(57) **CLAIM**

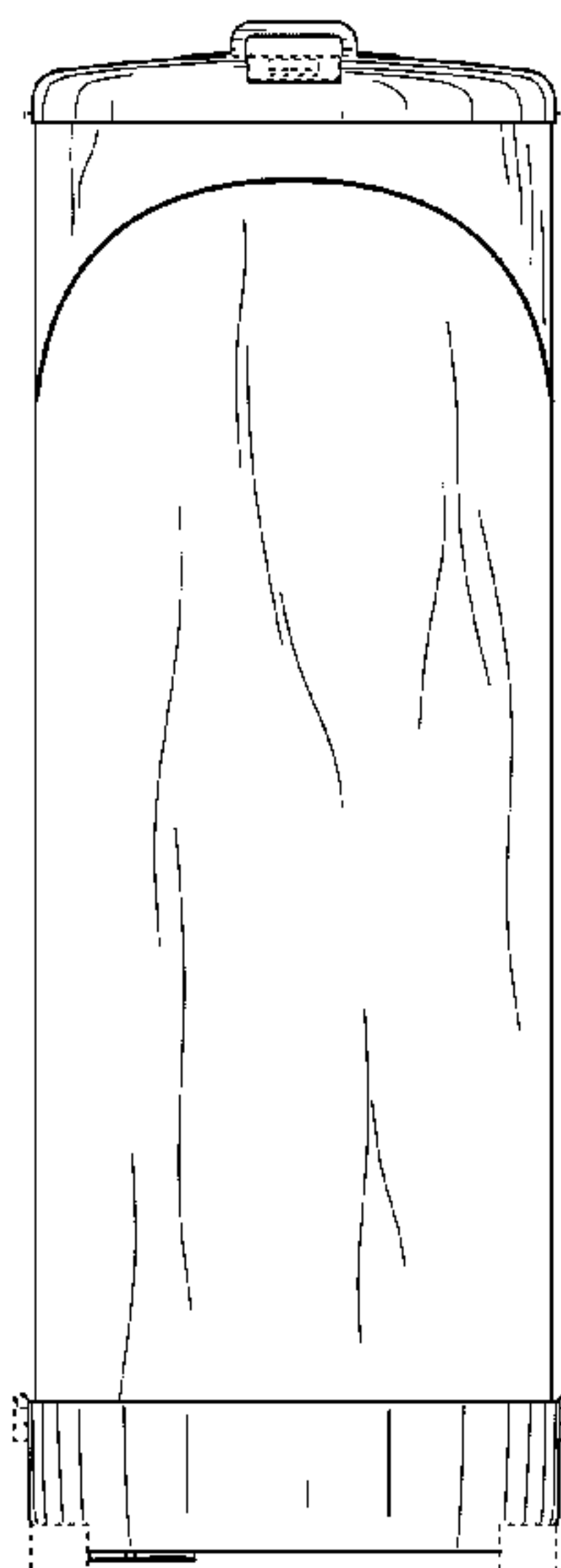
The ornamental design for a garment drying apparatus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a garment drying apparatus showing my new design expanded open with poles;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof.

The broken line showing of details in FIGS. 1-6 is included for the purpose of showing environmental portions of the garment drying apparatus and forms no part of the claimed design.

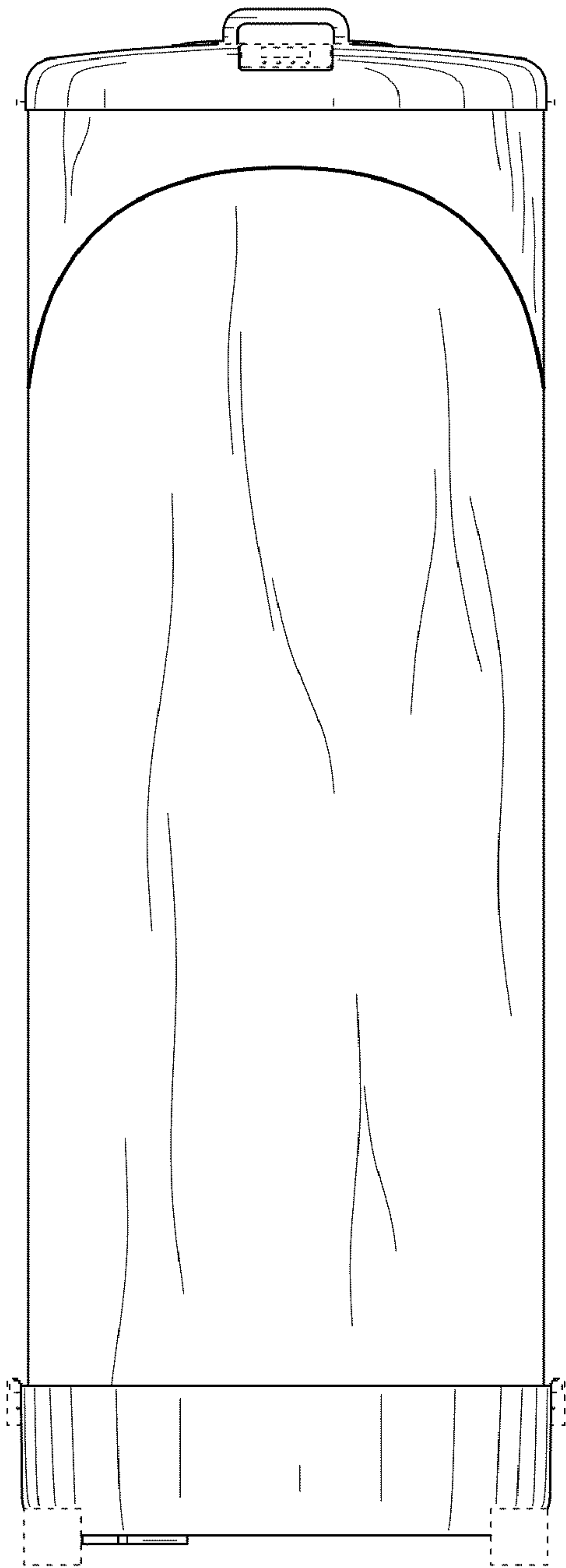

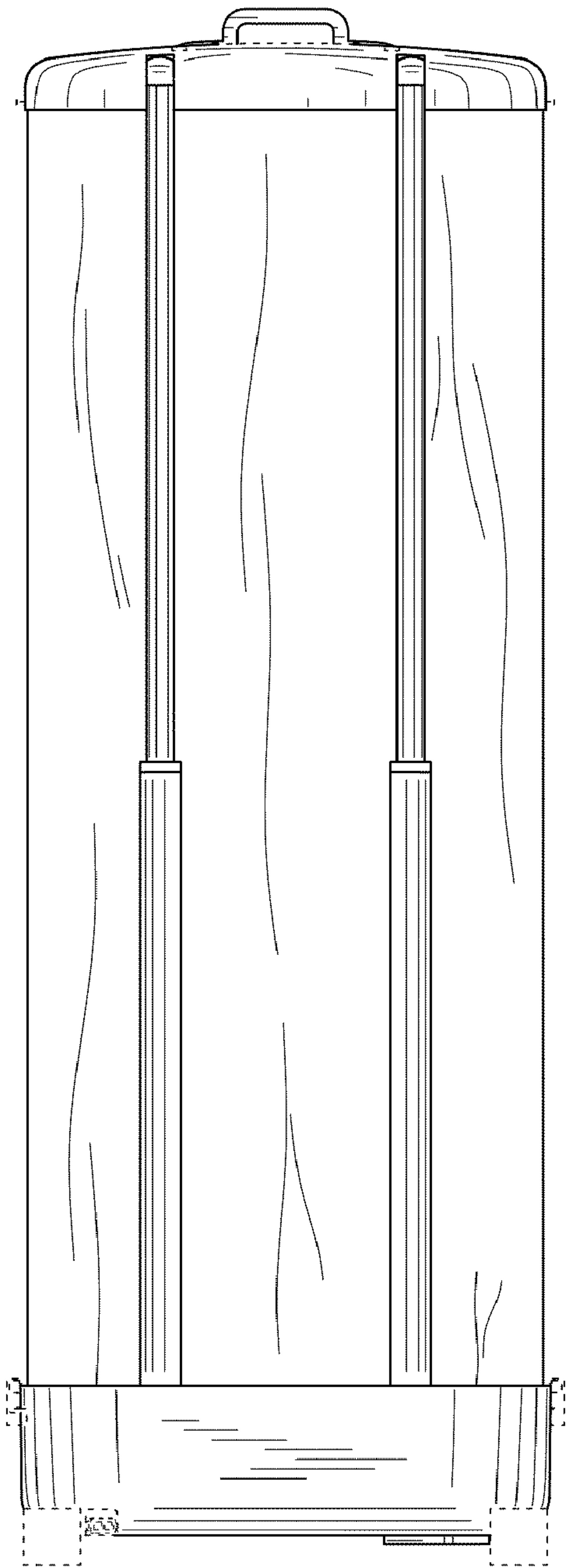

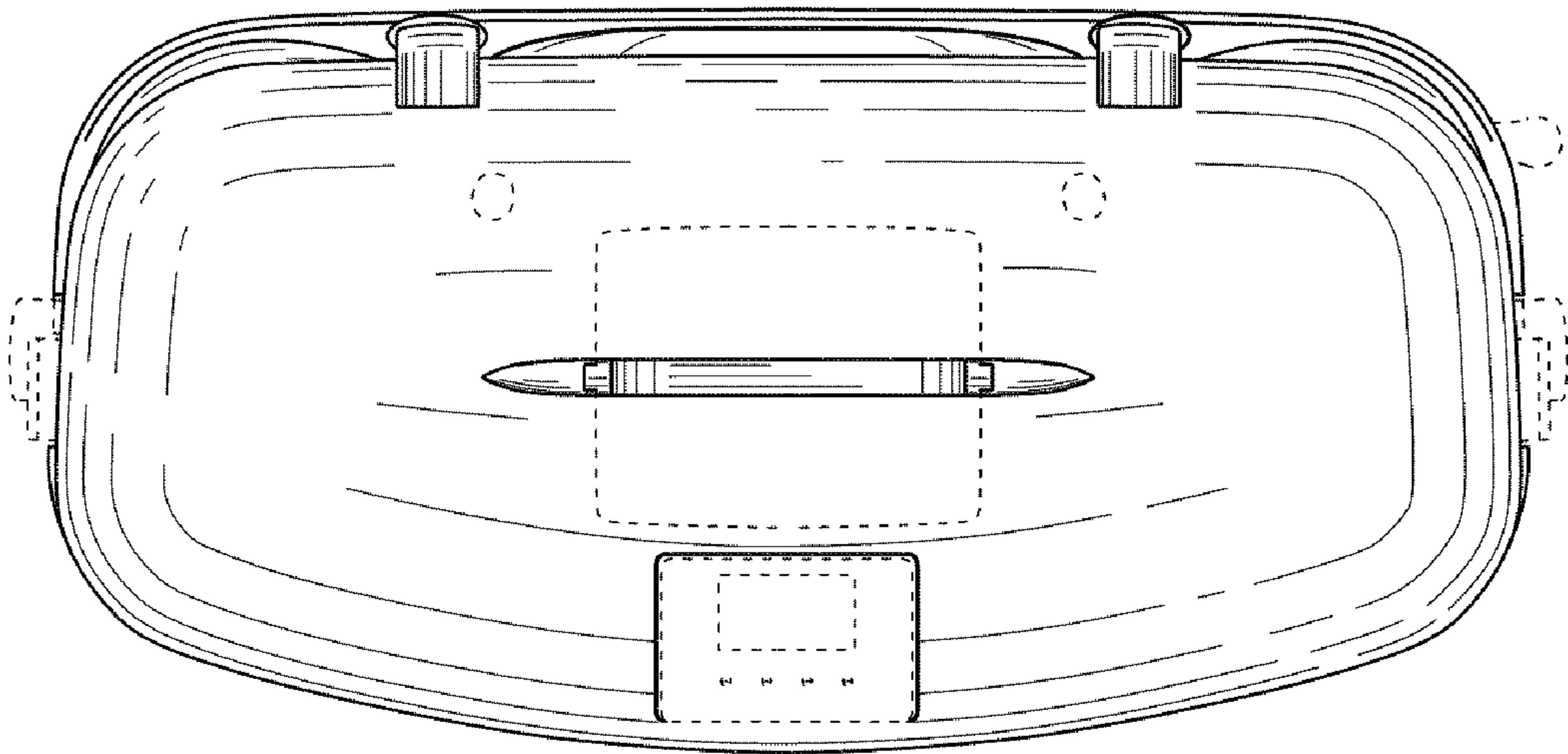

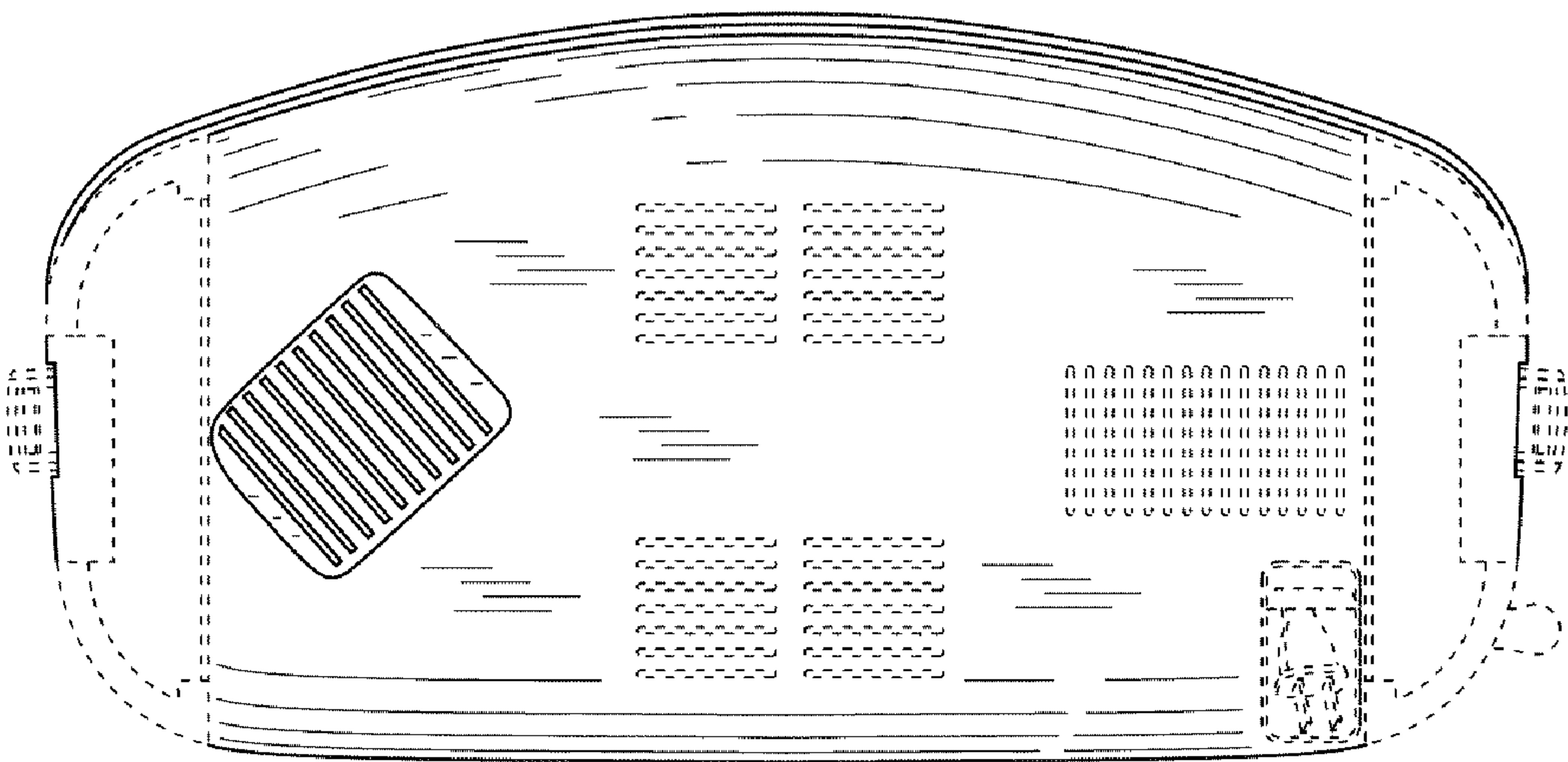

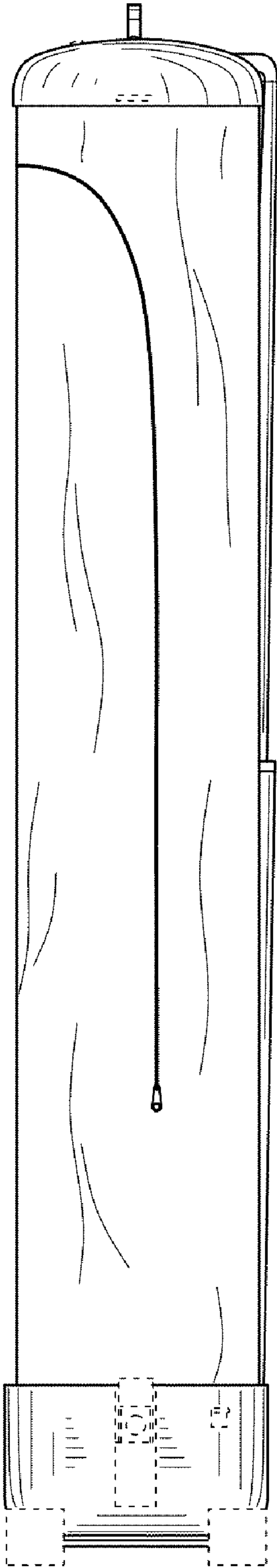

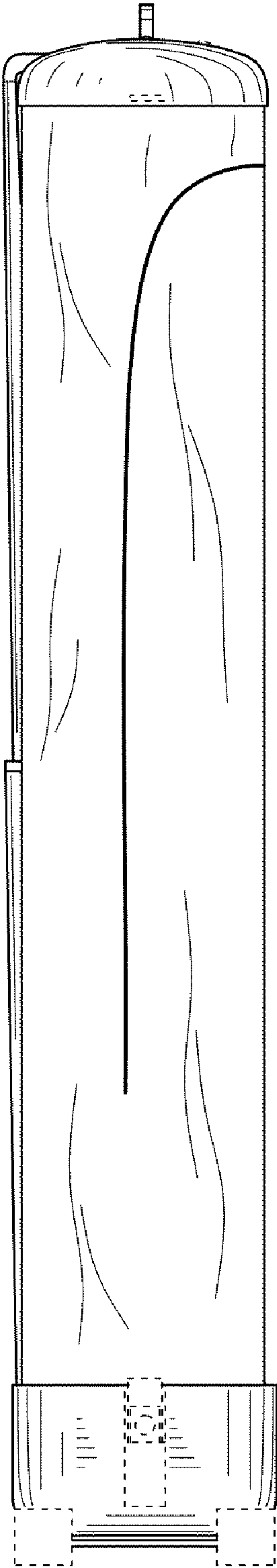
