FIG. 15 is an end elevational view thereof;

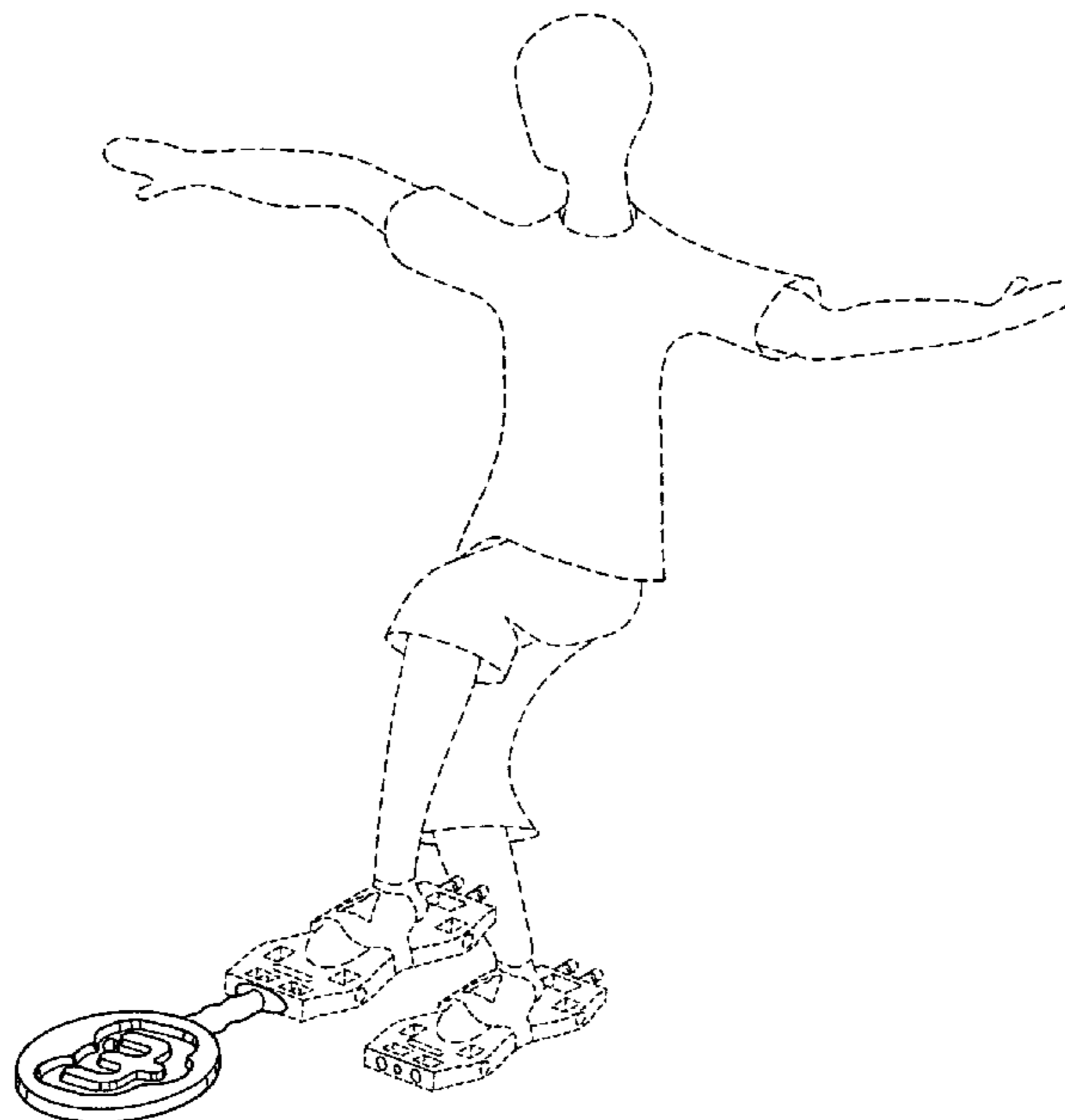
FIG. 16 is a side elevational view thereof; and,

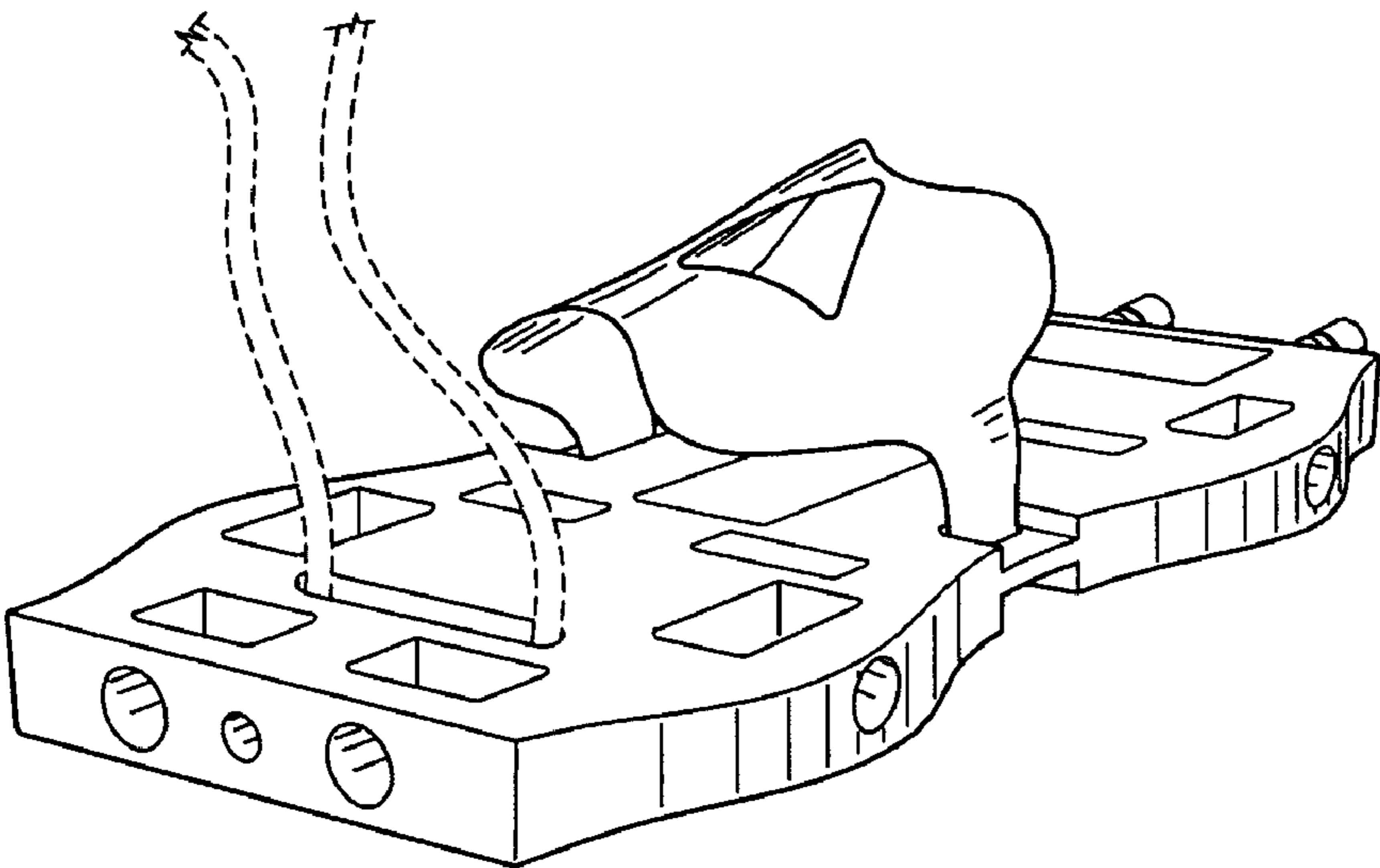

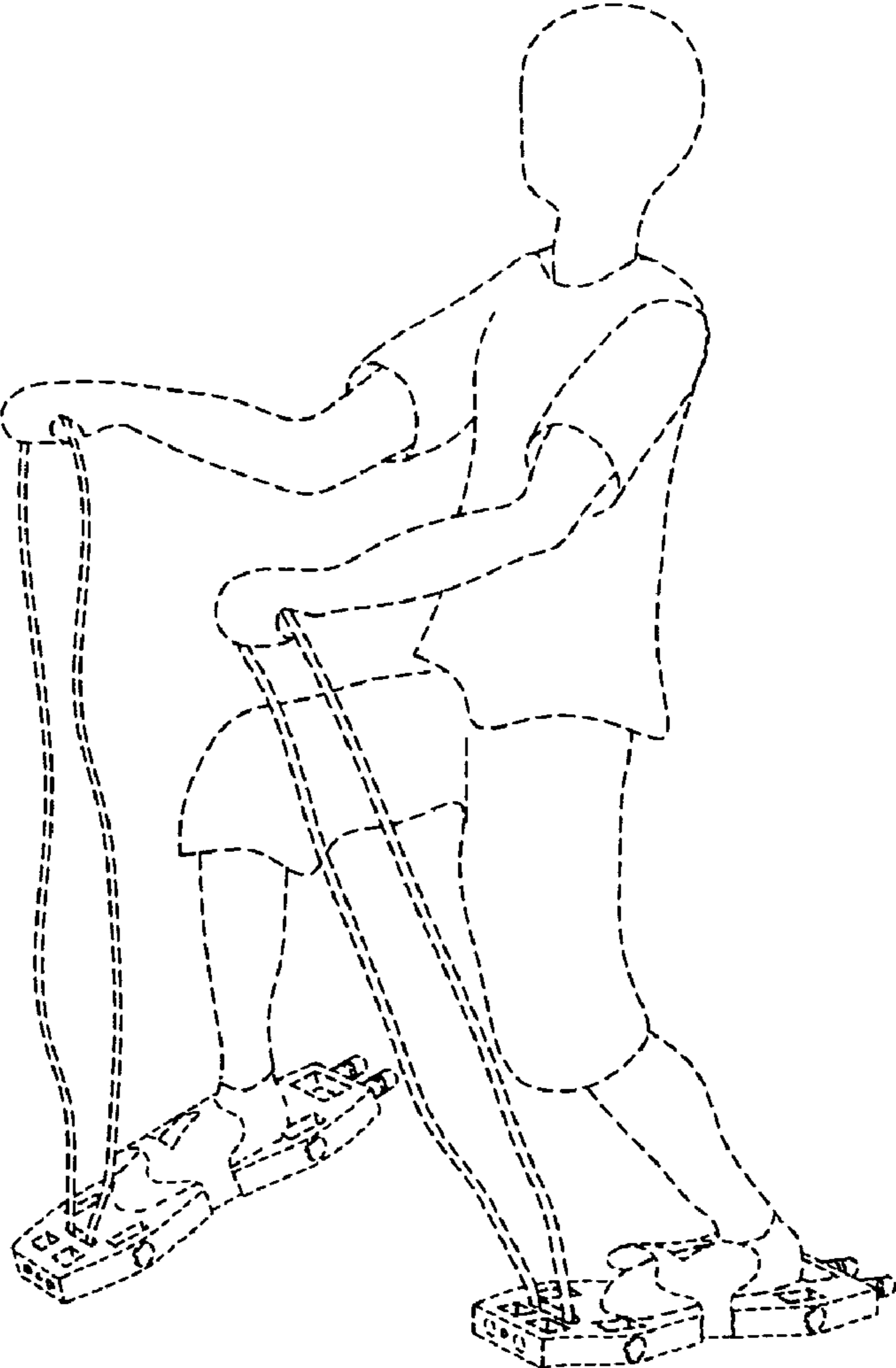

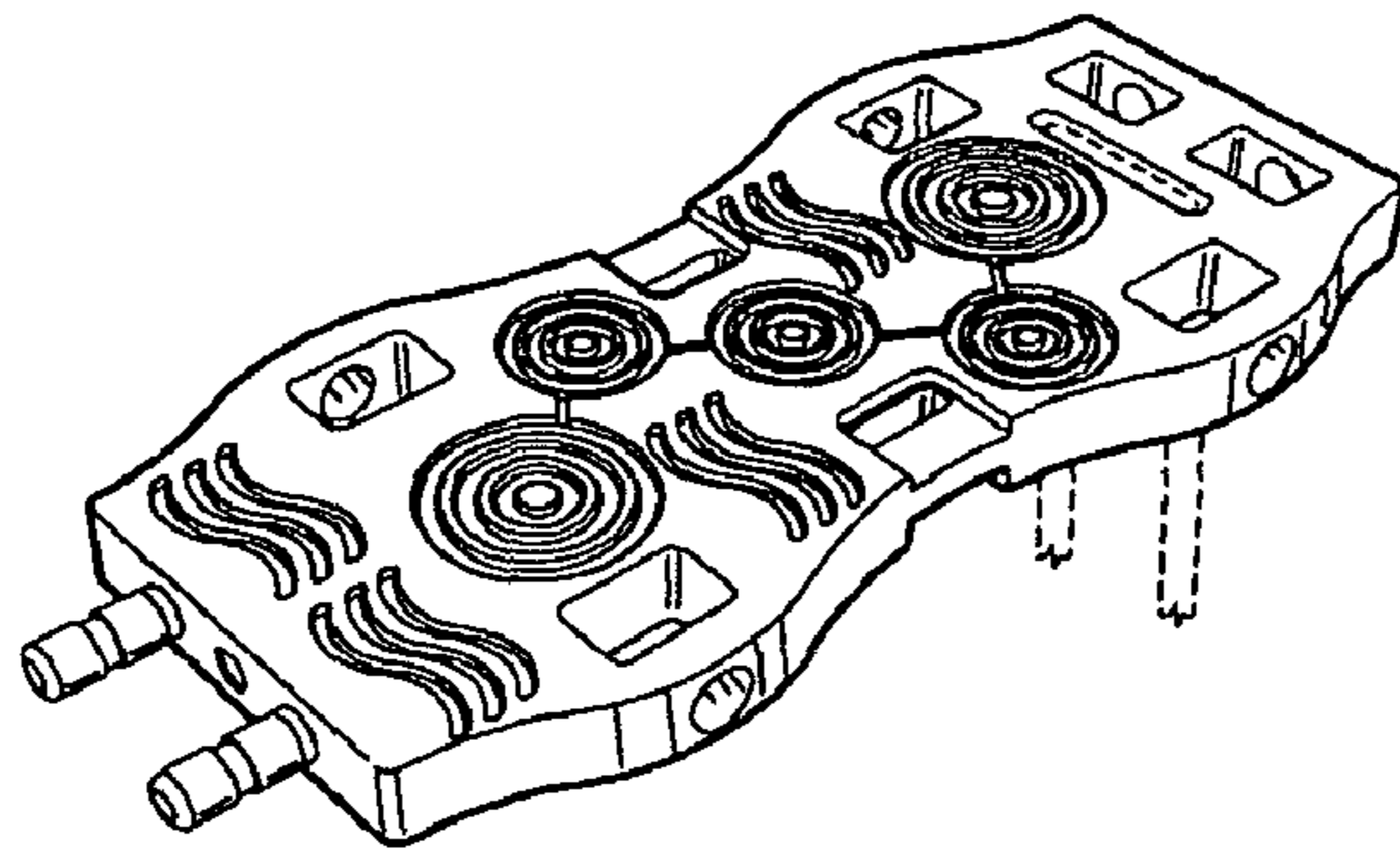

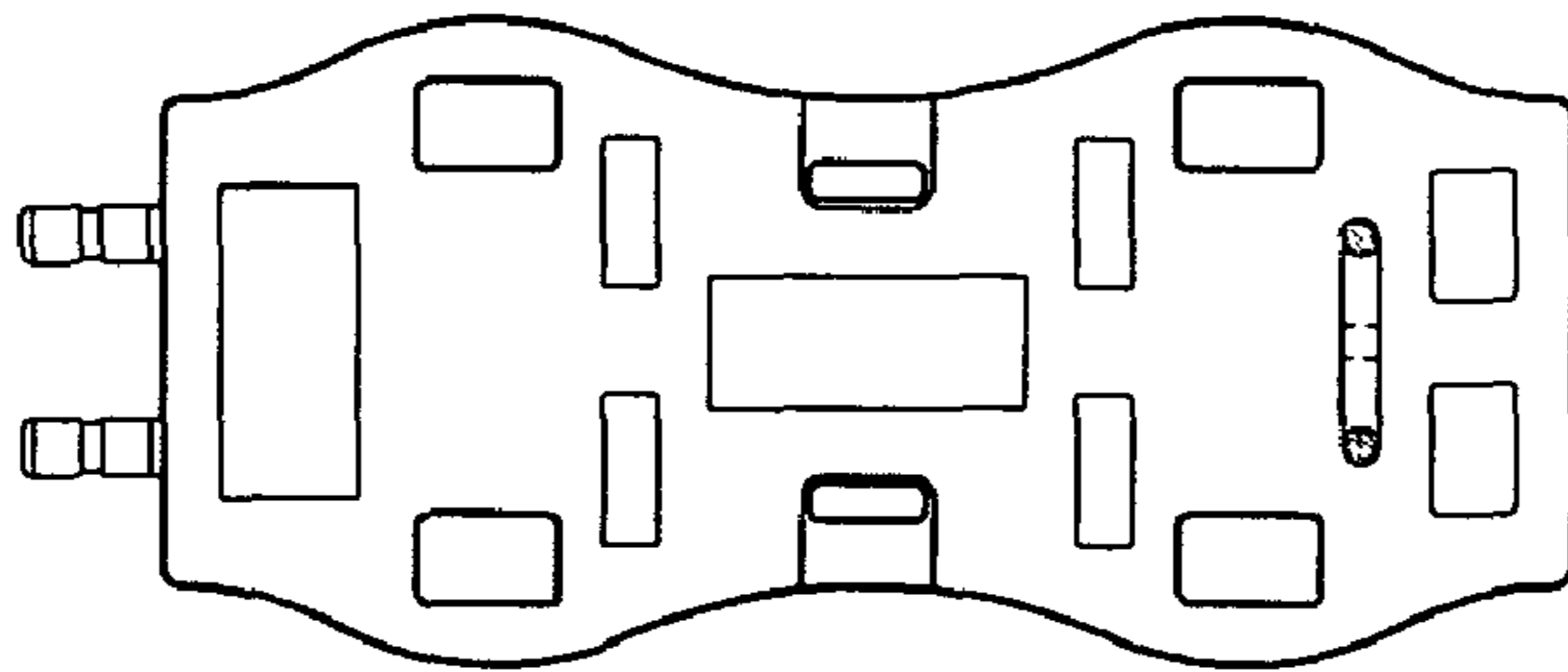

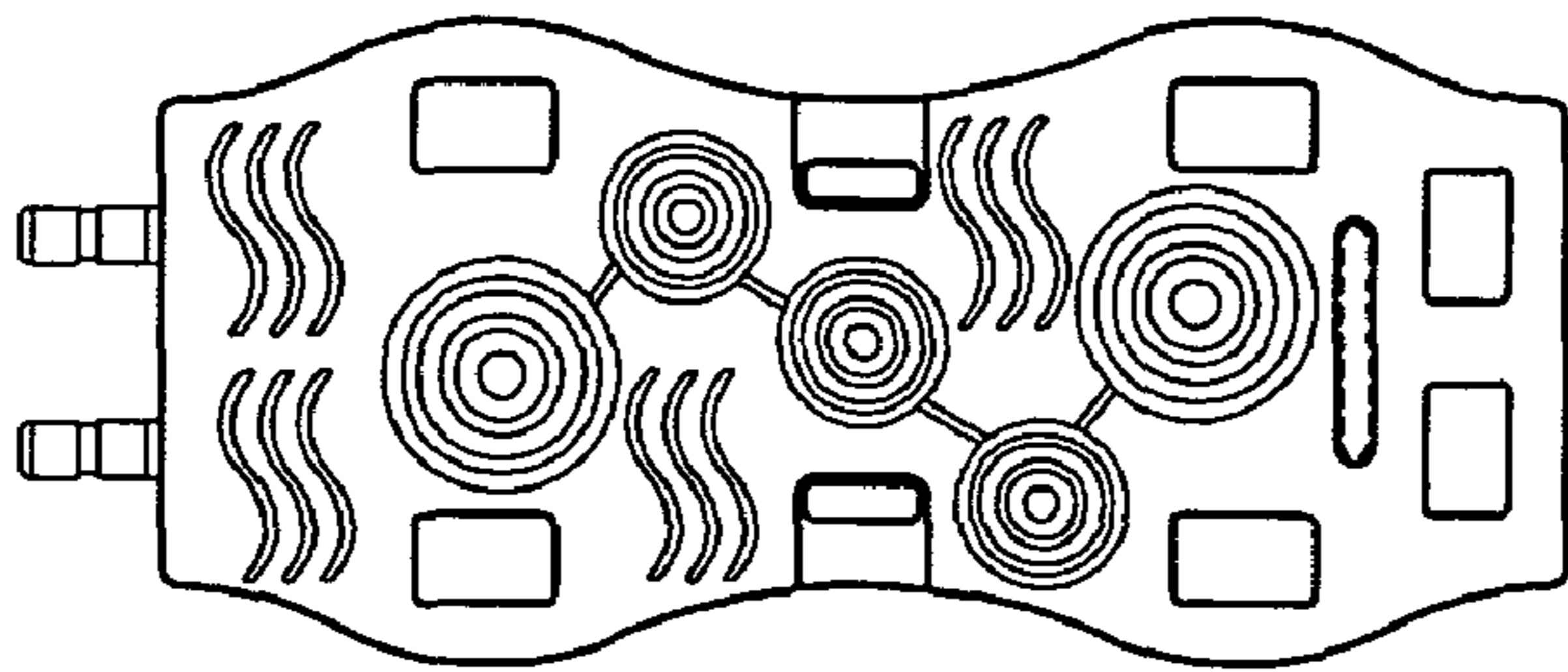

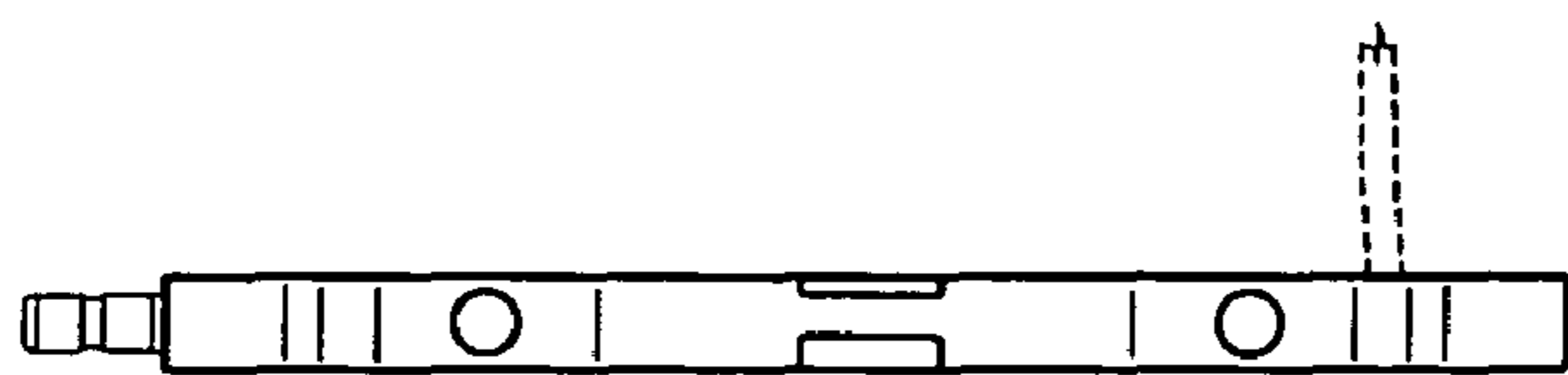

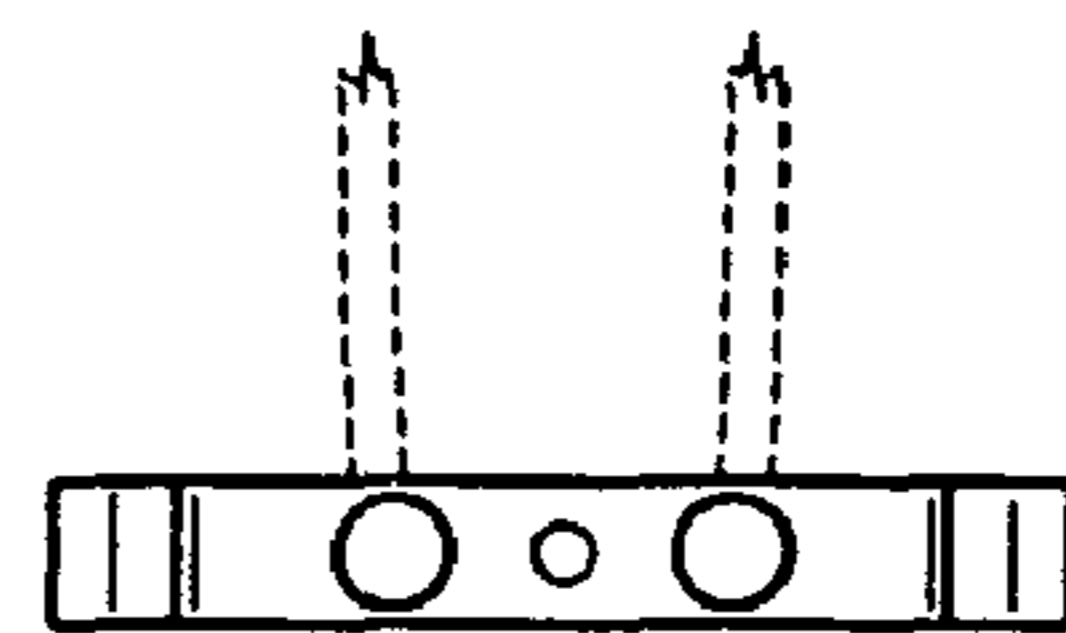

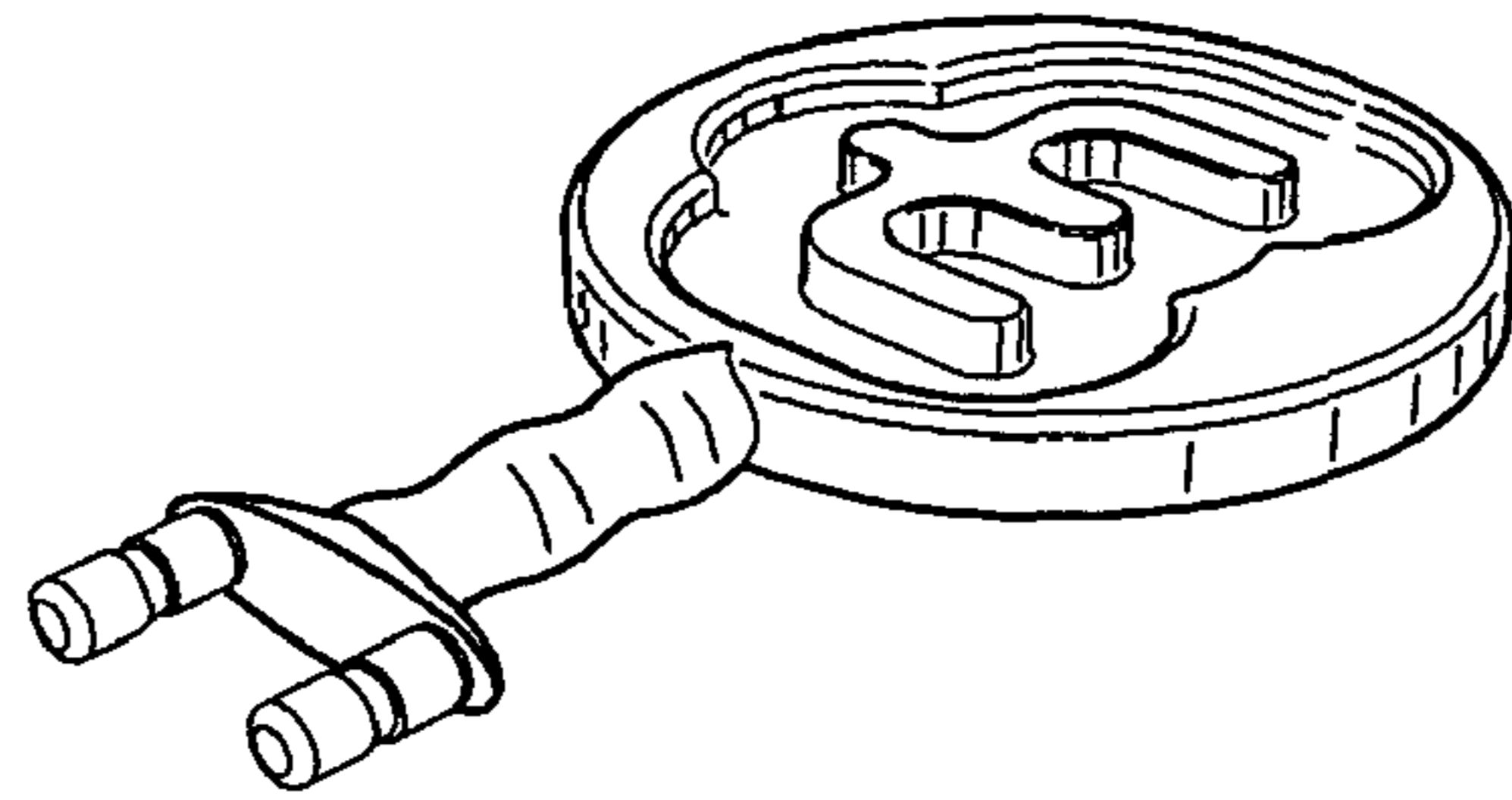

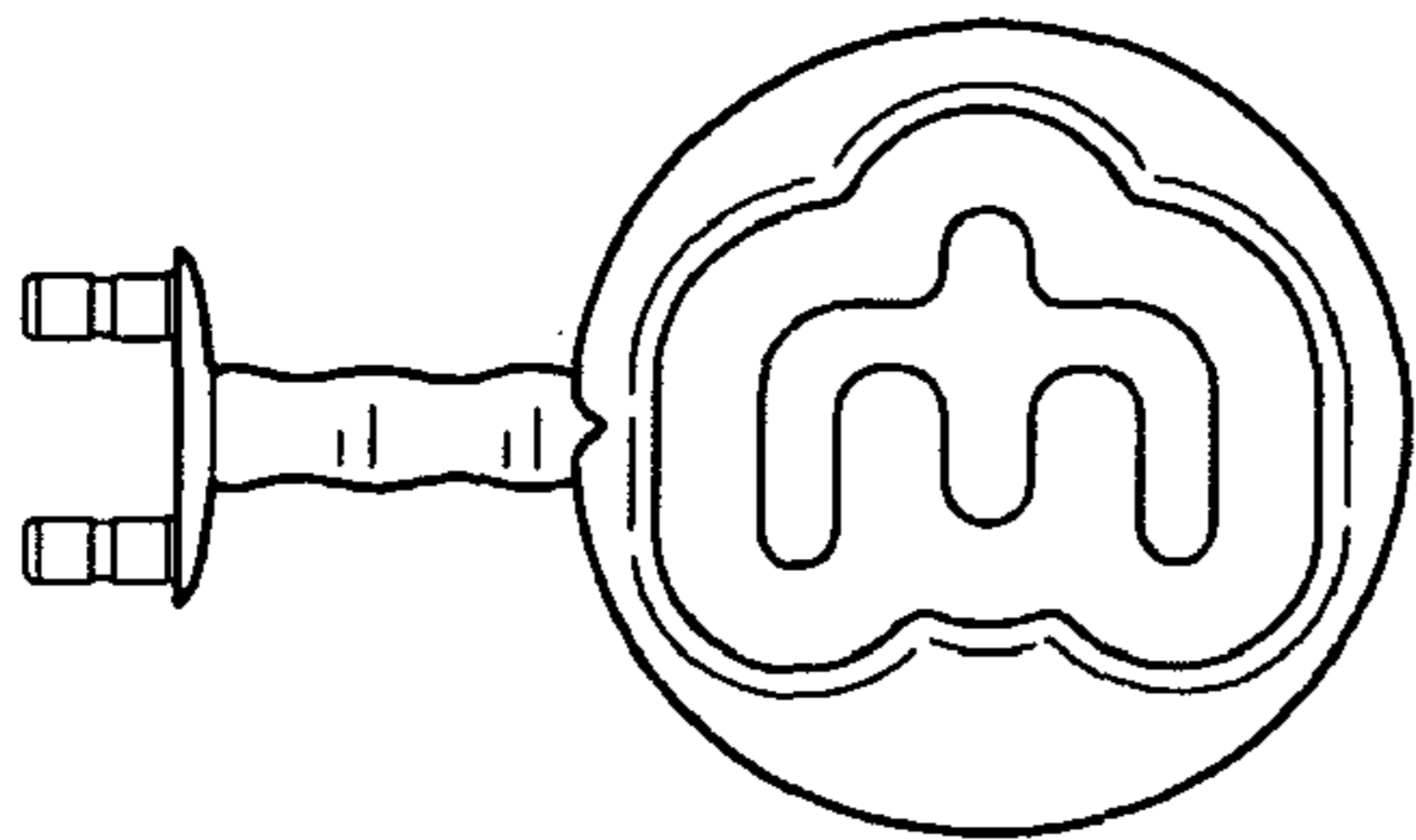

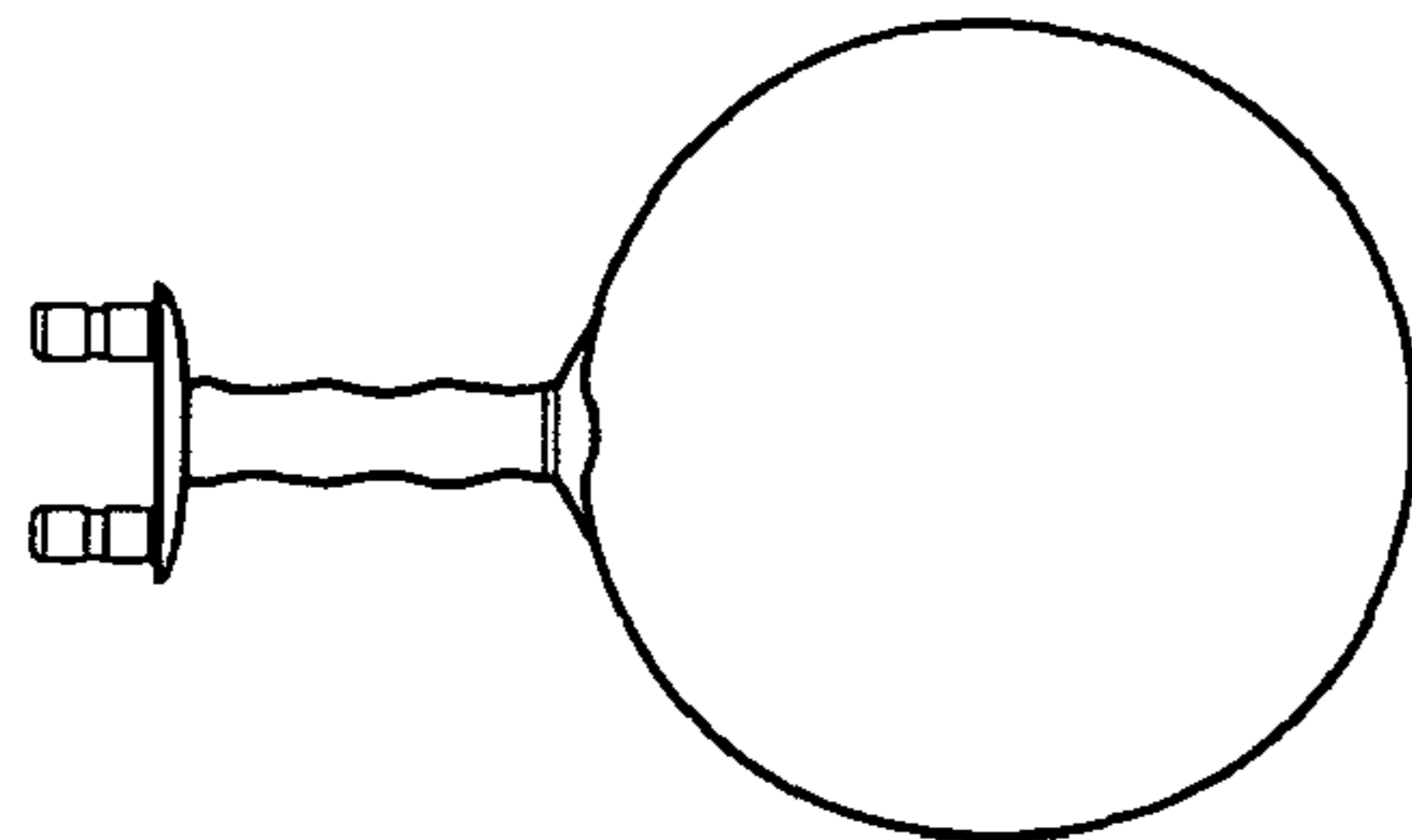

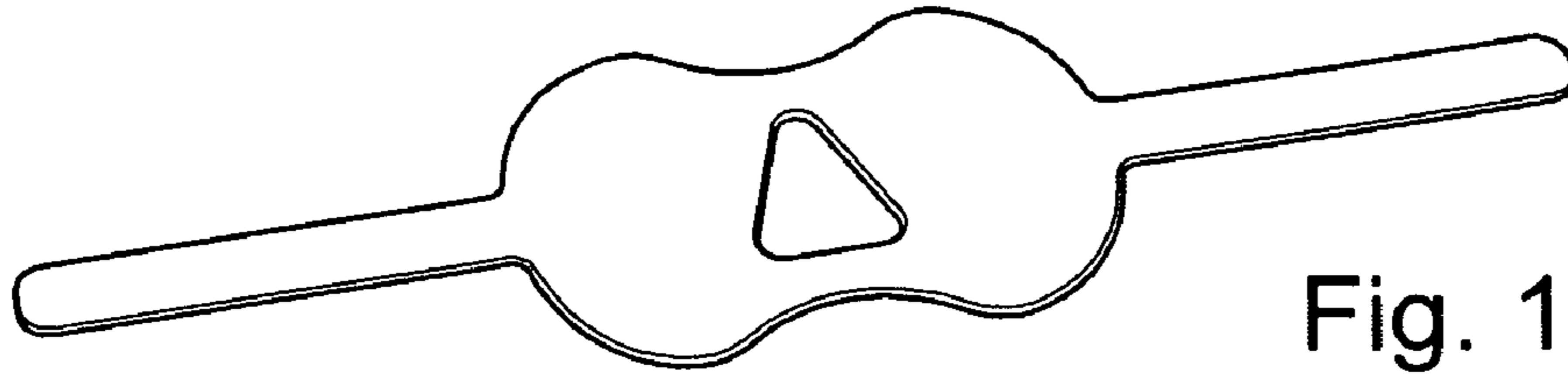

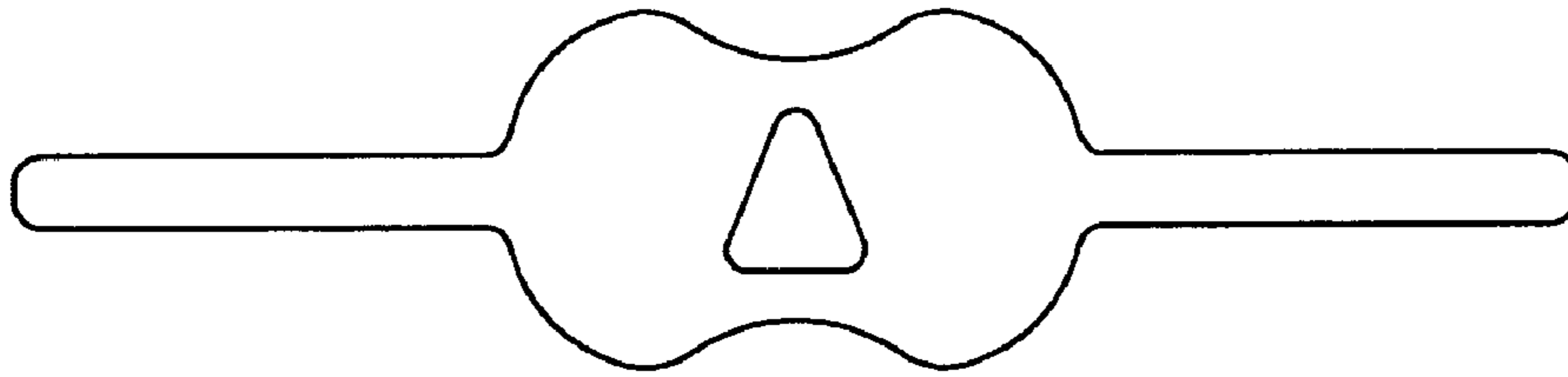

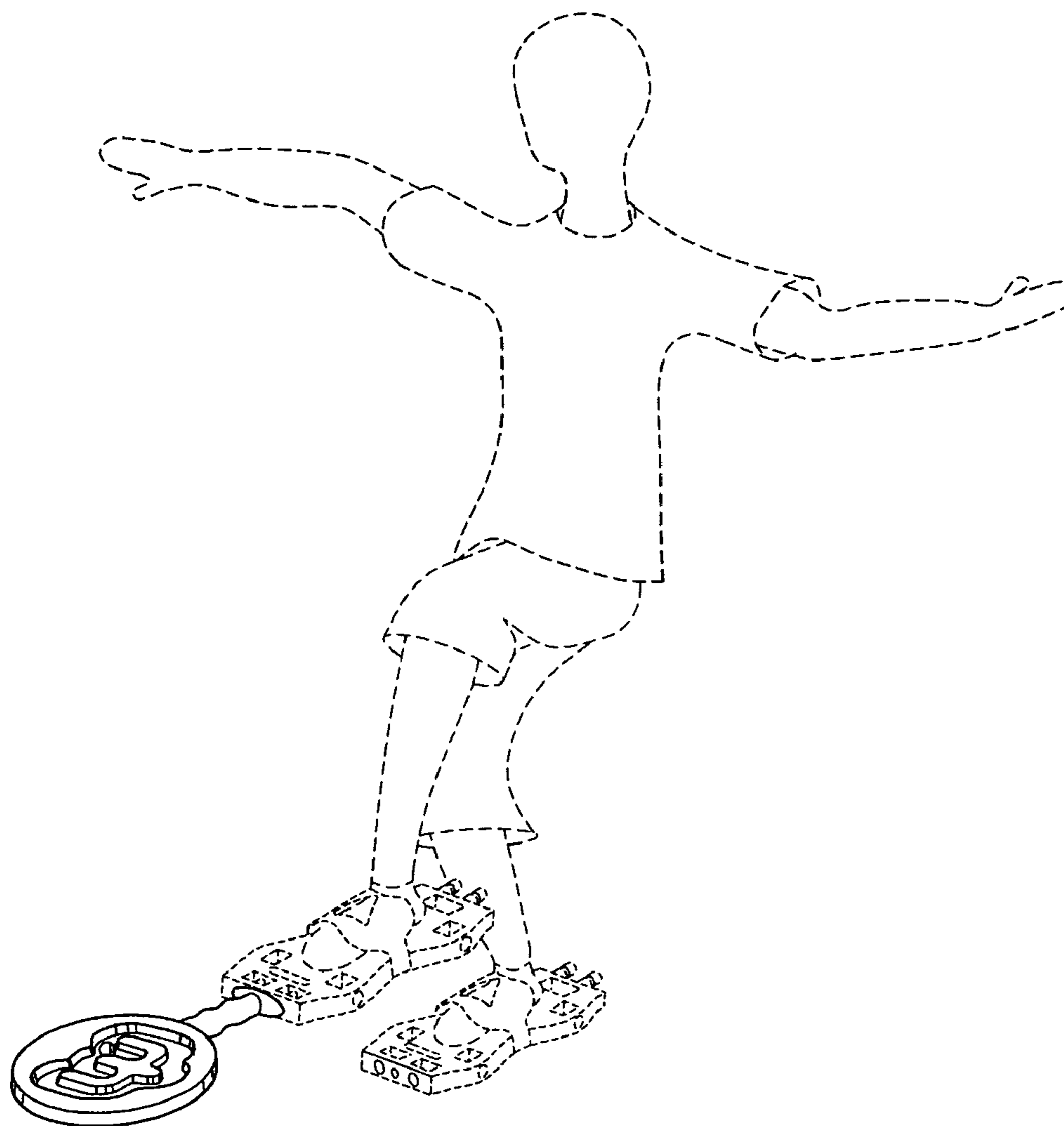
