FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

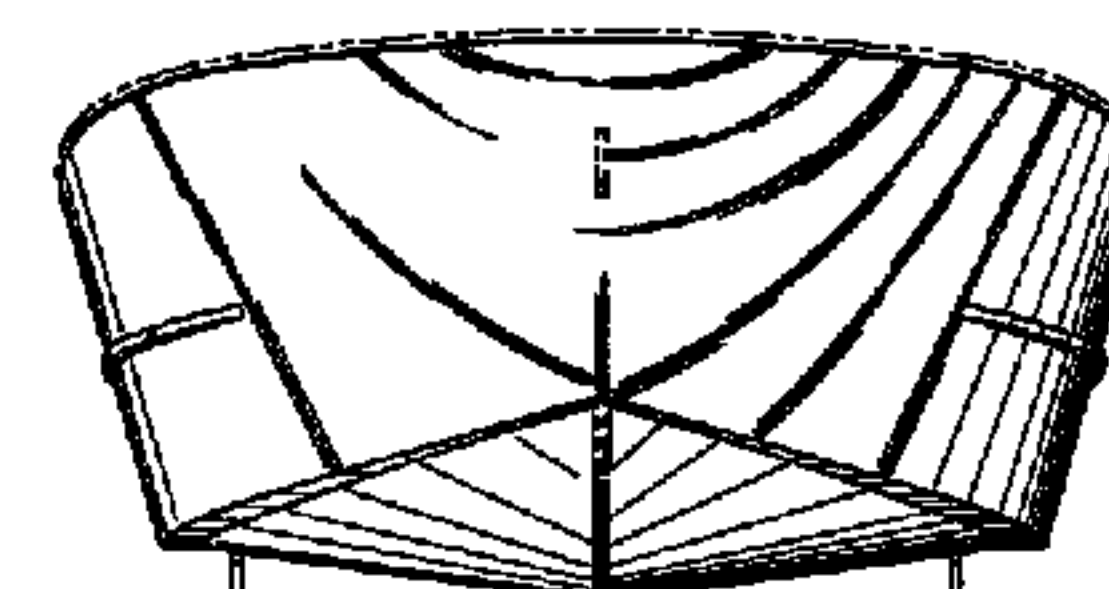
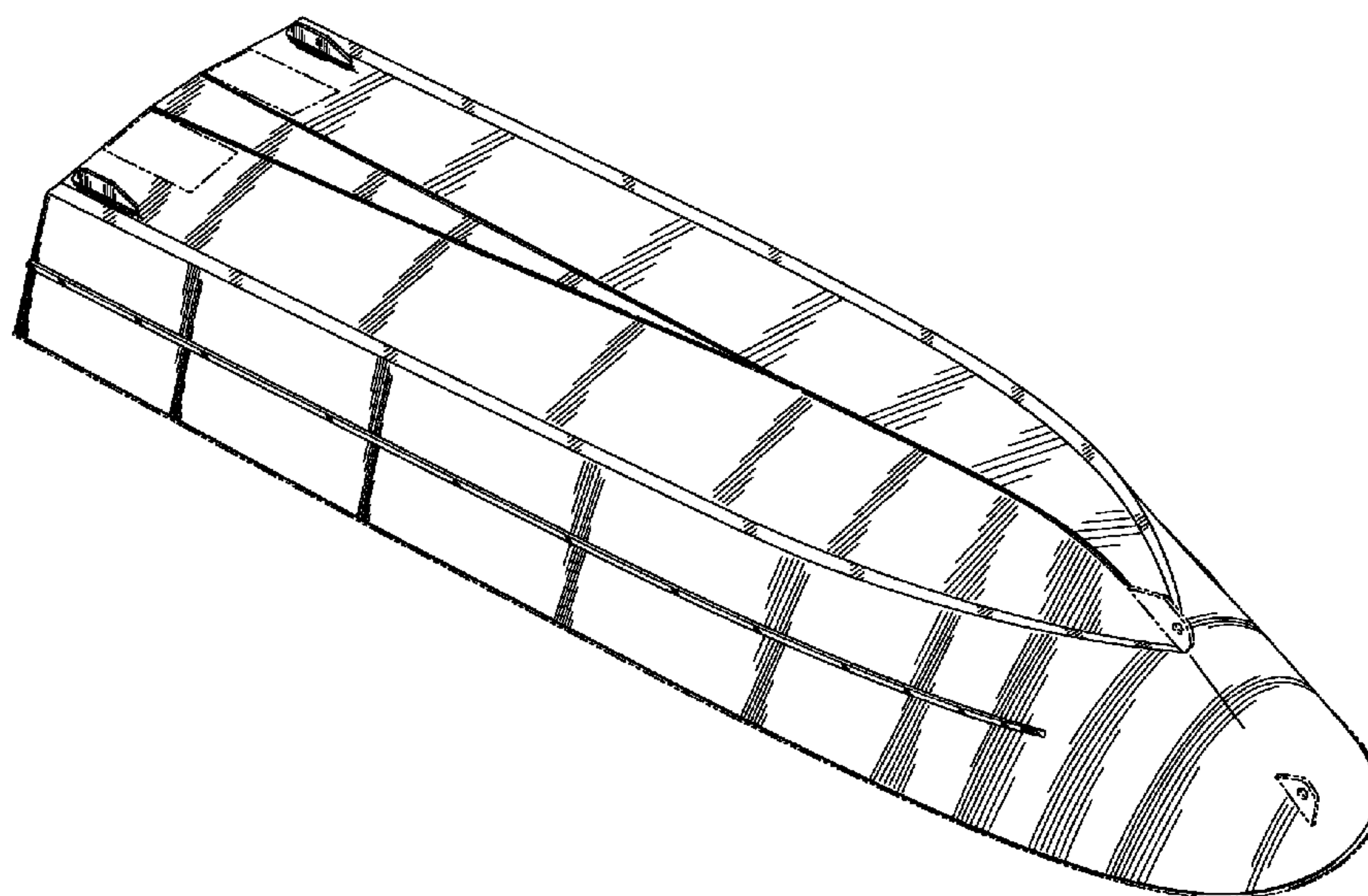
FIG. 4 is a top view of the outline of the outer upper edge in phantom lines;

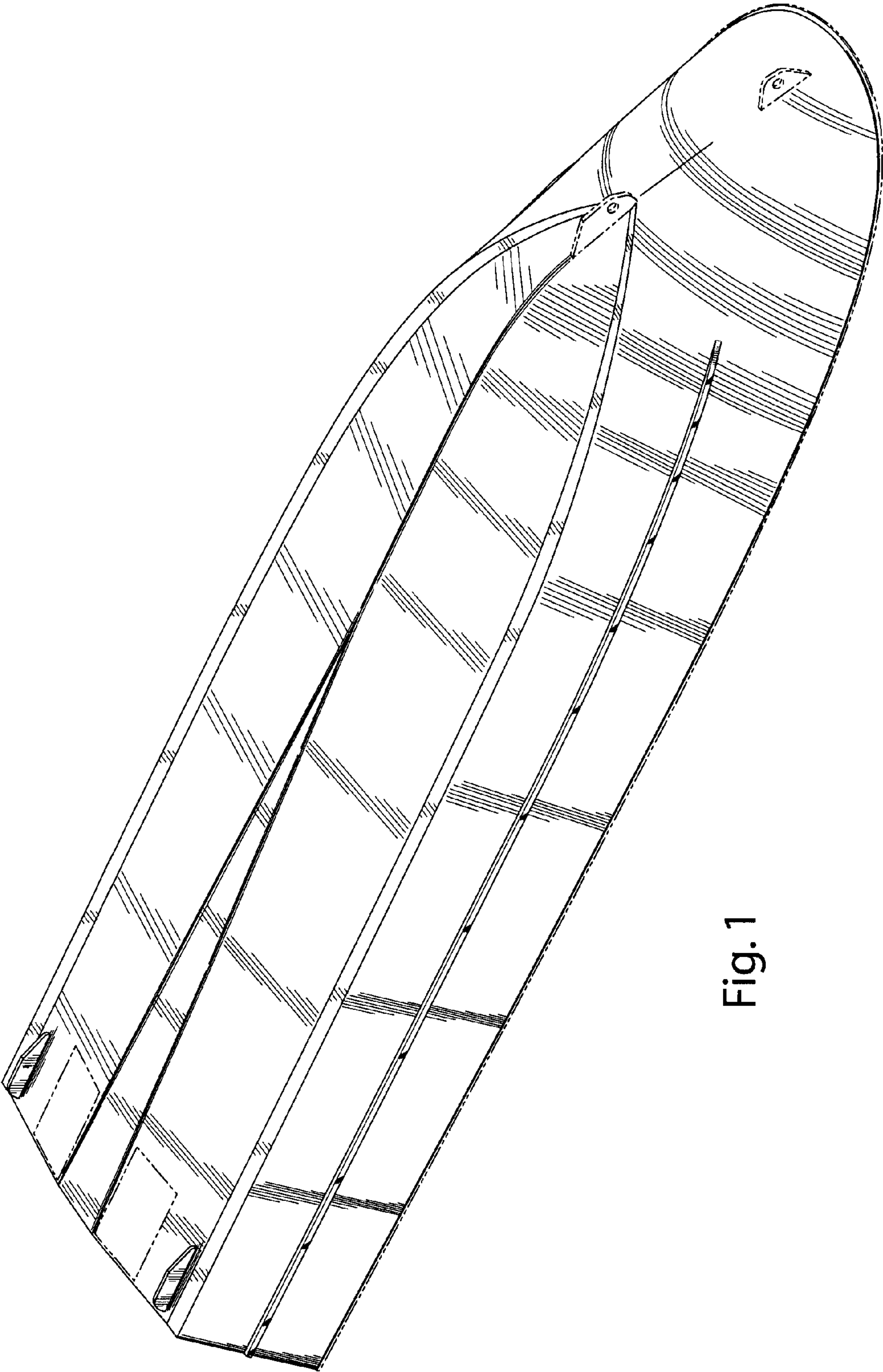

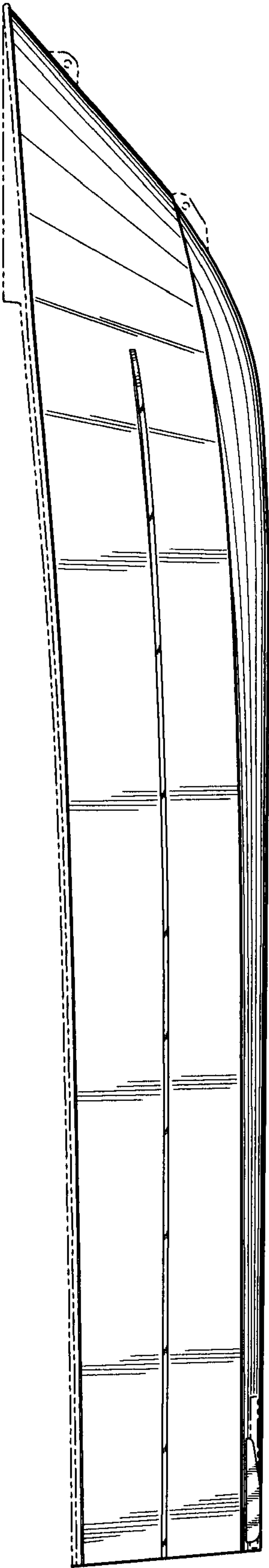

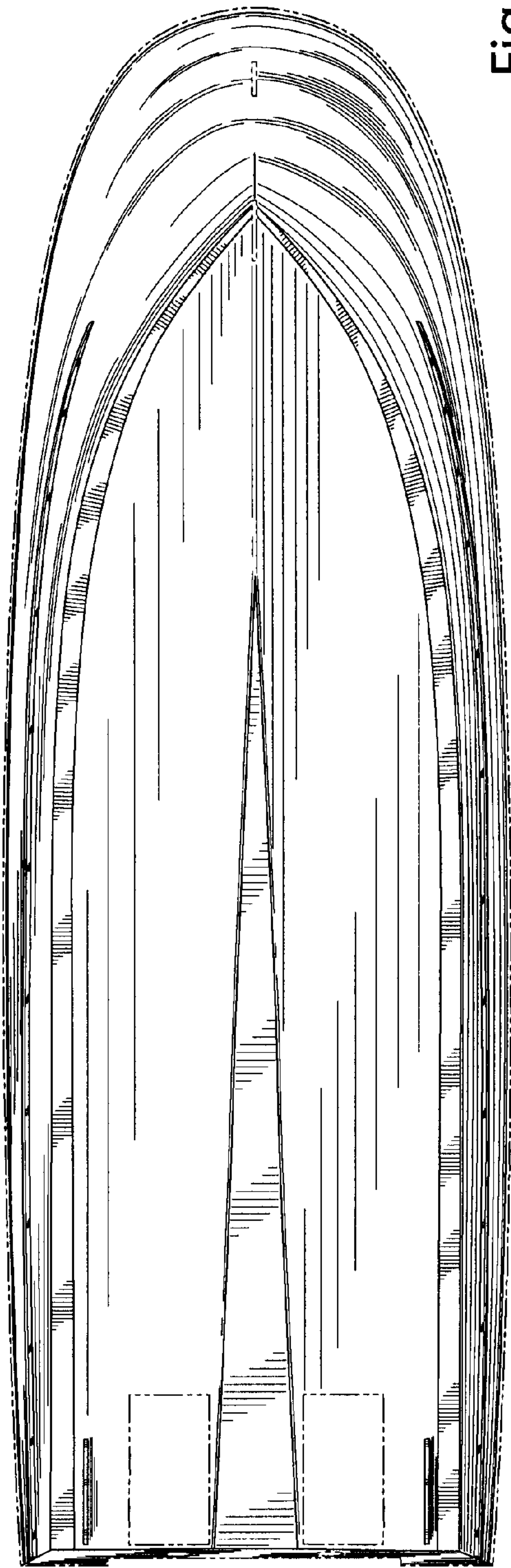

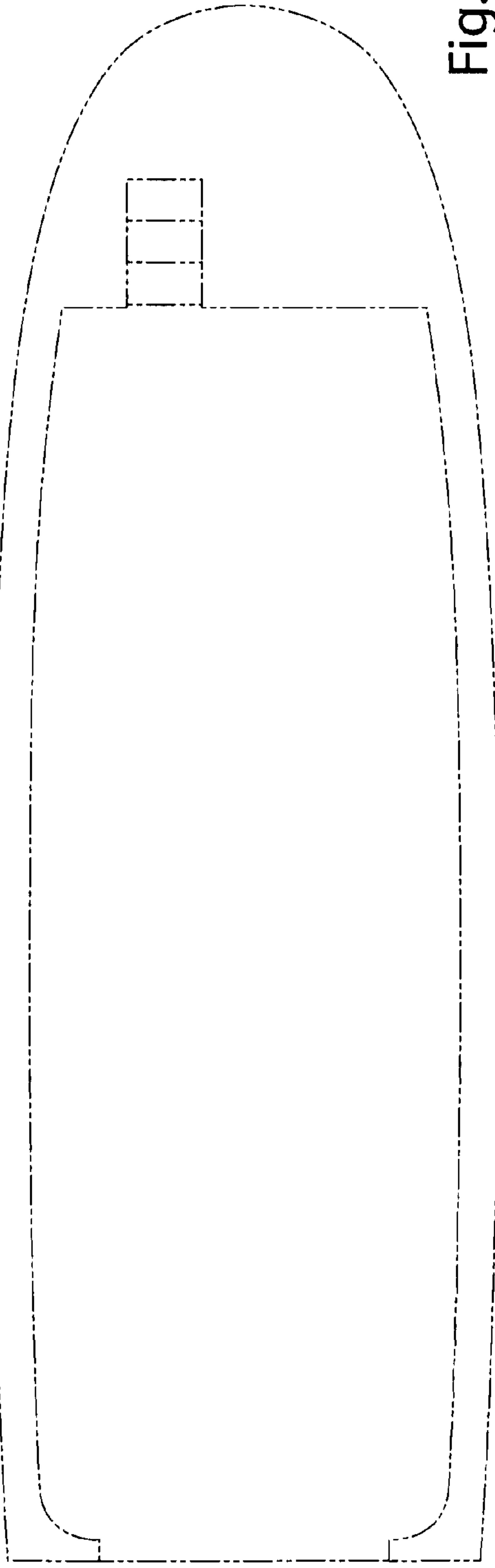

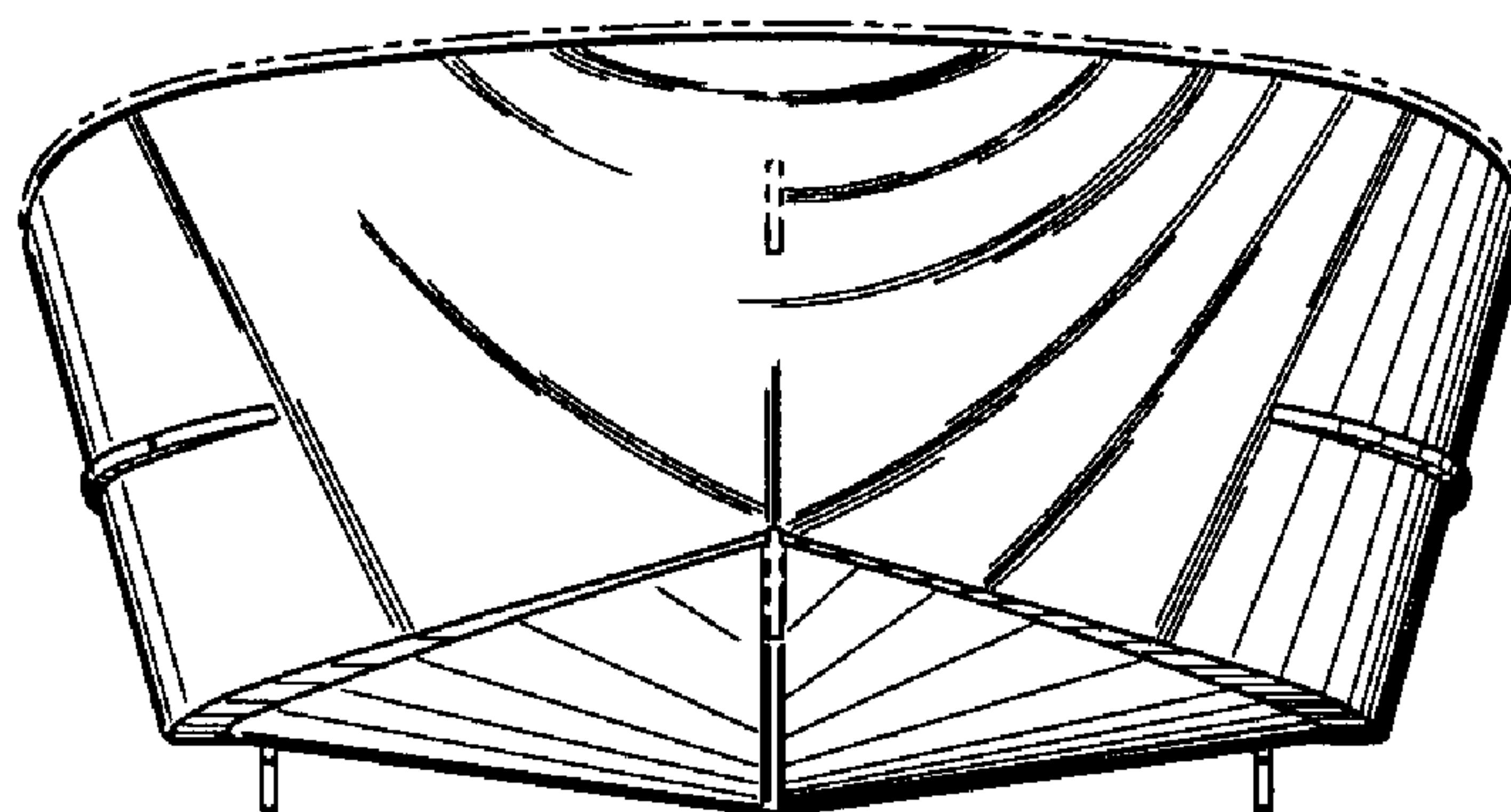

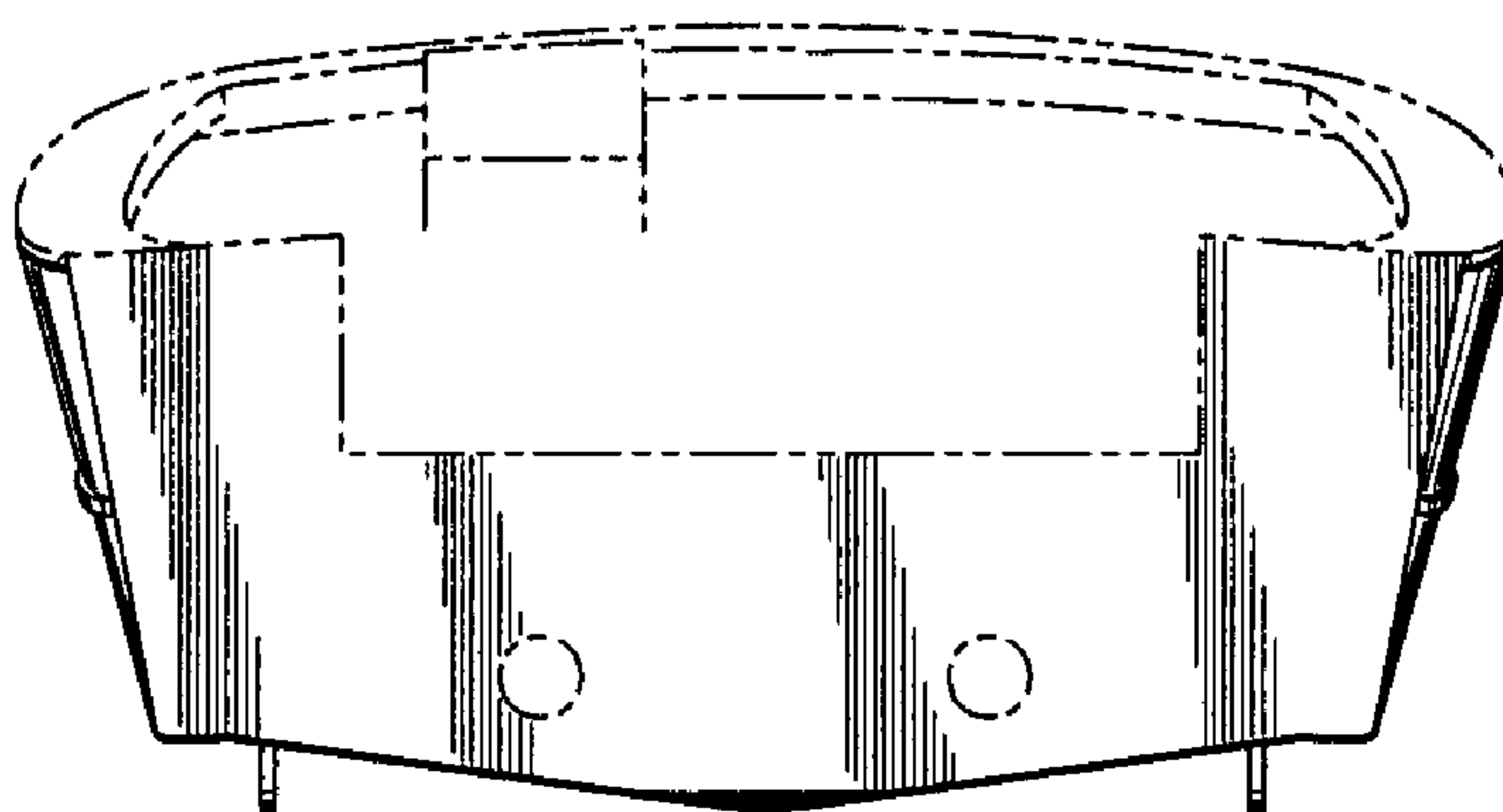
