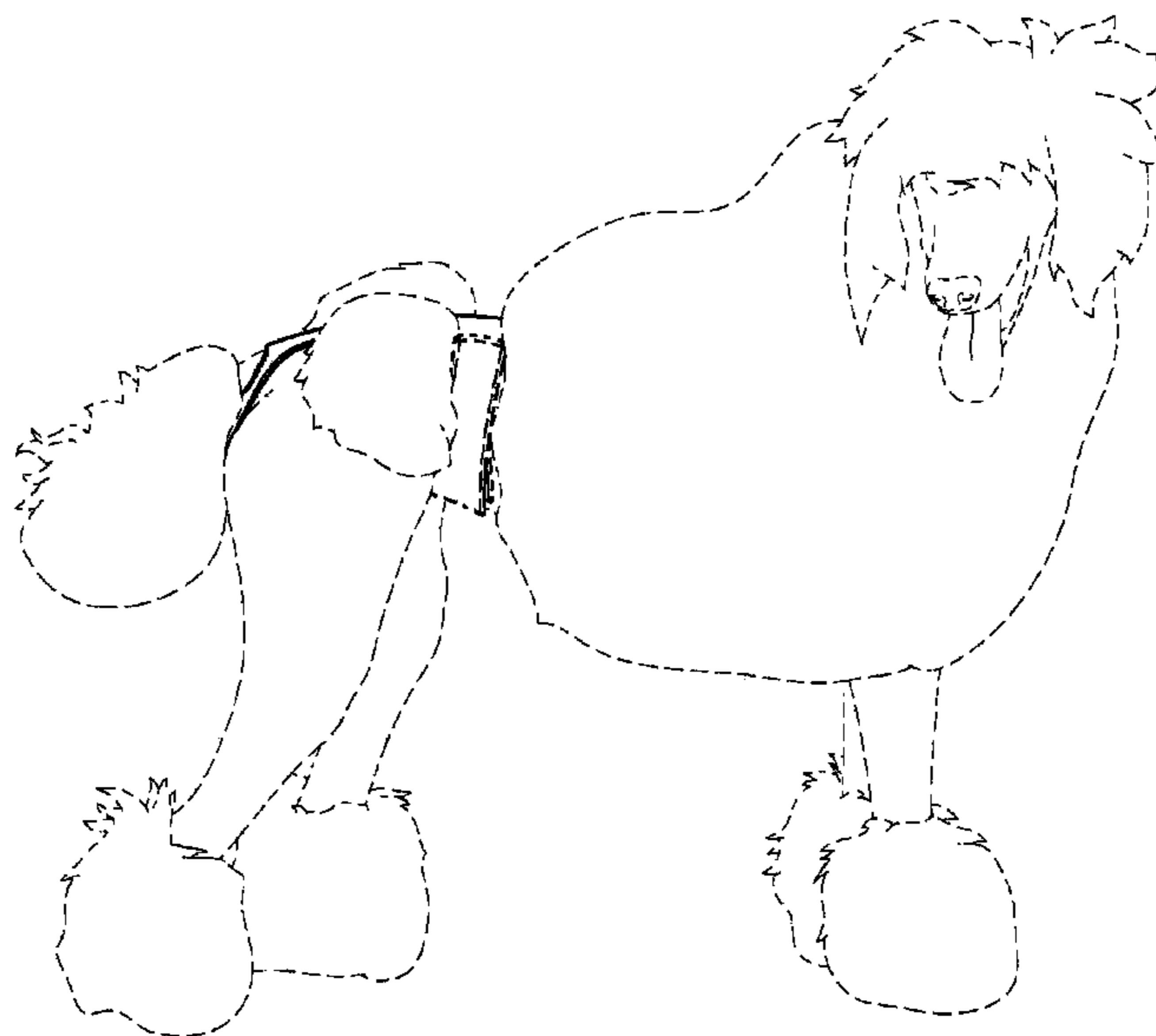
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an animal pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 depicts the animal pad as shown worn on a canine. FIG. 2 is a view of a first-side of the animal pad; and, FIG. 3 is a view of a second-side of the animal pad. The broken lines in FIGS. 1-3 show exemplary structures of the animal pad that do not form a part of the claimed design.

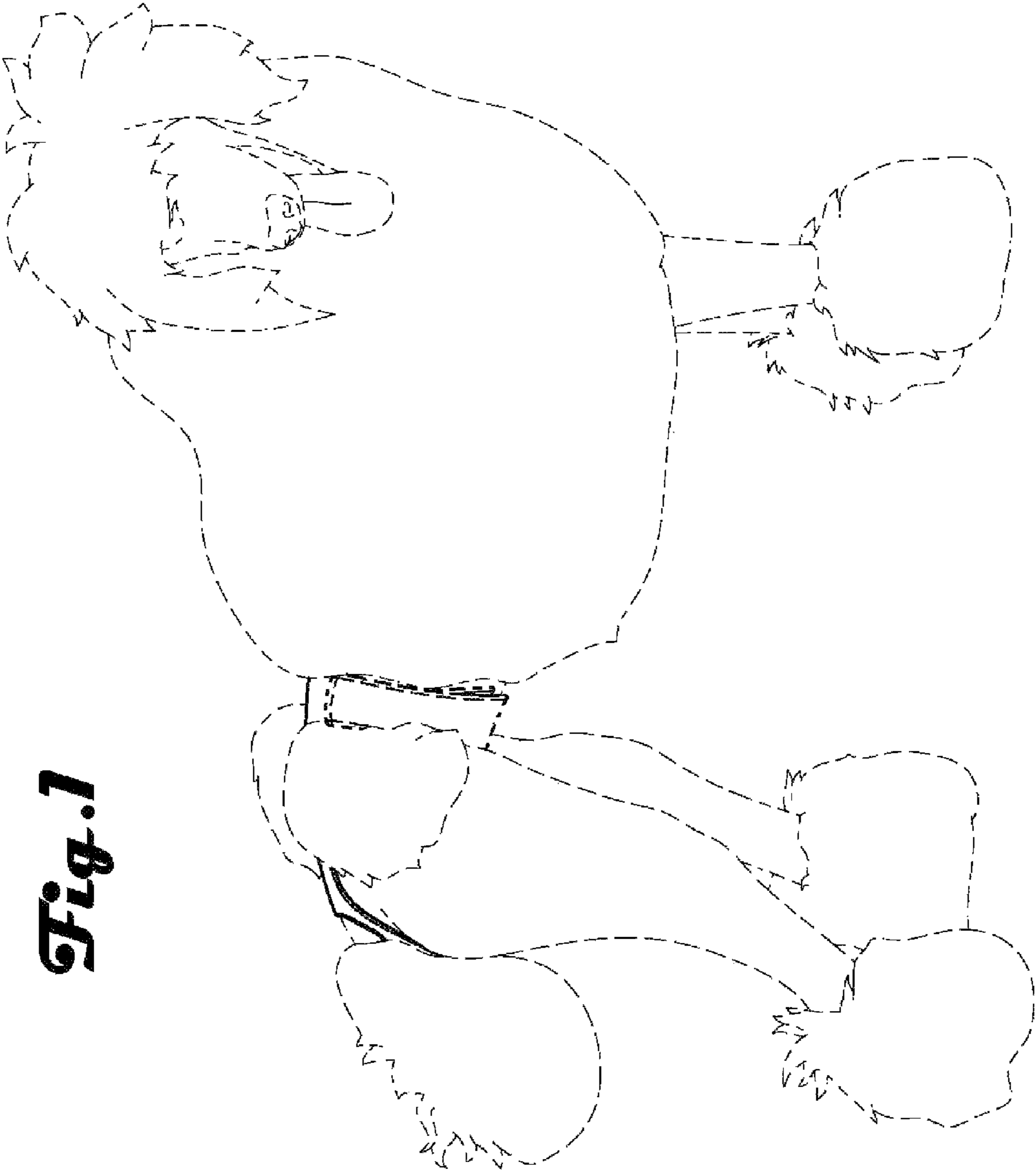

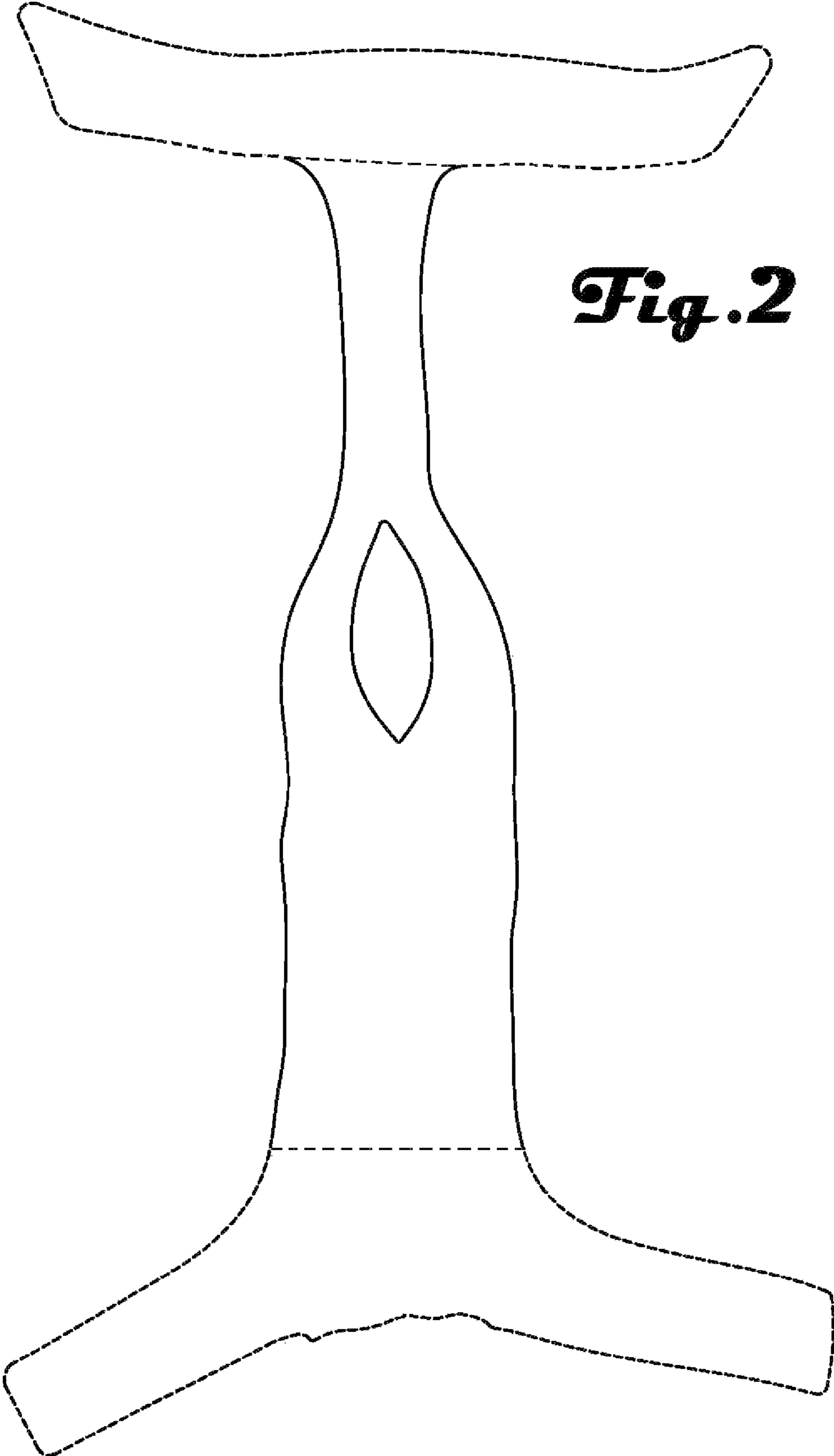

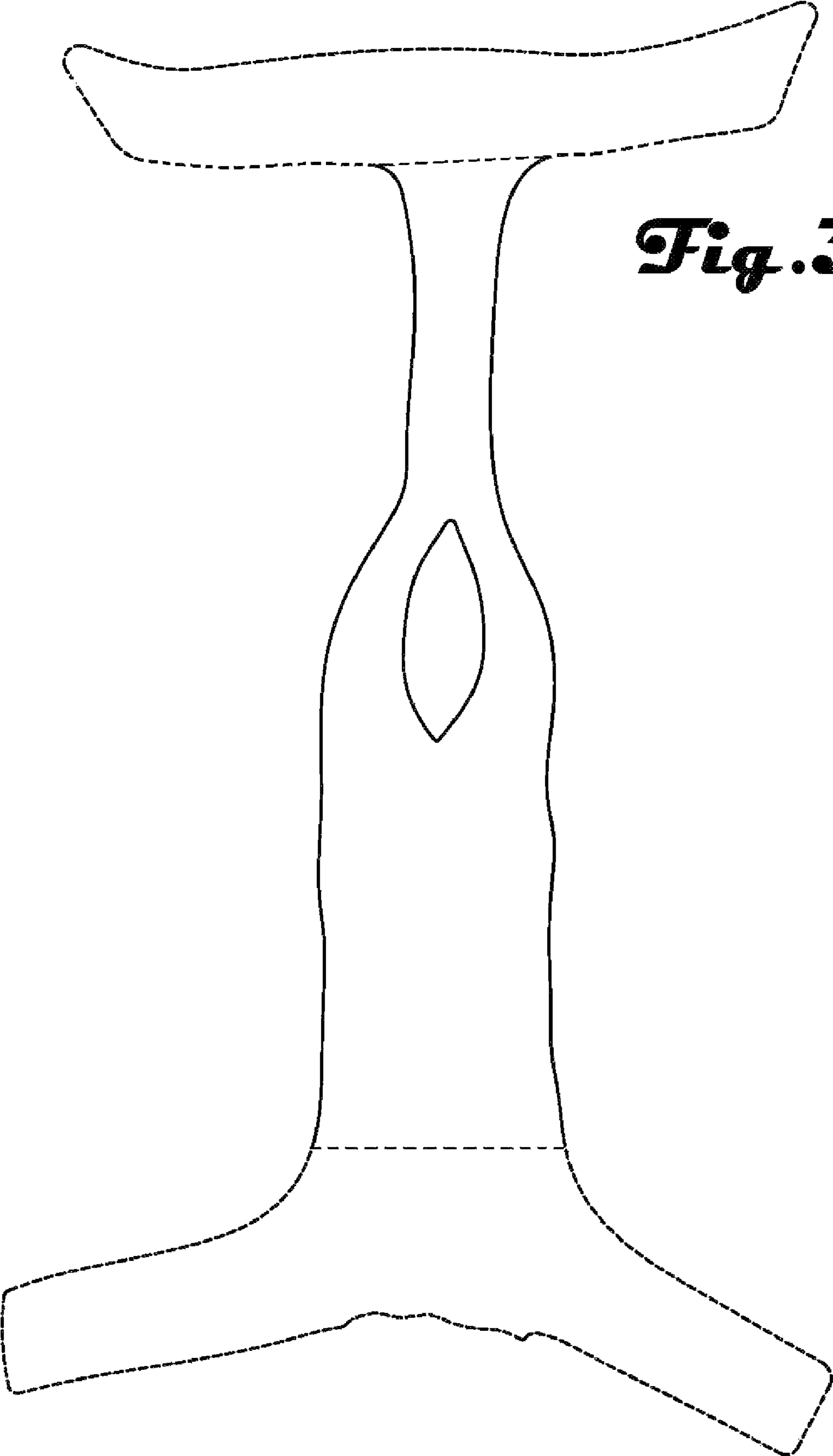
