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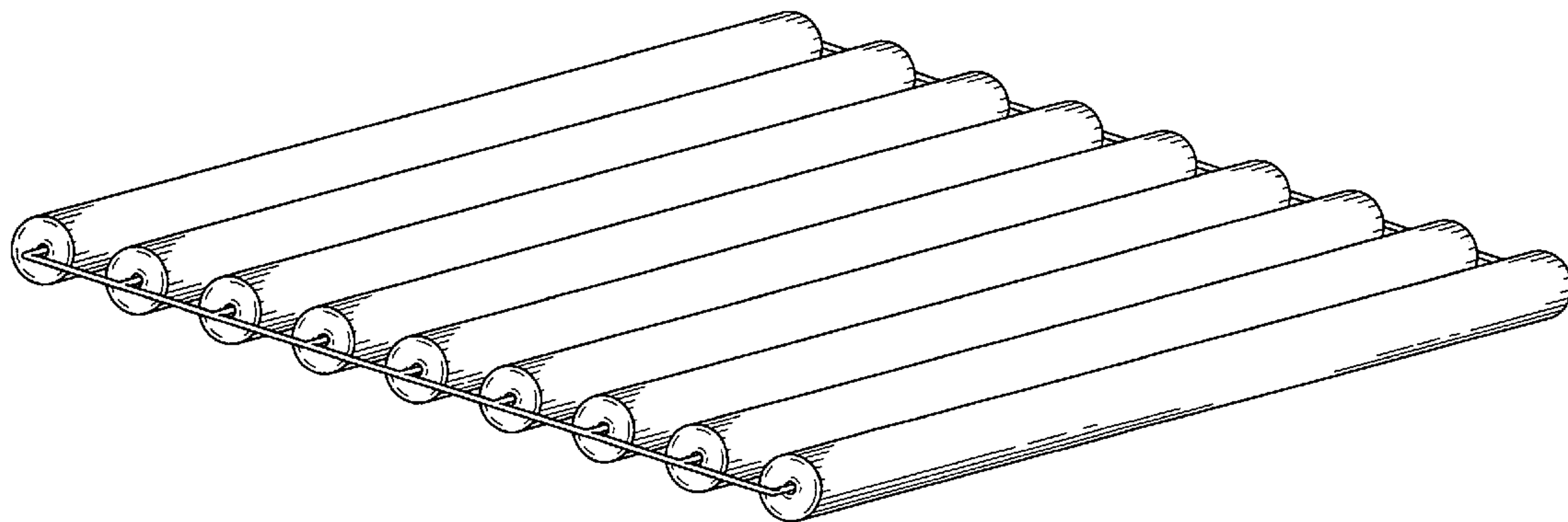
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the massage device; FIG. 2 is a front view of the massage device, the rear view being a mirror image of the front view of the massage device; FIG. 3 is a right side view of the massage device, the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view of the massage device; and, FIG. 4 is a top view of the massage device, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view of the massage device.

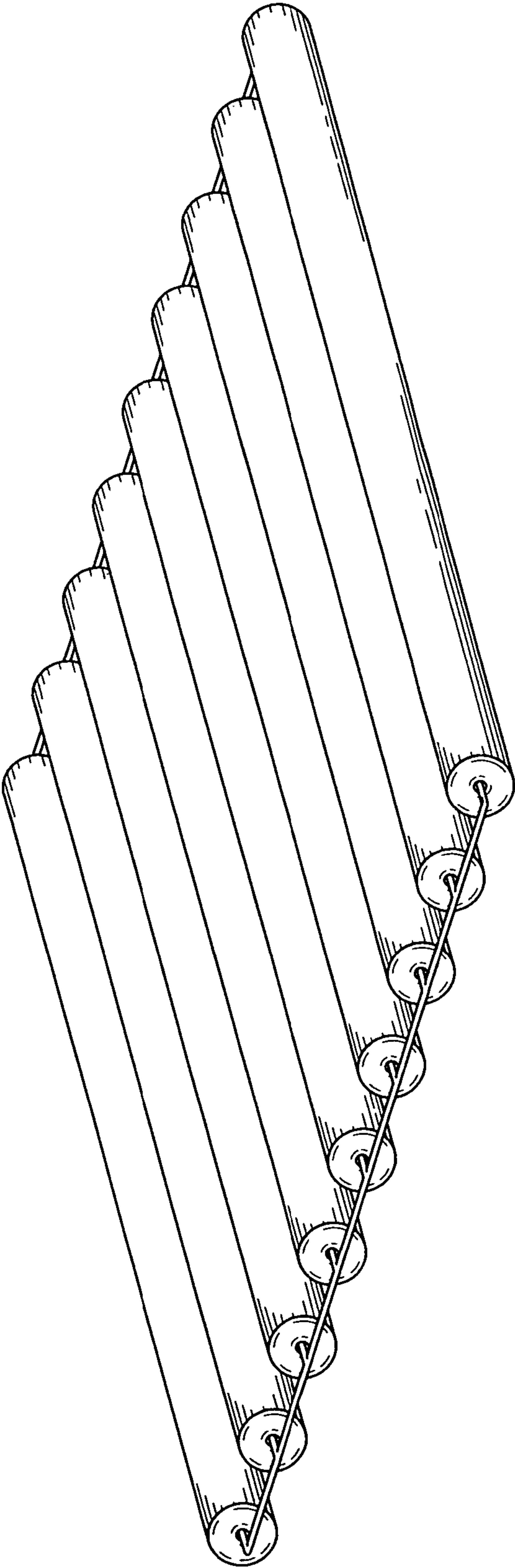

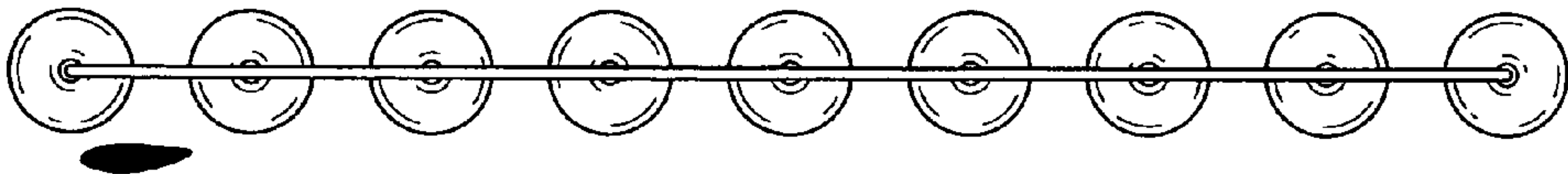

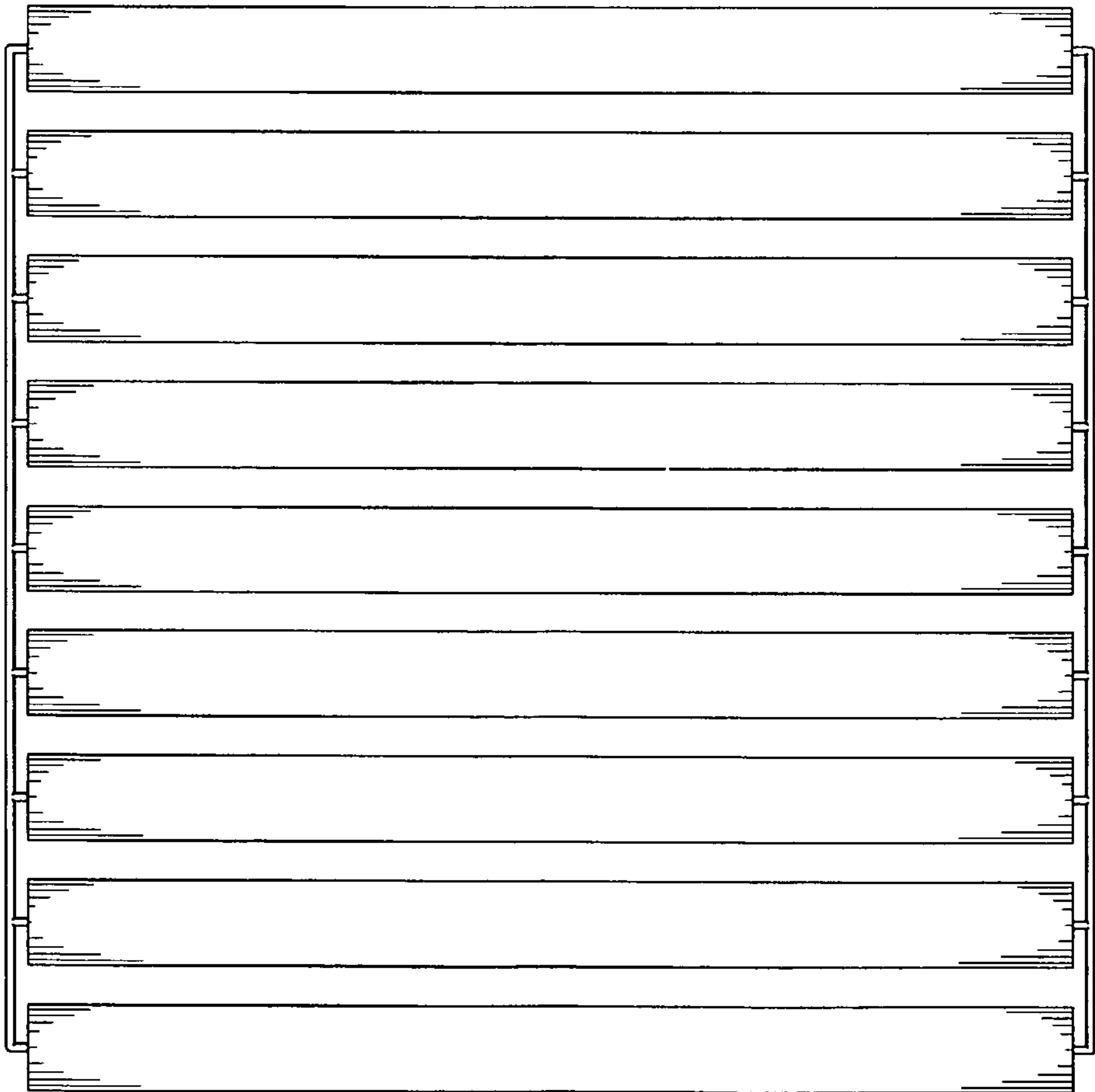
