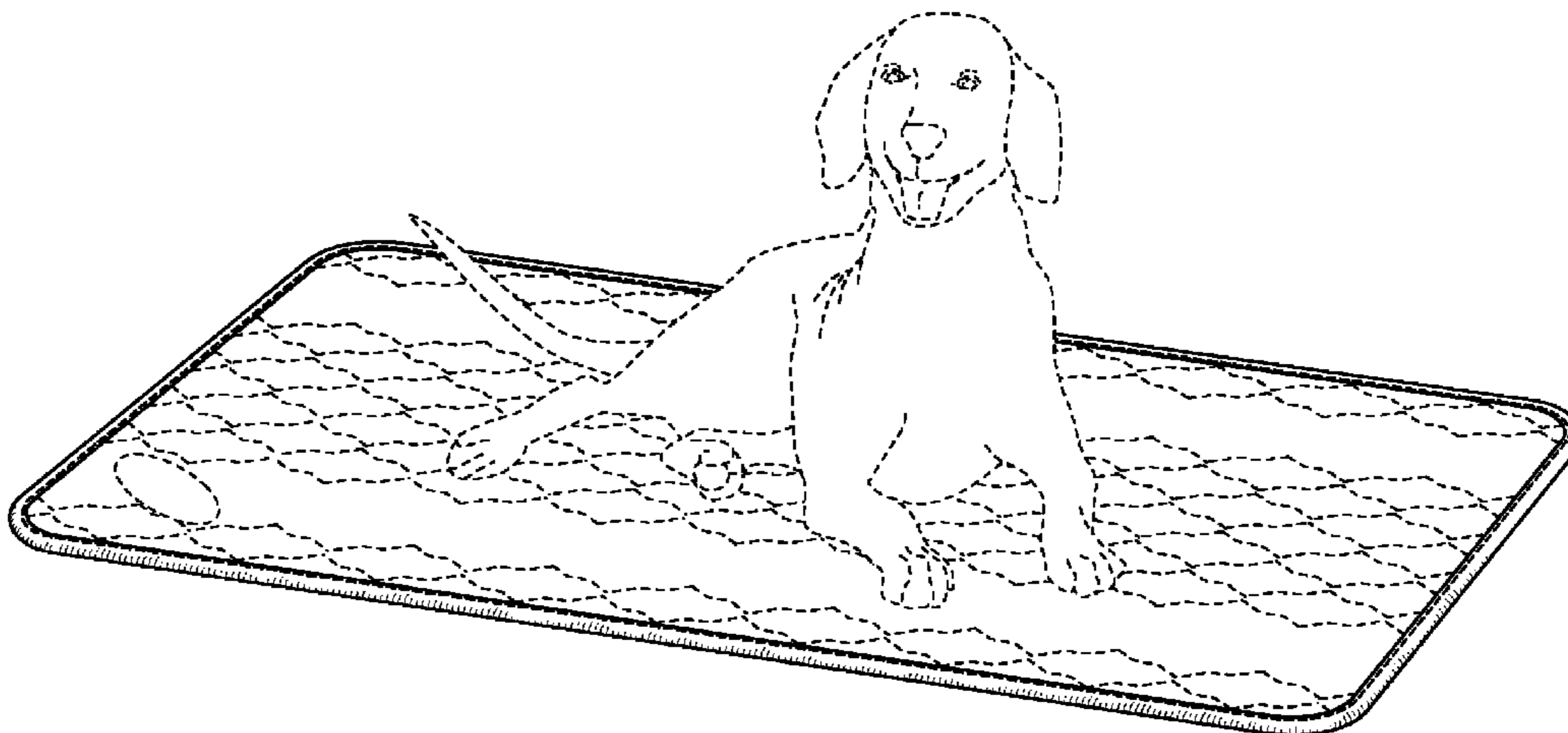
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pet blanket, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the pet blanket, showing our design in typical use;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a right side view thereof.
In the drawings, the broken lines on the blanket itself represent stitching forming part of the claimed design. The broken lines of the dog in FIG. 1 represents environmental structure that forms no part of the design to be patented.

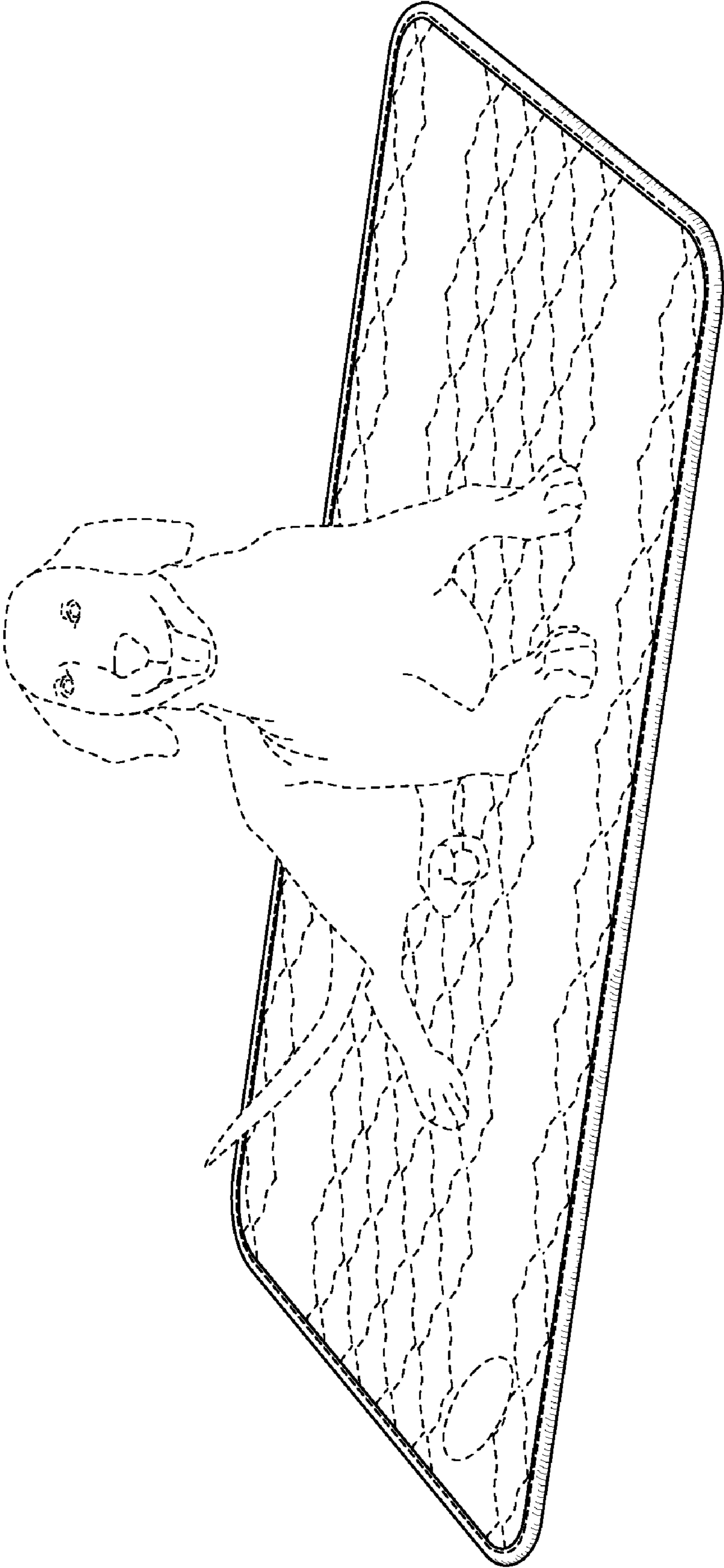

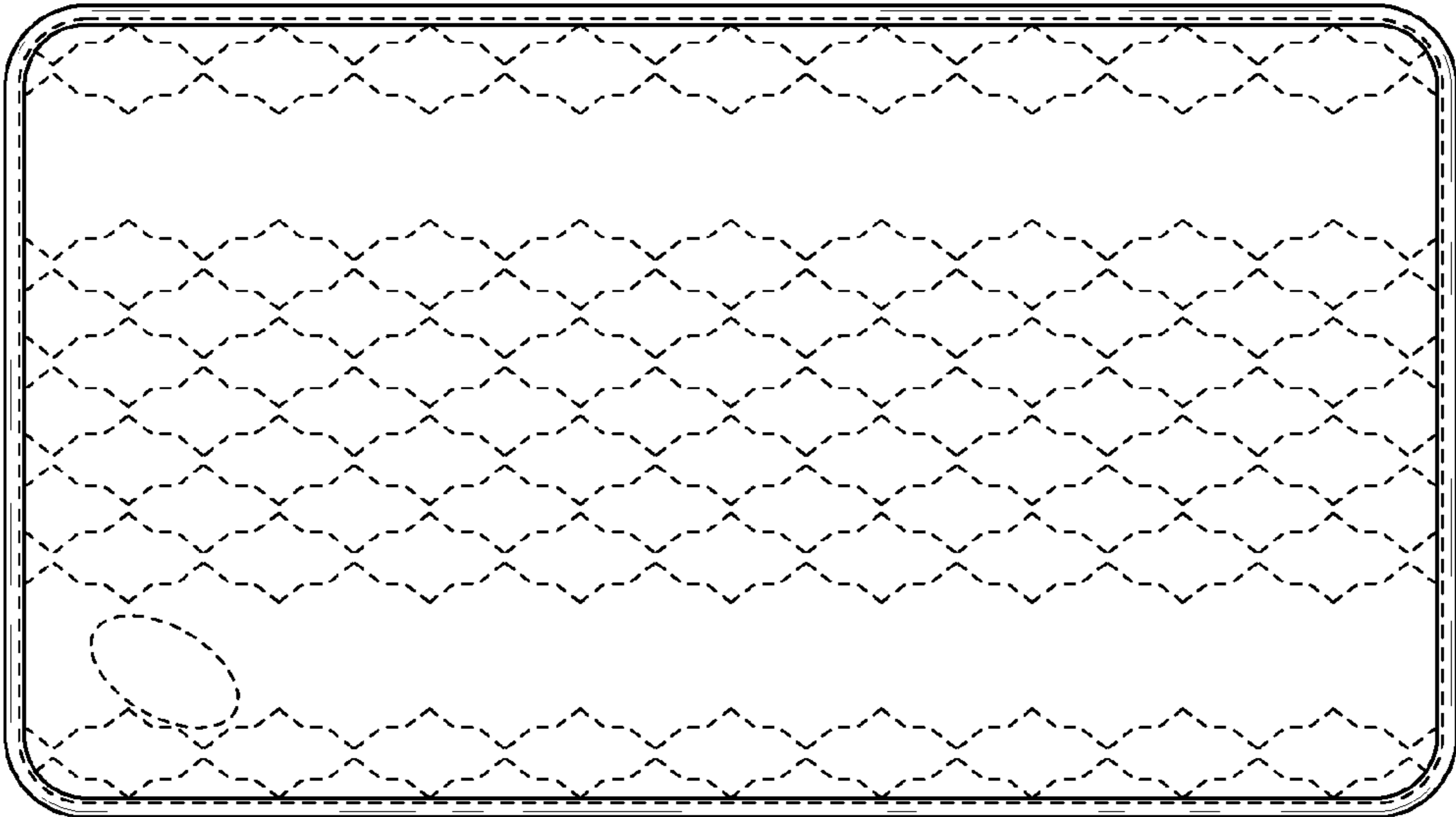

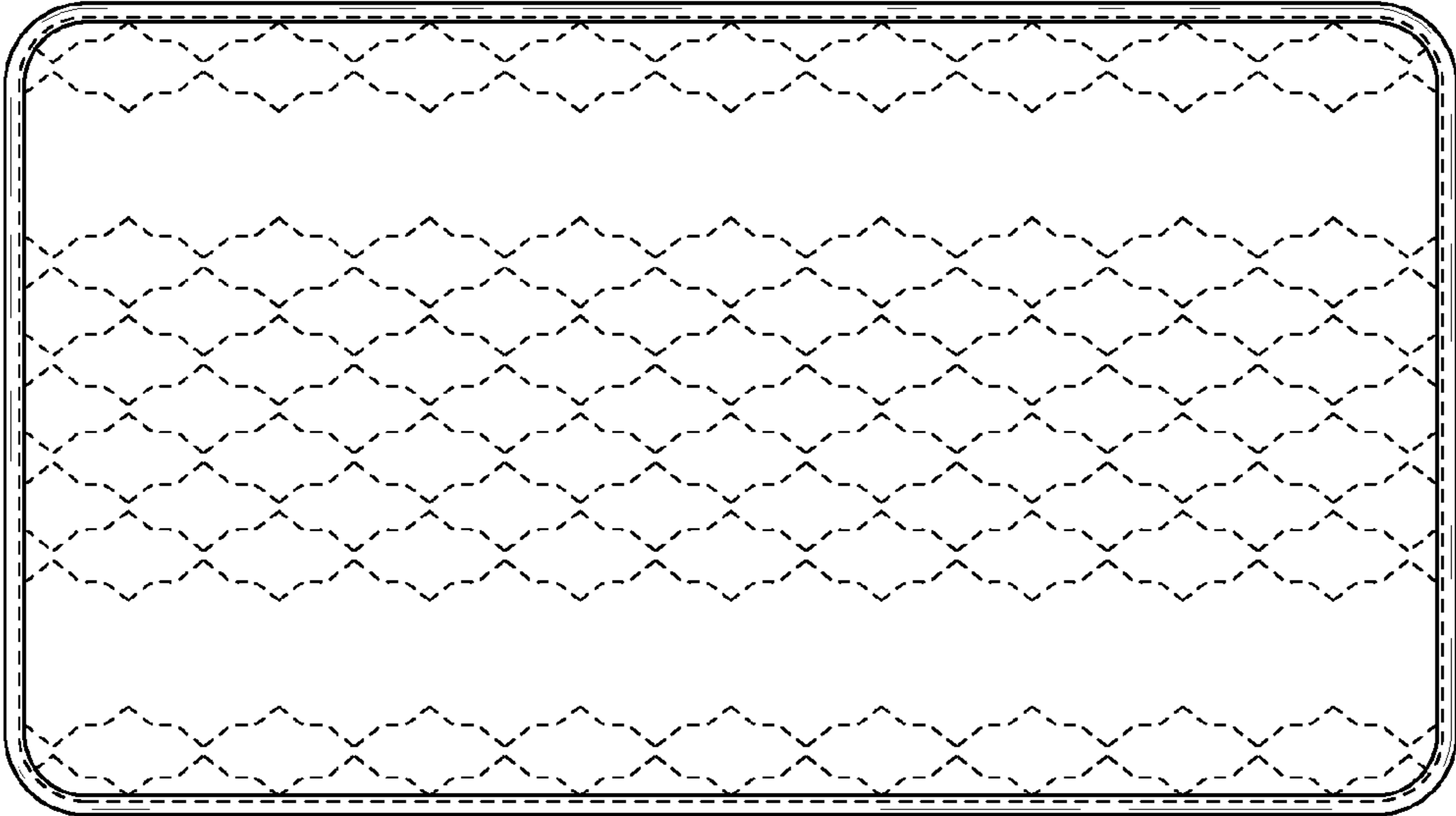

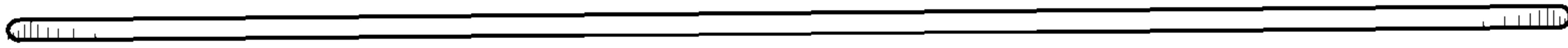

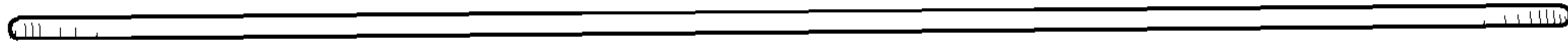

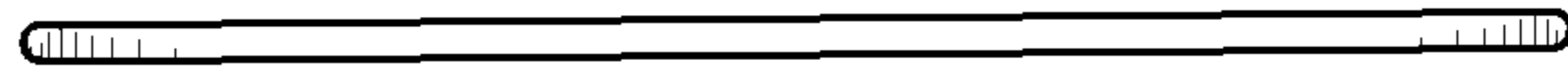

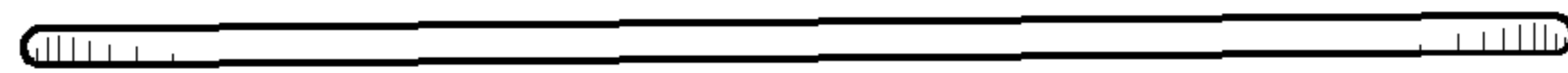
