**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 15 is a right side view thereof; and,

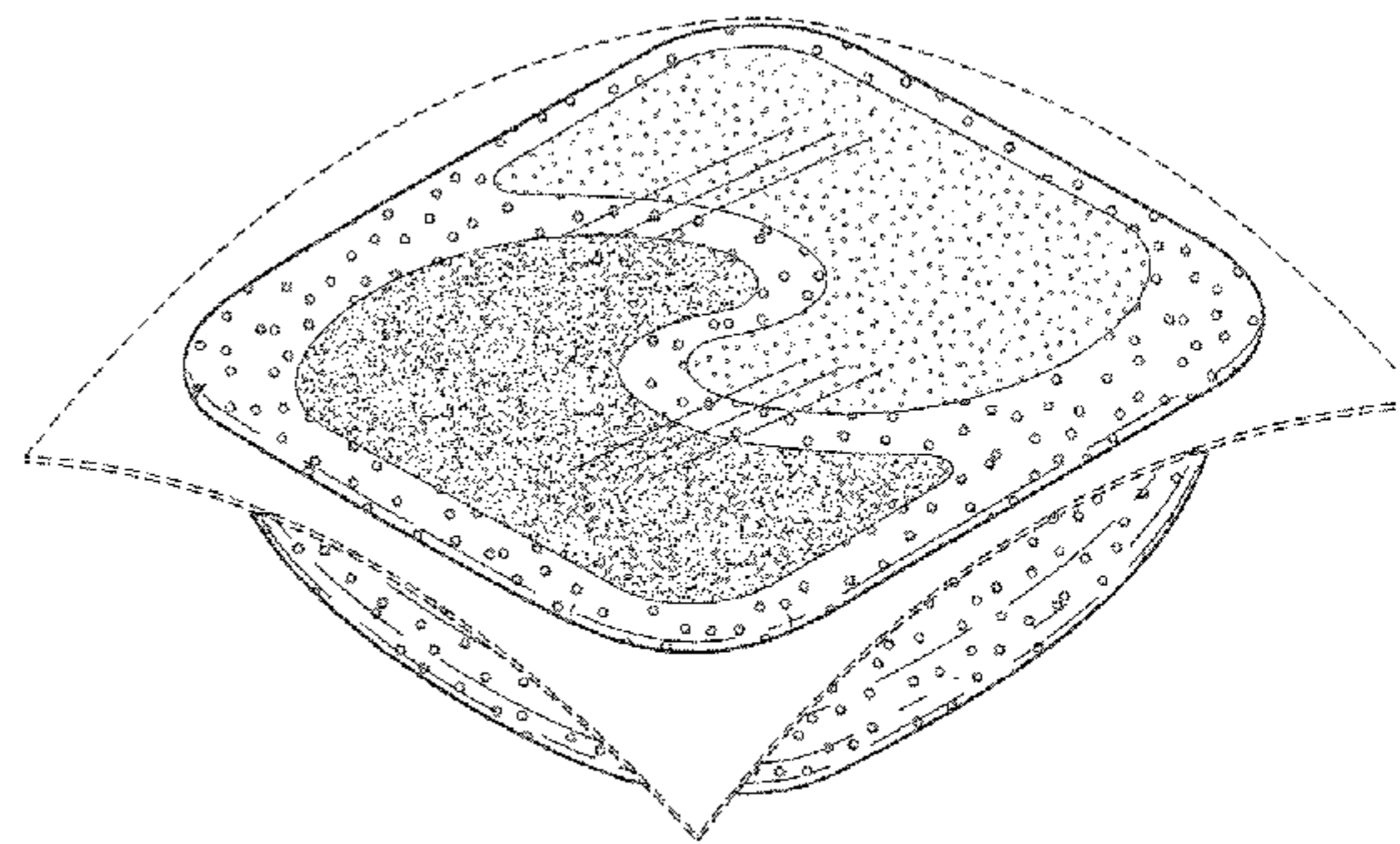
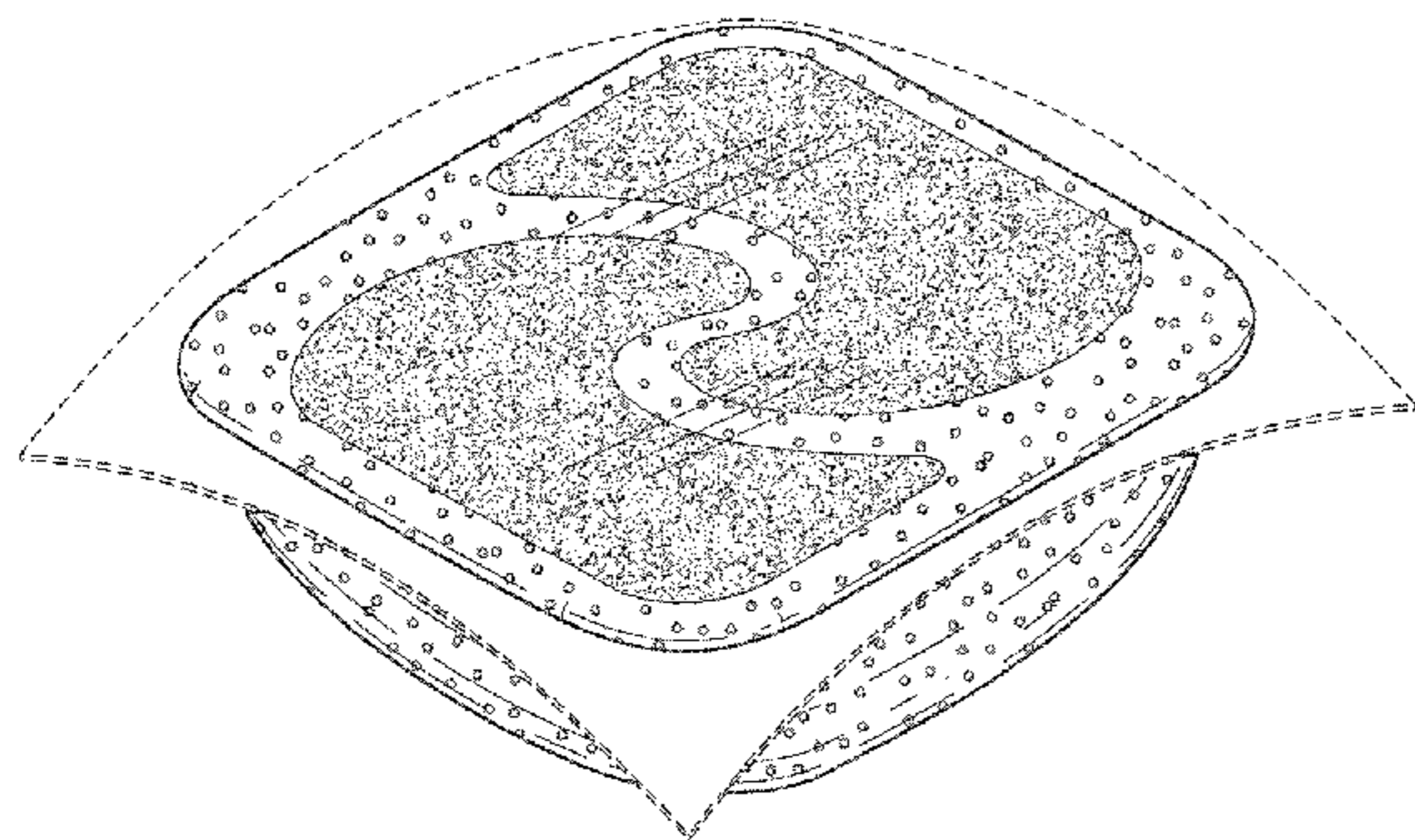
FIG. 16 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 16—16 in

The pouch of the present invention is transparent and may  
contain contrasting materials. The contrasting materials may  
be cleaning compositions such as automatic dishwashing  
compositions.

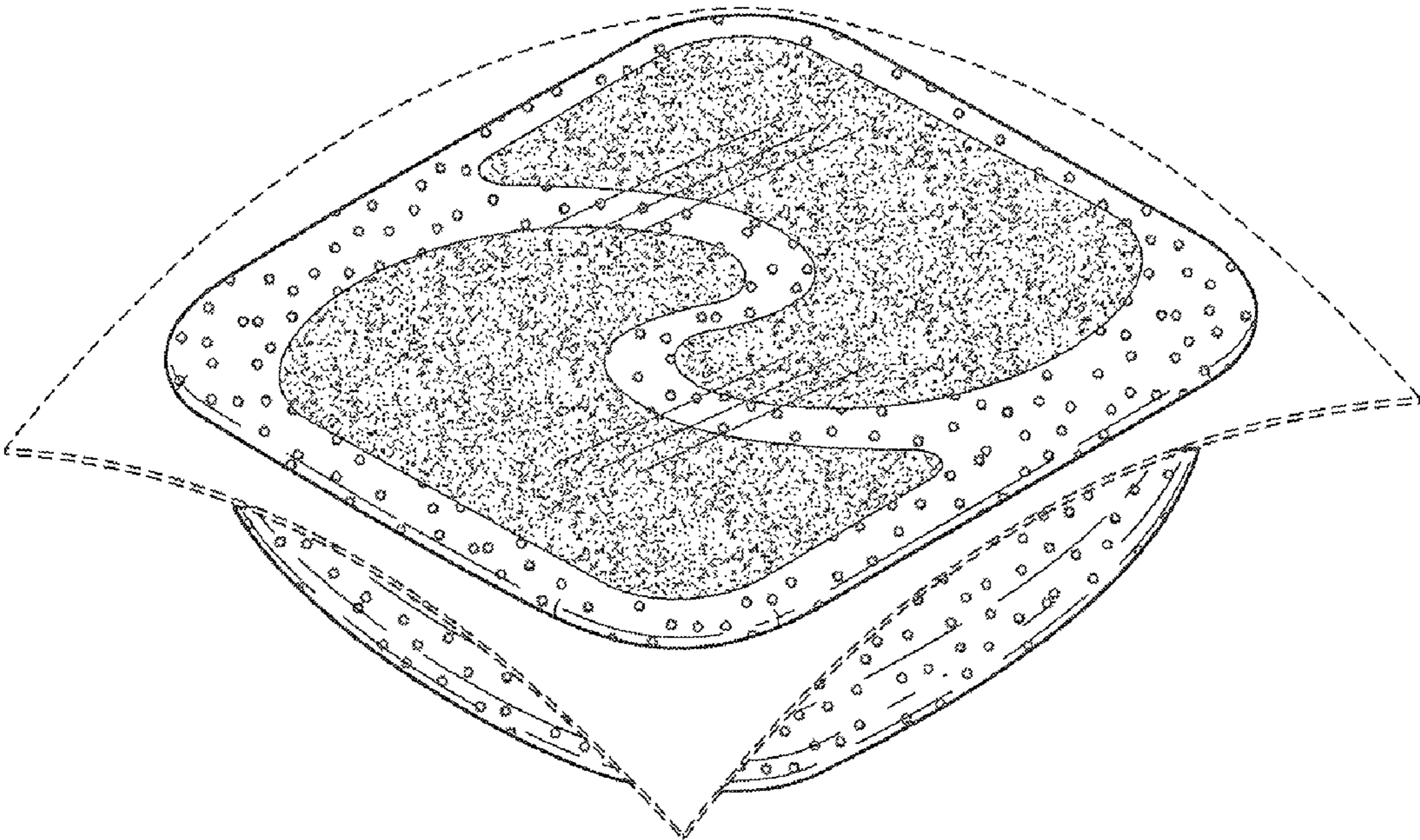

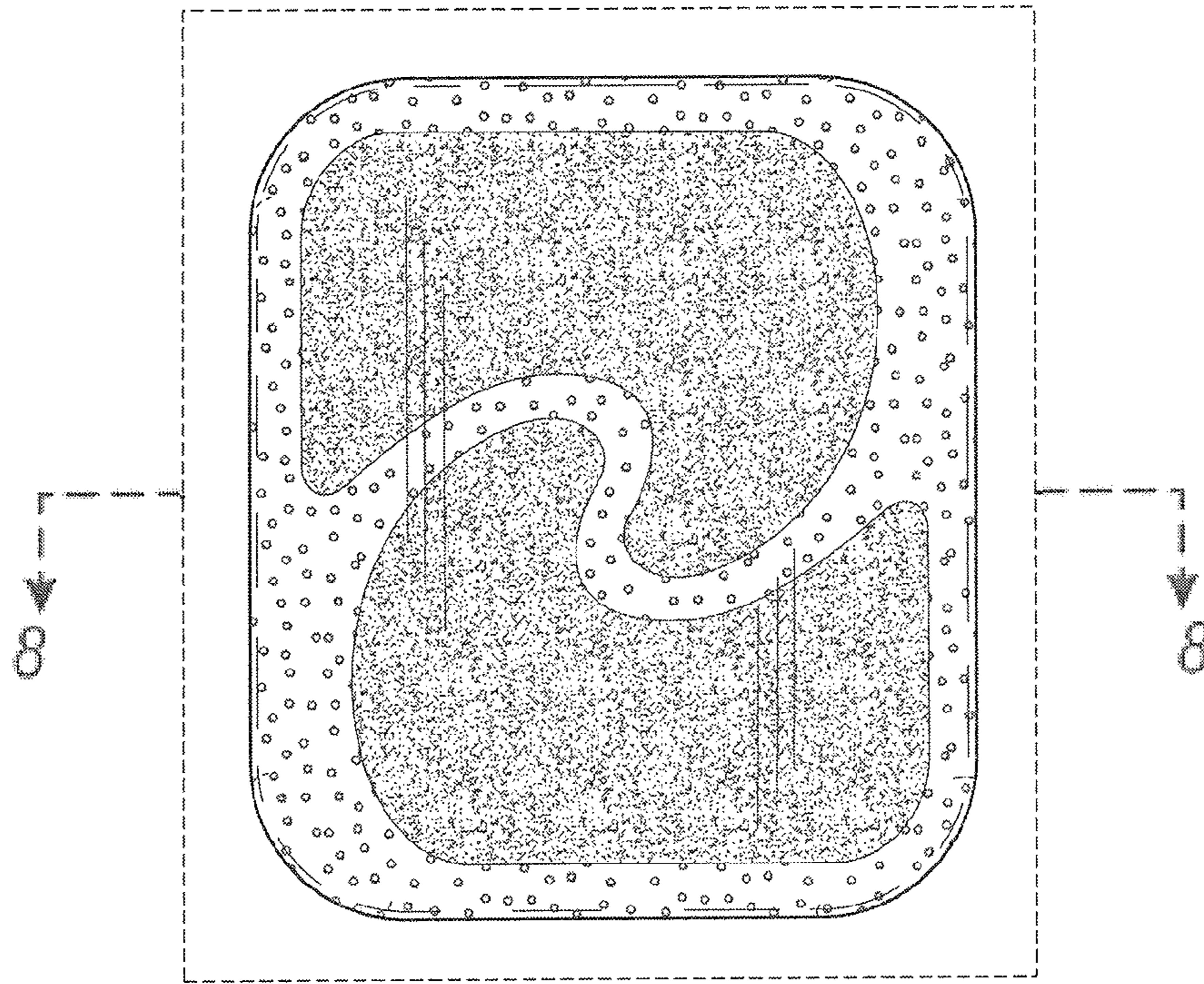

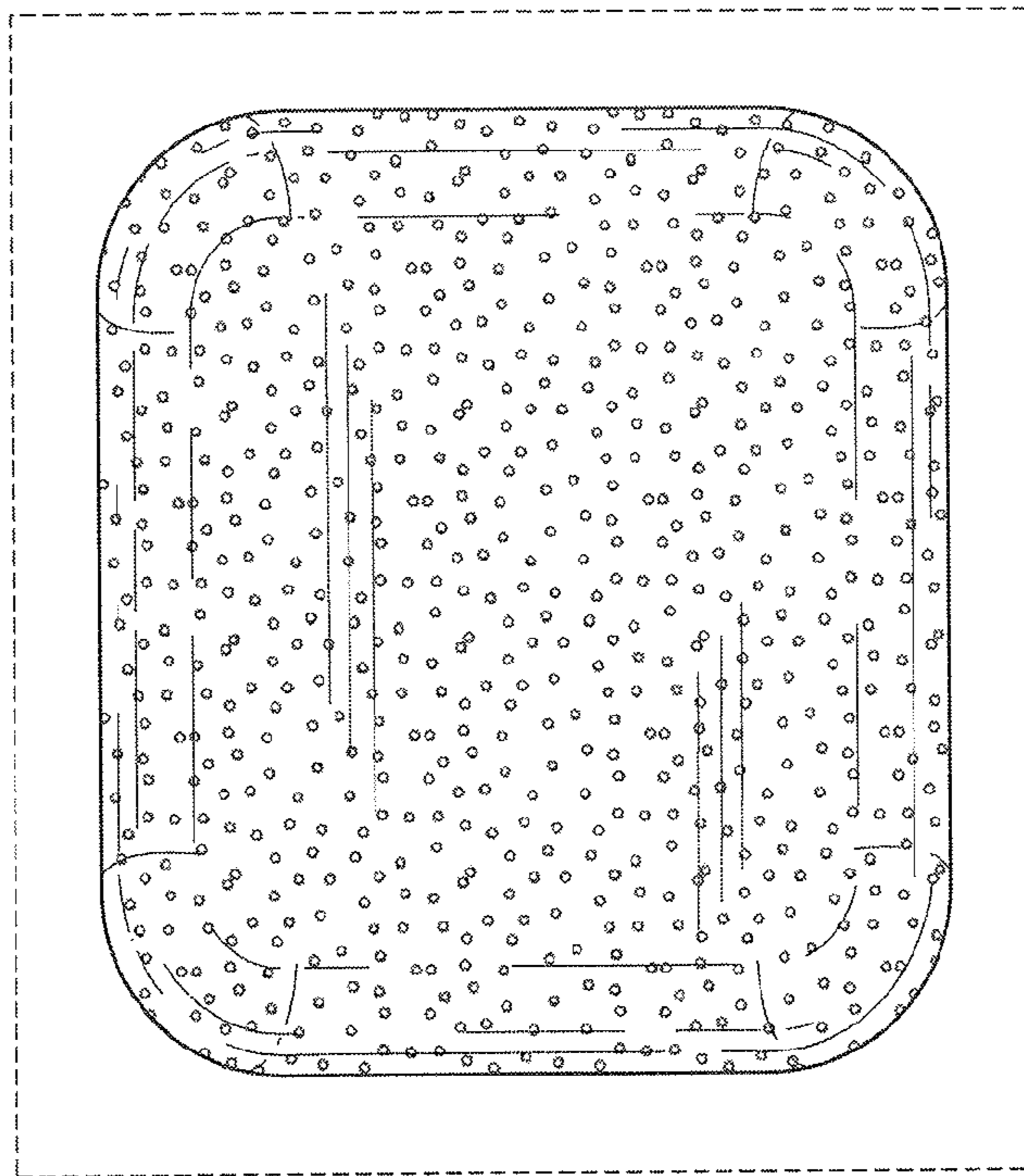
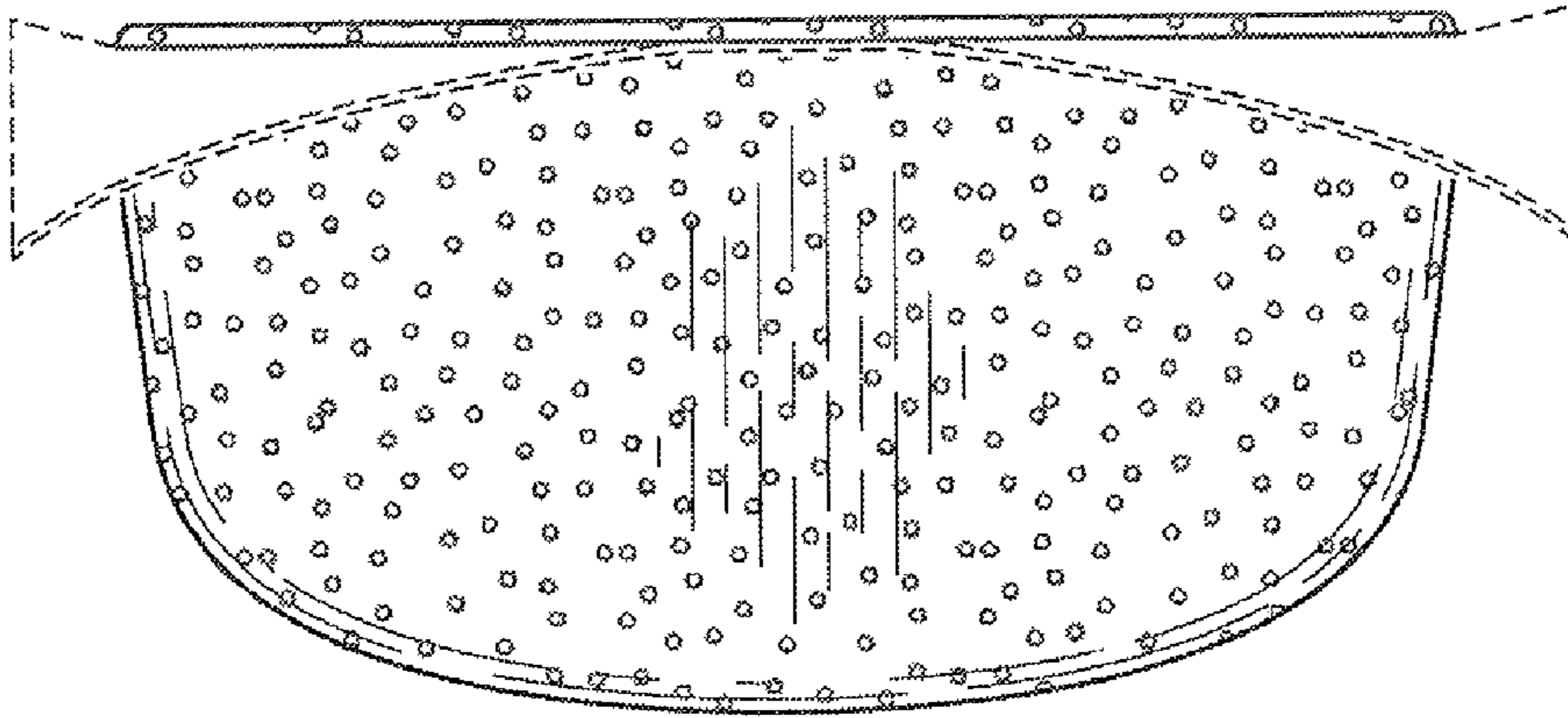
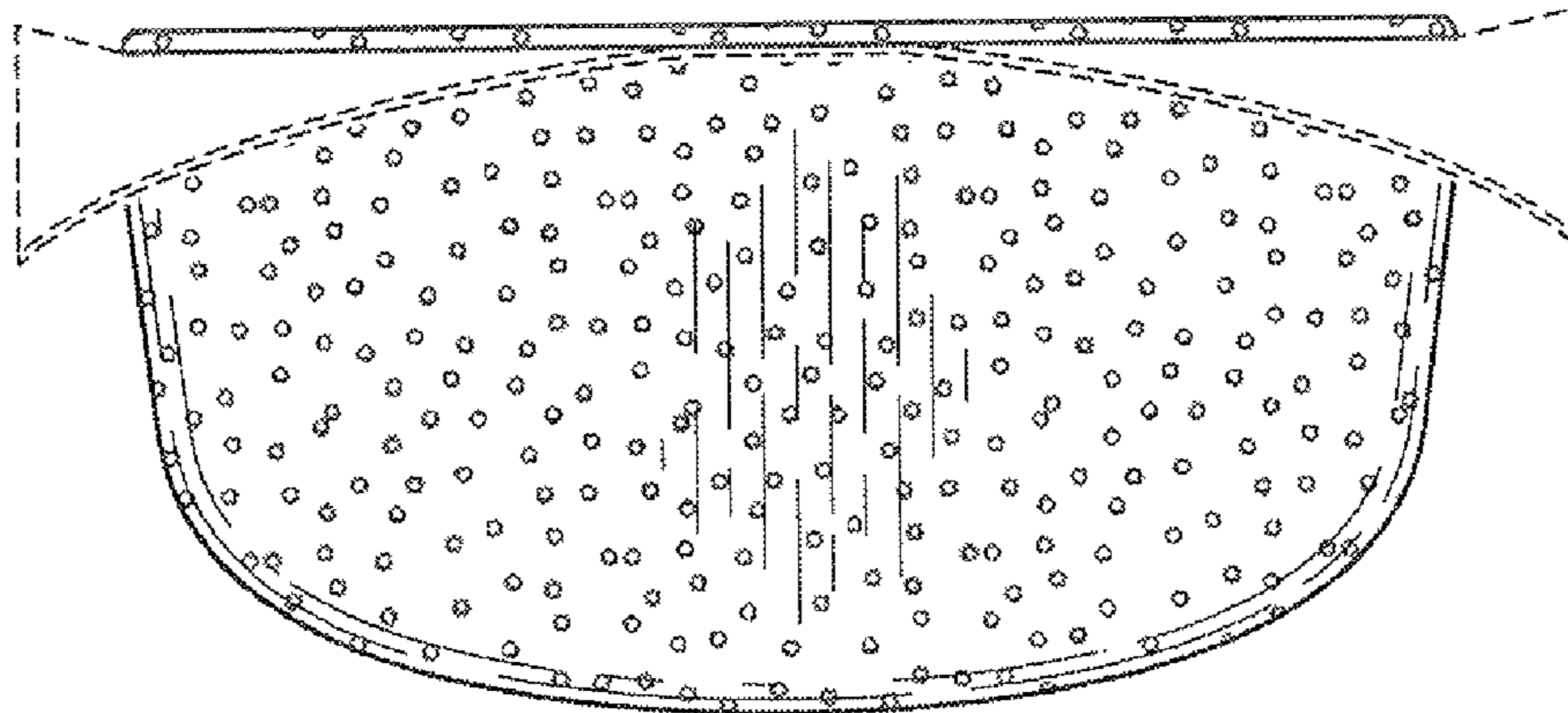


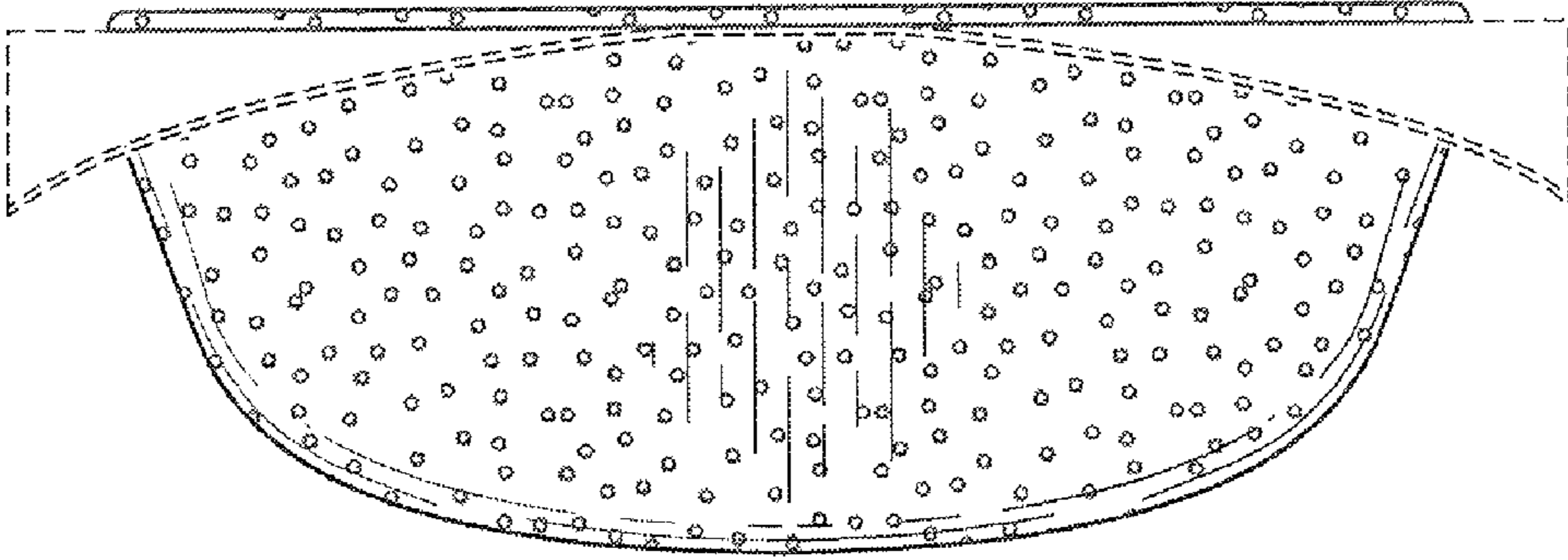

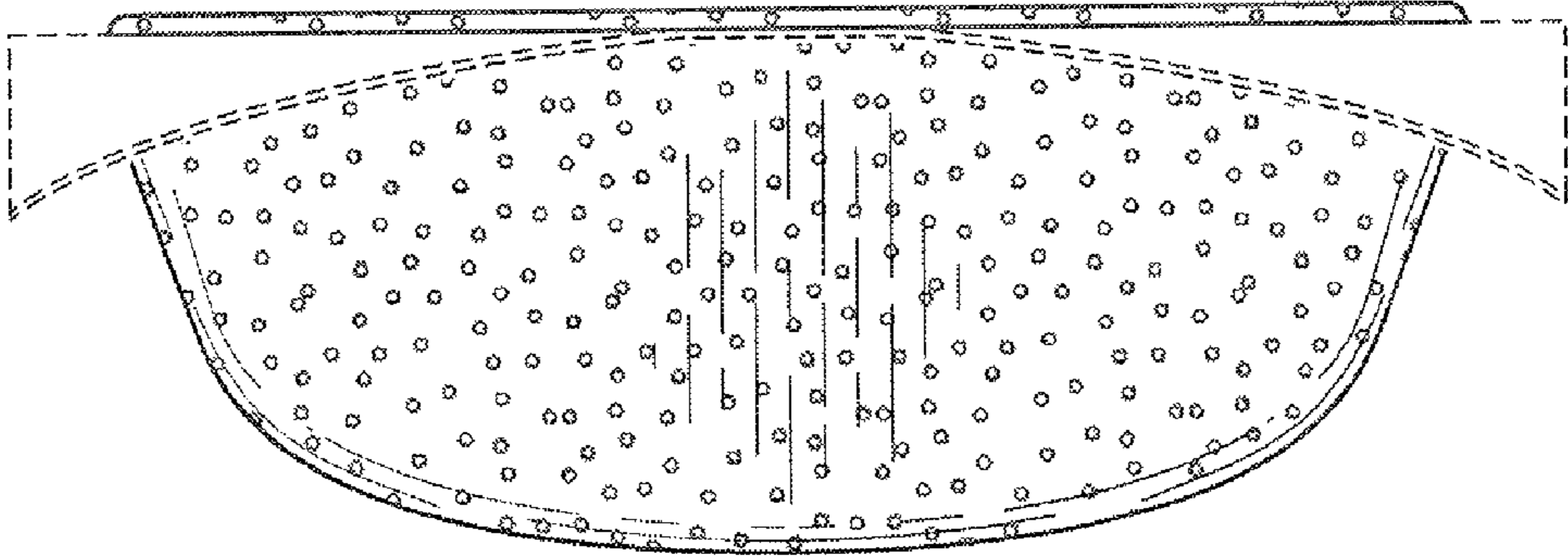

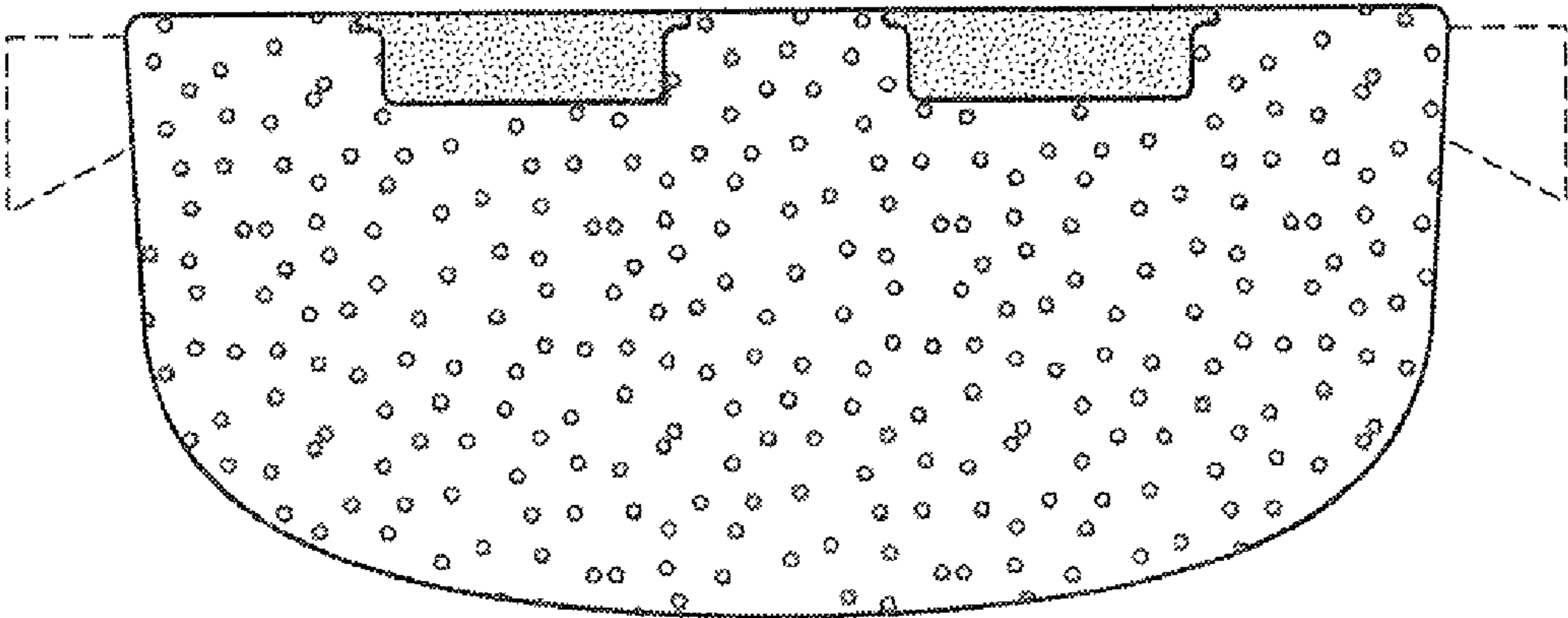

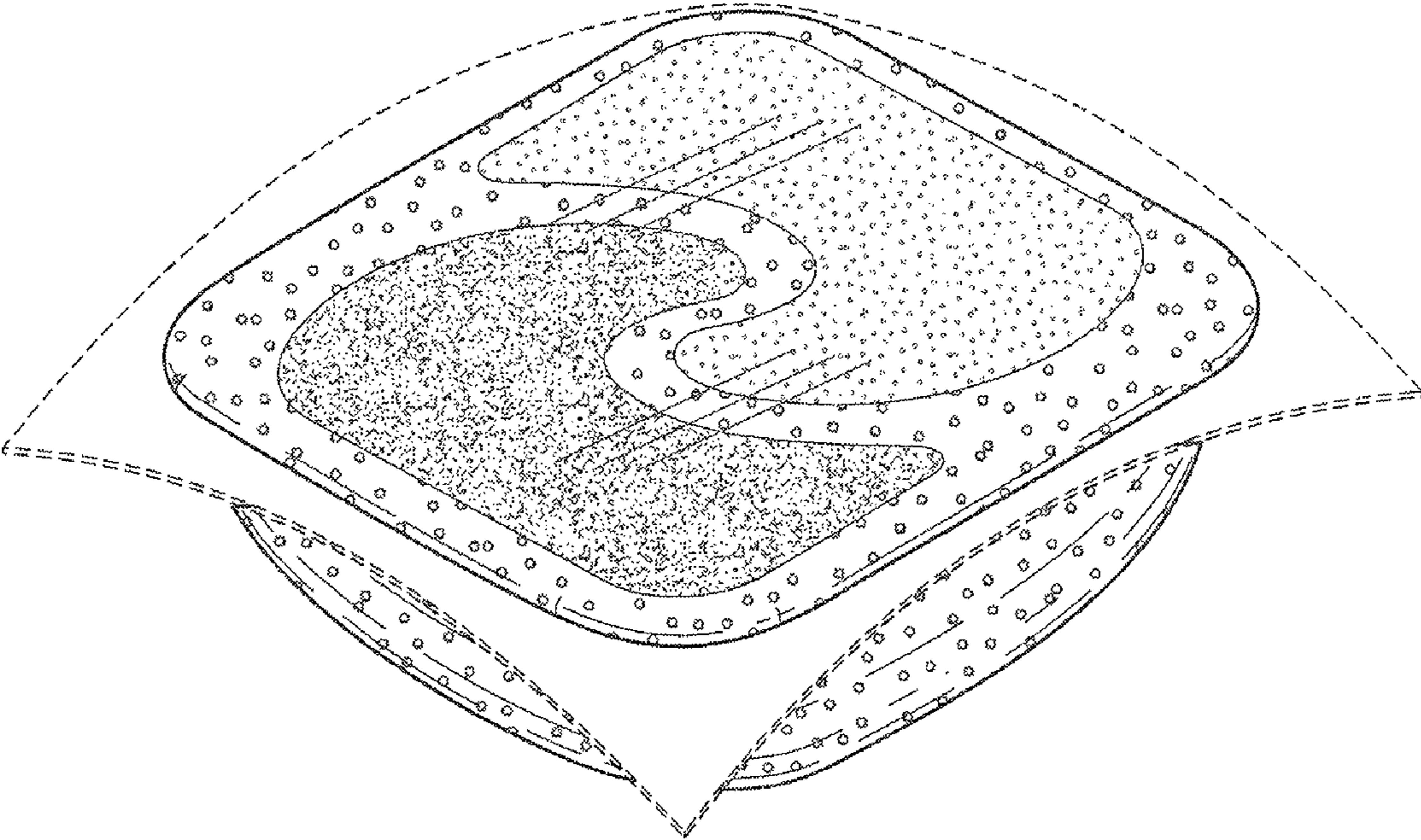

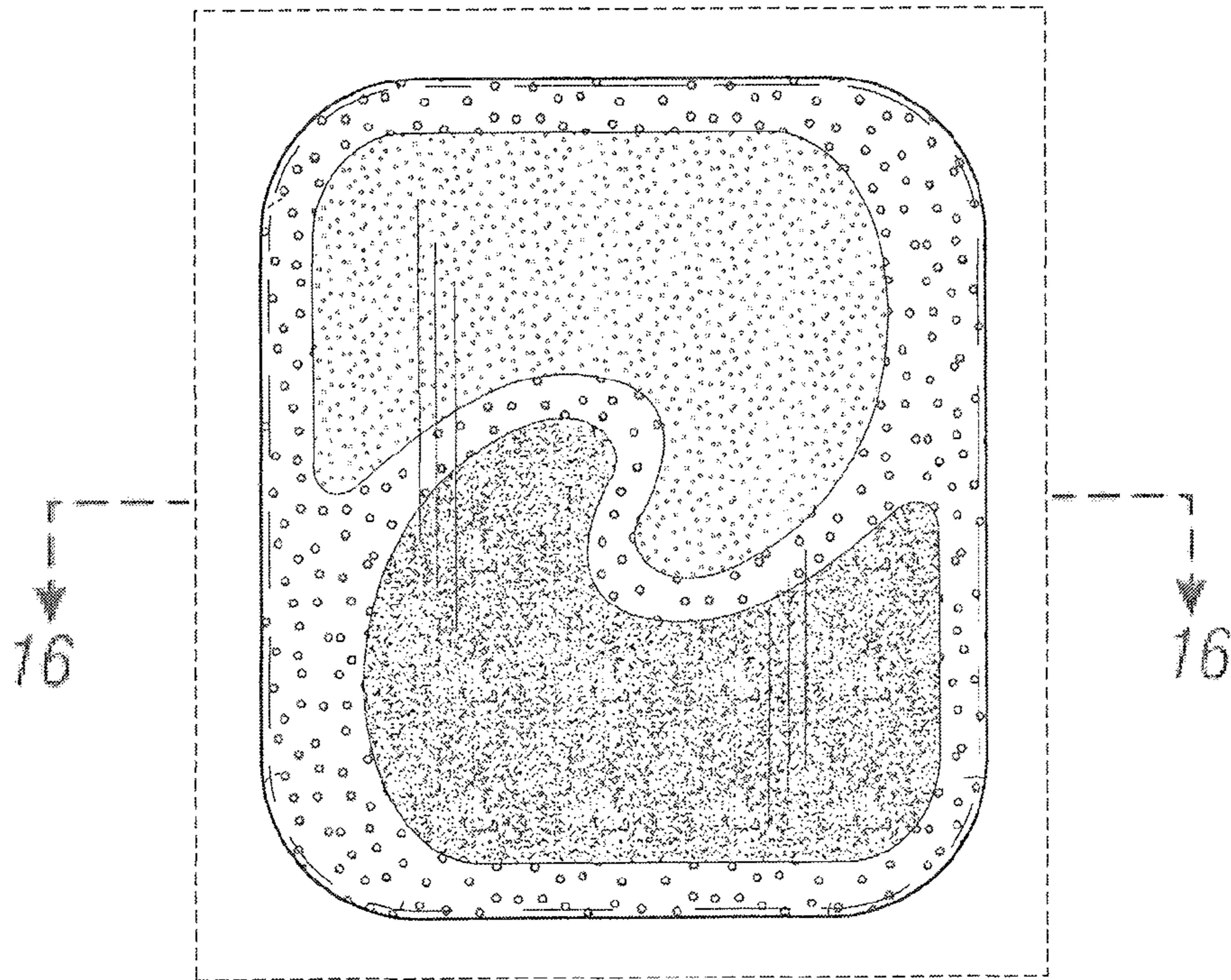

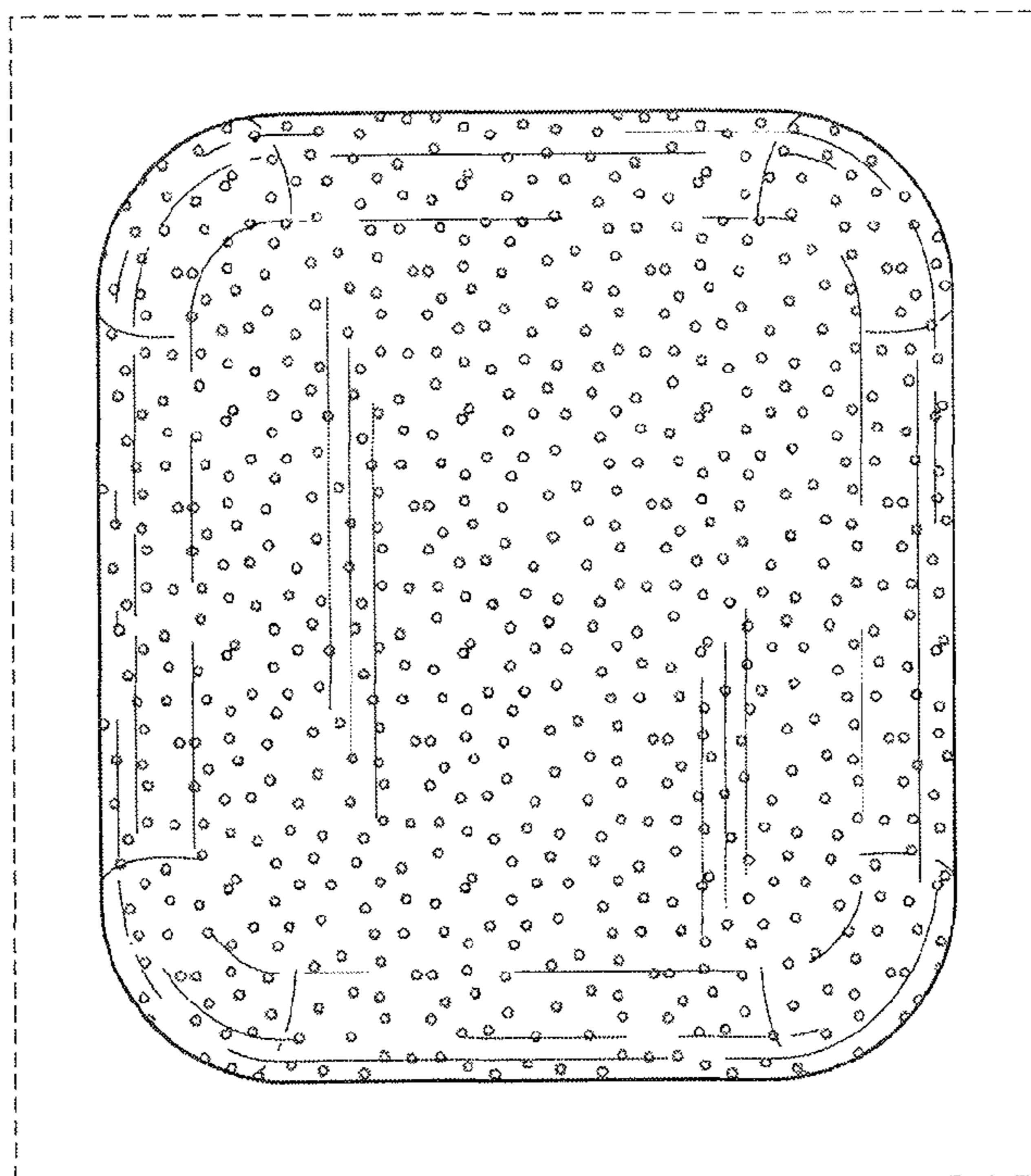
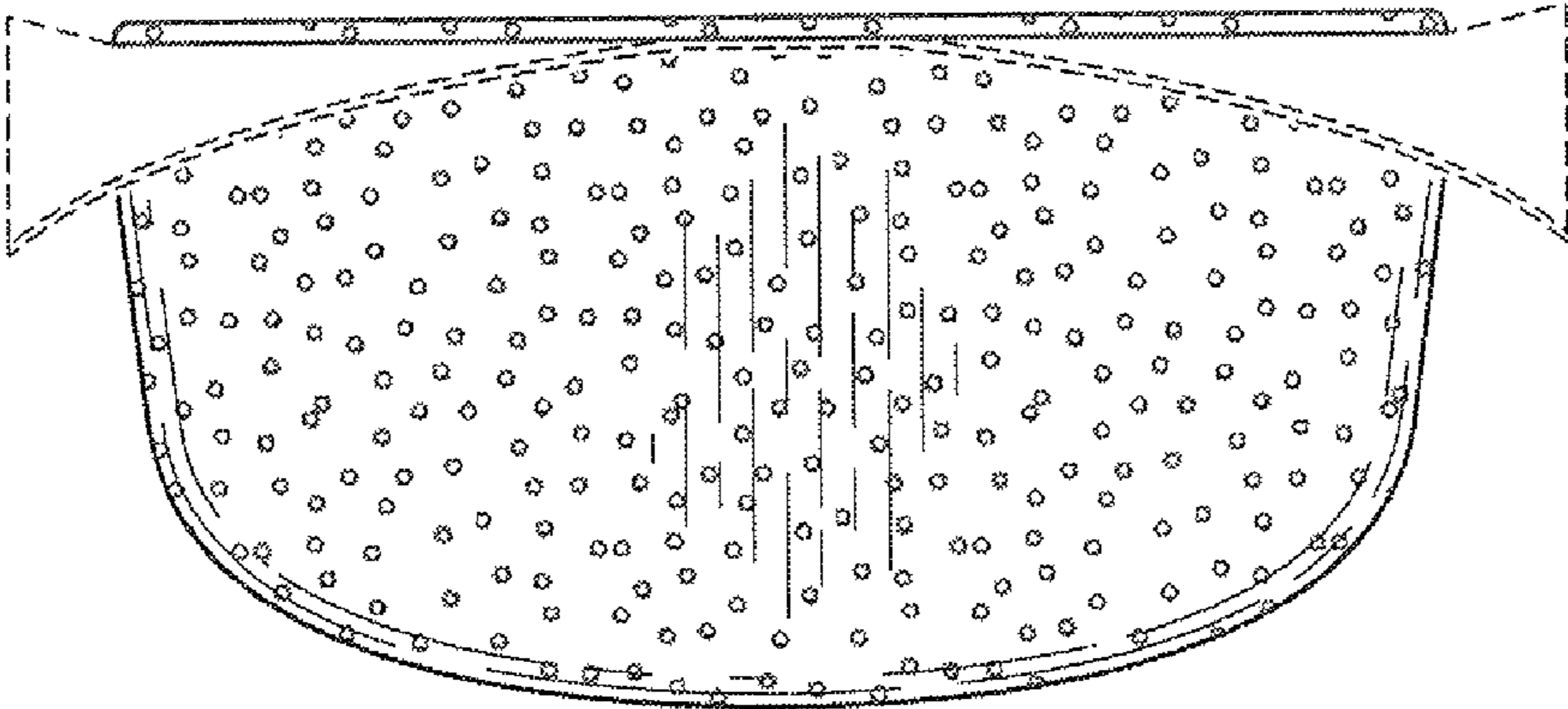
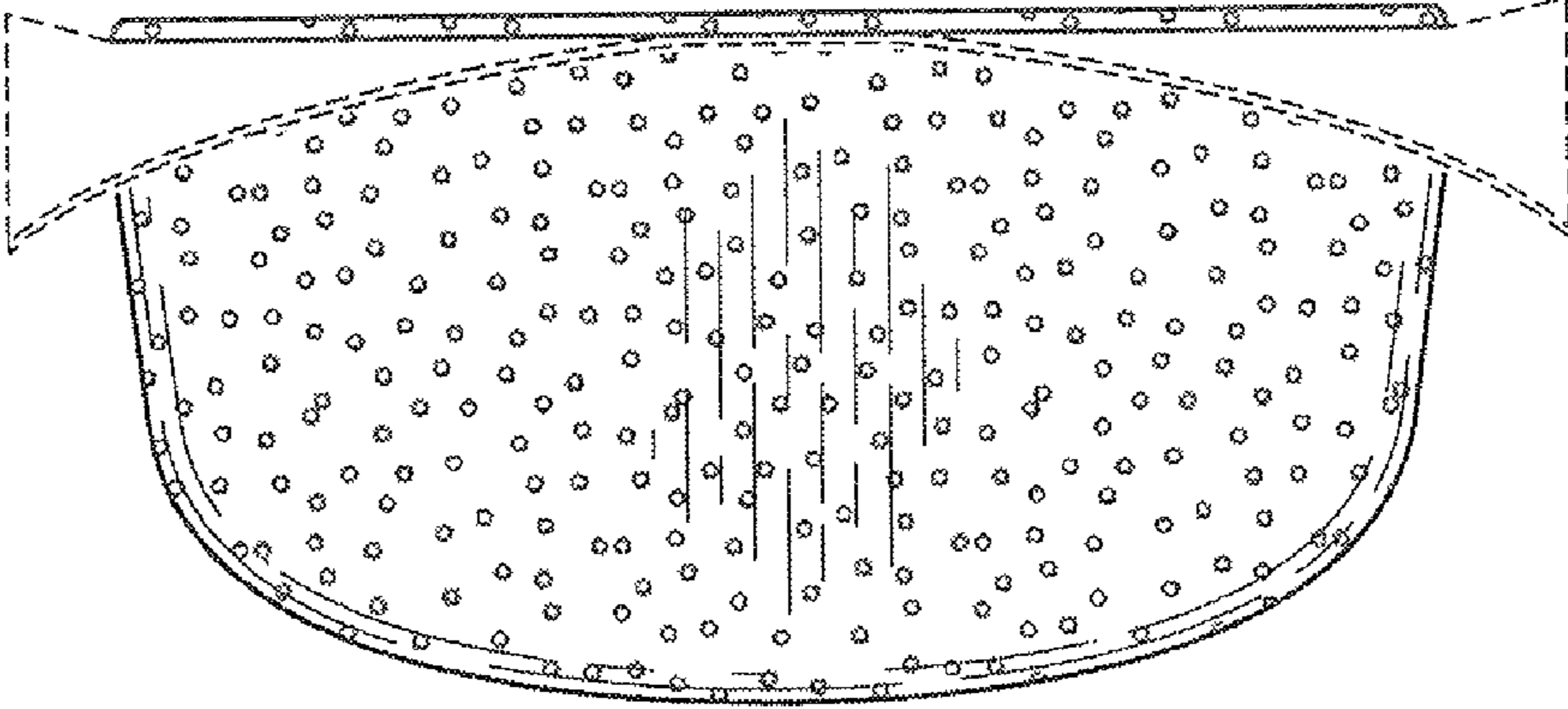


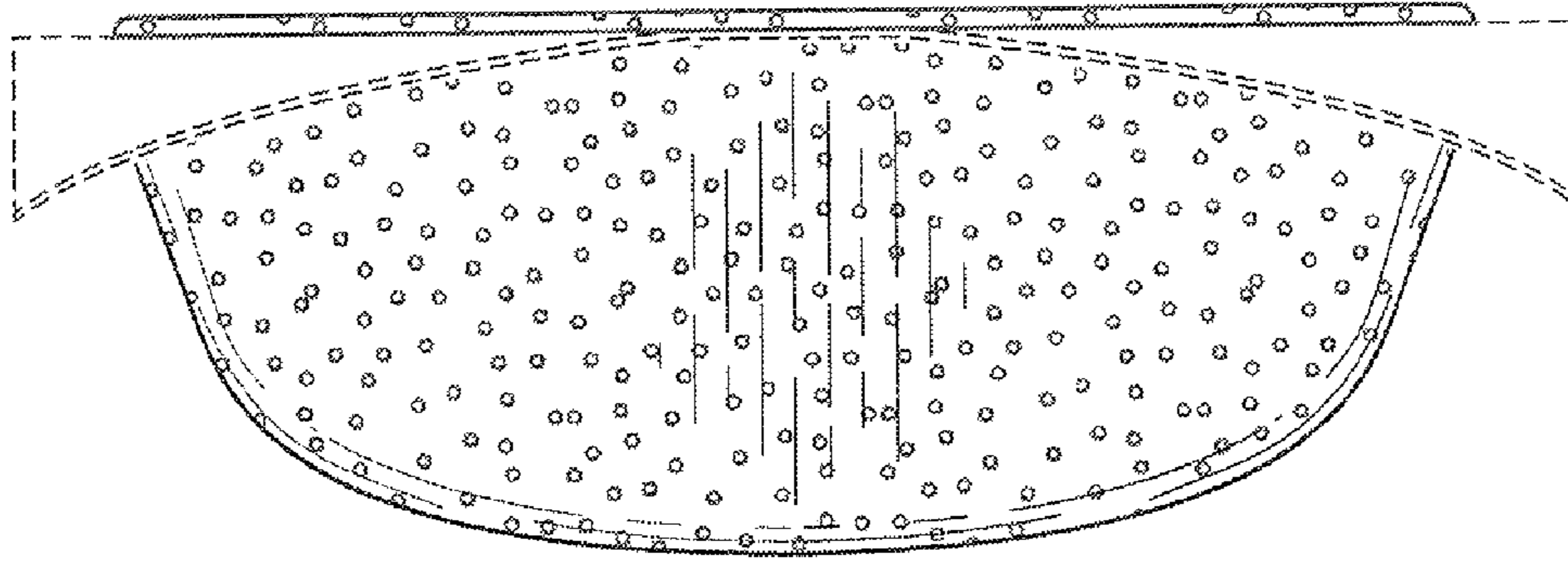

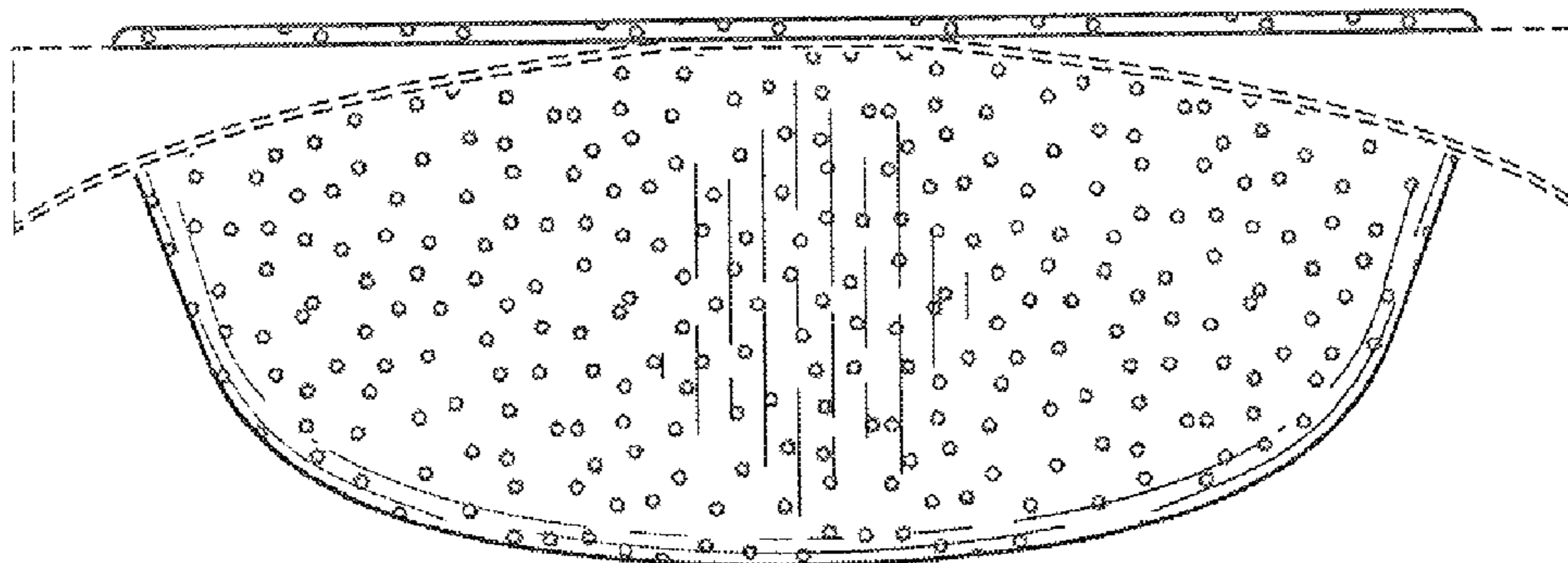

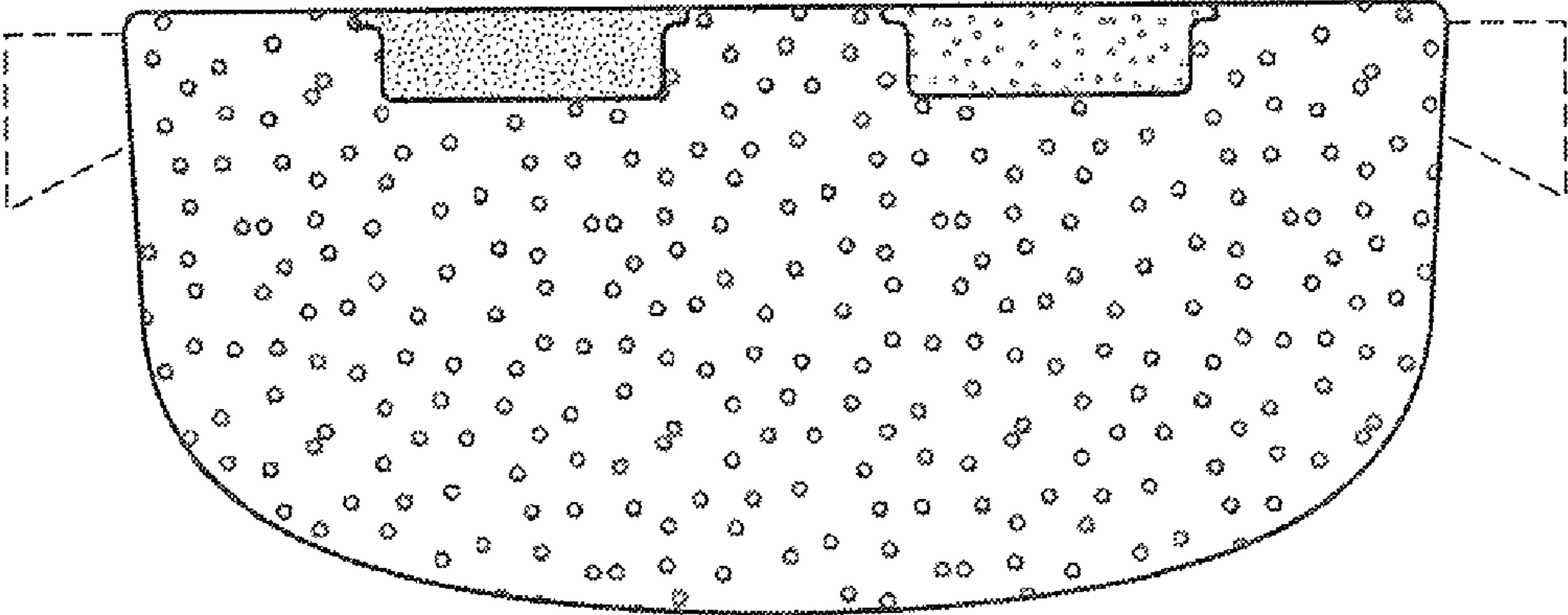
