FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof;

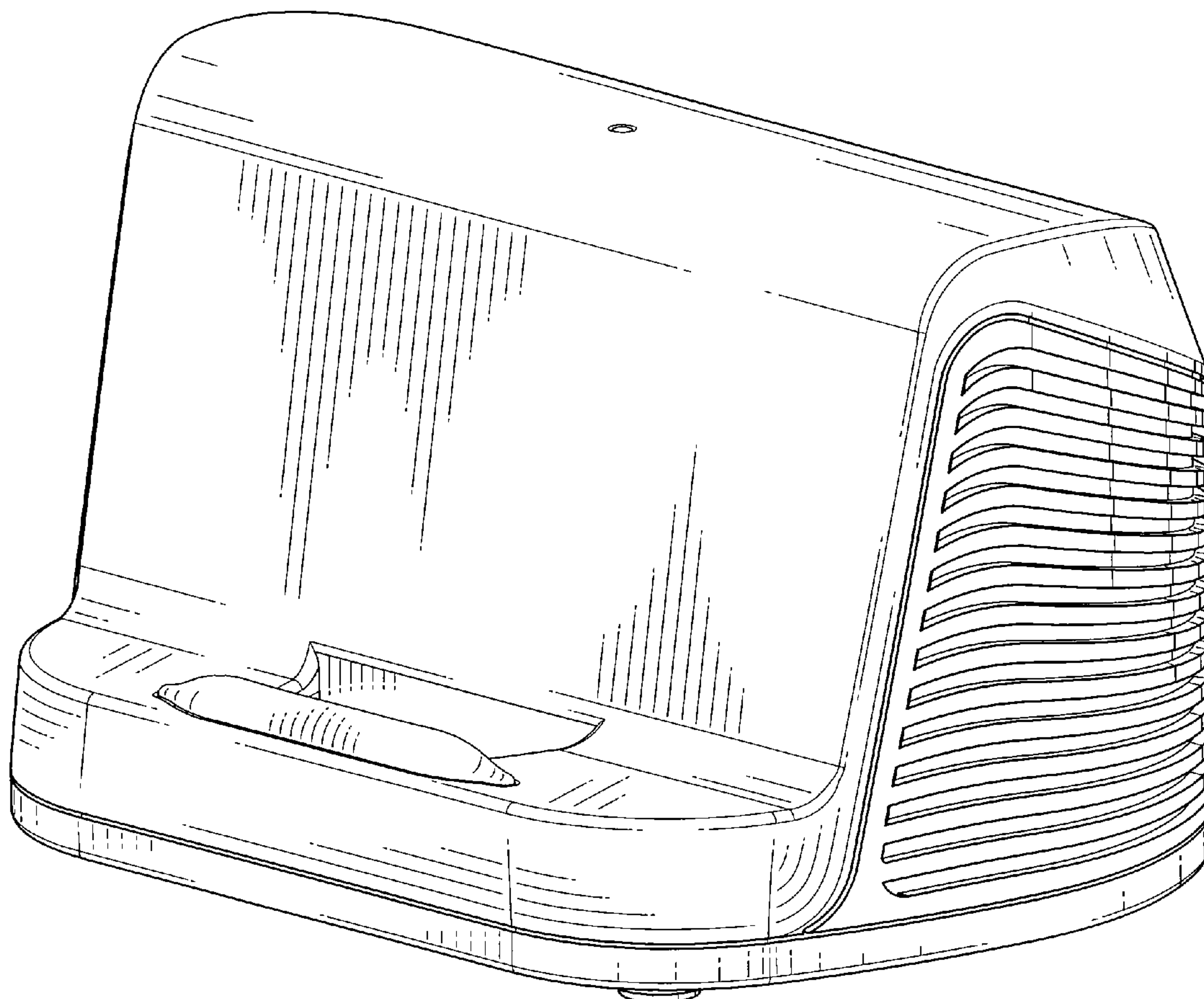
FIG. 7 is a side view thereof, the opposite side view being a mirror image;

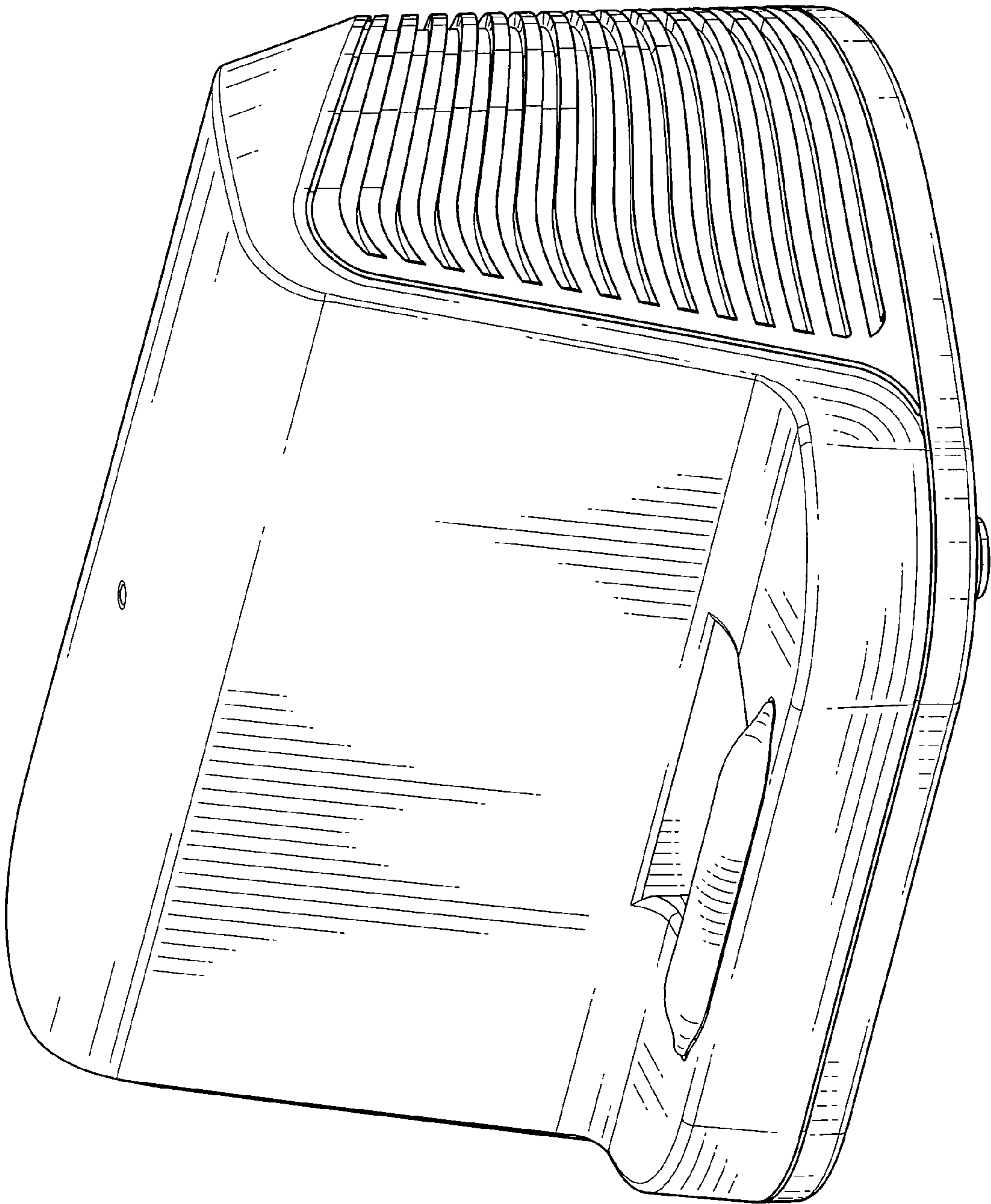

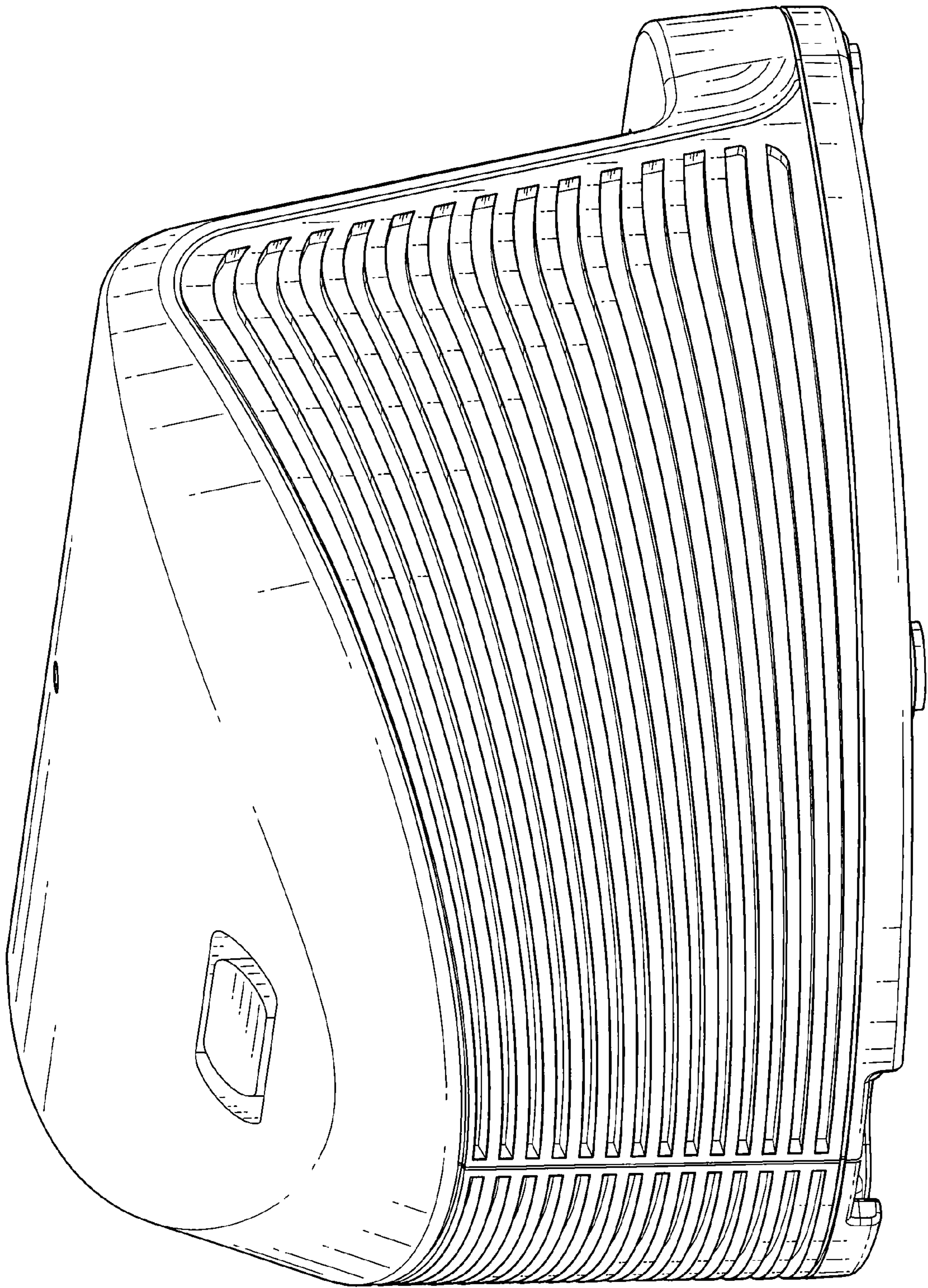
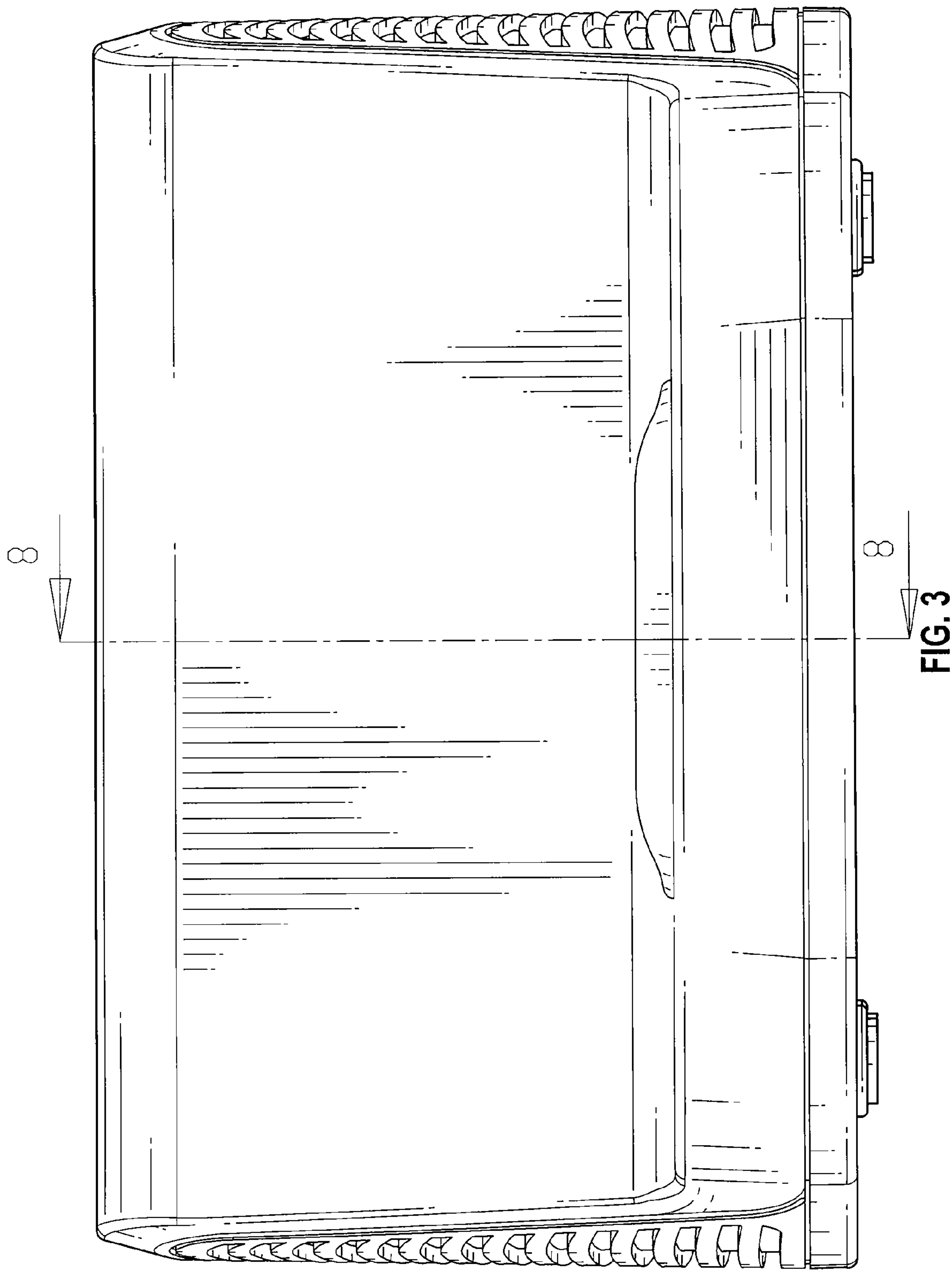

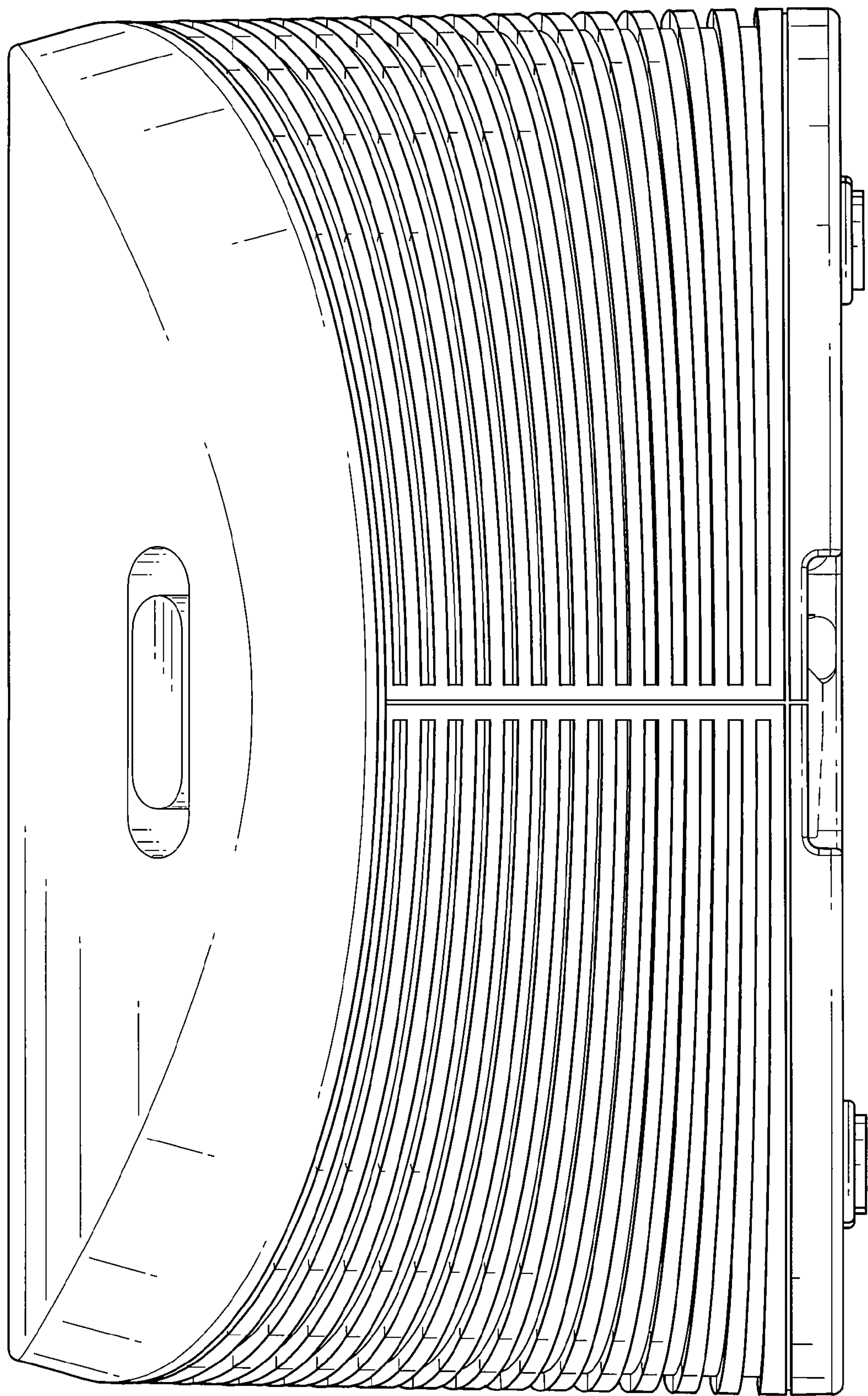

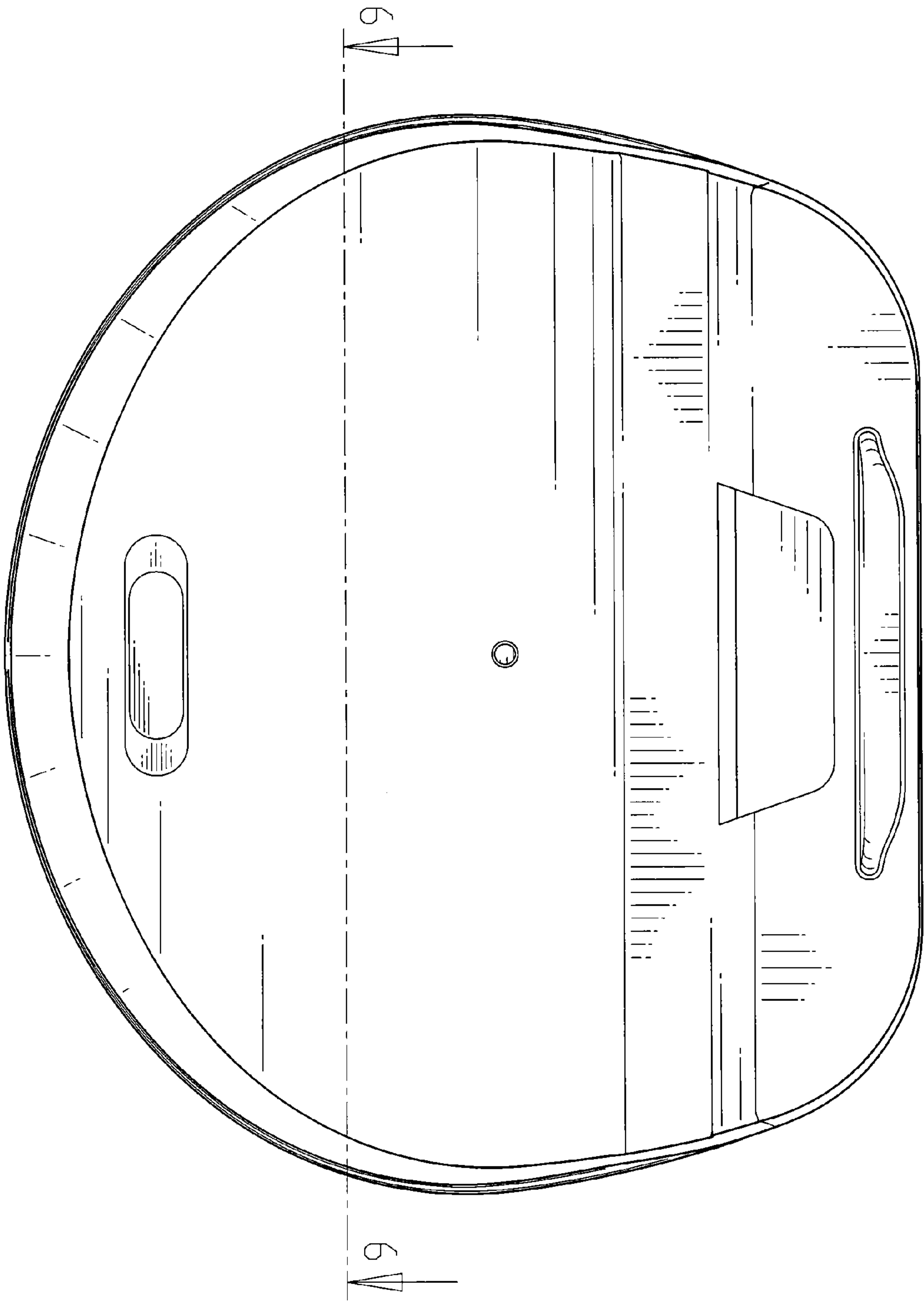

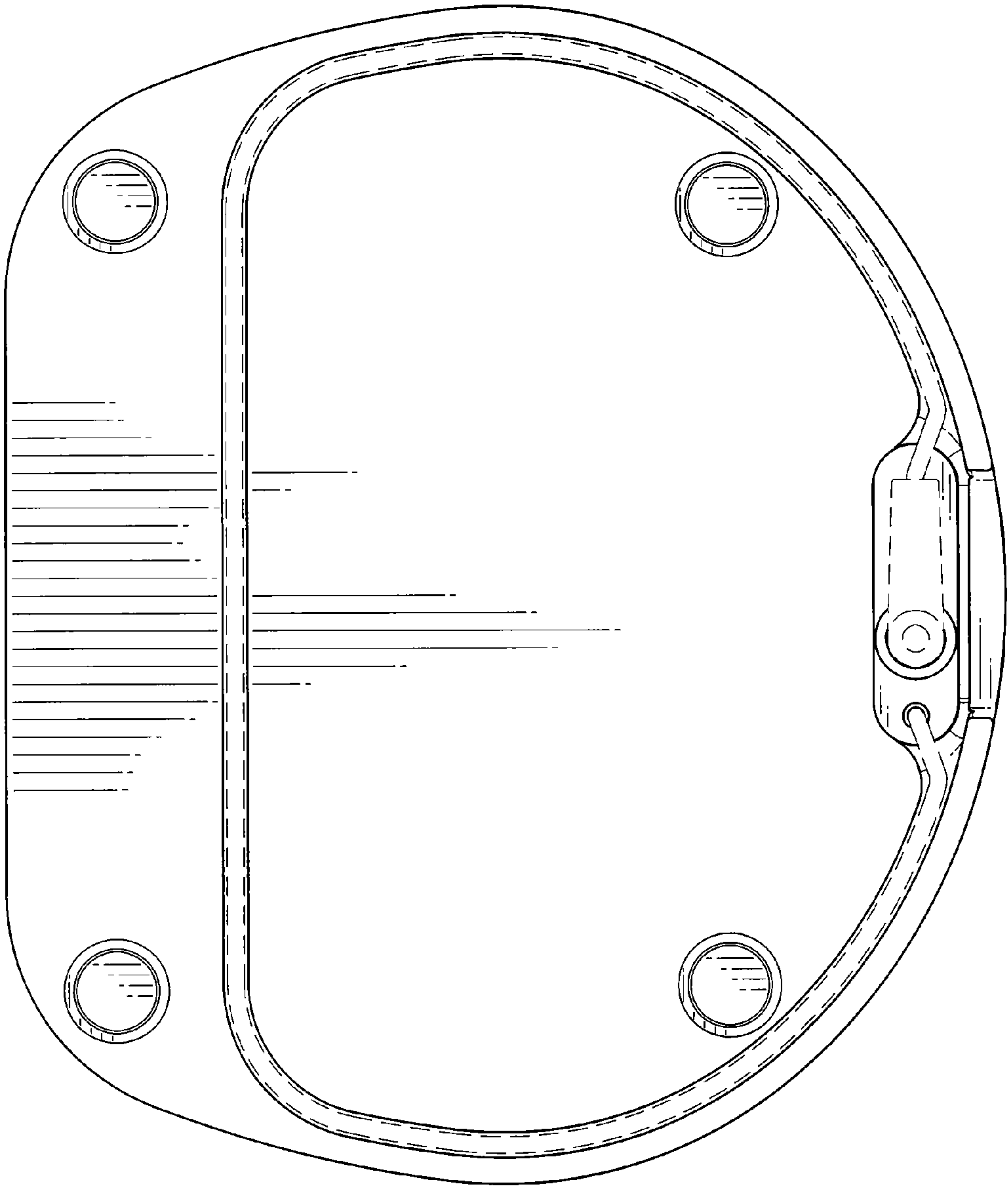

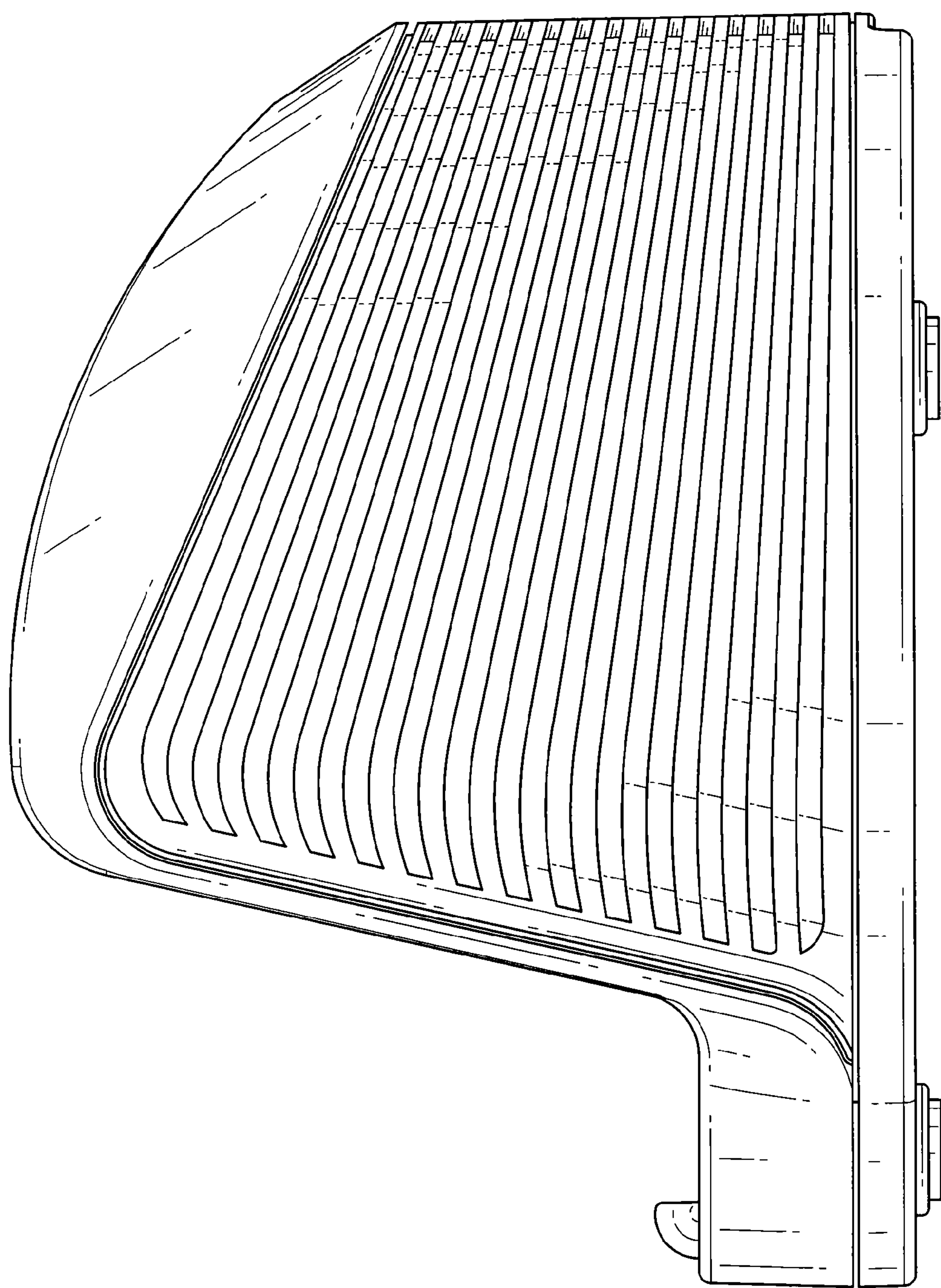

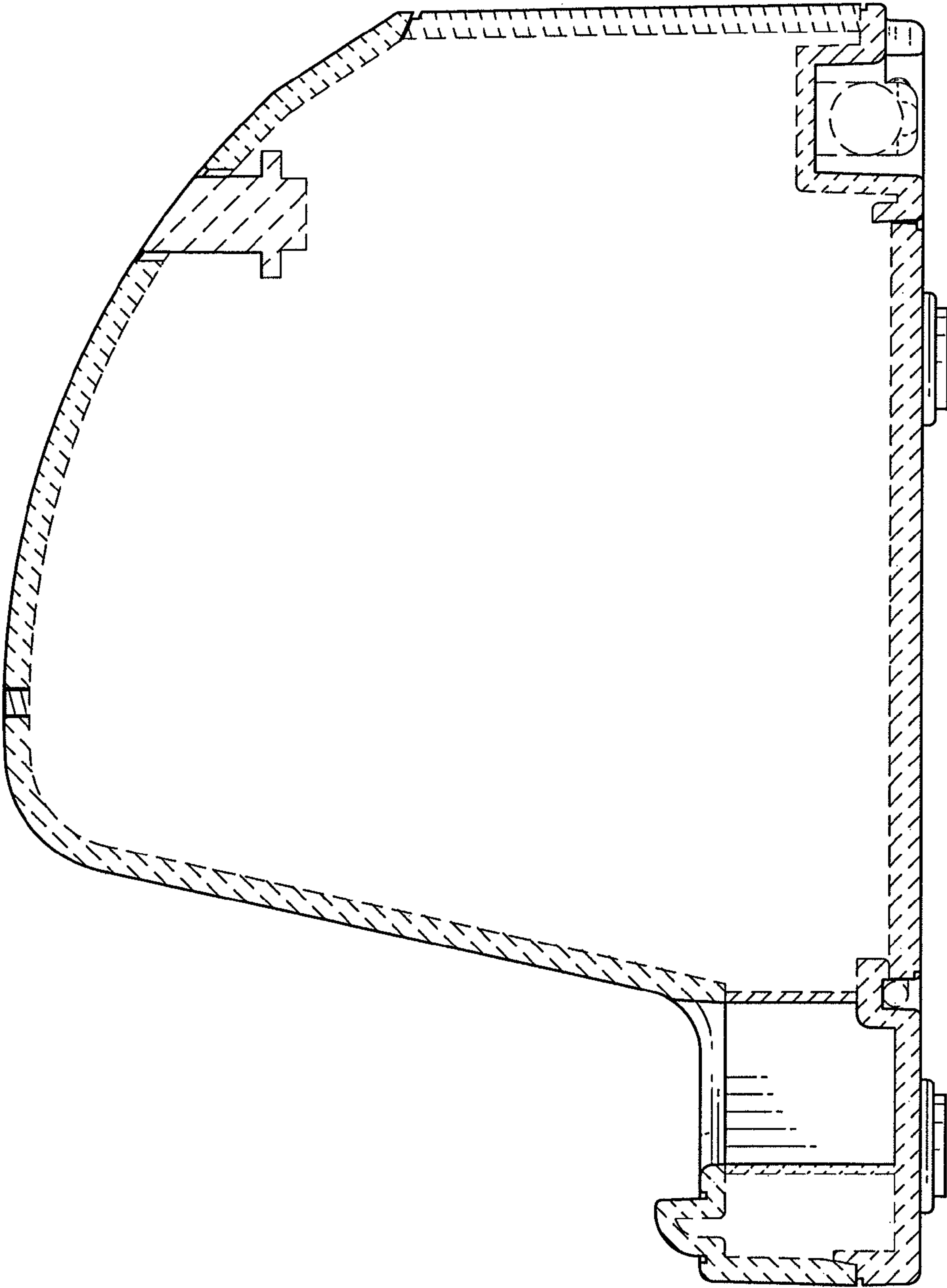

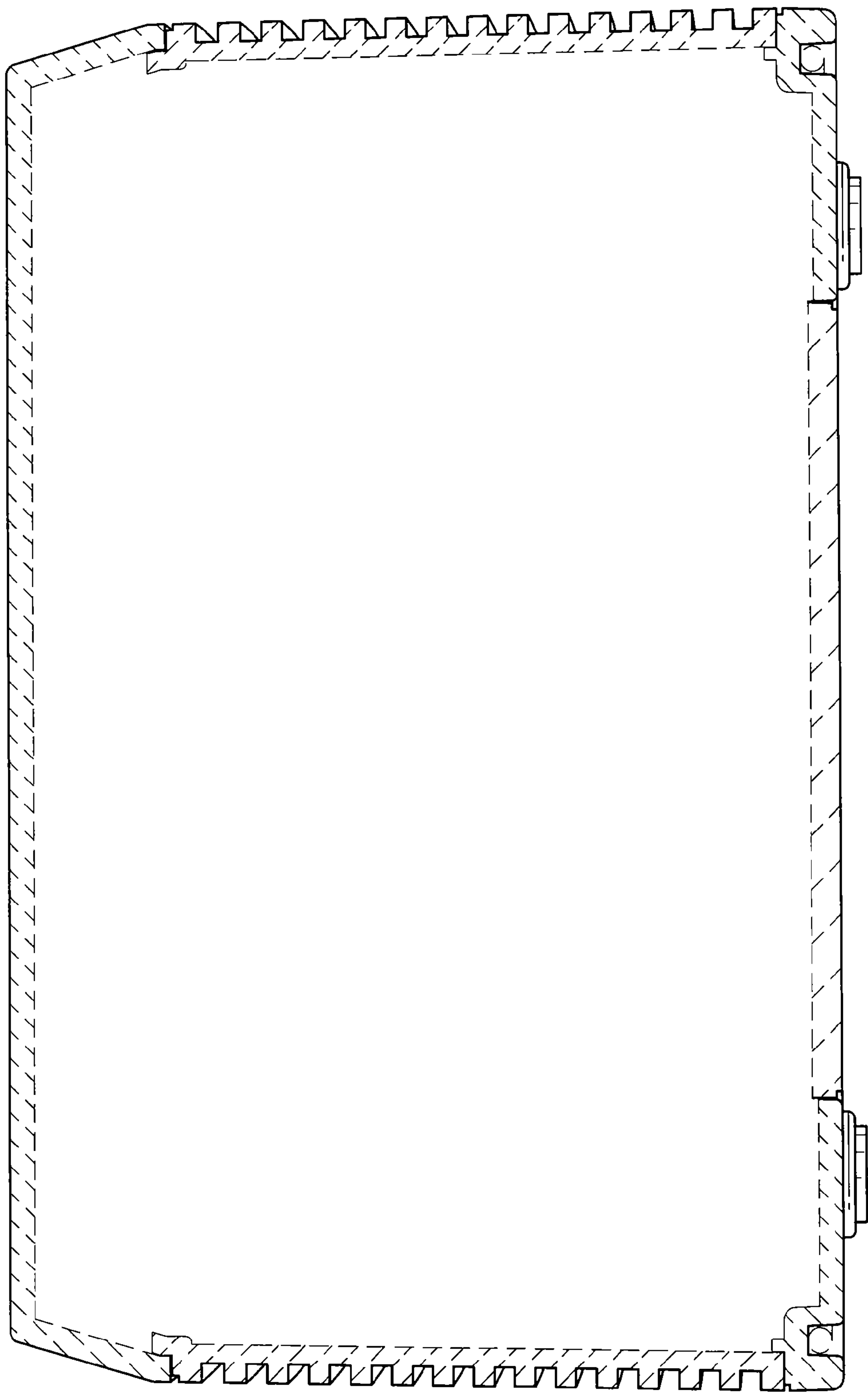
