1.

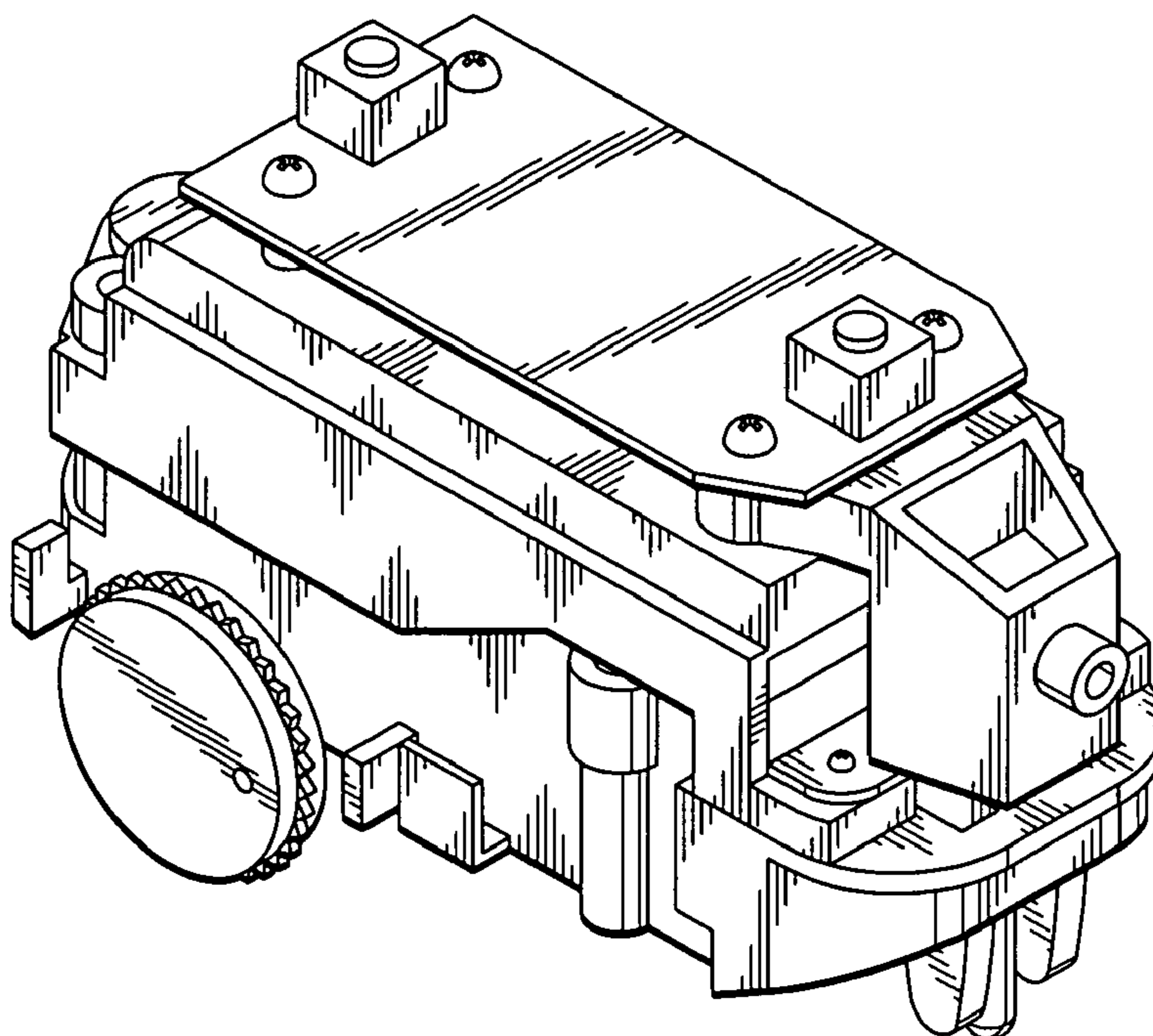

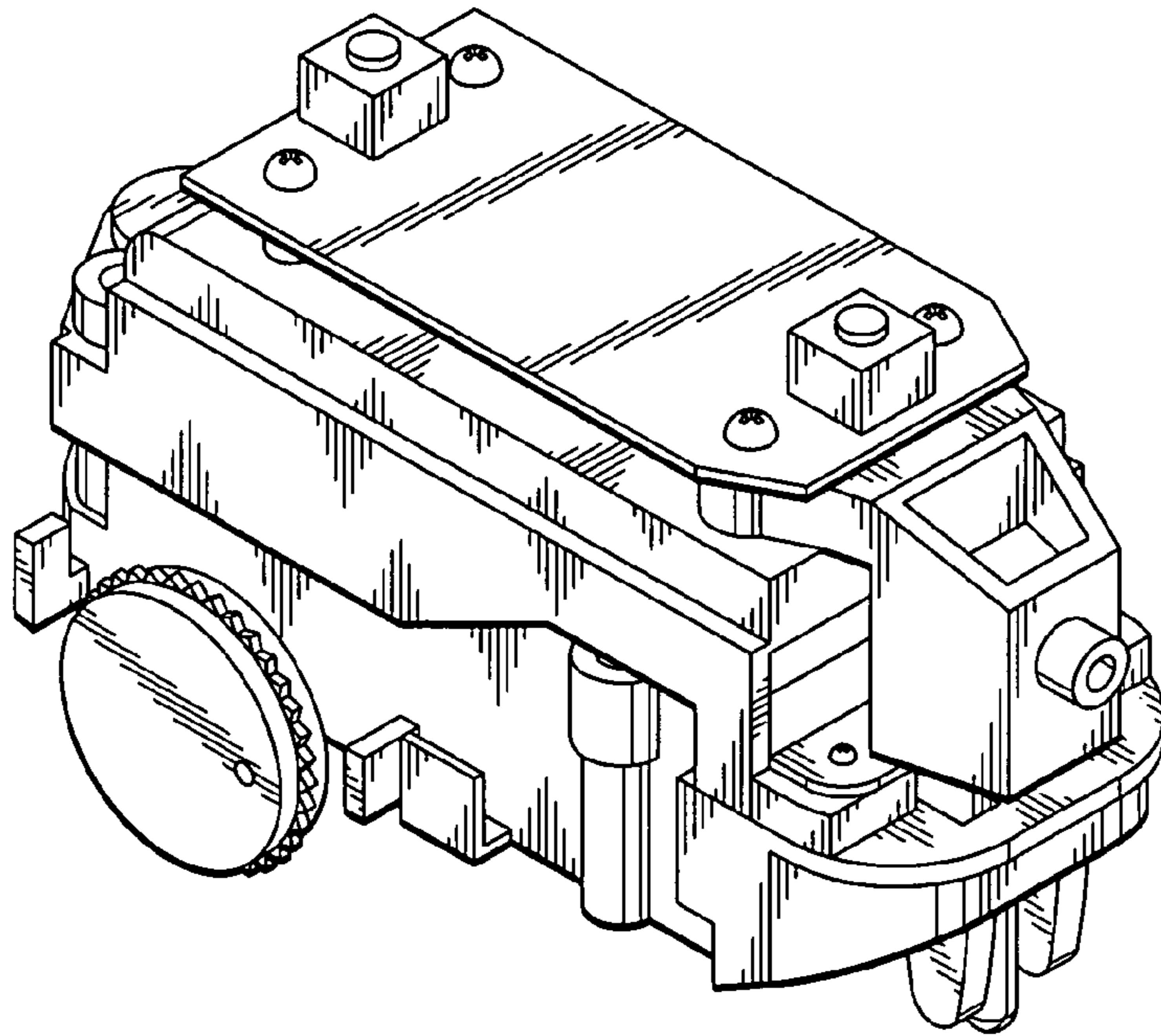

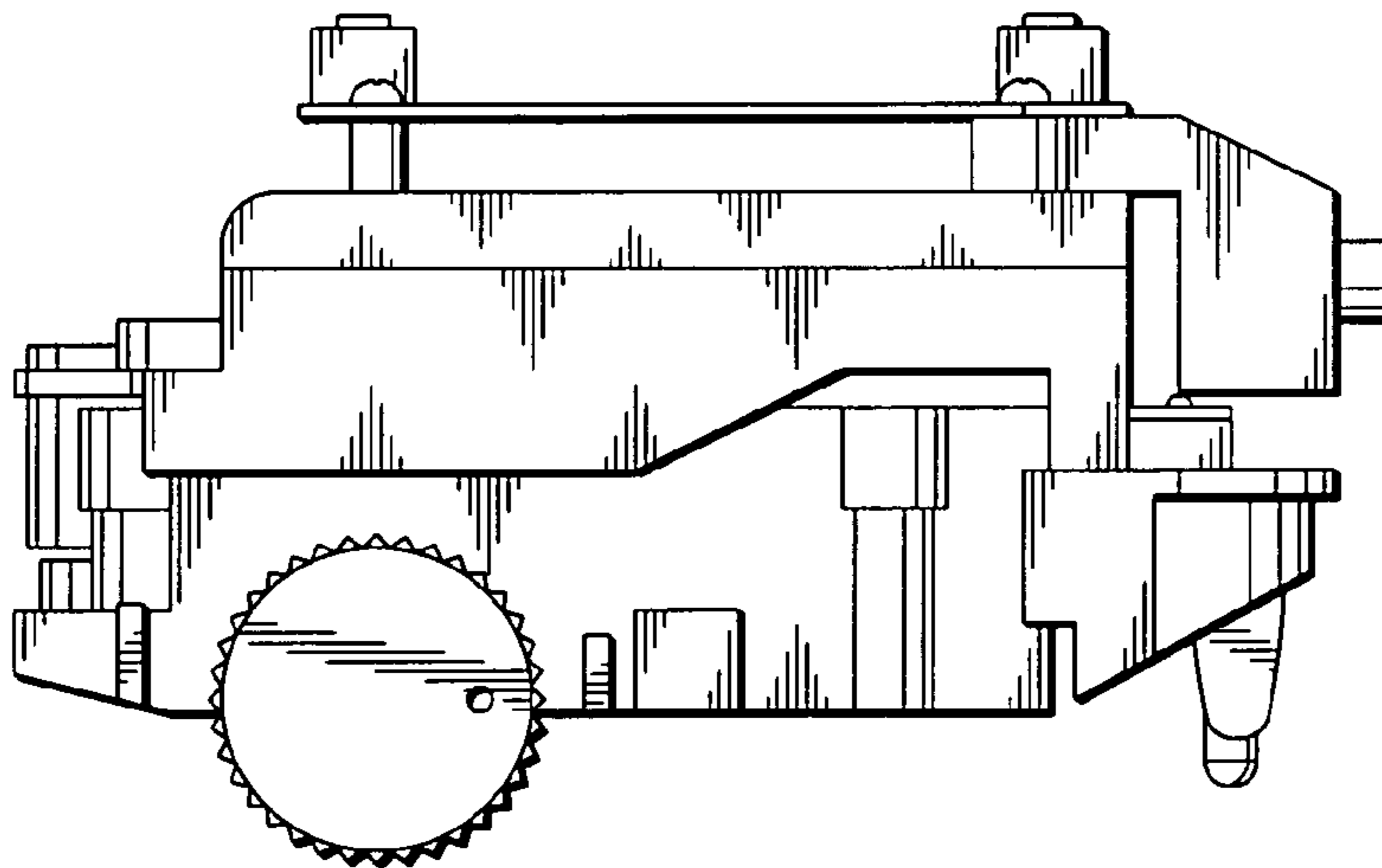

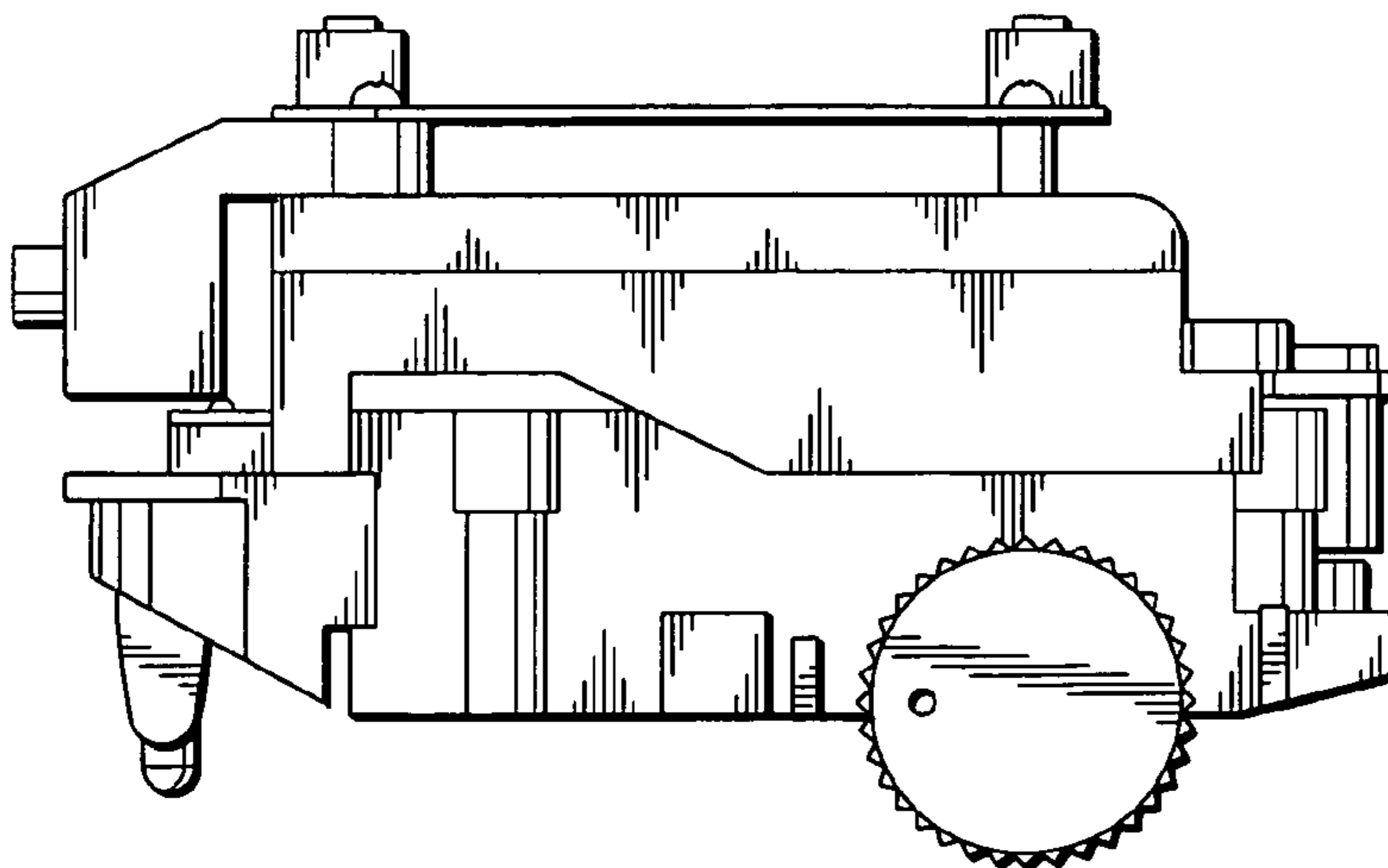

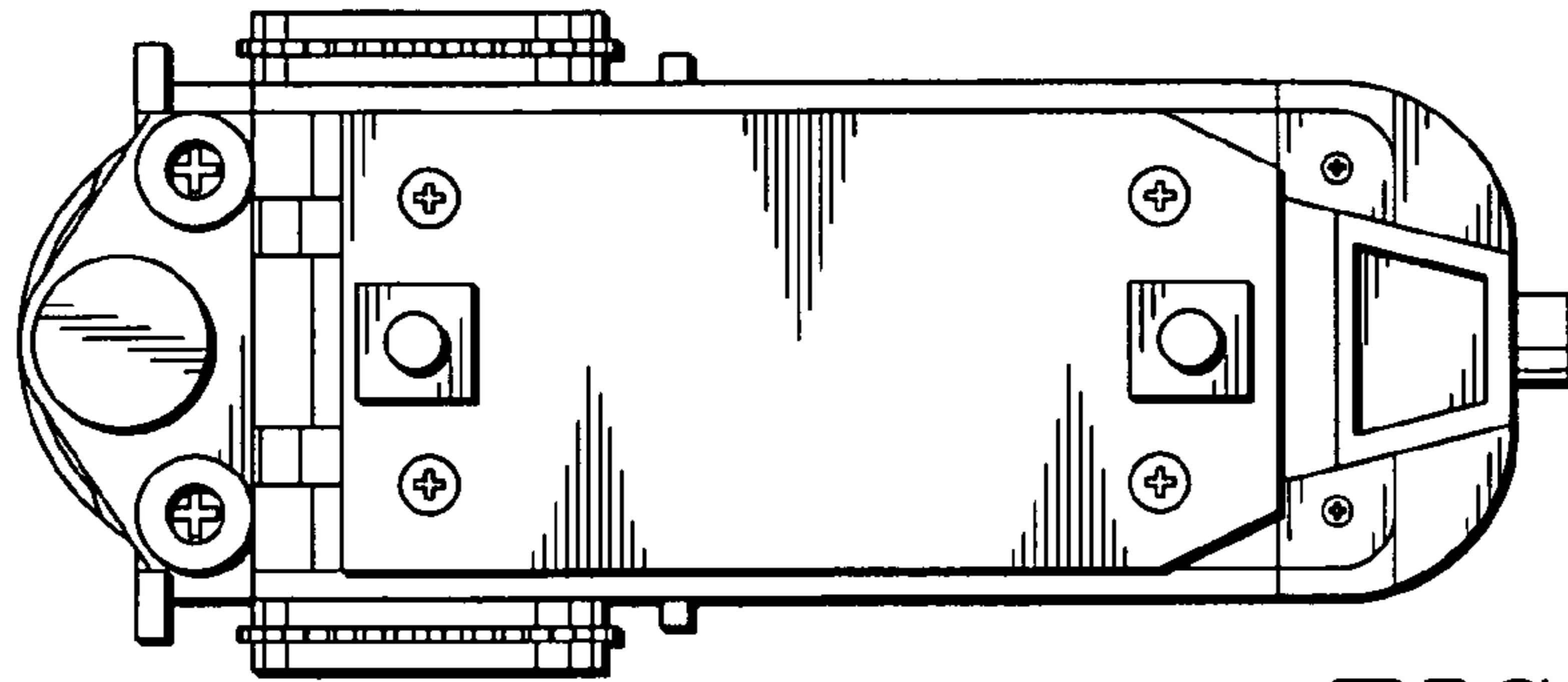

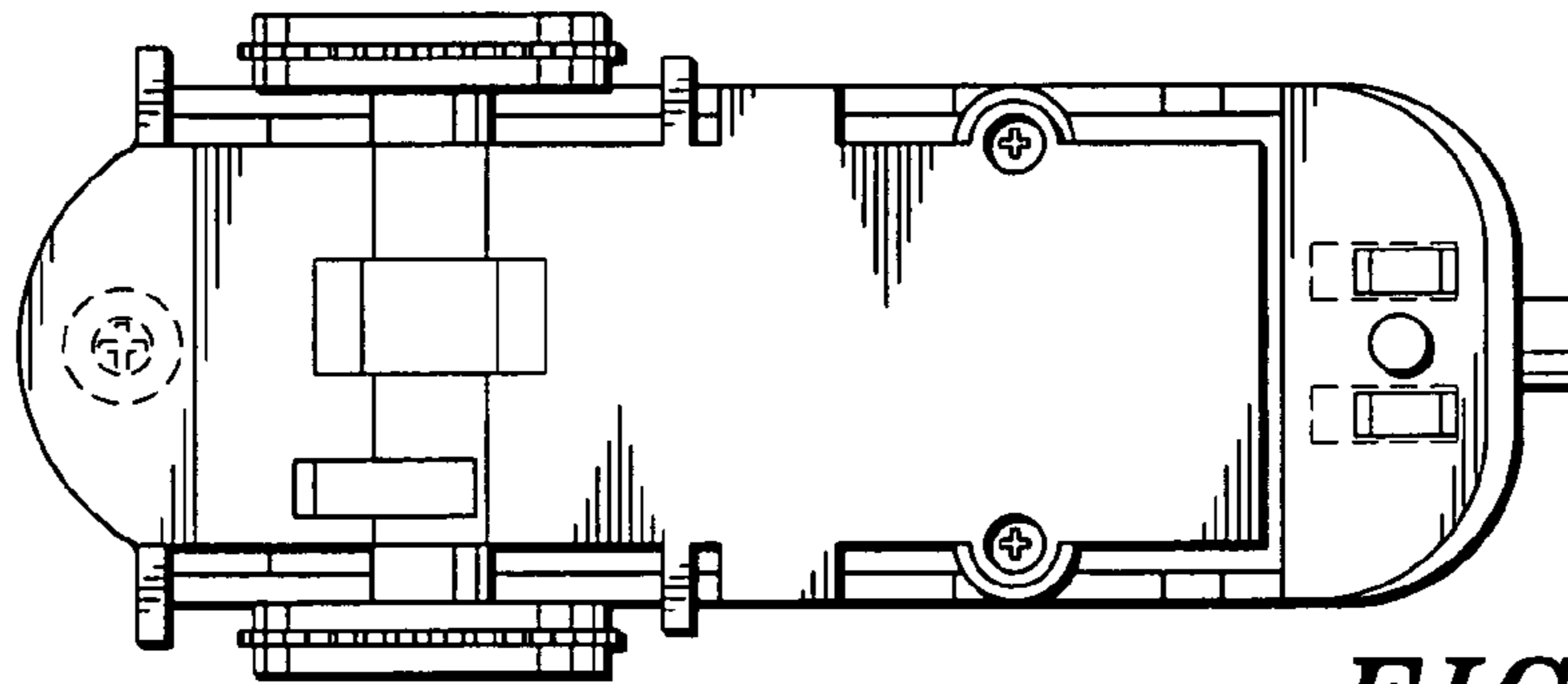

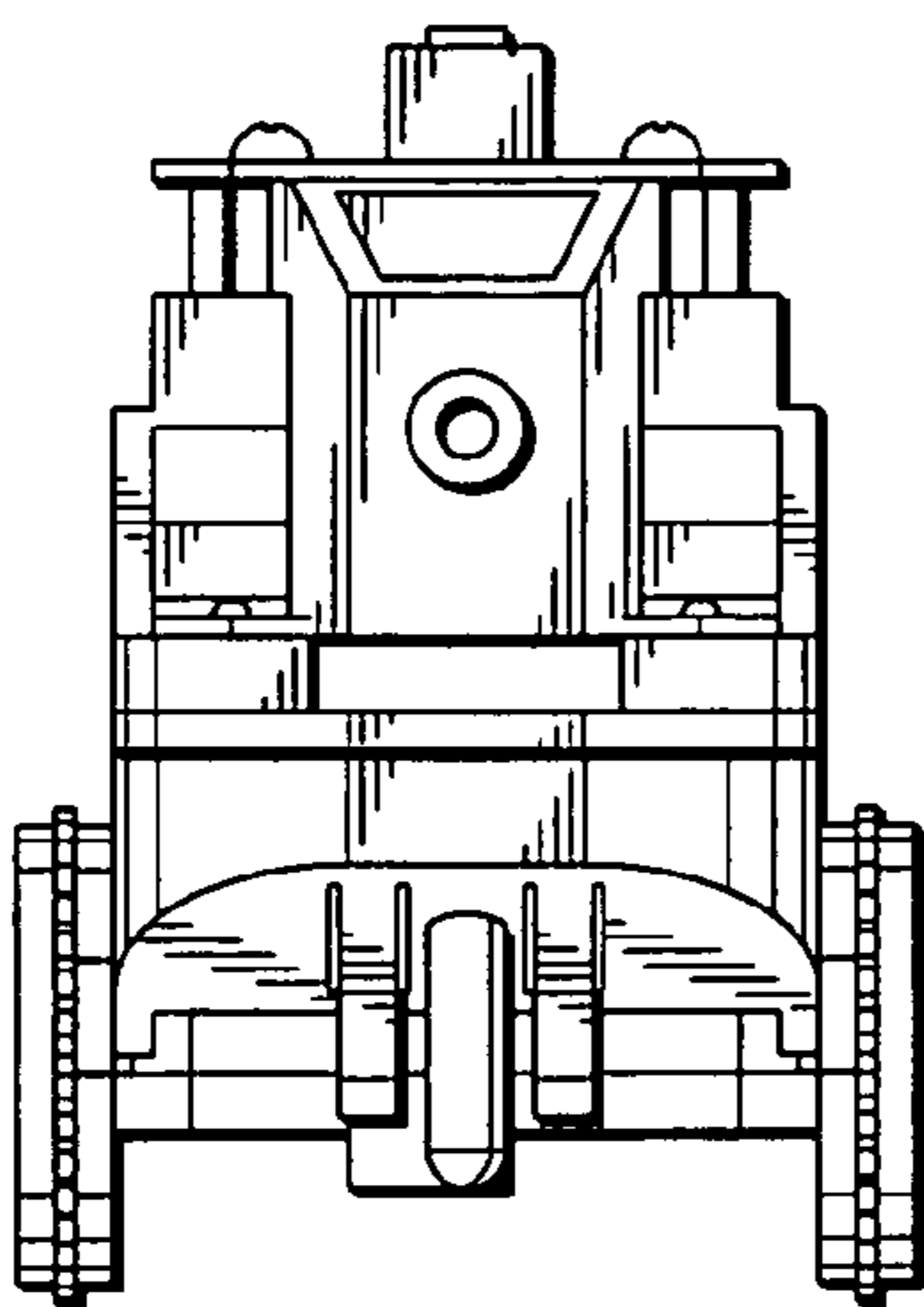

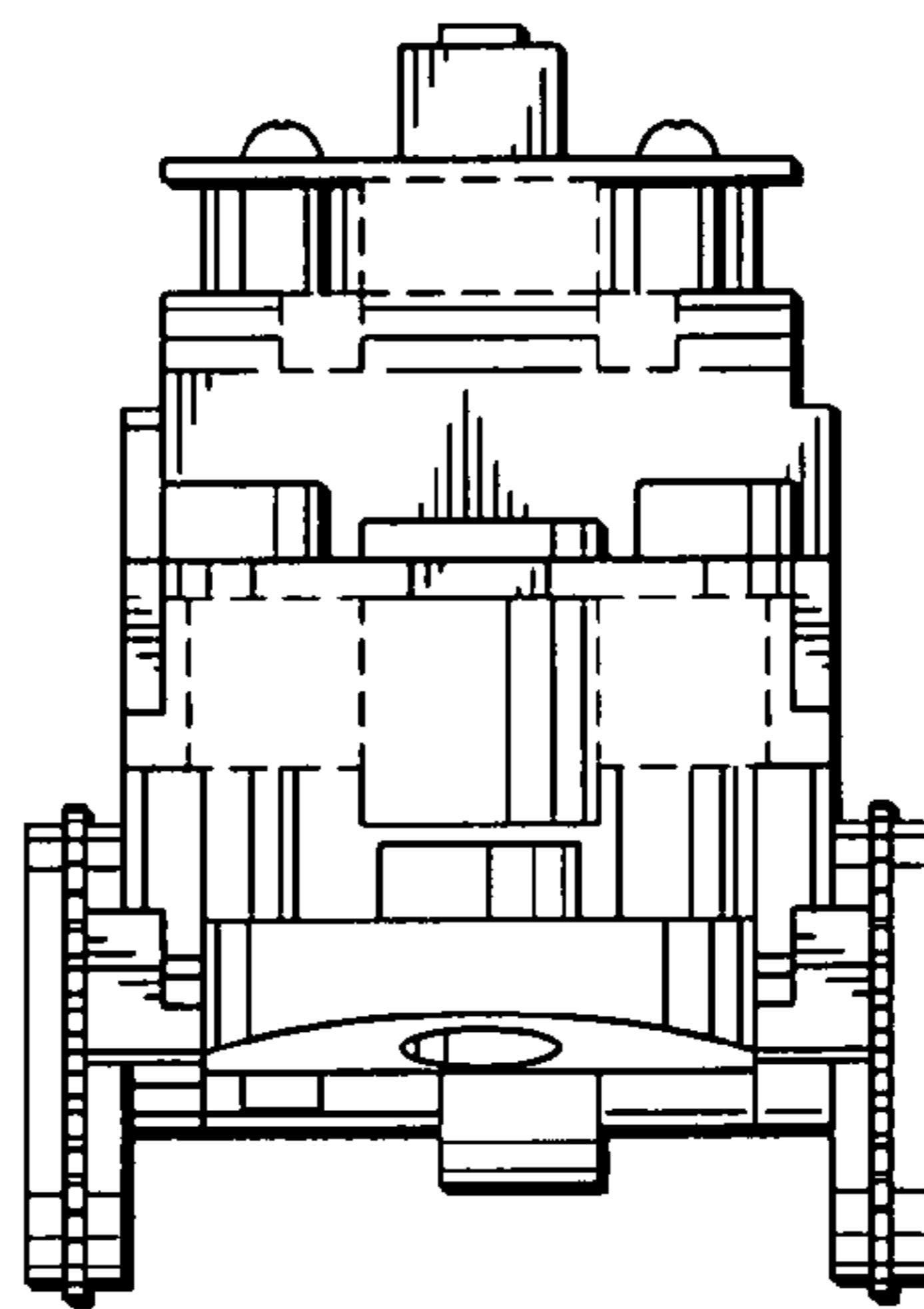
