FIG. 10 is a back view thereof;

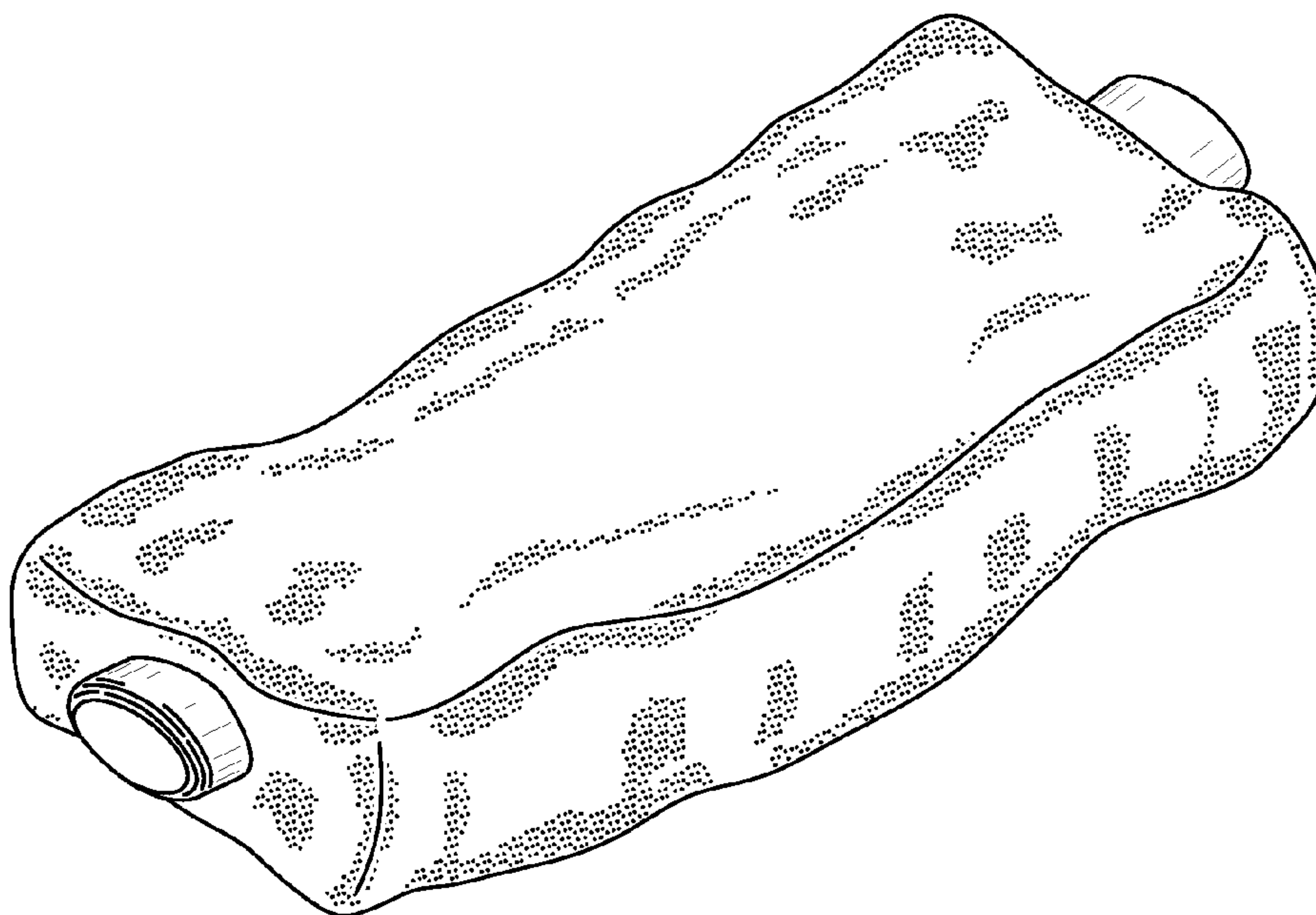
FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof;

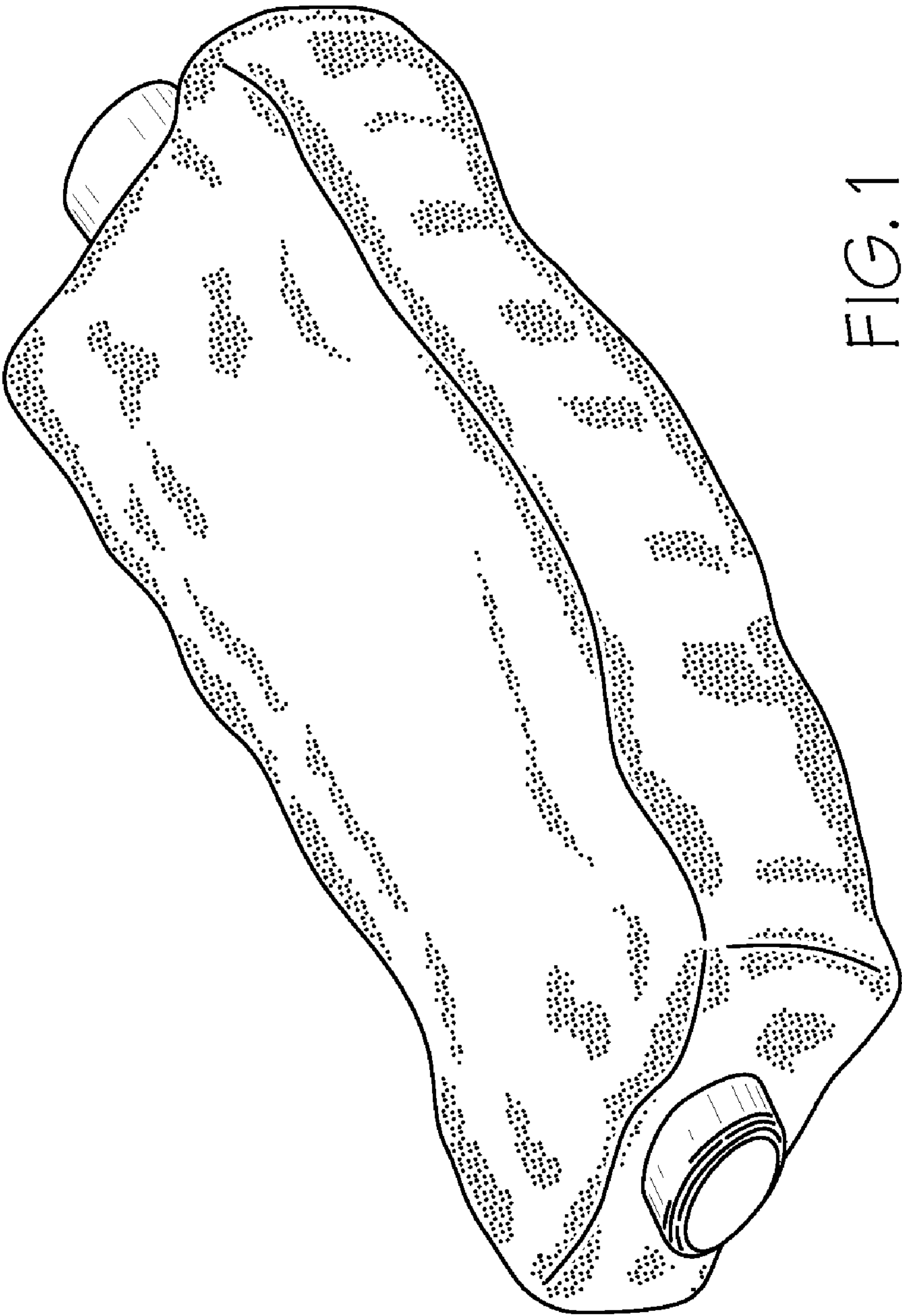

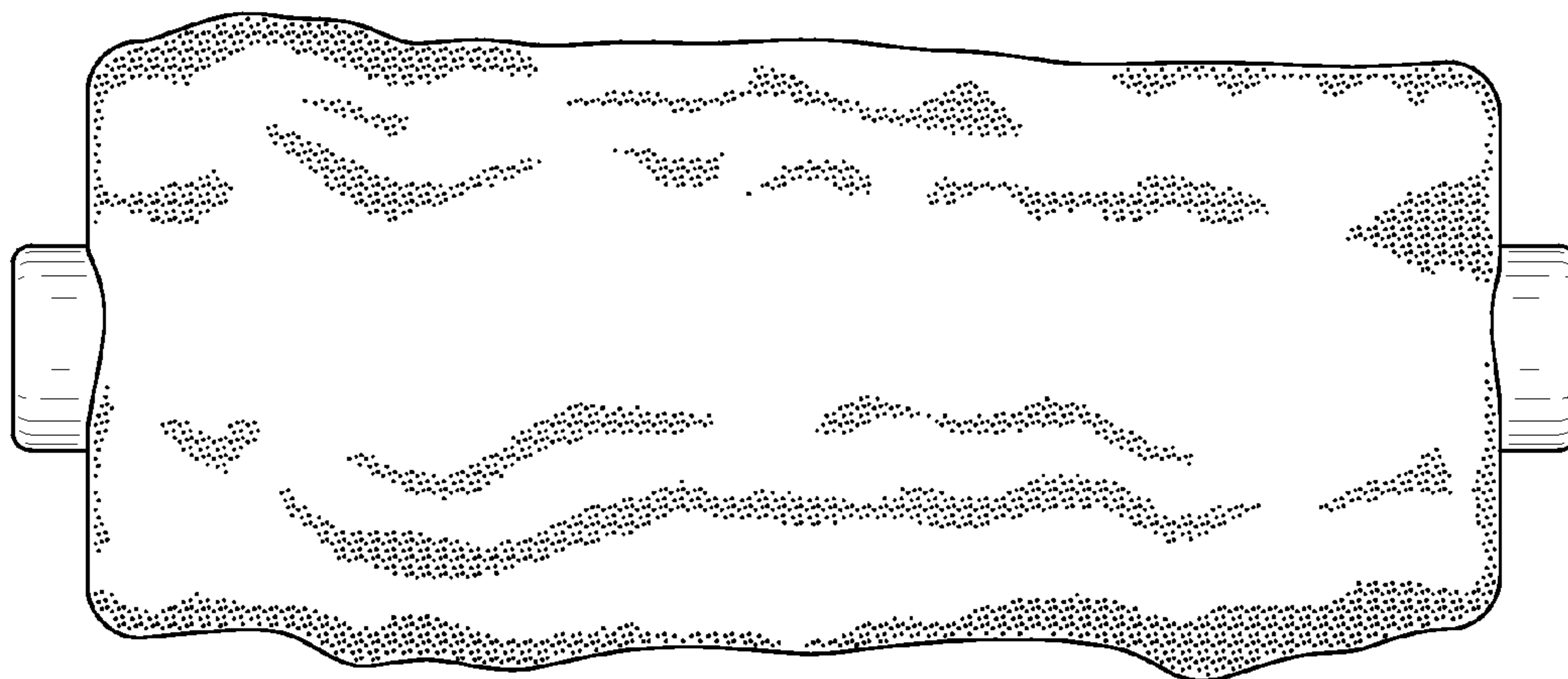

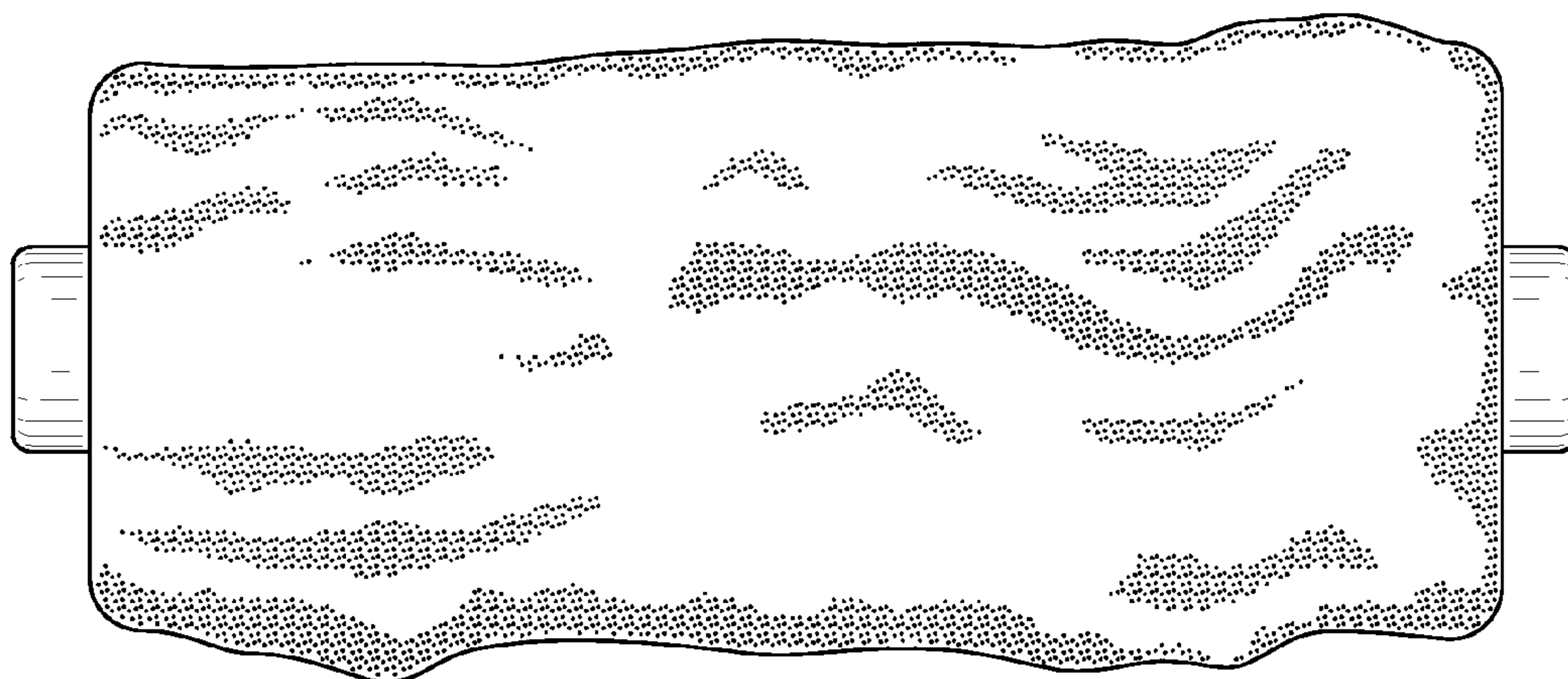

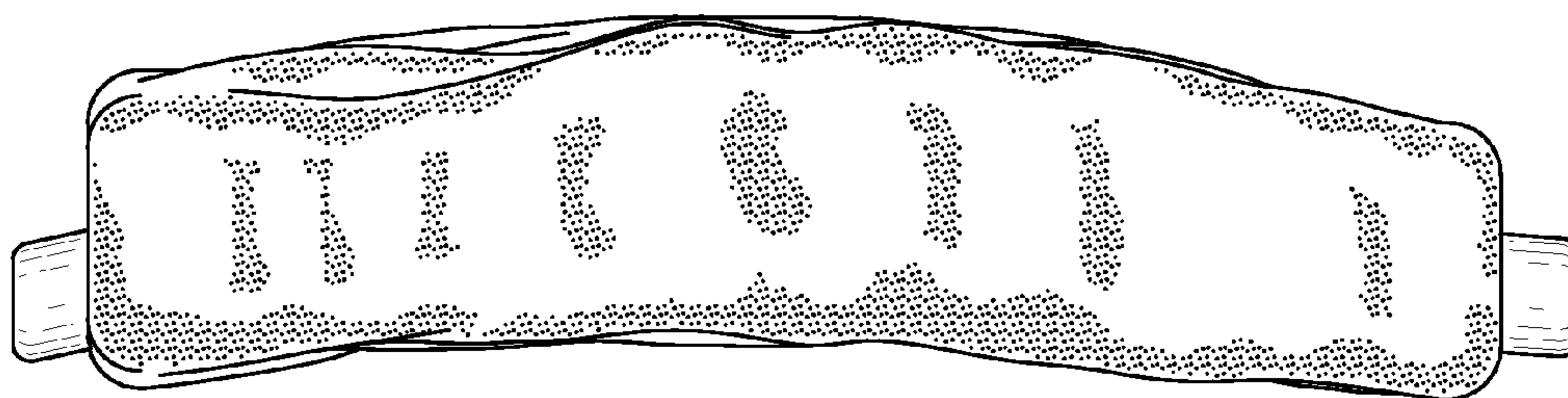

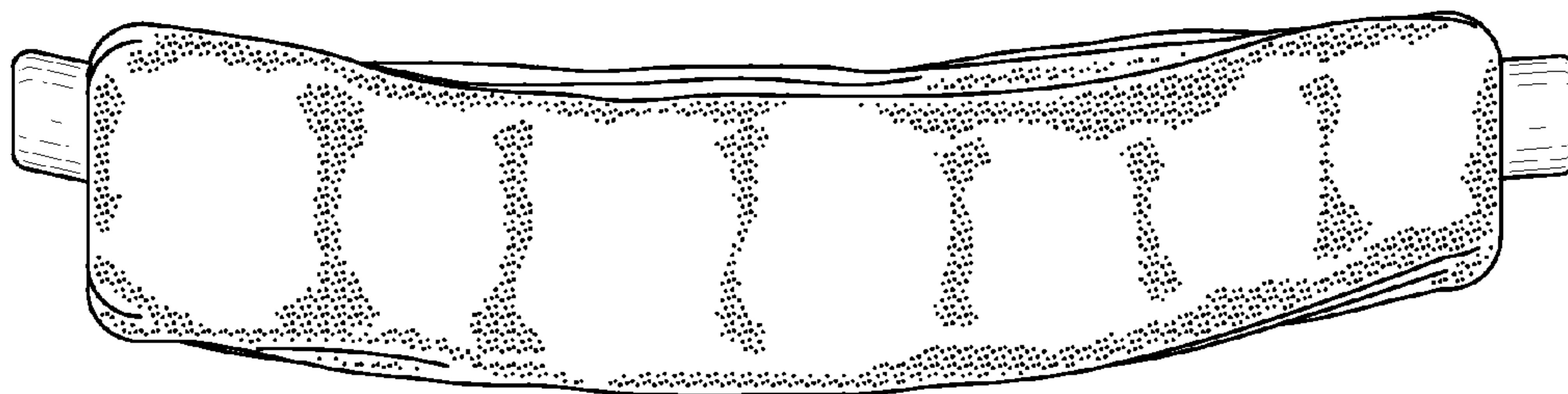

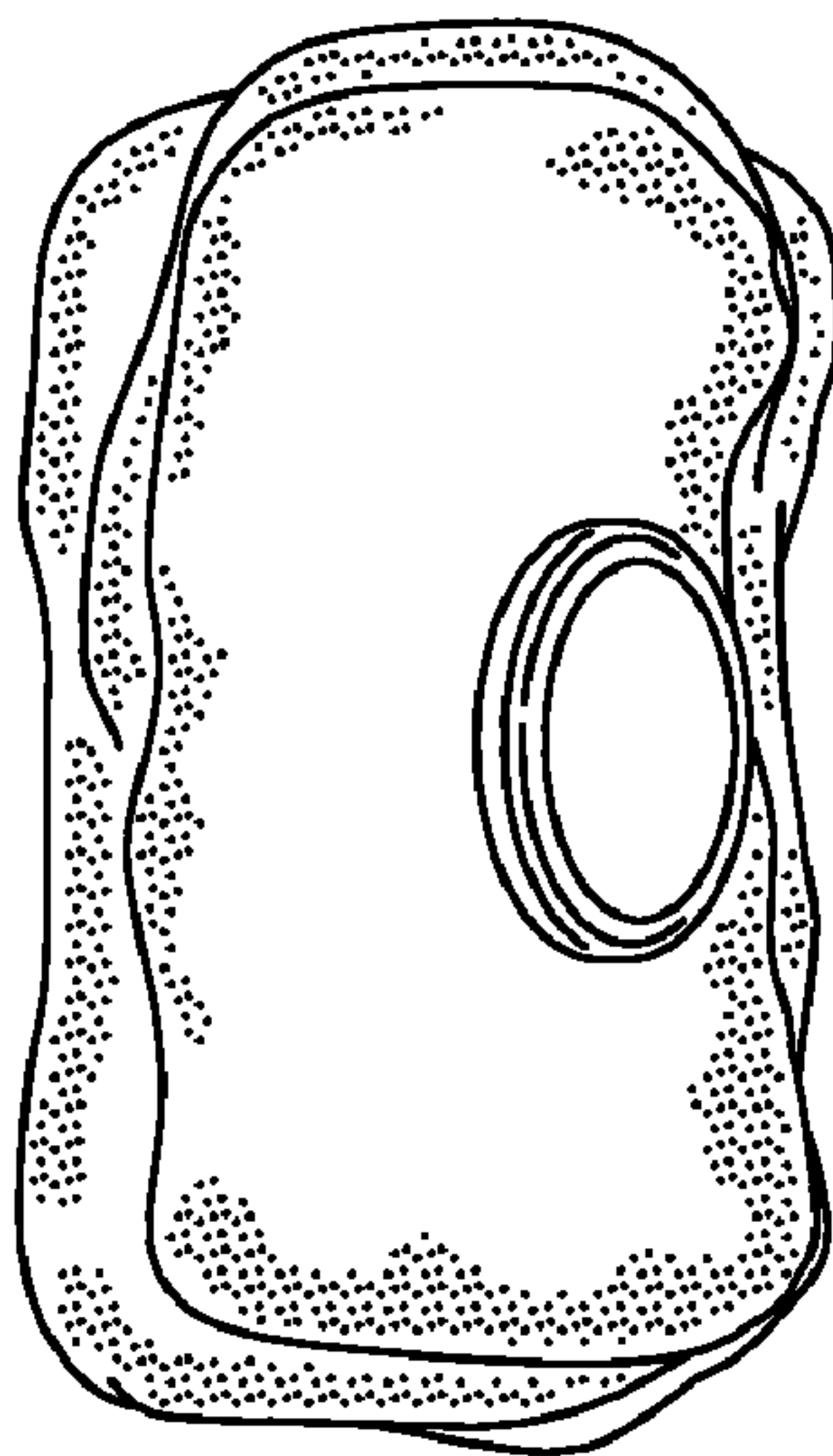

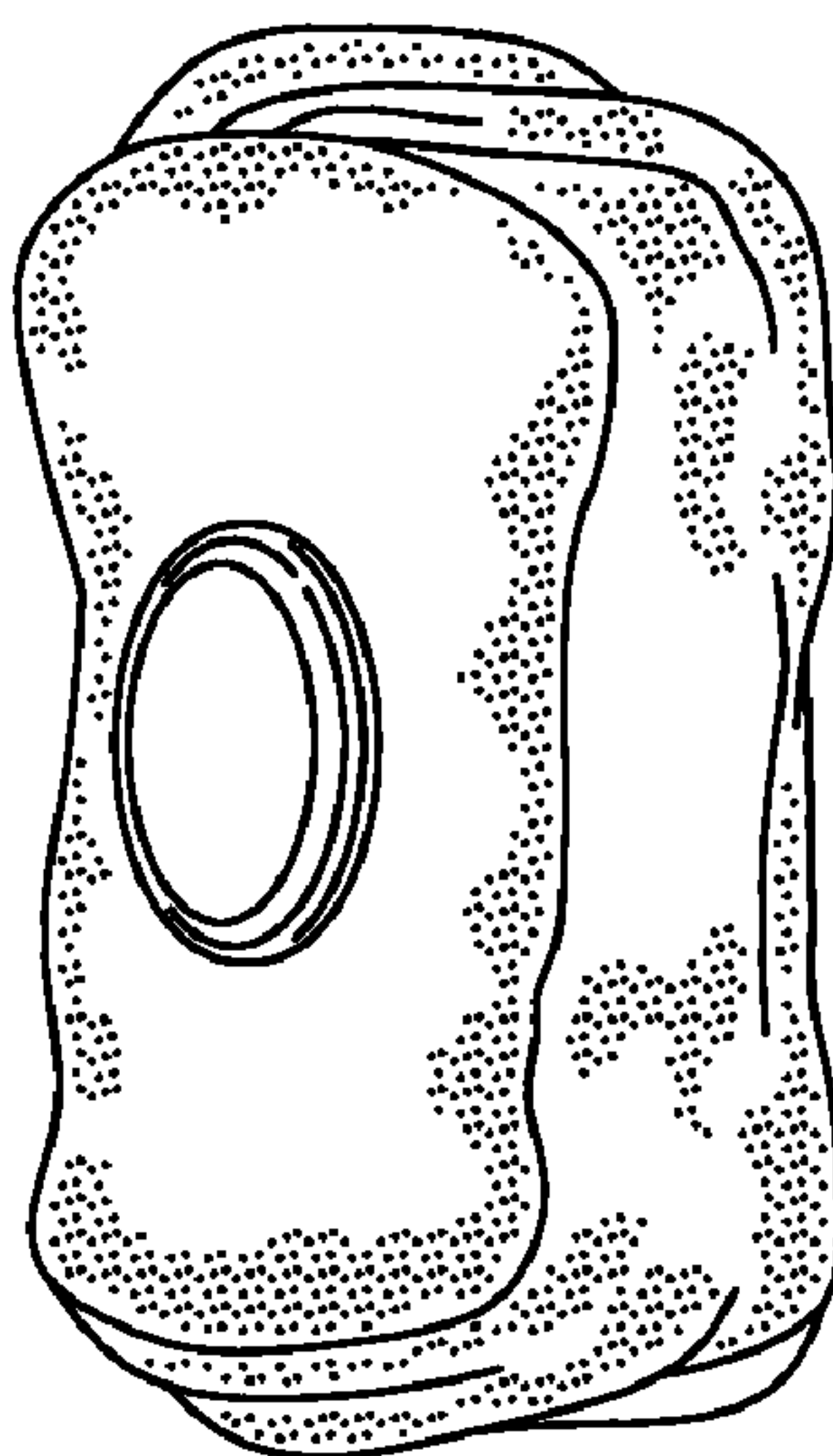

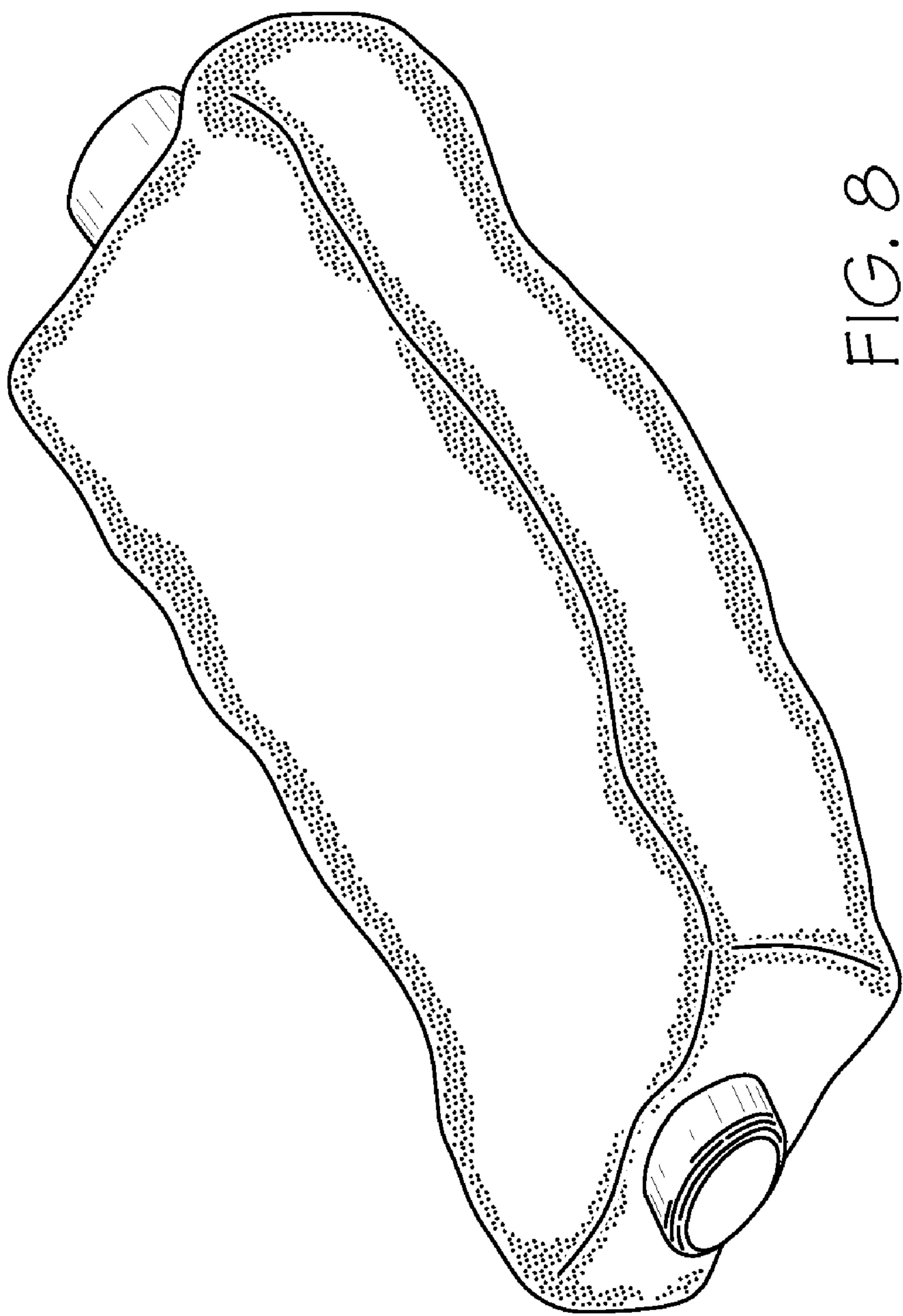

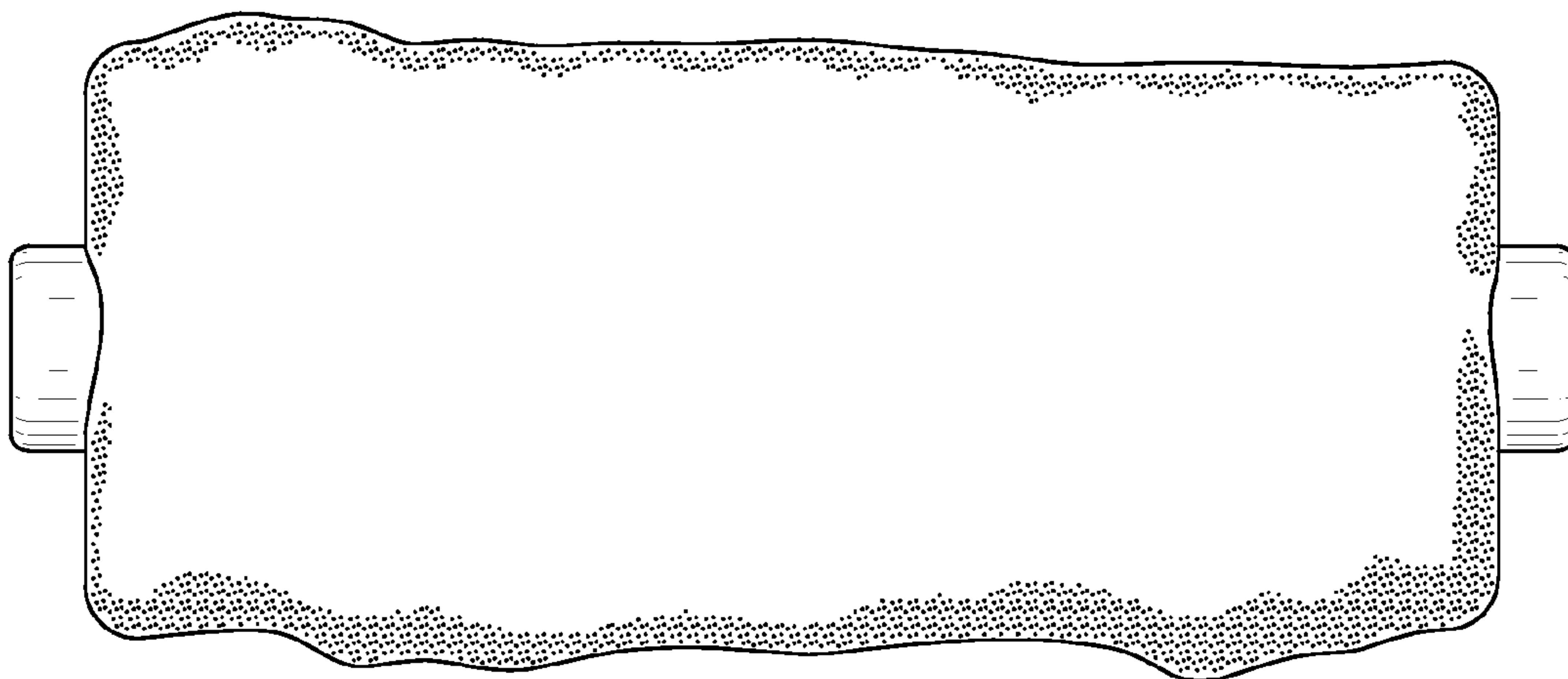

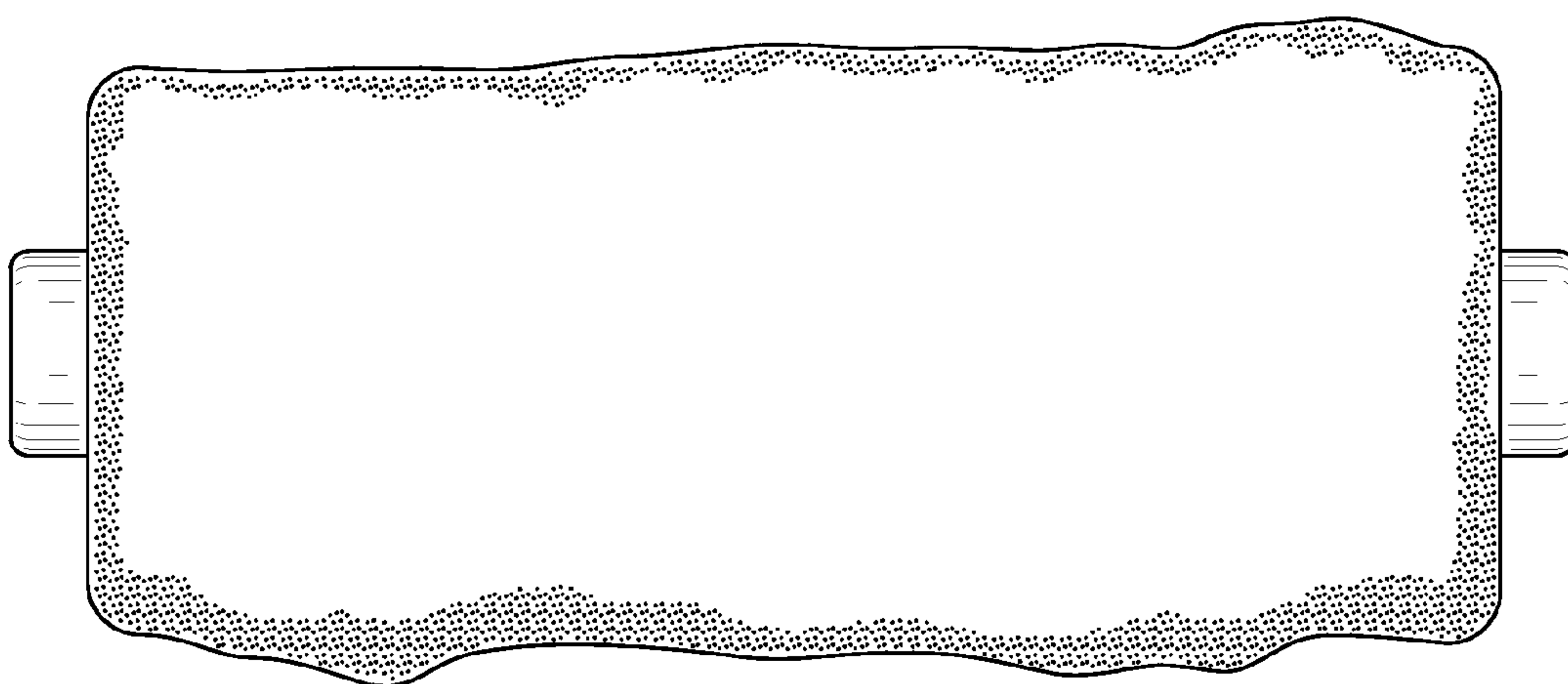

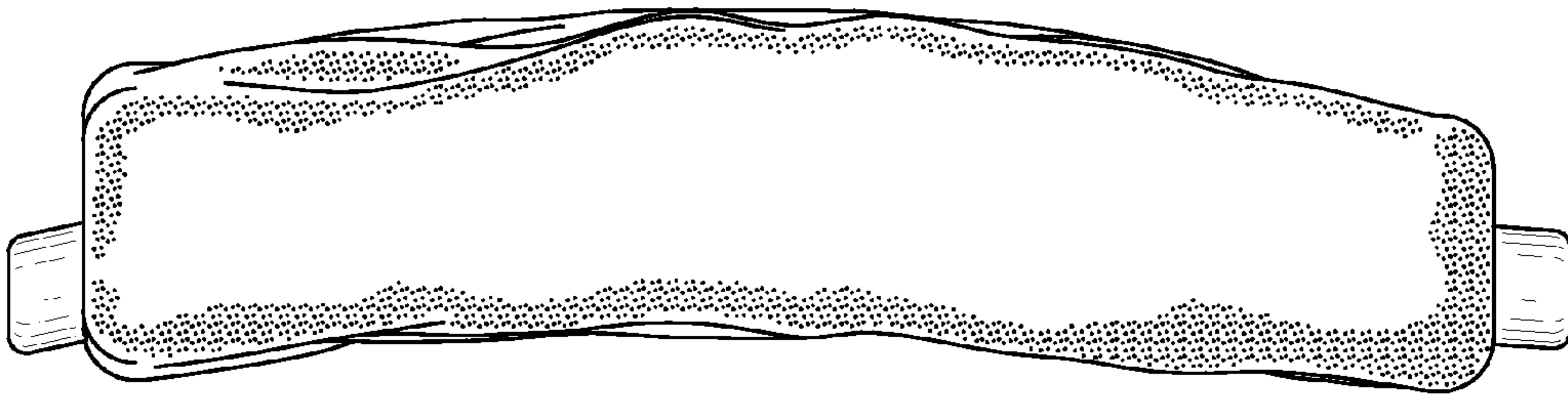

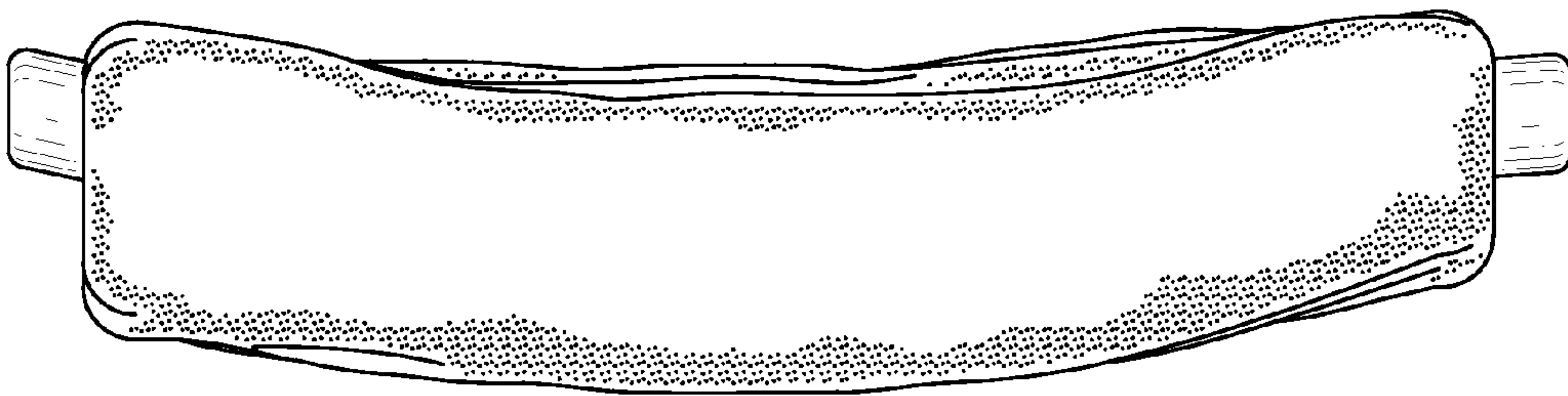

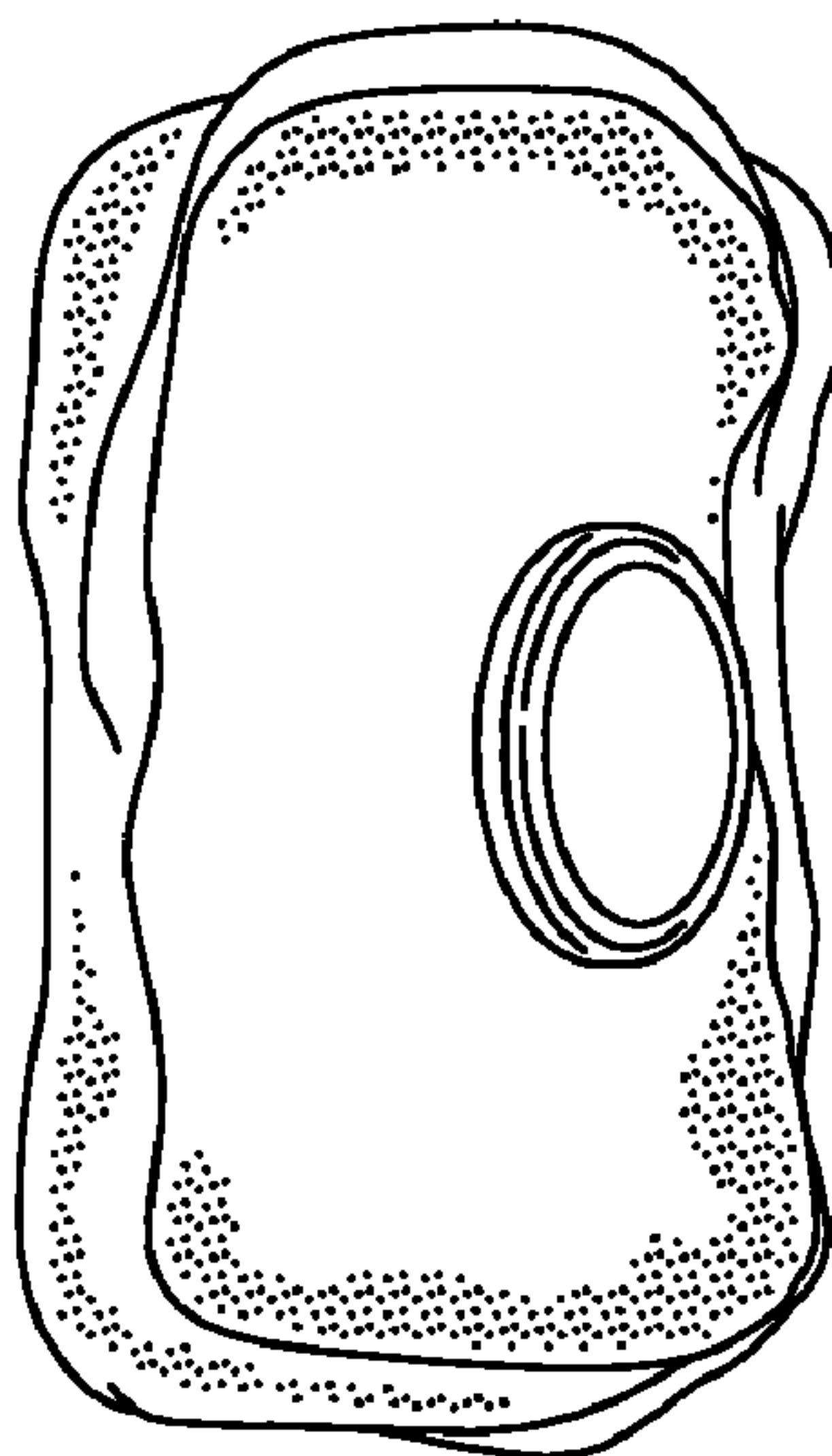

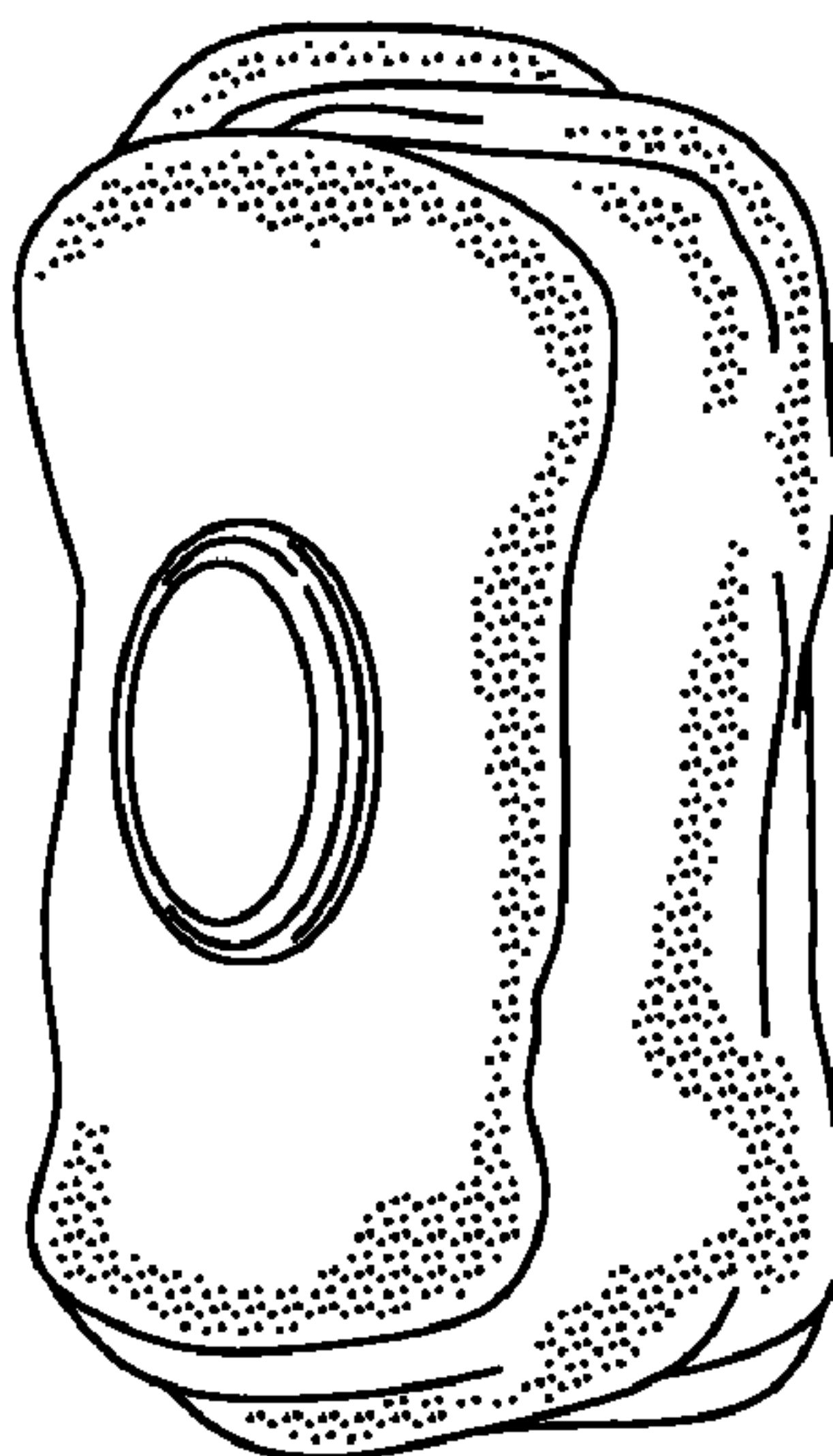
