The ornamental design for a shoe protector for motorcycle riding, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe protector for motorcycle riding showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view (opposite side view is mirror image) thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a back view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.
In FIG. 1, the broken lines showing of environmental structure for purposes of illustrating the shoe protector for motorcycle riding in a condition of use.

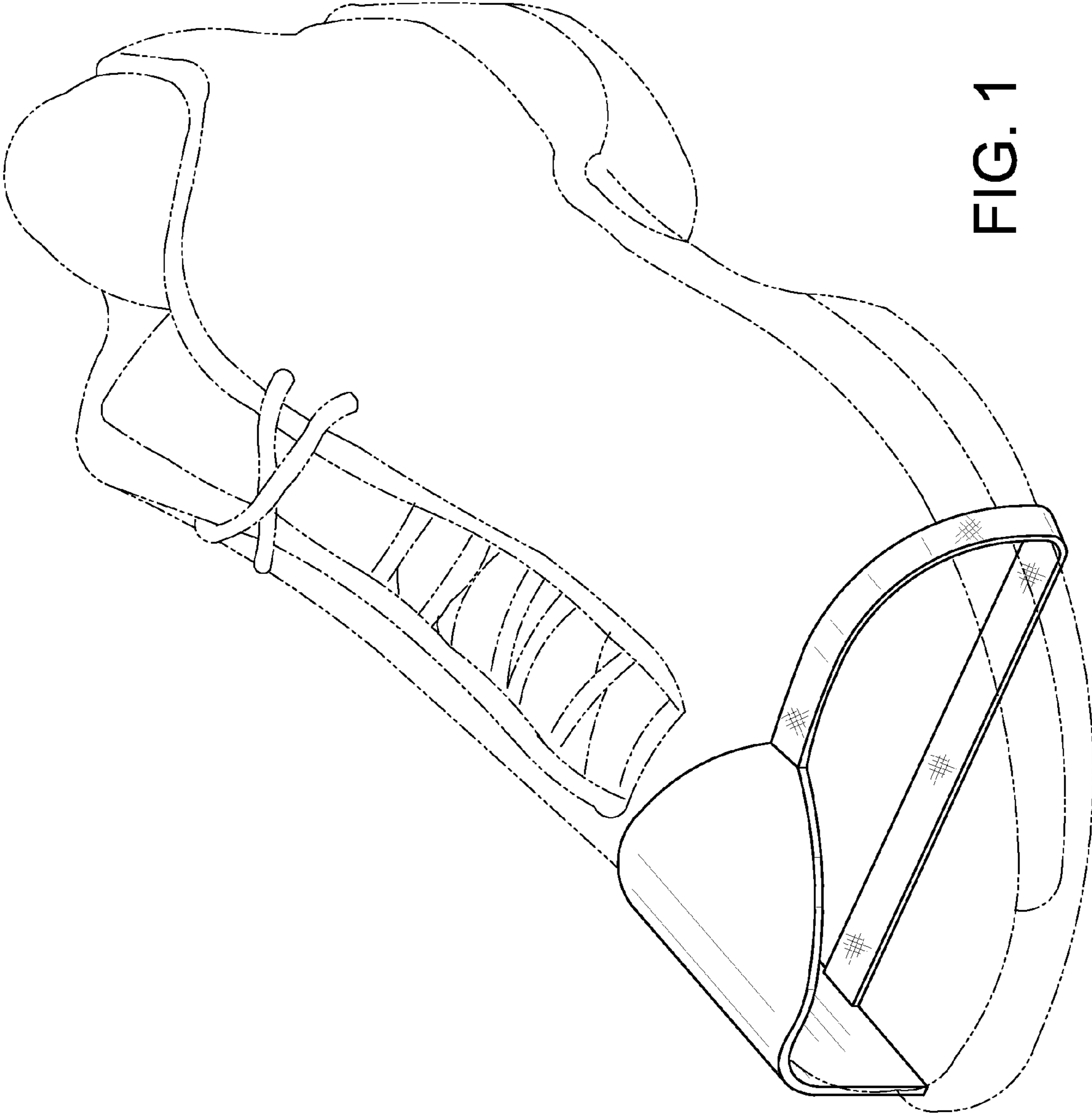

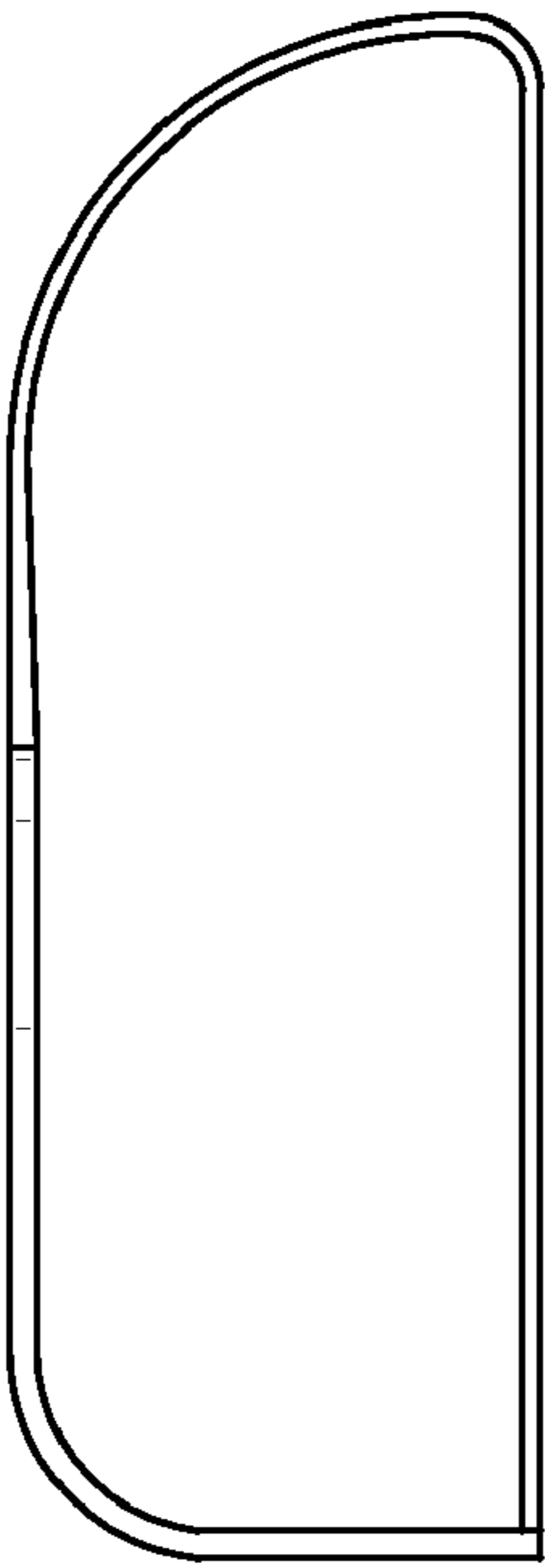

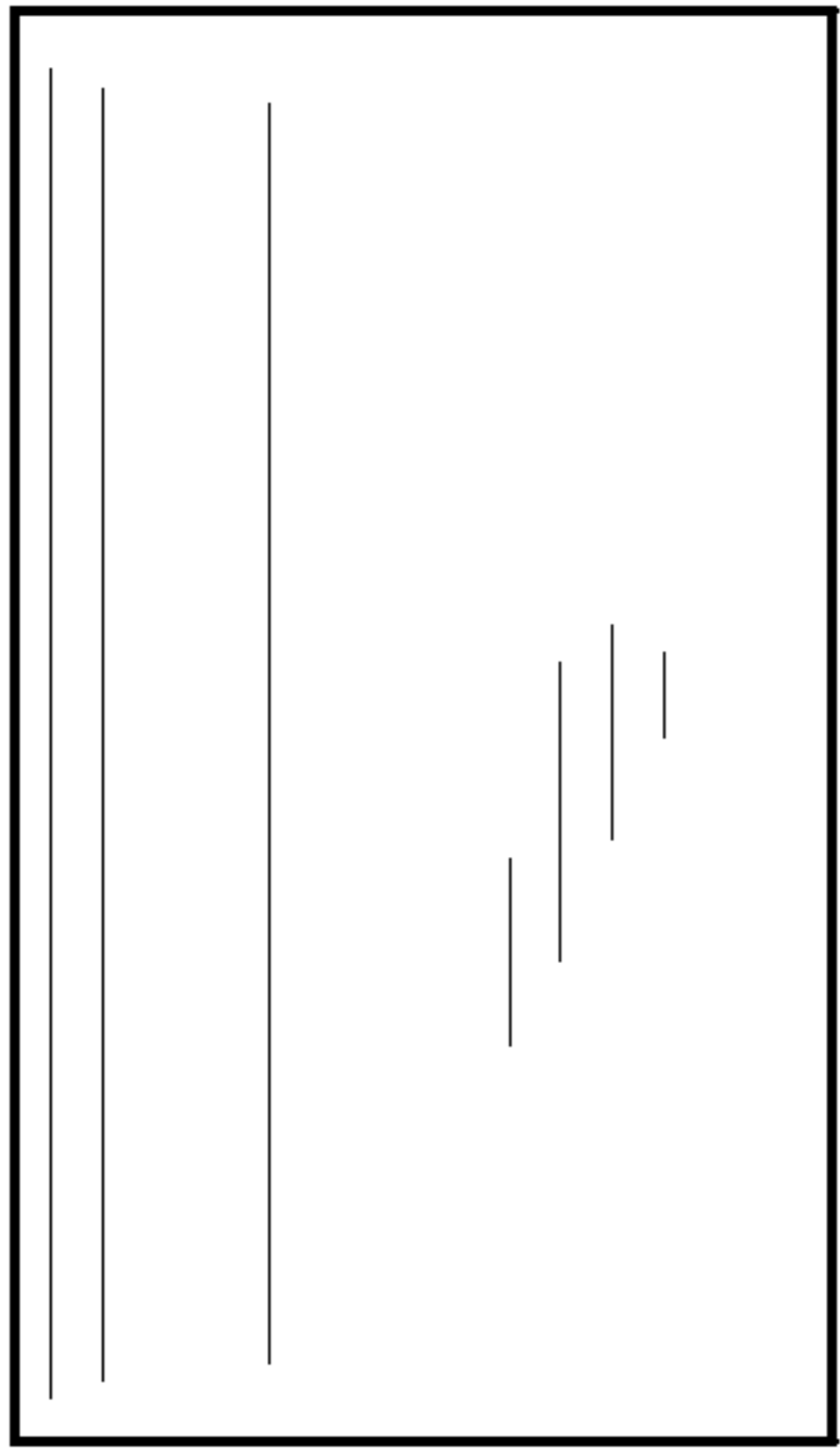

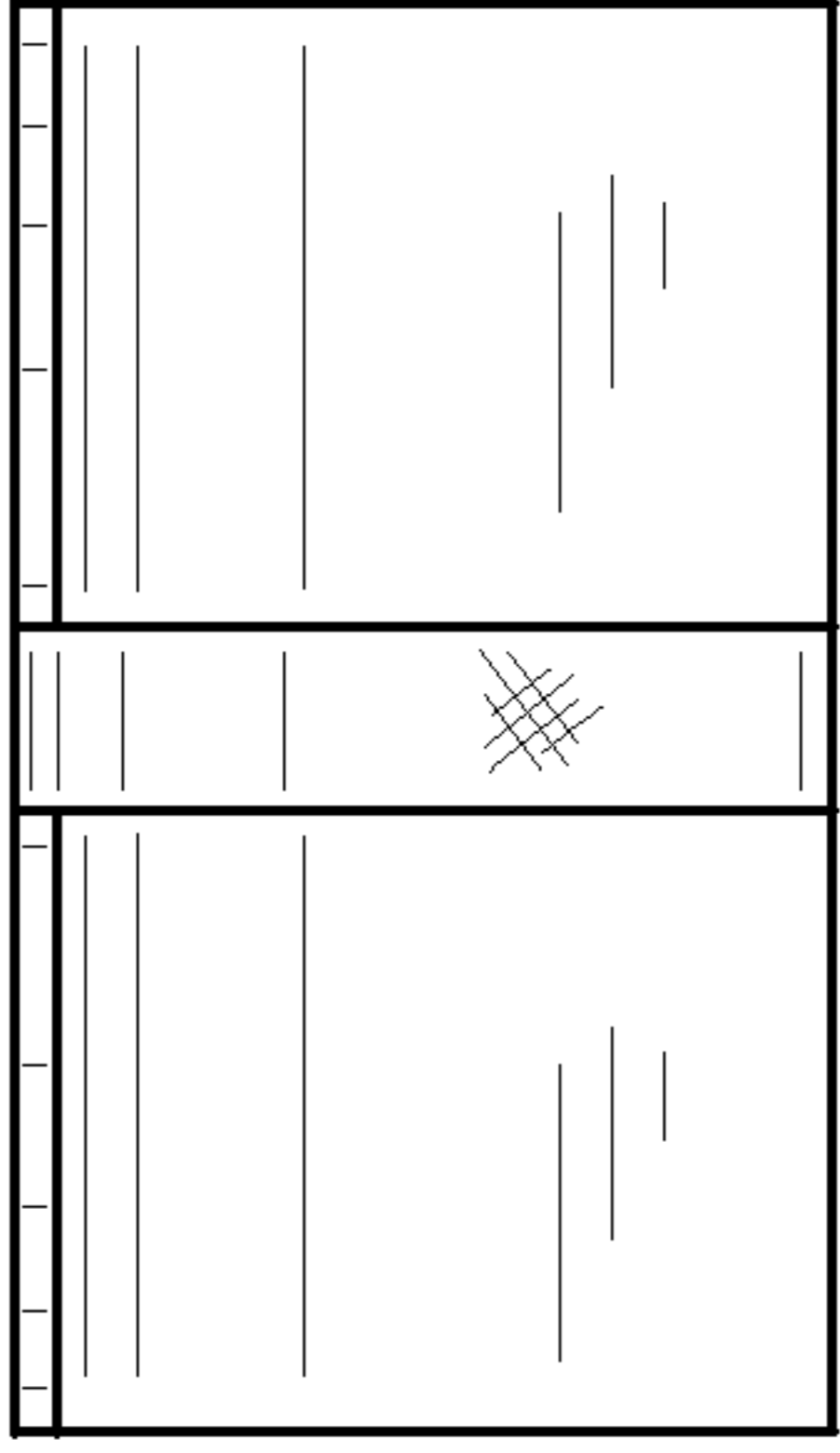

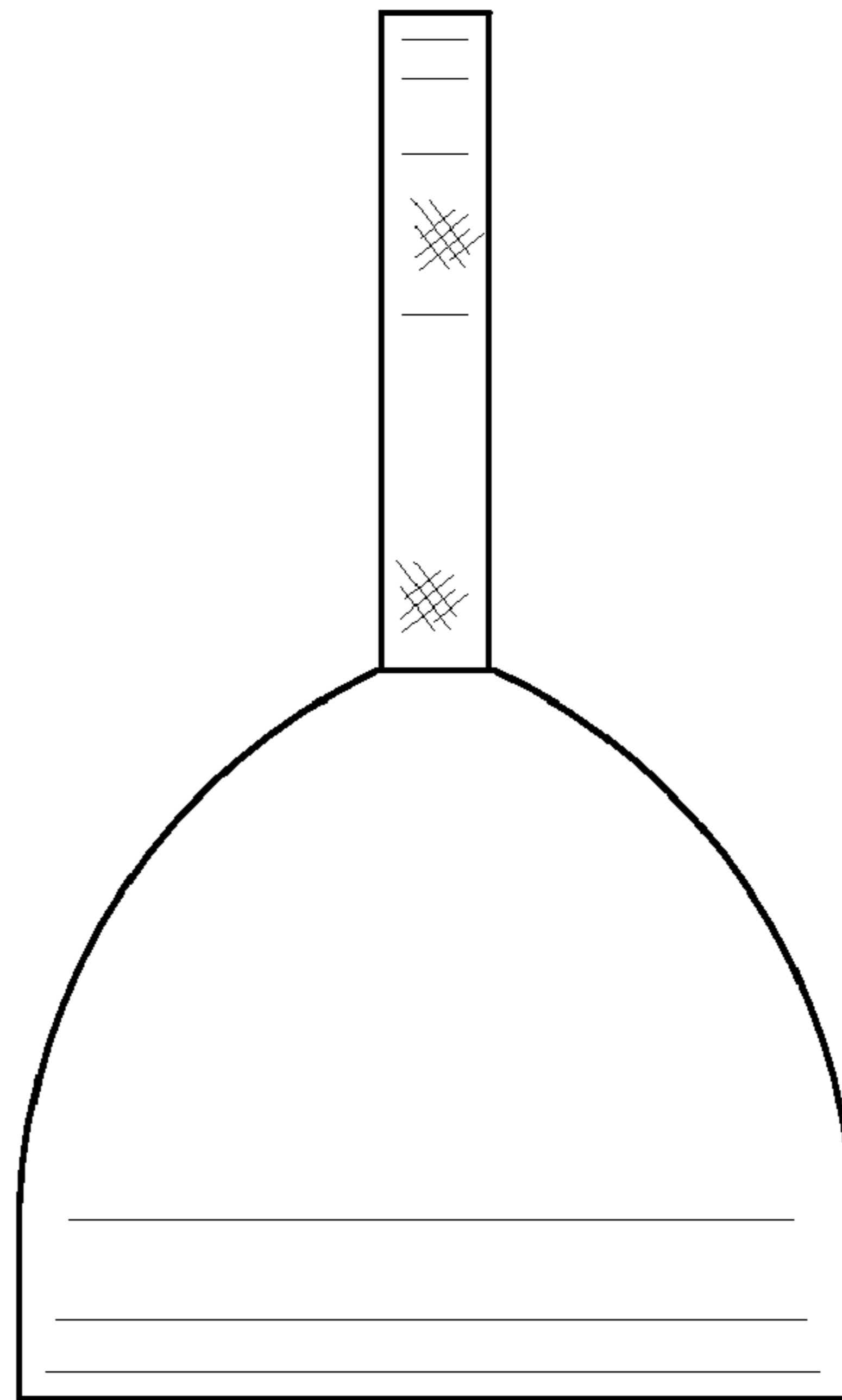

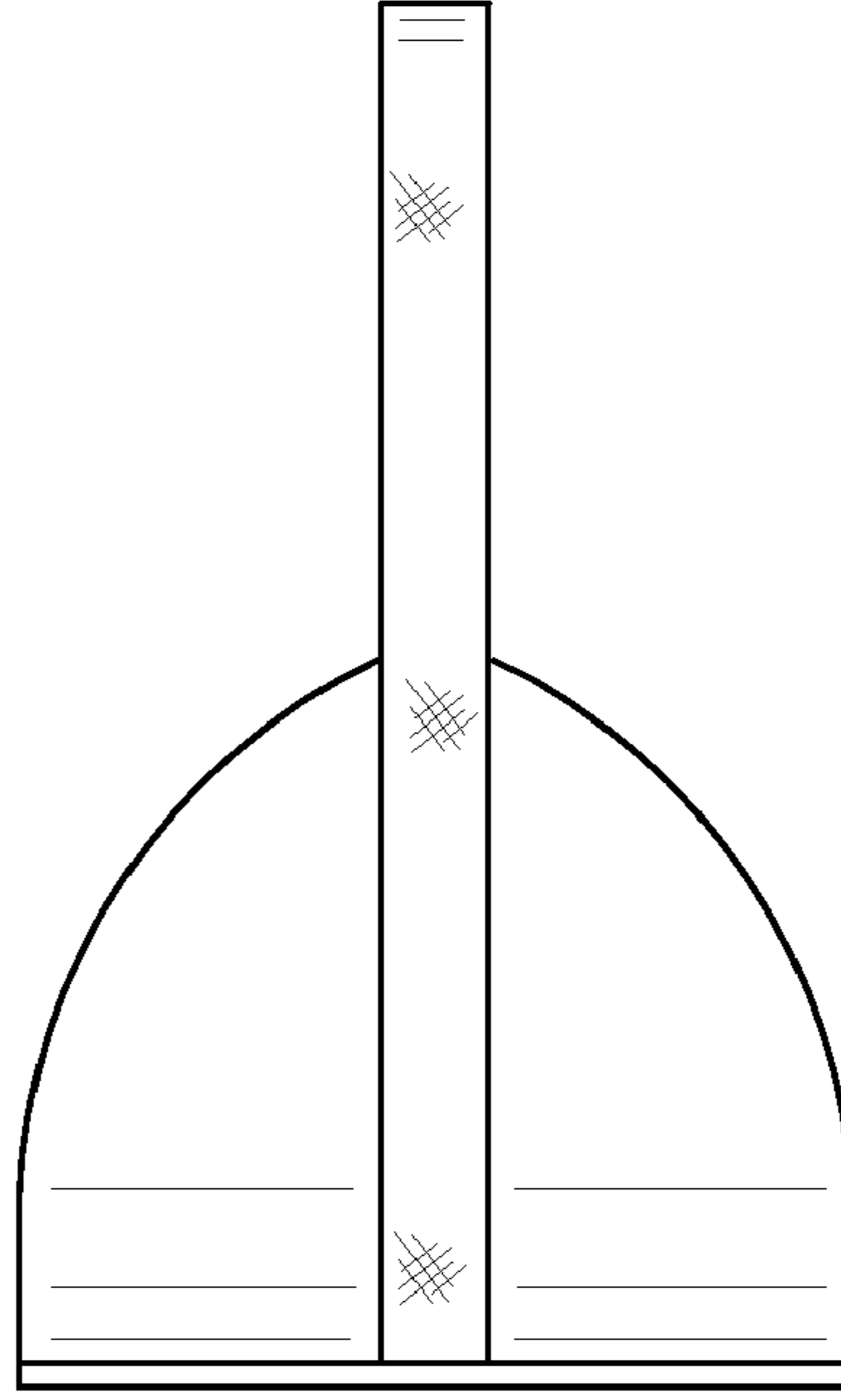
