(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an adjustable roll-up travel bag, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of the adjustable roll-up travel bag in an unfolded state;

FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged right side view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged left side view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a front view of the adjustable roll-up travel bag in a folded state;

FIG. 9 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 10 is an enlarged top perspective view thereof;

FIG. 11 is an enlarged bottom view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a right side view thereof;

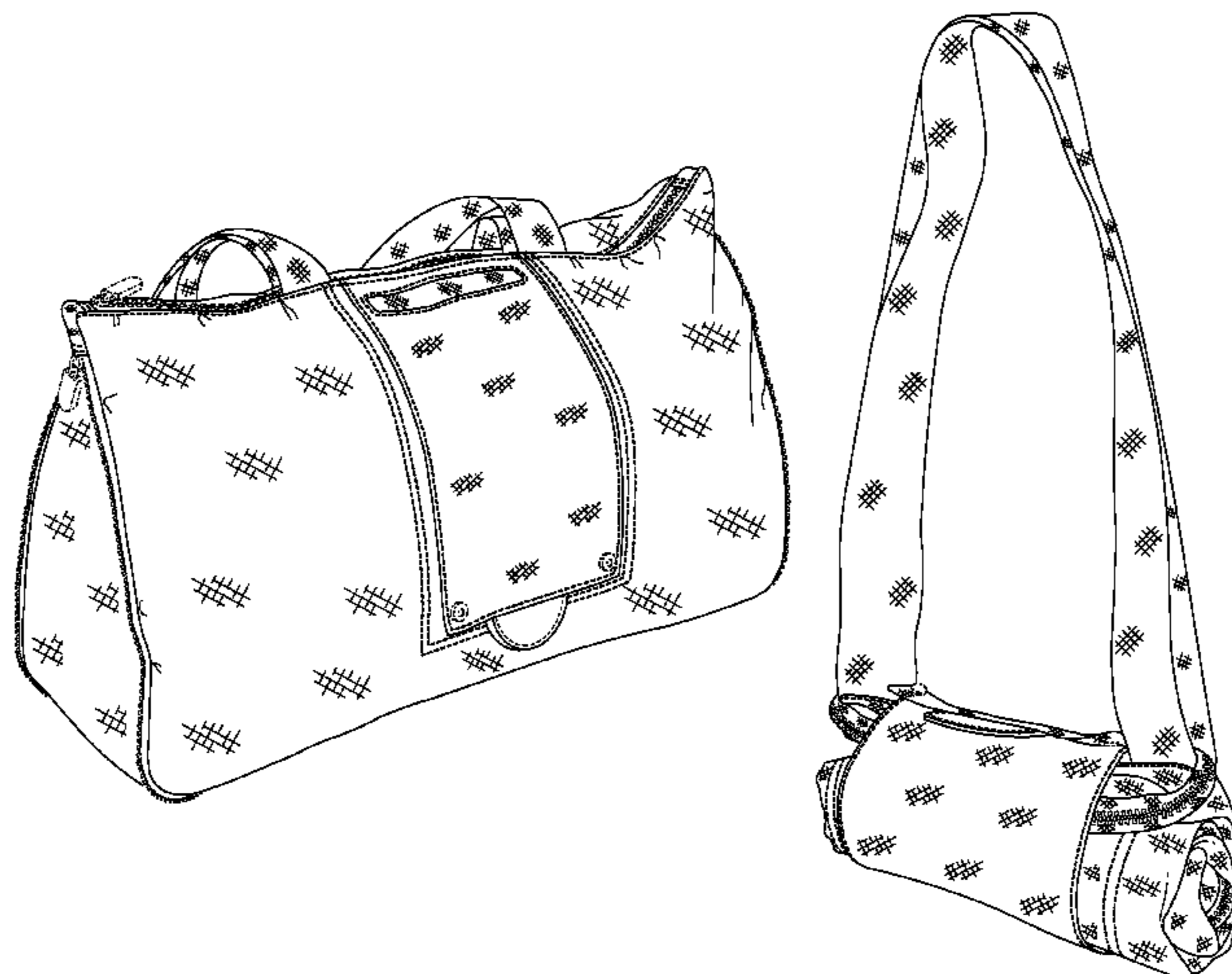
FIG. 13 is left side view thereof; and,

FIG. 14 is a perspective view thereof.

The zipper pulls and snaps shown in broken lines illustrate portions of the article to which the design is applied that form no part of the claim. The broken lines shown along the edges of features are stitch lines and form a part of the claimed design.

The crosshatched pattern, although shown intermittently, is meant to illustrate the texture of fabric, and is understood to be distributed uniformly over the surfaces of the claimed design upon which it resides.

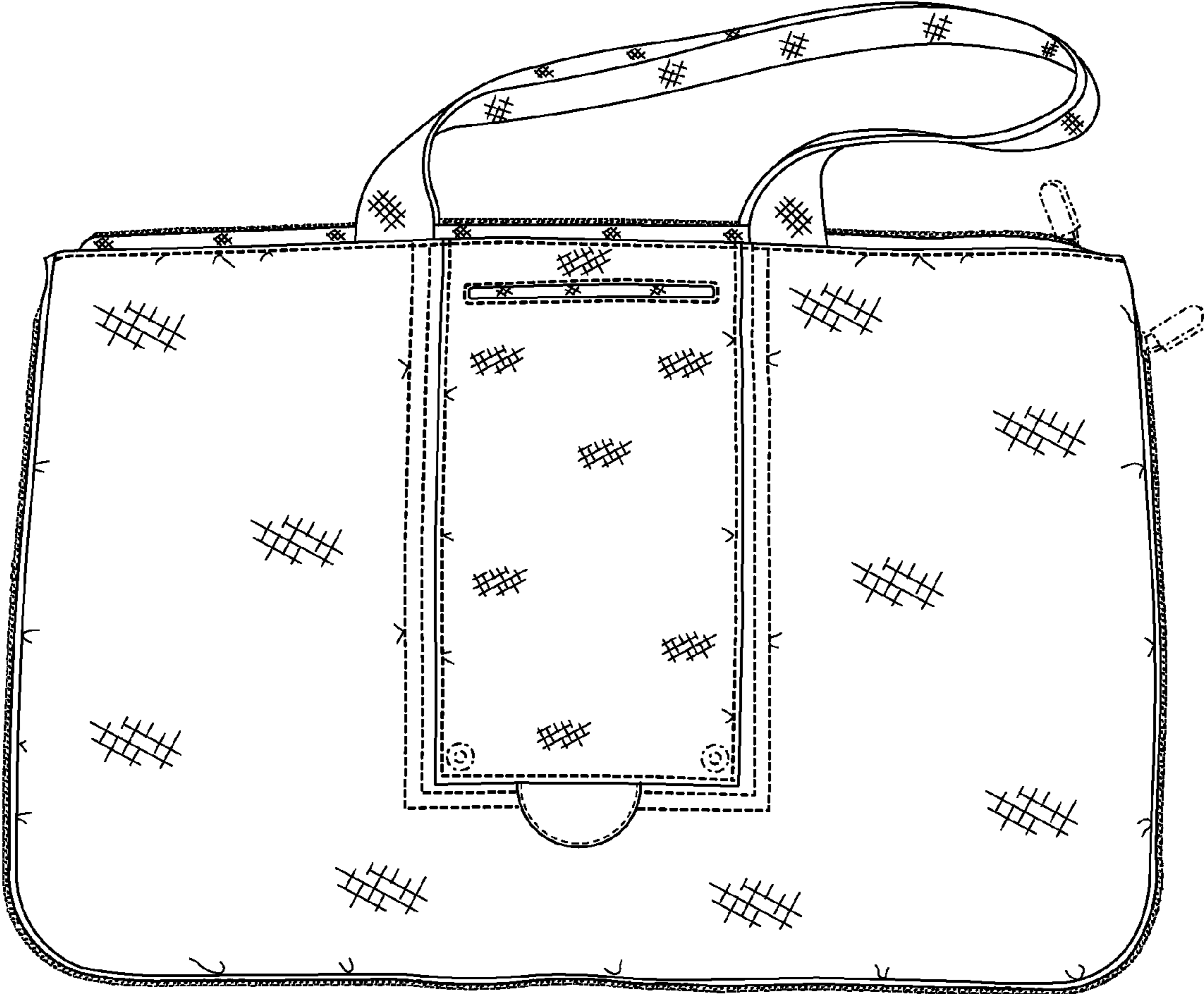

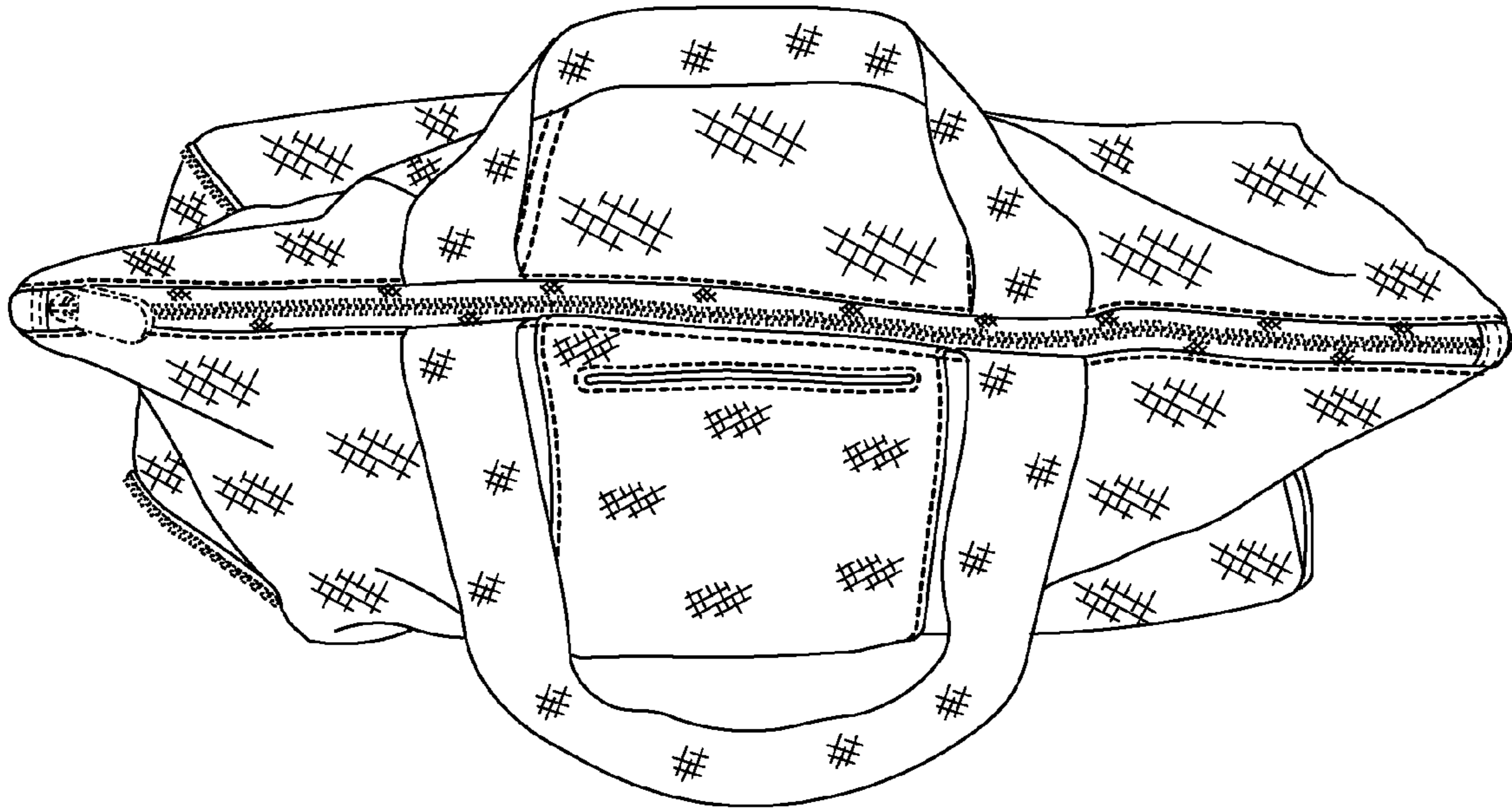

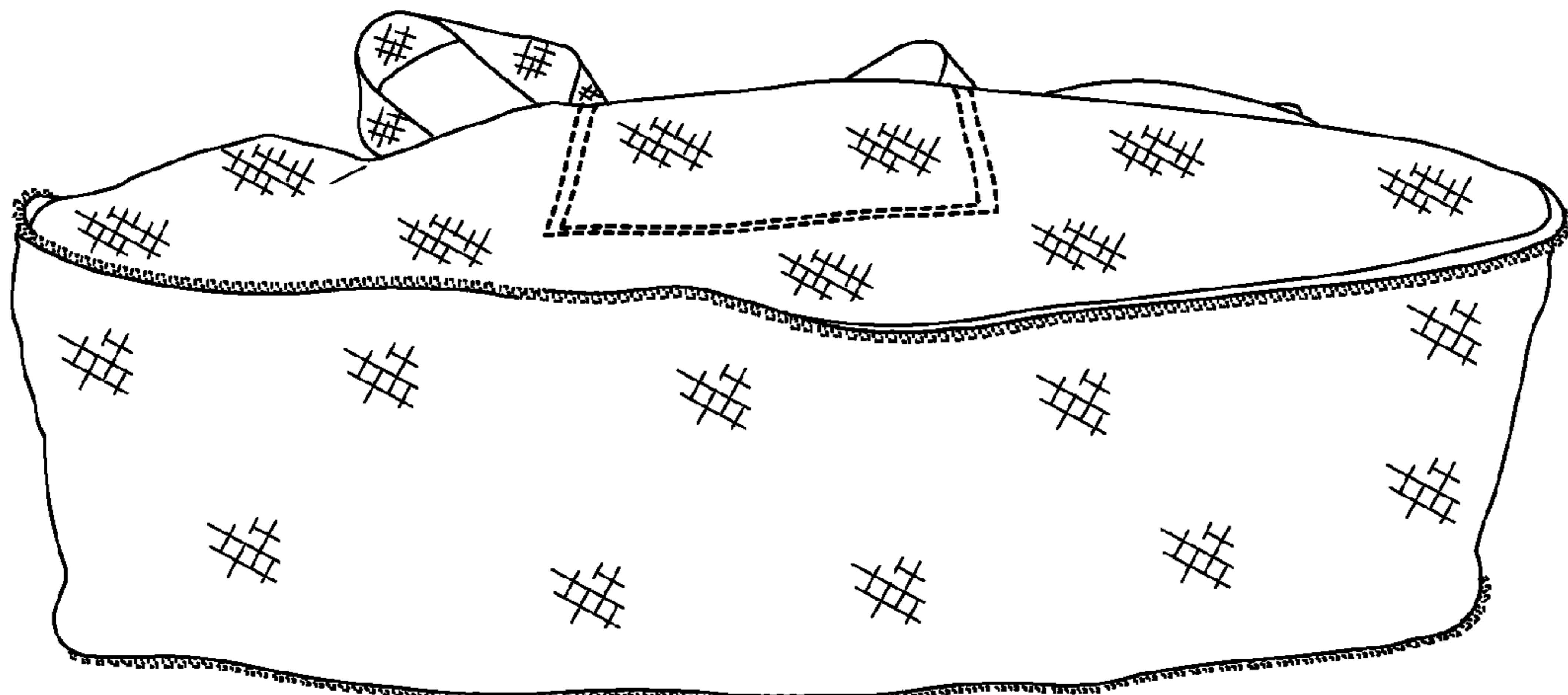

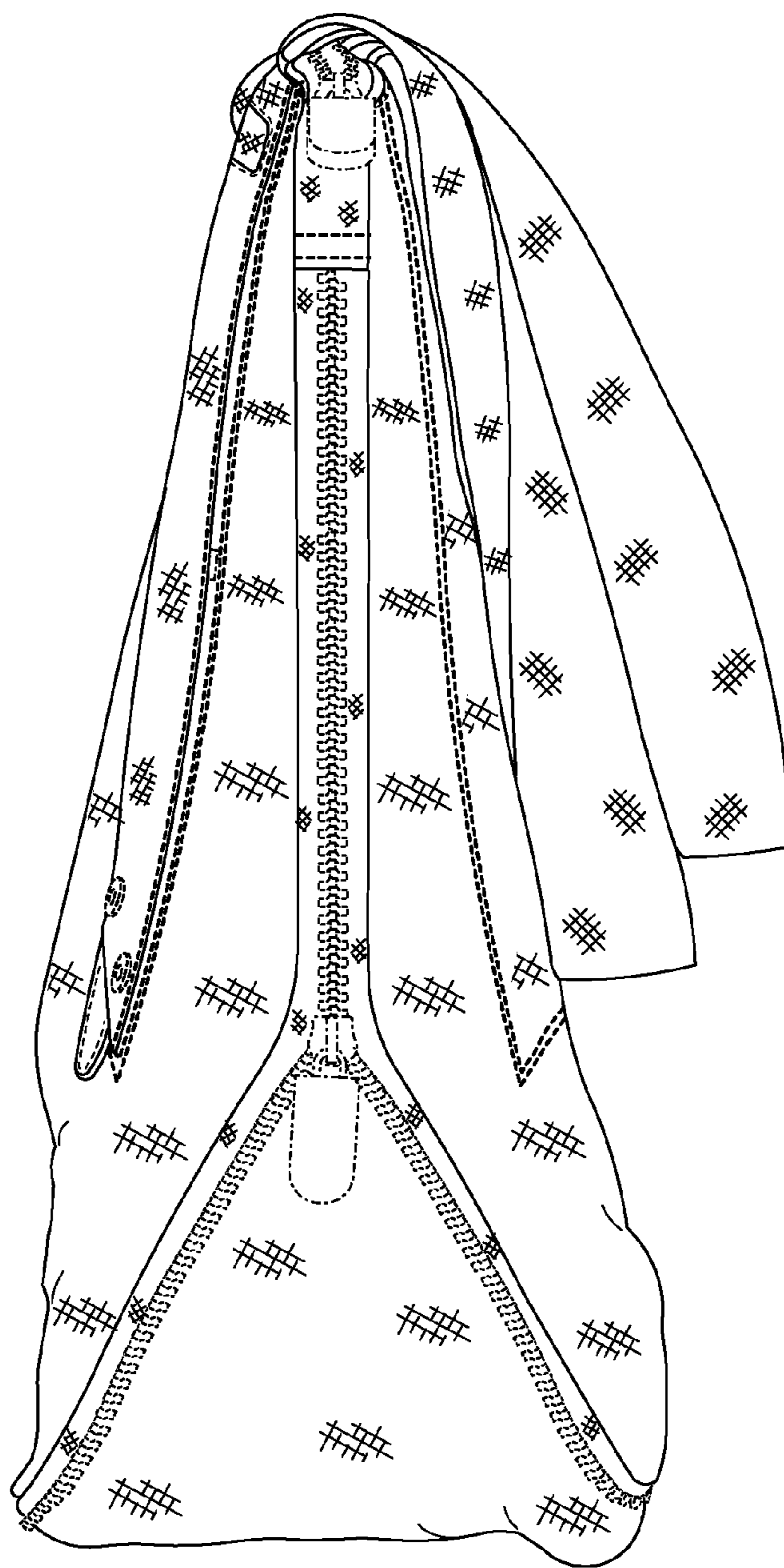

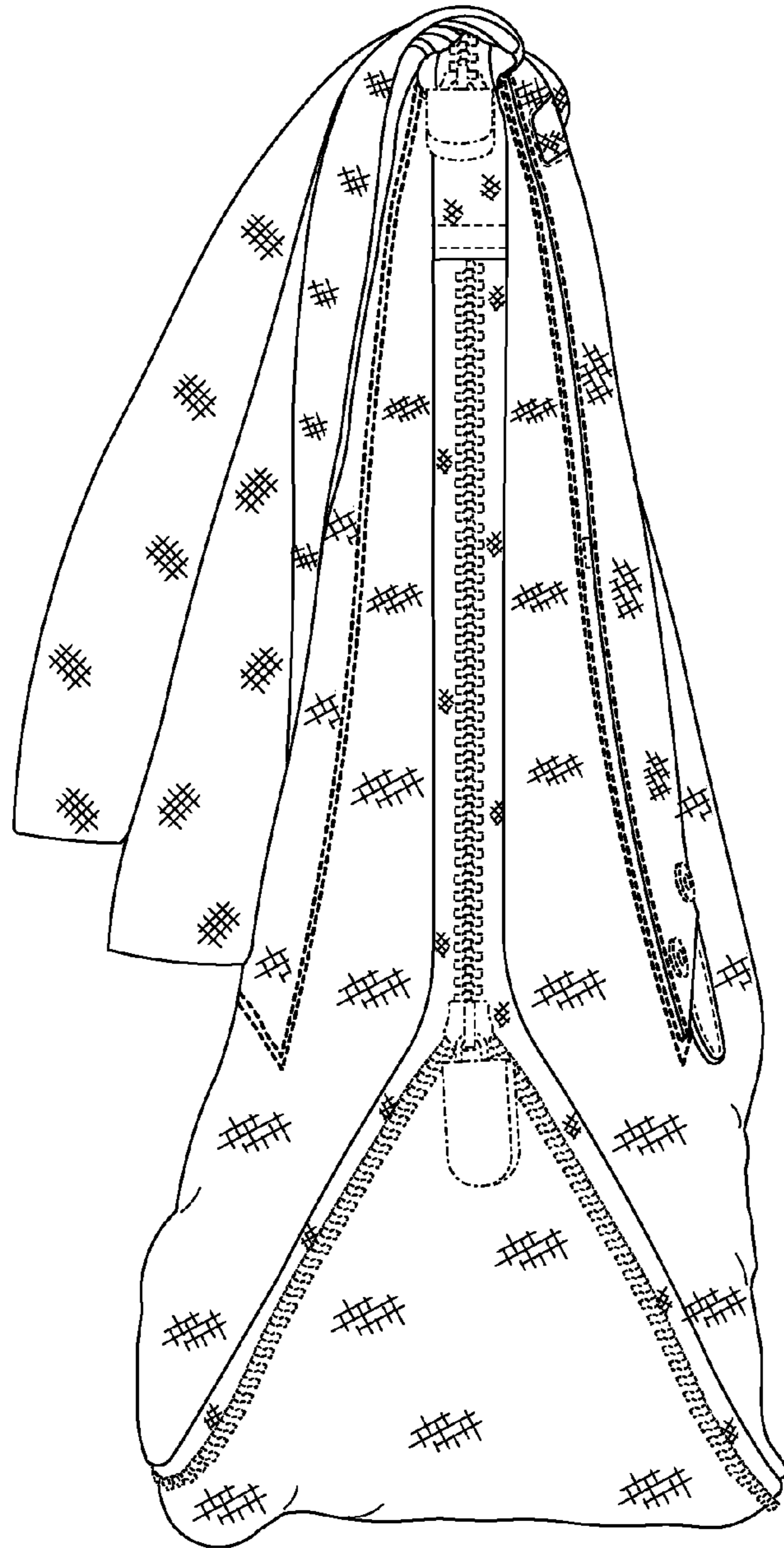

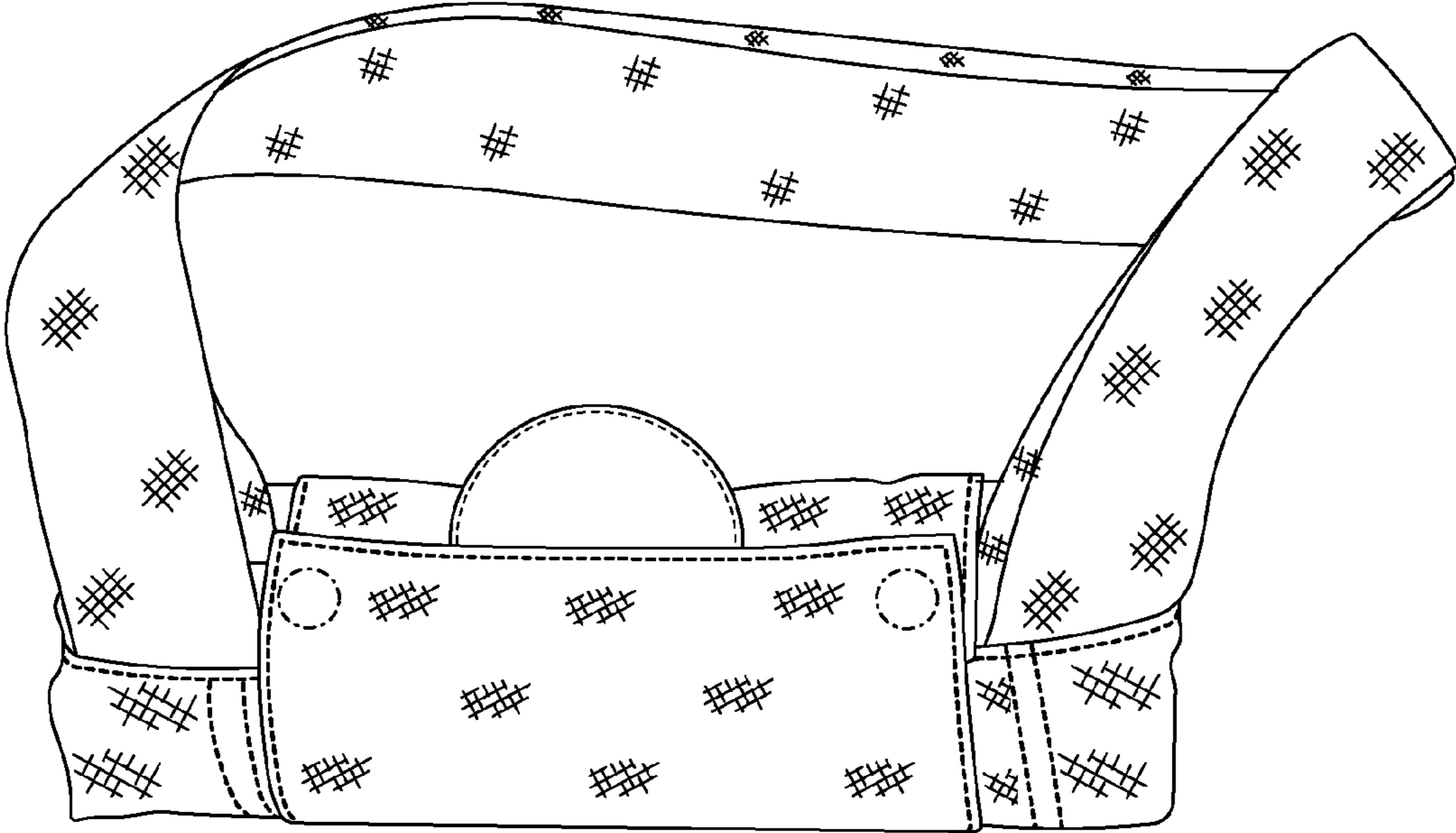

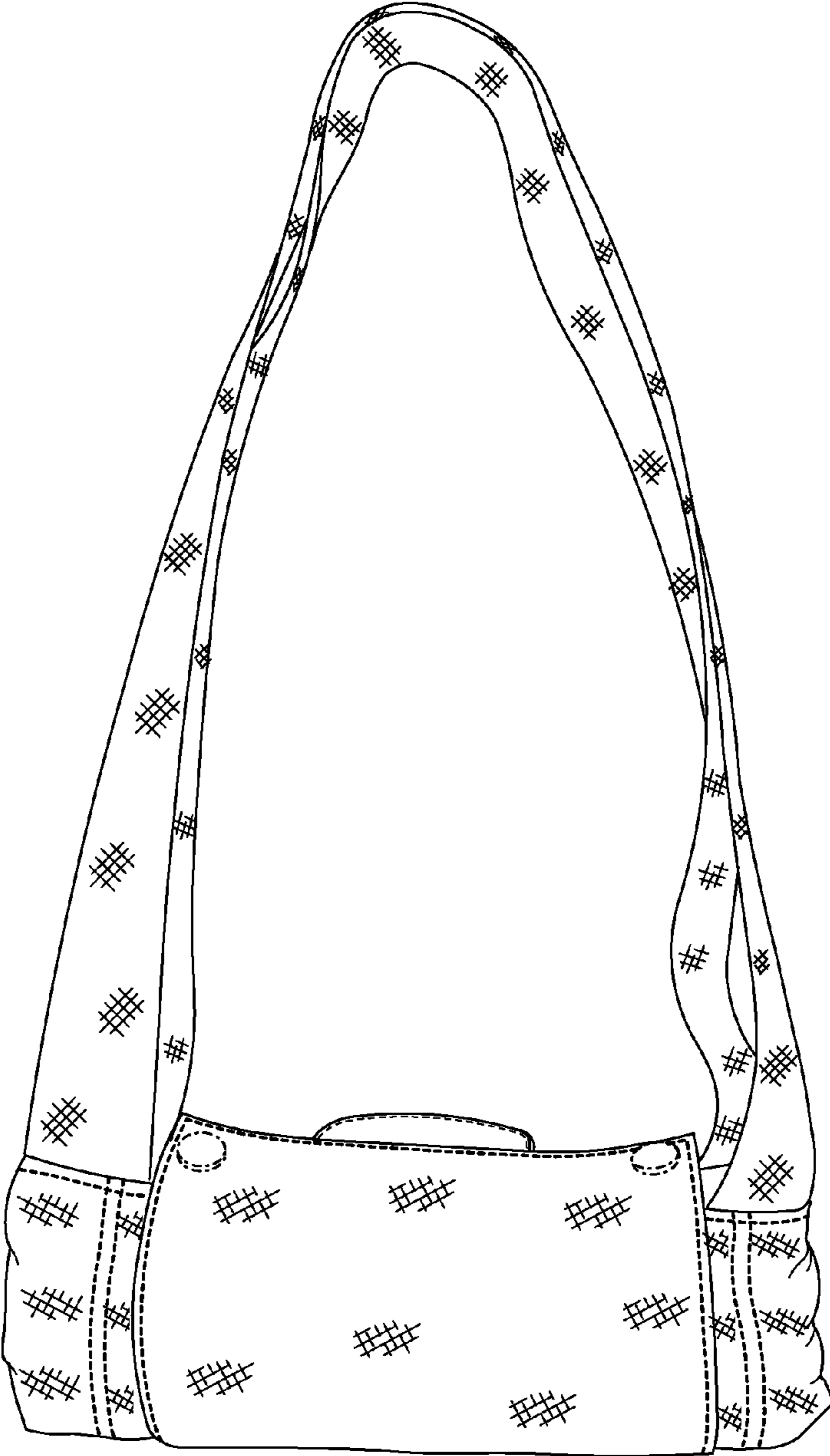

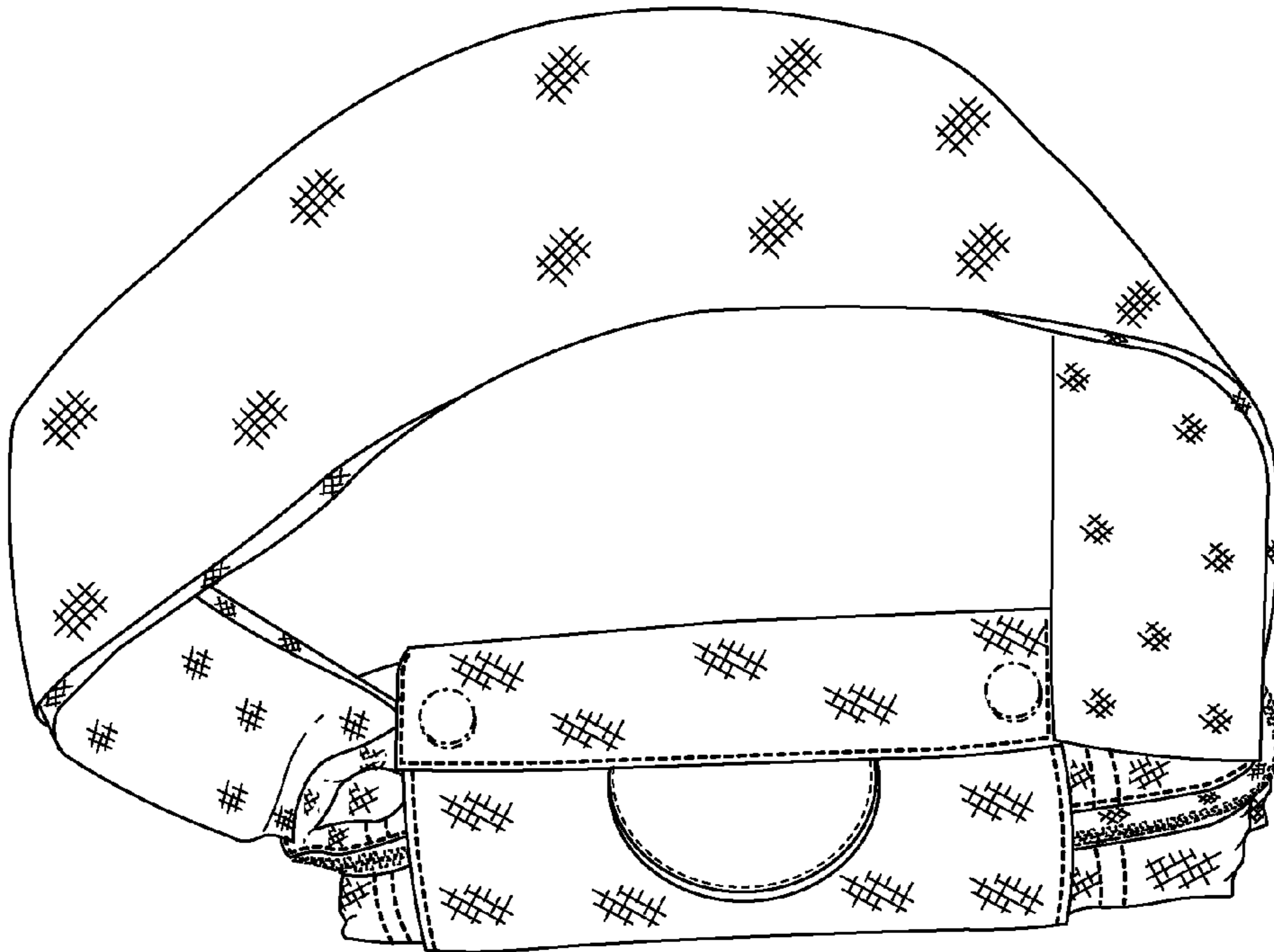

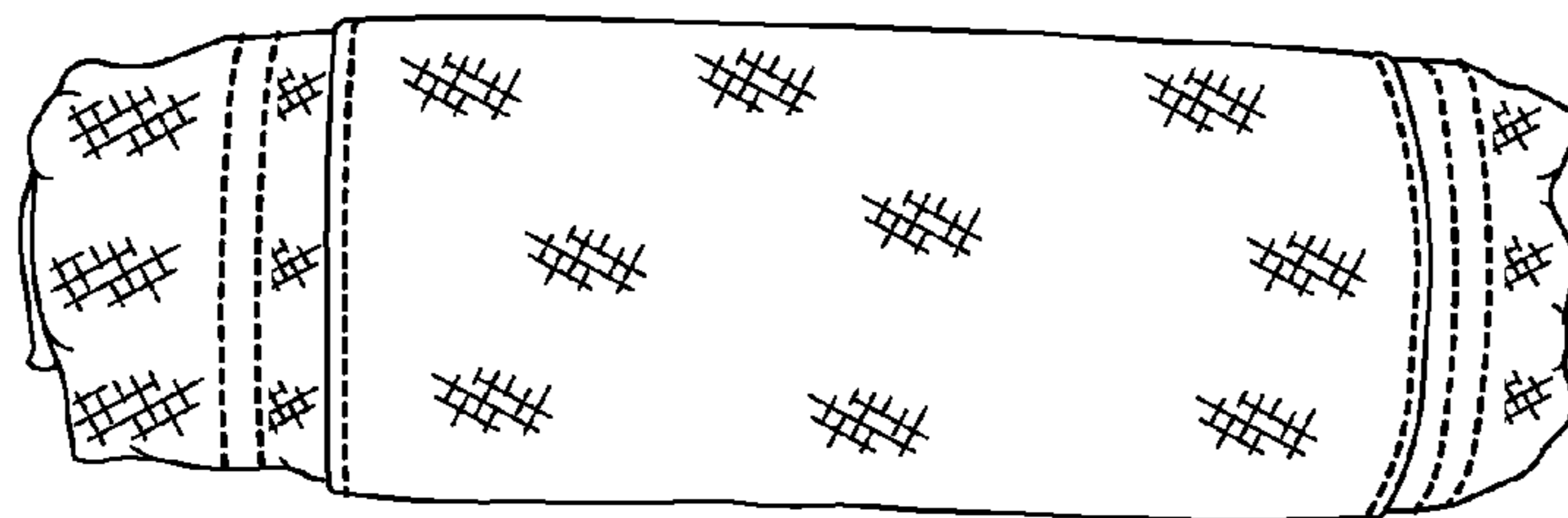
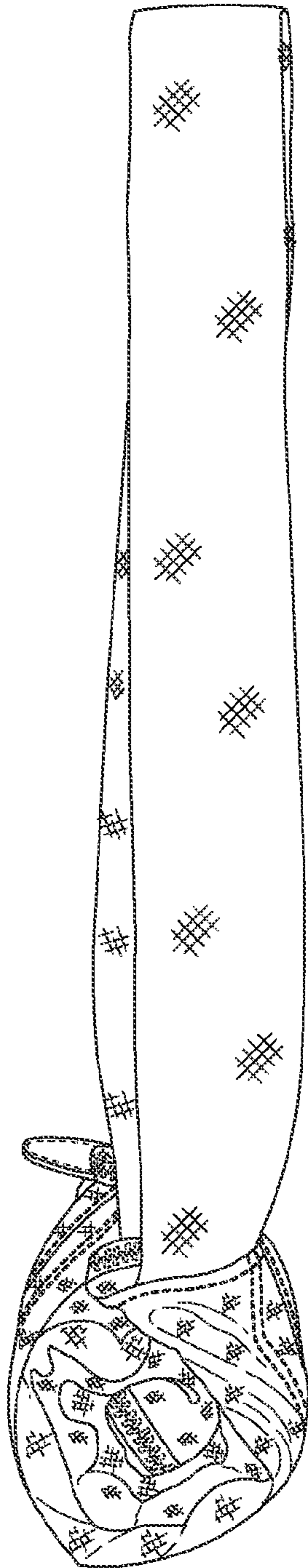

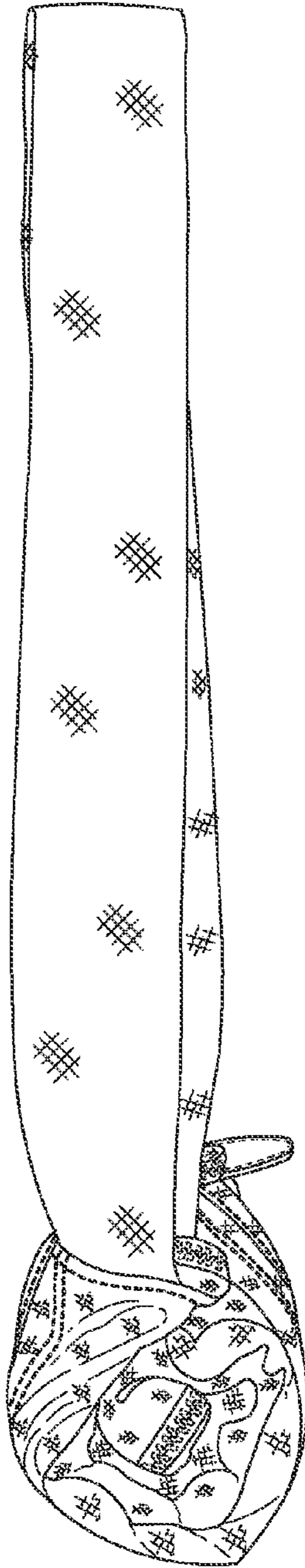
