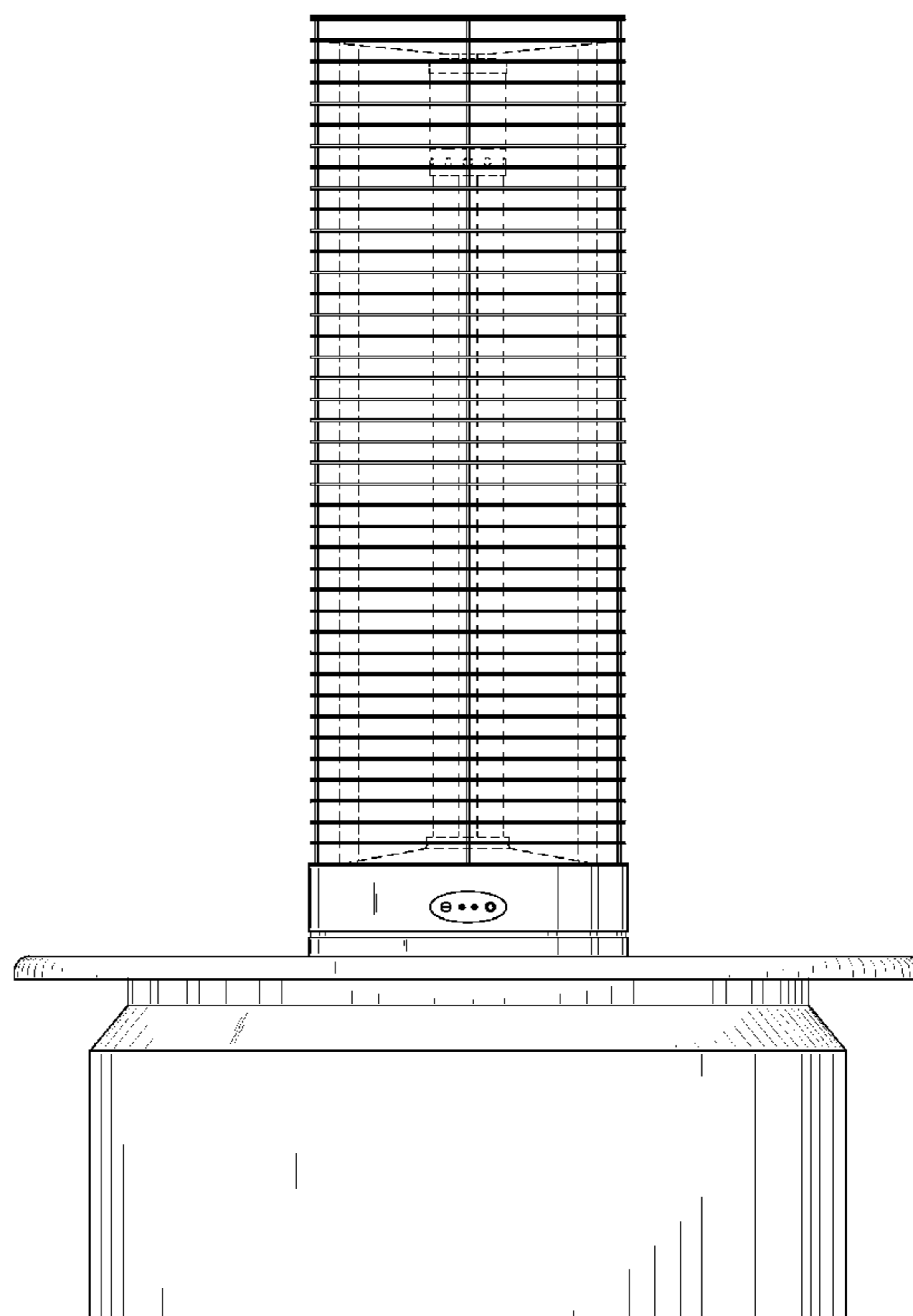

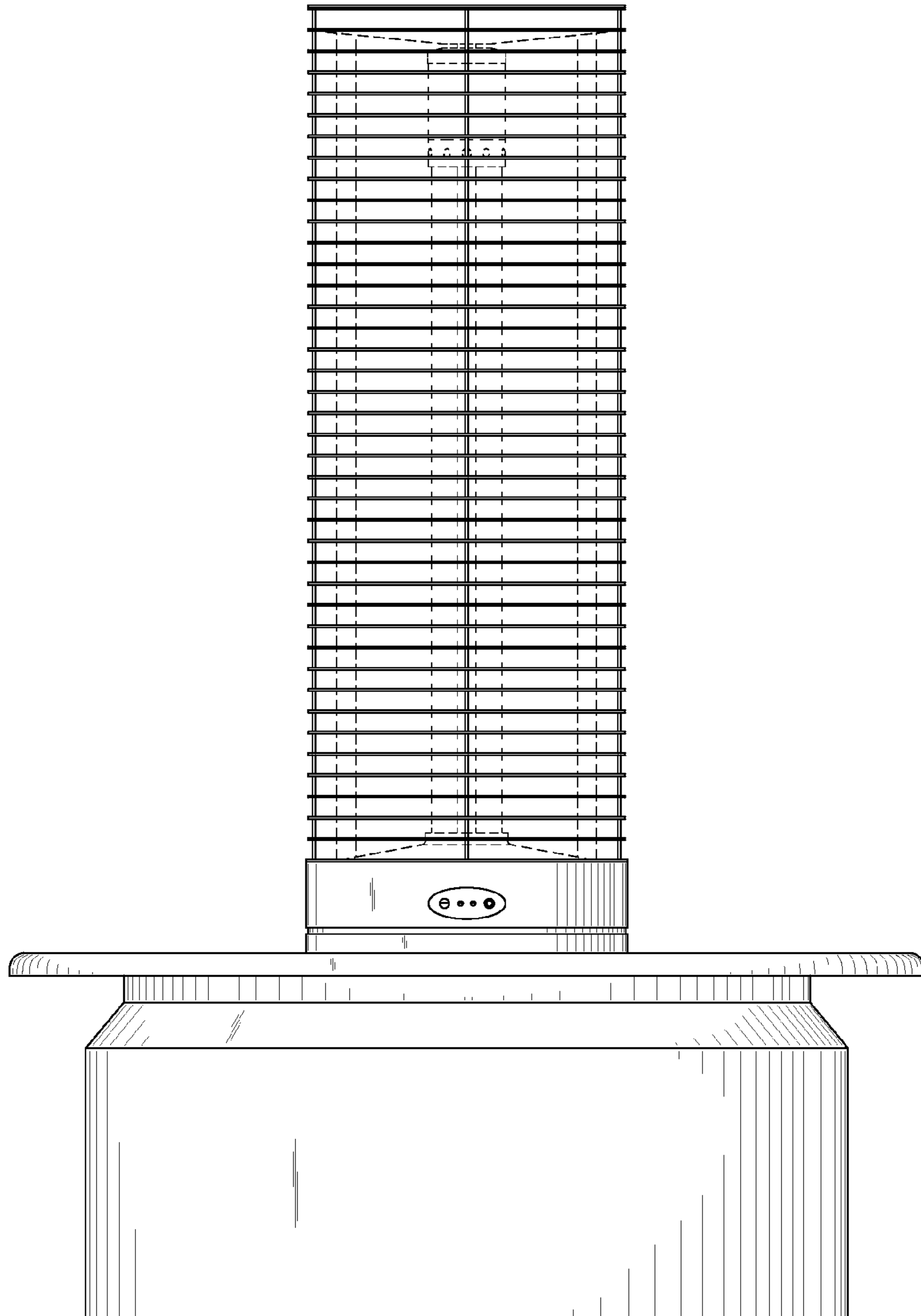

**DESCRIPTION**

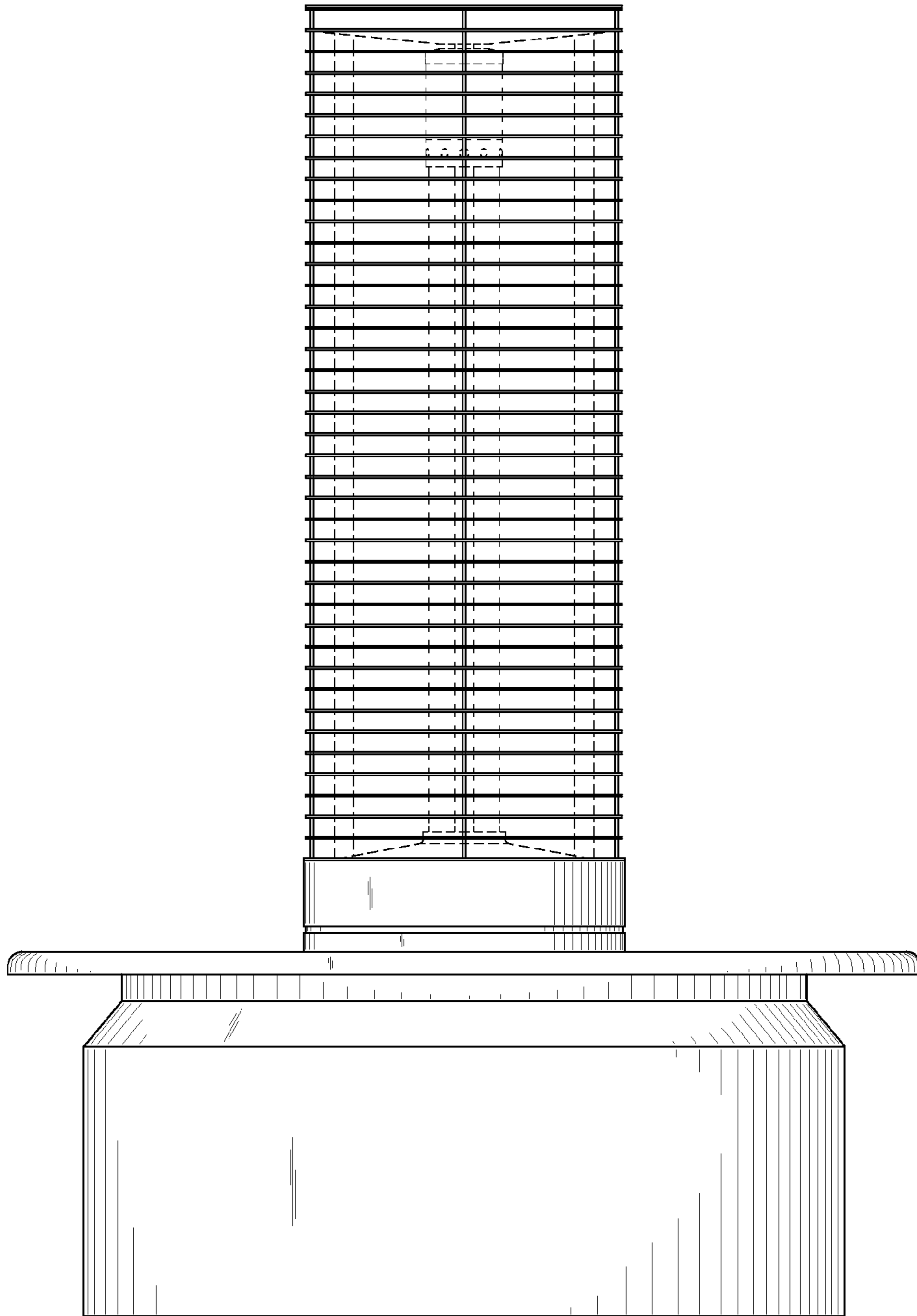
FIG. 1 is a front side view of a table flame heater showing my new design;

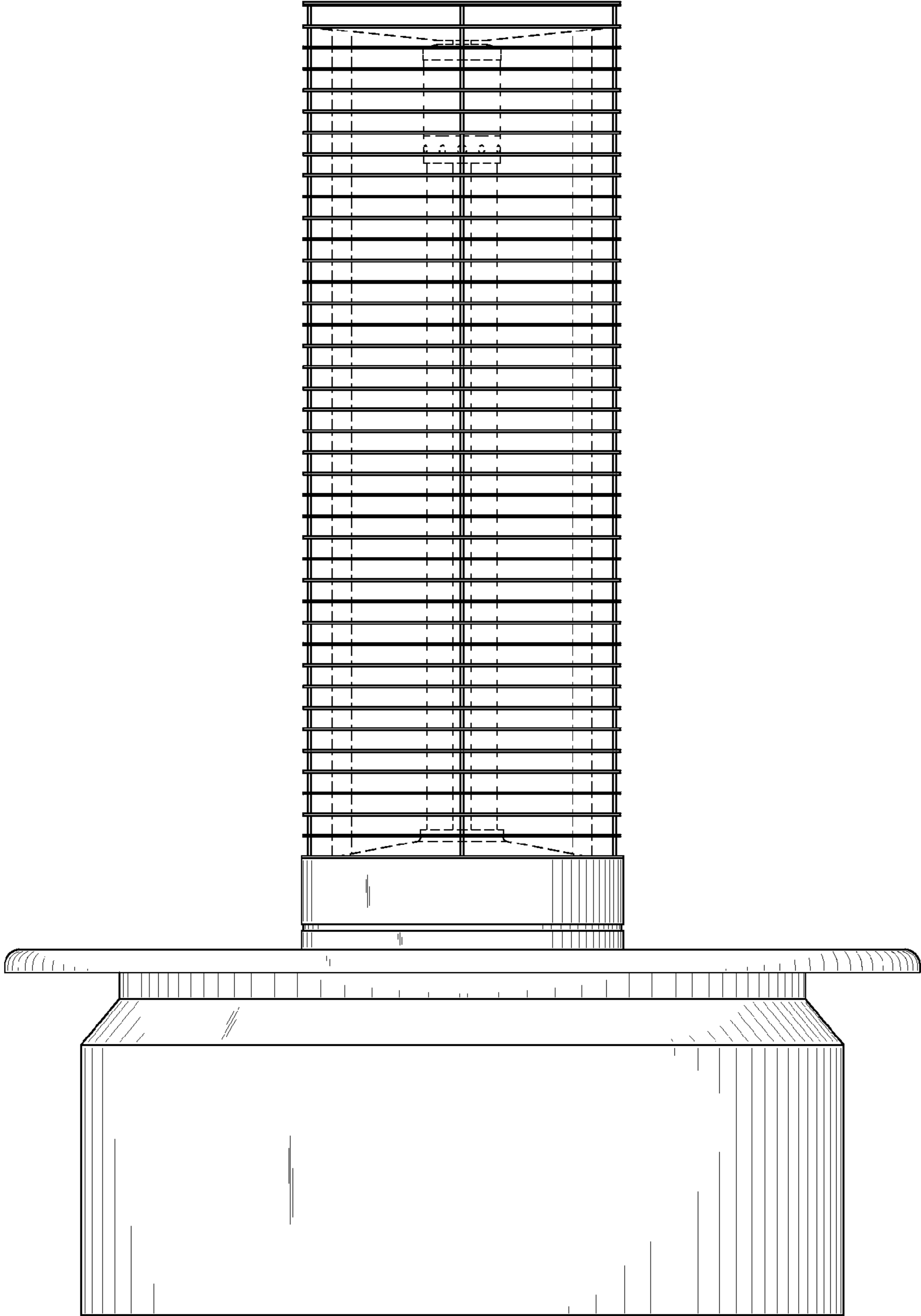




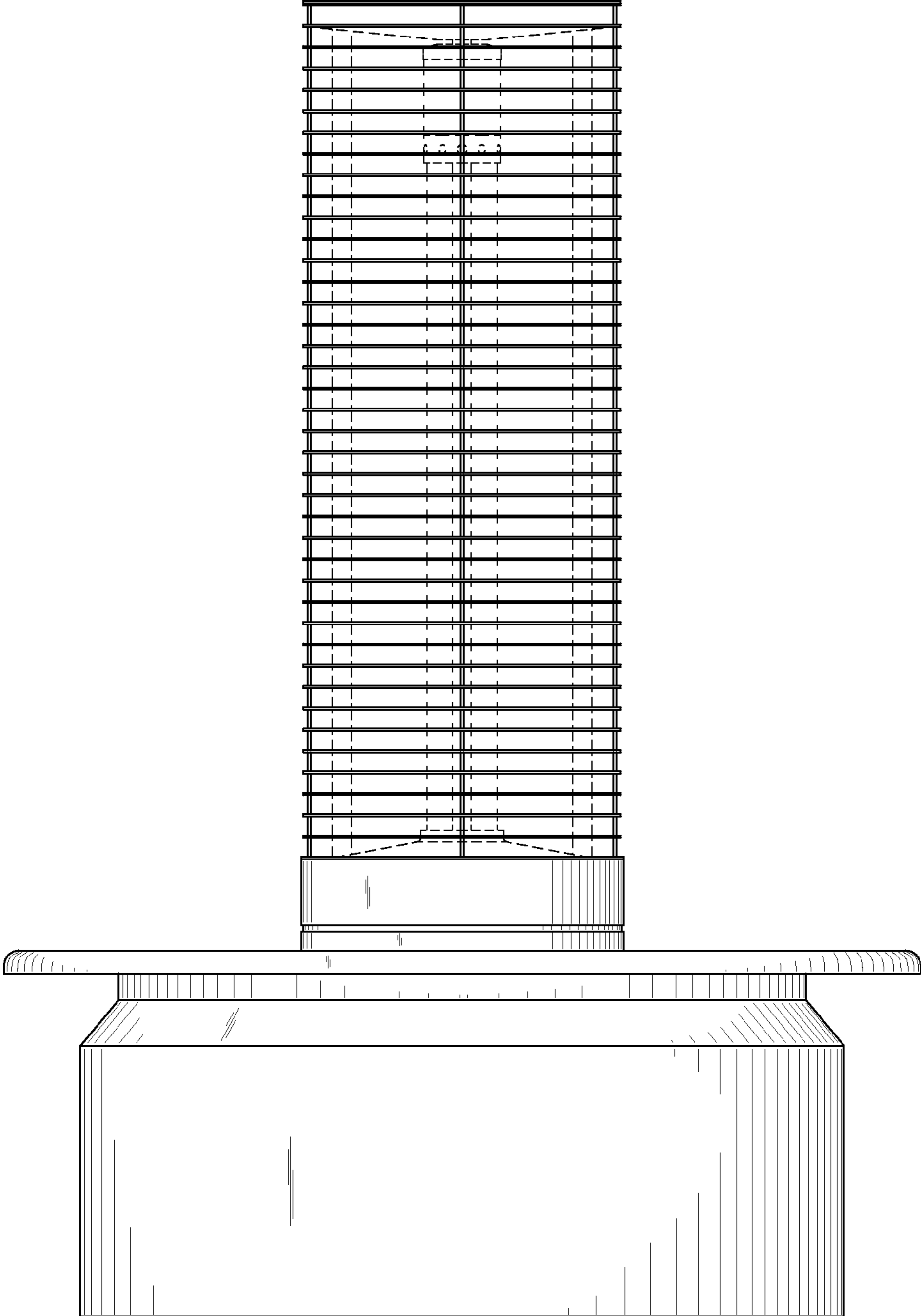

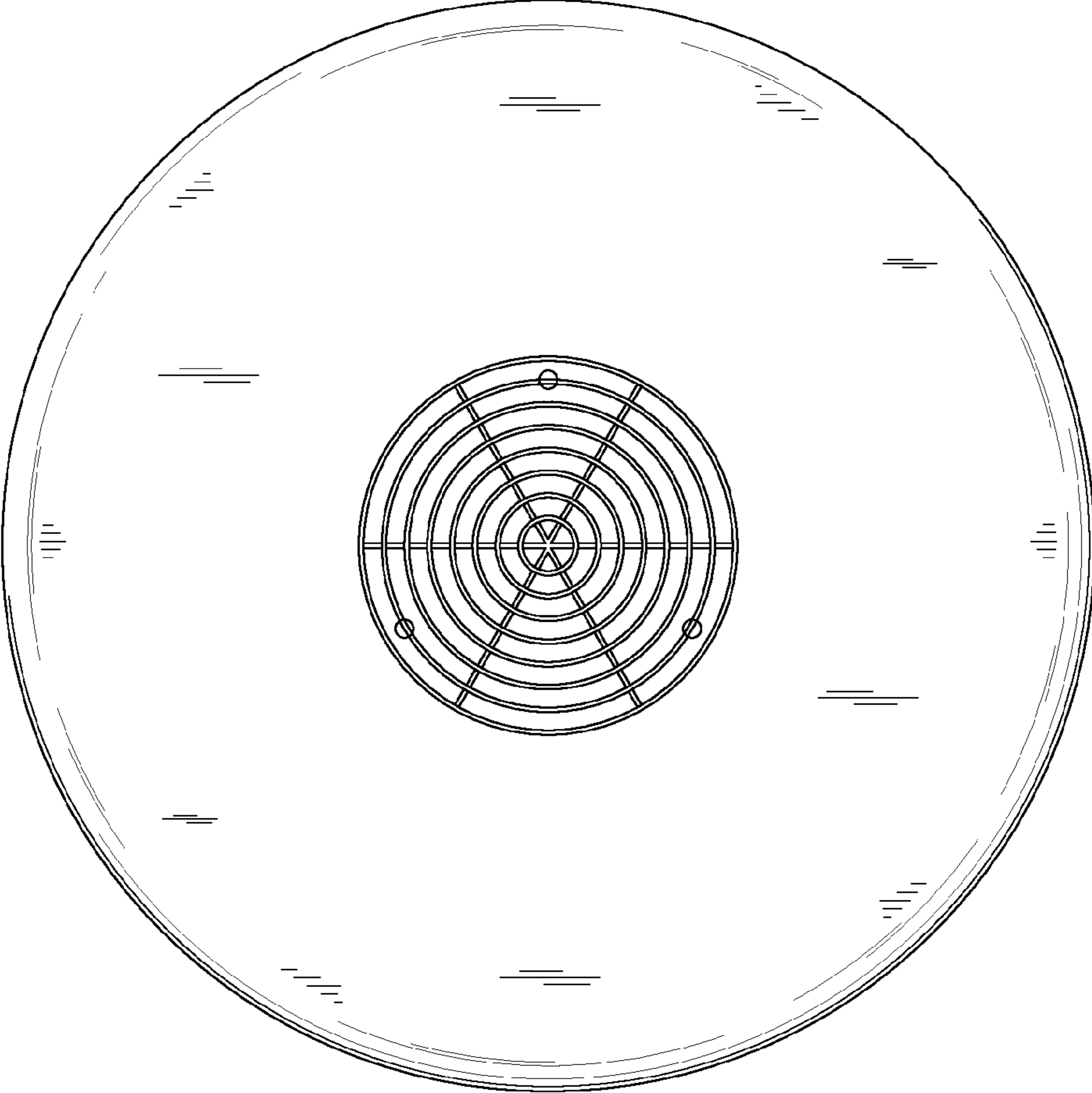
