FIG. 6 is a top, rear perspective view thereof;

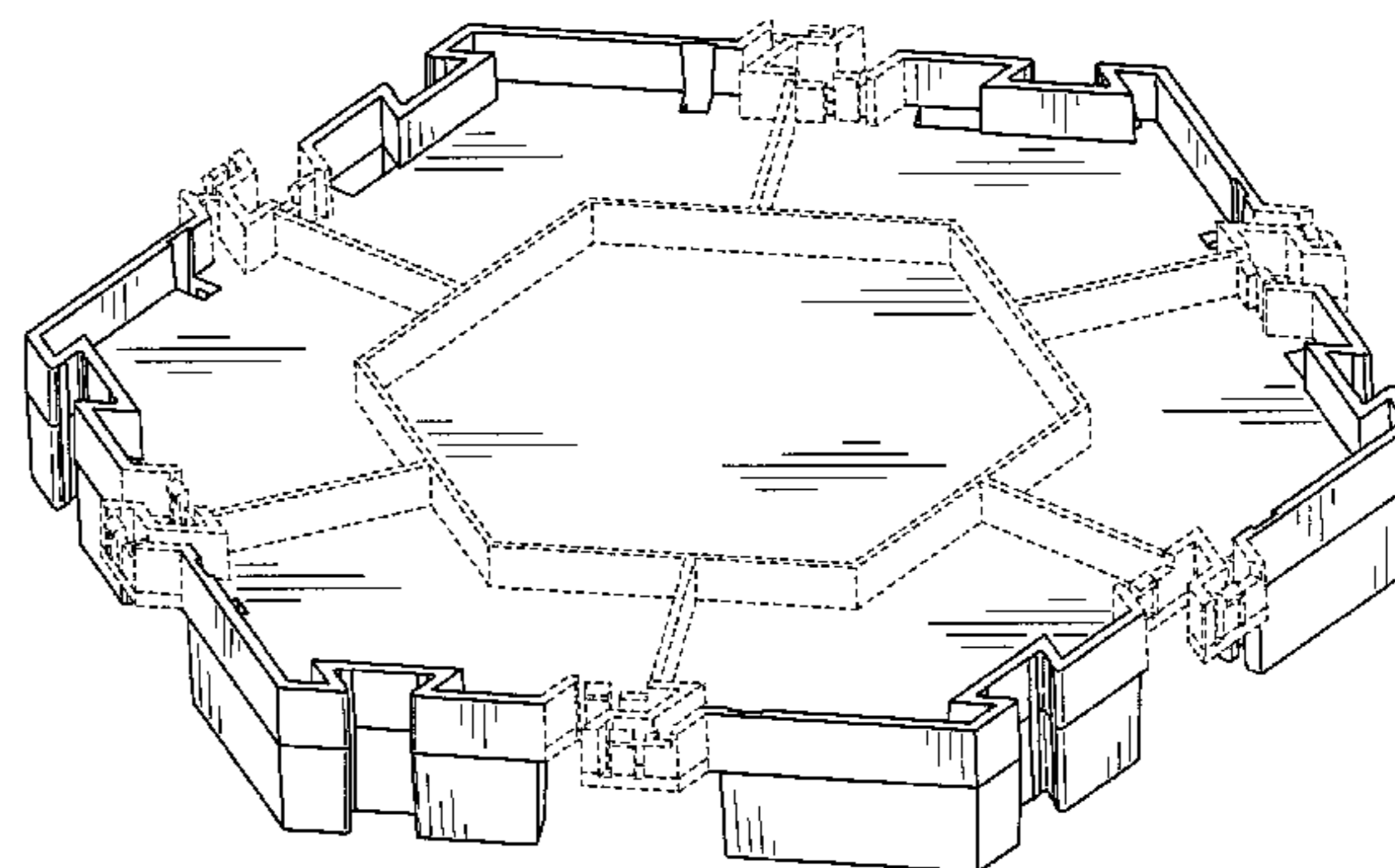
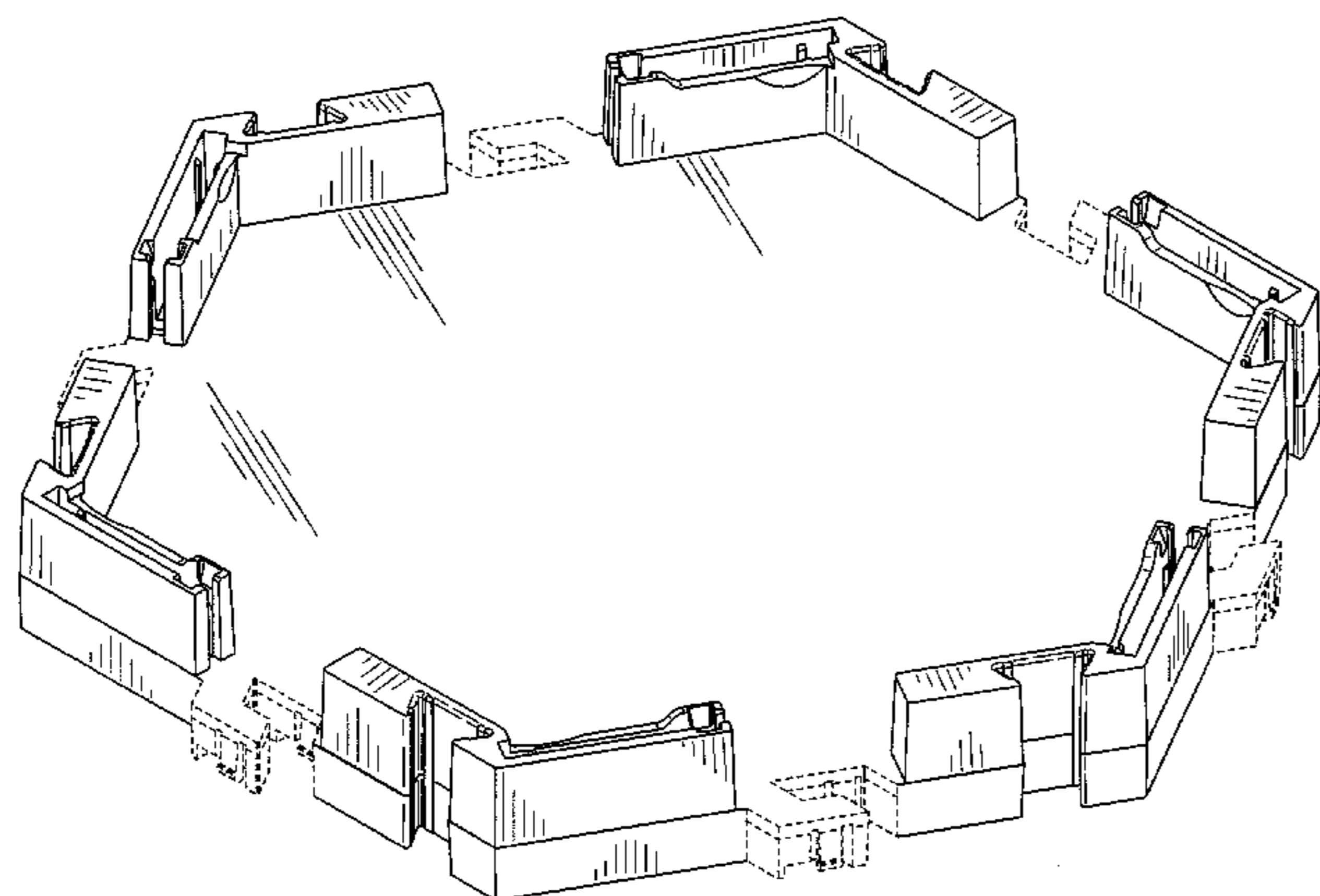
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

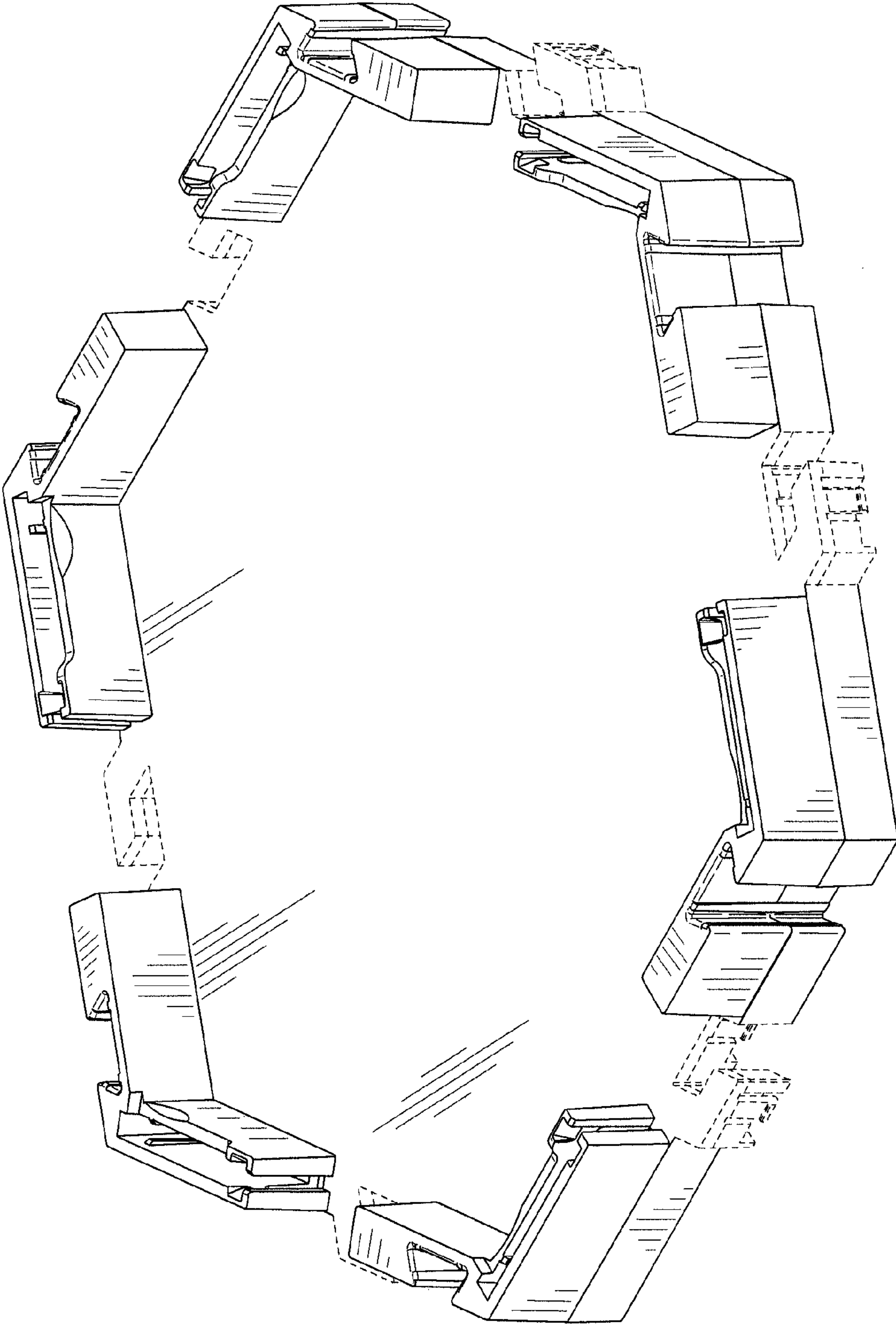

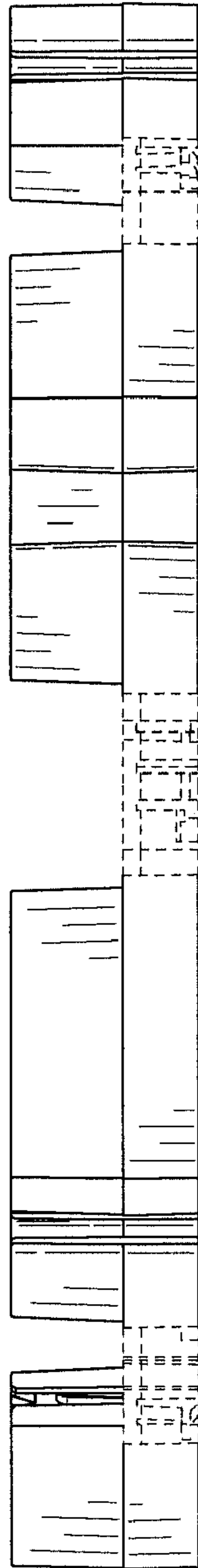

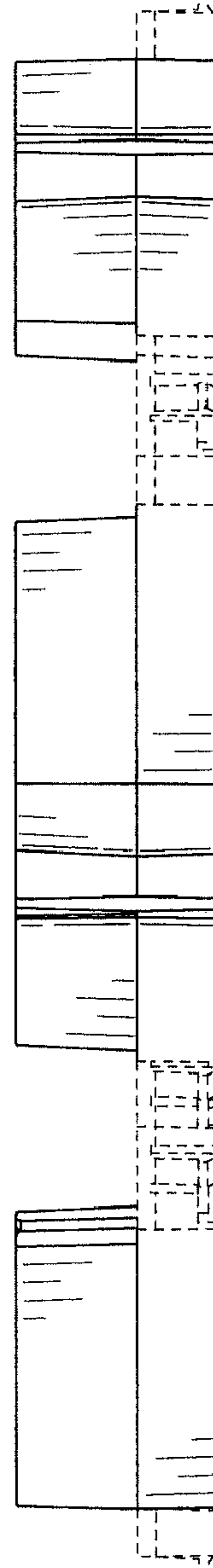

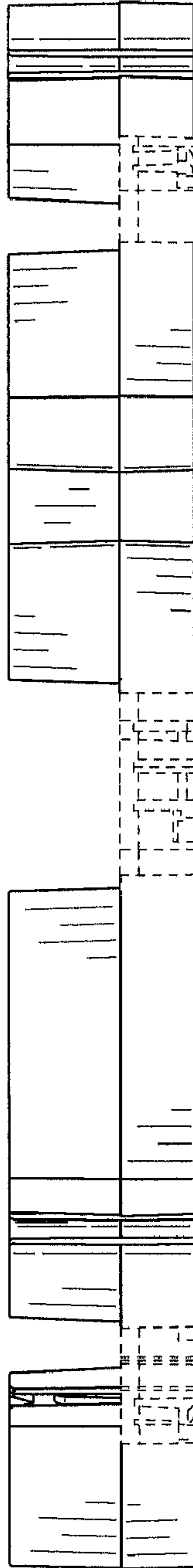

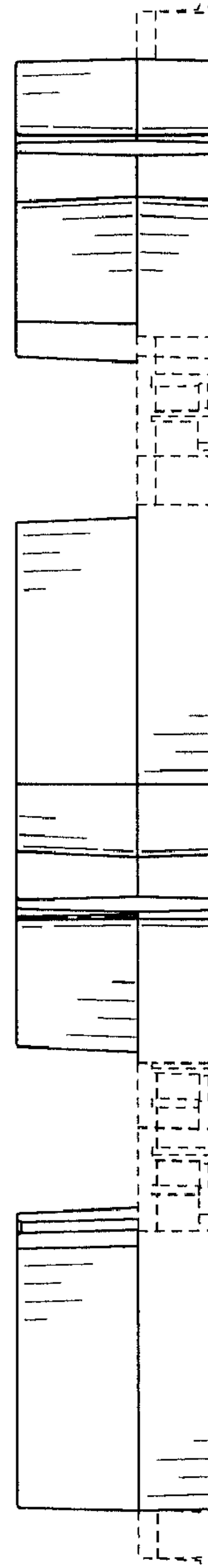

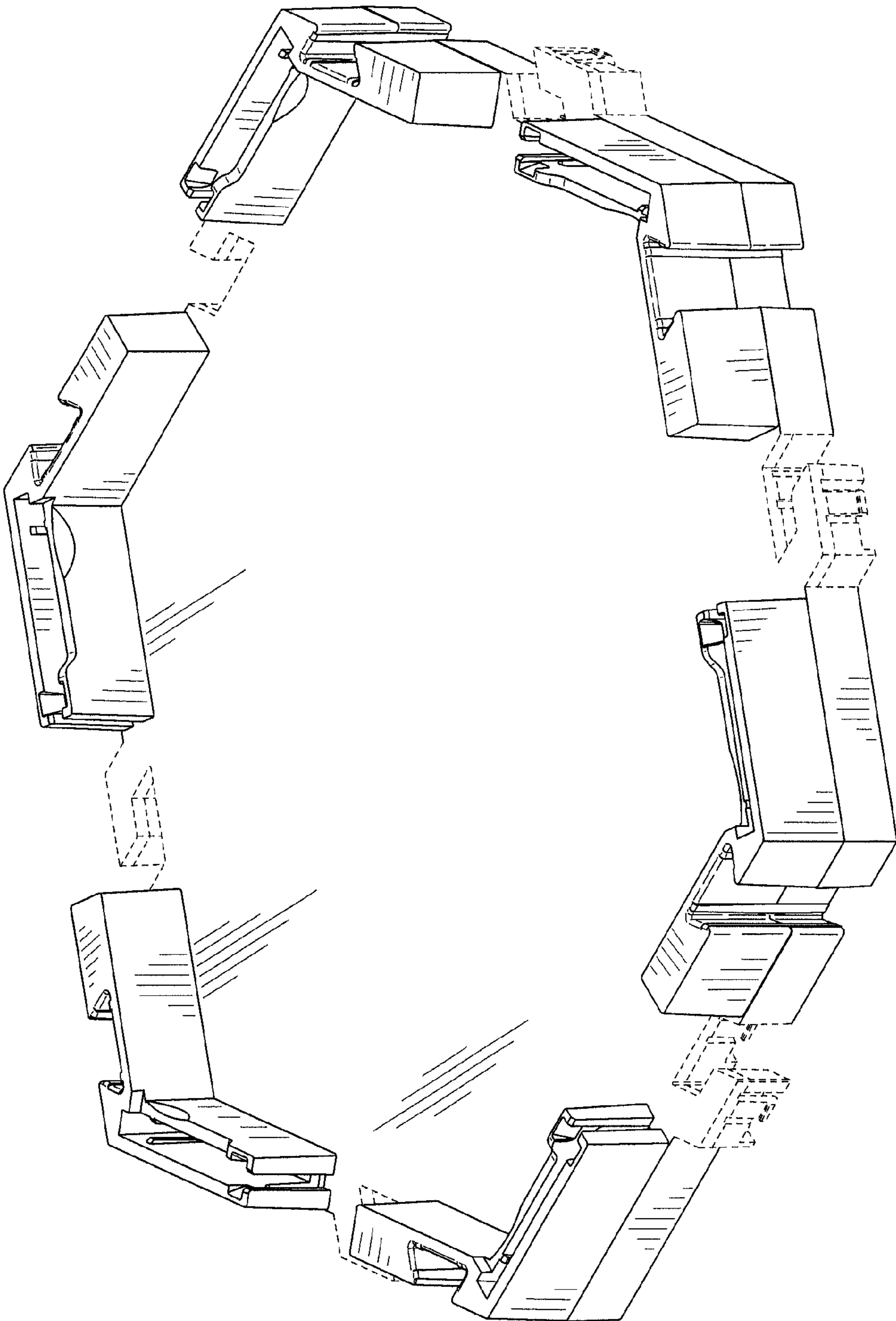

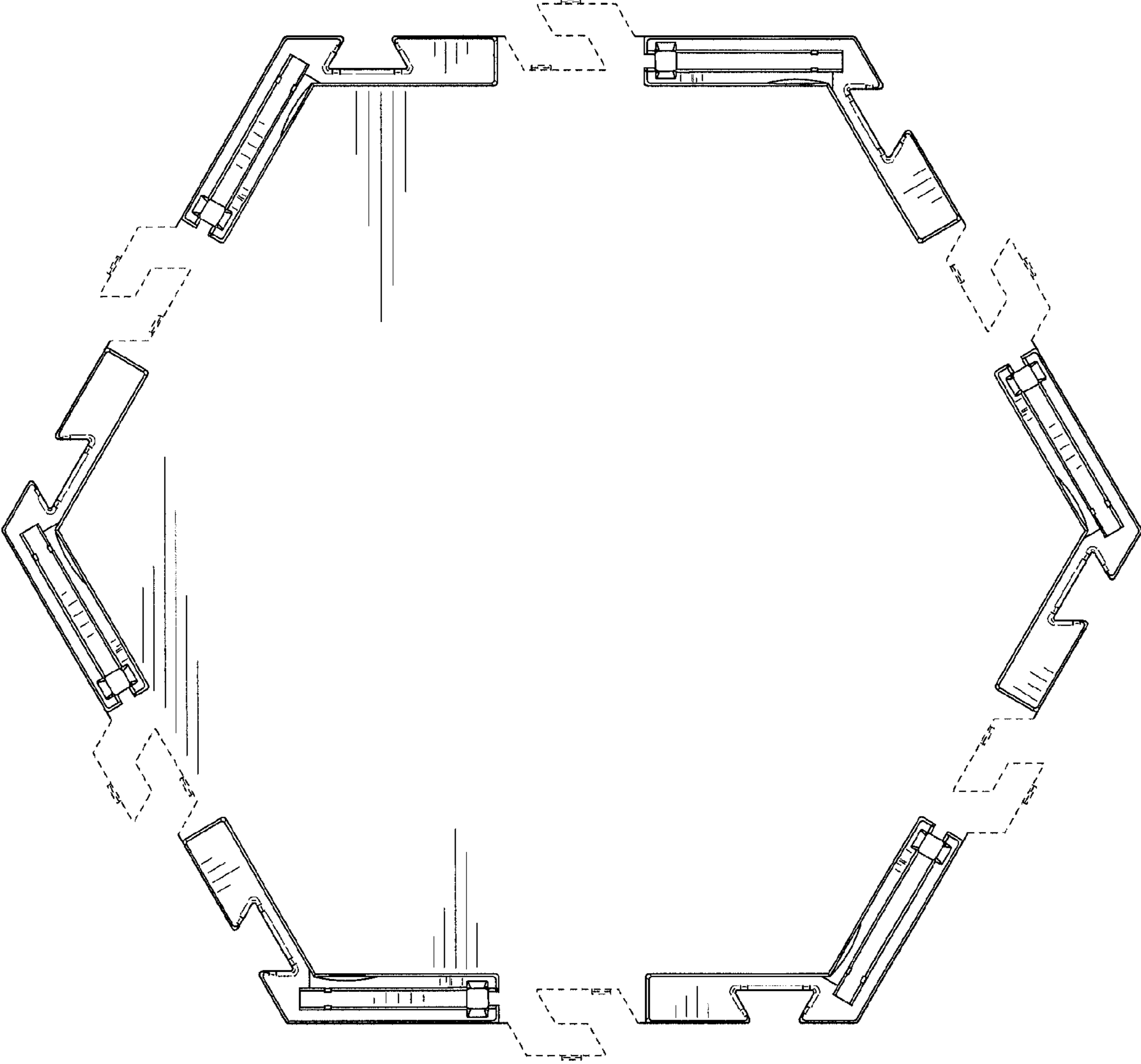

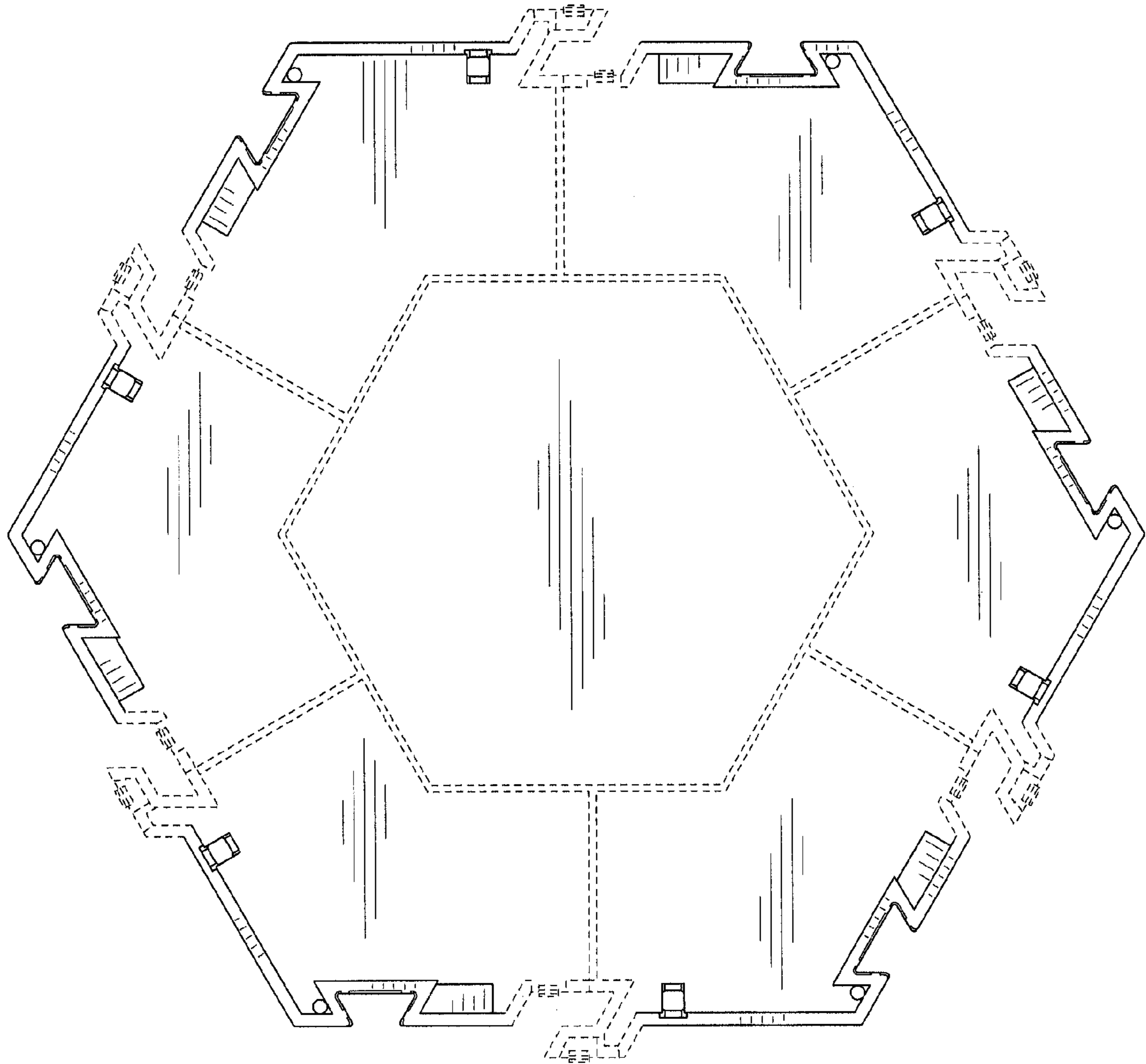

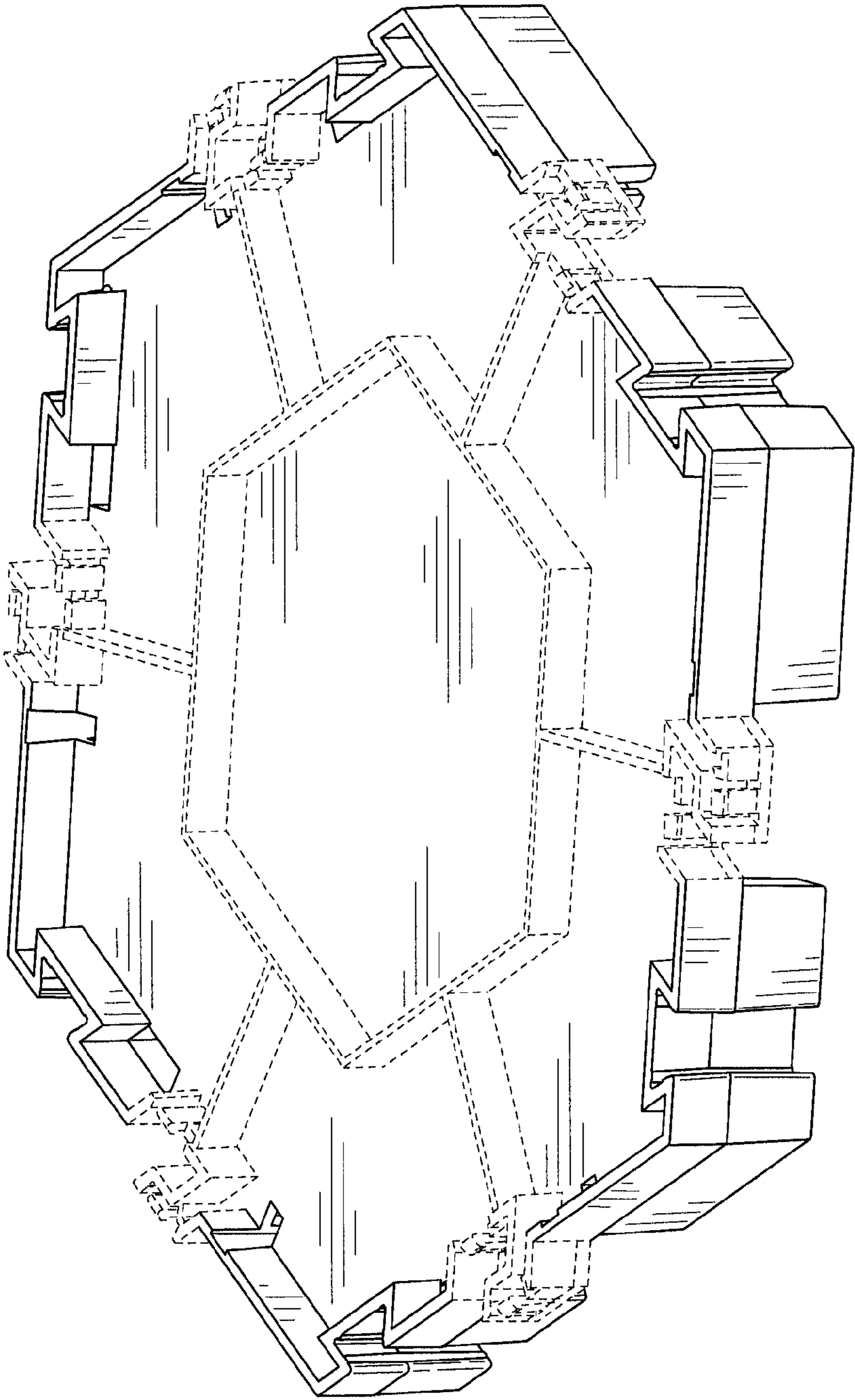
