FIG. 1 is a front view of a flag;

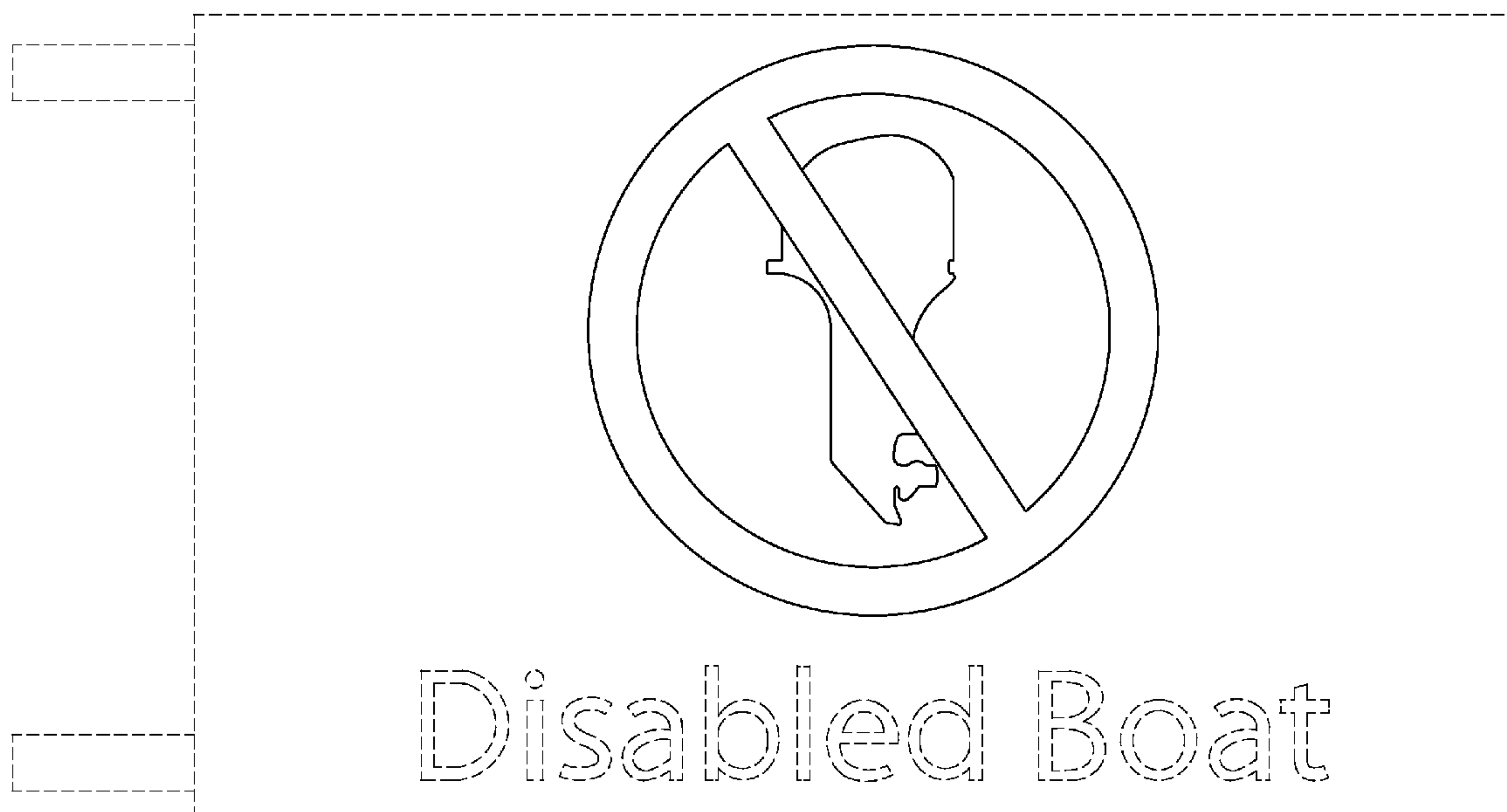
FIG. 2 is a top view of the design of FIG. 1, where the bottom

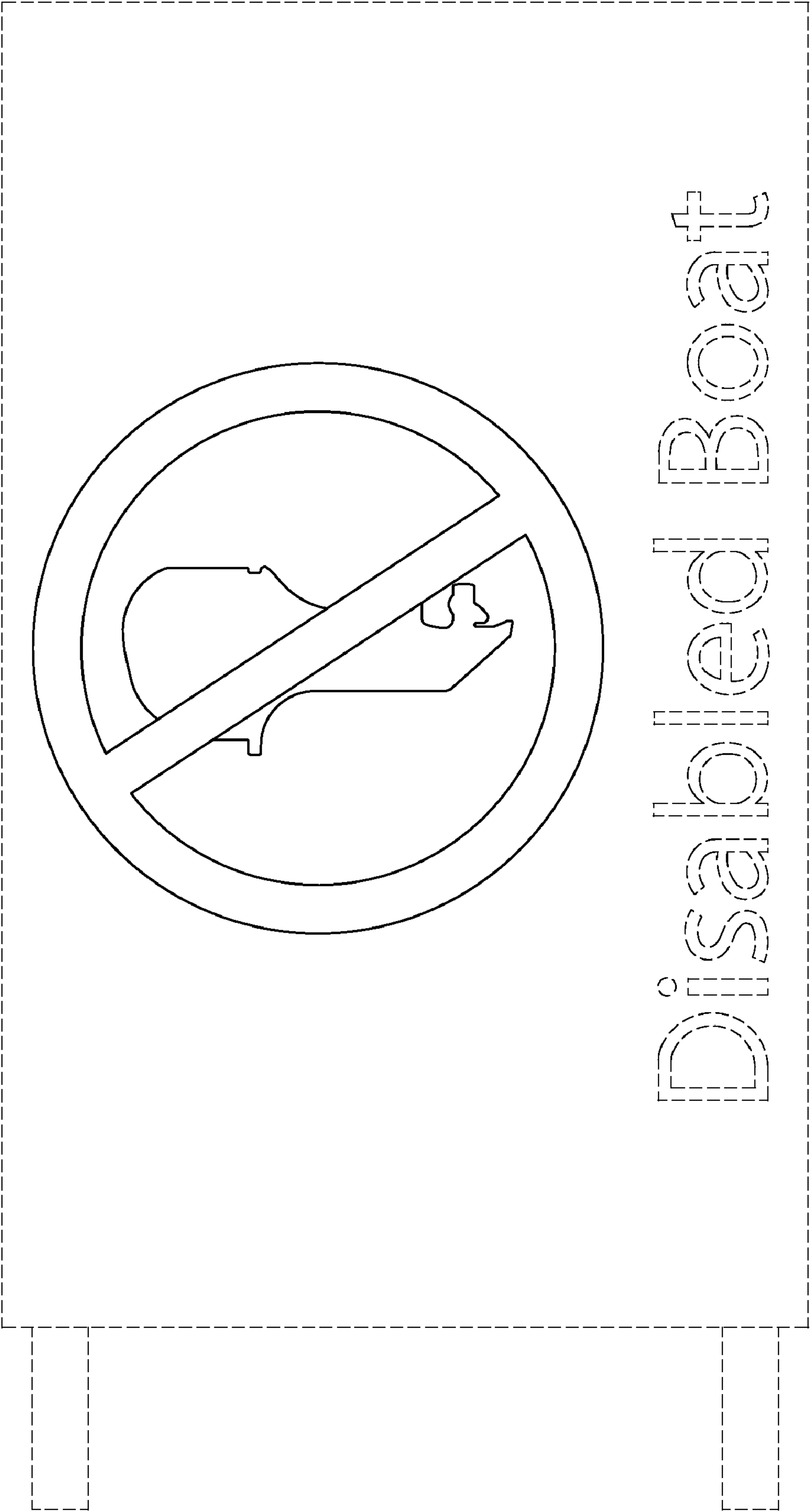

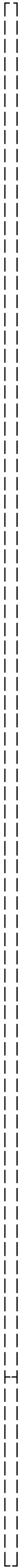

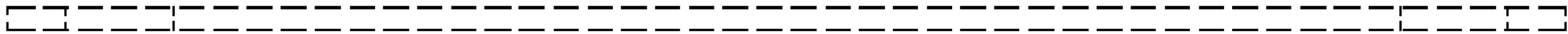

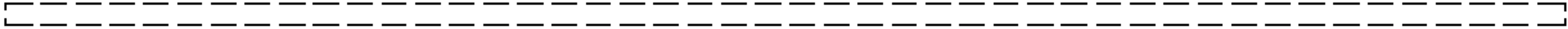
