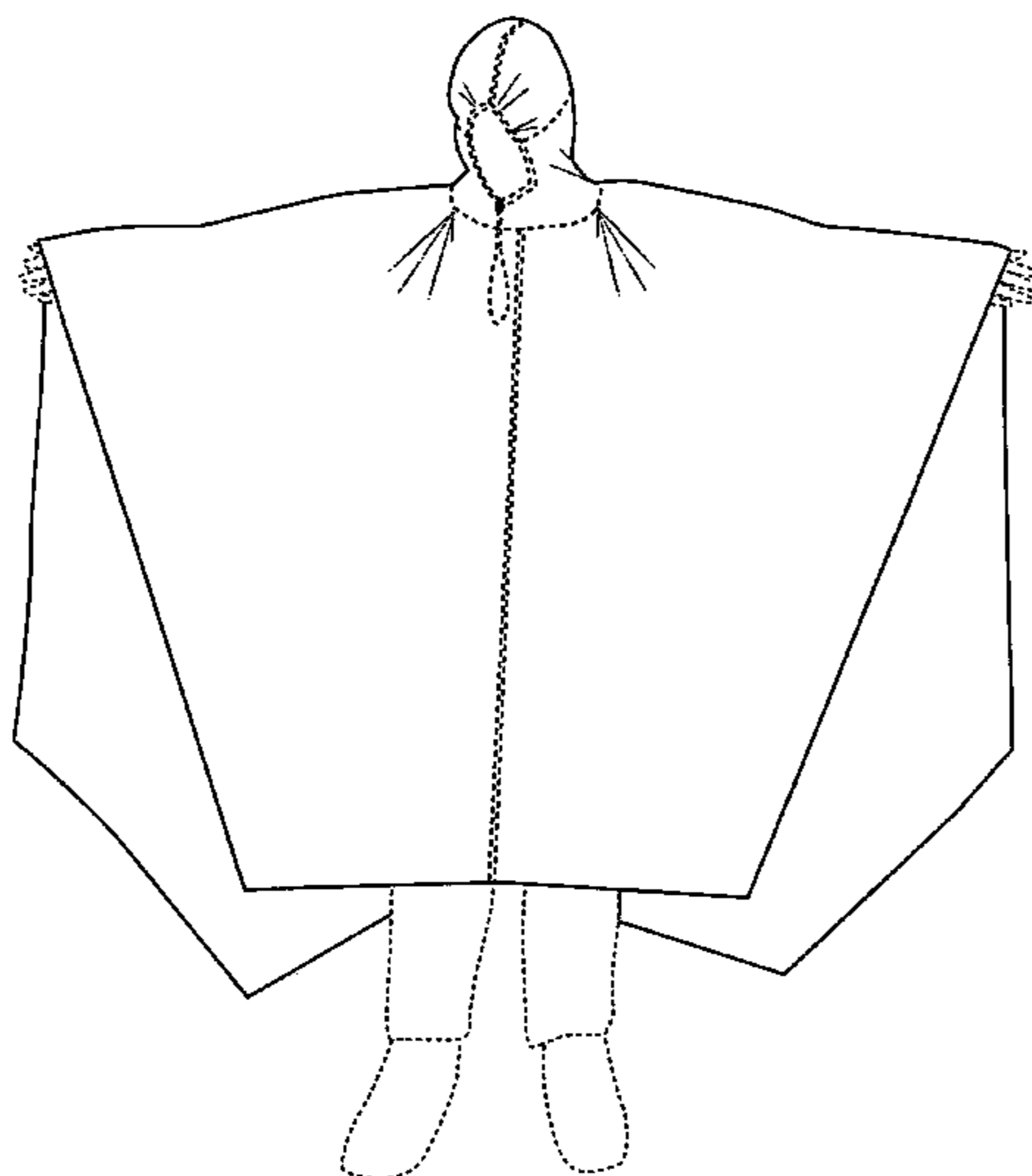
The ornamental design for a poncho-tent, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a poncho-tent design showing a tent configuration;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view showing a poncho configuration thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view showing a poncho configuration thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is an additional front elevational view showing a poncho configuration thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is an additional rear elevational view showing a poncho configuration thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view showing a tent configuration thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view showing a tent configuration thereof;  
 FIG. 8 is a front right perspective view showing a tent configuration thereof;  
 FIG. 9 is a front left perspective view showing a tent configuration thereof;  
 FIG. 10 is a rear left perspective view showing a tent configuration thereof;  
 FIG. 11 is a rear right perspective view showing a tent configuration thereof; and,  
 FIG. 12 is an additional top plan view showing a tent configuration thereof.

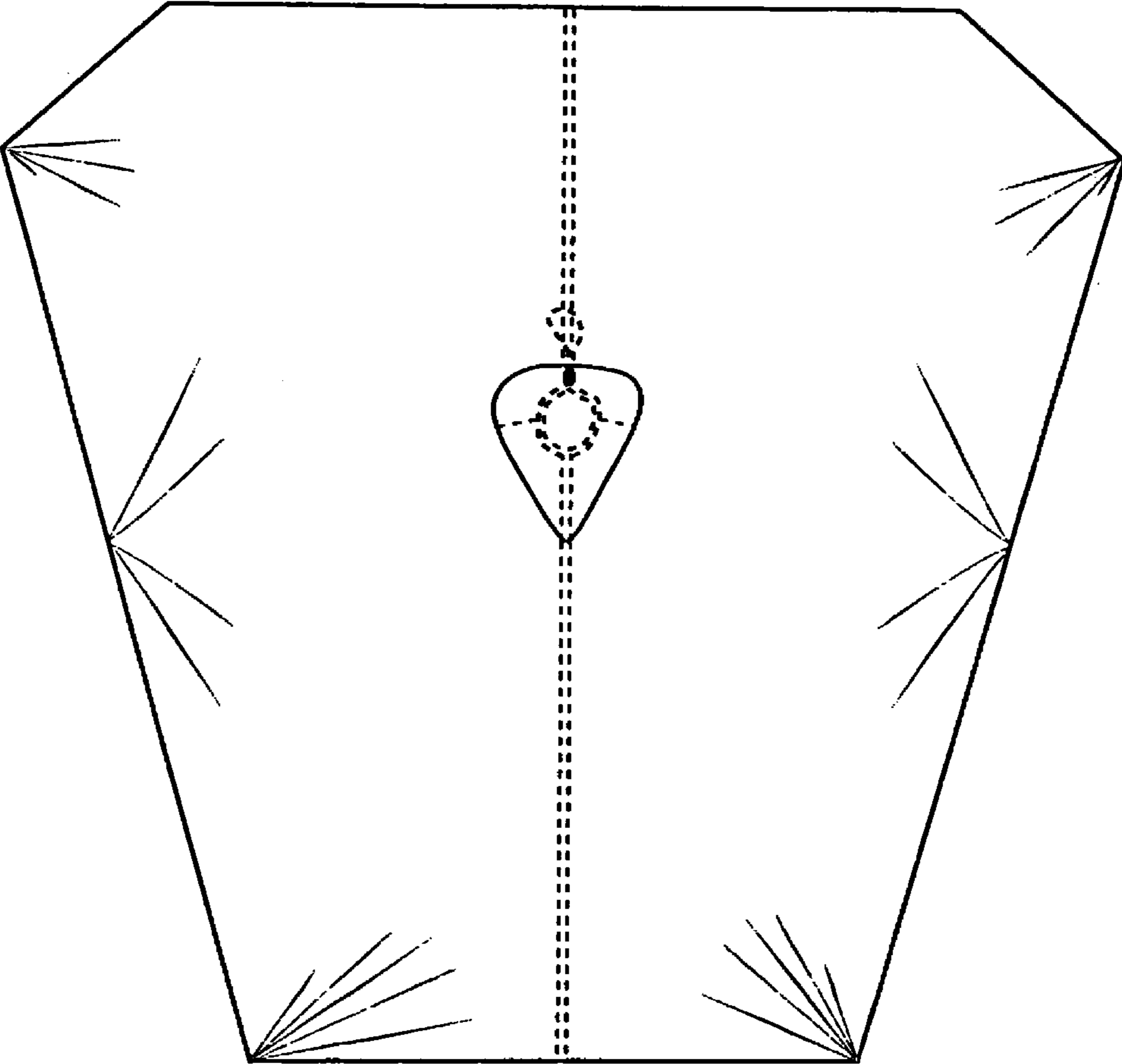

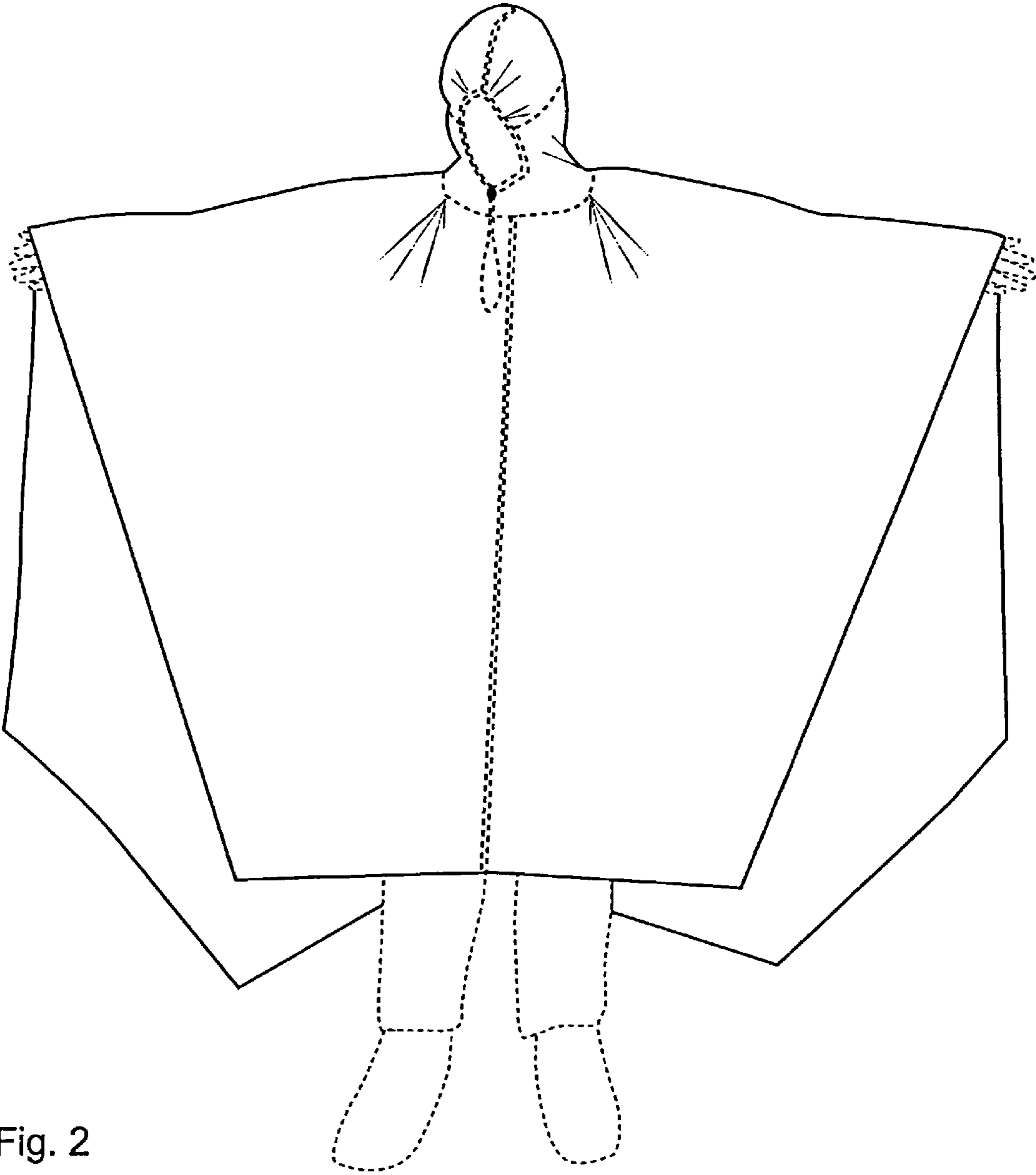

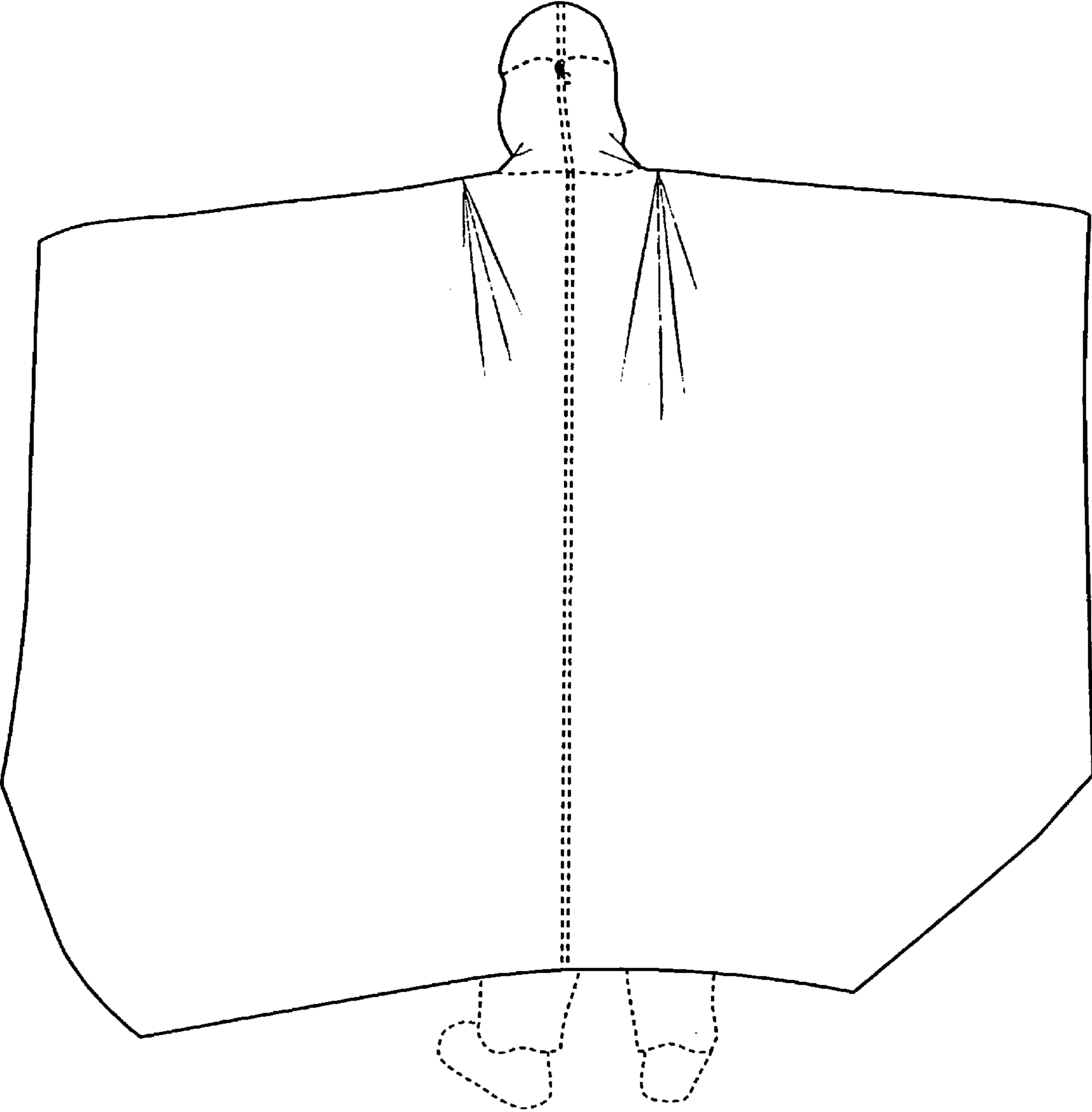

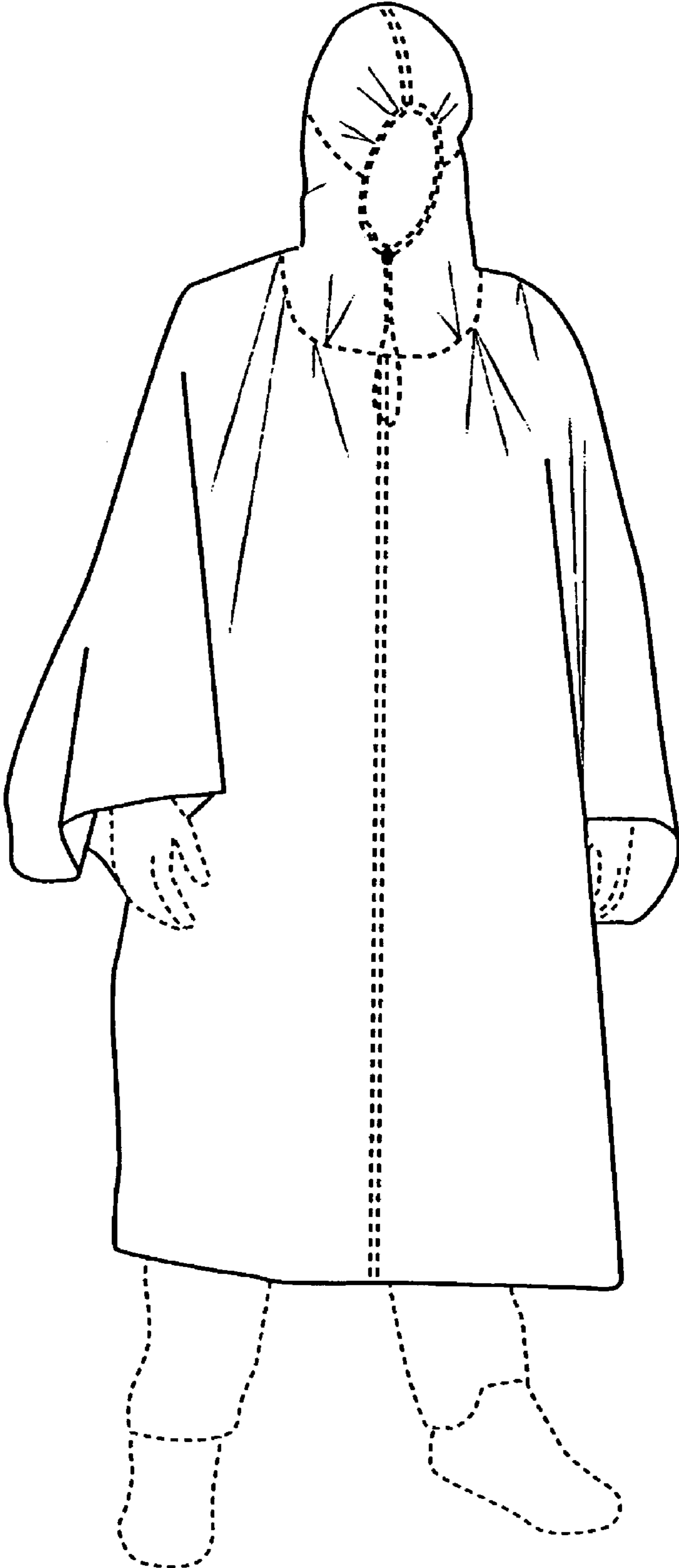

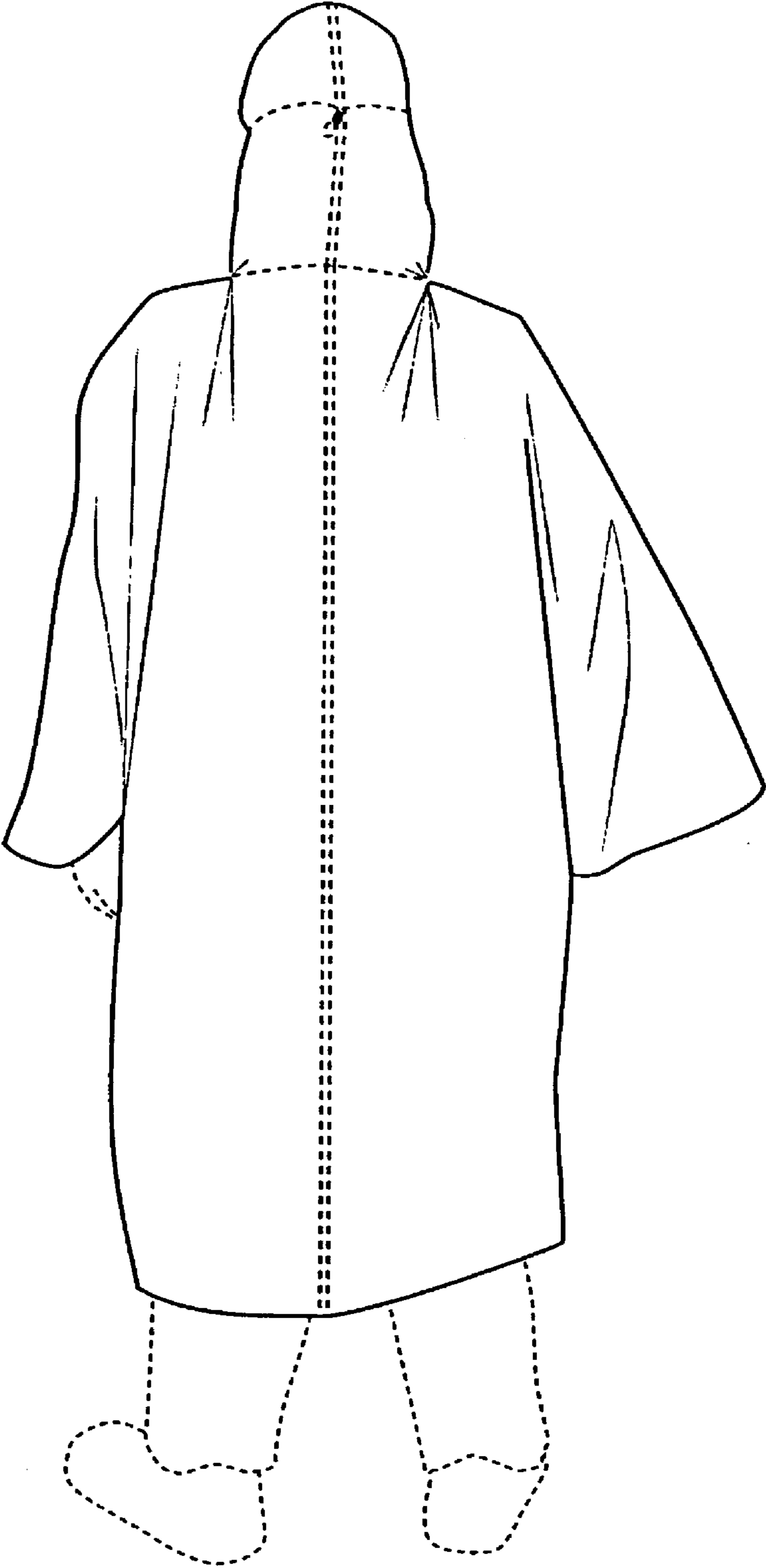

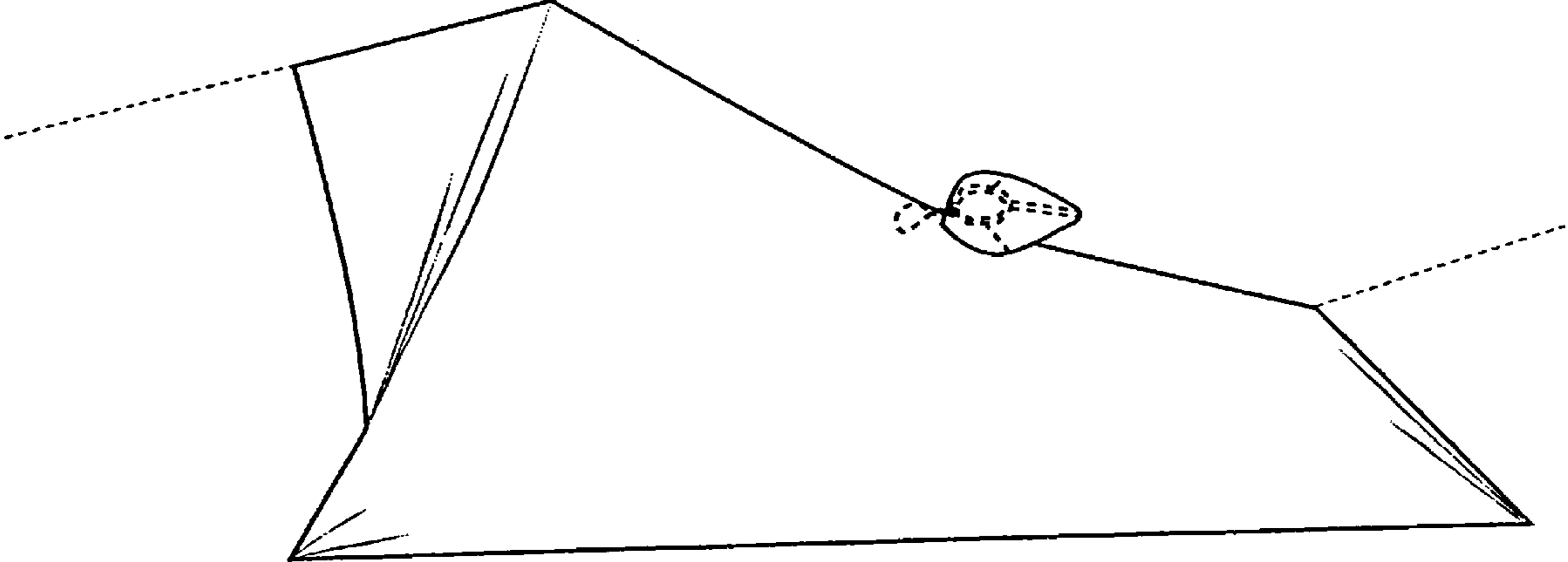

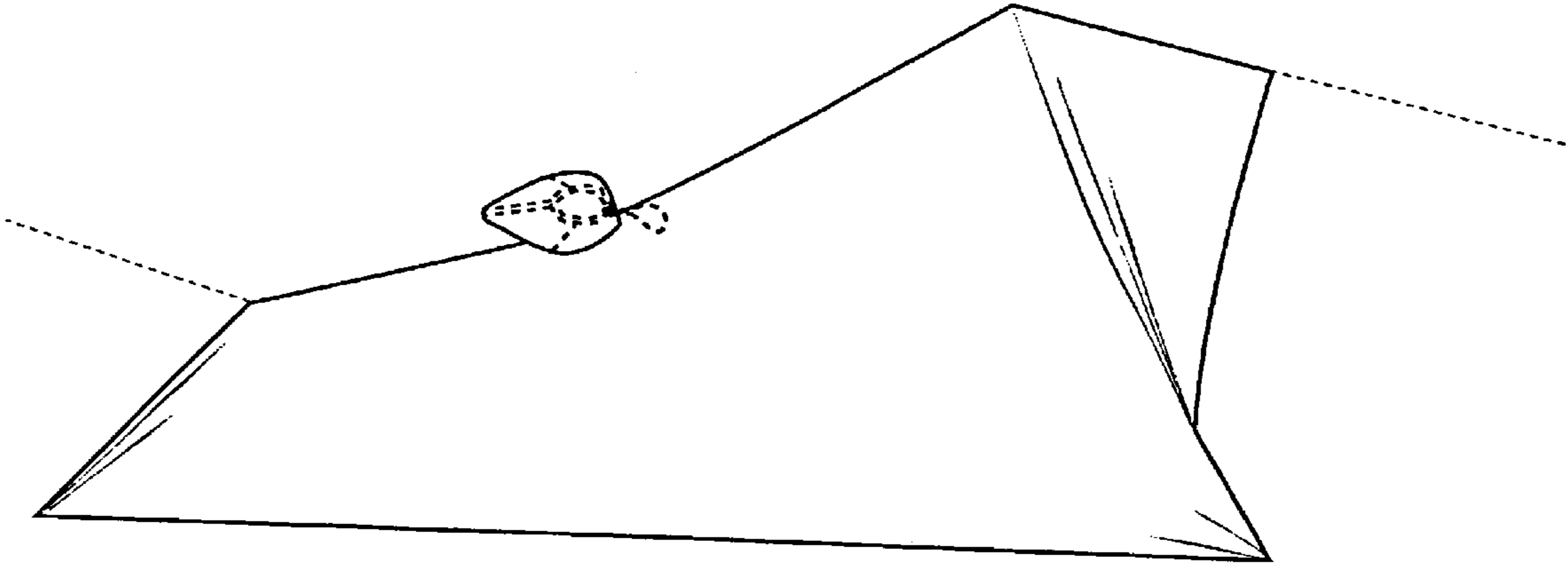

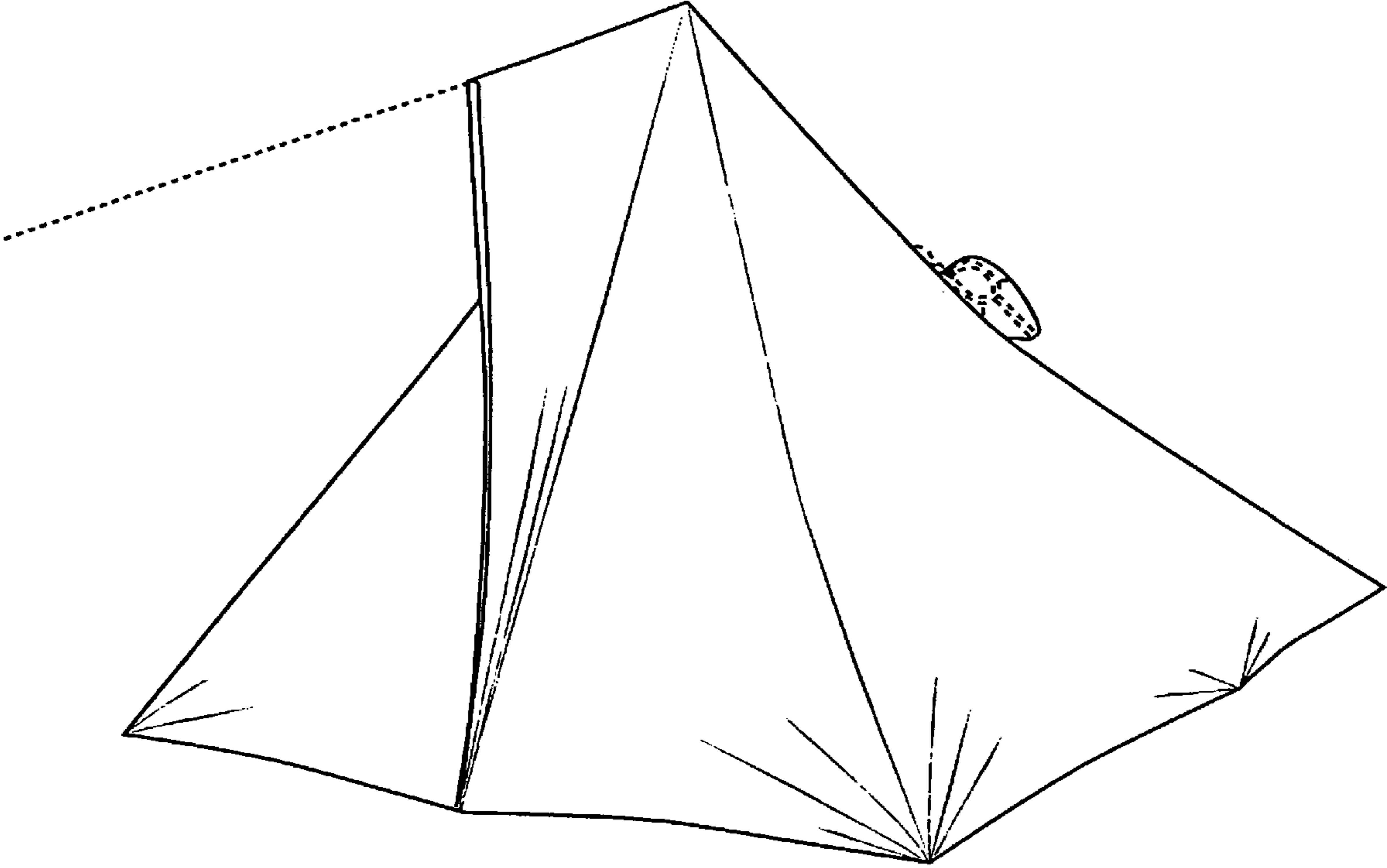

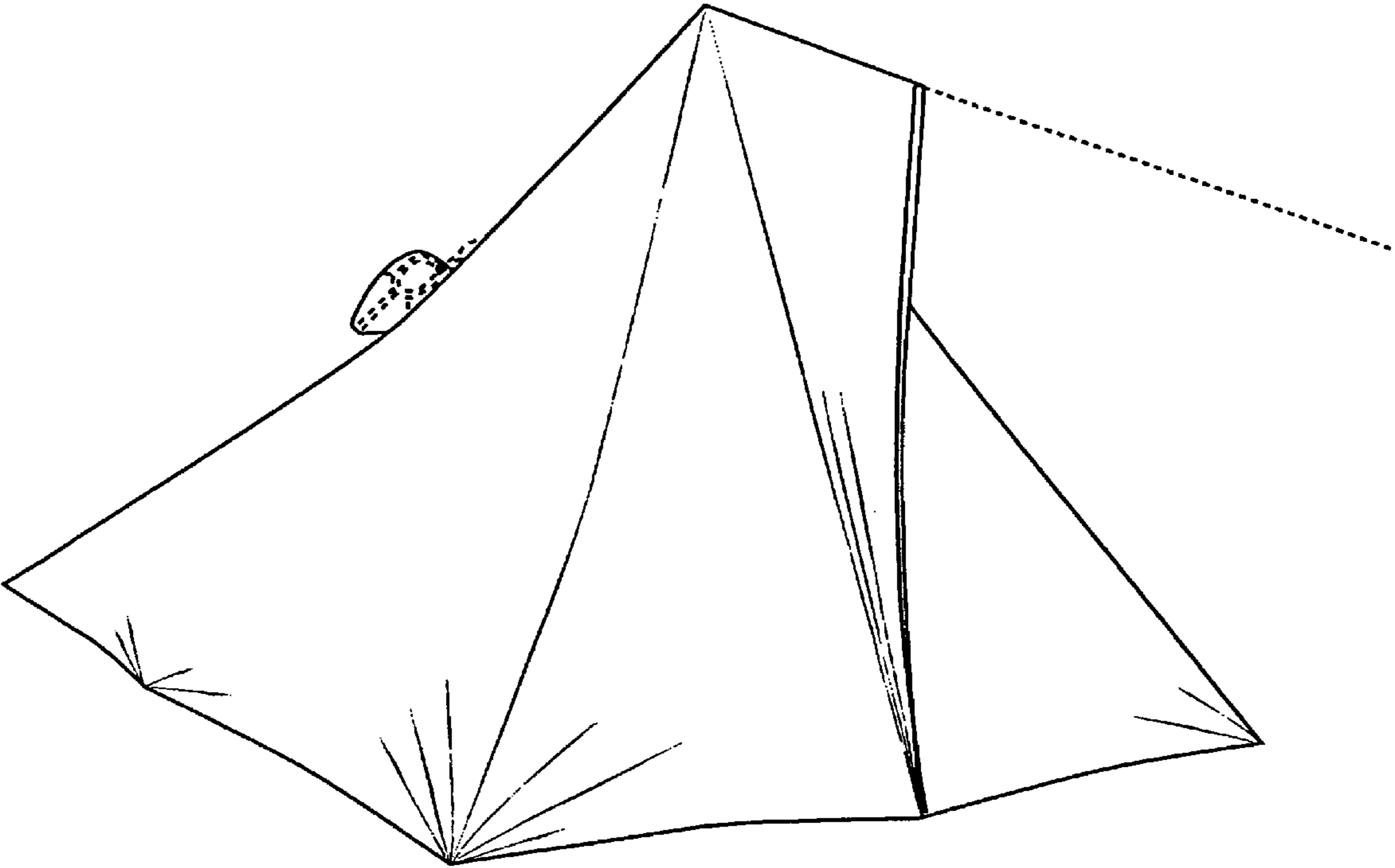

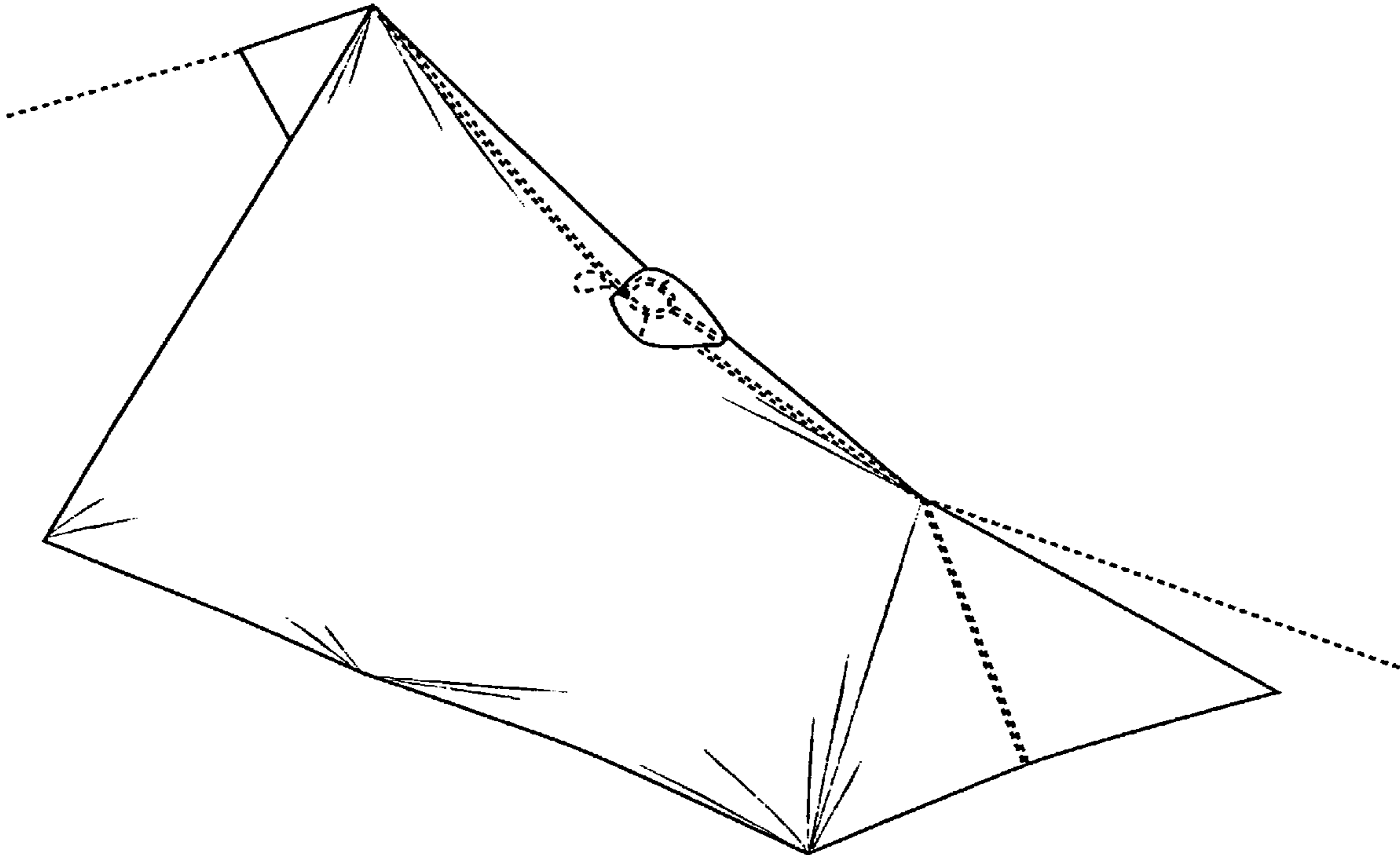

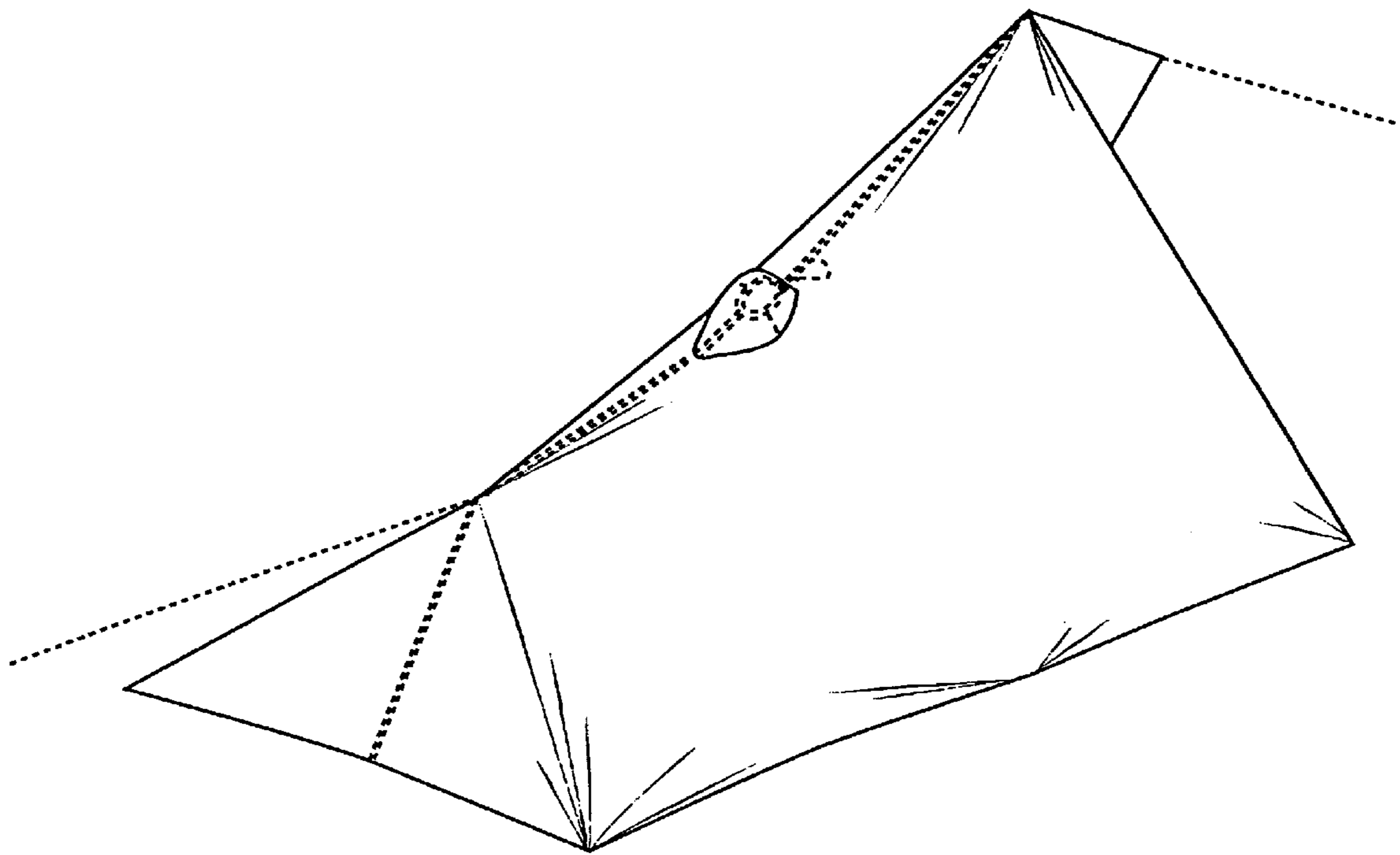

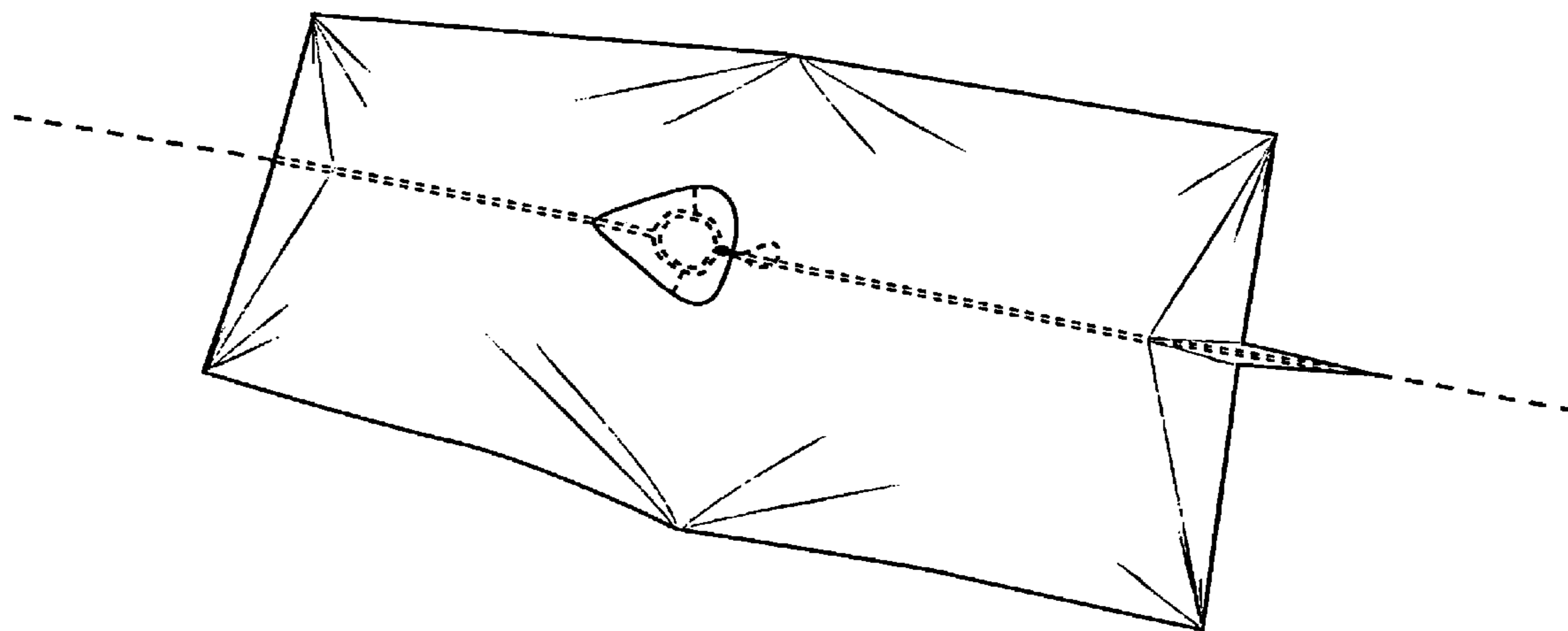
