The ornamental design for a bidet attachment for a toilet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevated perspective view of a bidet attachment in accordance with the present invention shown coupled to a toilet.

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the bidet attachment of FIG. 1, with the cord shown broken away in the middle to indicate indeterminate length.

FIG. 3 is a right side view of the bidet attachment of FIG. 1, with the cord shown broken away in the middle to indicate indeterminate length.

FIG. 4 is a left side view of a spray nozzle portion of the bidet attachment of FIG. 1 shown separately for ease of illustration.

FIG. 5 is a front view of the spray nozzle portion of the bidet attachment of FIG. 1 shown separately for ease of illustration.

FIG. 6 is a top view of the spray nozzle portion of the bidet attachment of FIG. 1 shown separately for ease of illustration.

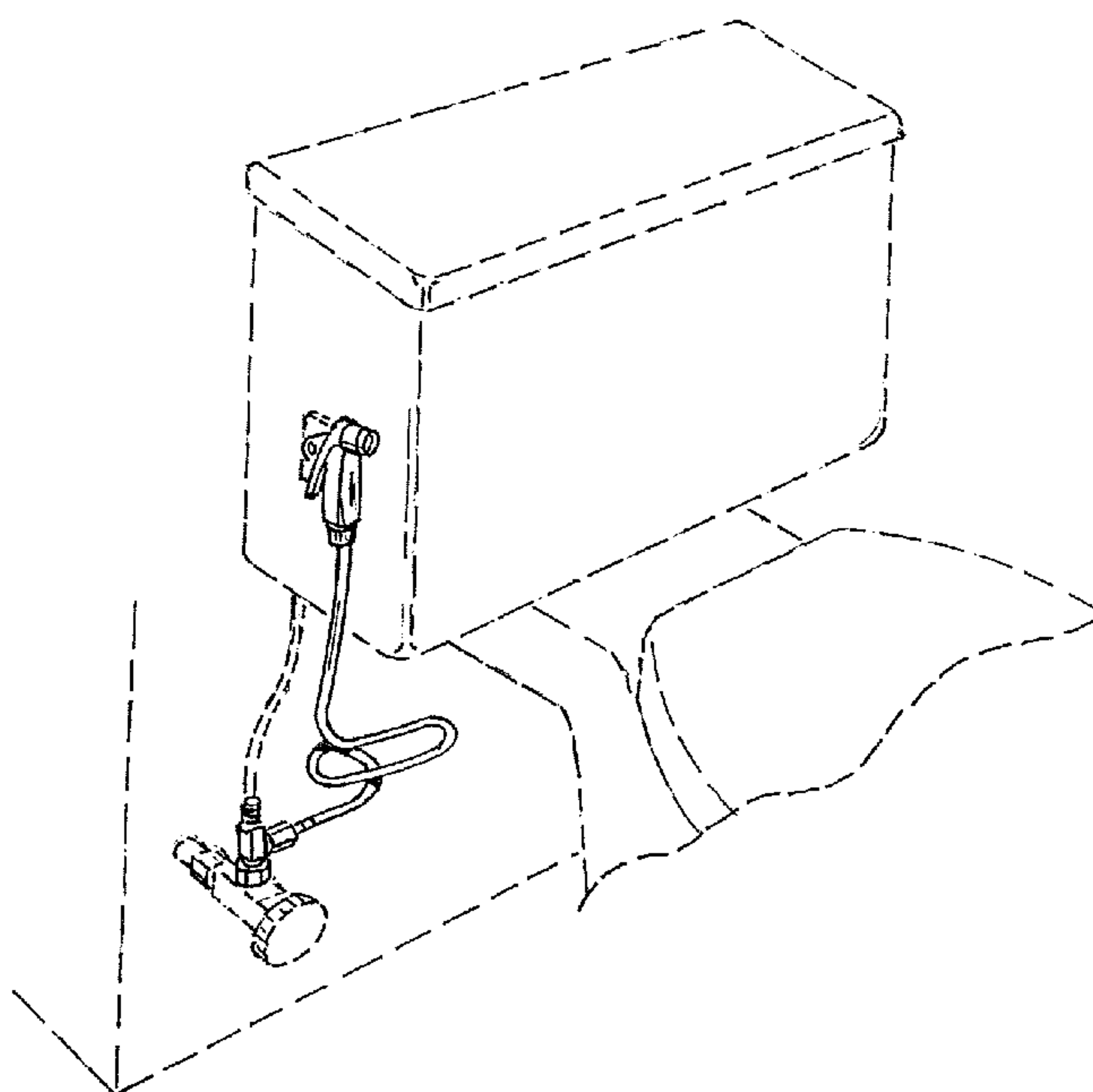
FIG. 7 is a rear view of the spray nozzle portion of the bidet attachment of FIG. 1 shown separately for ease of illustration.

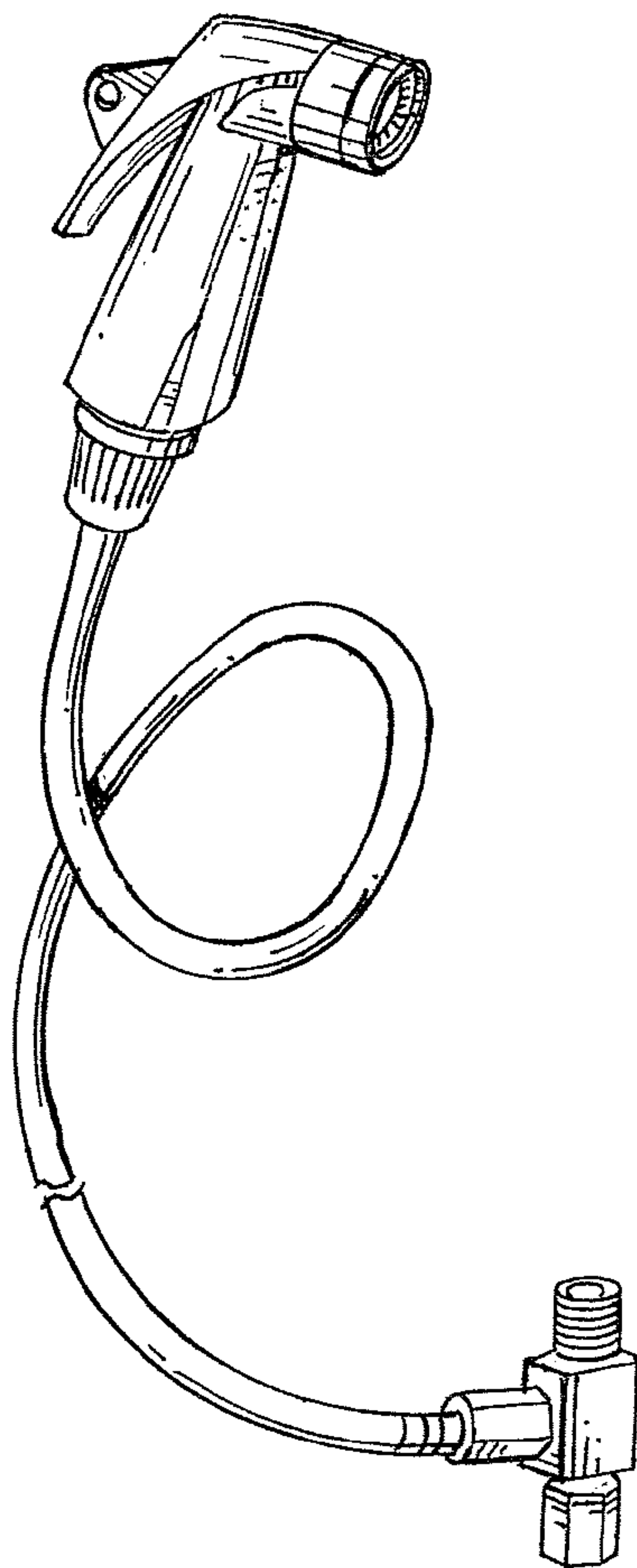
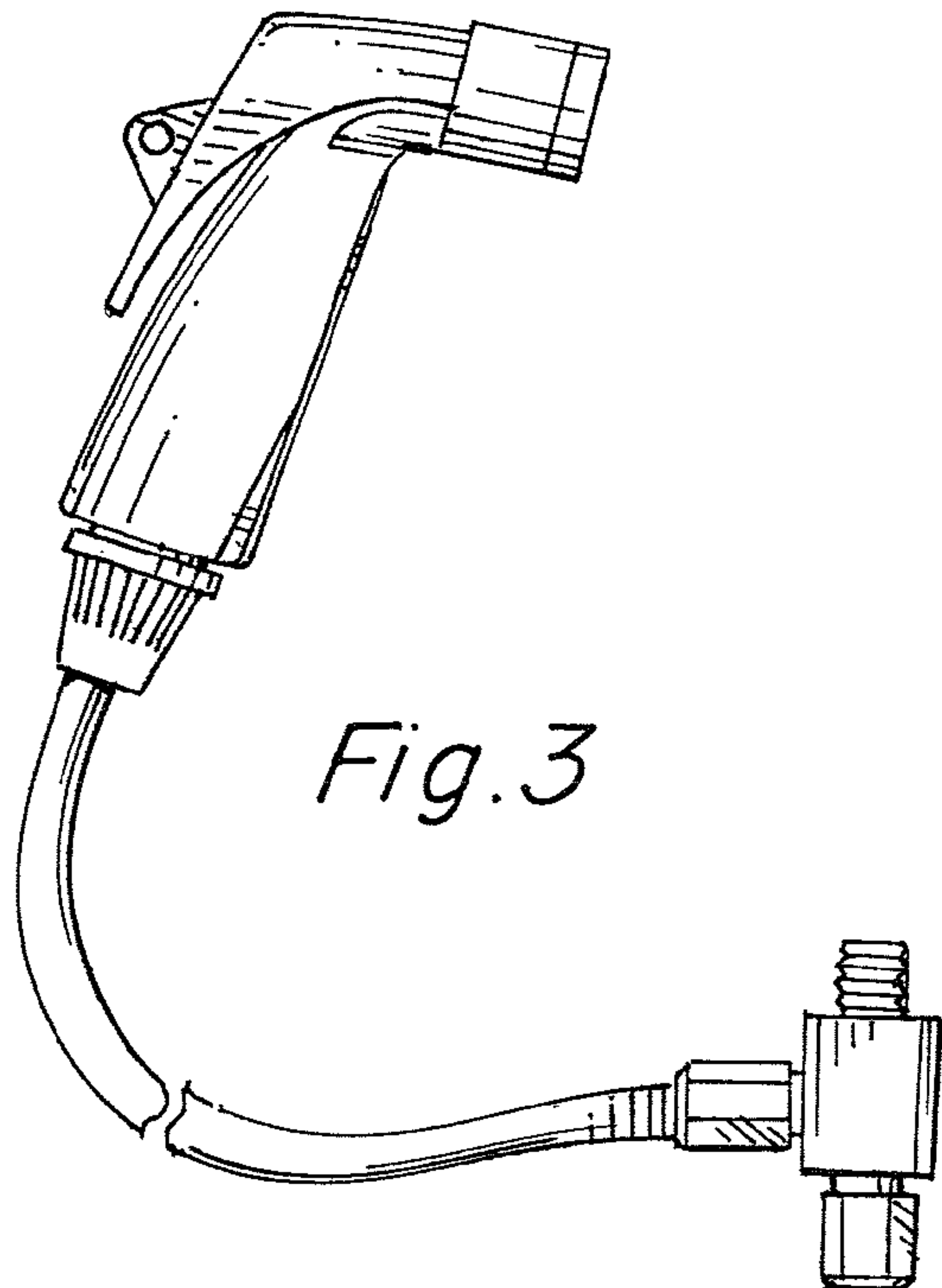
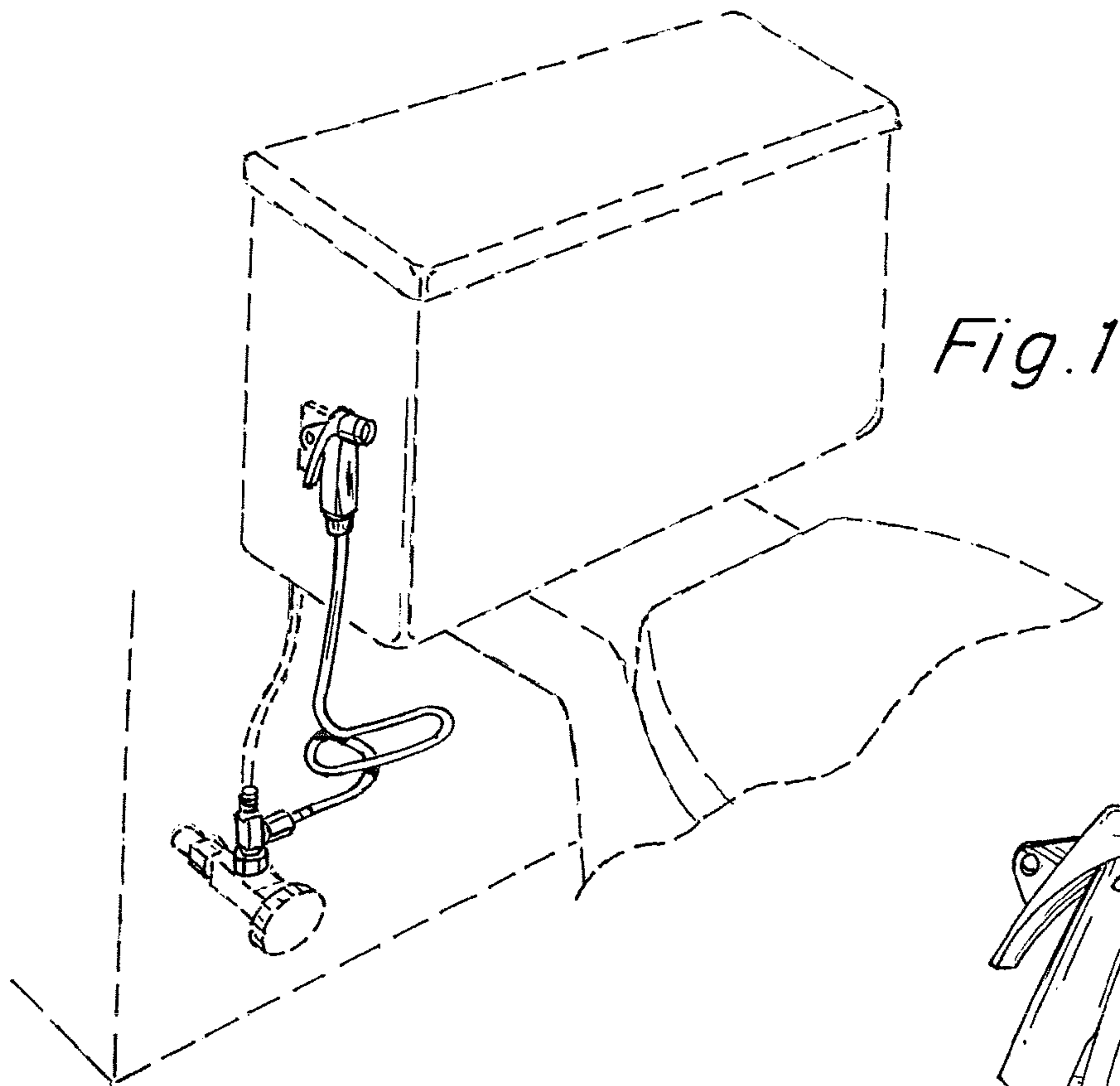
FIG. 8 is a bottom view of a T-shaped compression fitting portion of the bidet attachment of FIG. 1 shown separately for ease of illustration; and,

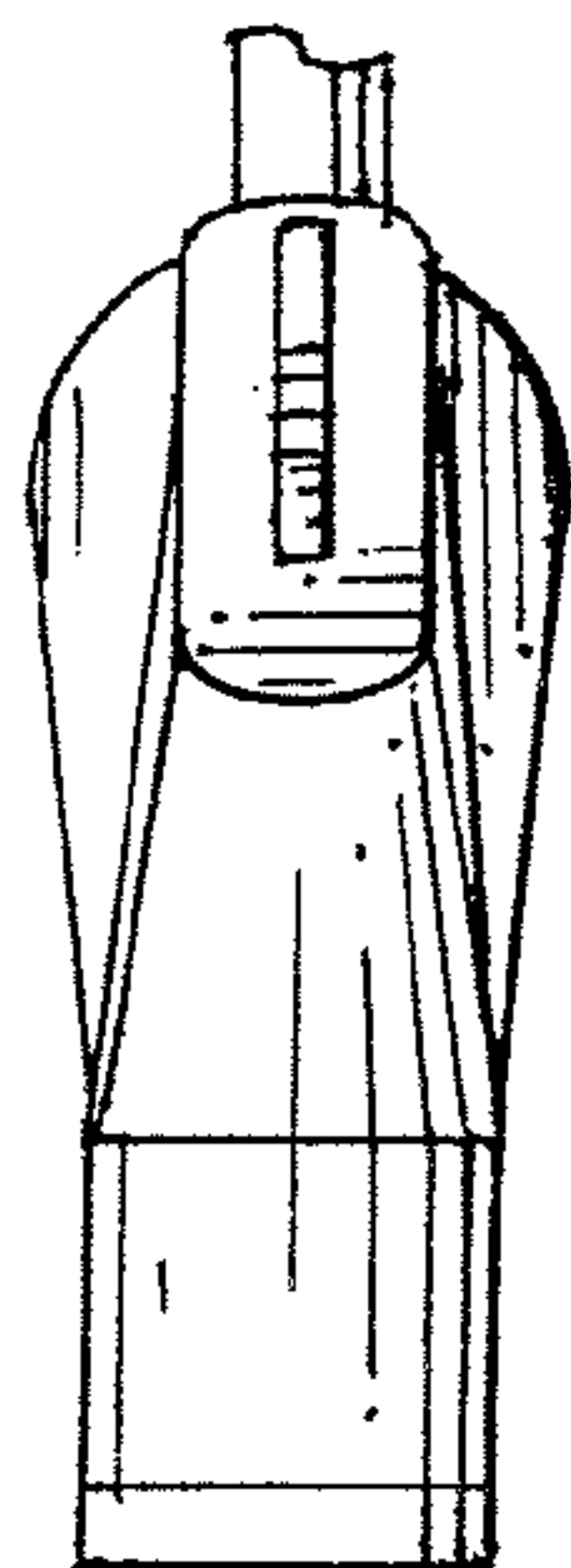

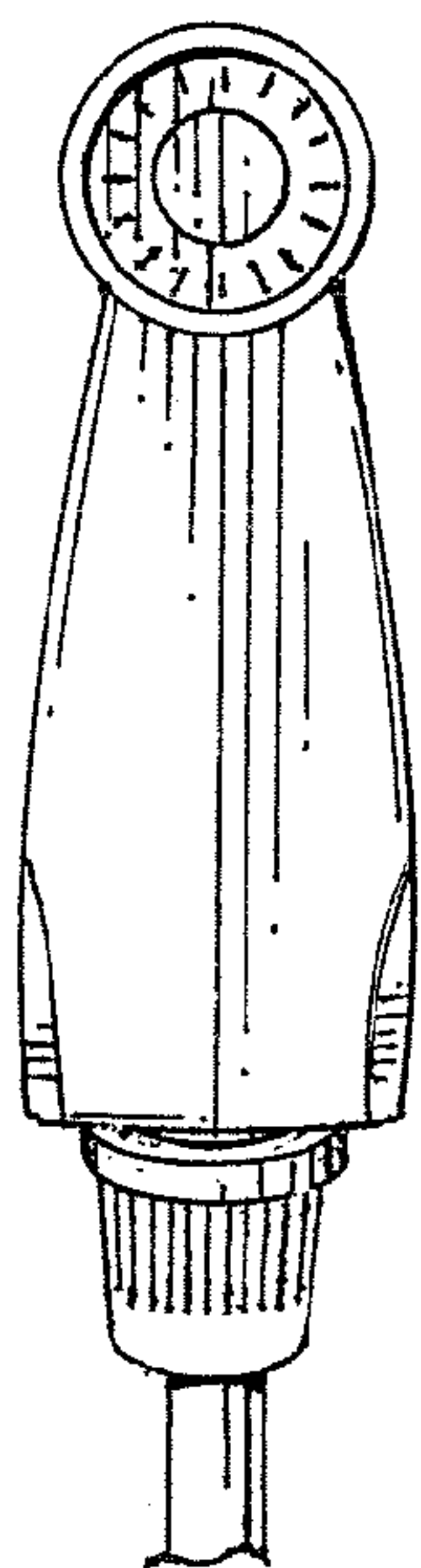

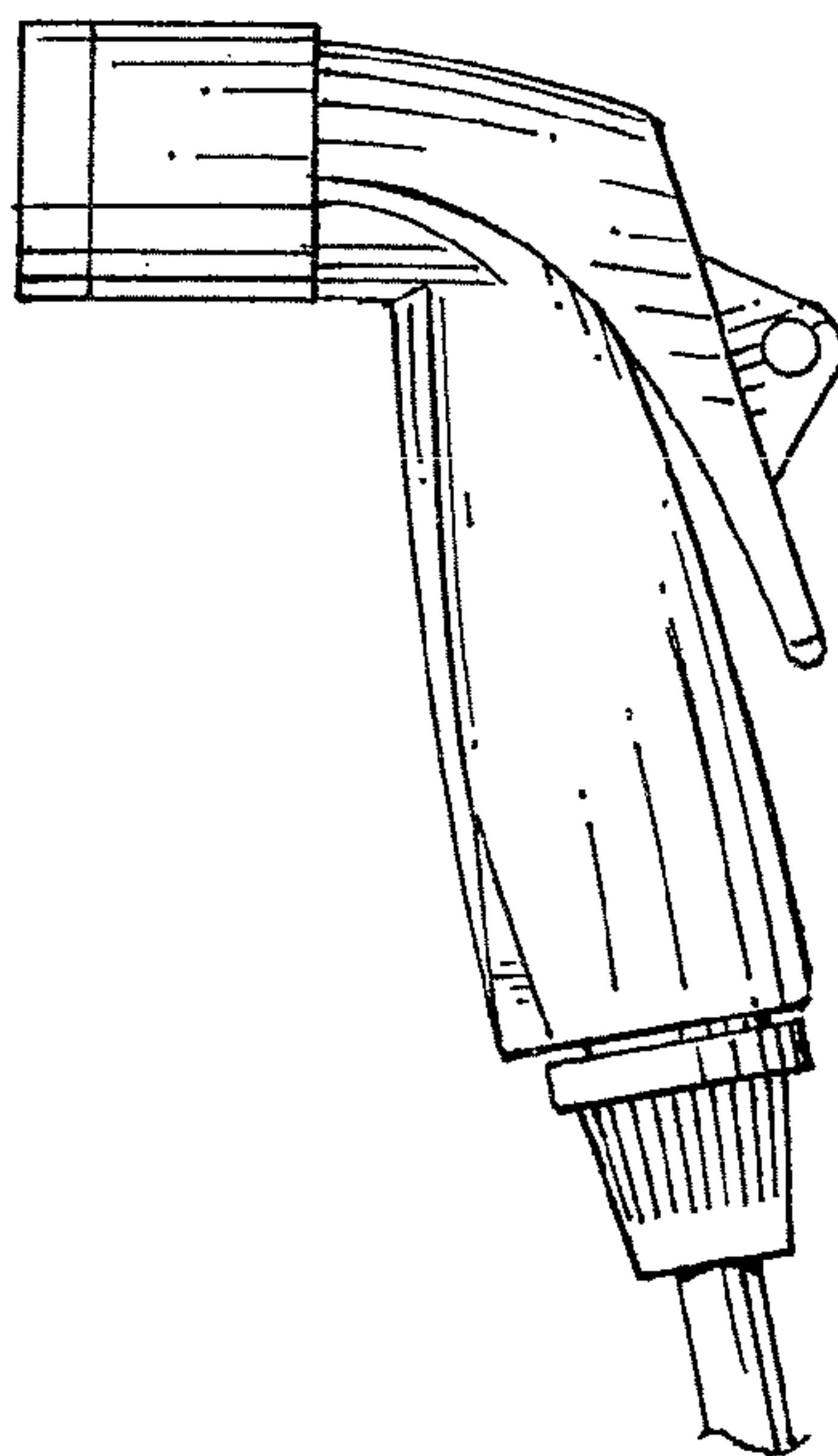

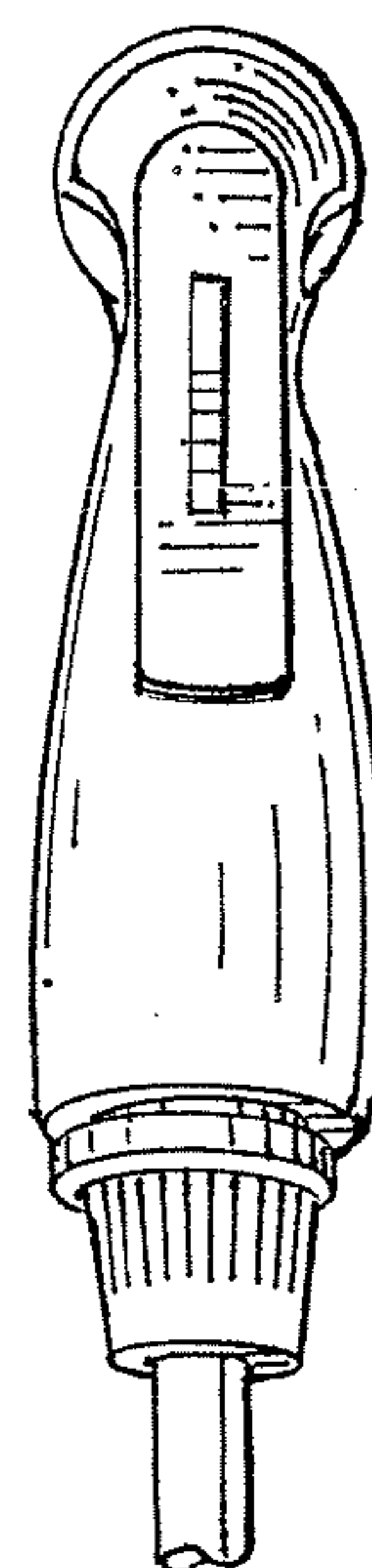
