(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe sole assembly, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the shoe sole assembly.

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the shoe sole assembly, showing our new design;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the shoe sole assembly, showing our new design;

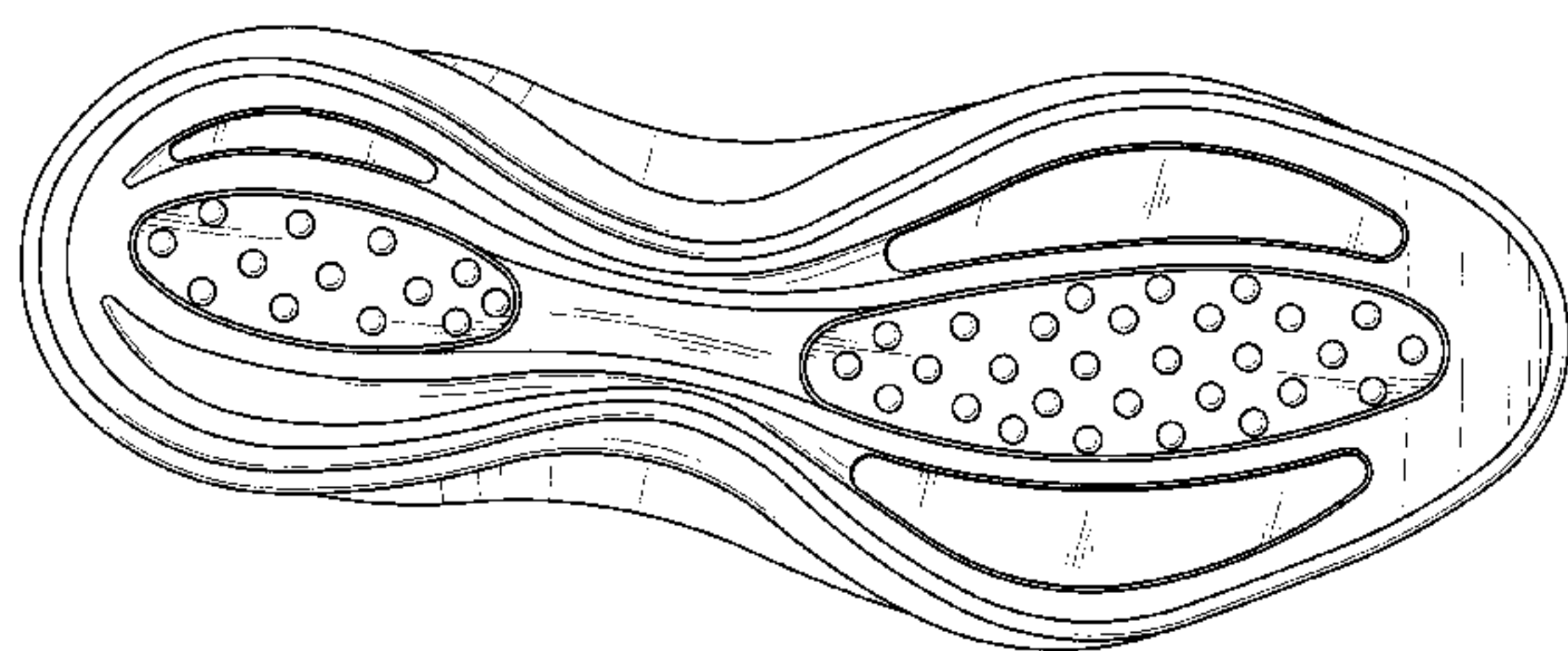
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the shoe sole assembly, showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a front view of the shoe sole assembly, showing our new design; and,

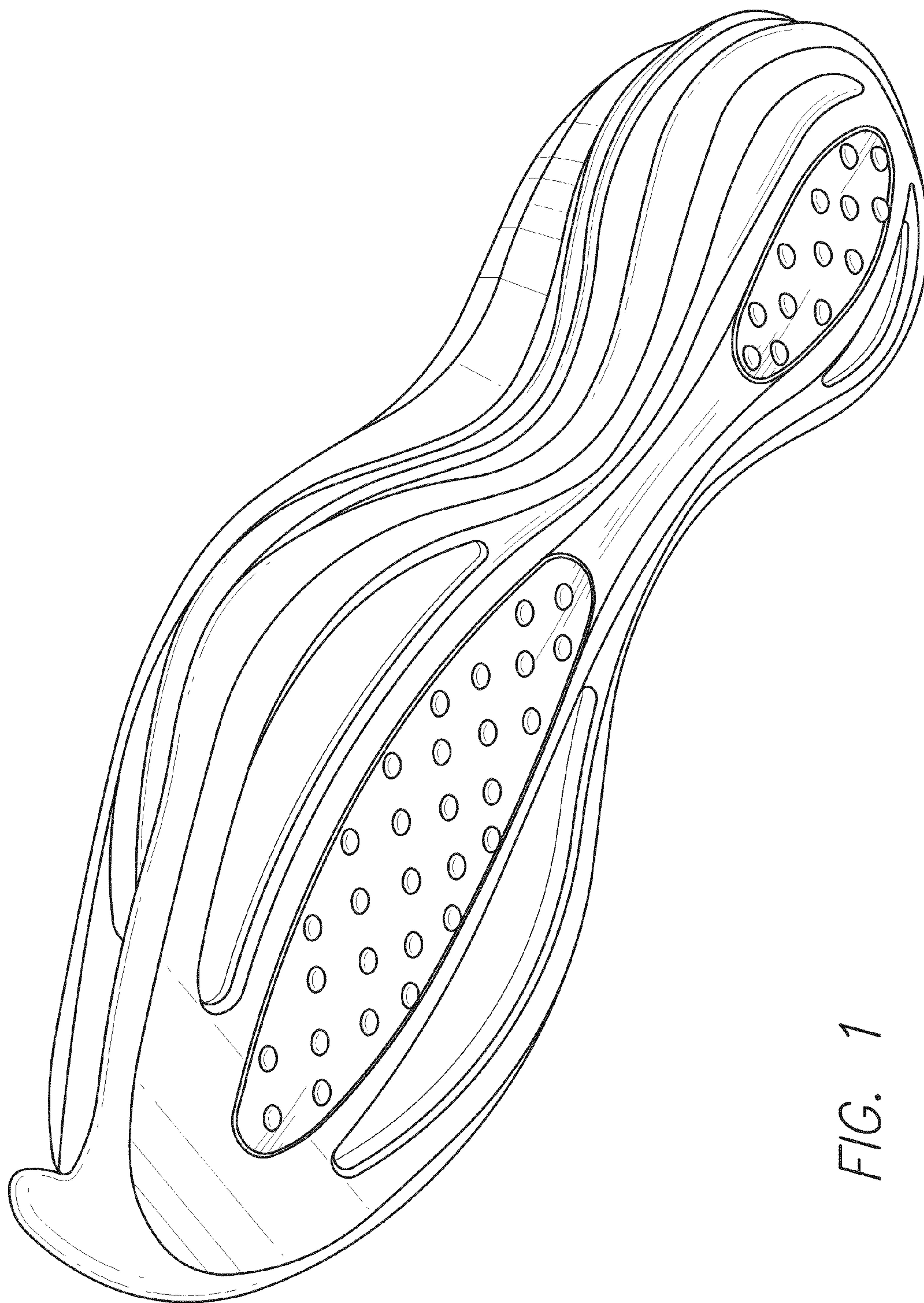

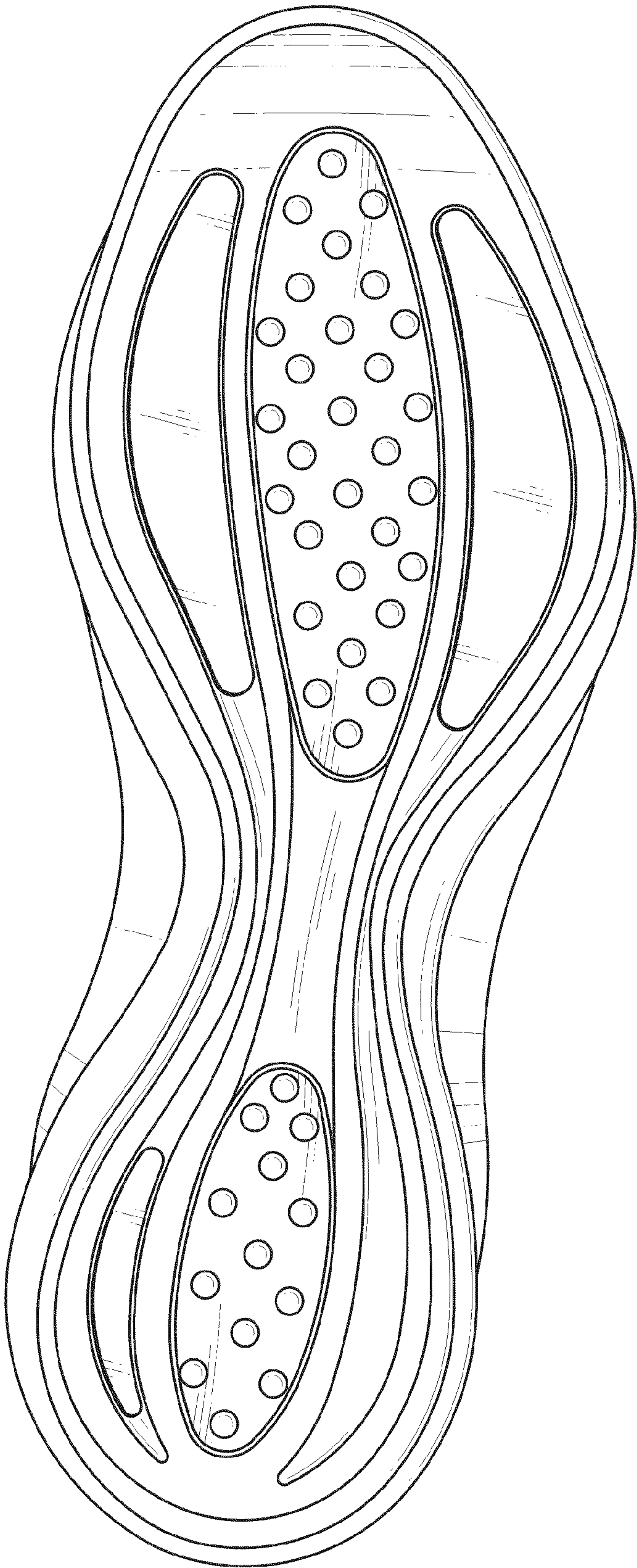

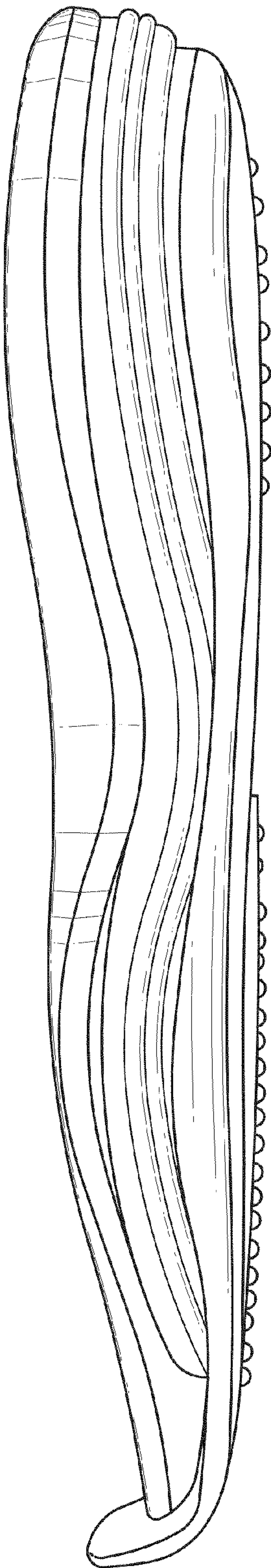

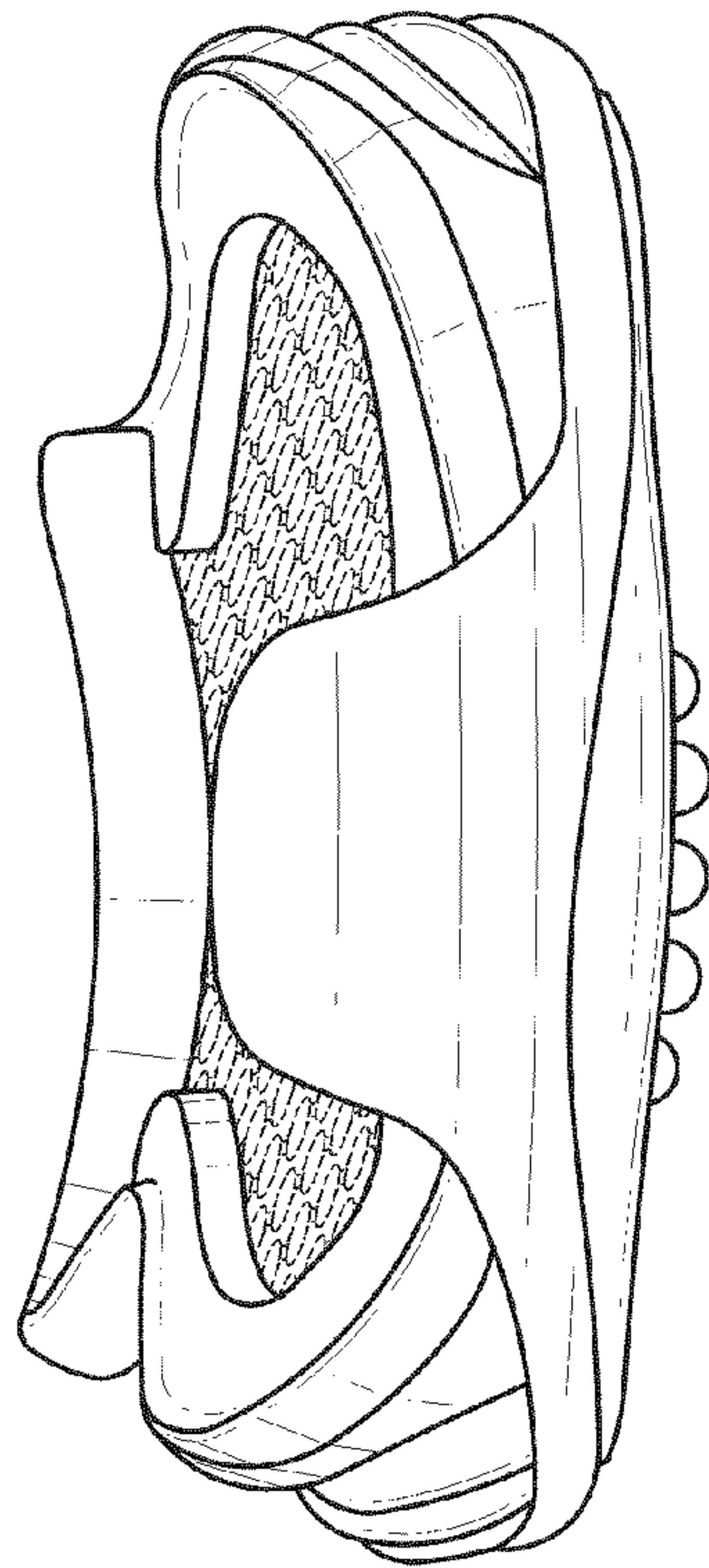

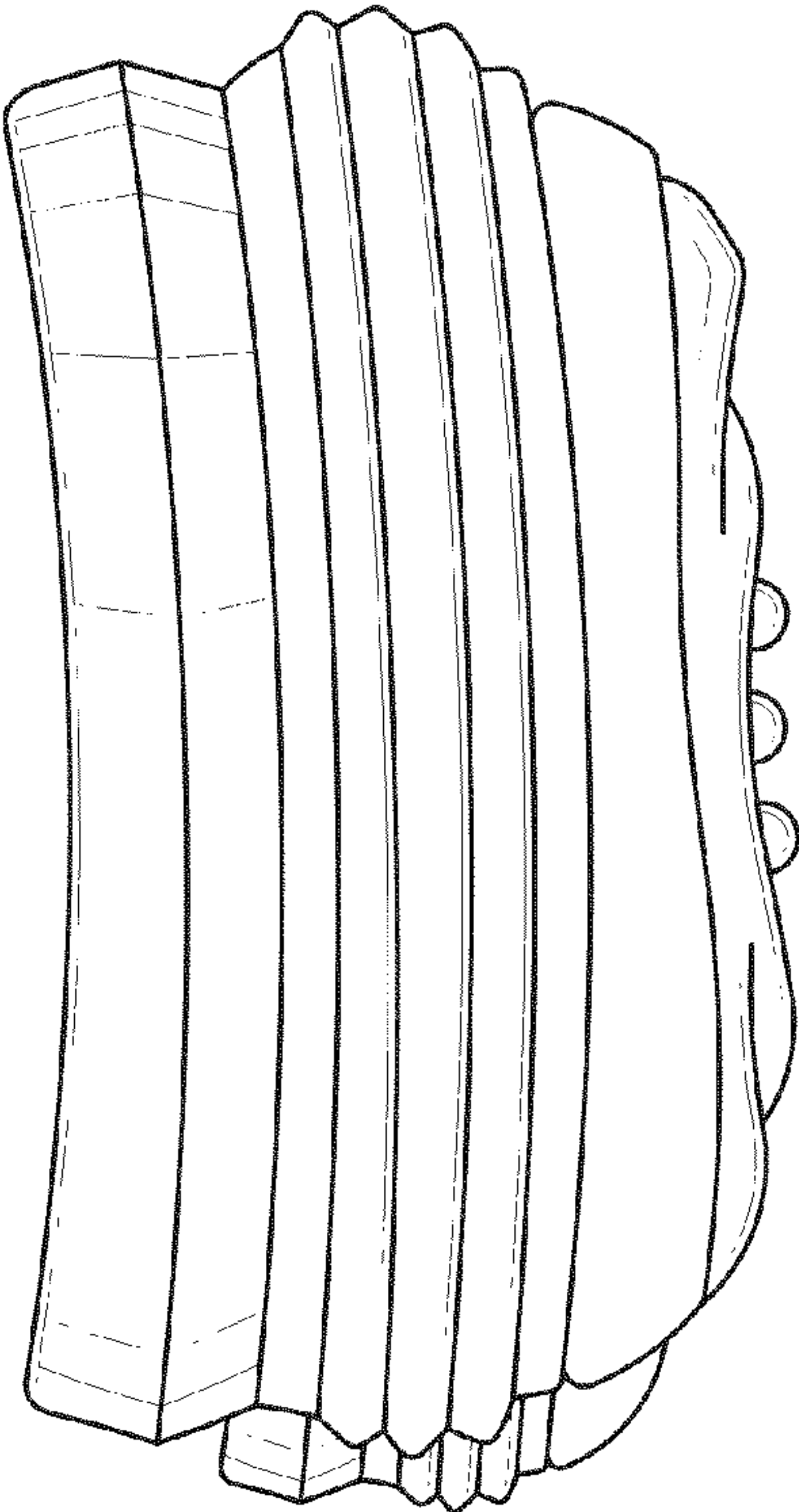
