(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for dog tag holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and bottom plan view, which are identical, of my new design for a dog tag holder, the broken lines indicate stitching, which is part of the claimed design.

FIG. 2 is a left and right side elevation view, which are identical, of FIGS. 1 and 9.

FIG. 3 is a front and back elevation view, which are identical, of FIGS. 1 and 9.

FIG. 4 is a top perspective view of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 a top and bottom plan view, which are identical, of an alternate embodiment of my new design for a dog tag holder.

FIG. 6 is a left and right side elevation view, which are identical, of FIGS. 5 and 12.

FIG. 7 is a front and back elevation view, which are identical, of FIGS. 5 and 12.

FIG. 8 is a top perspective view of FIG. 5.

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of an alternate embodiment of my new design for a dog tag holder, the broken lines indicate stitching, which is part of the claimed design.

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 9.

FIG. 11 is a top perspective view of FIG. 9.

FIG. 12 is a top plan view of an alternate embodiment of my new design for a dog tag holder.

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 12; and,

FIG. 14 is a top perspective view of FIG. 12.

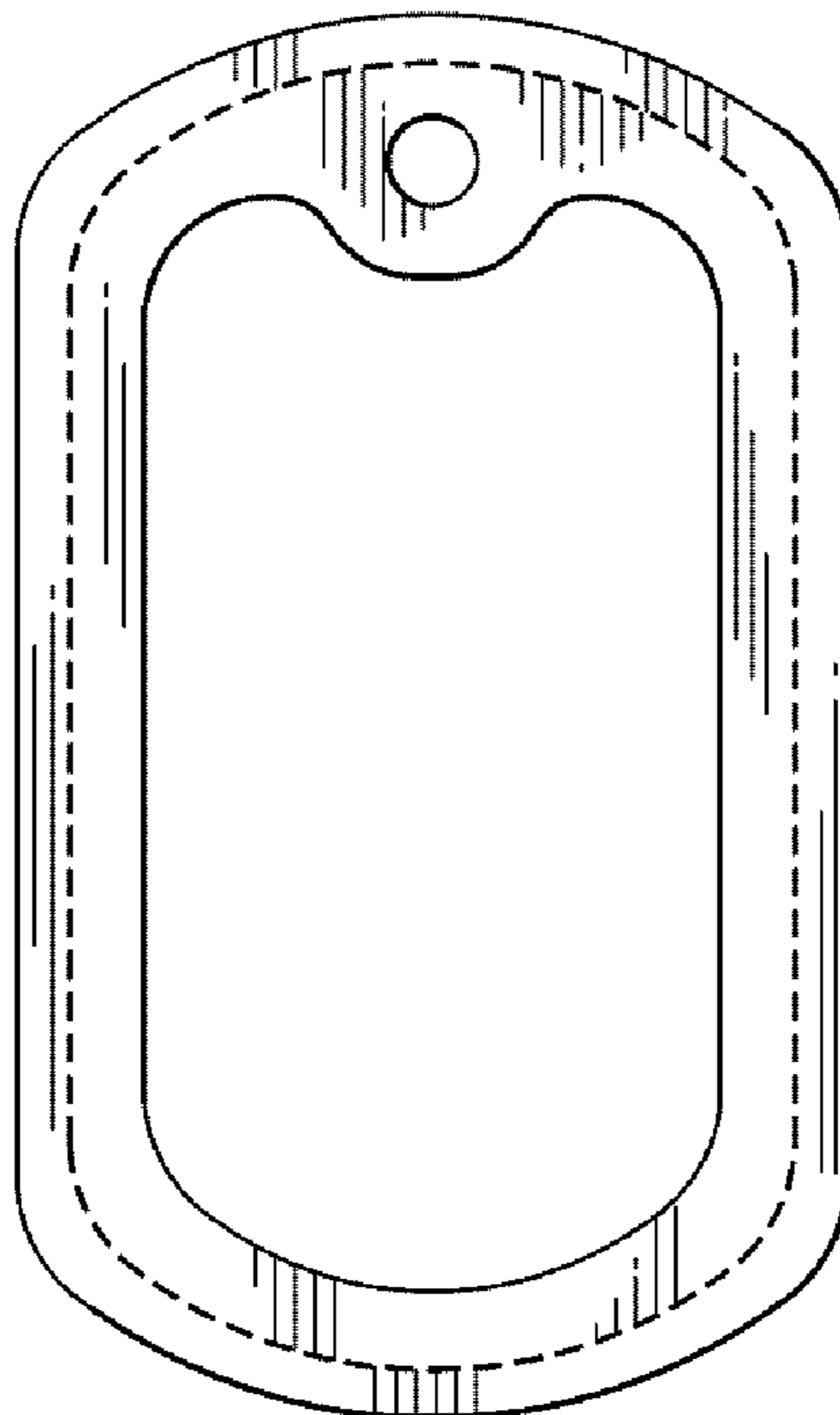

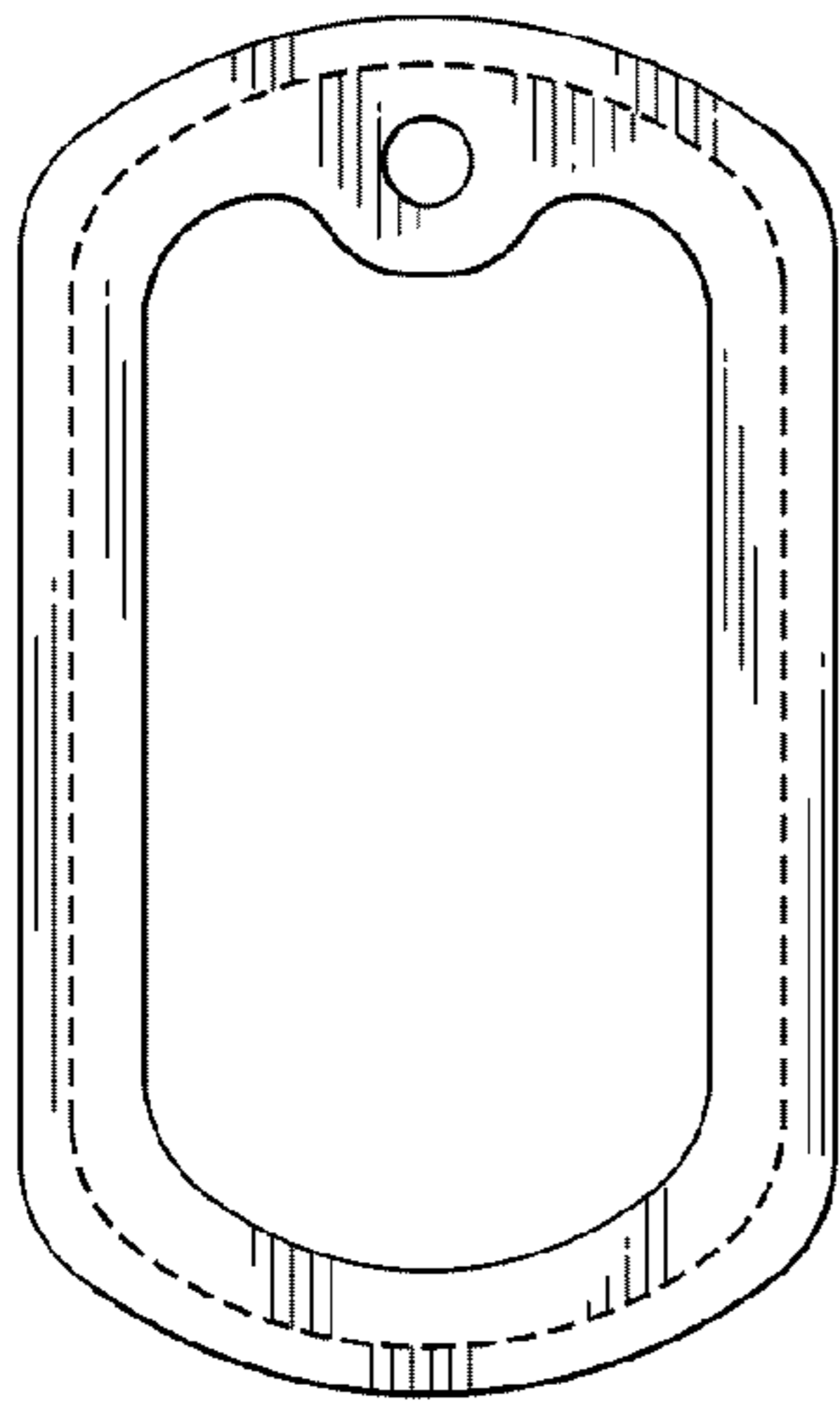

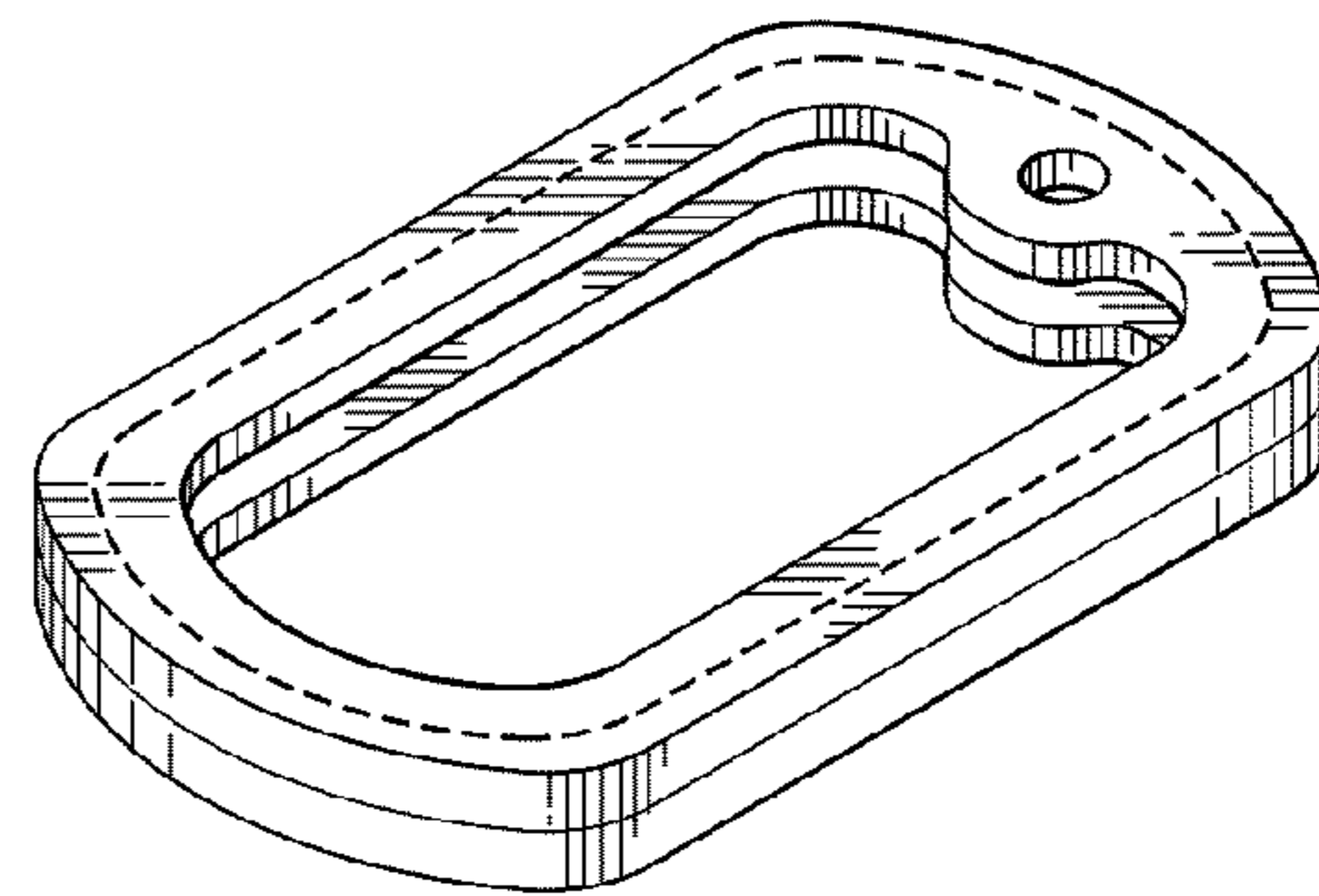

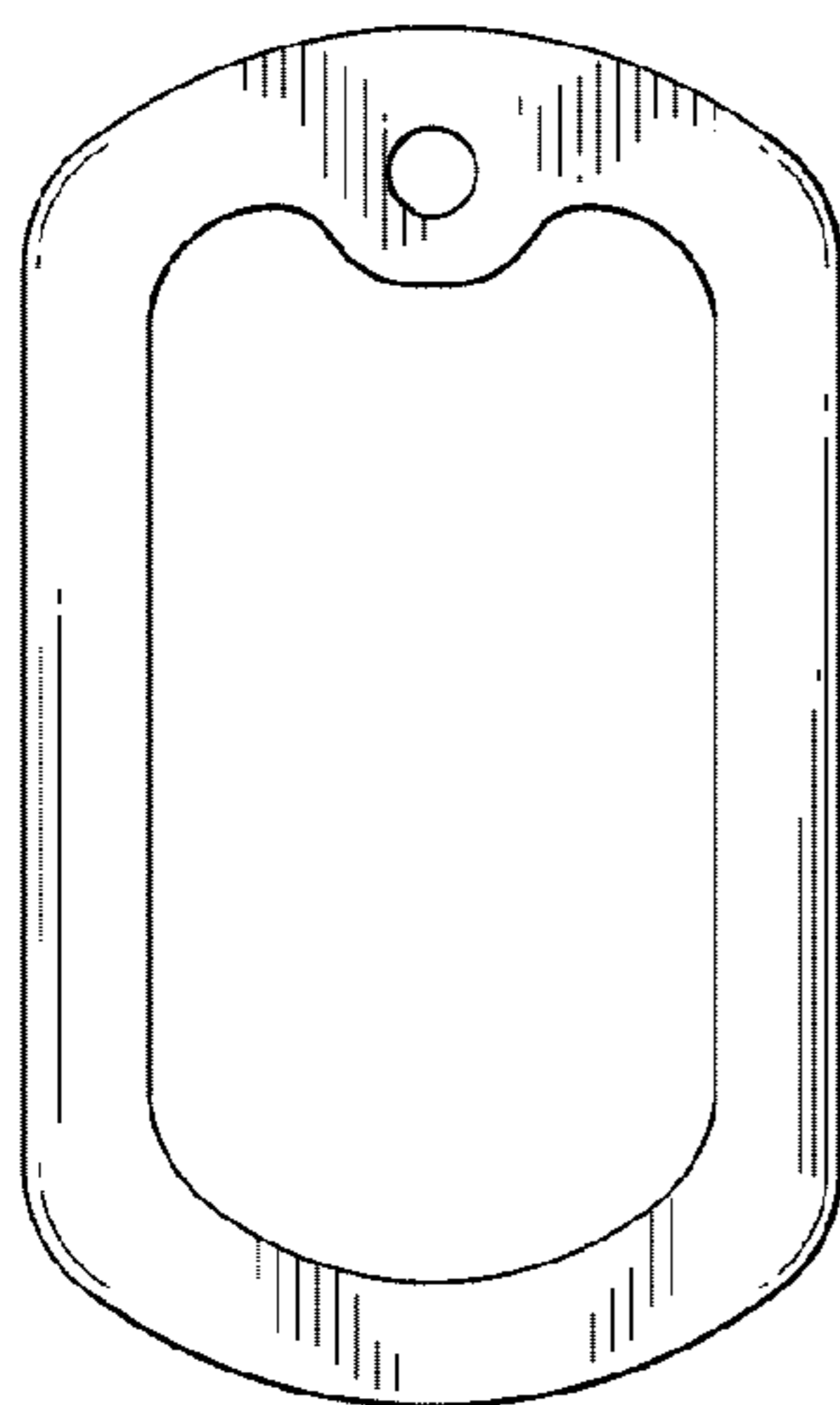

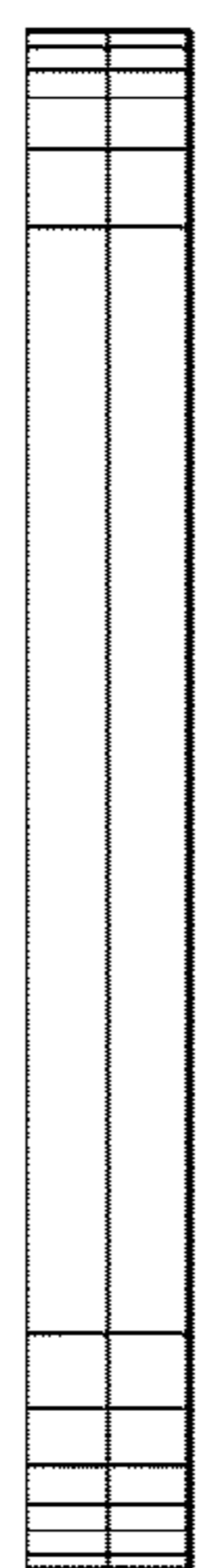

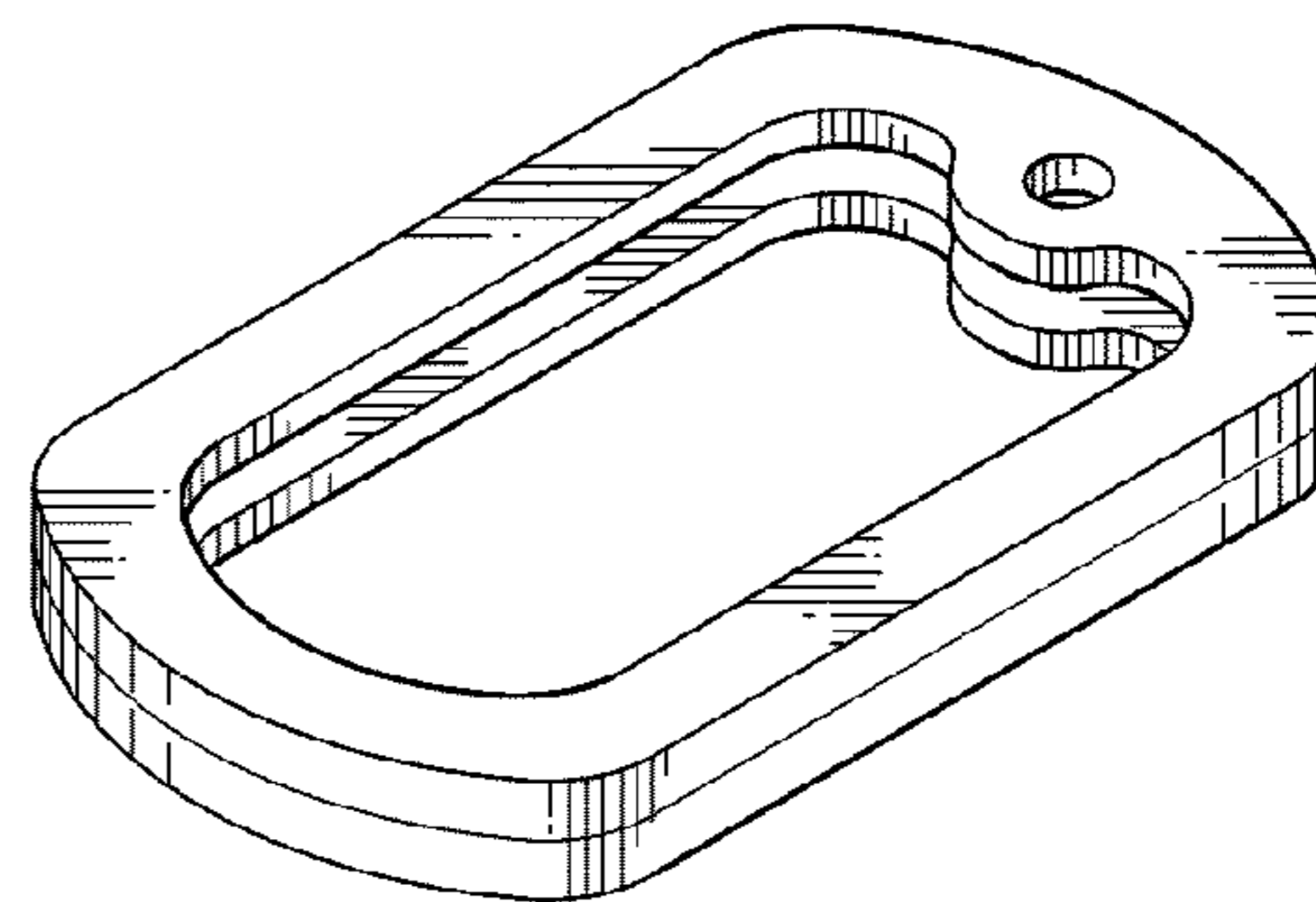

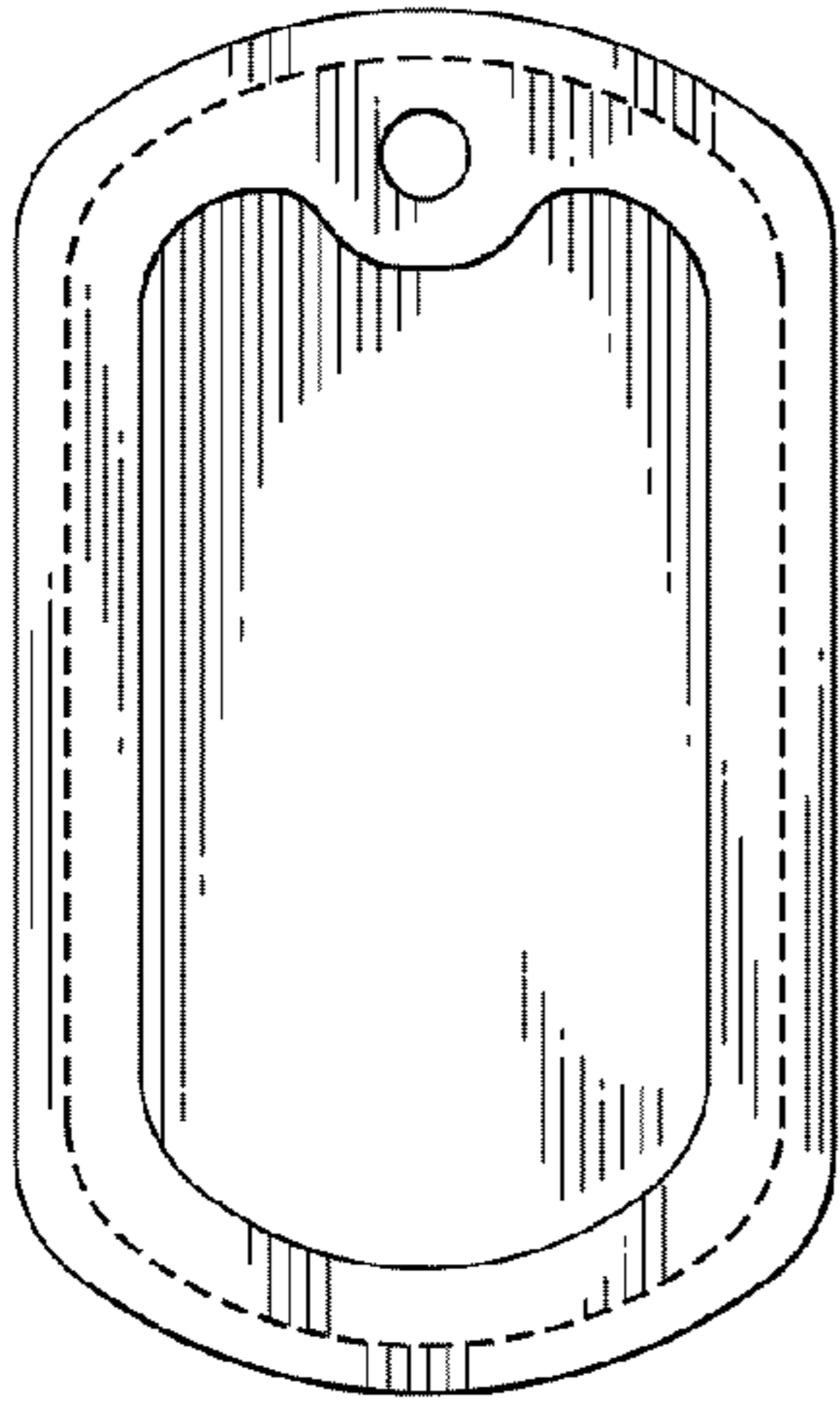

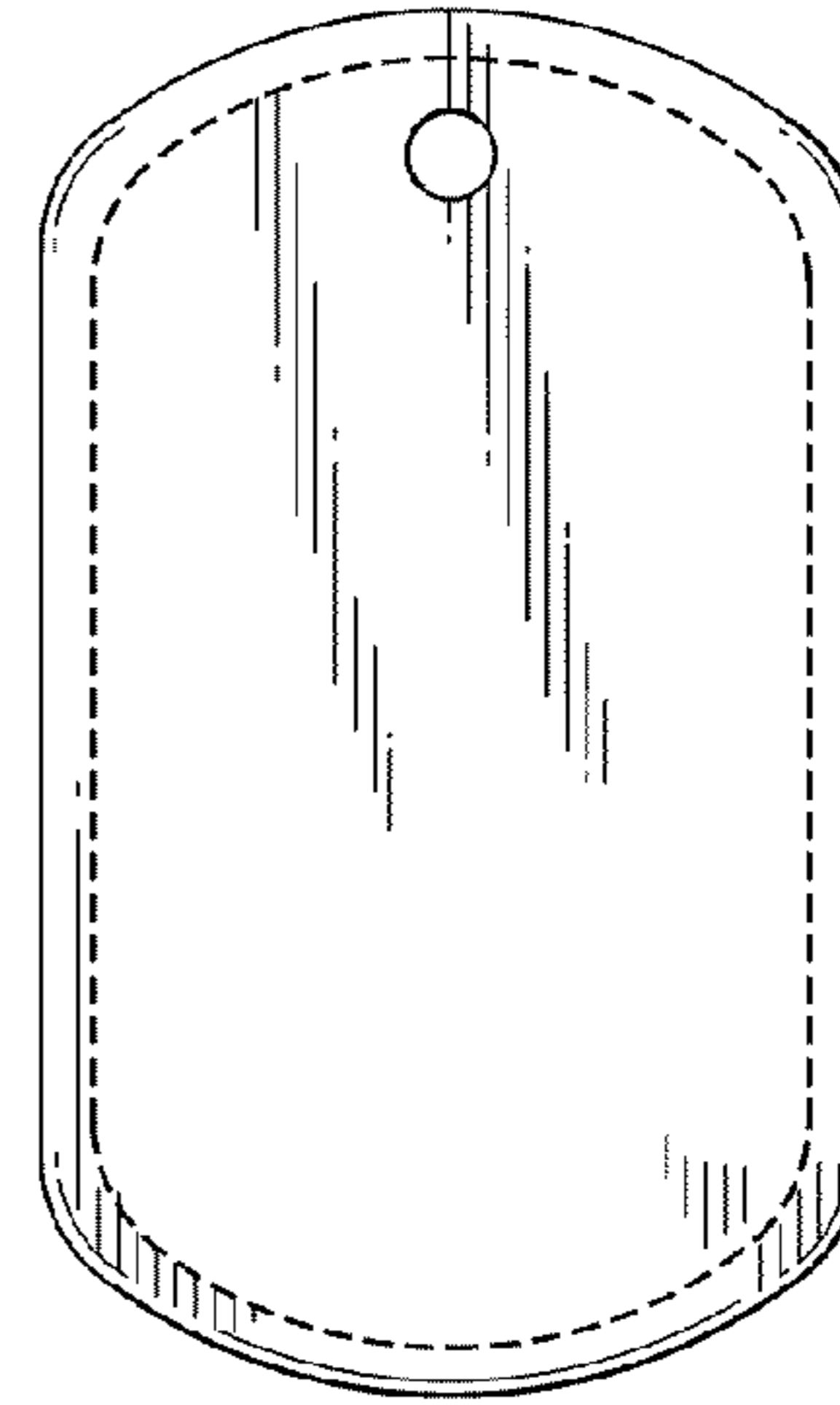

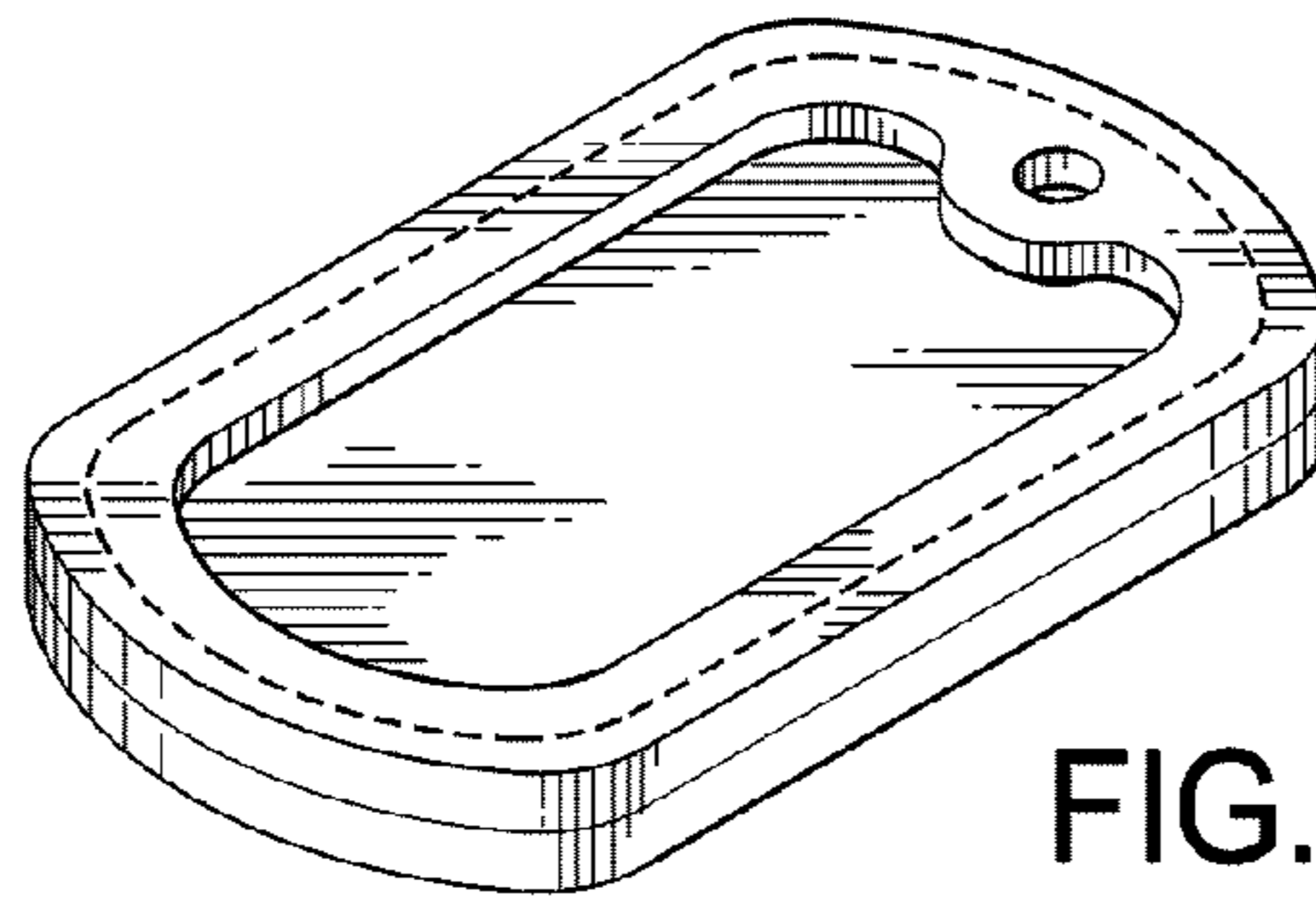

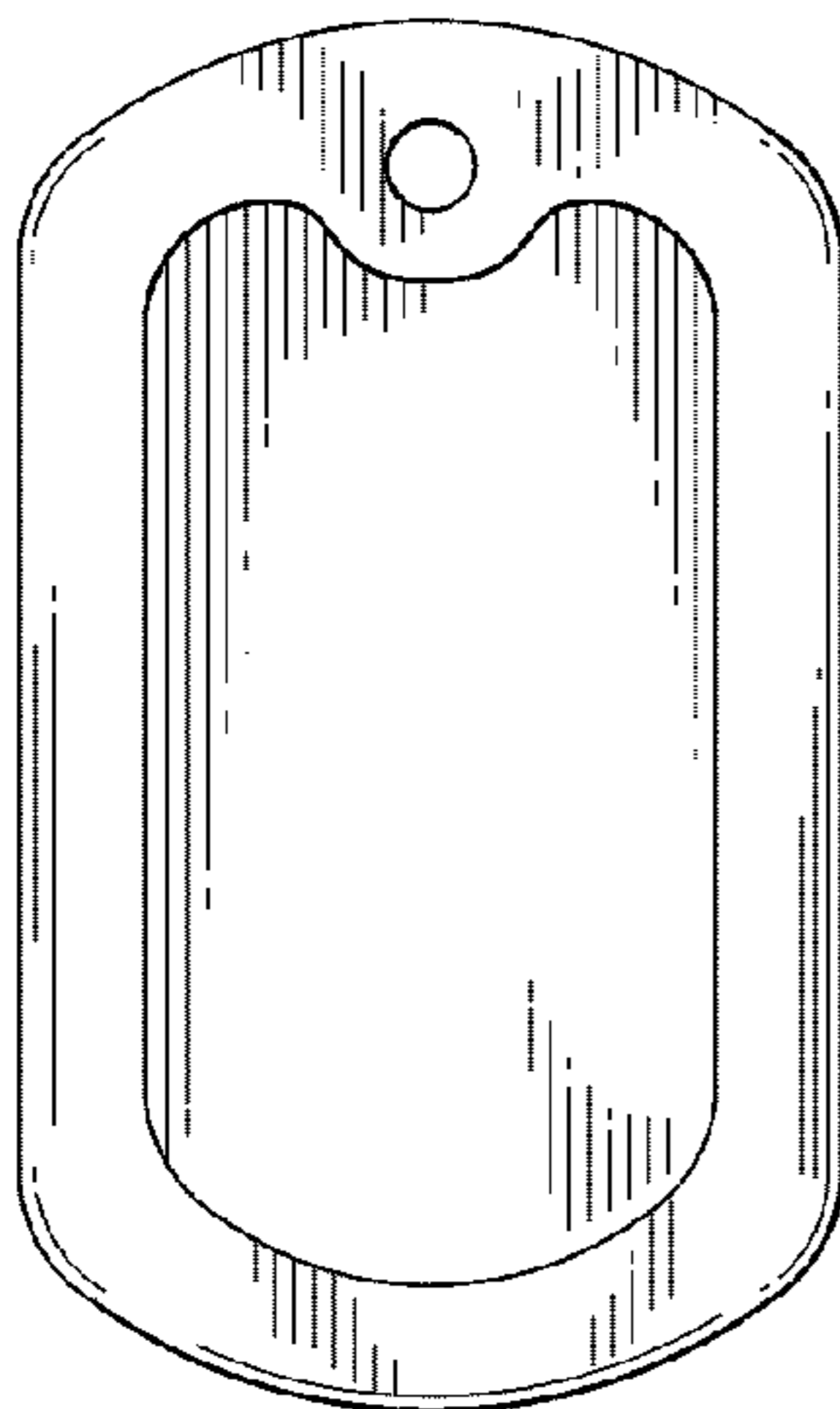

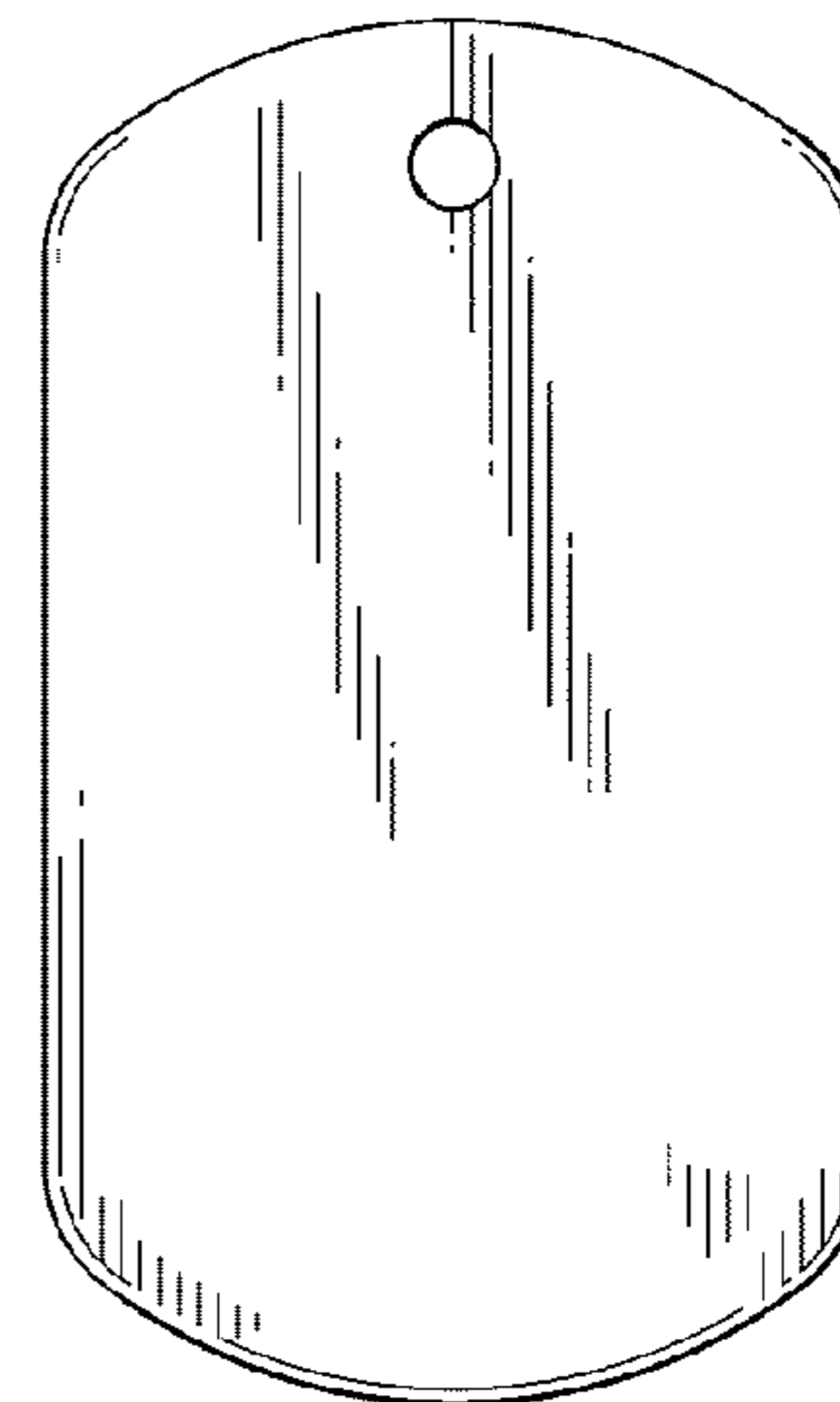

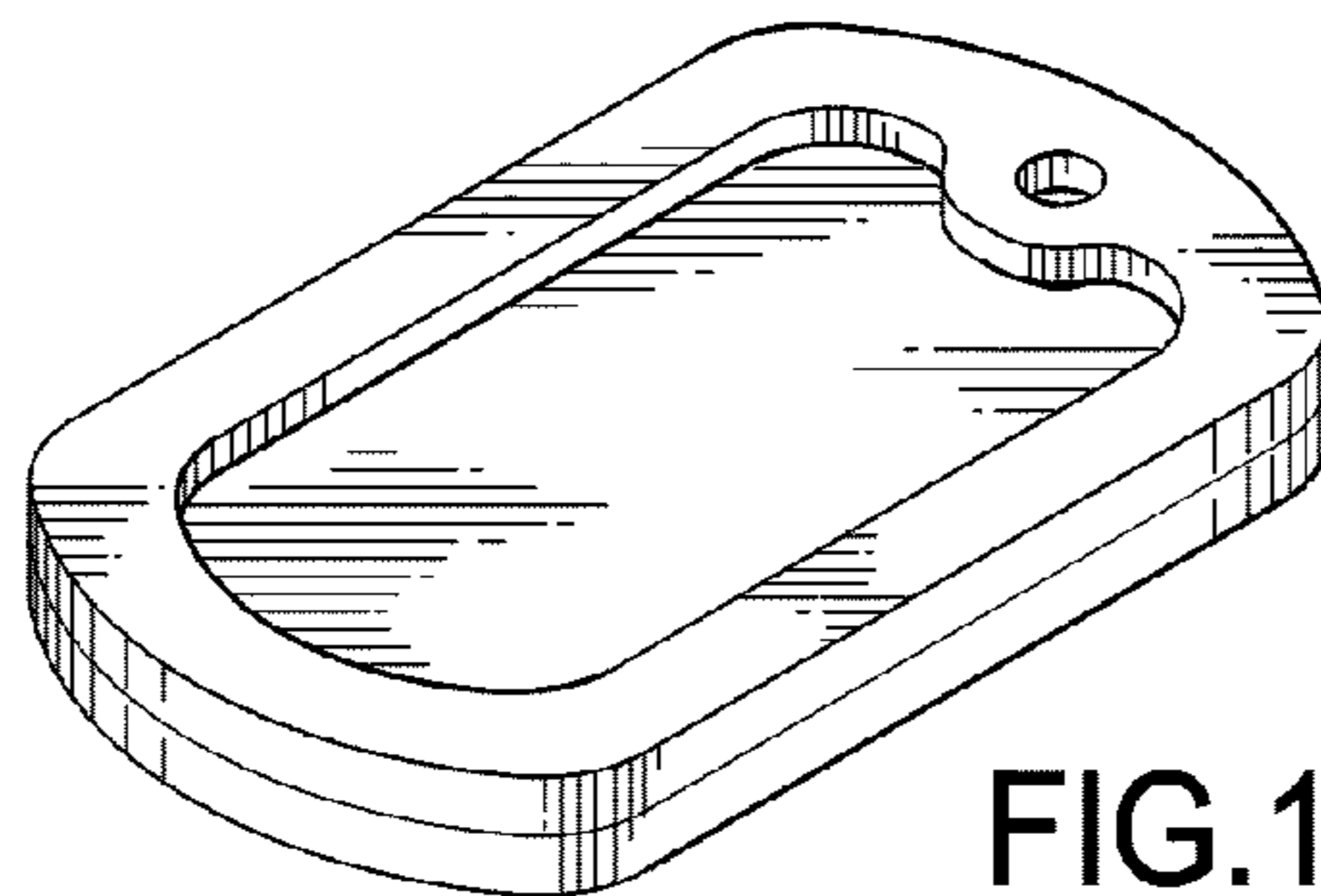
