FIG. 11 is a right side view thereof;

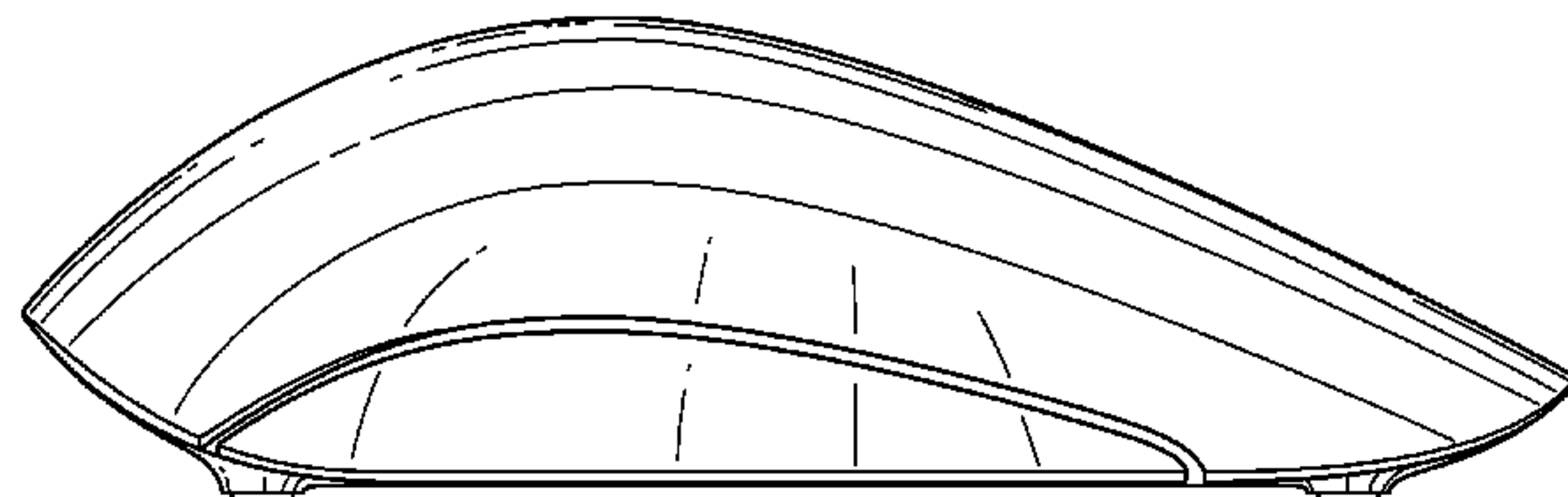
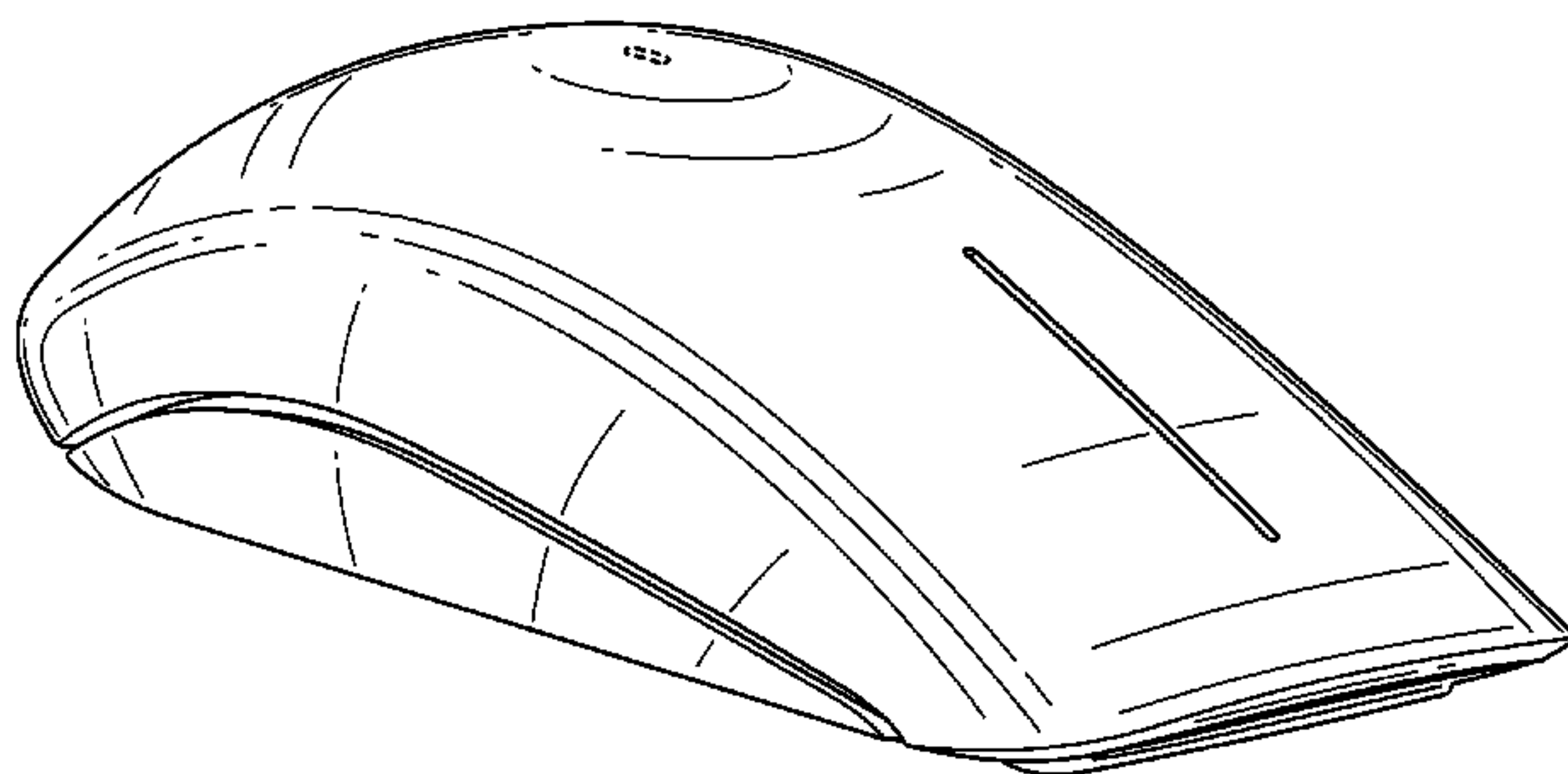
FIG. 12 is a front view thereof;

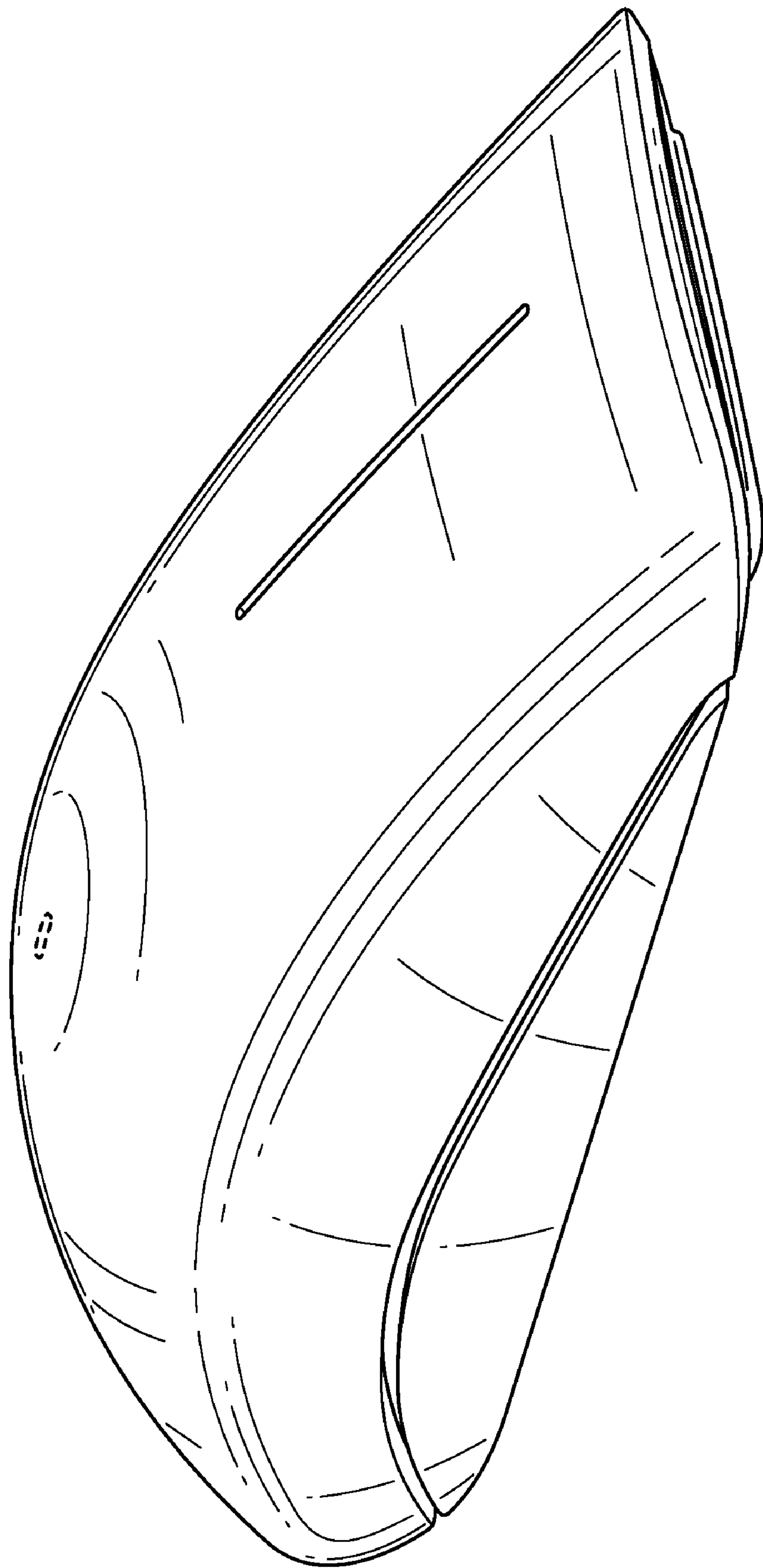

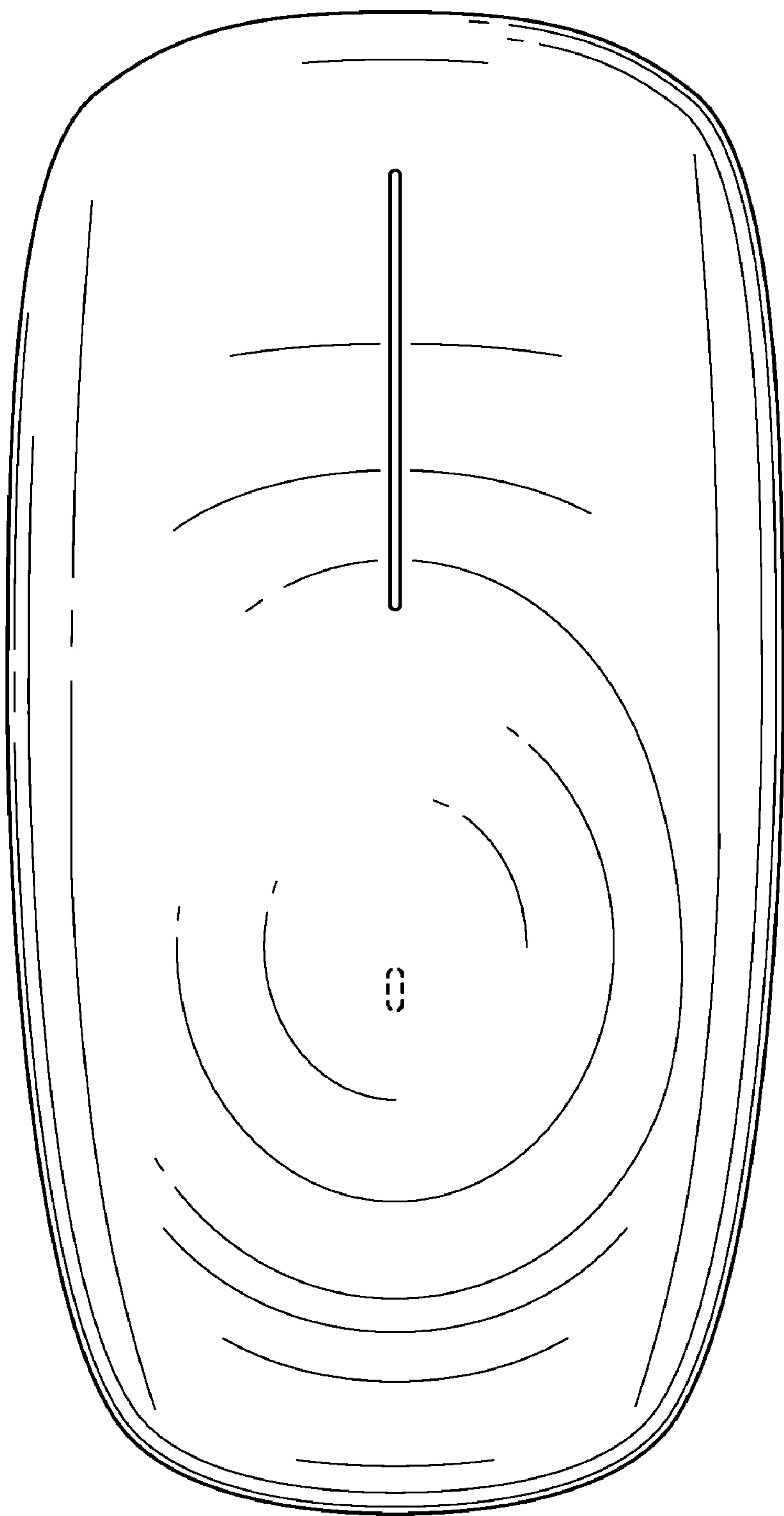

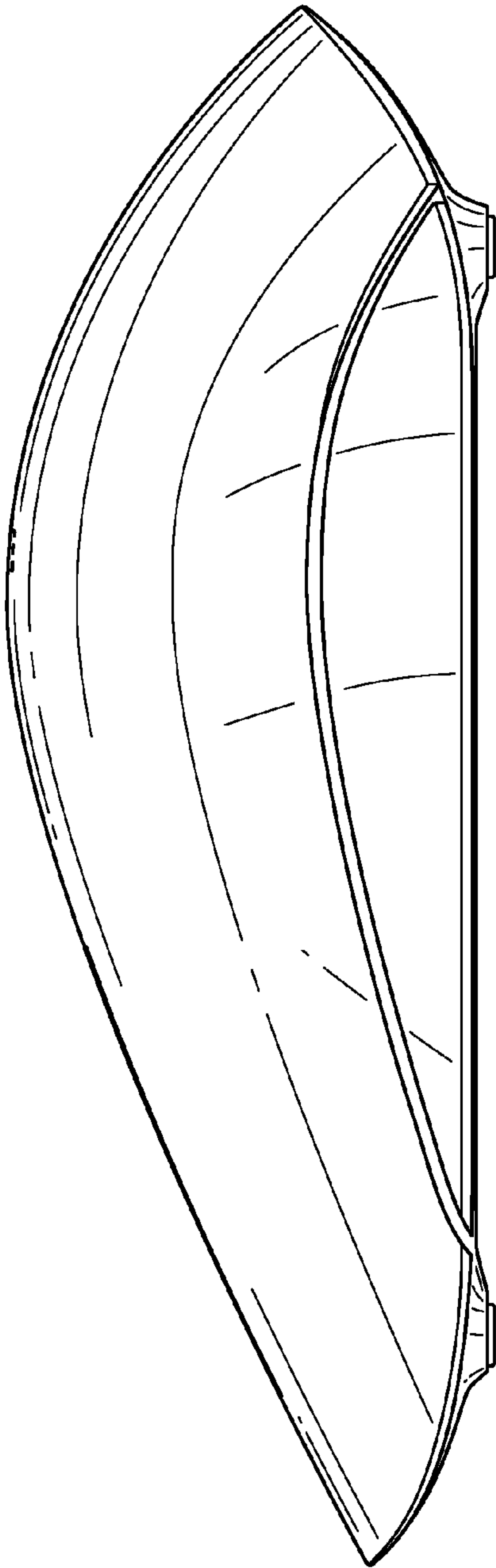

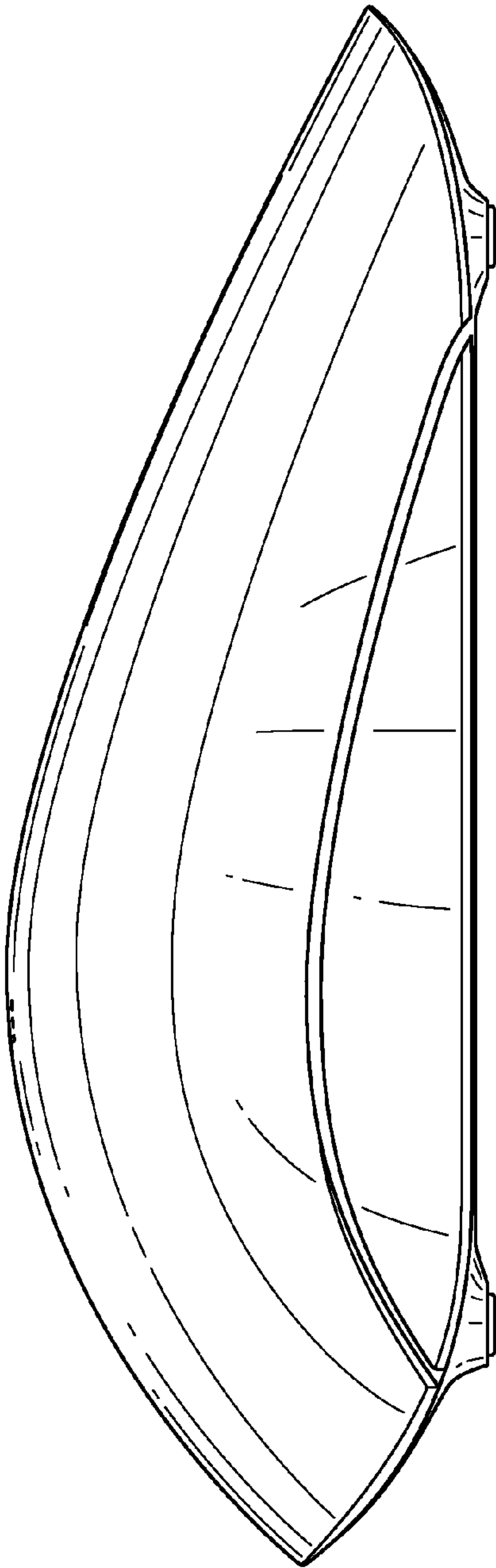

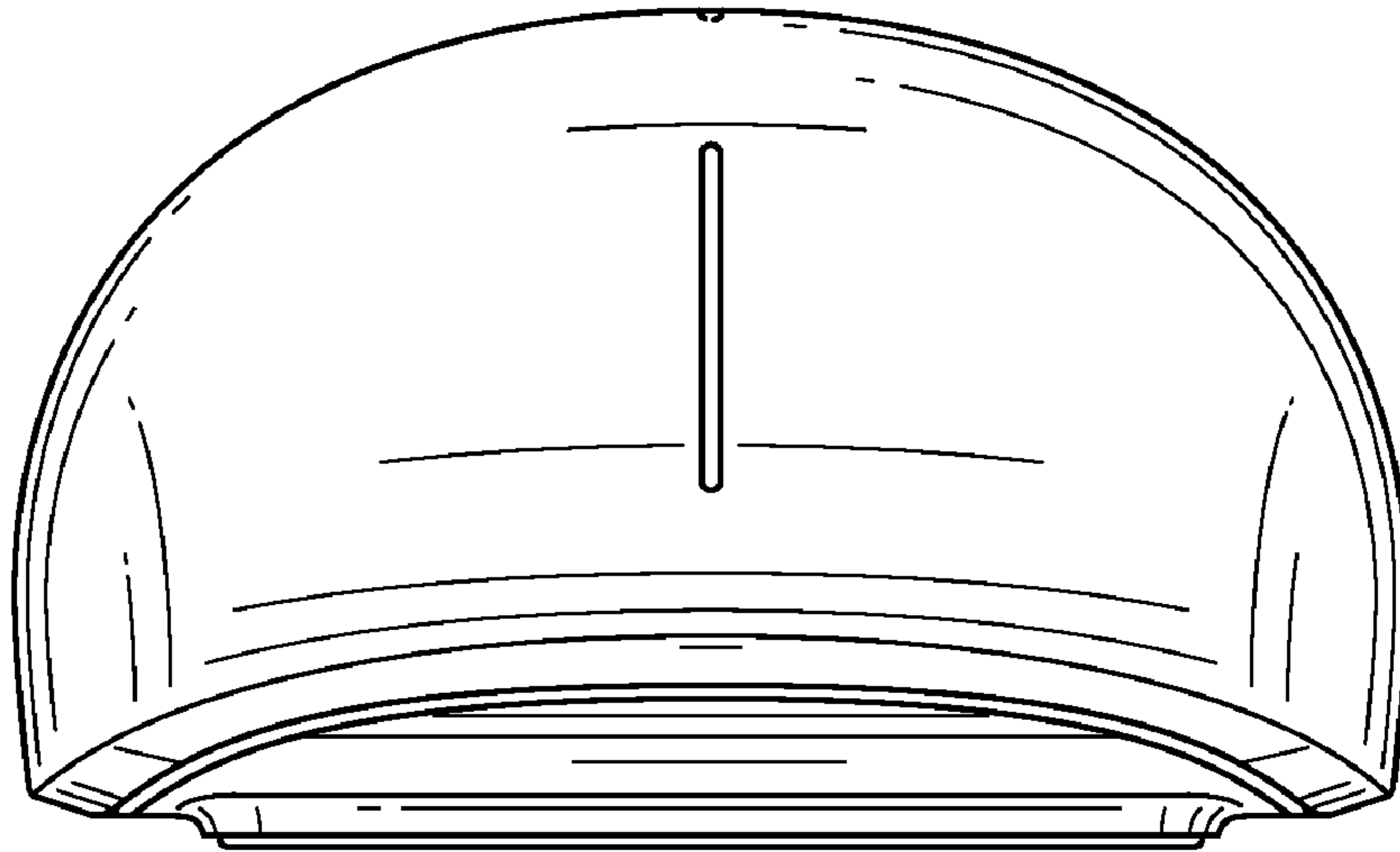

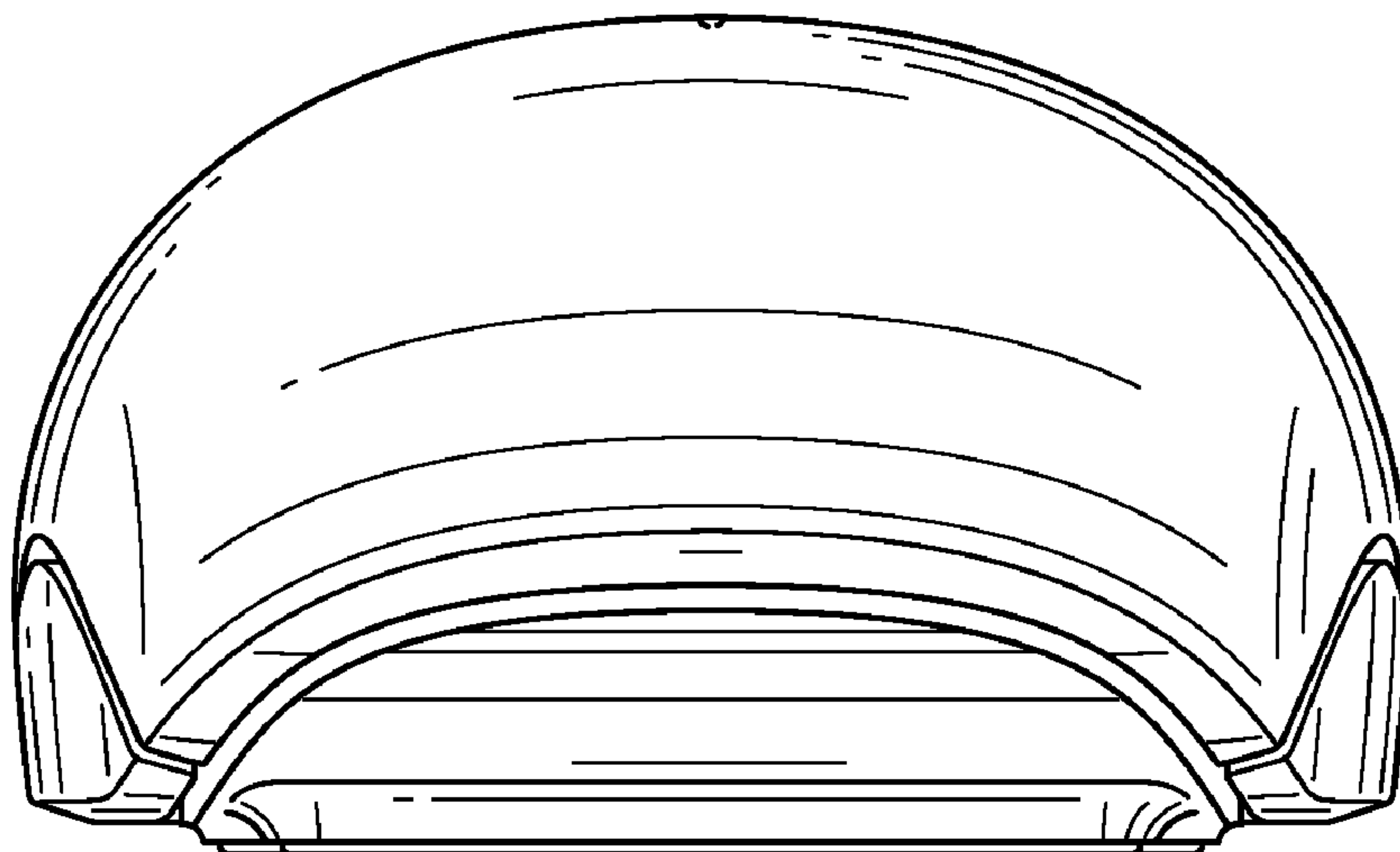

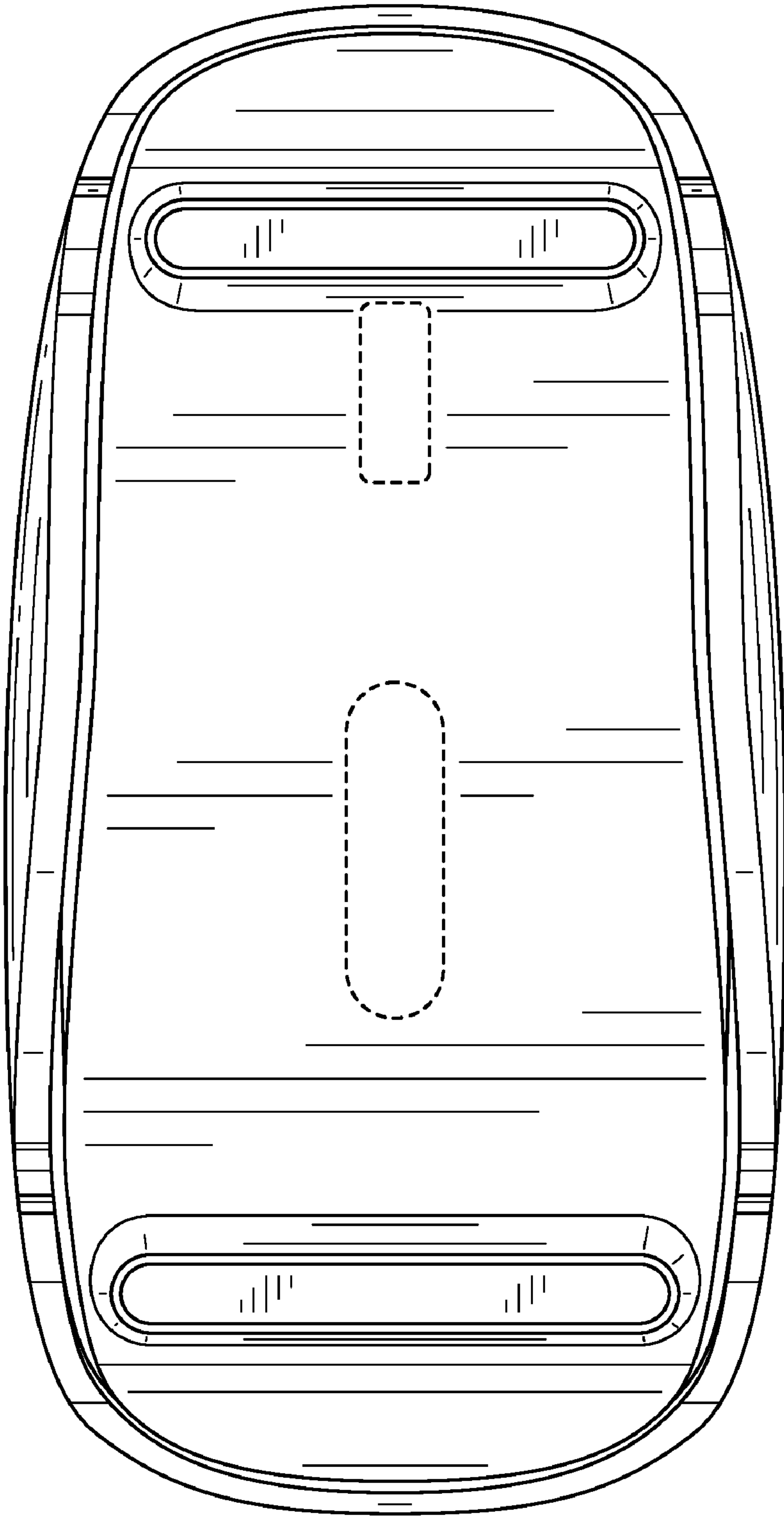

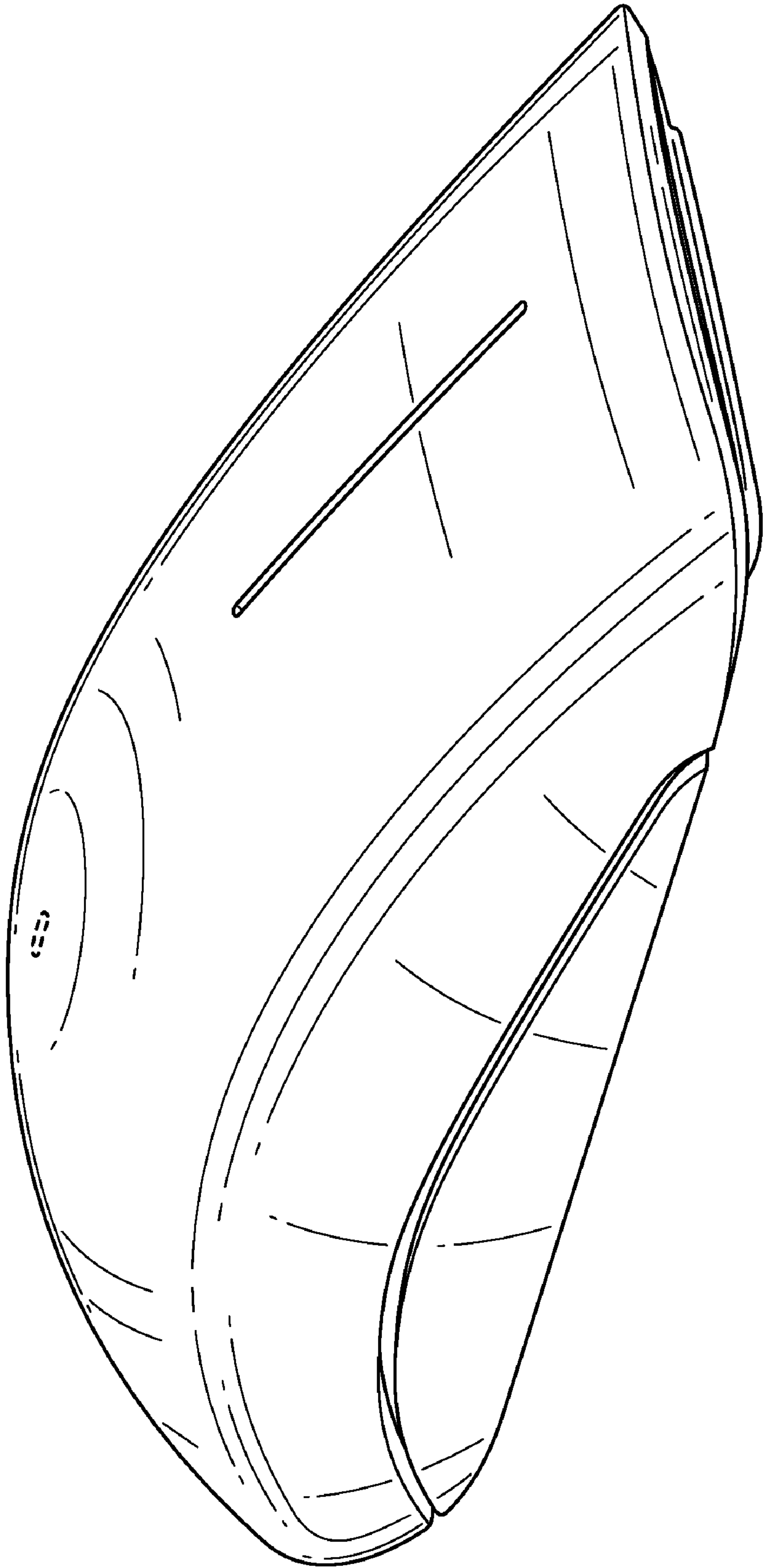

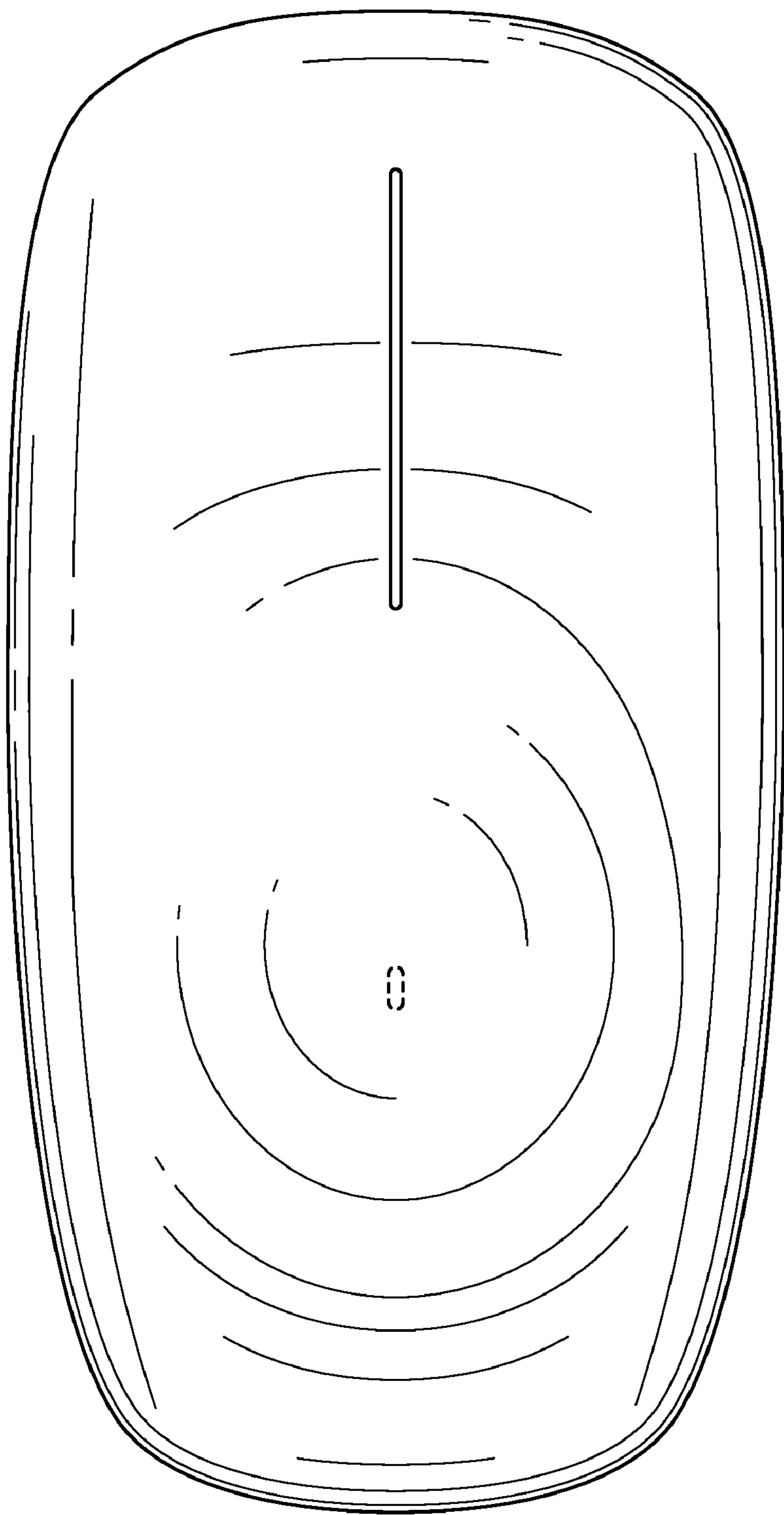

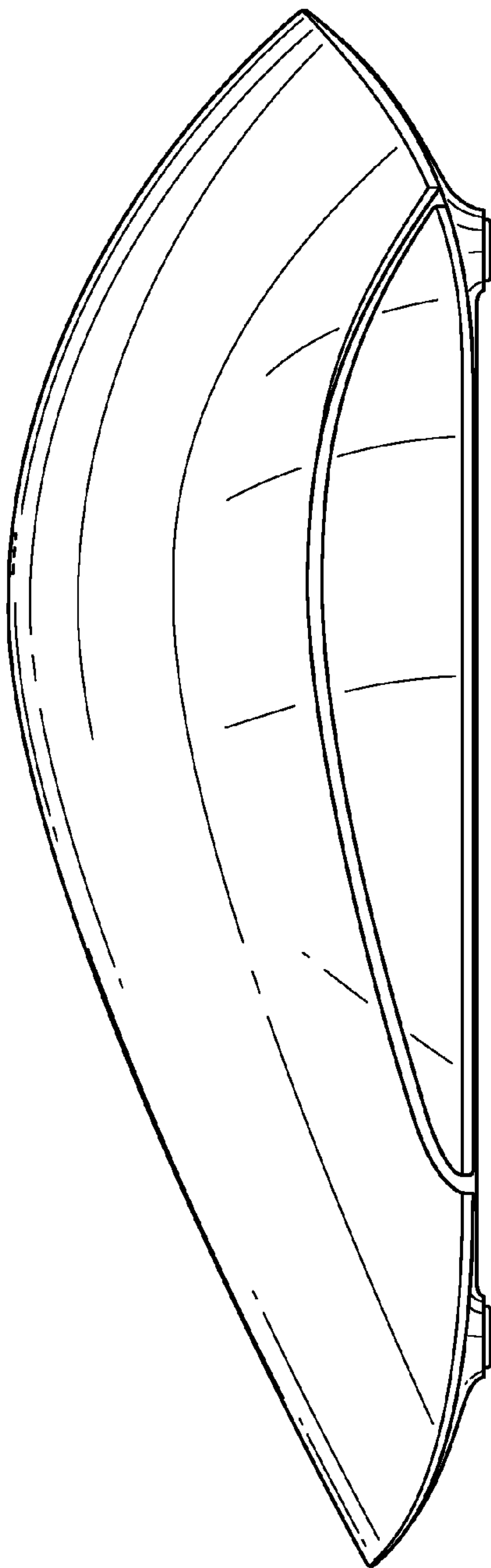

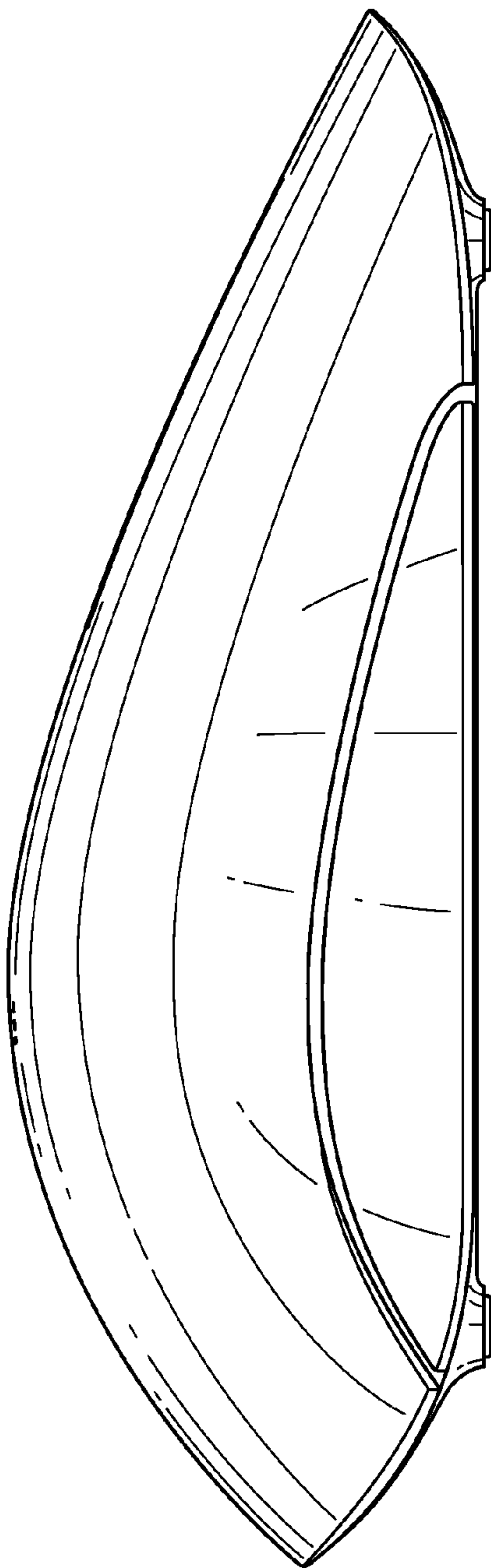

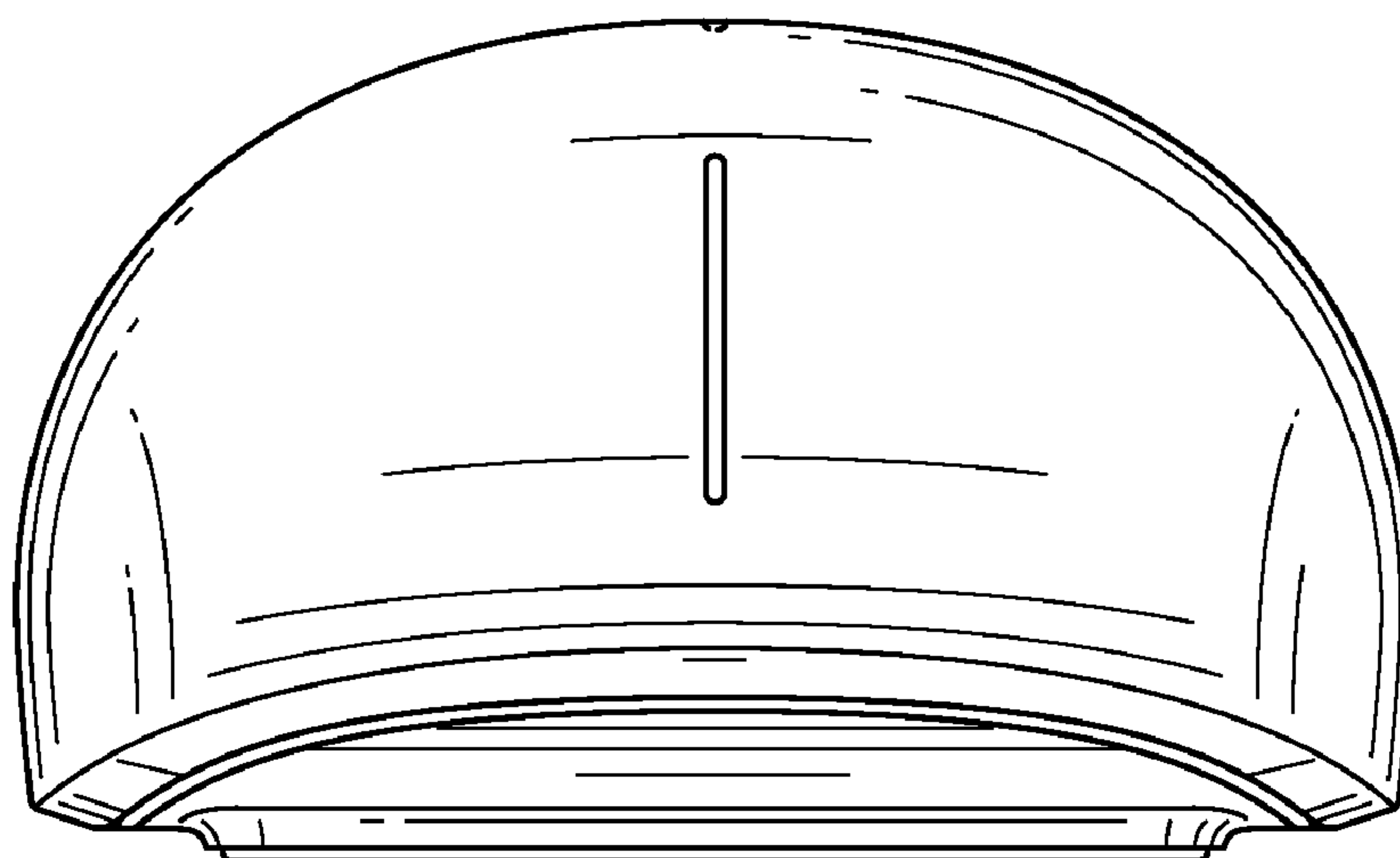

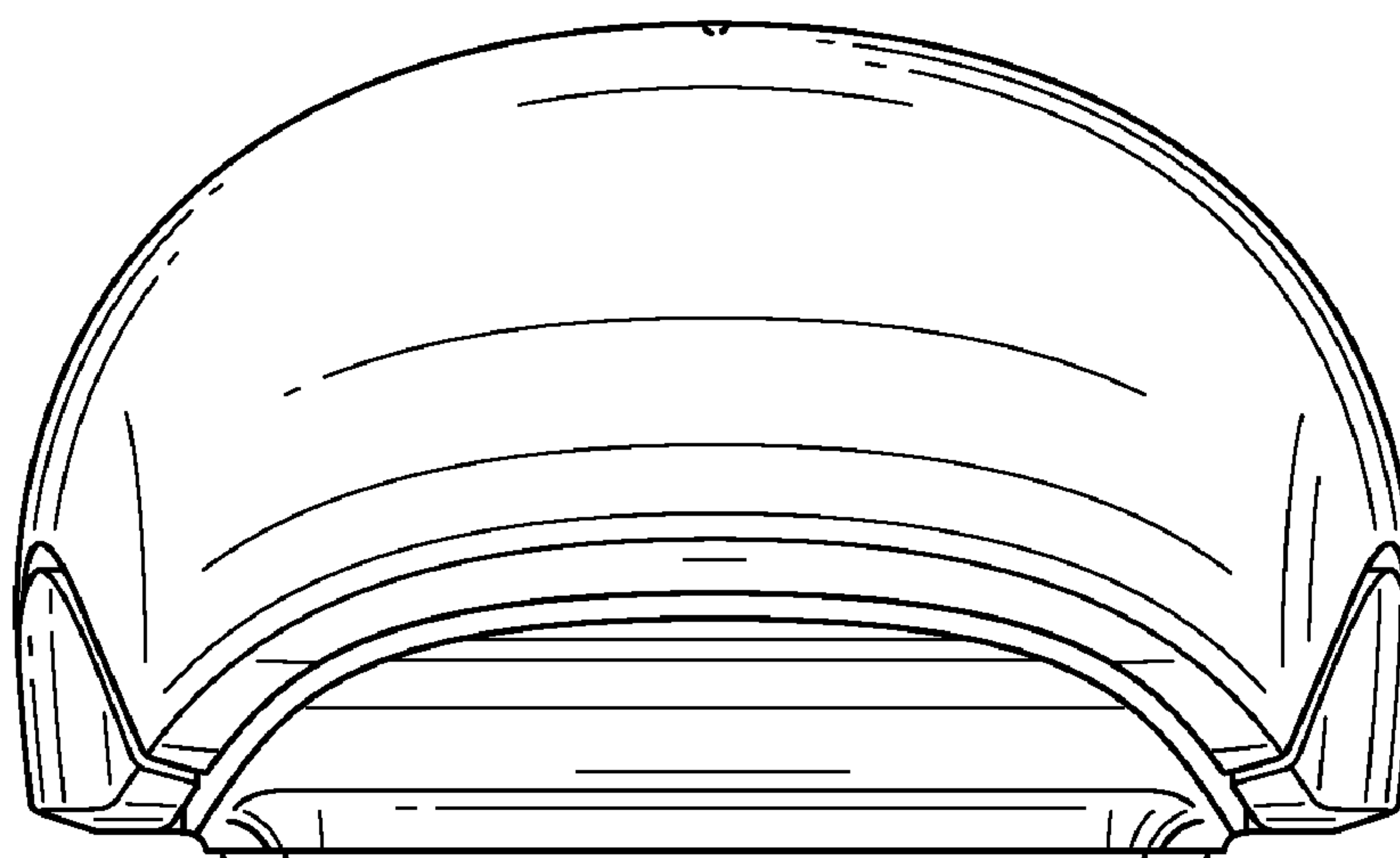

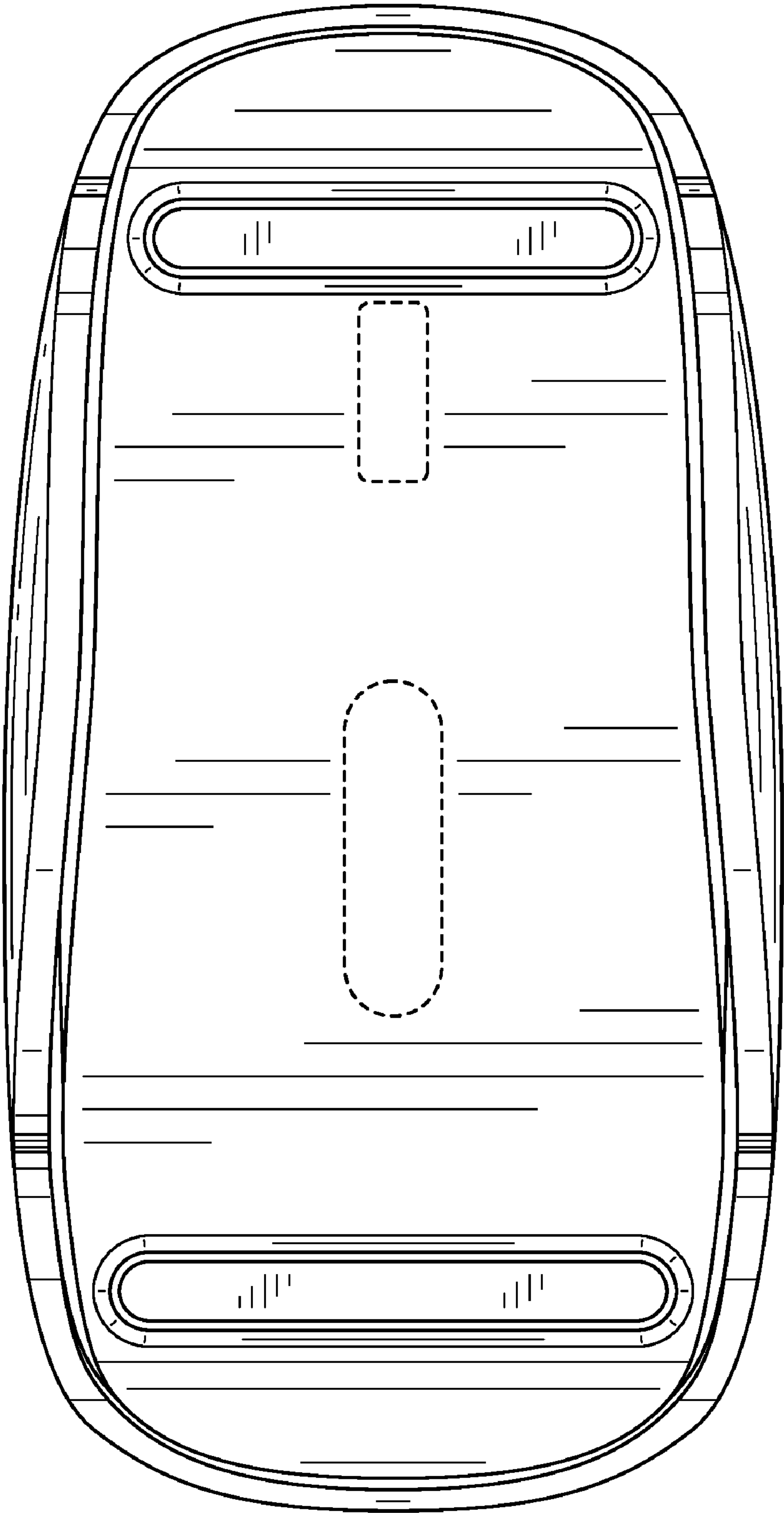
