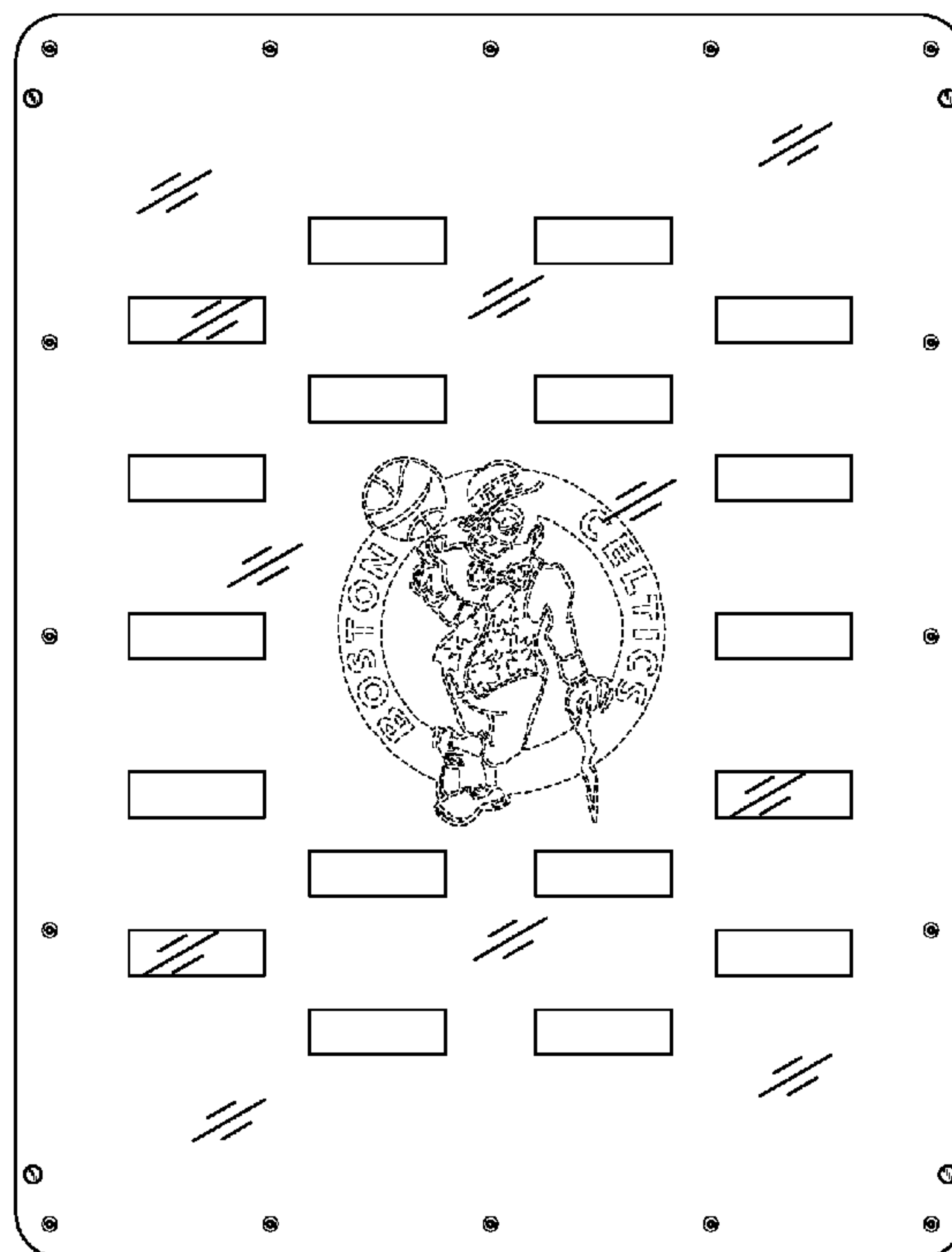

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wall display;  
FIG. 2 is an exploded perspective view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 1, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 1, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and,  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof.  
The broken lines in FIGS. 1, 2, and 5 showing team logos and the broken lines in FIG. 1 depicting a vehicle window flag depict environmental matter, and form no part of the claimed design.

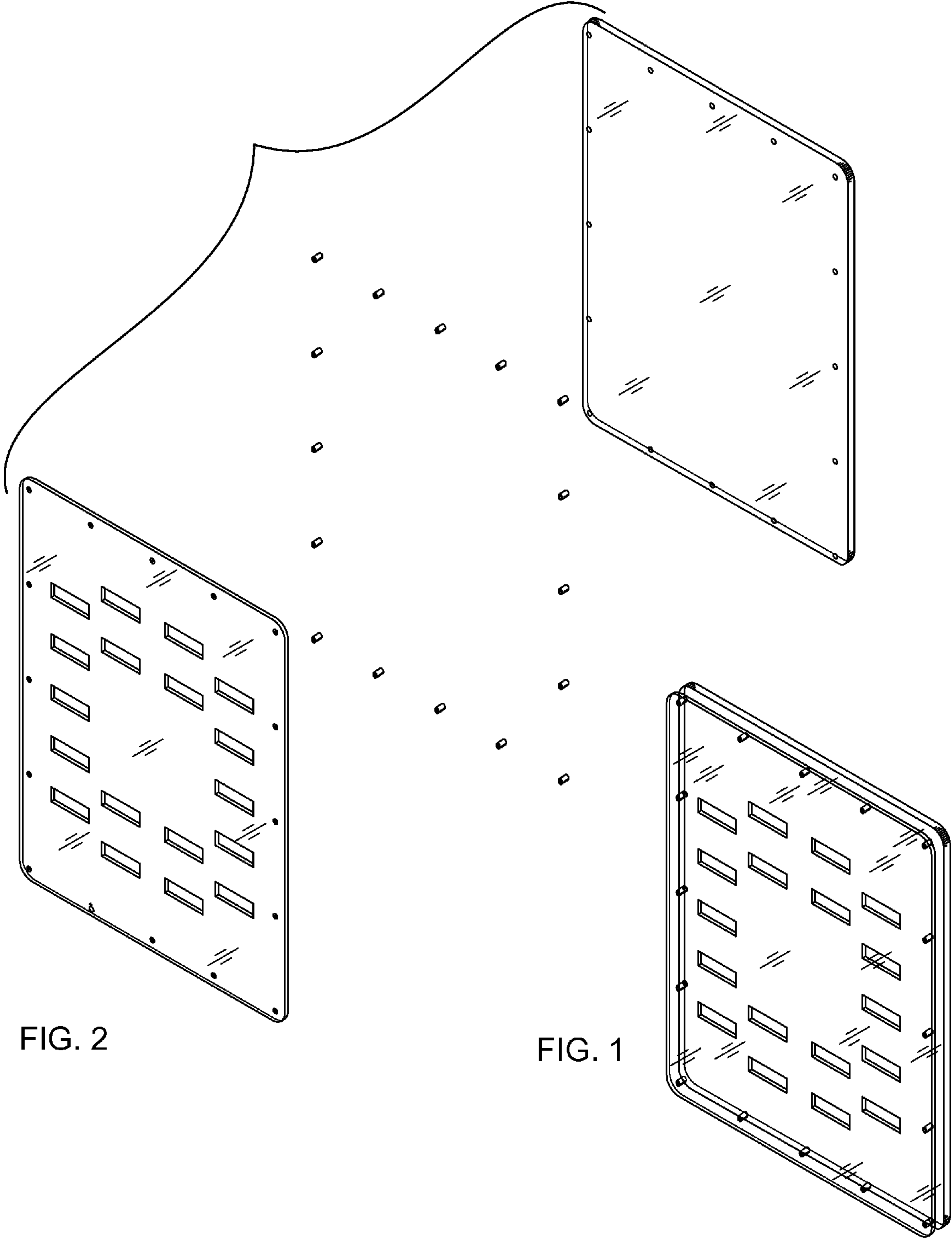

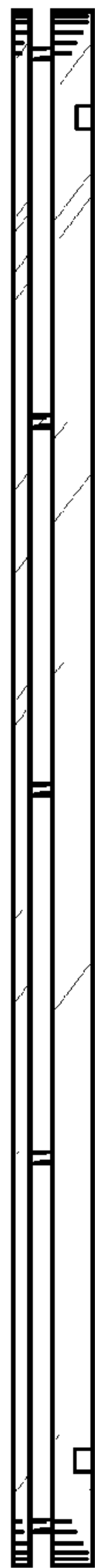

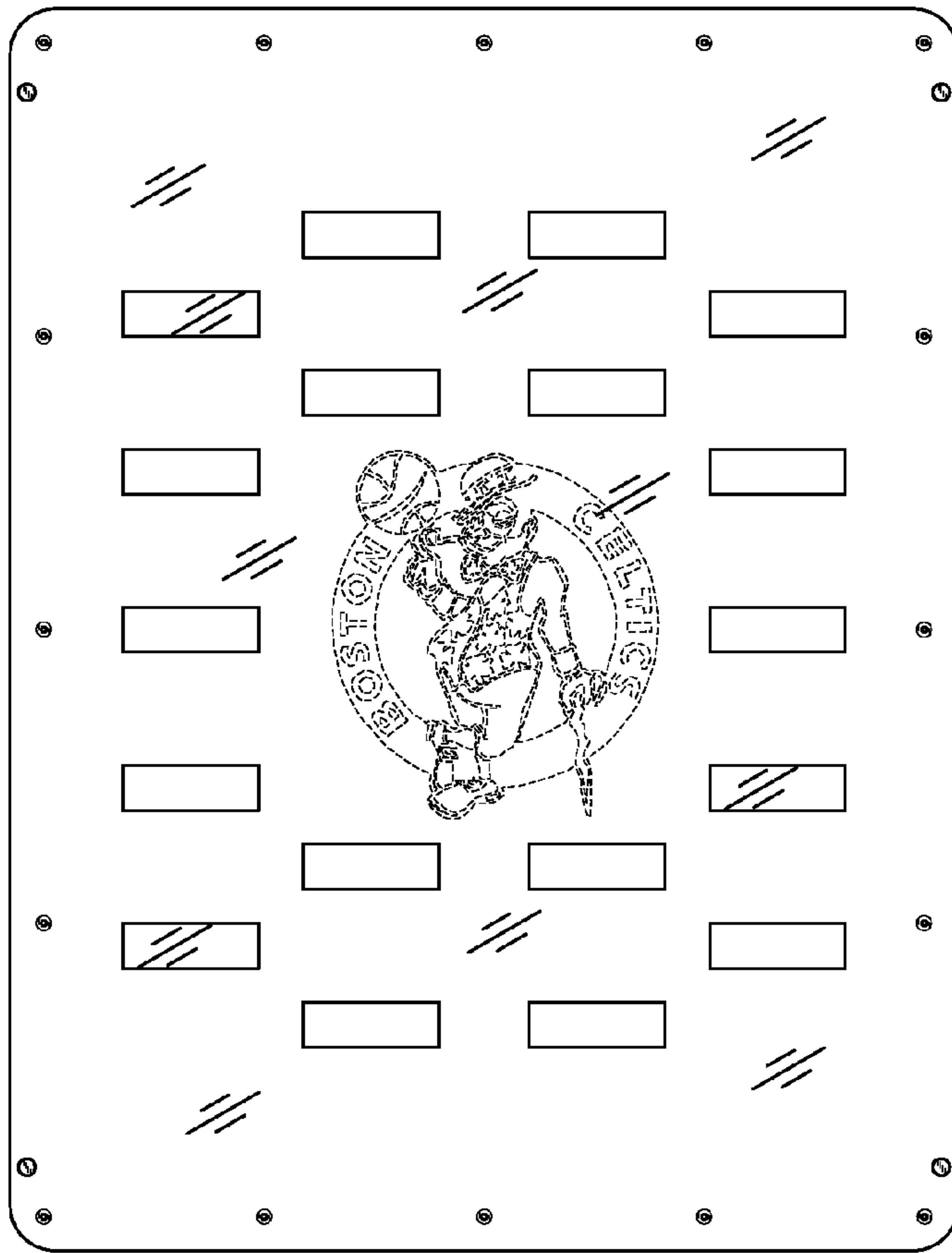
