FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;

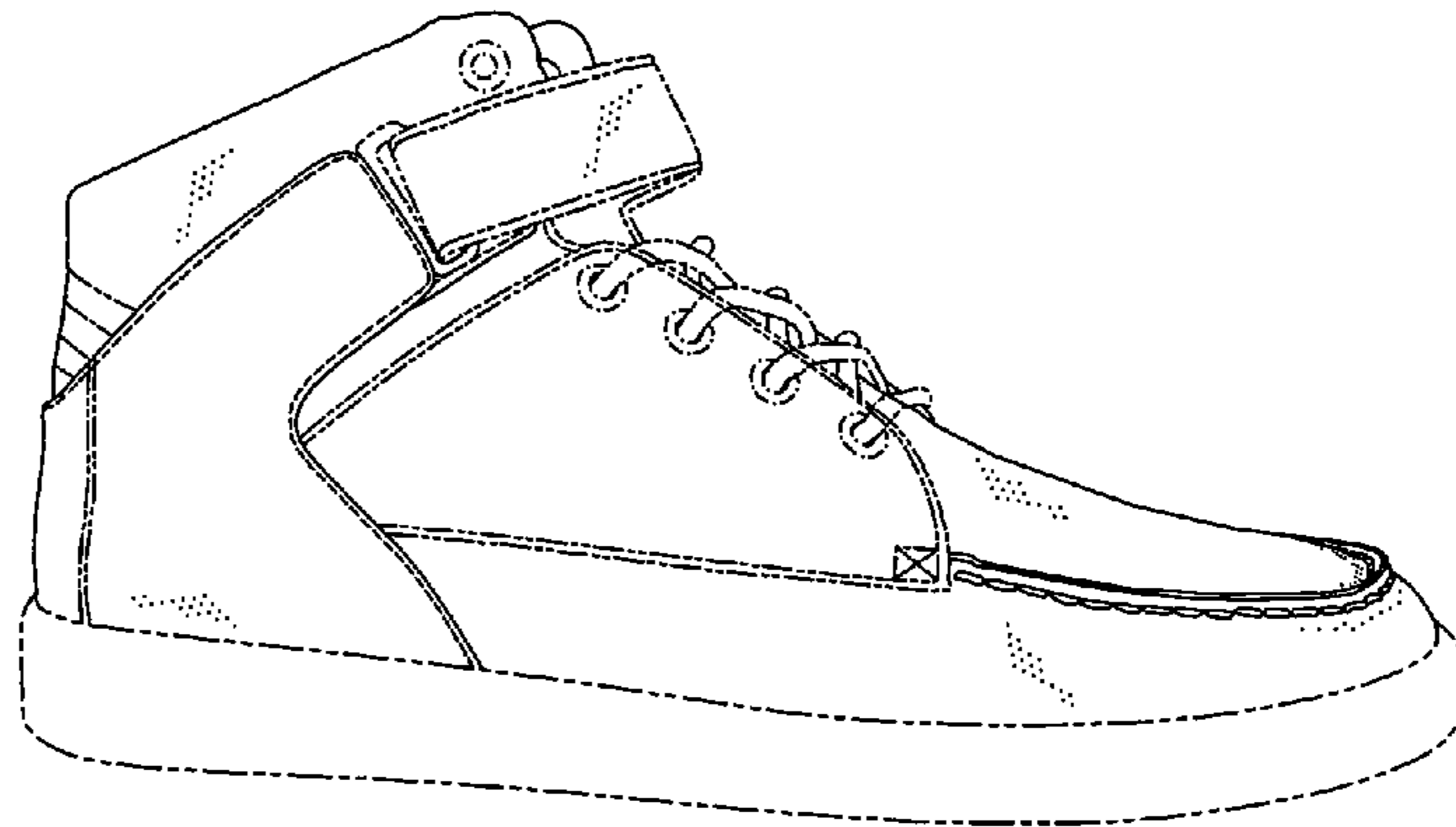
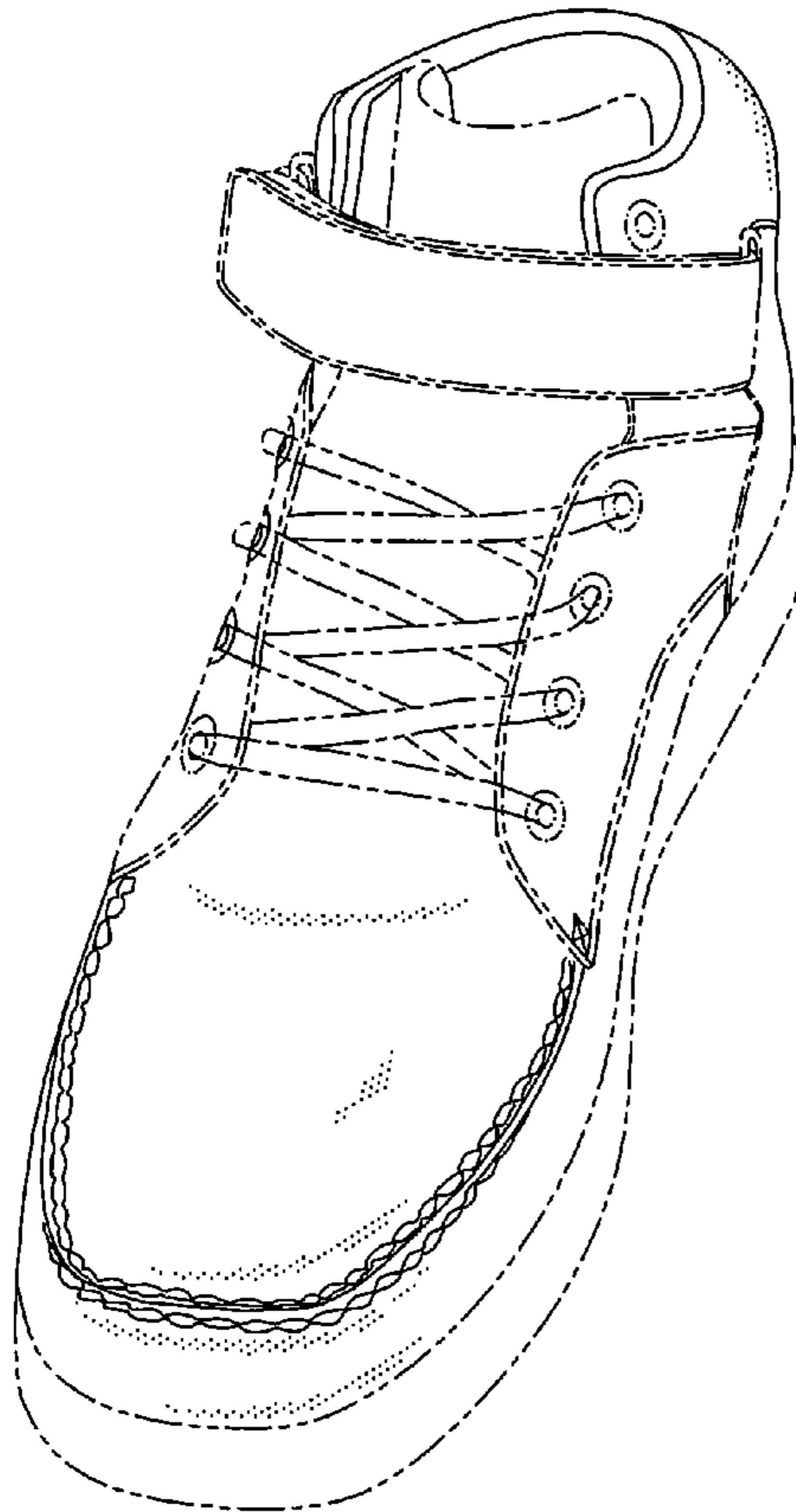
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

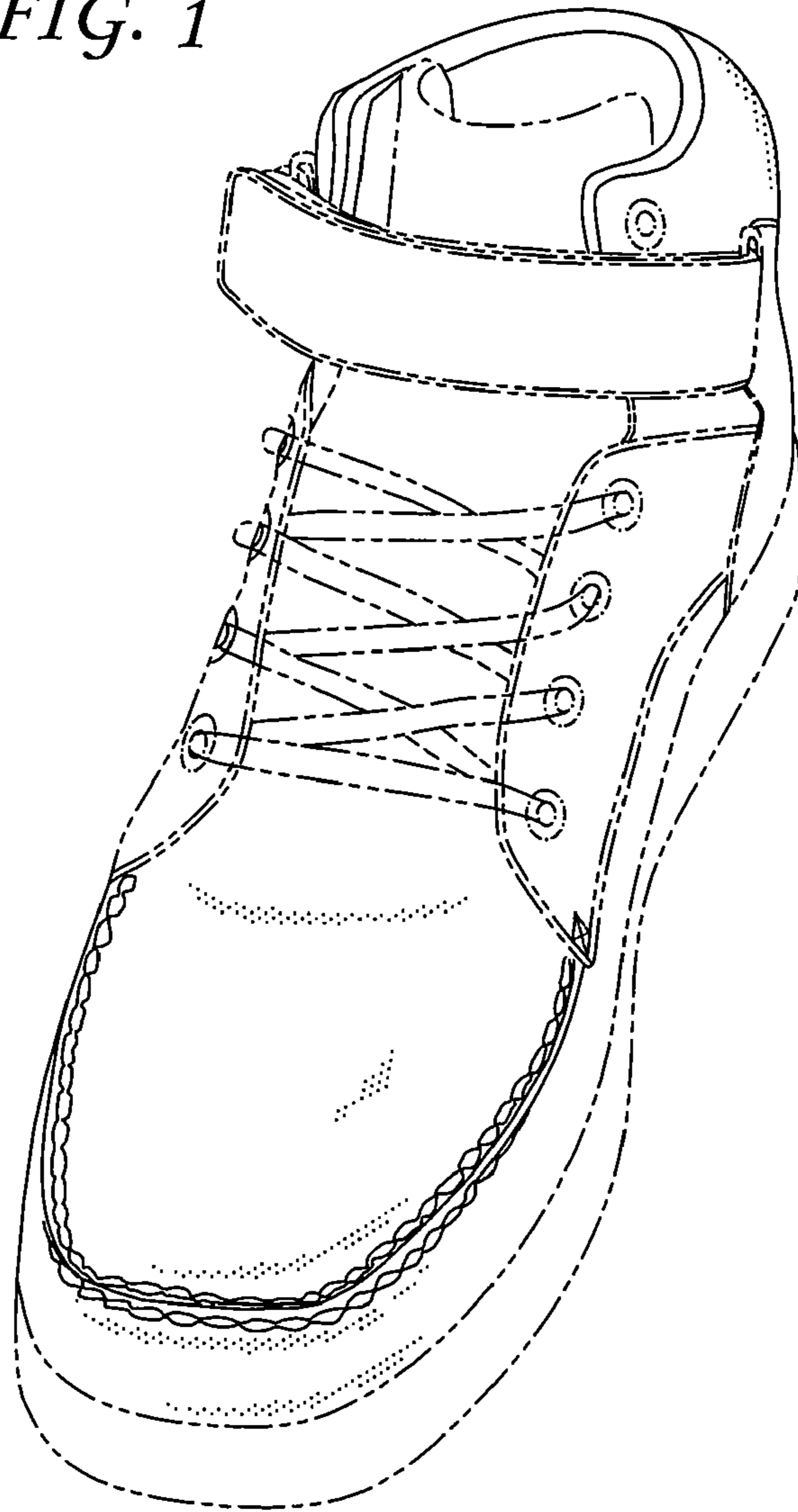
The dot-dot-dash broken lines shown are included the purposes of illustrating unclaimed portions of the article and form no part of the claim.

The dash-dash-dash broken lines within the claim area represent stitching.

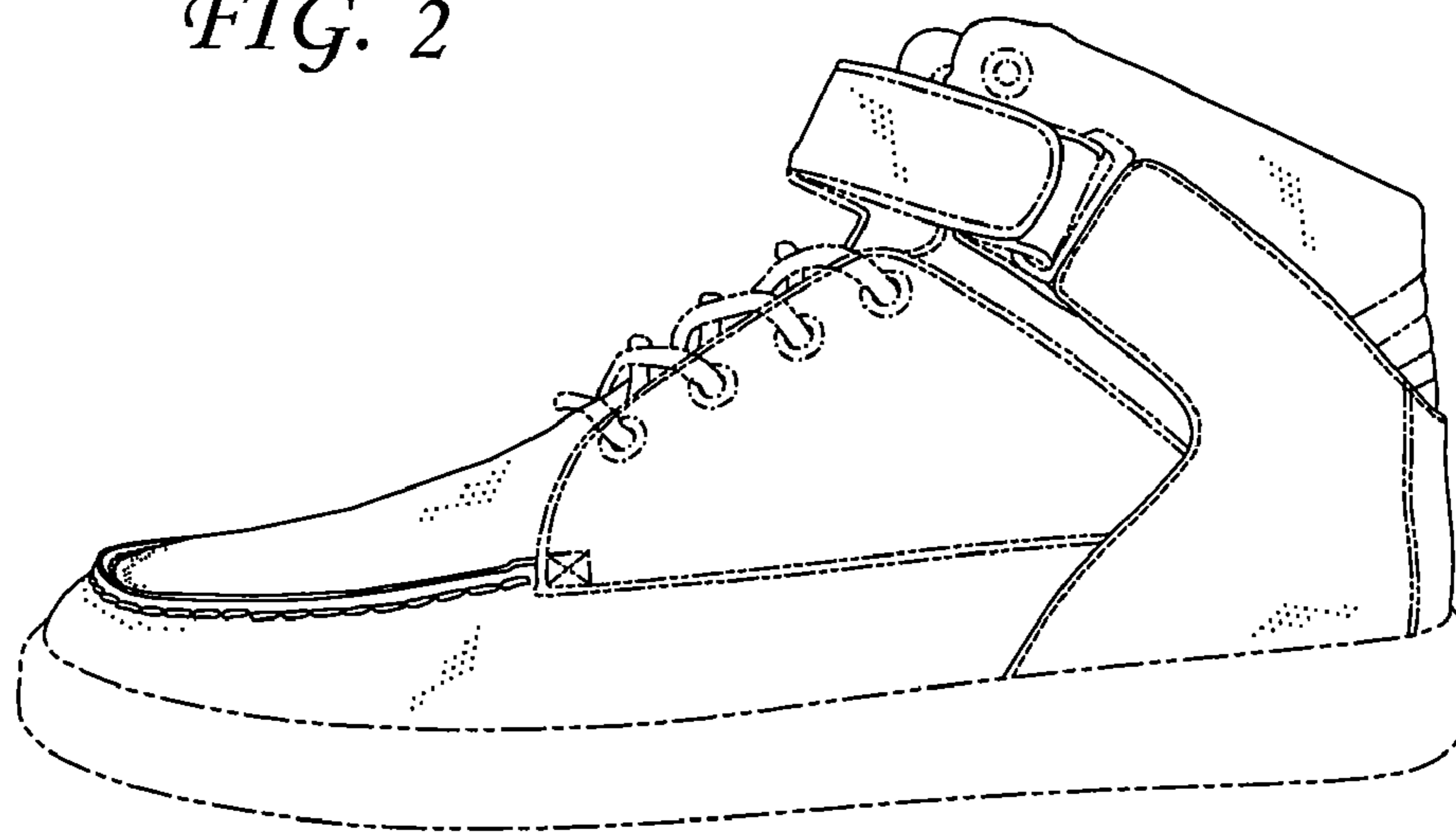

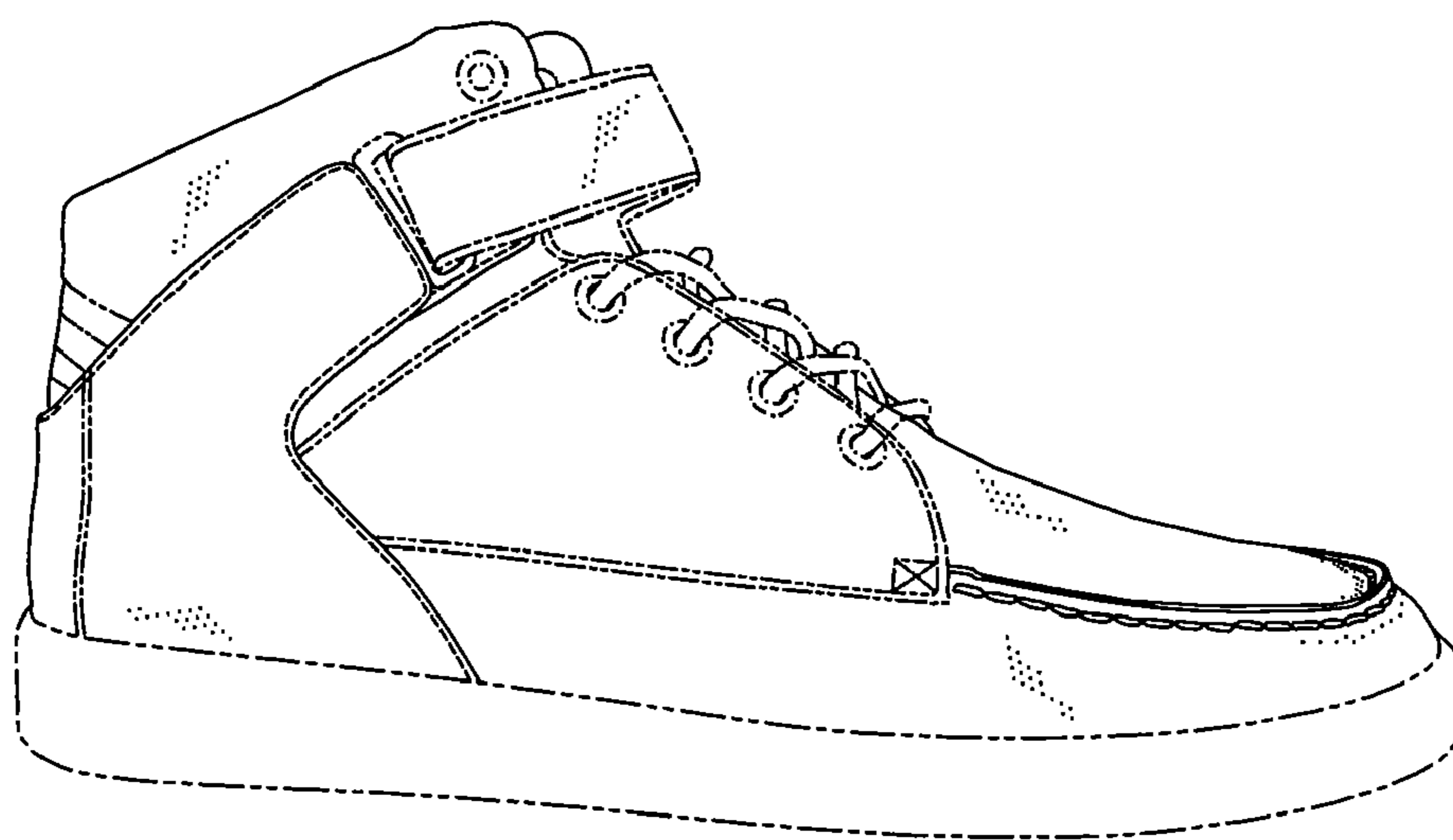

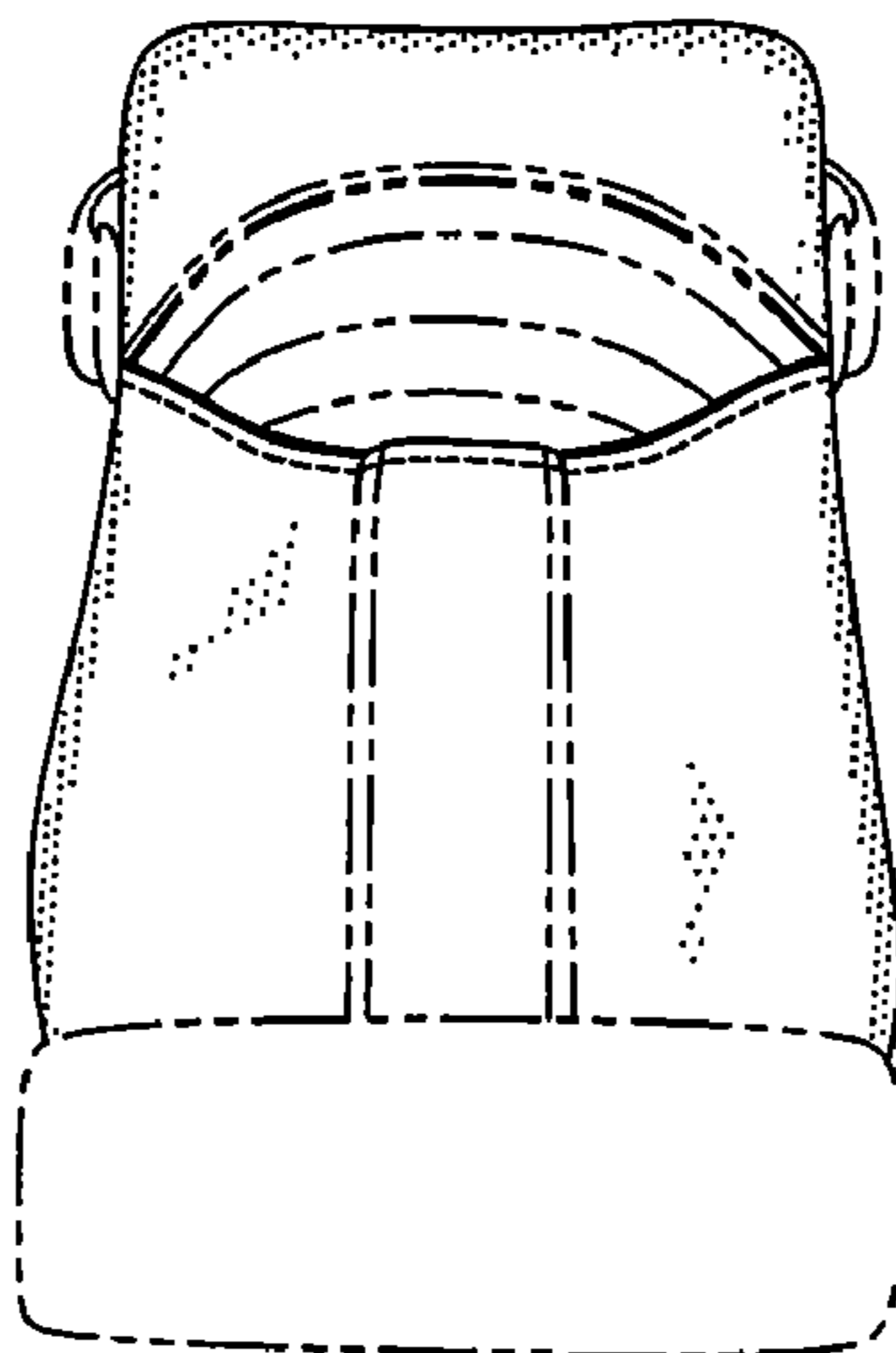

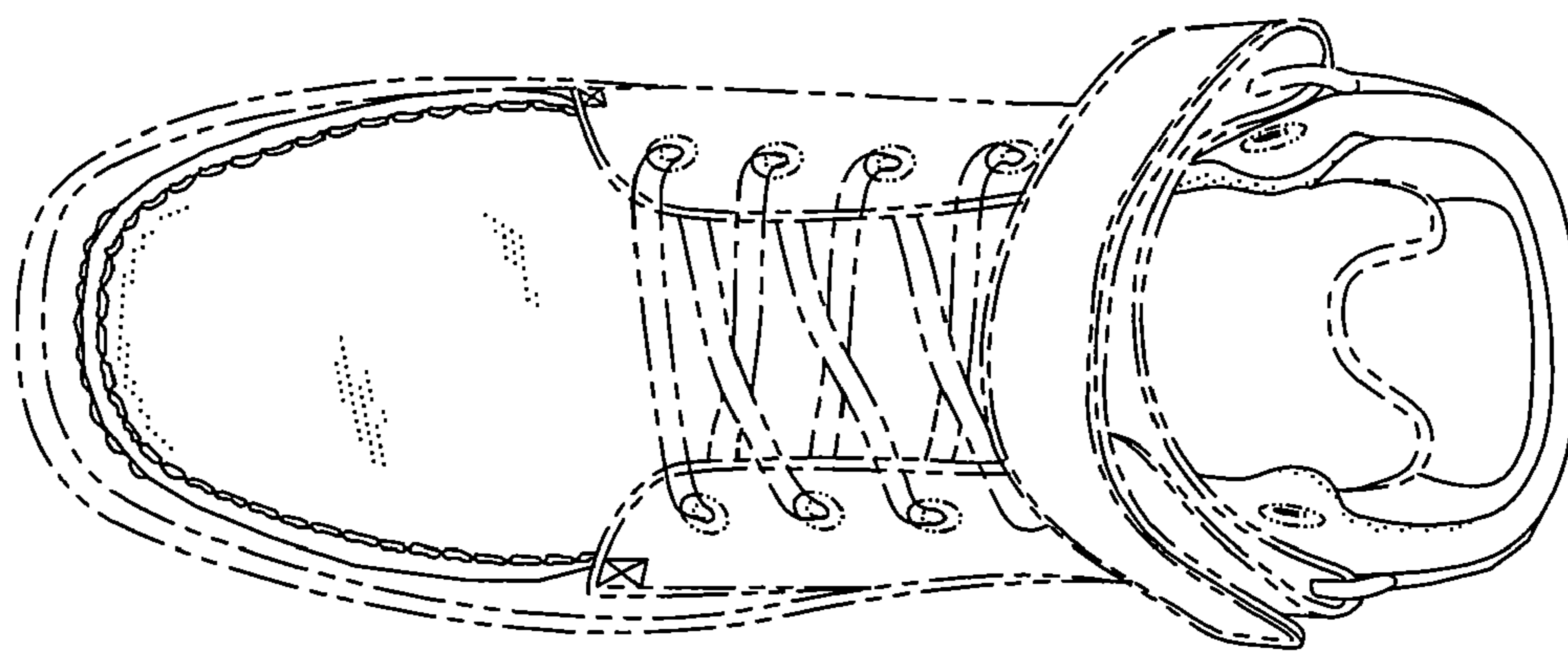
