FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;

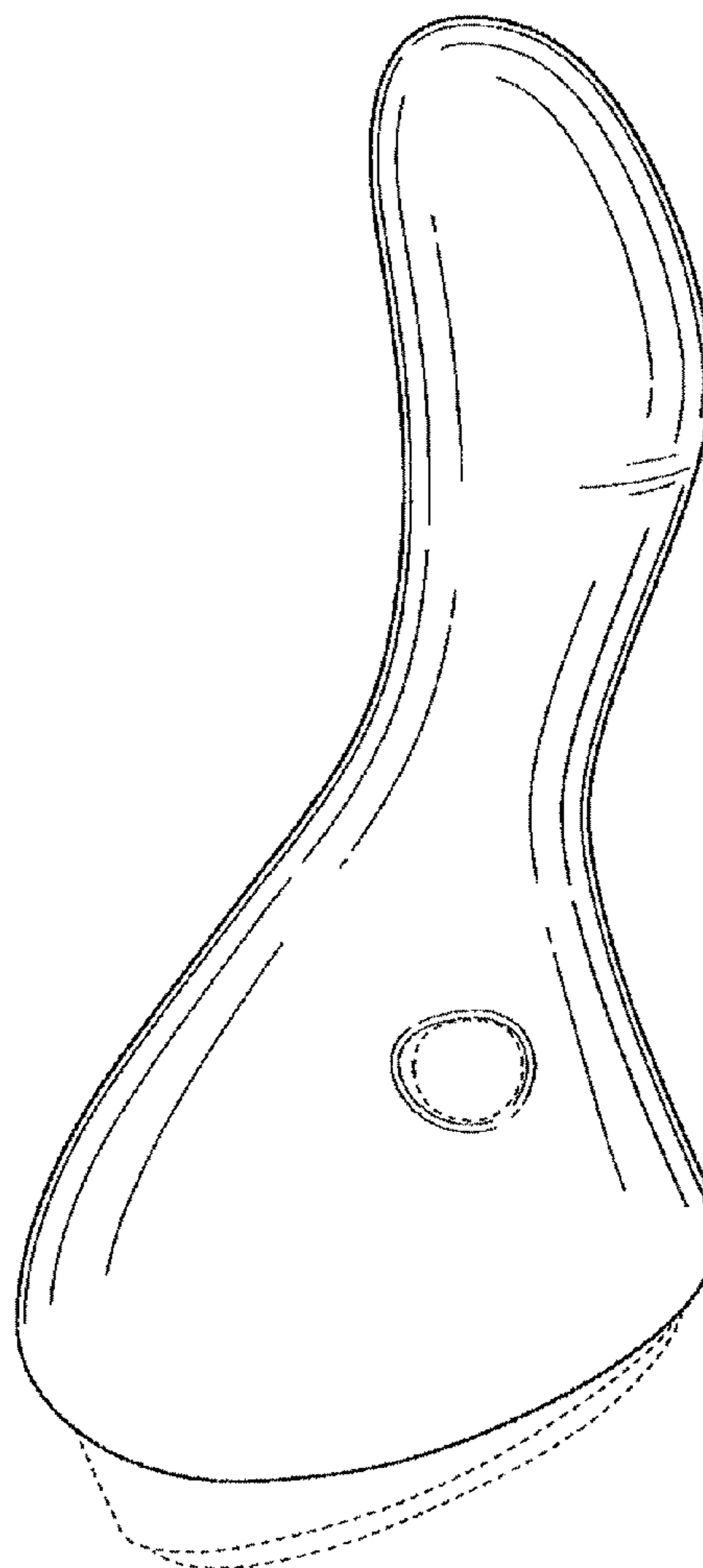
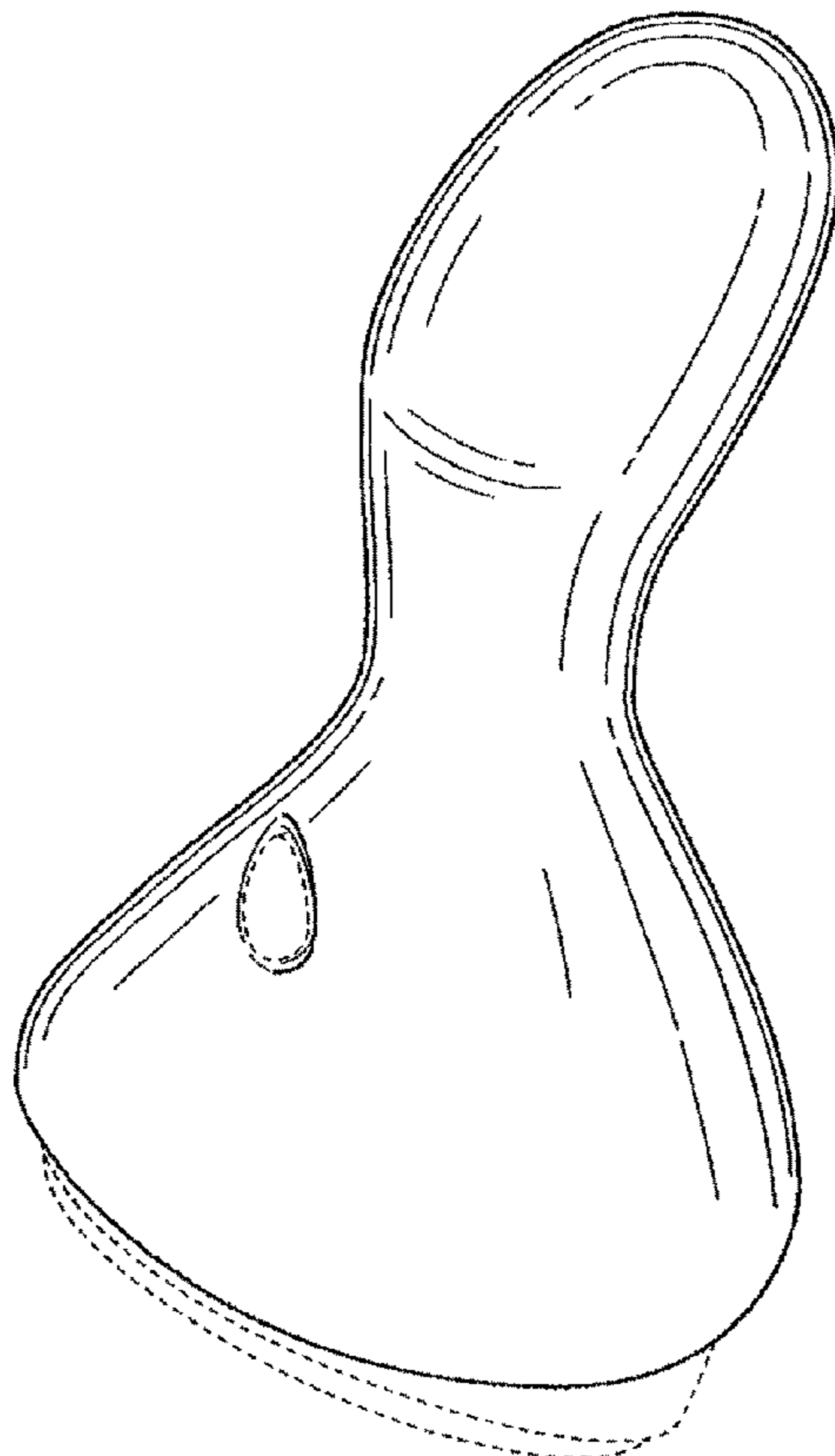
FIG. 4 is a first side view thereof;

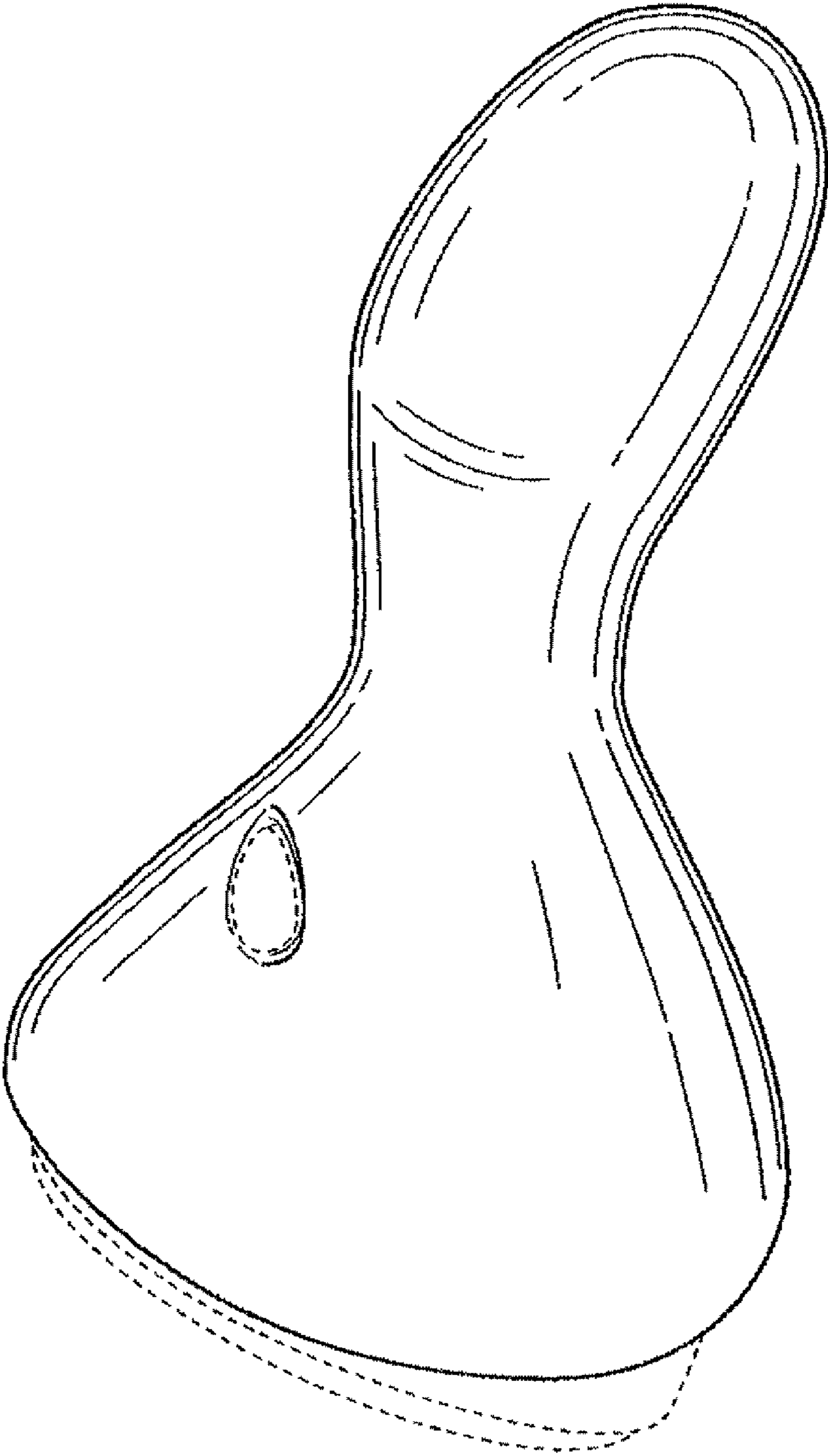
FIG. 5 is a second side view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

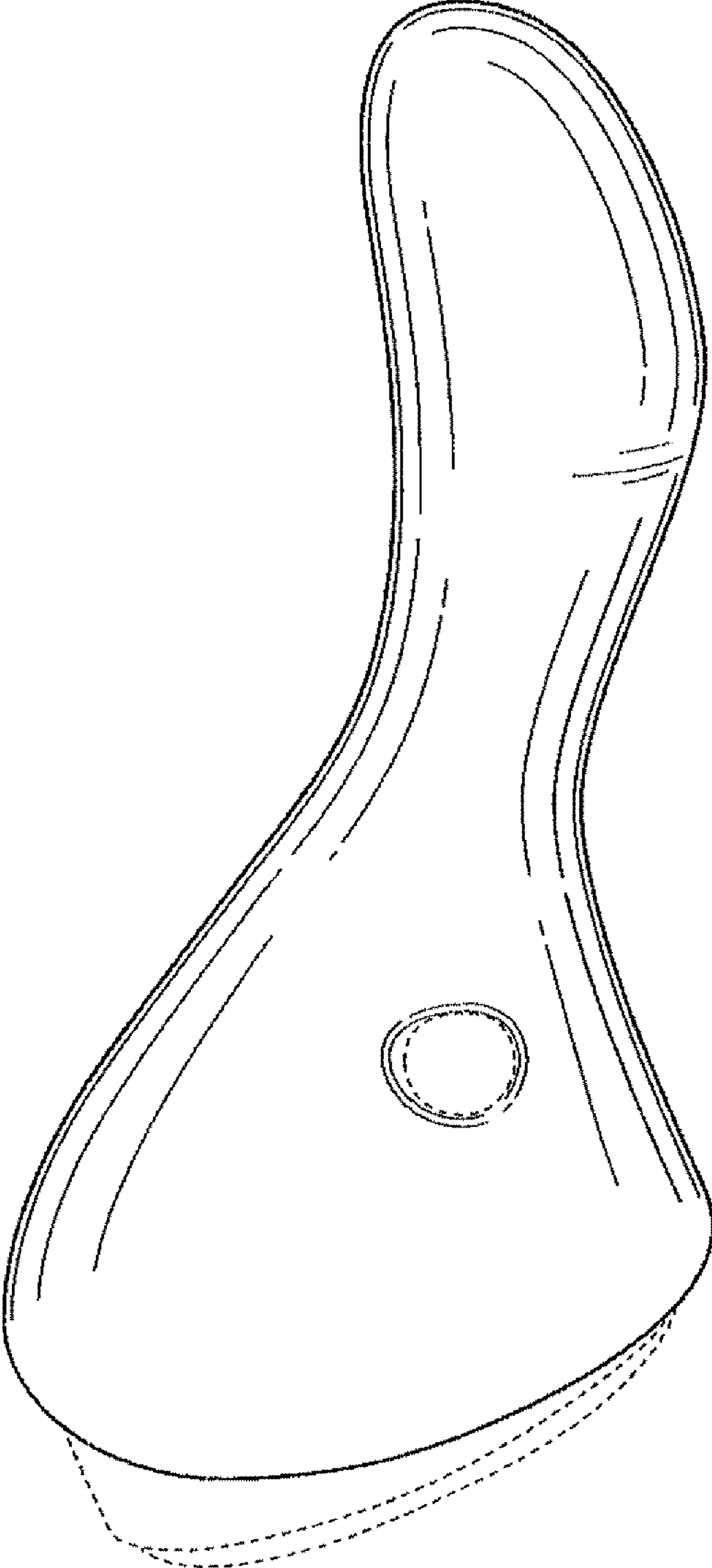
The broken lines showing portions of the faucet are included for the purpose of illustrating a portion of the faucet that forms no part of the claimed design.

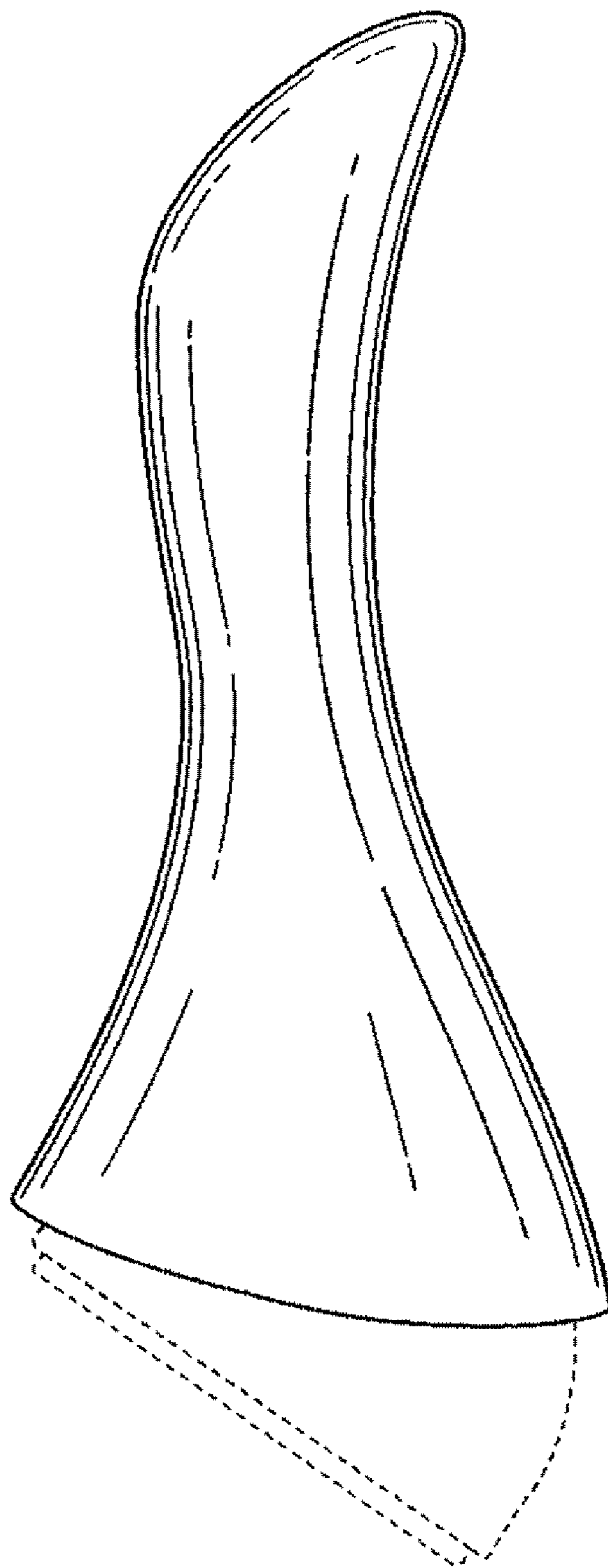

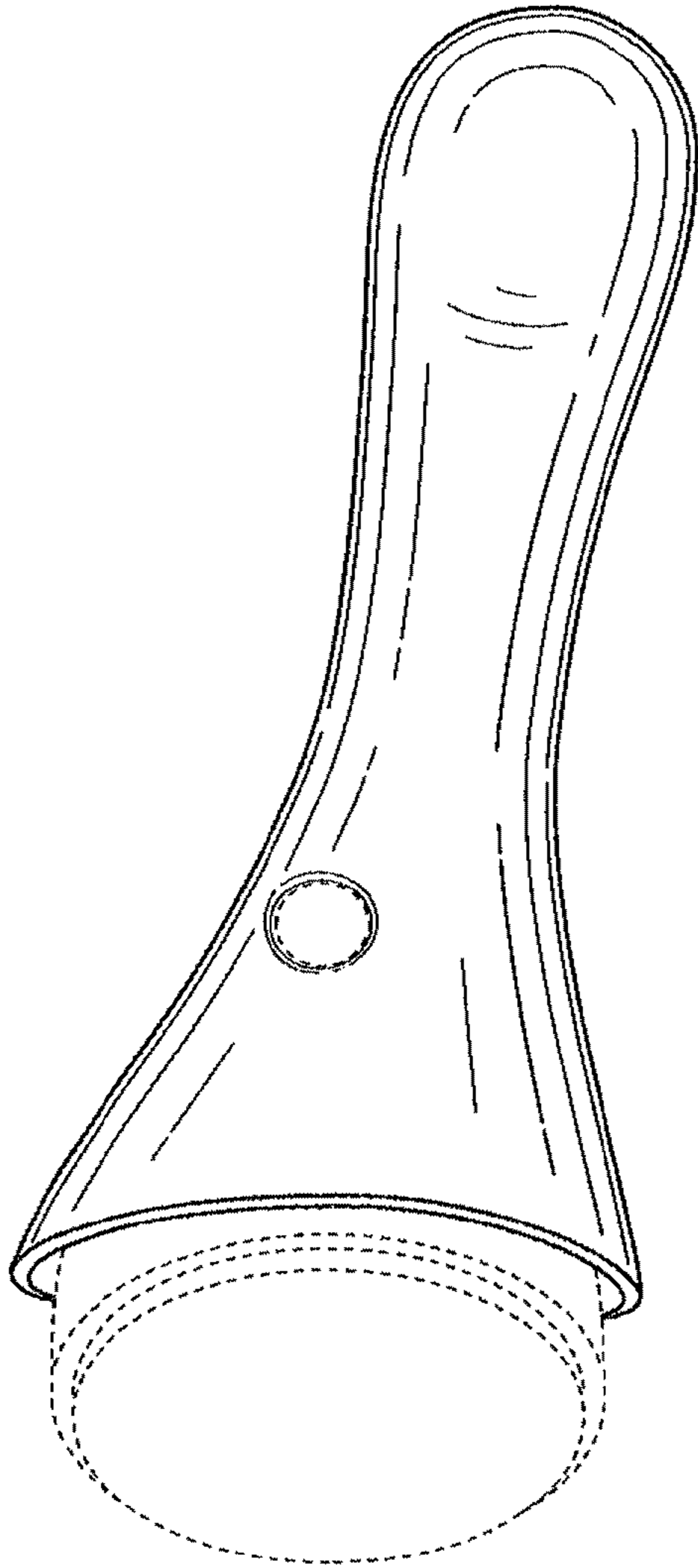

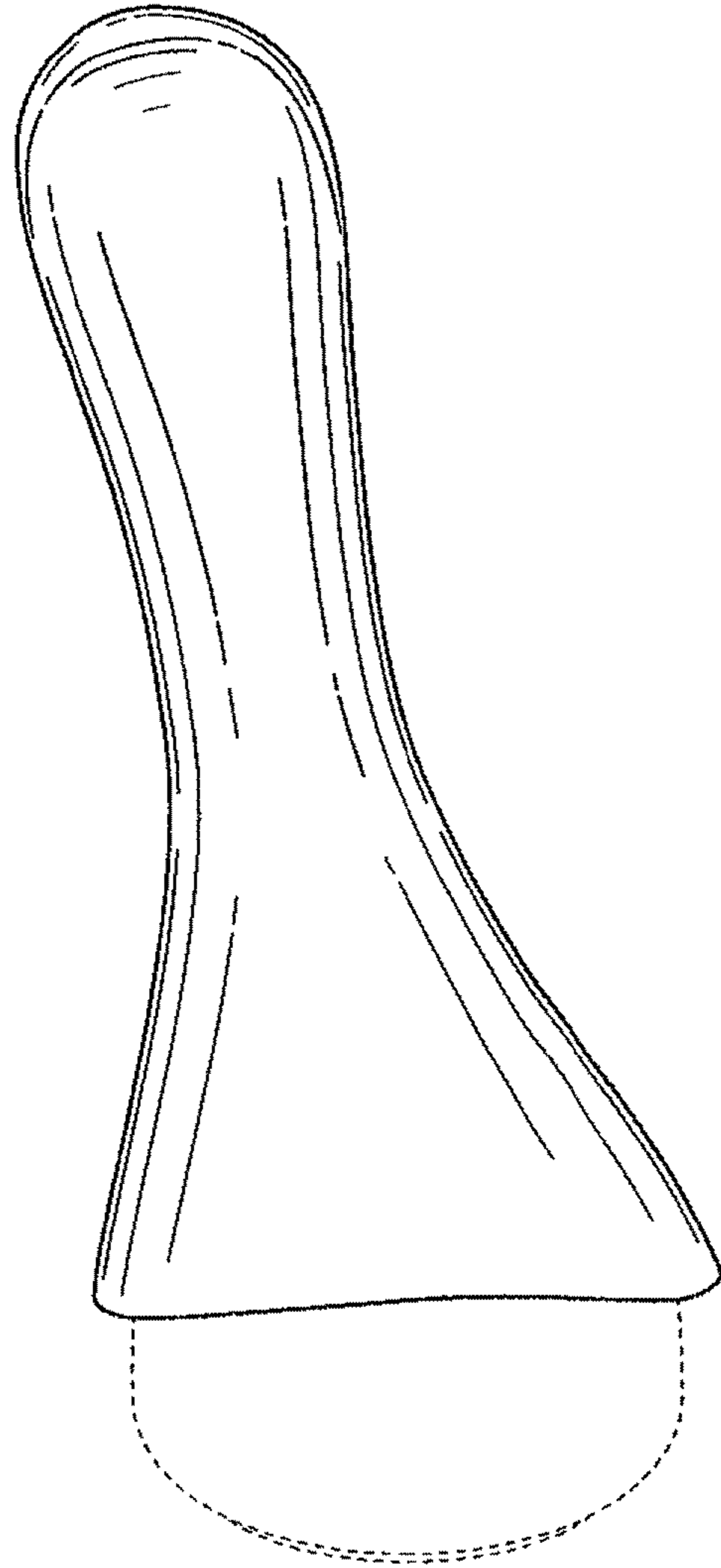
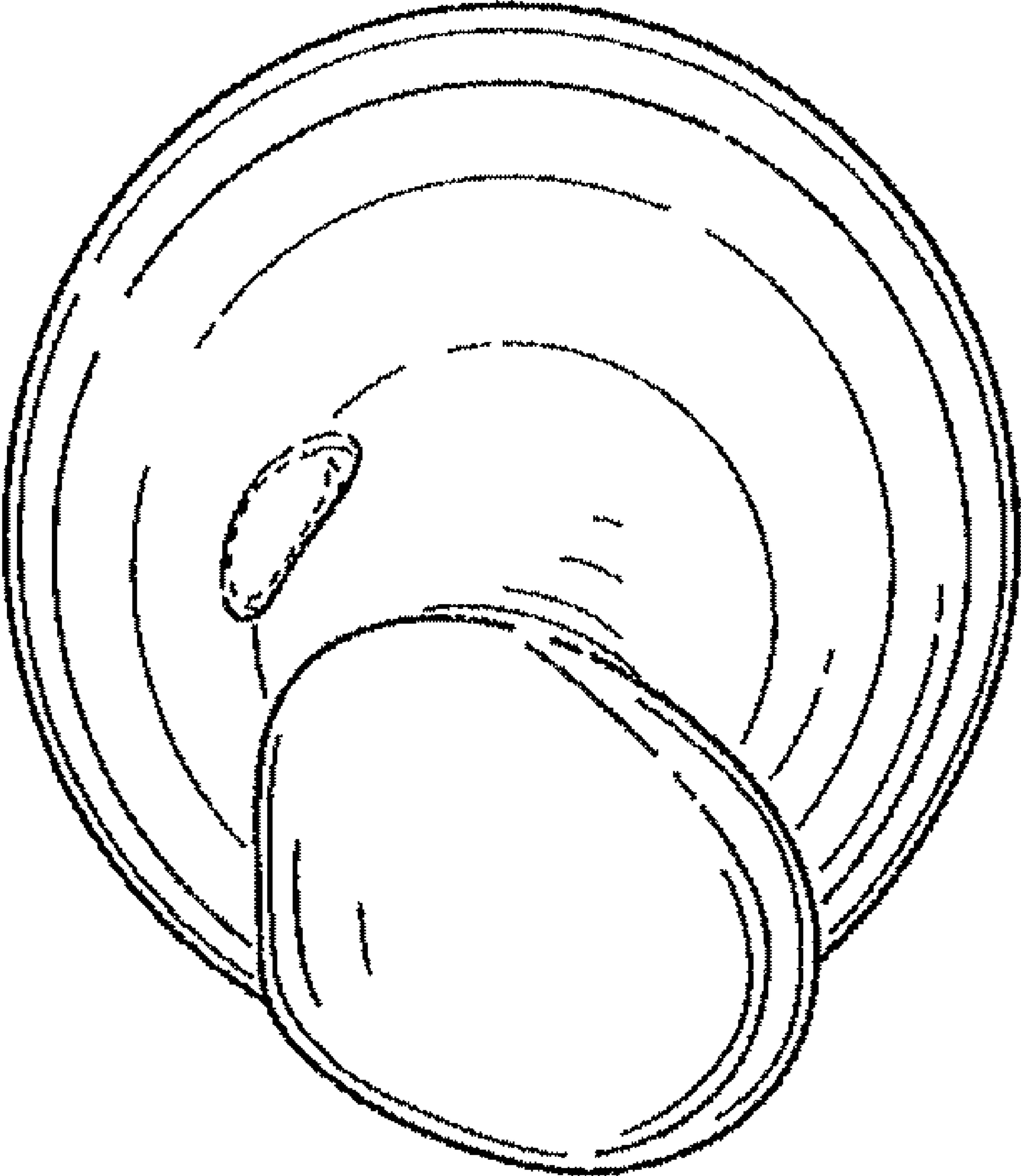
