FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the first and second embodiments of the gown;

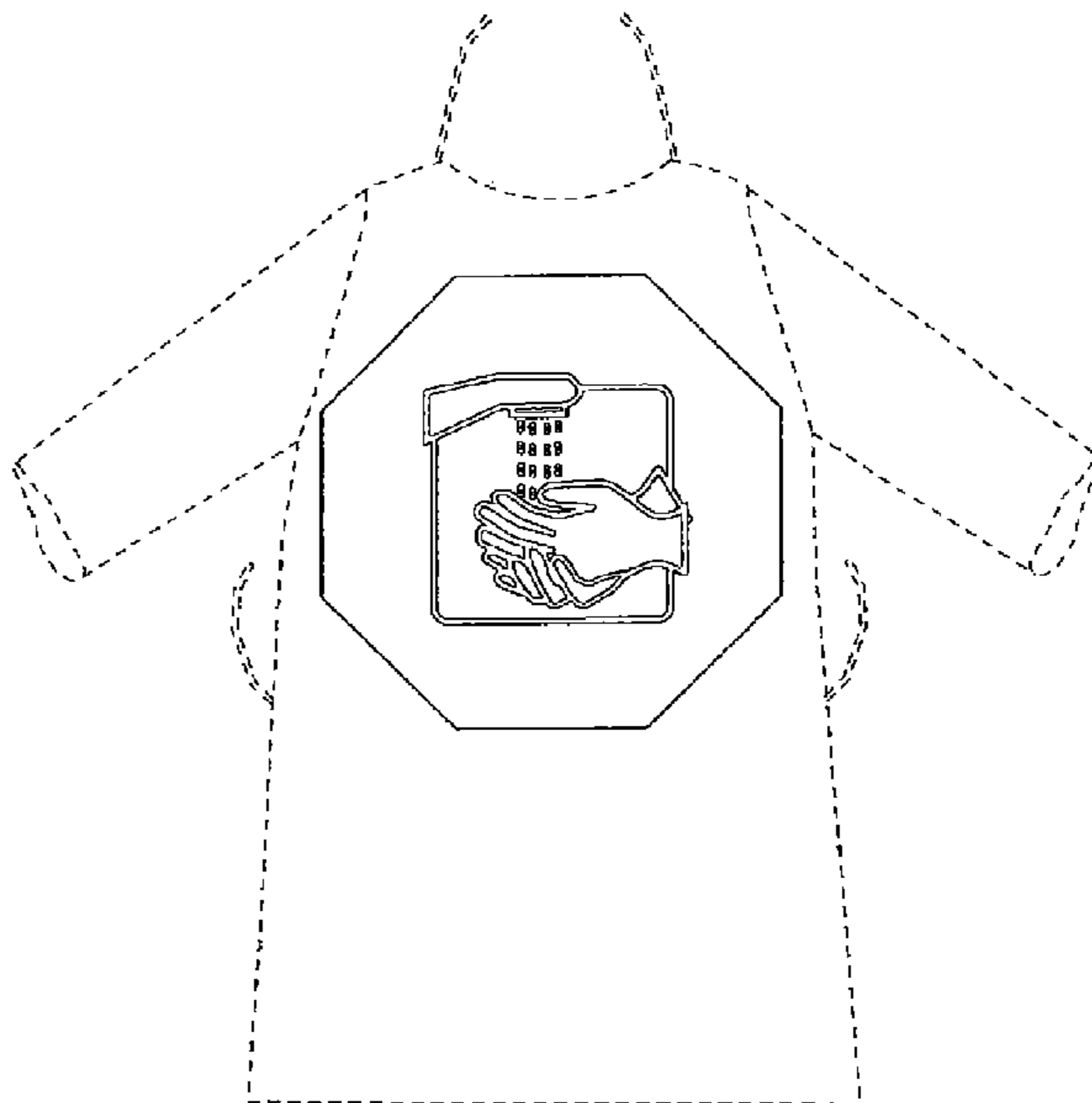
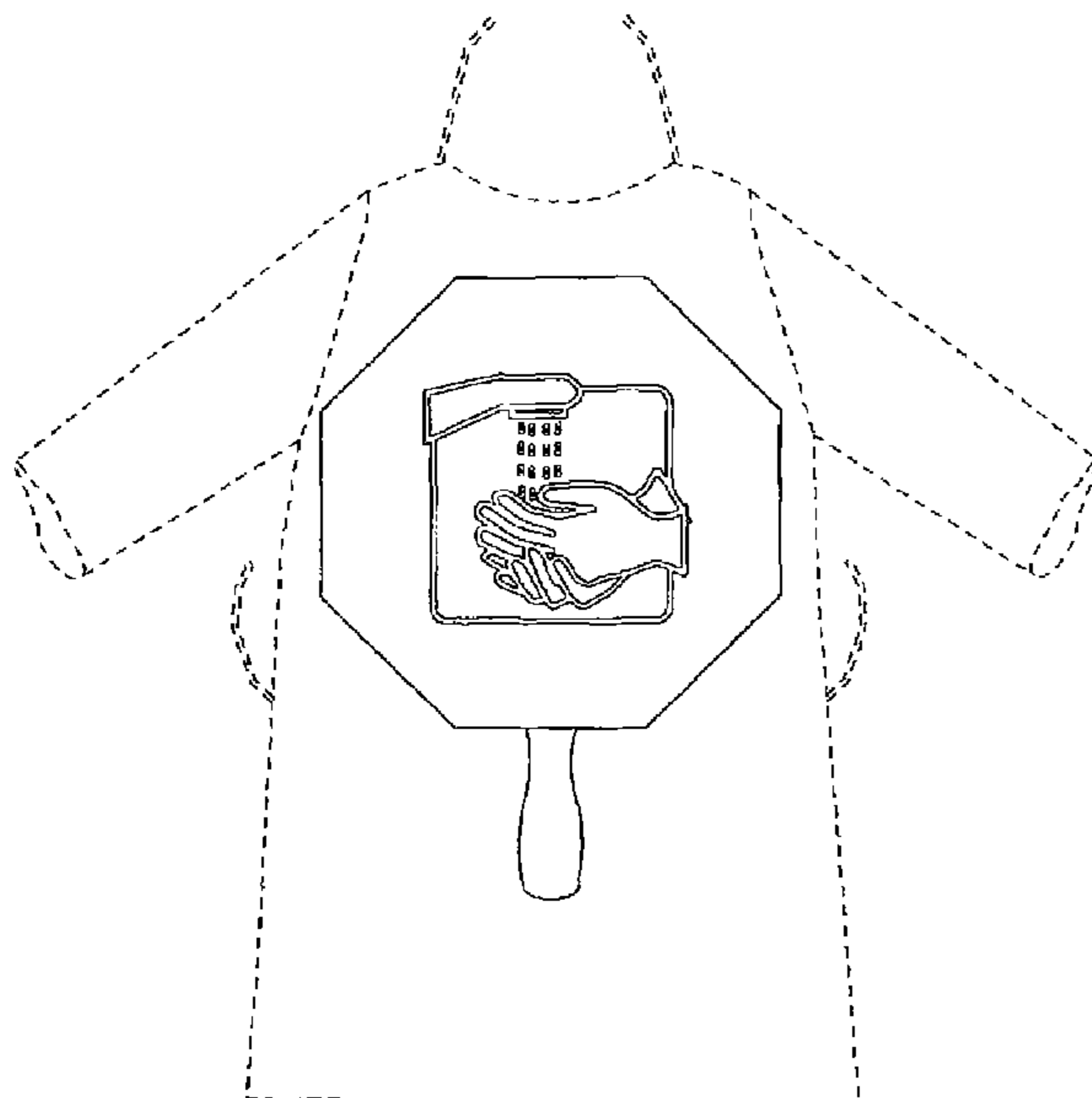
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the first and second embodiments of the gown;

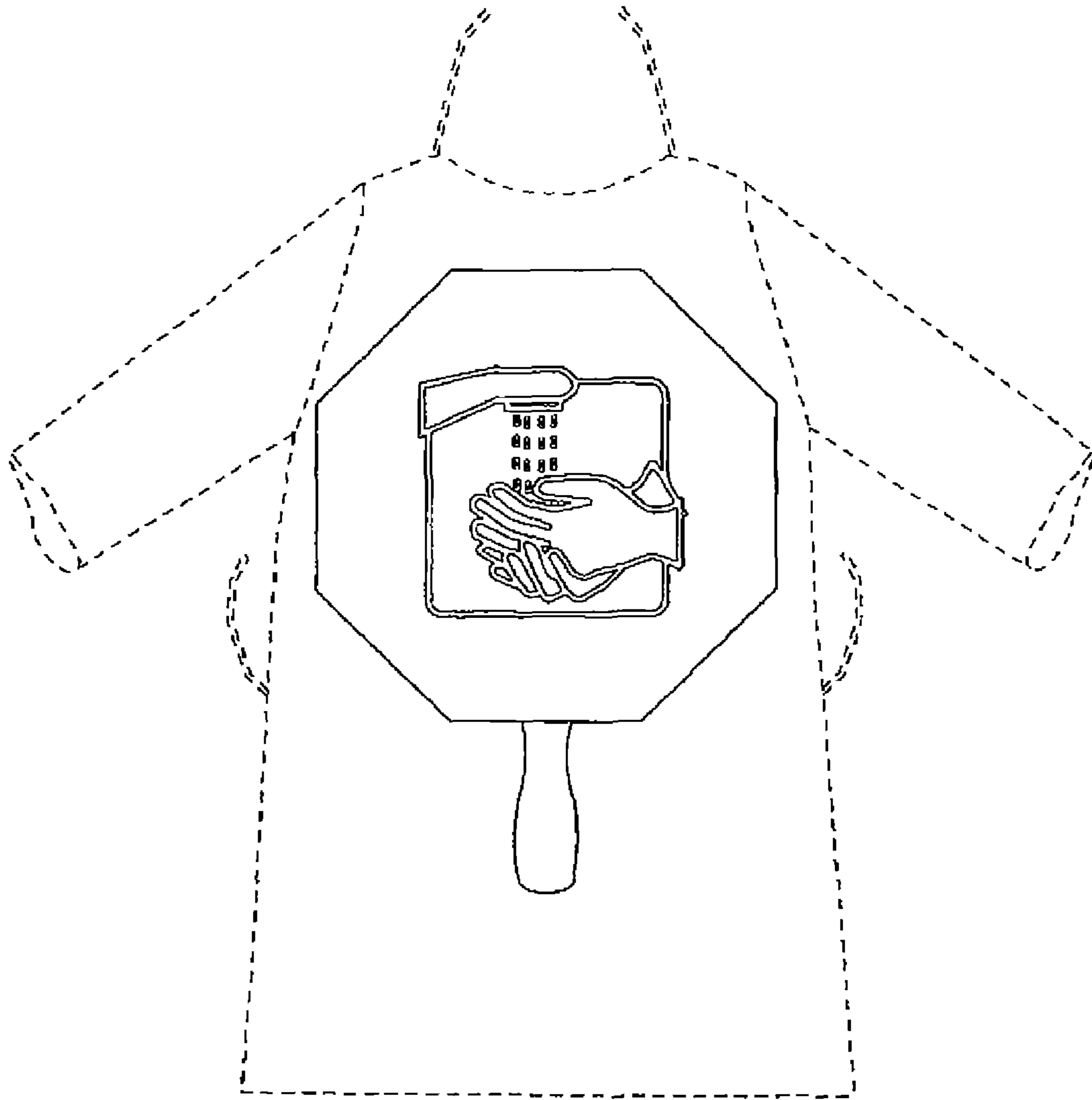

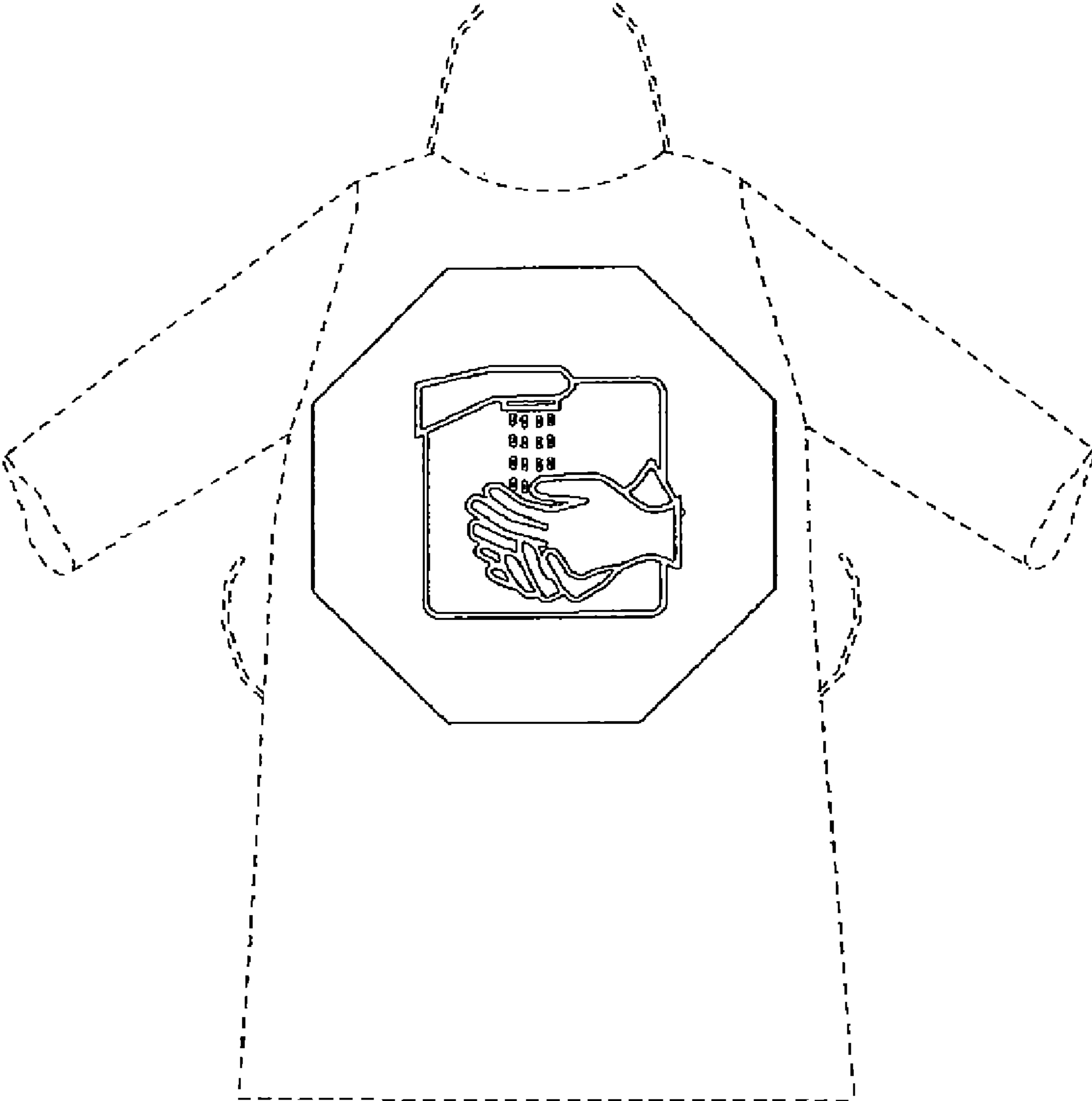

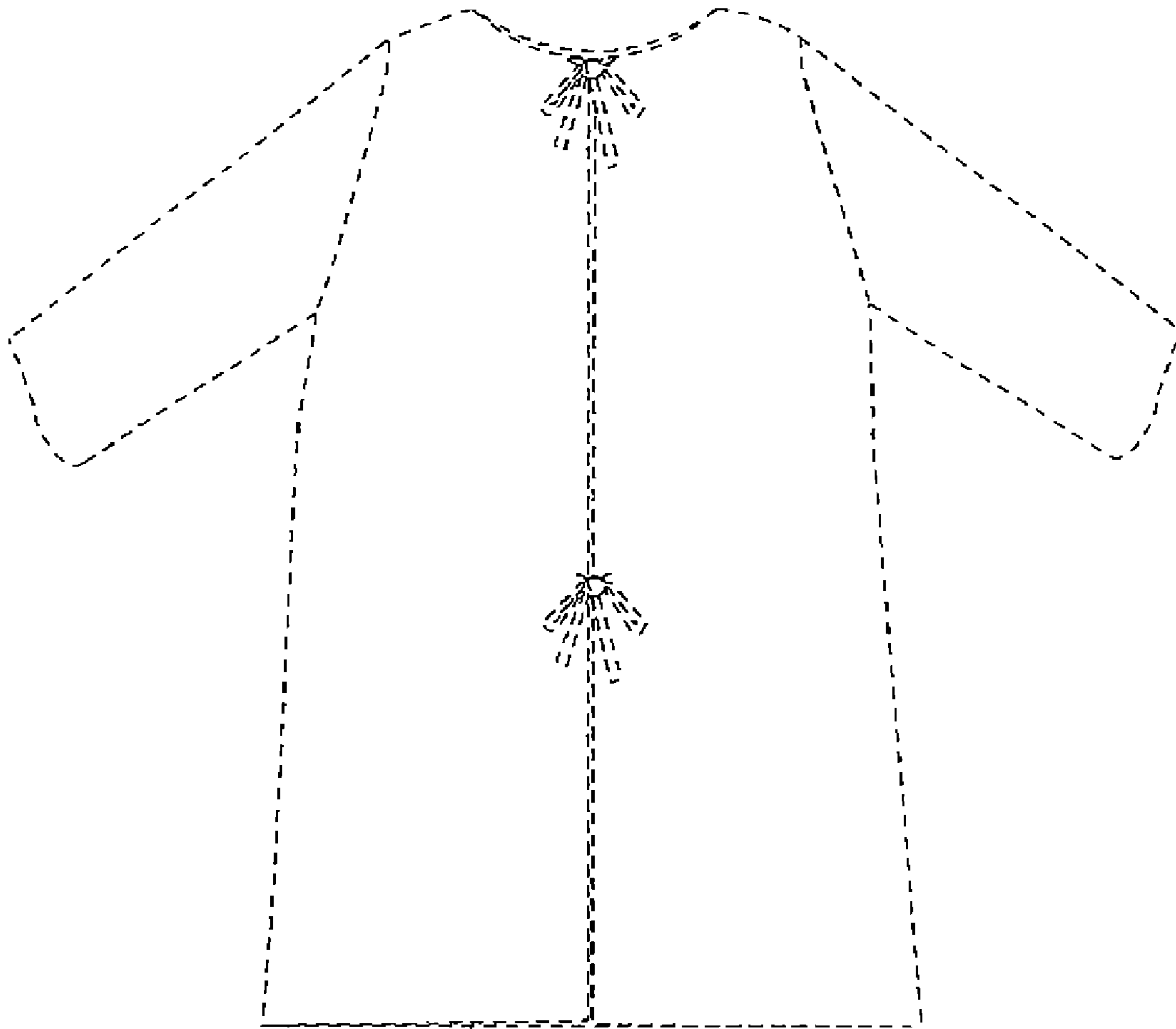

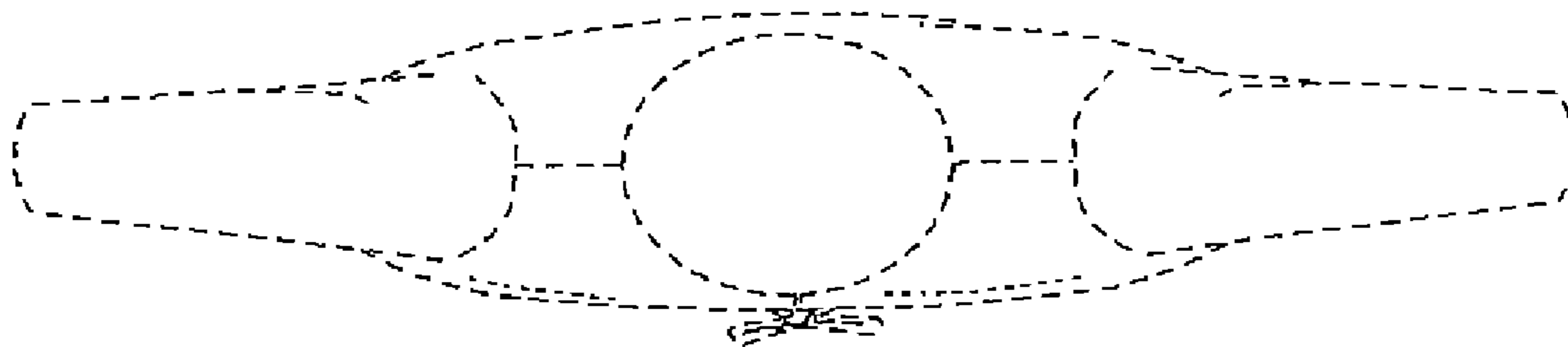

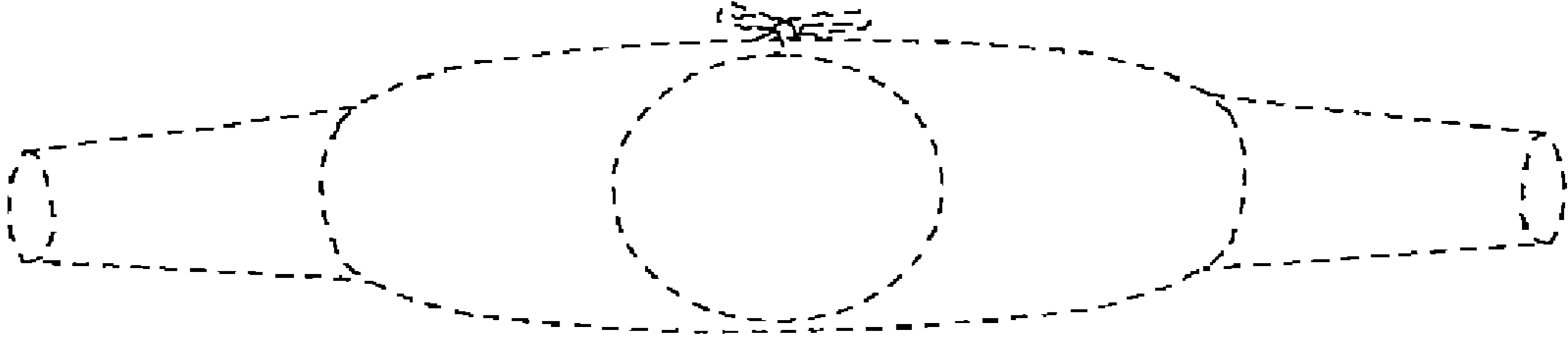

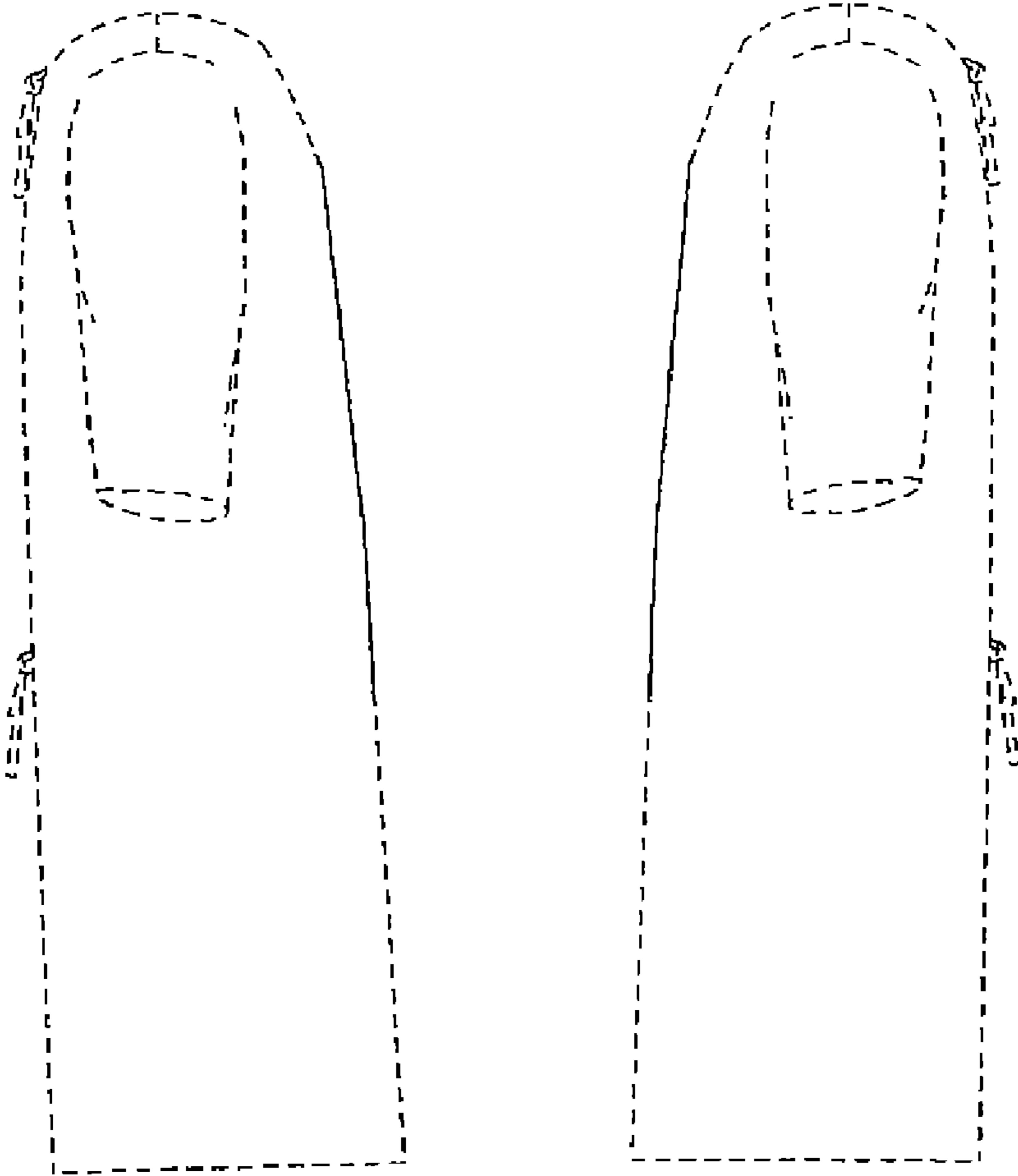
