FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of the lift hole plug;

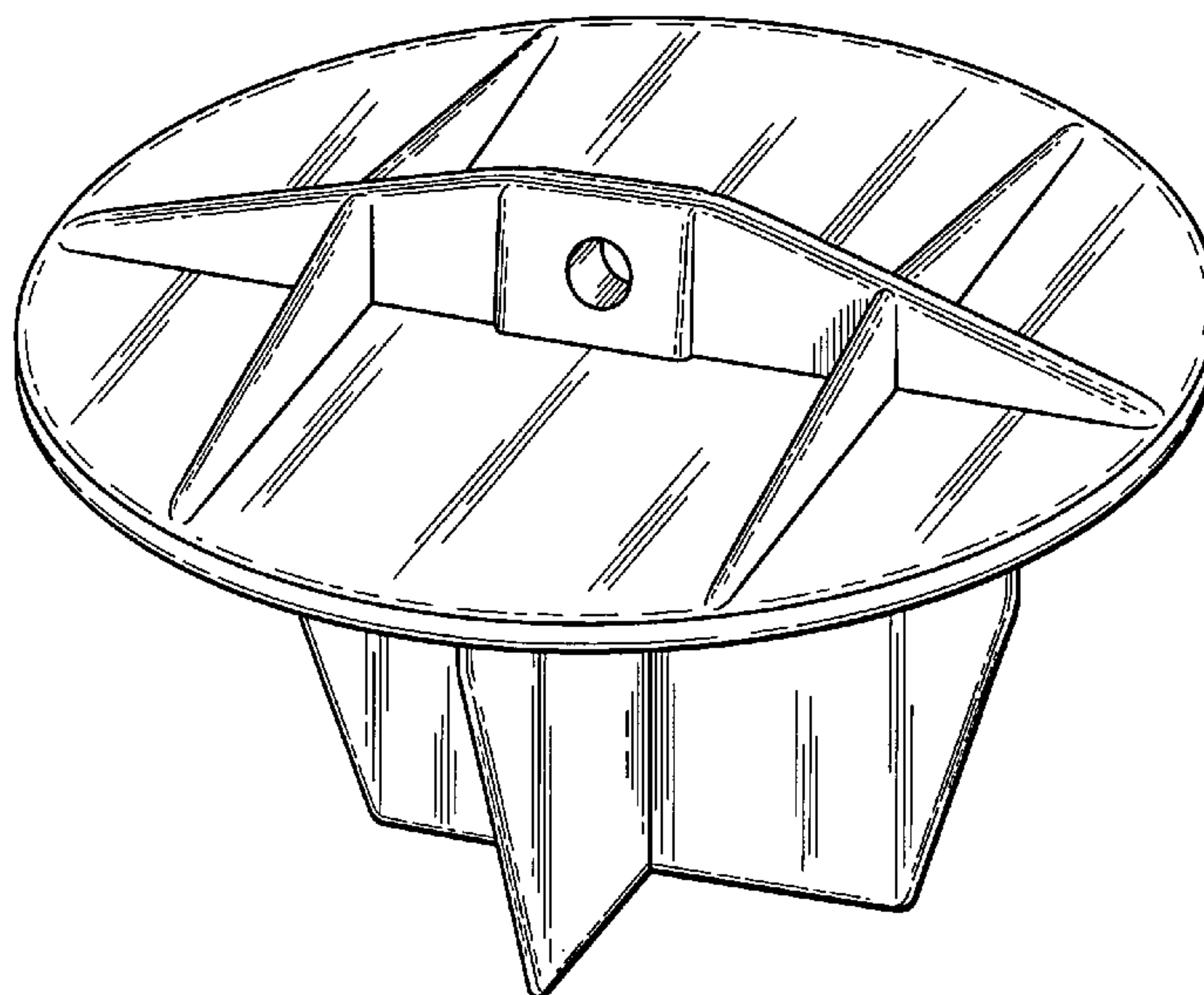
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation view being identical;

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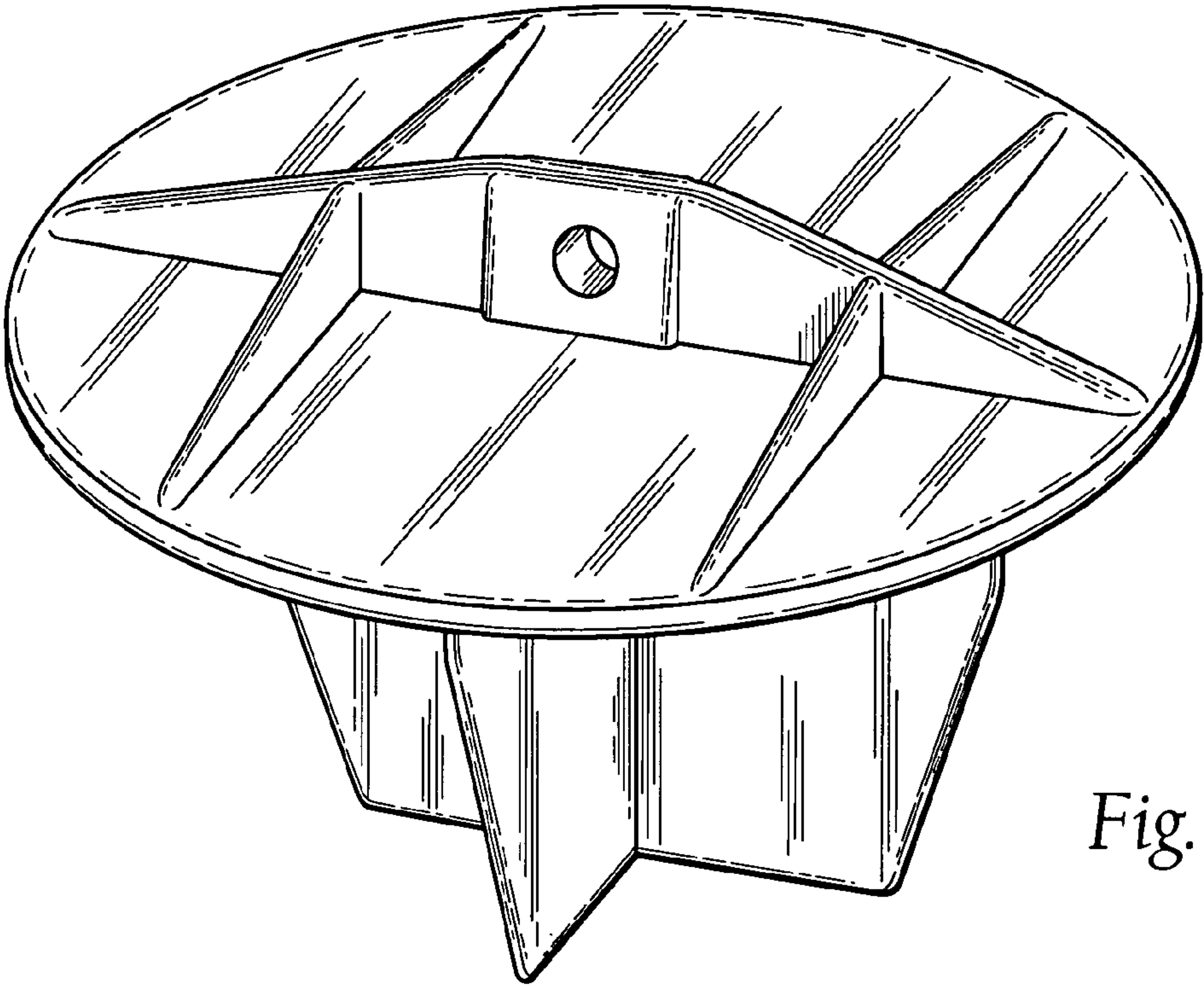

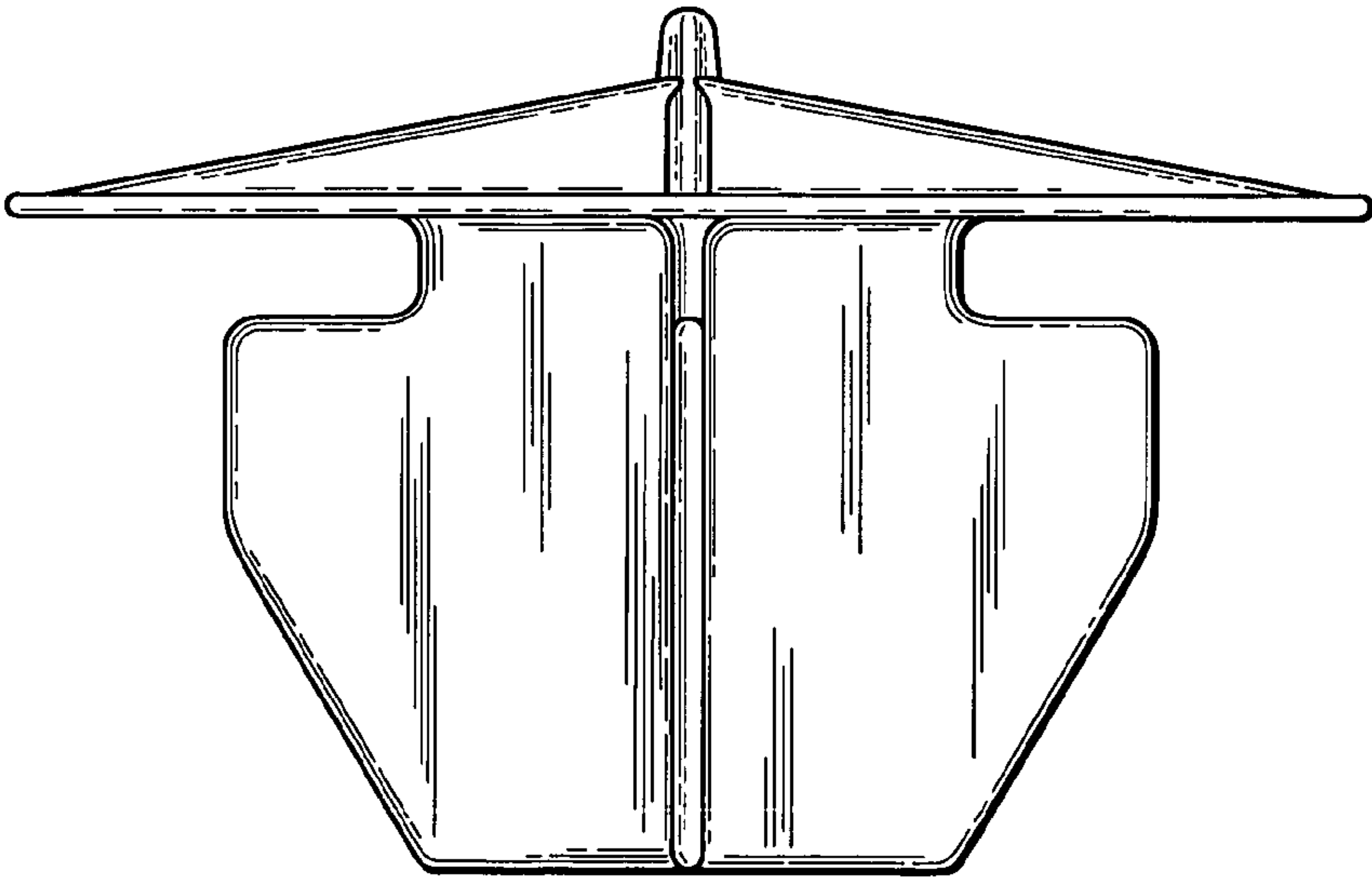

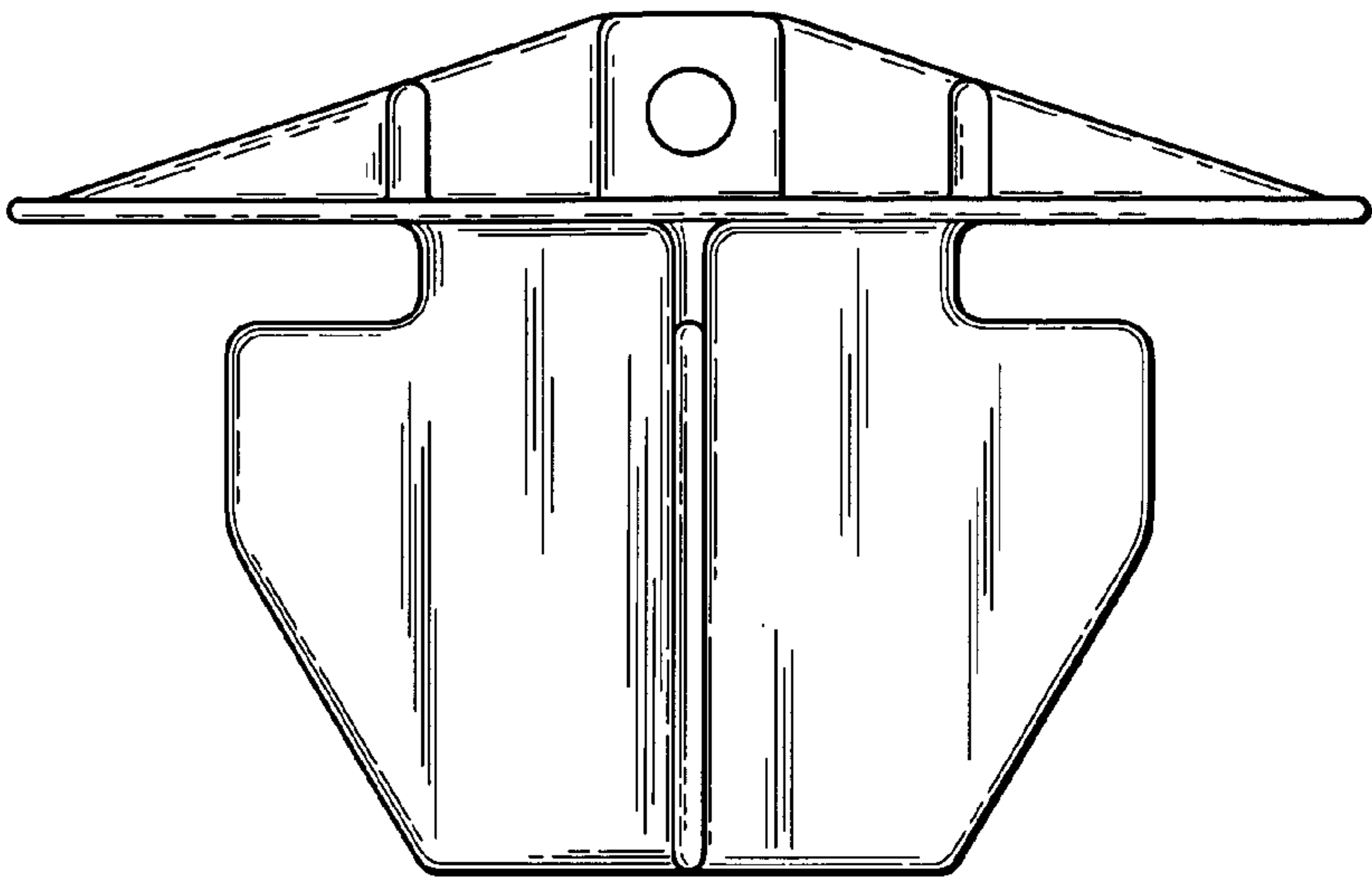

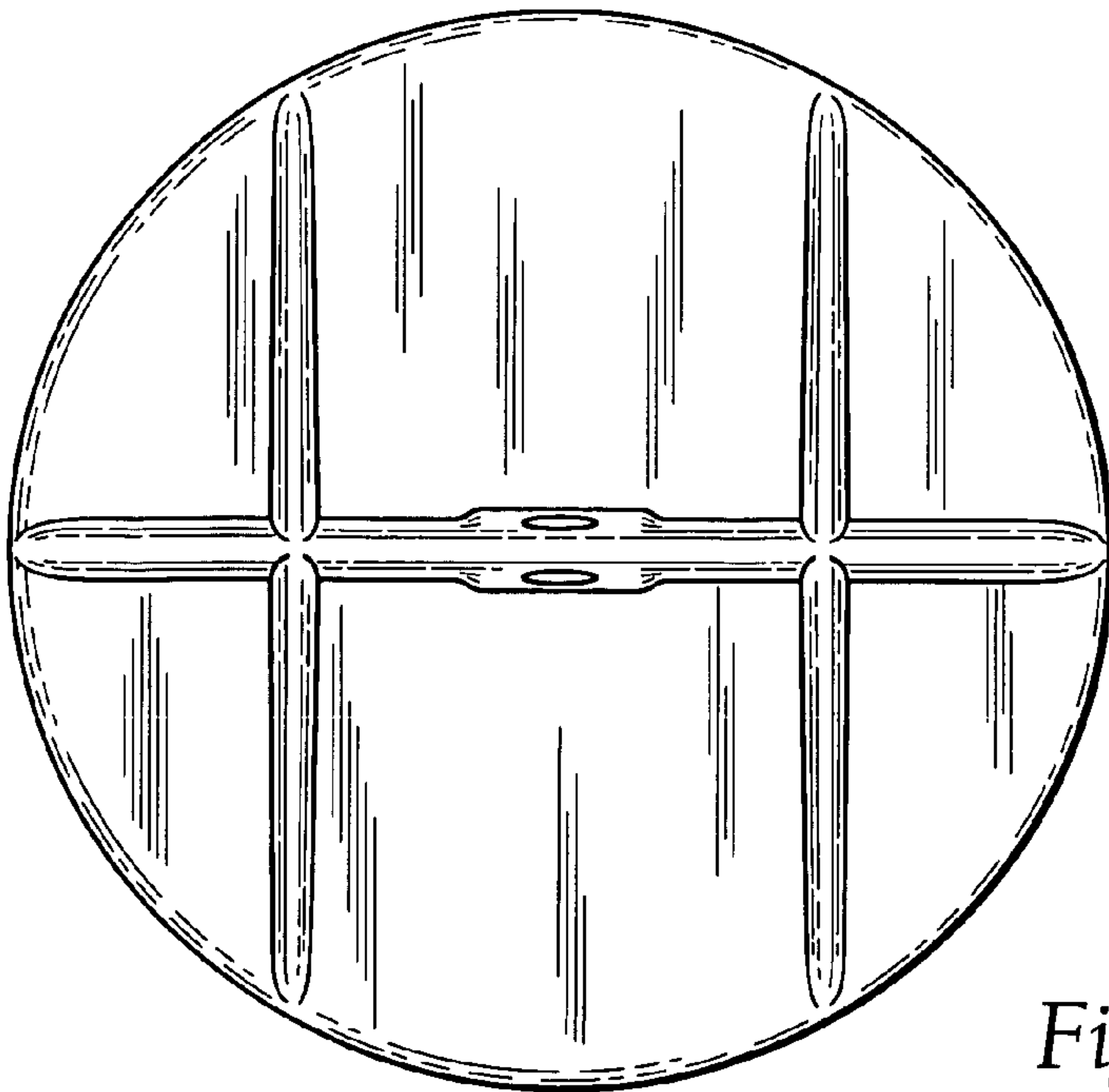

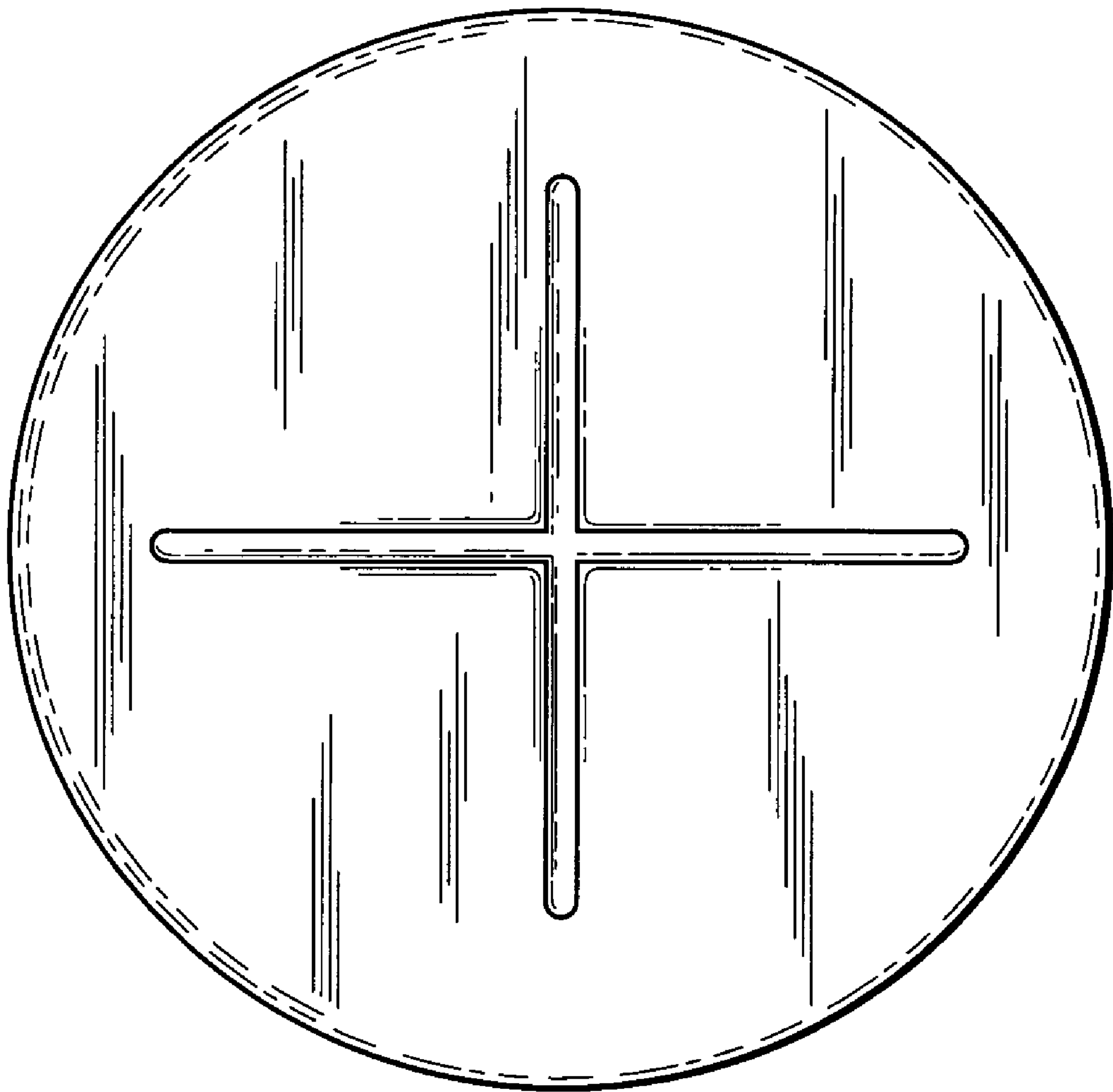
