FIG. 5 is a back side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the present invention with the lid closed; and,

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof.

The dots in FIGS. 1 and 3 to 7 are stippling that represents curvature of the soft toy chest. The broken lines showing the inside surface in FIG. 2 represent a portion of the chest that forms no part of the claimed design.

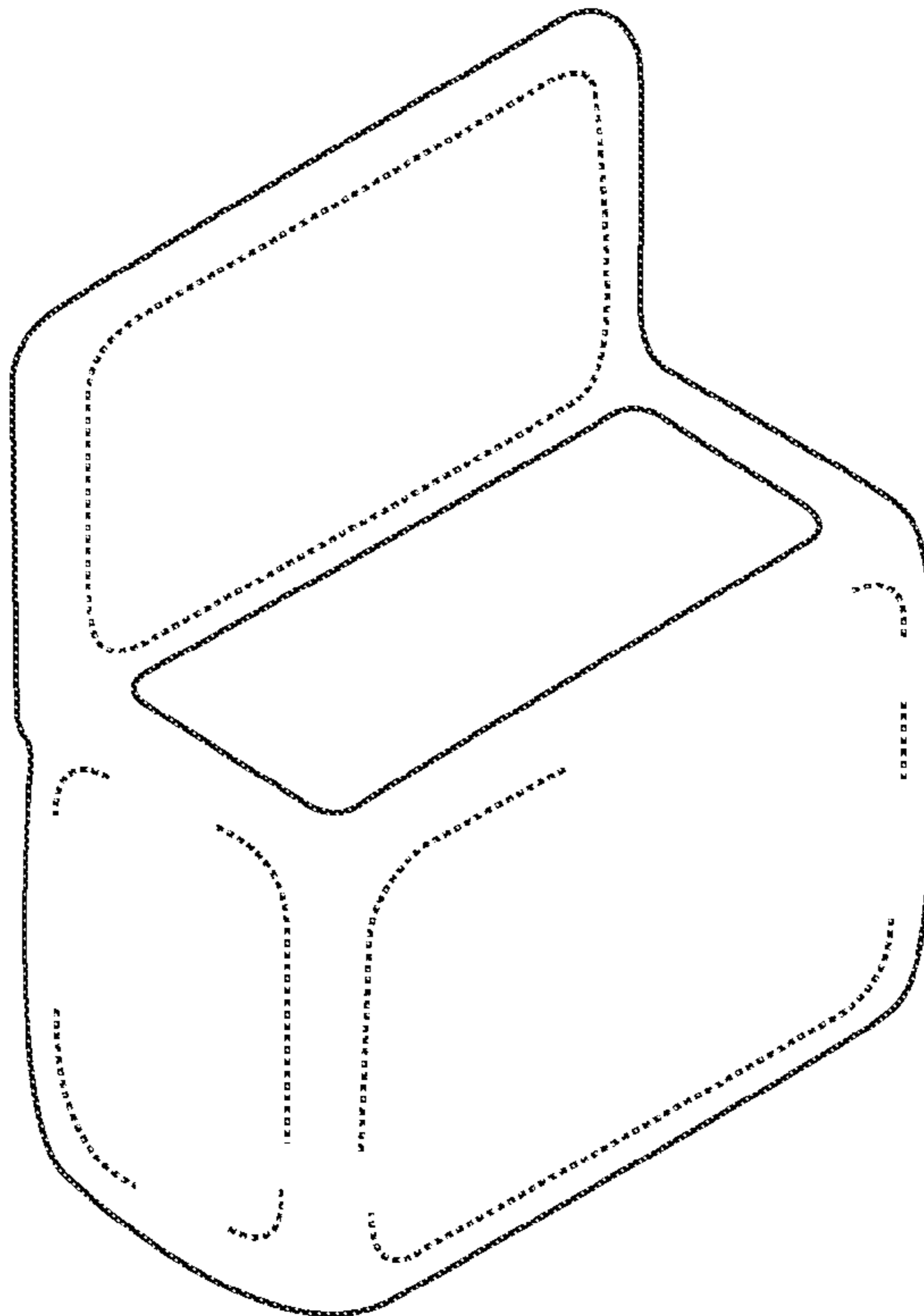

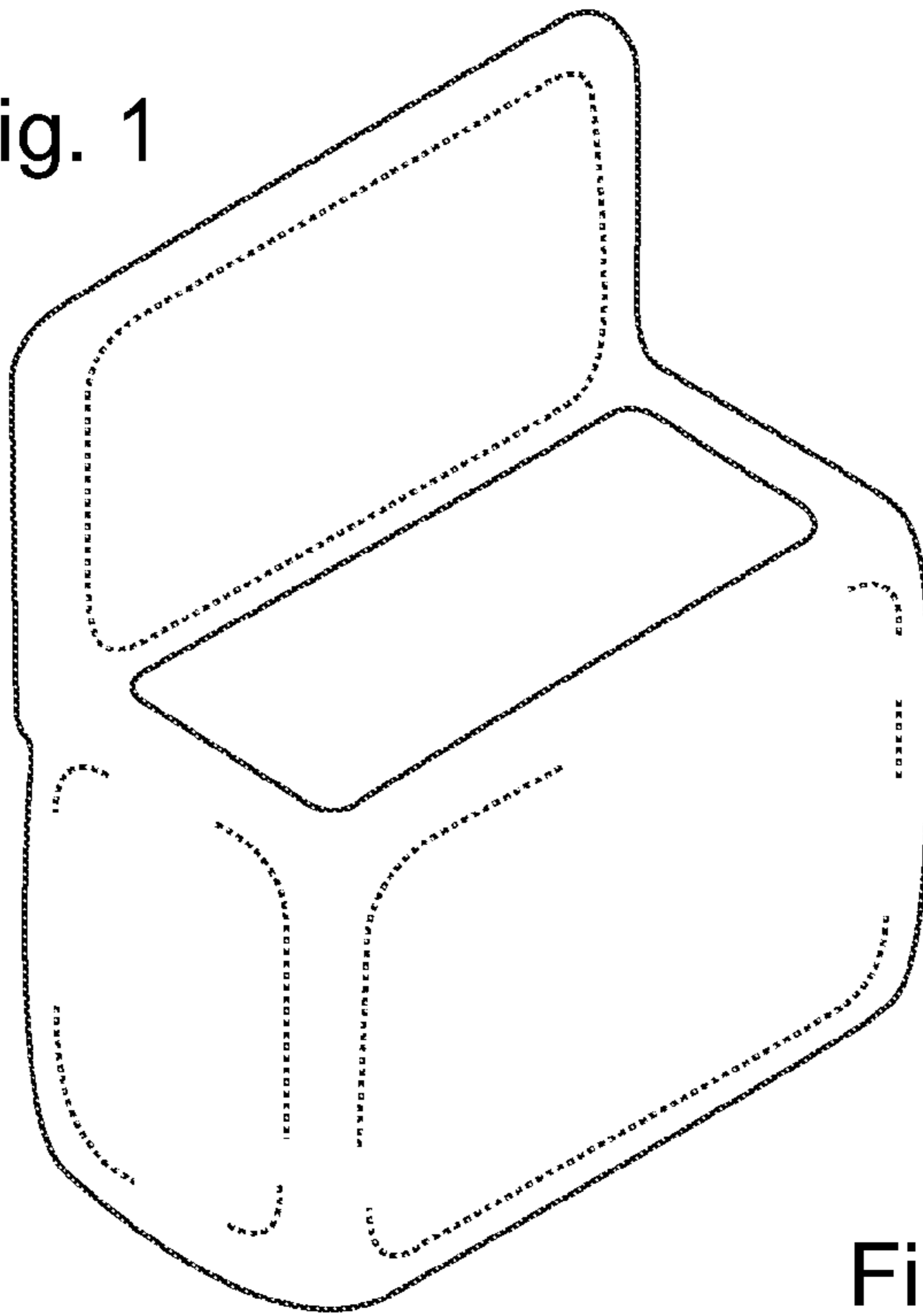

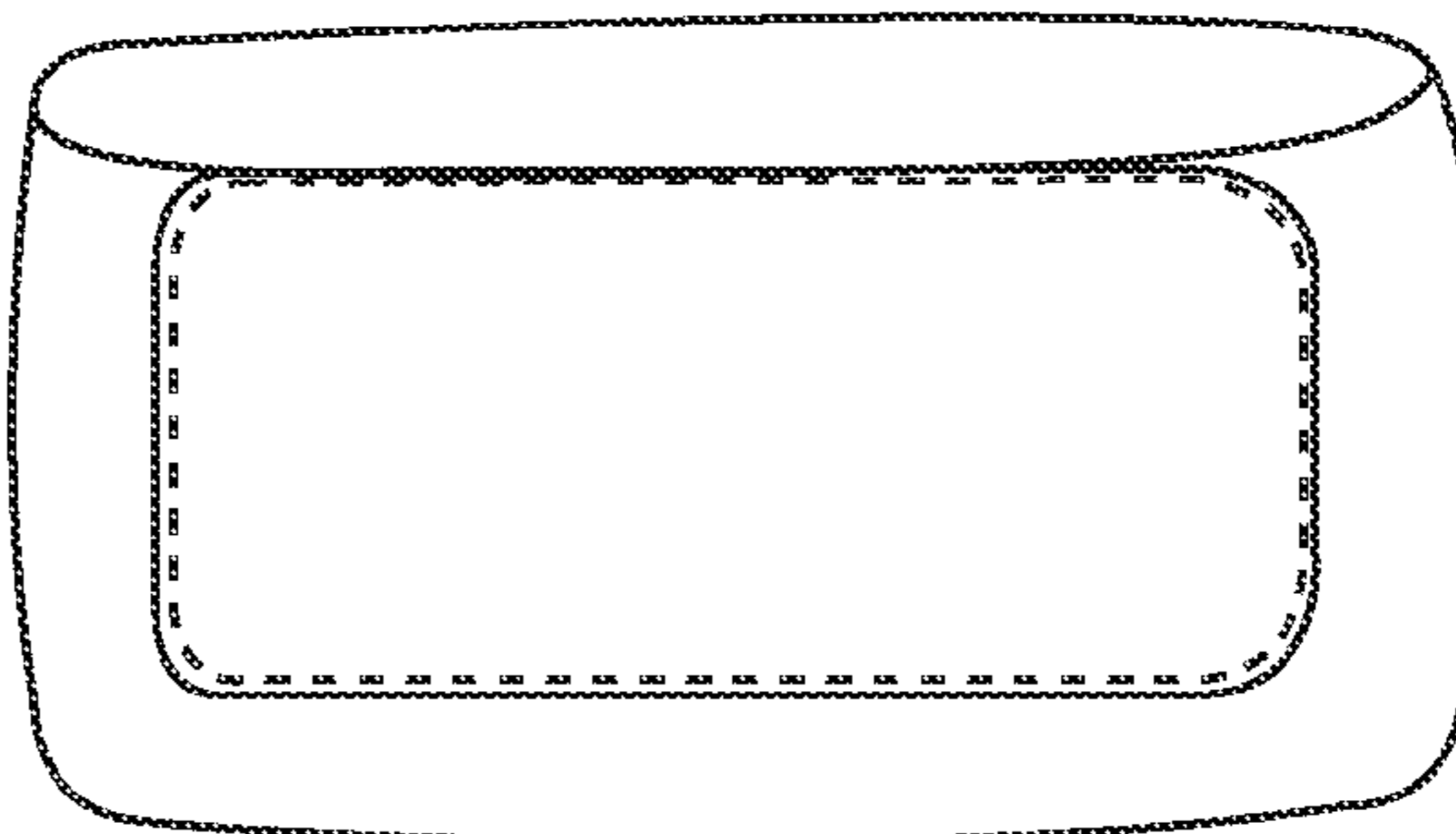

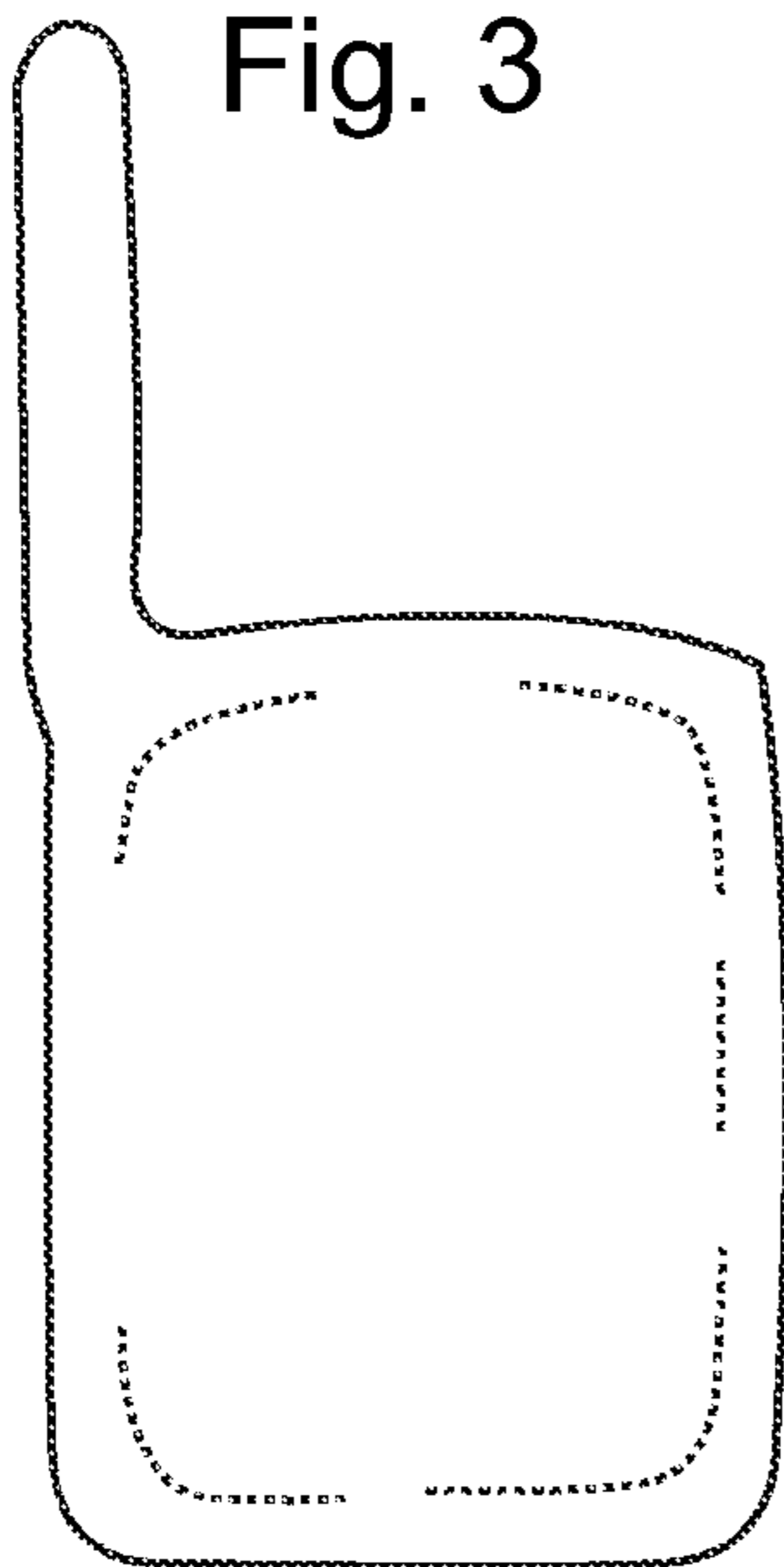

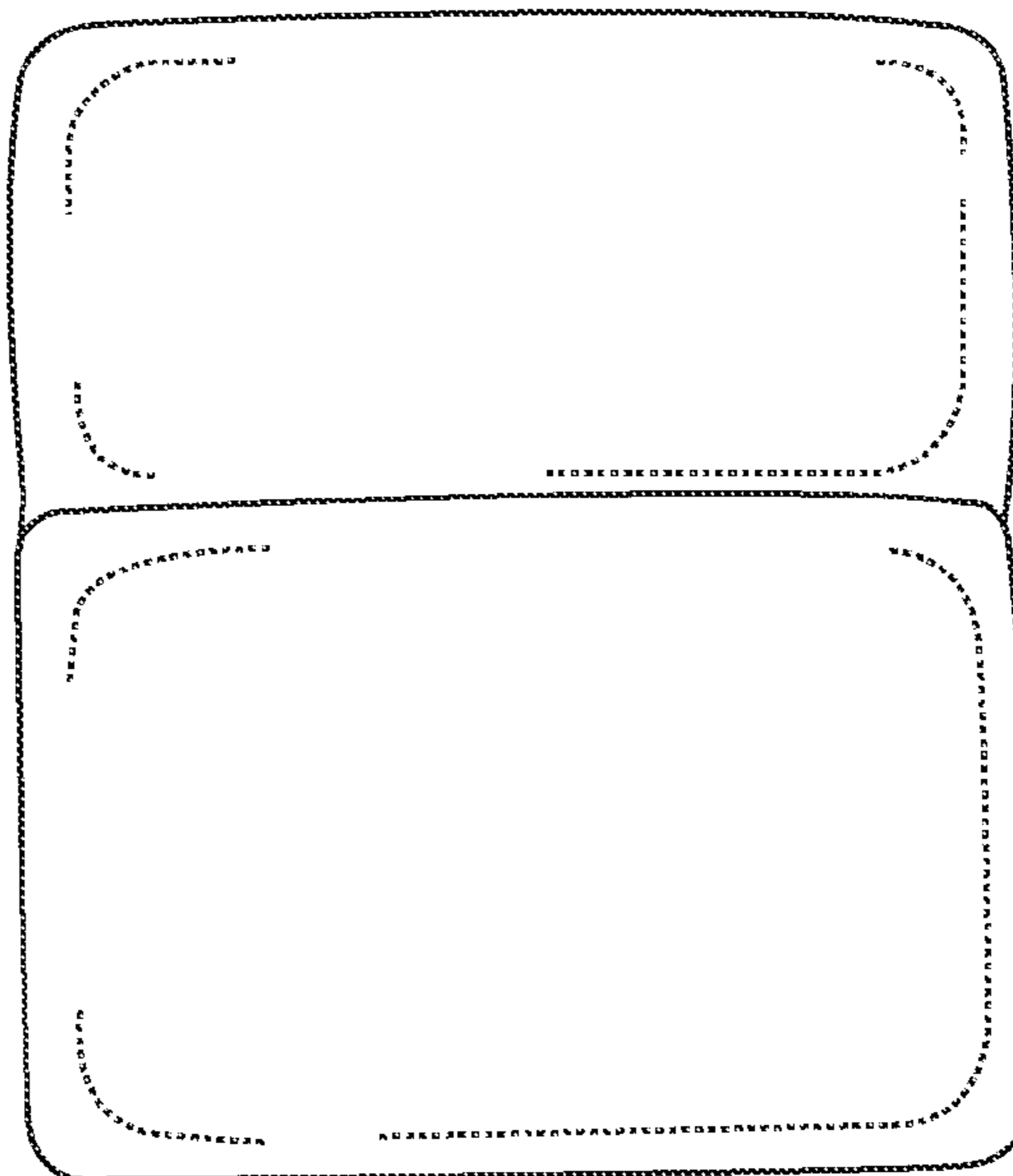

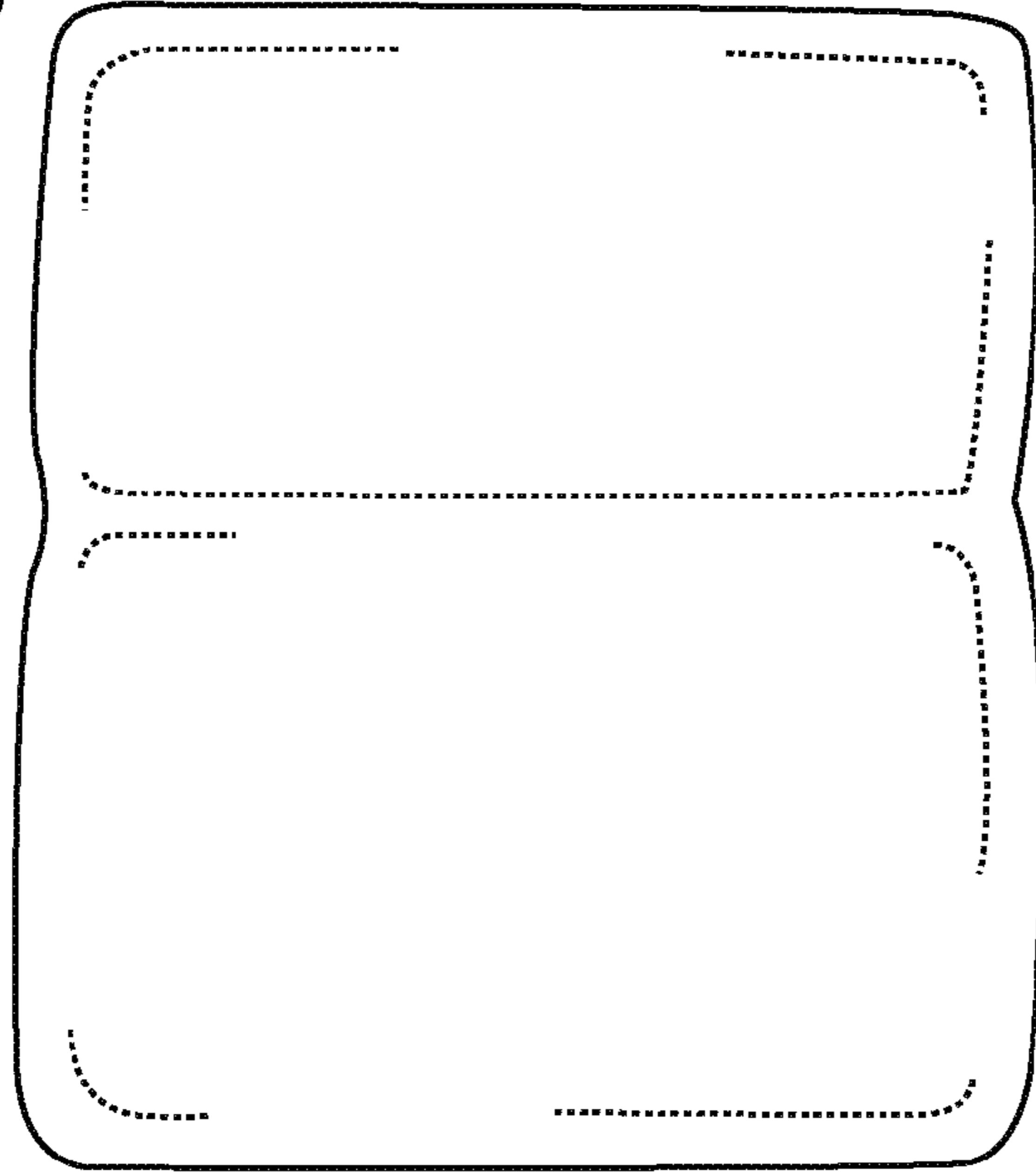

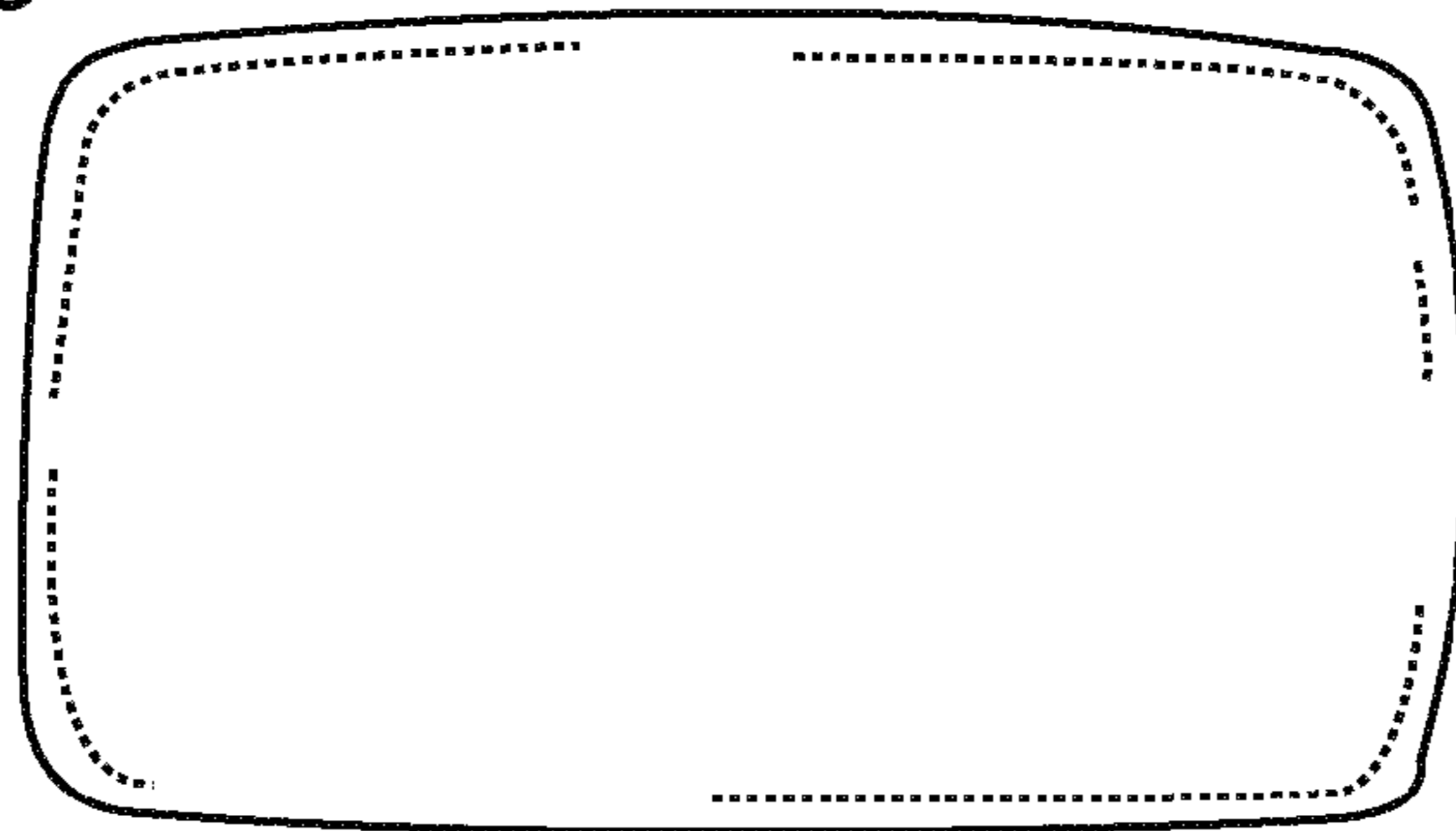
