DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe upper embodying my new design.

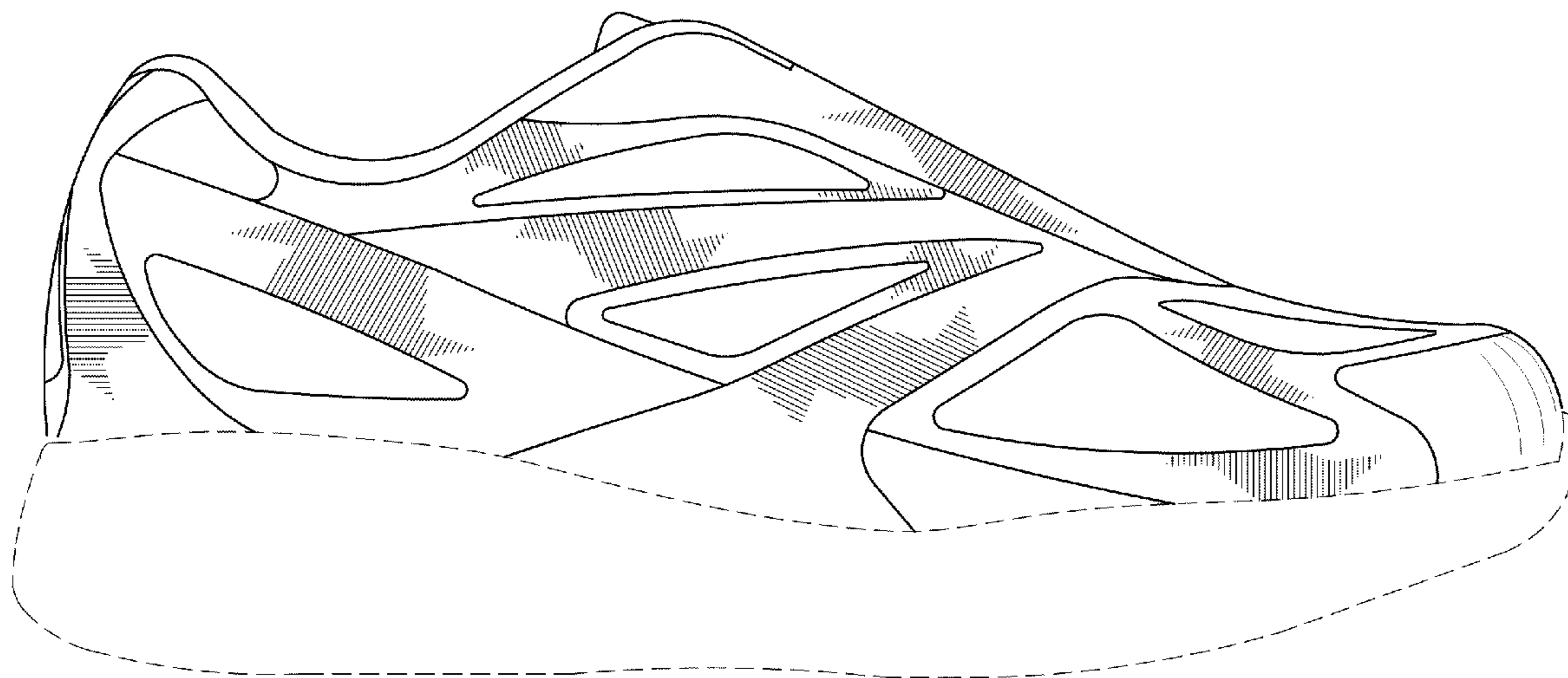

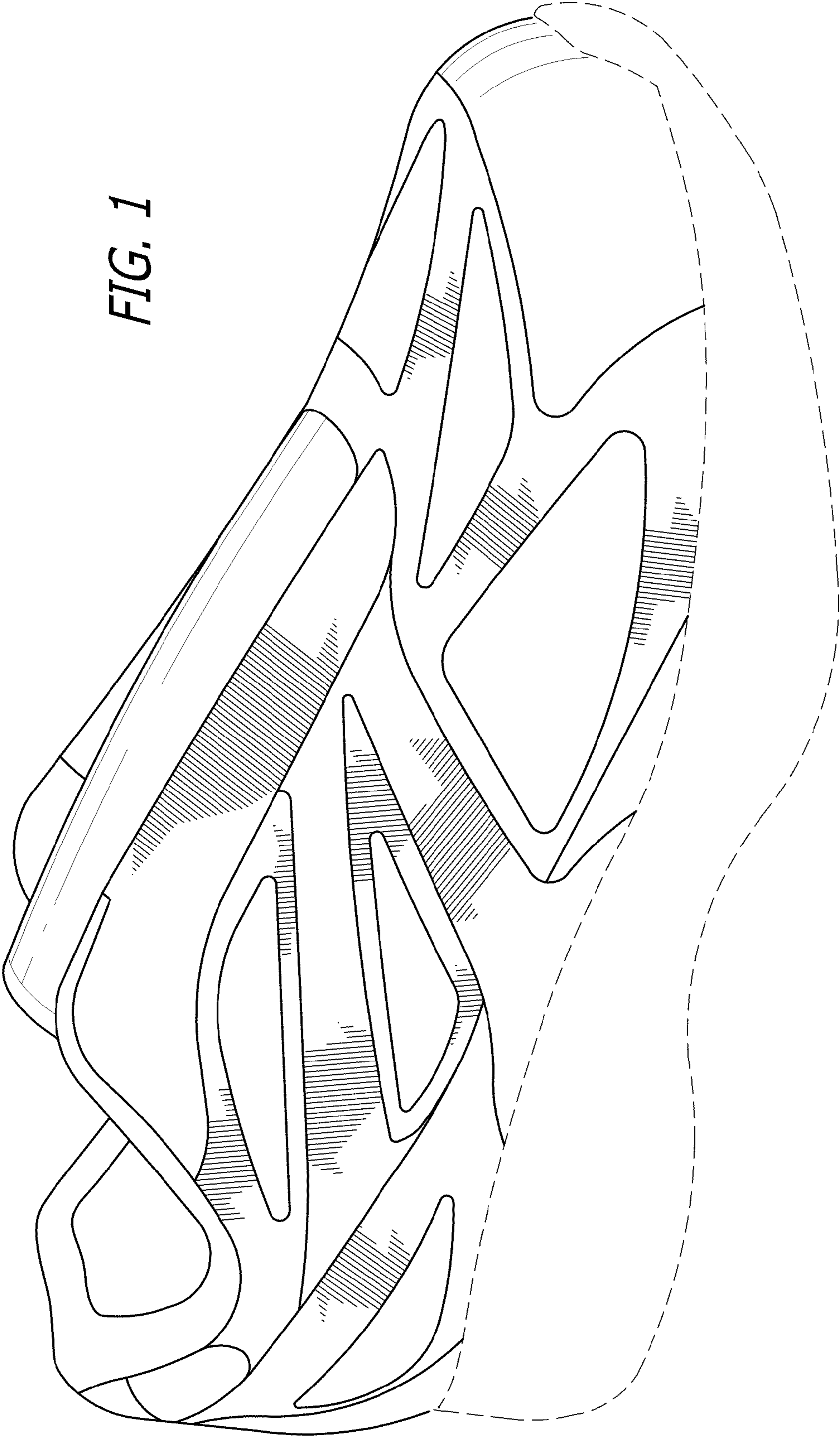
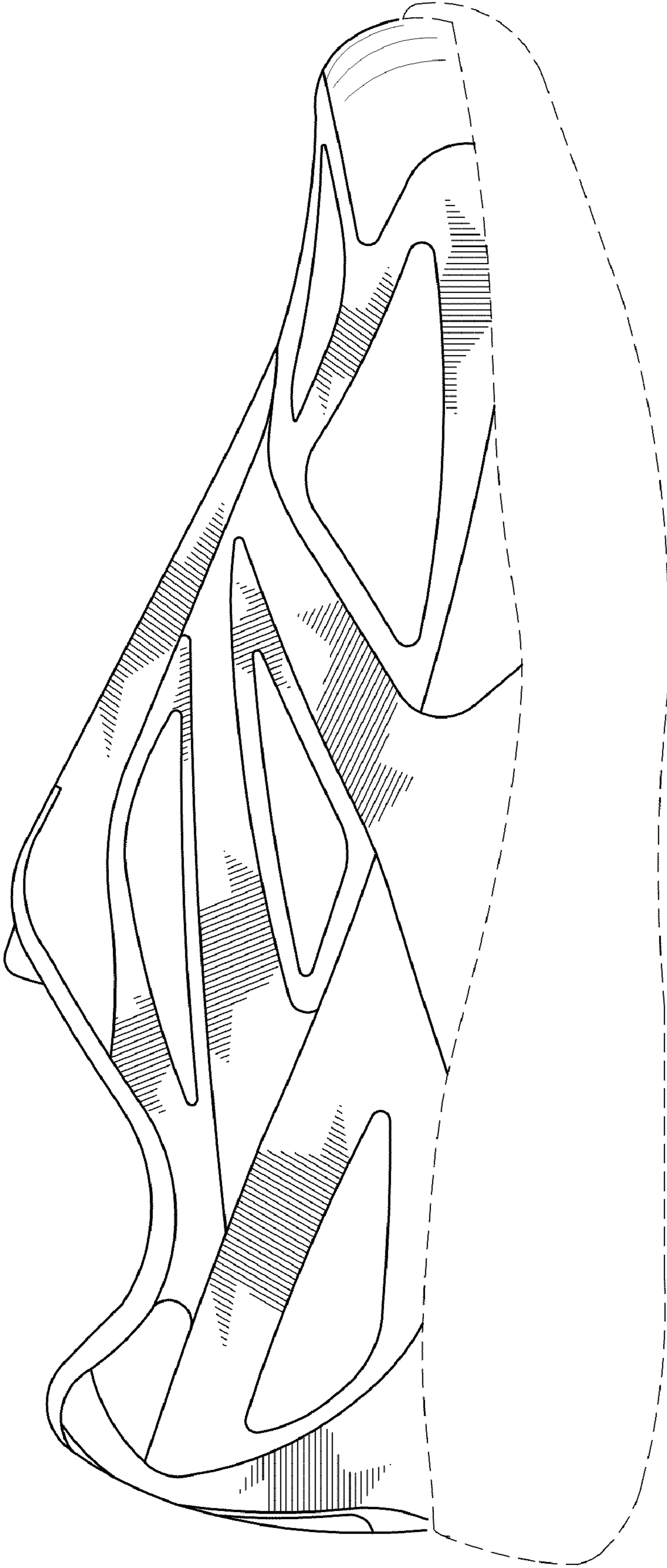

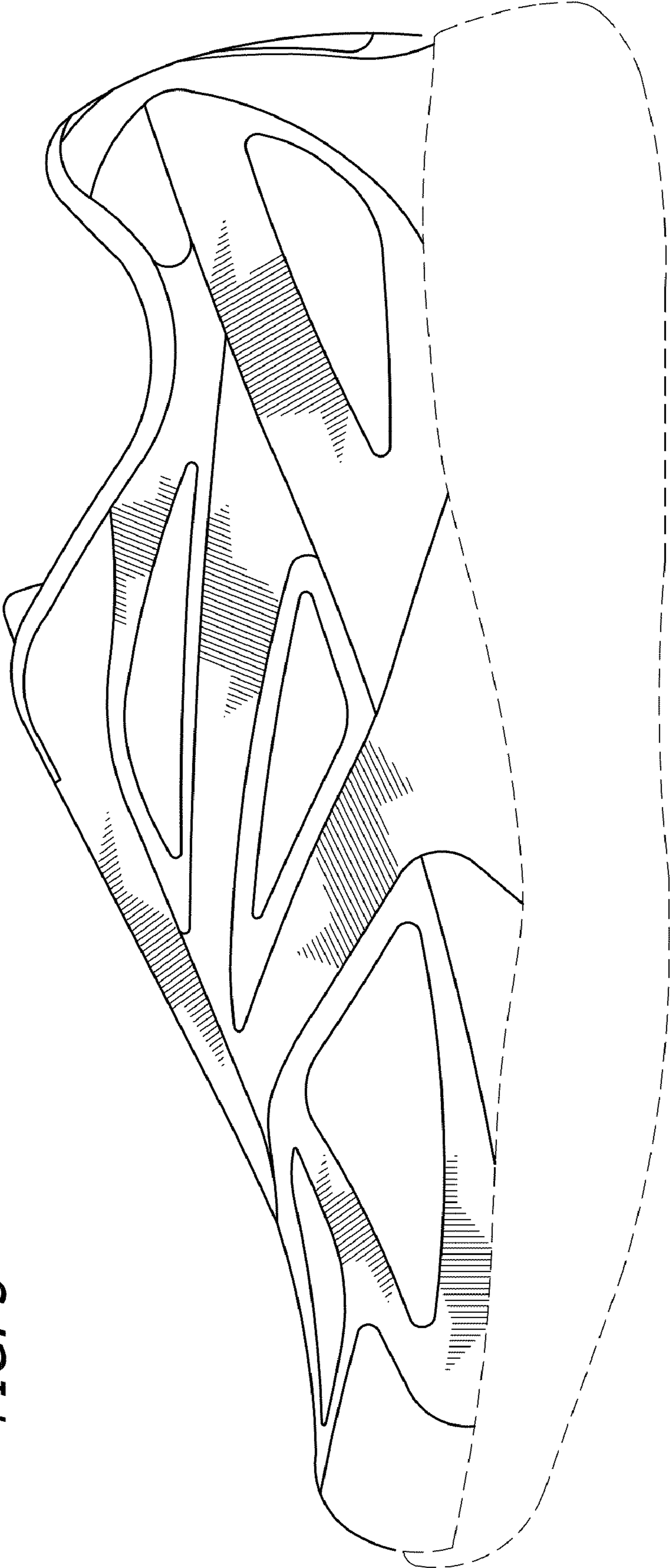

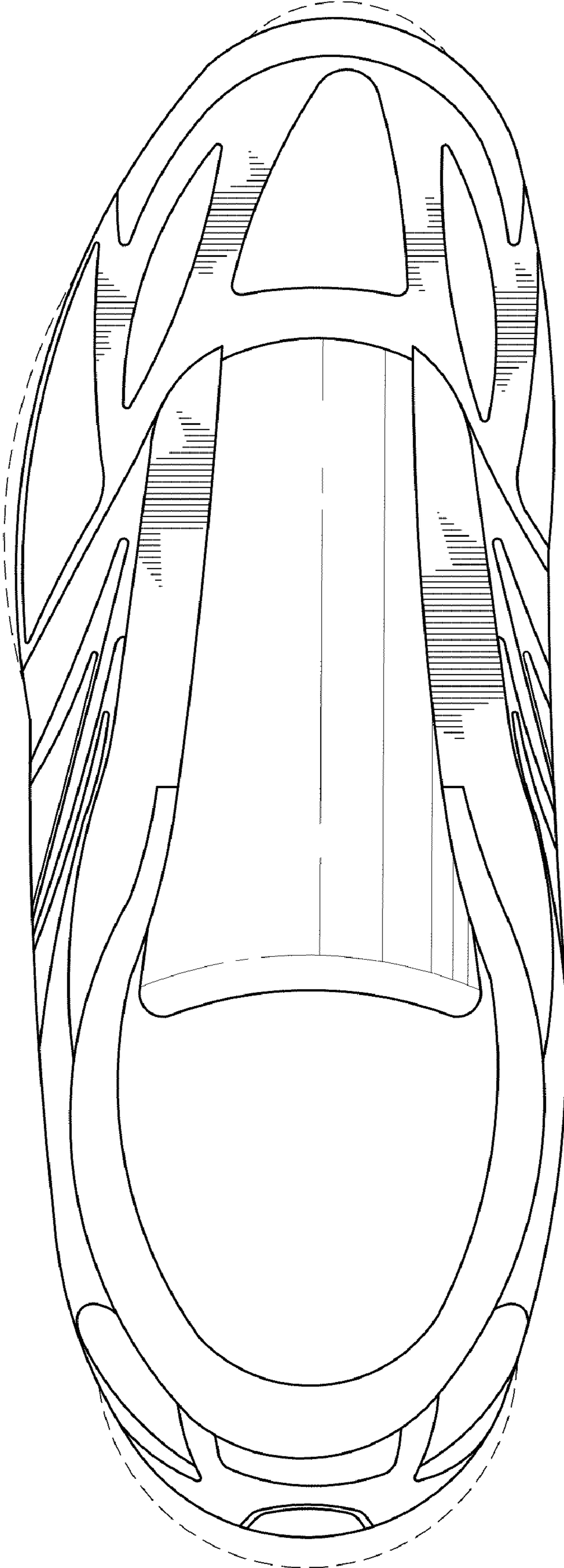

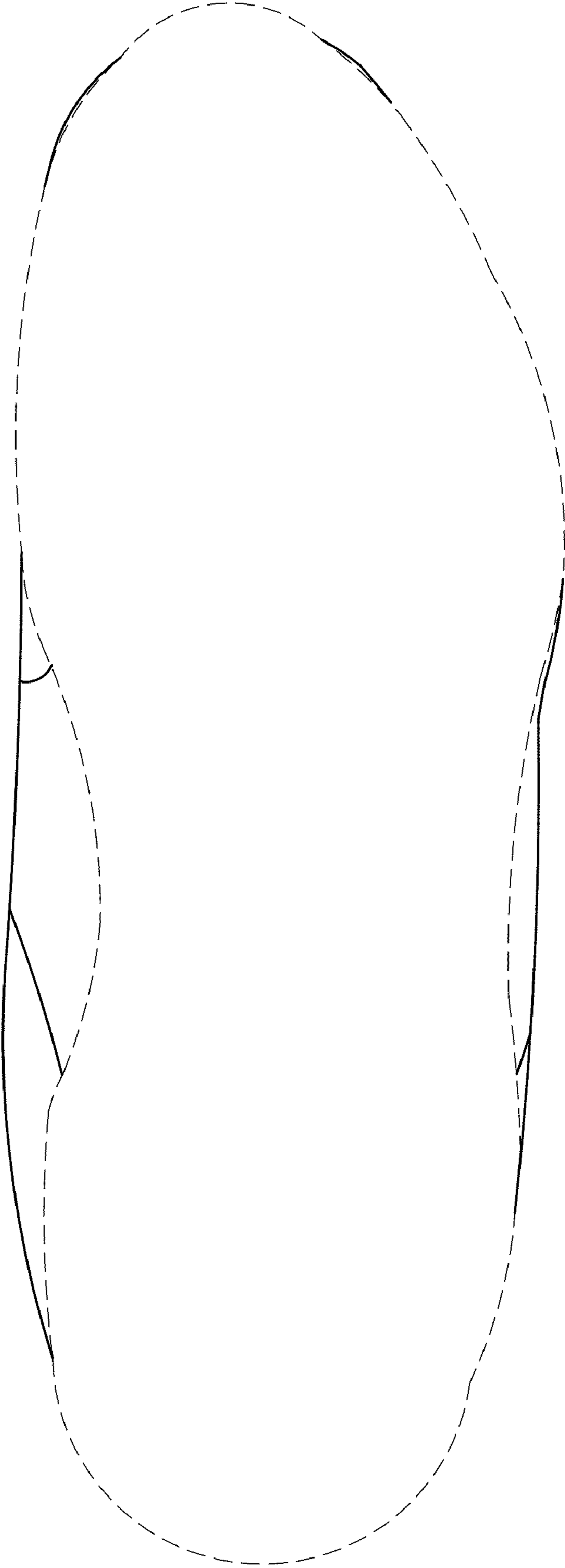

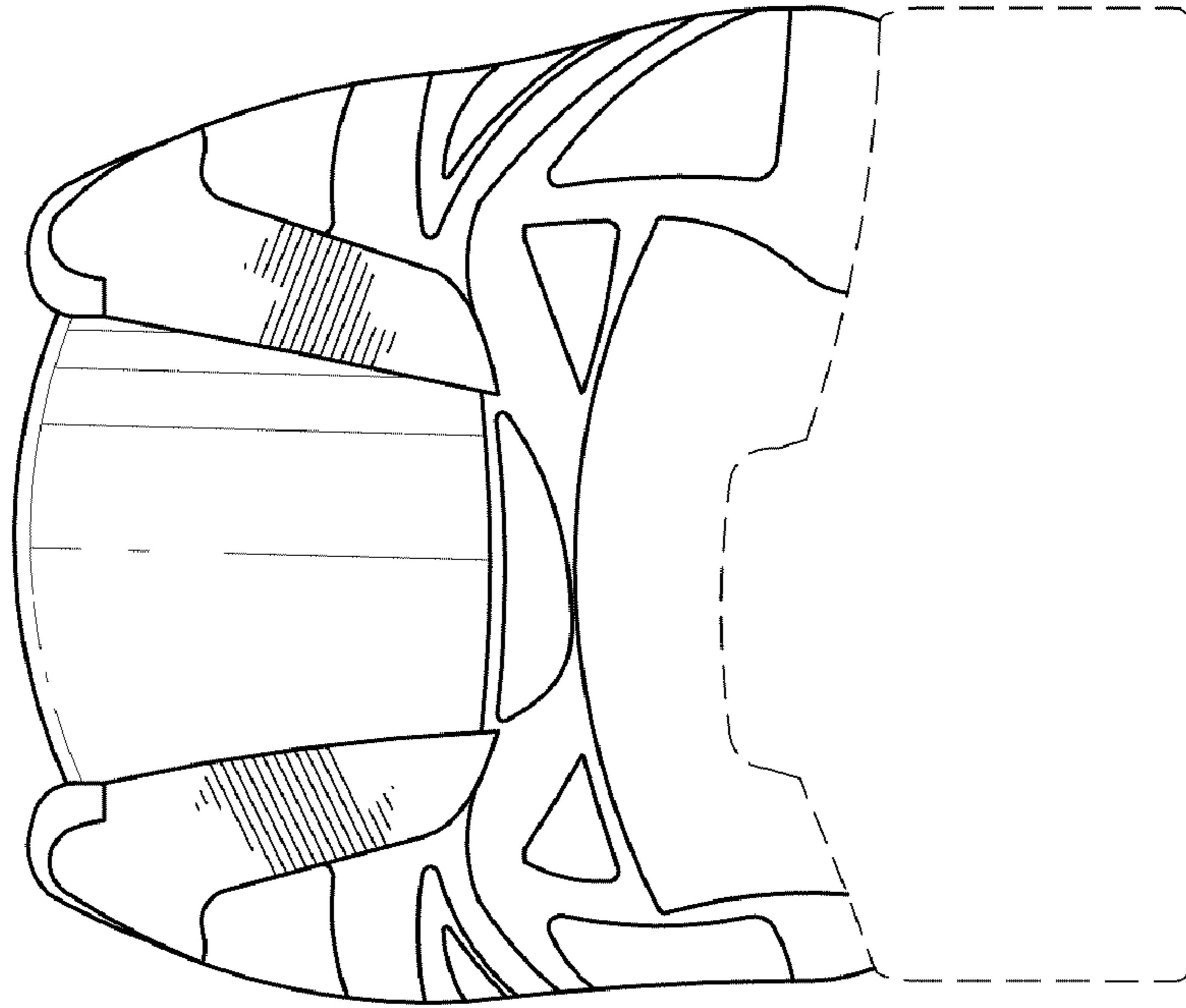

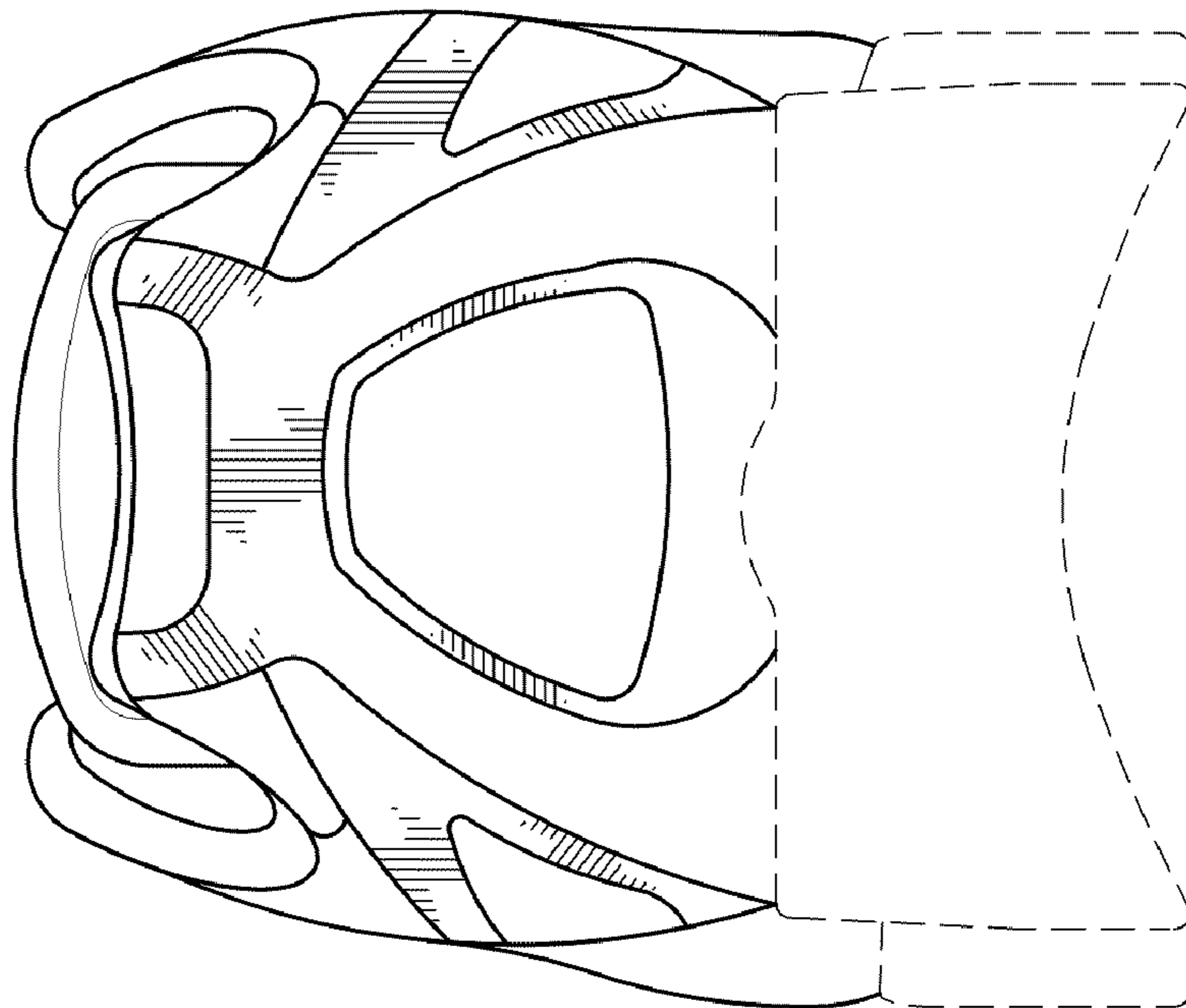
