We claim the ornamental design for a cowling of a goalie skate, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cowling of a goalie skate according to a first embodiment of the present design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a first side elevational view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a second side elevational view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a cowling of a goalie skate according to a second embodiment of the present design;

FIG. 10 is a bottom perspective view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a first side elevational view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 is a second side elevational view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 9;

FIG. 13 is a bottom view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 9;


FIG. 14 is a top view of the cowling of a goalie skate of FIG. 9;
































