FIG. 4 is a front side elevation view of the post guard portion of FIG. 1;

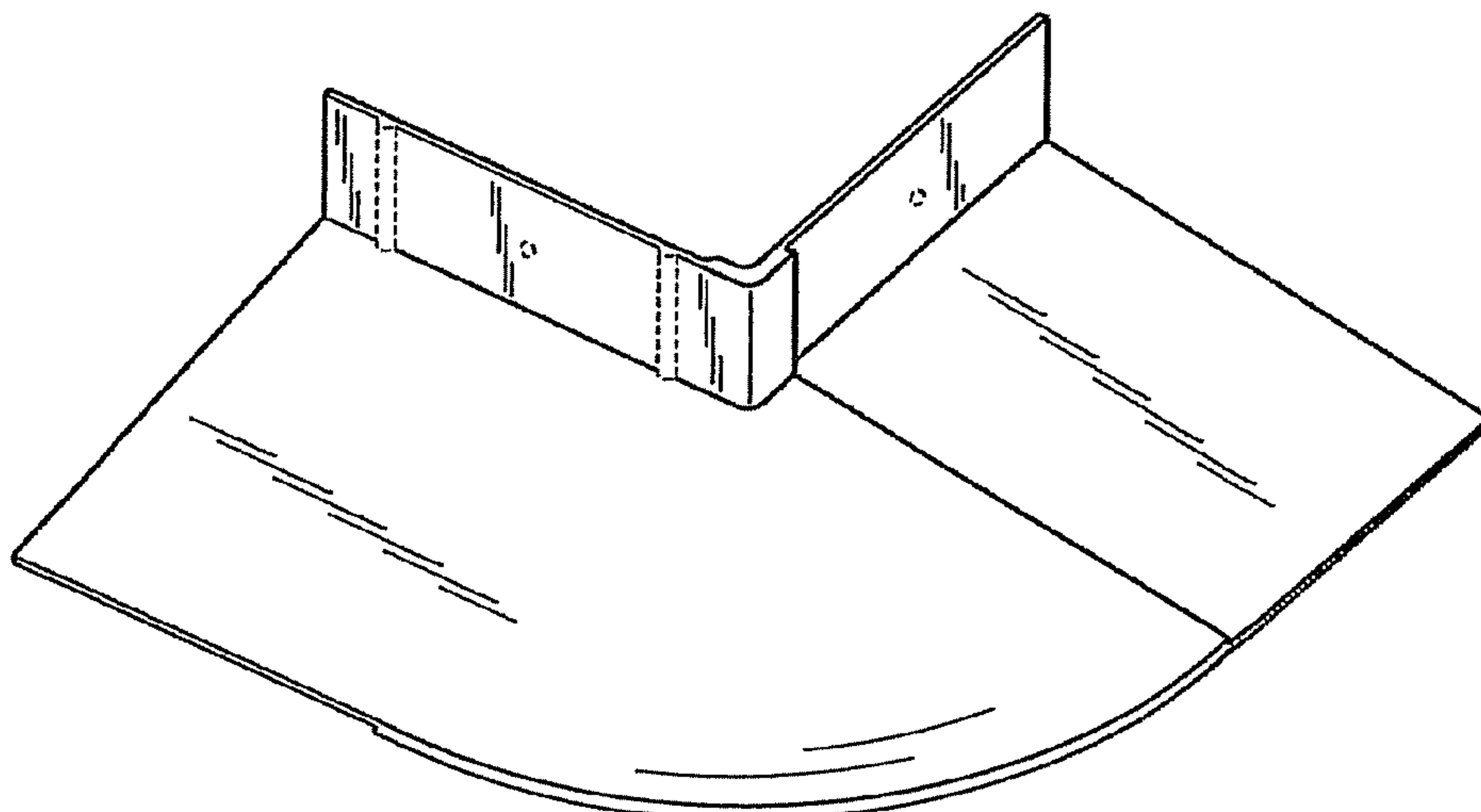
FIG. 5 is a rear side elevation view of the post guard portion of FIG. 1;

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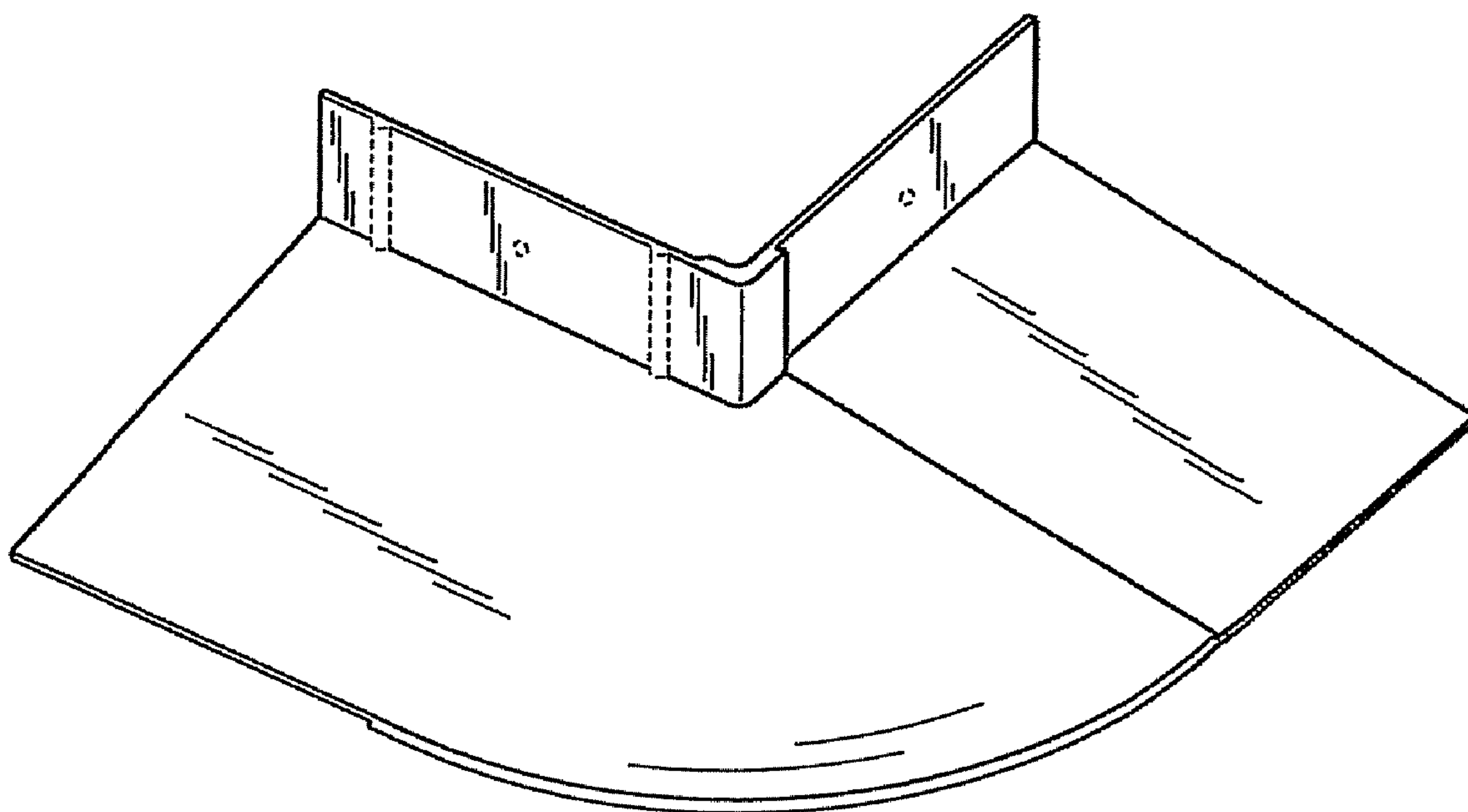

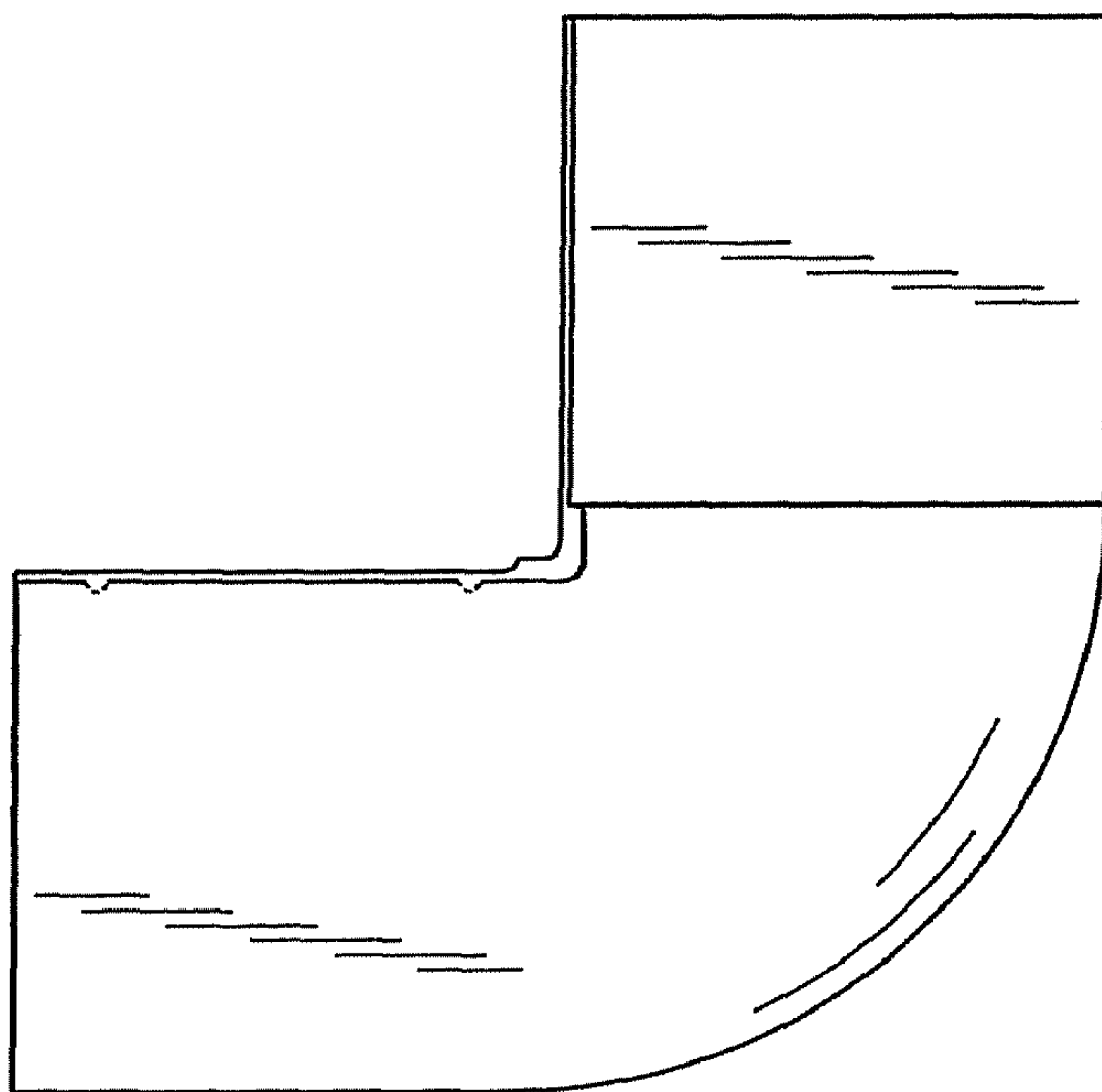

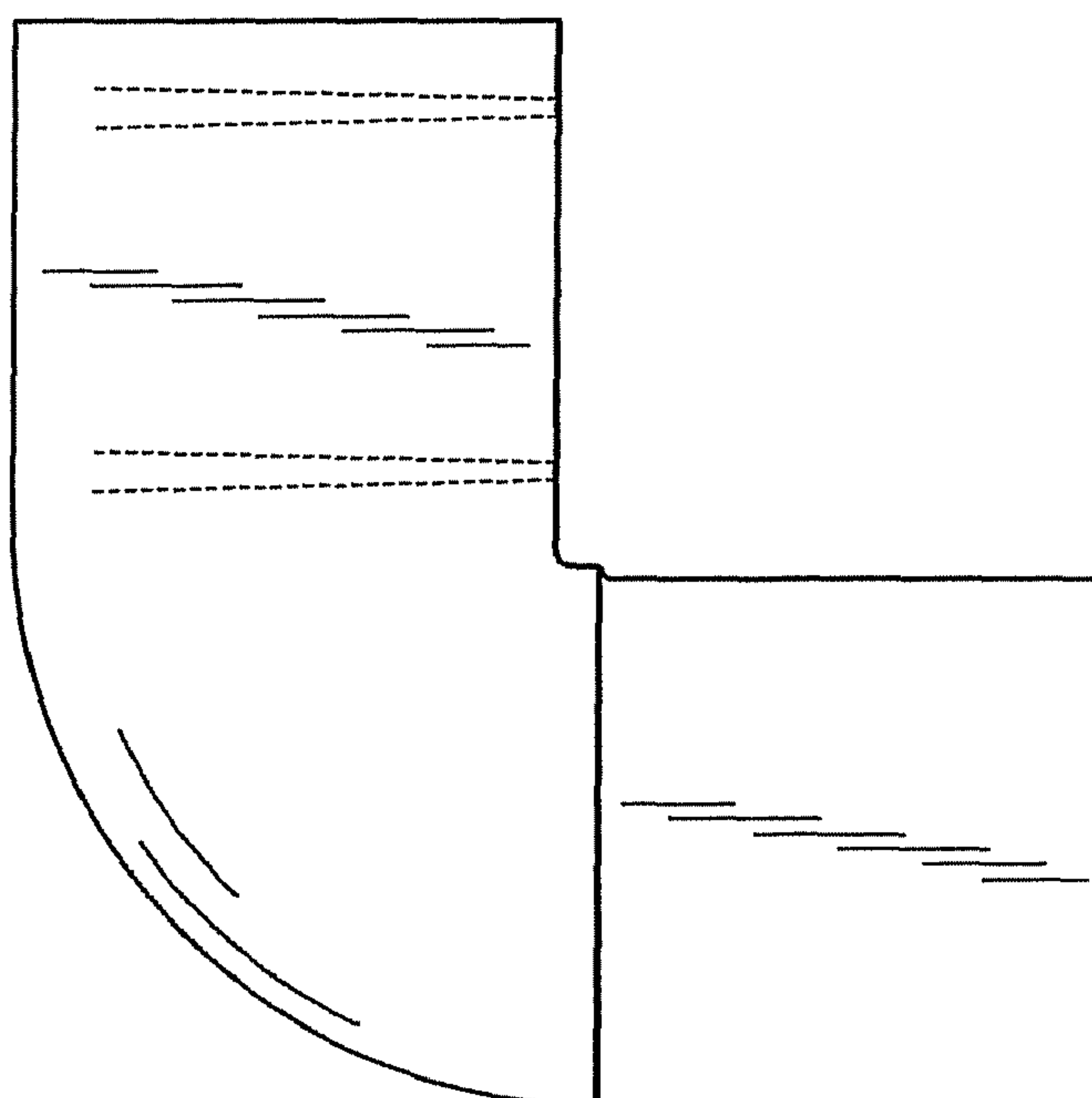

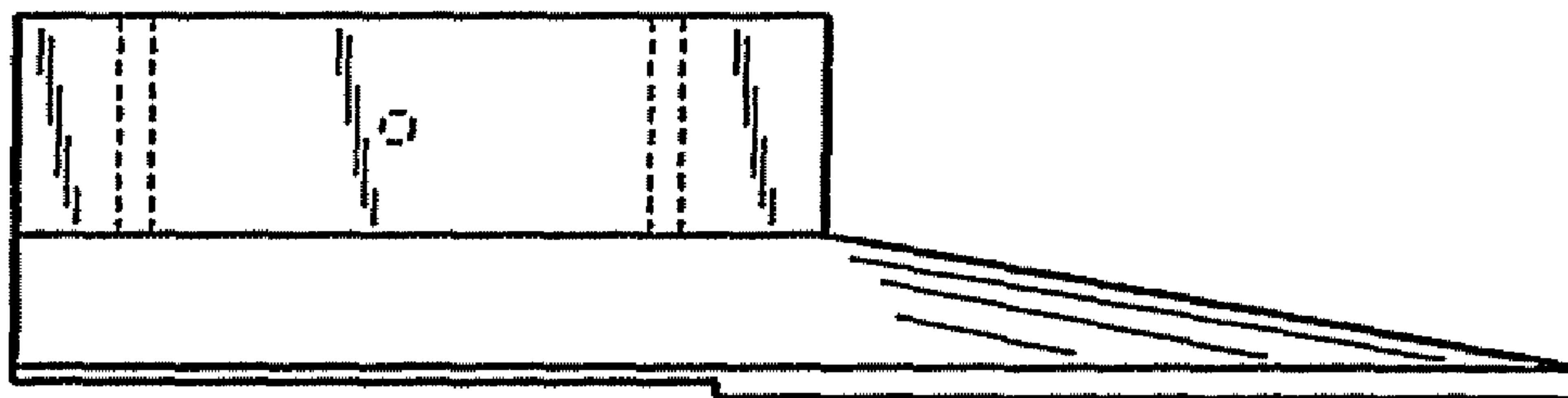

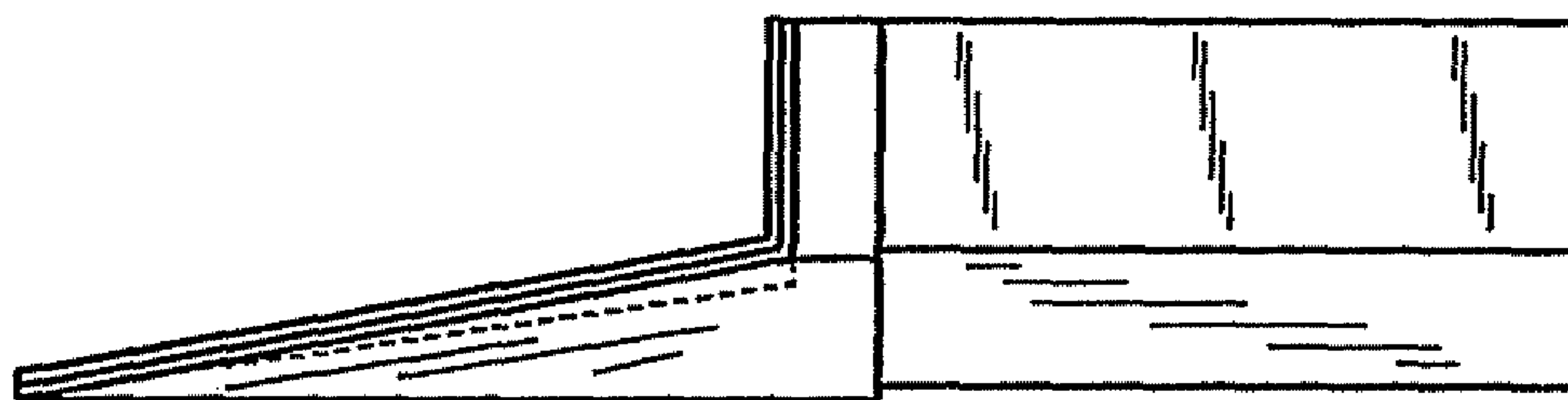

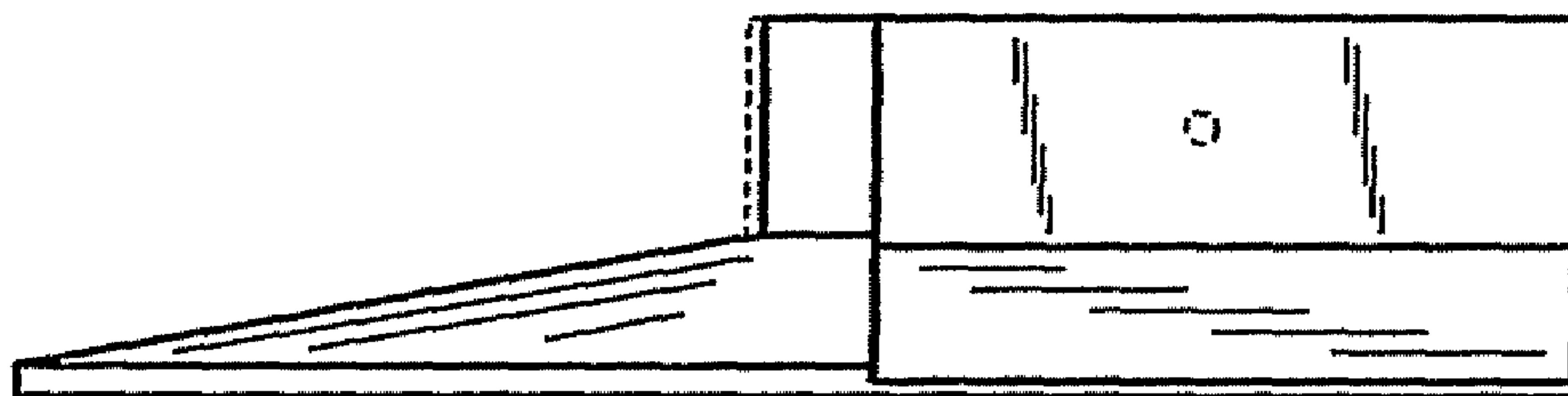

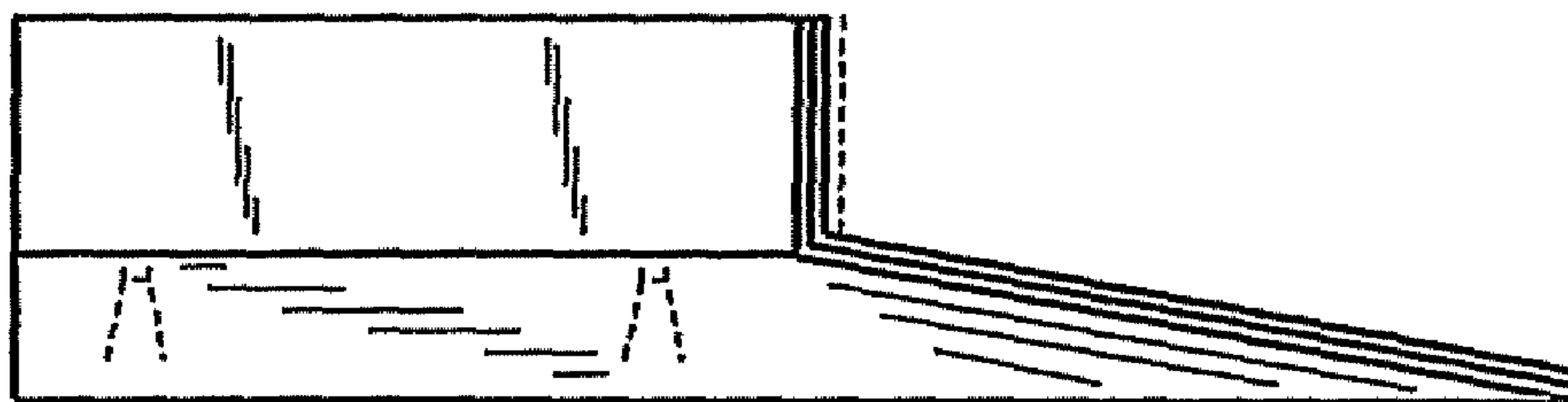
