FIG. 9 is a front view thereof in a straight configuration;

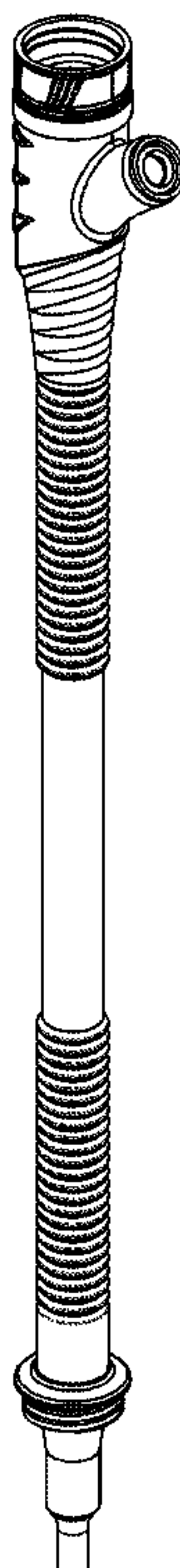
FIG. 10 is a front view thereof in a looped configuration;

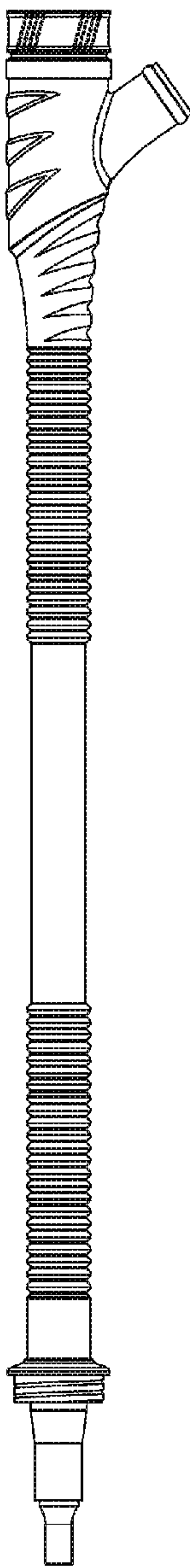

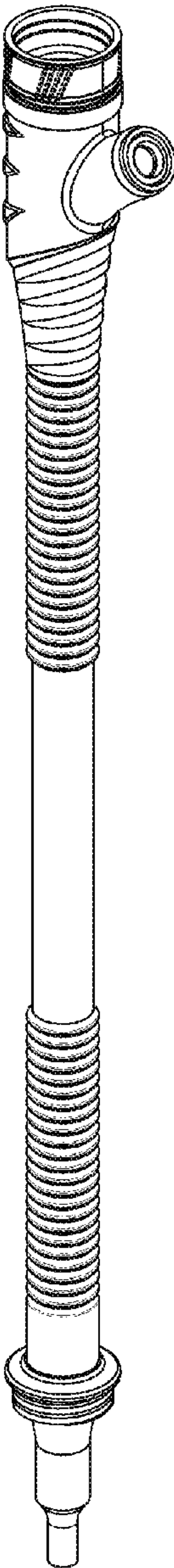

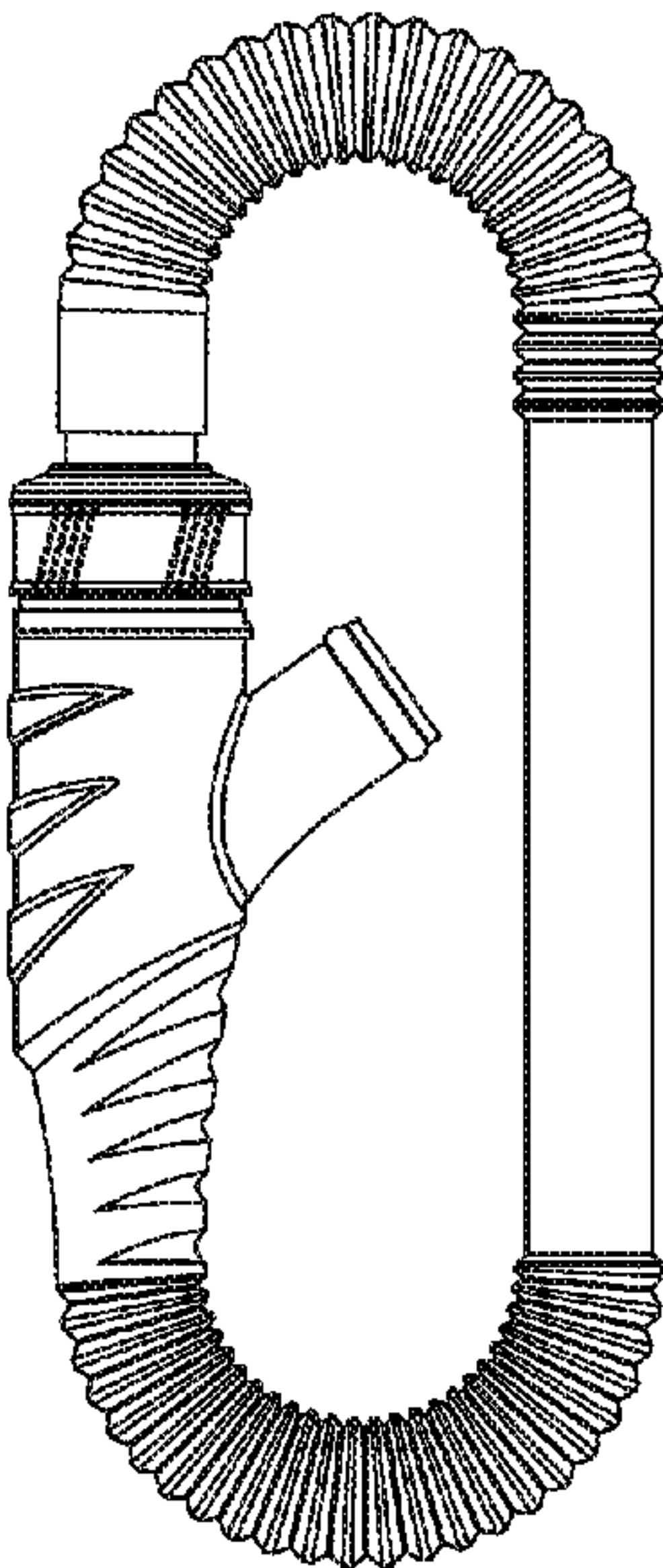

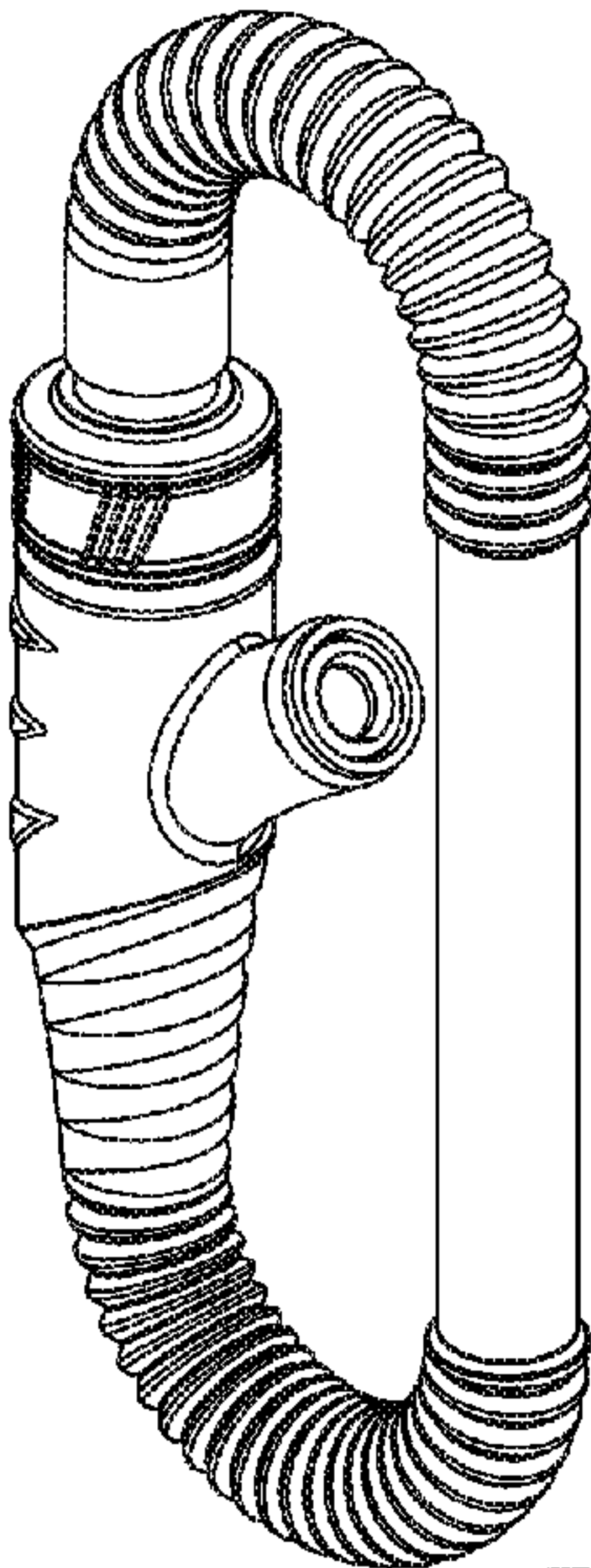

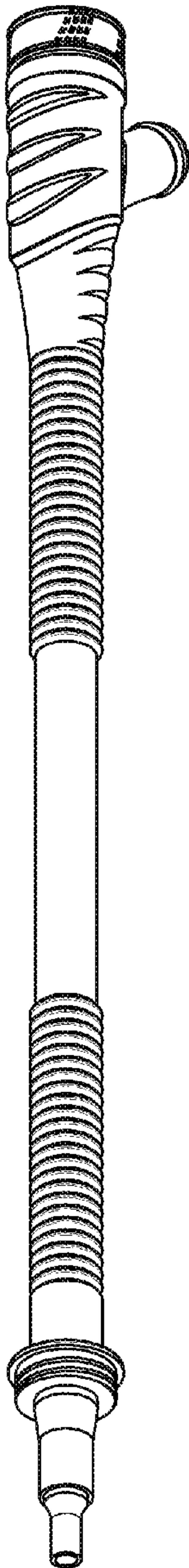

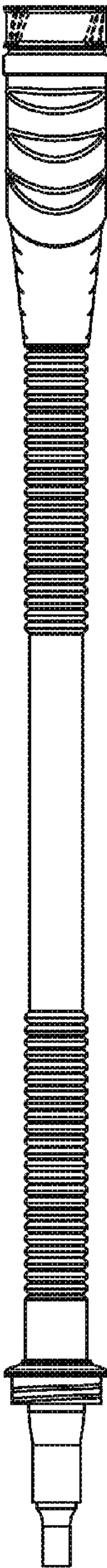

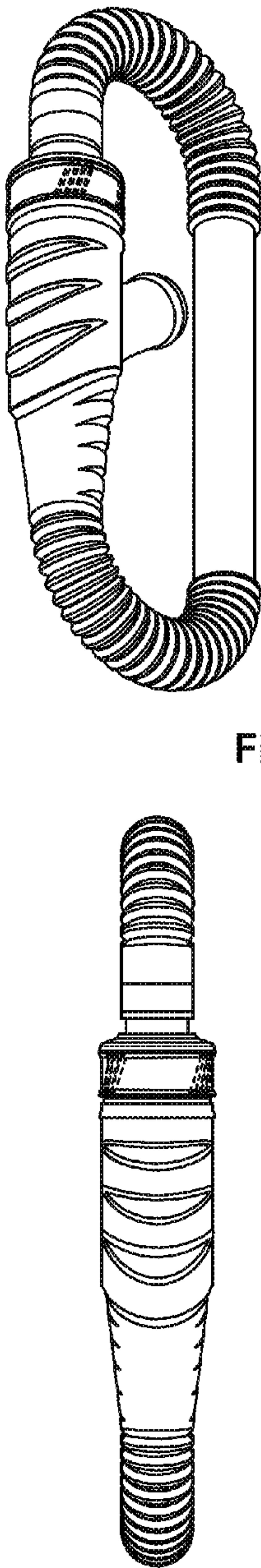

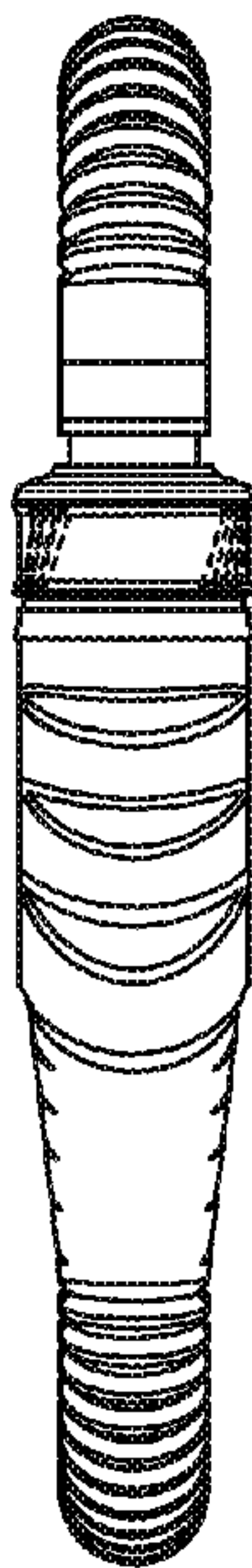

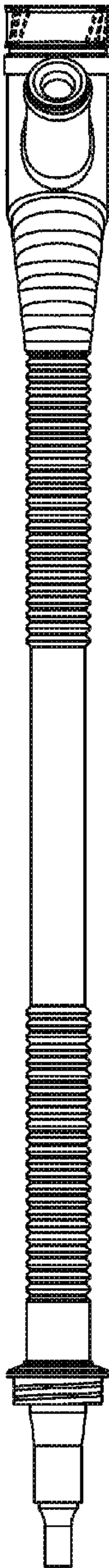

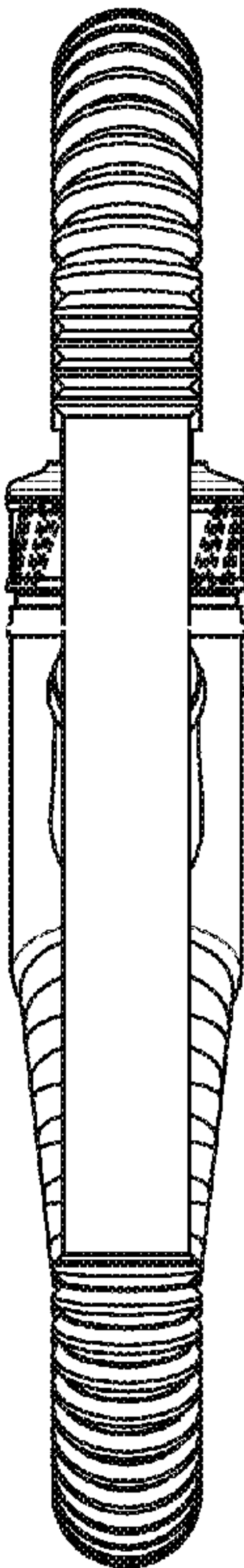

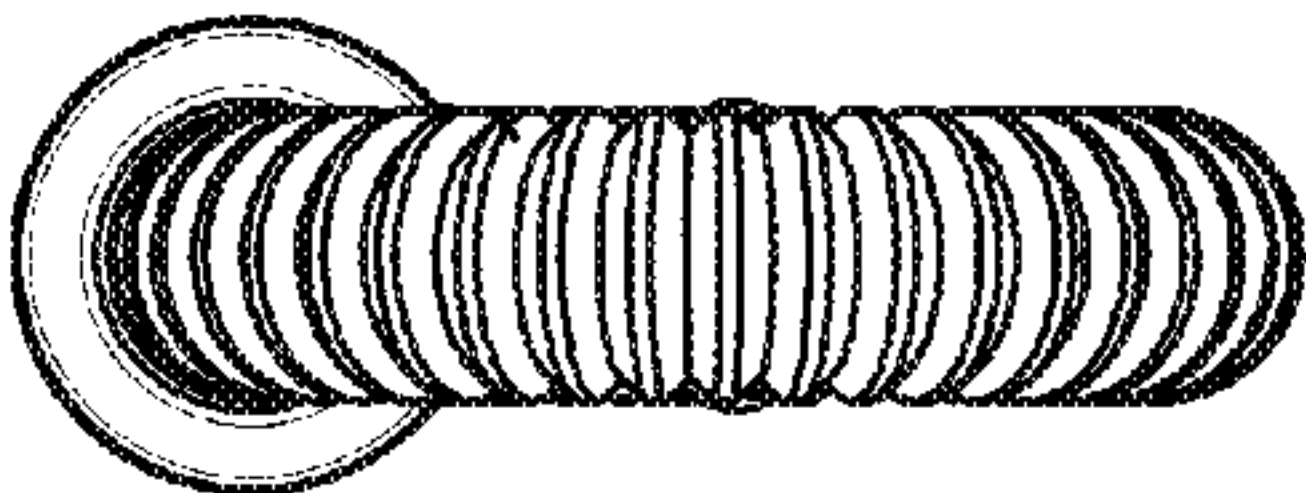

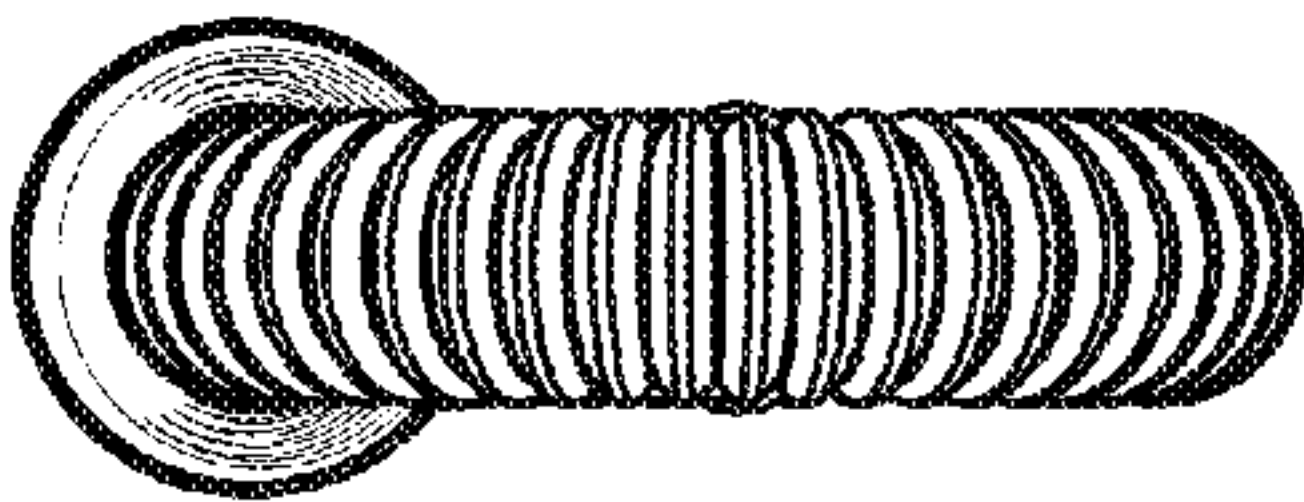
