FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof;

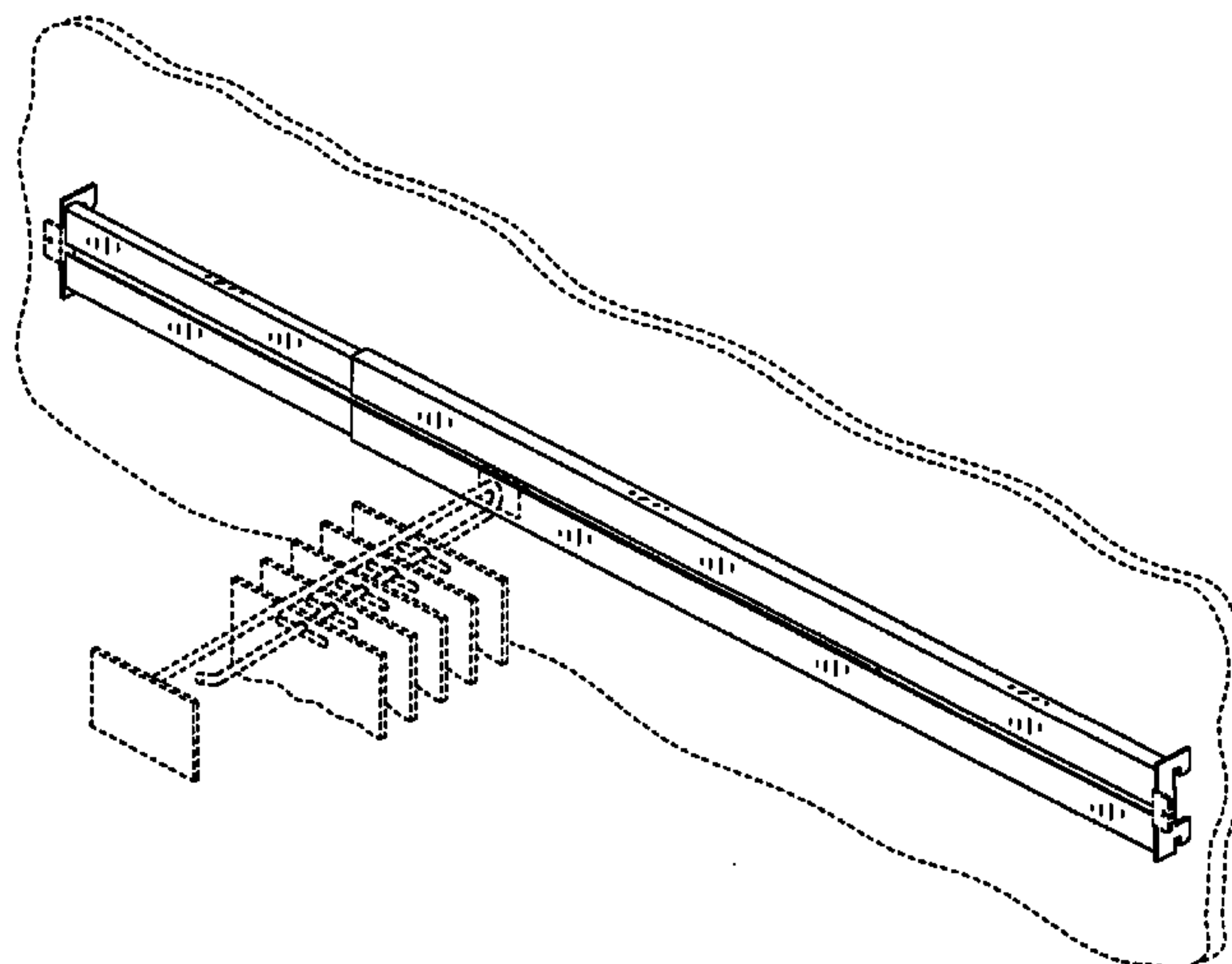
FIG. 8 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a front perspective view with the two segments separated; and,

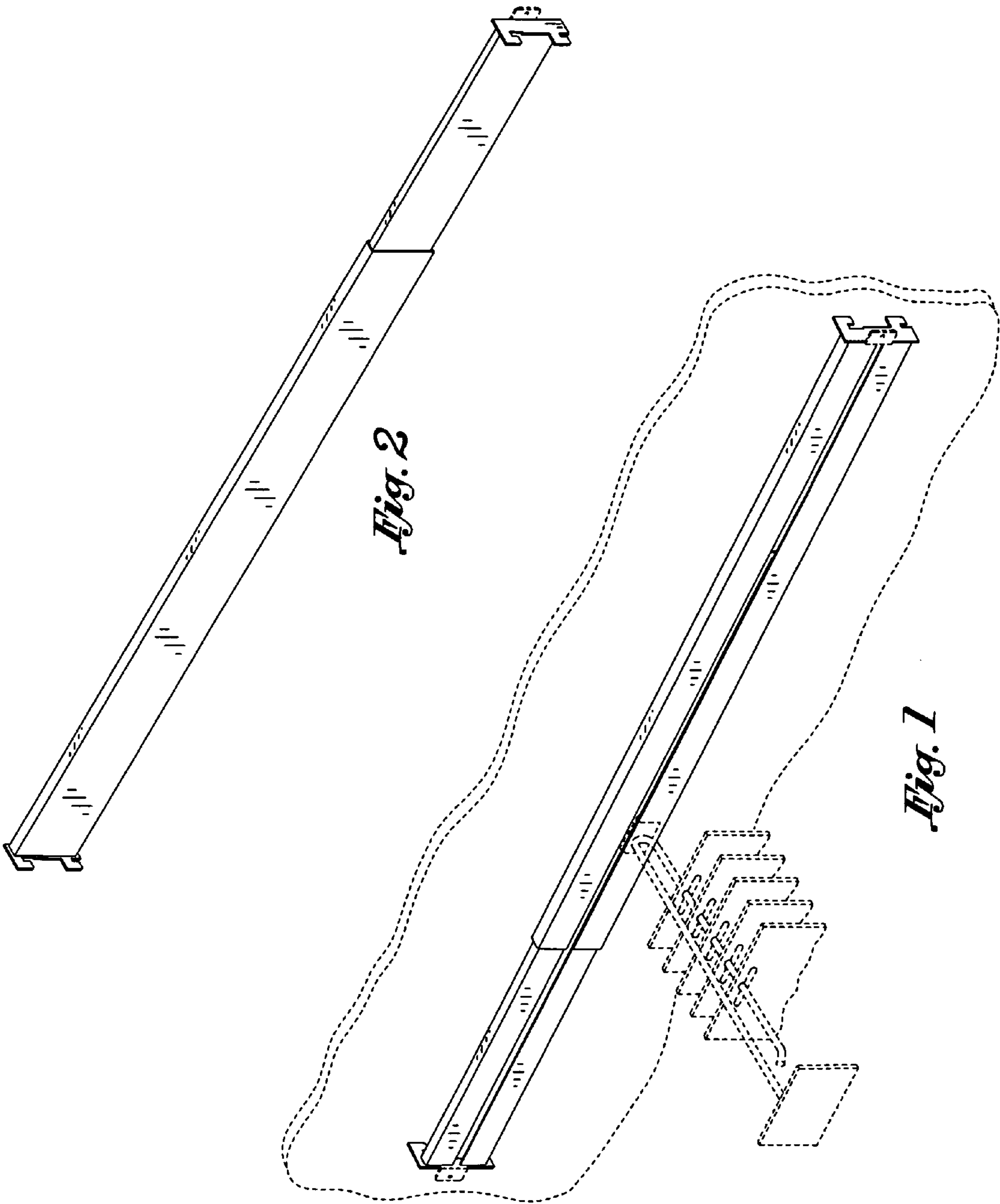
FIG. 10 is a rear perspective view with the two segments separated.

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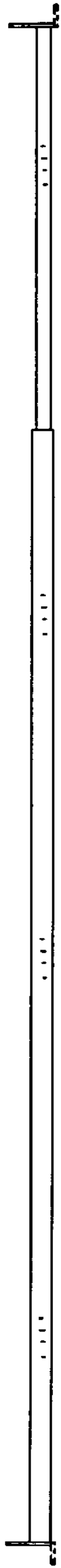

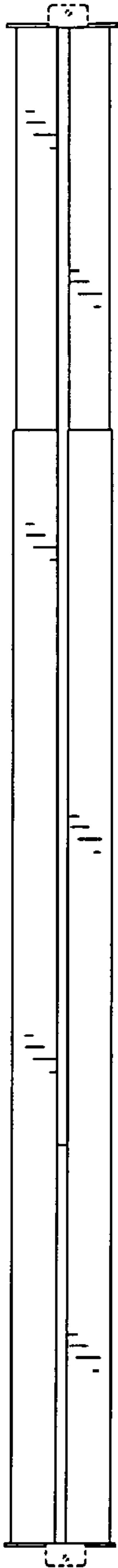

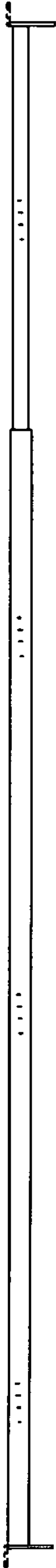

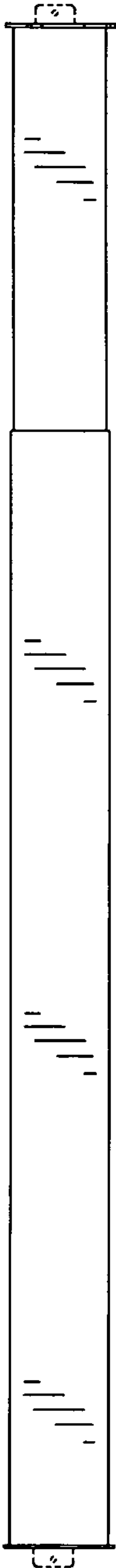

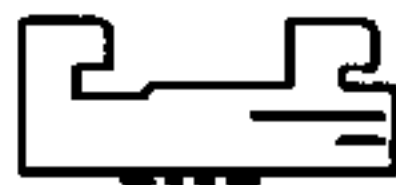
