(57) **CLAIM**

What is claimed is the ornamental design for a shirt, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shirt showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

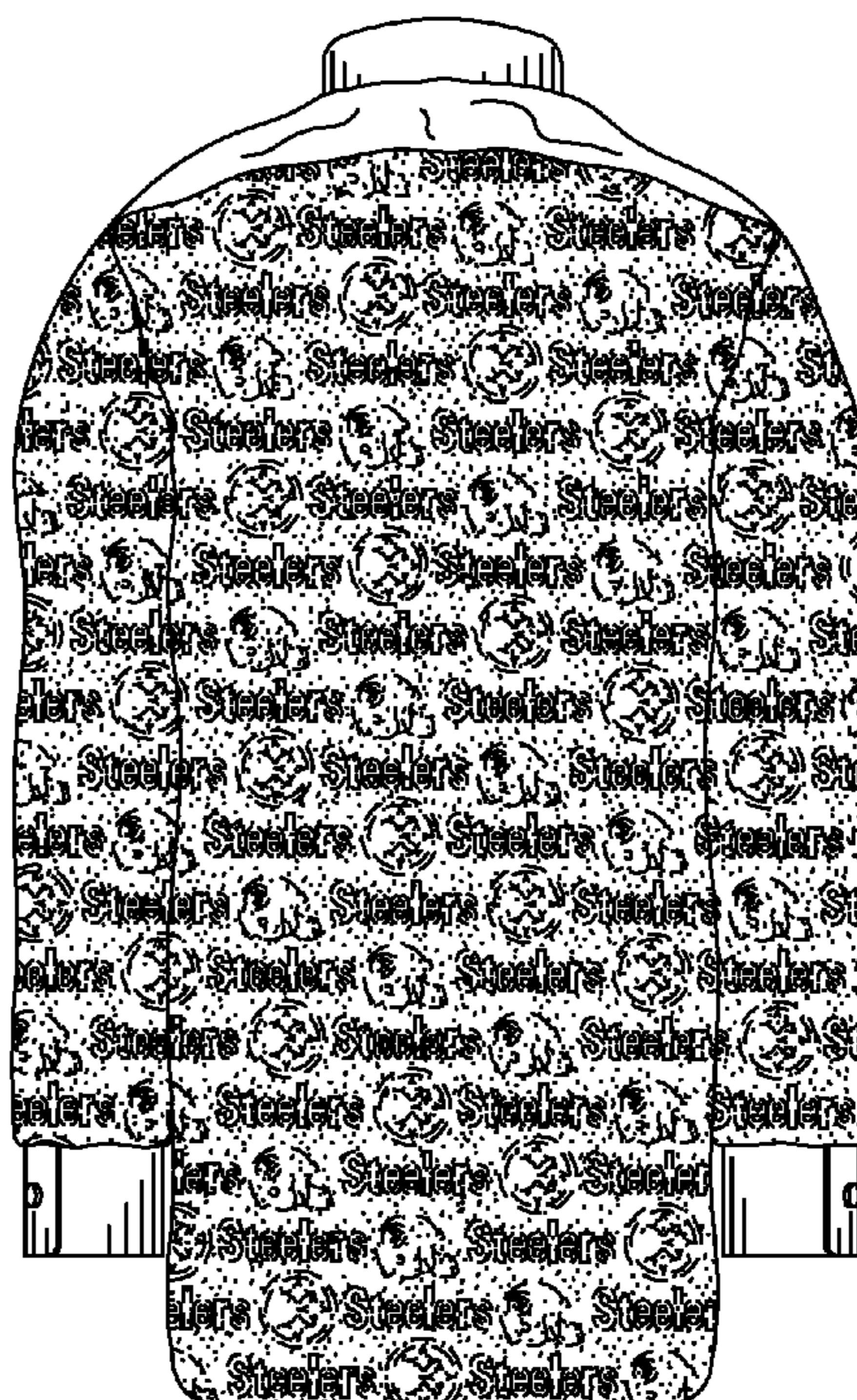
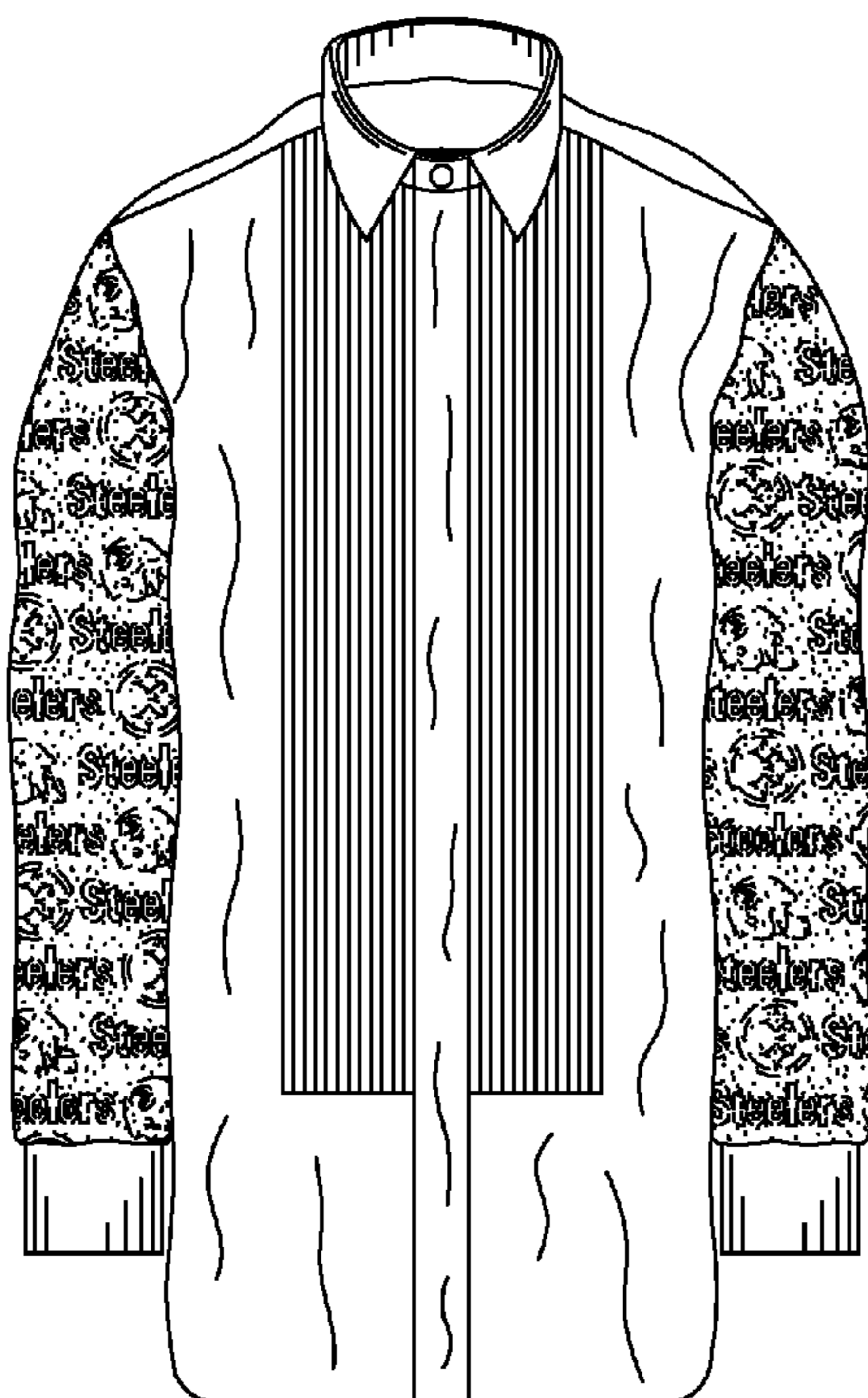
FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

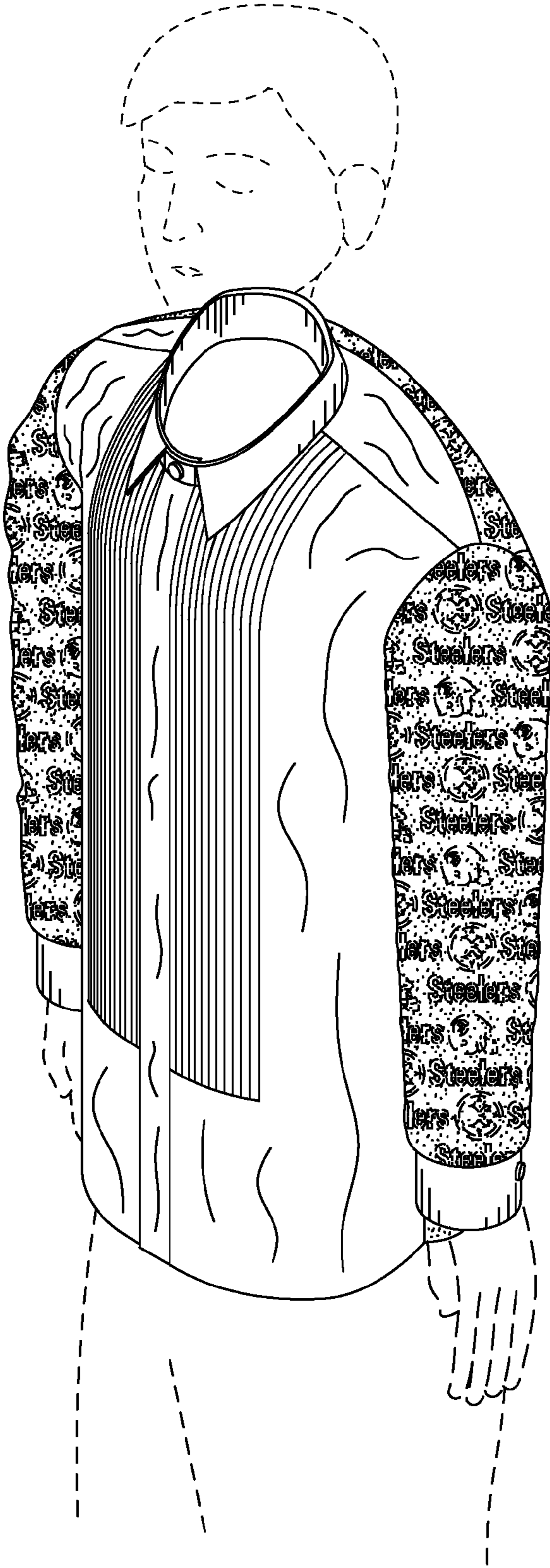

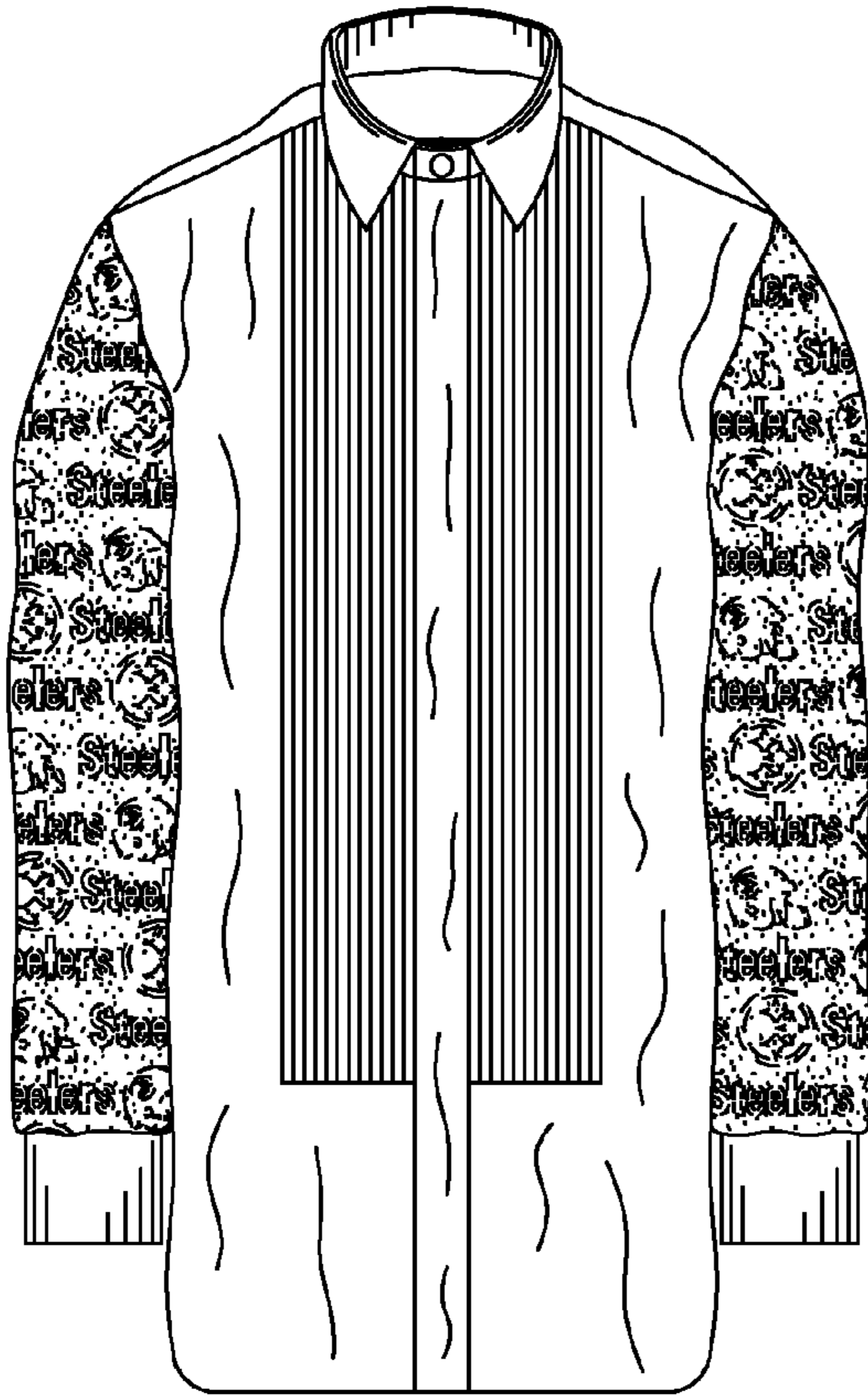

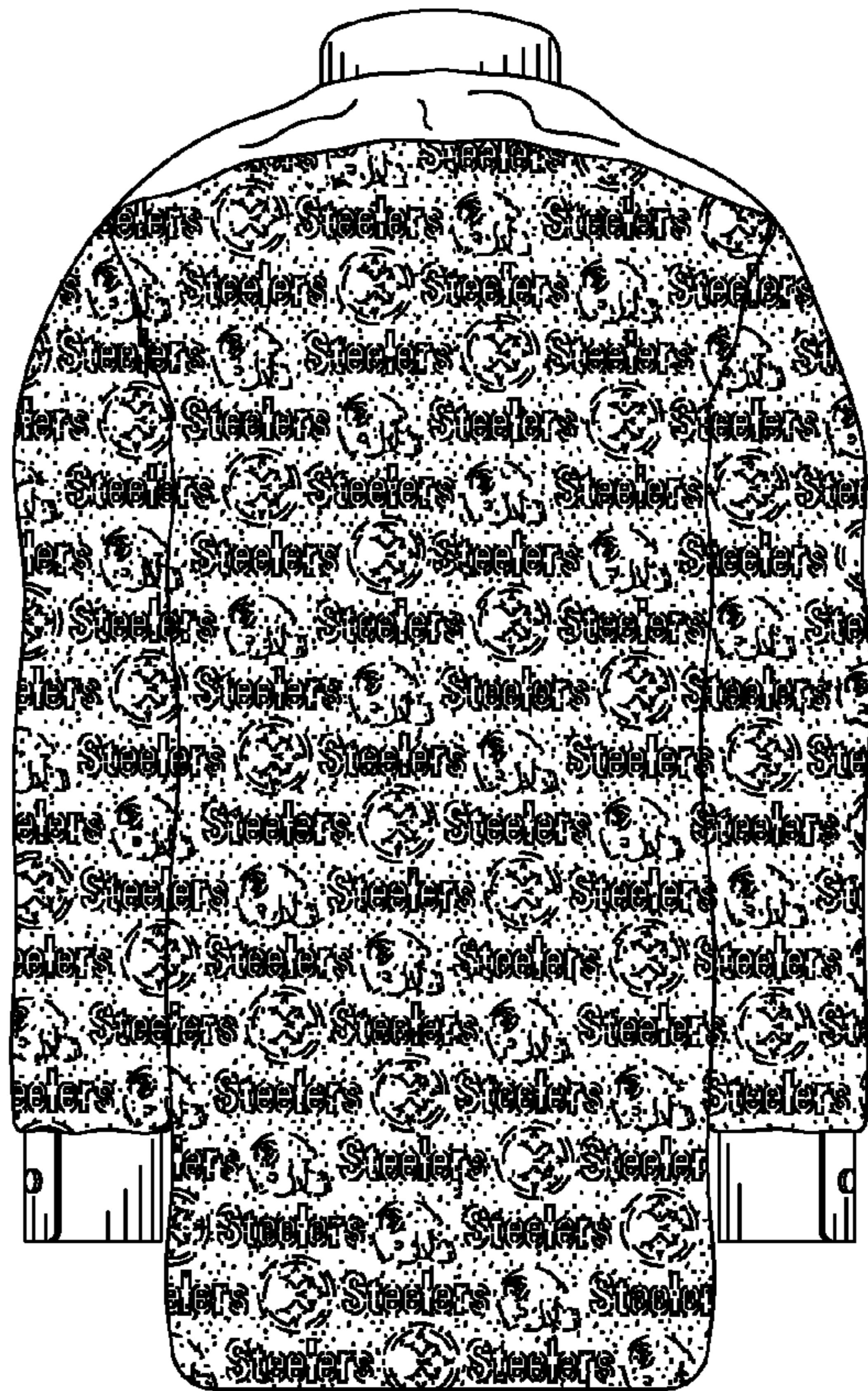

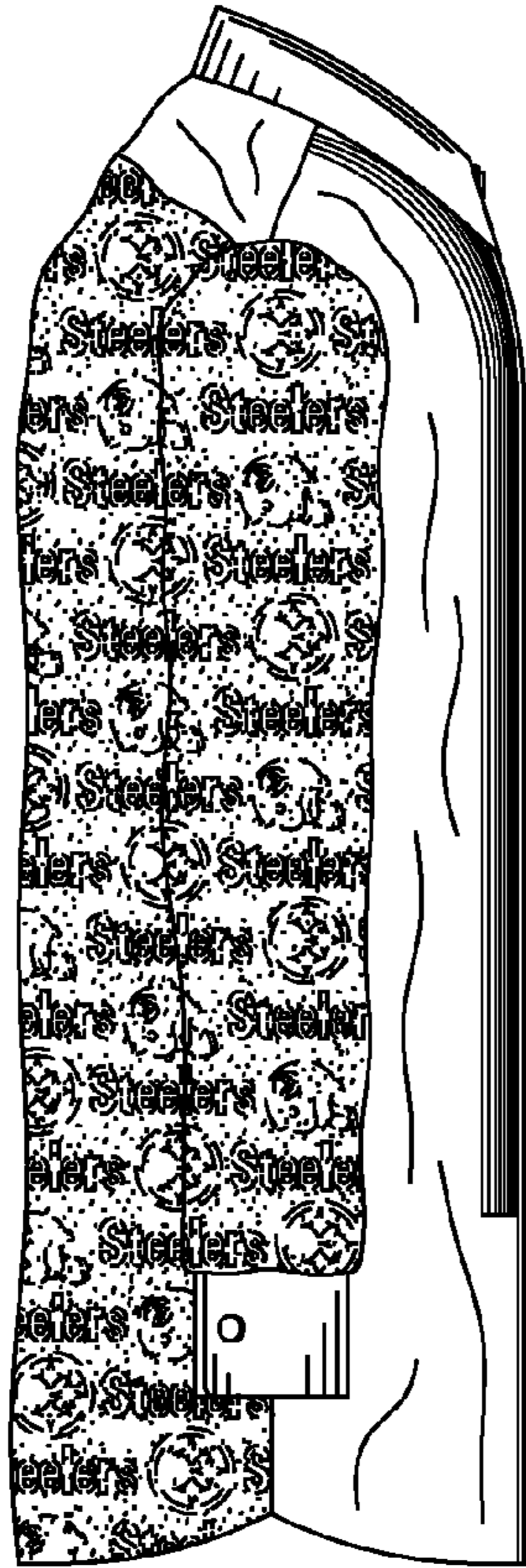

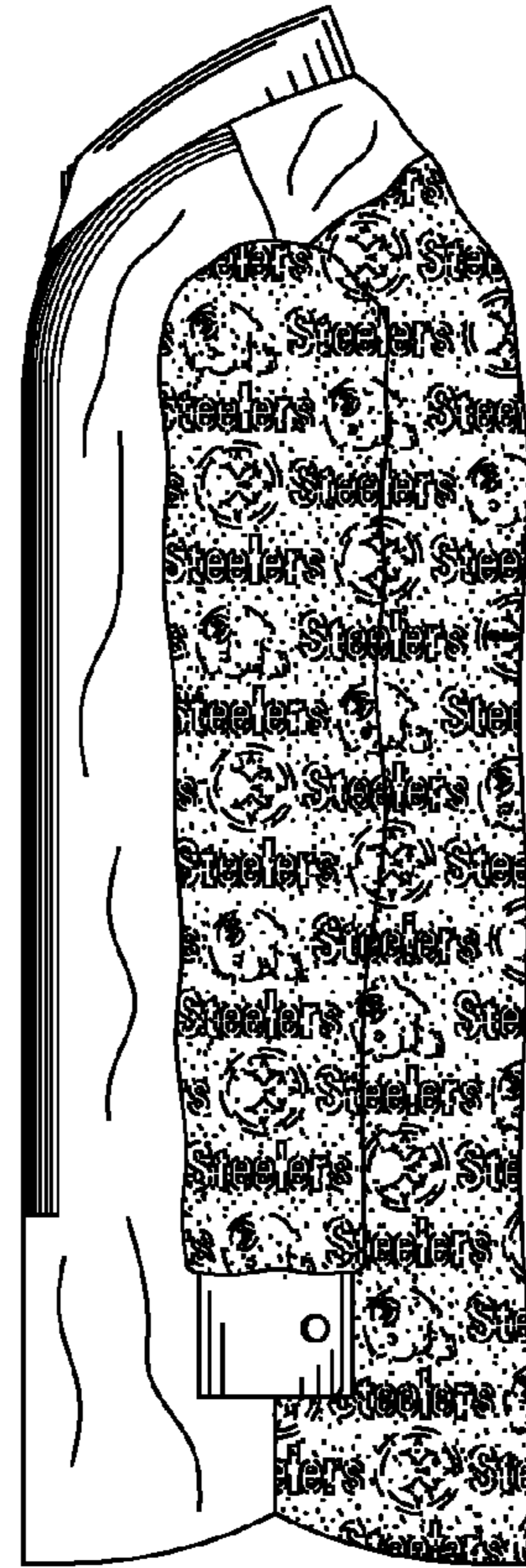

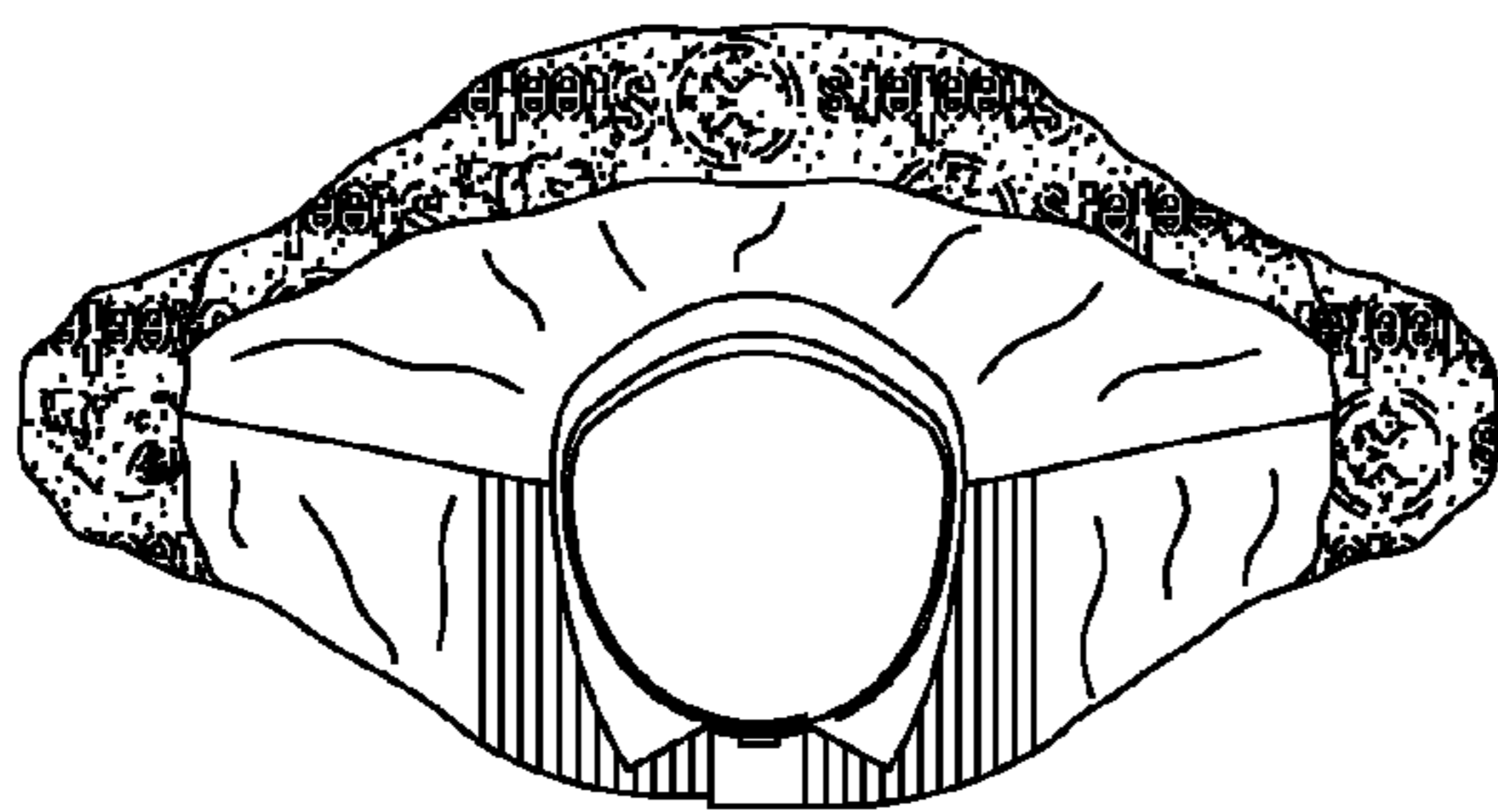

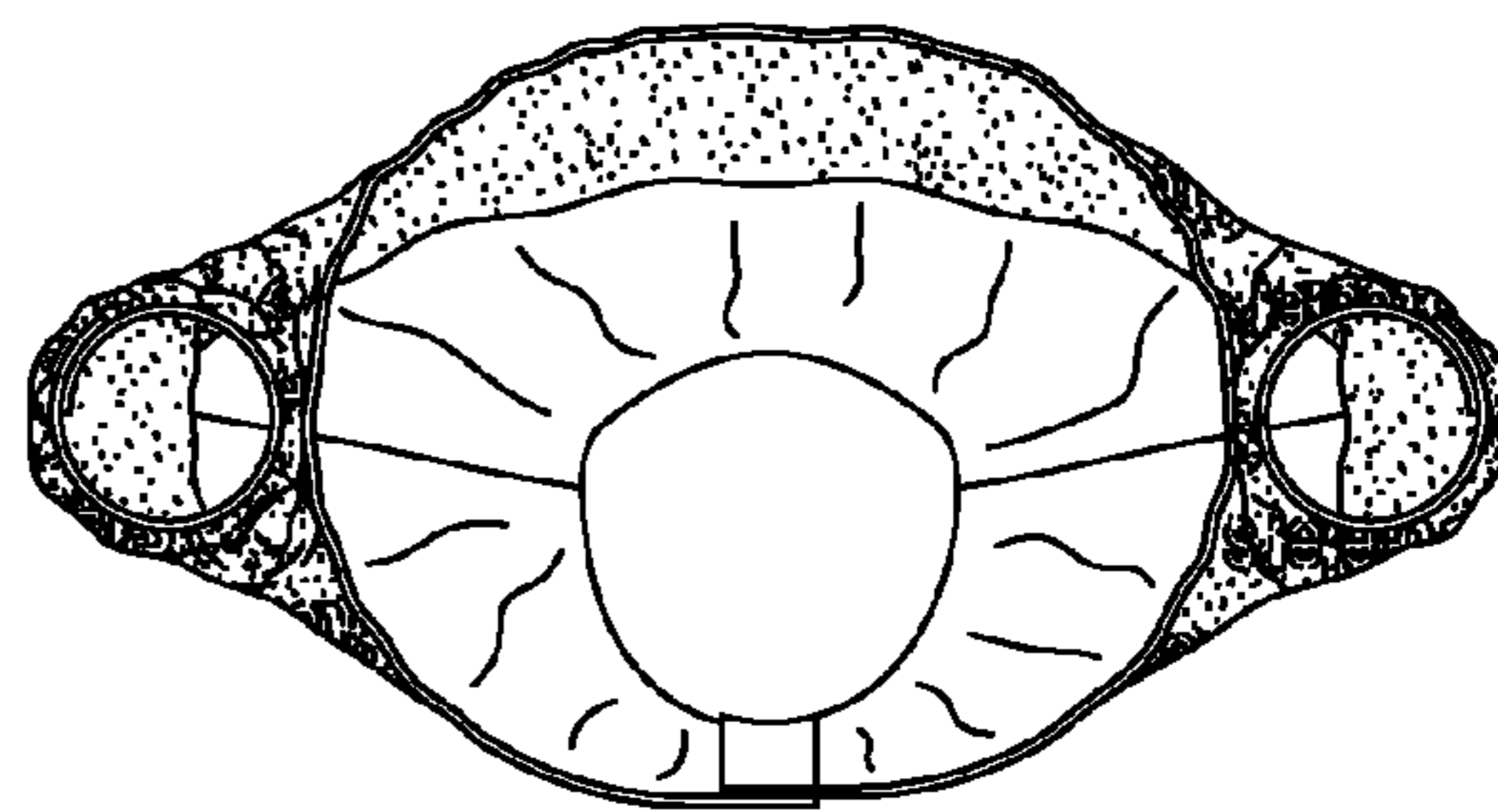
