FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a supportive apparel showing my new design.

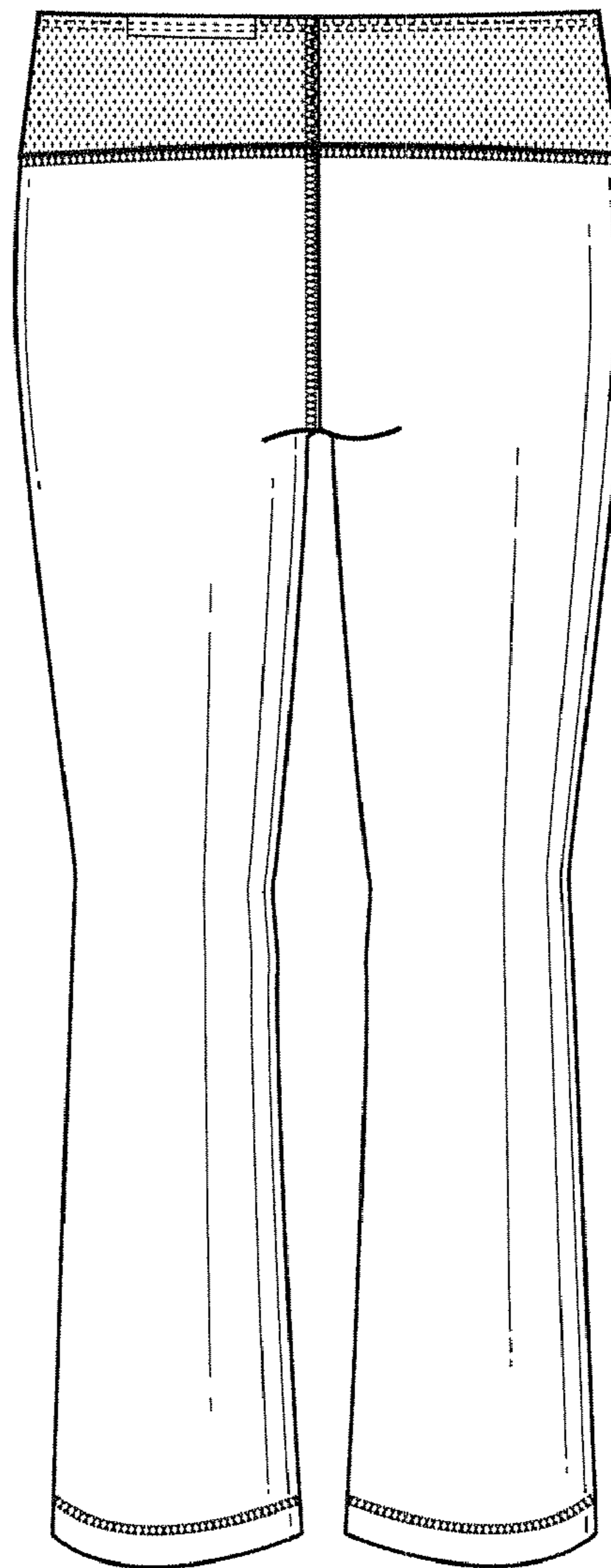
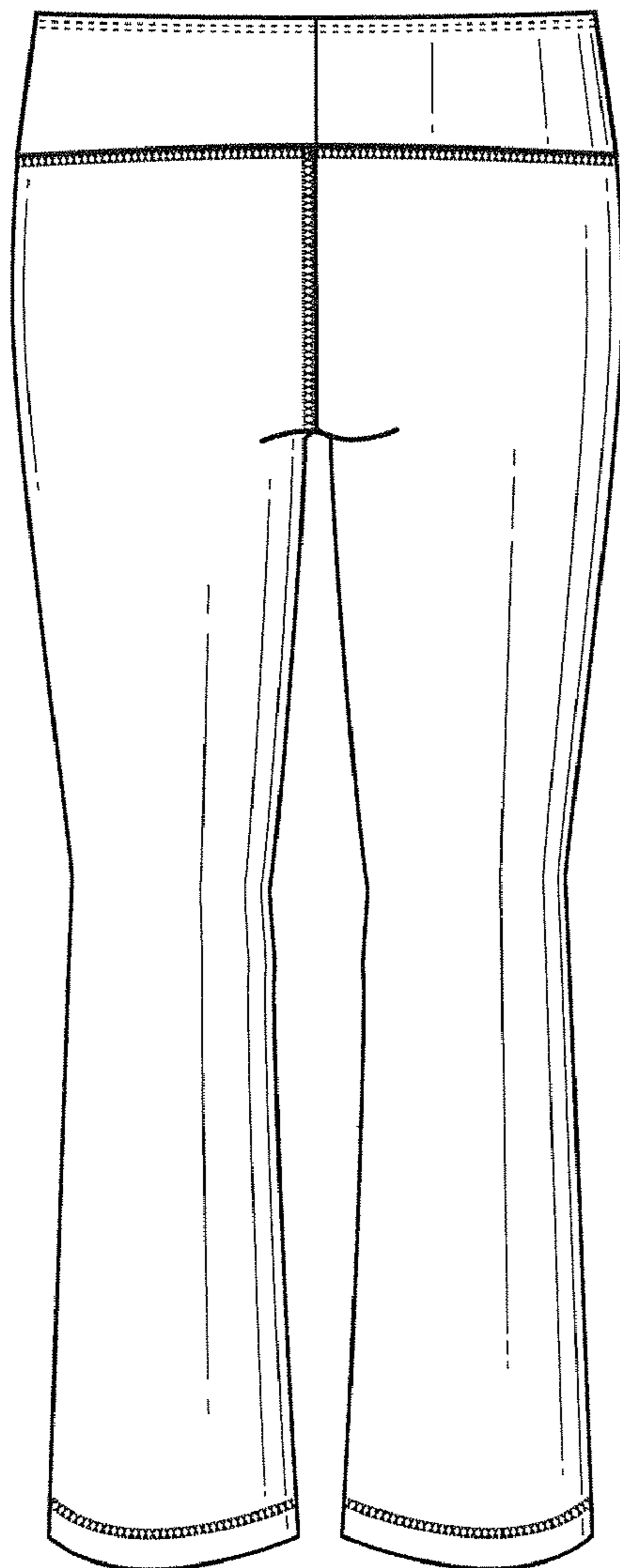
FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view of the supportive apparel of FIG. 1; and,

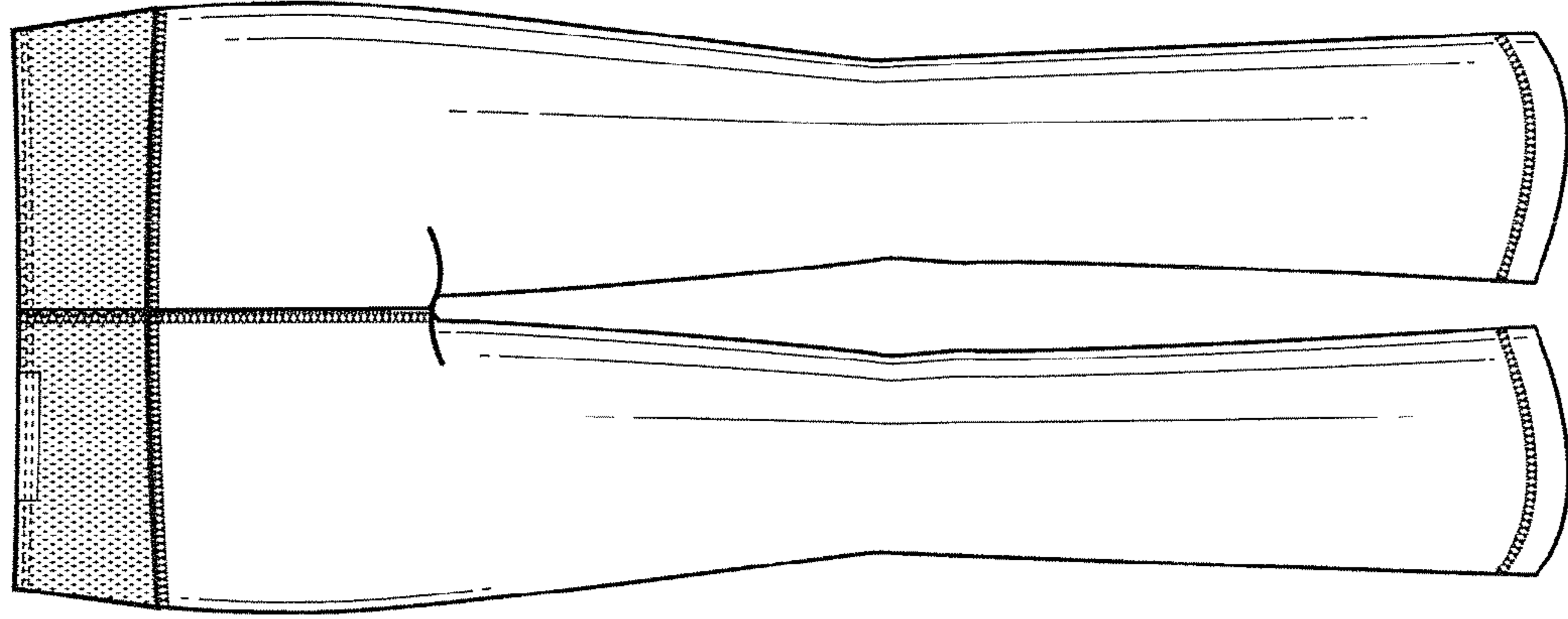

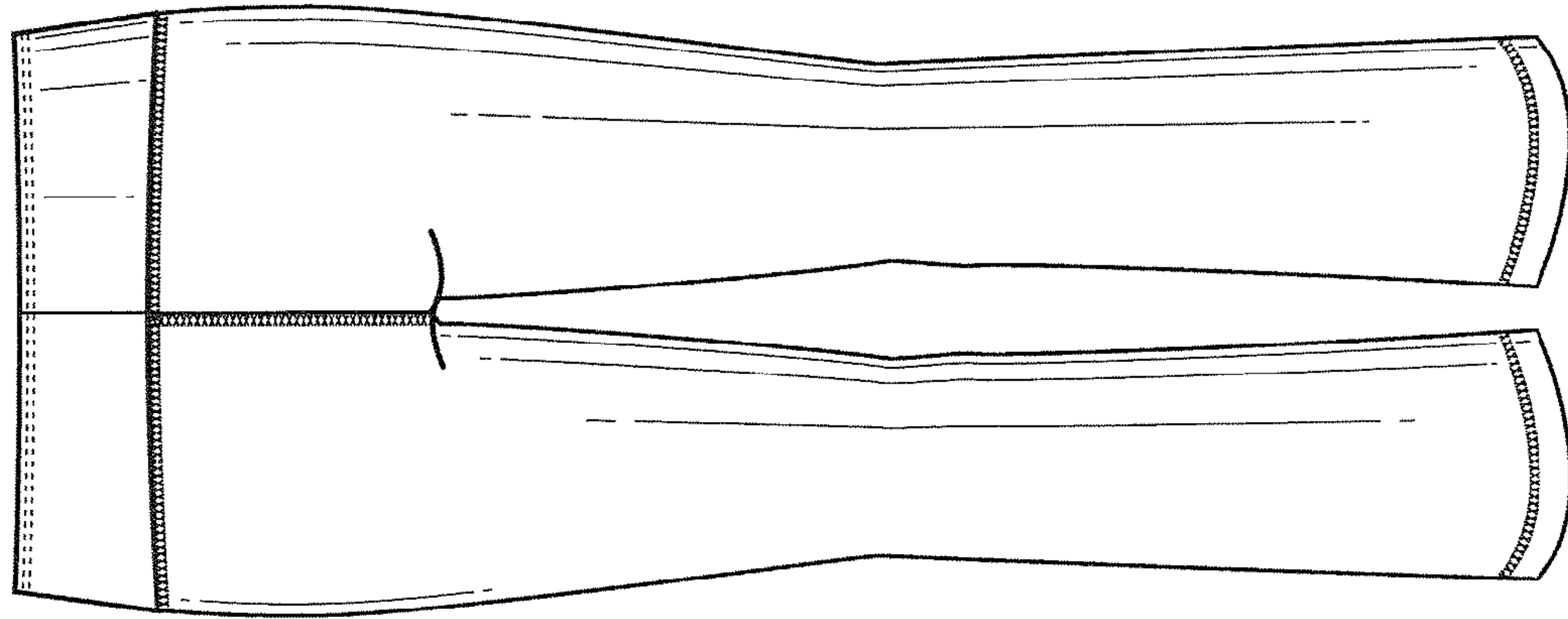

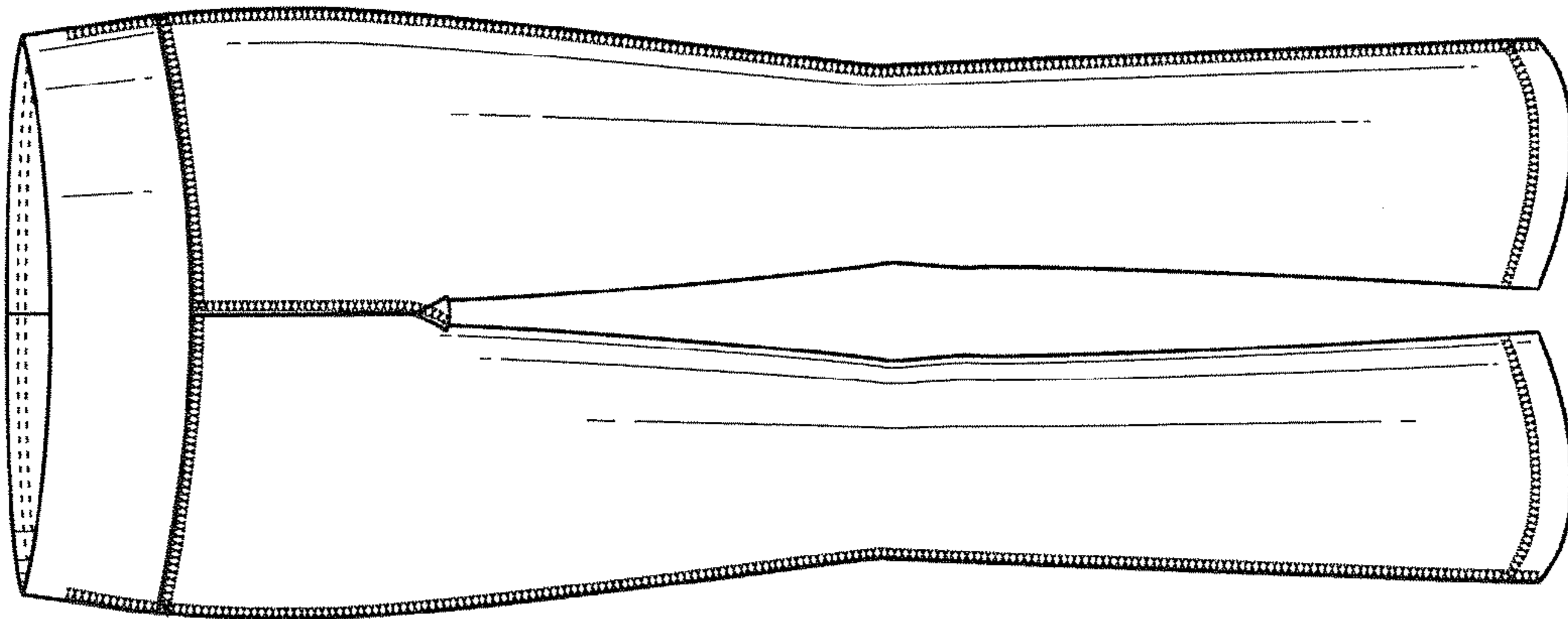
