FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.

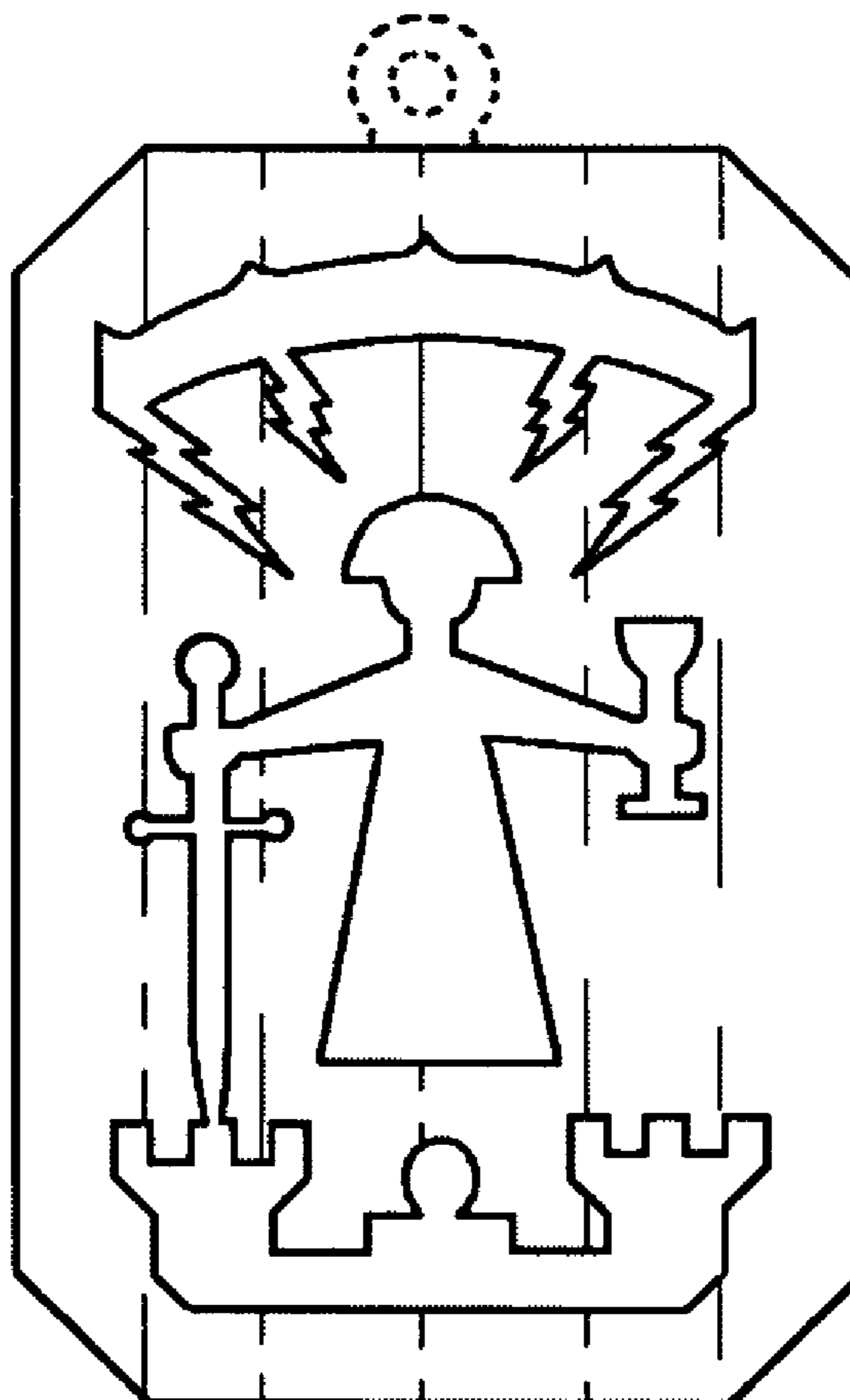
The broken lines are included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the jewelry medallion that form no part of the claimed design.

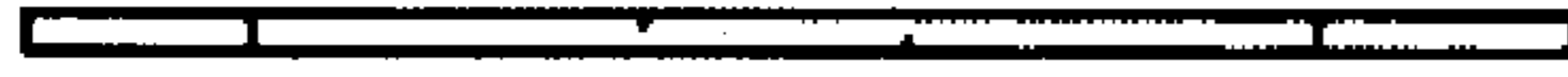

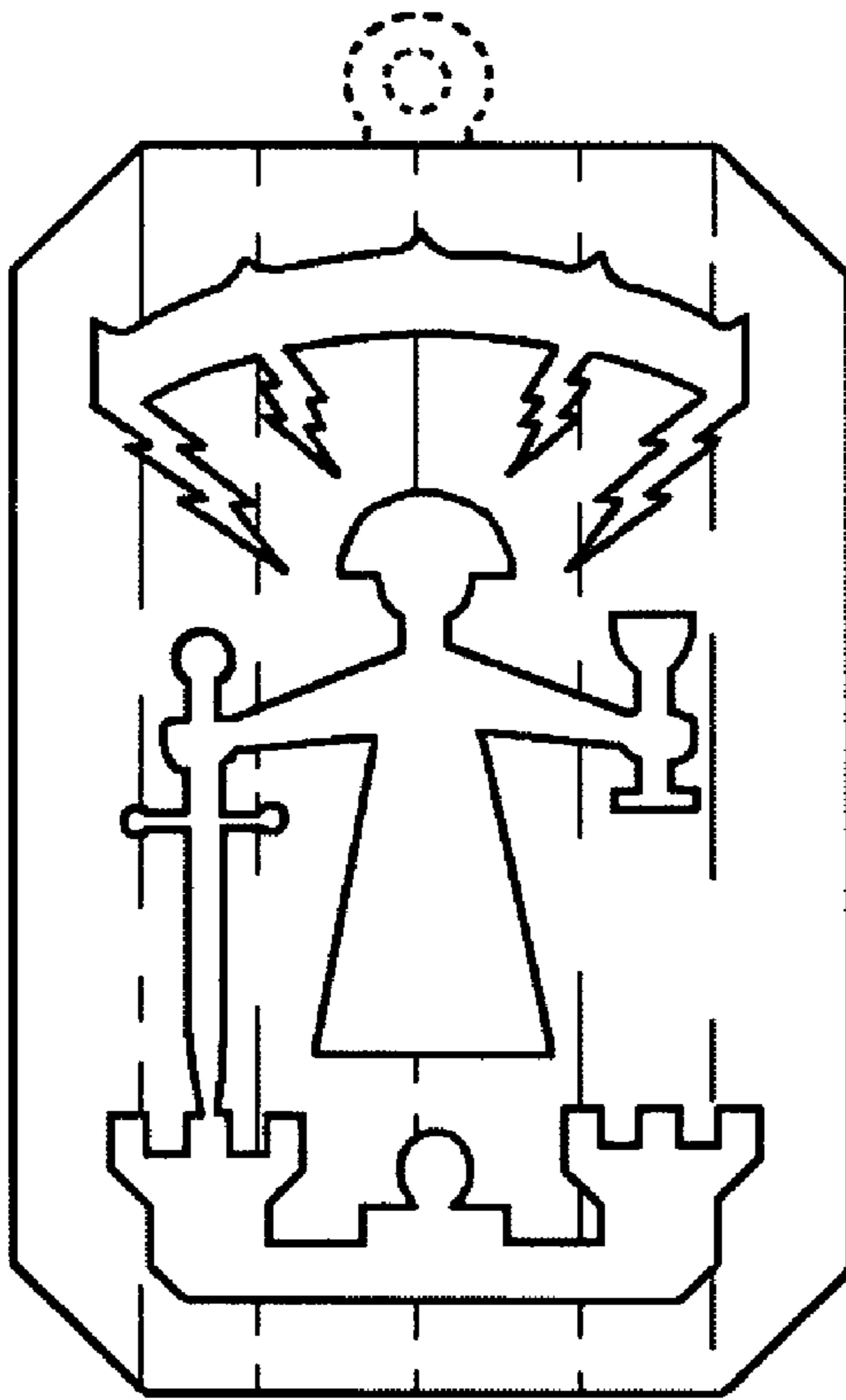

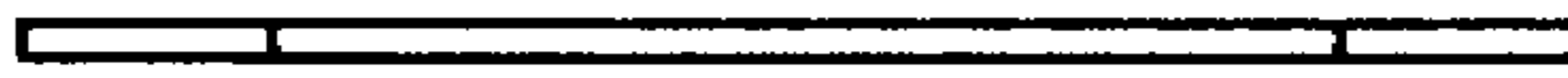
